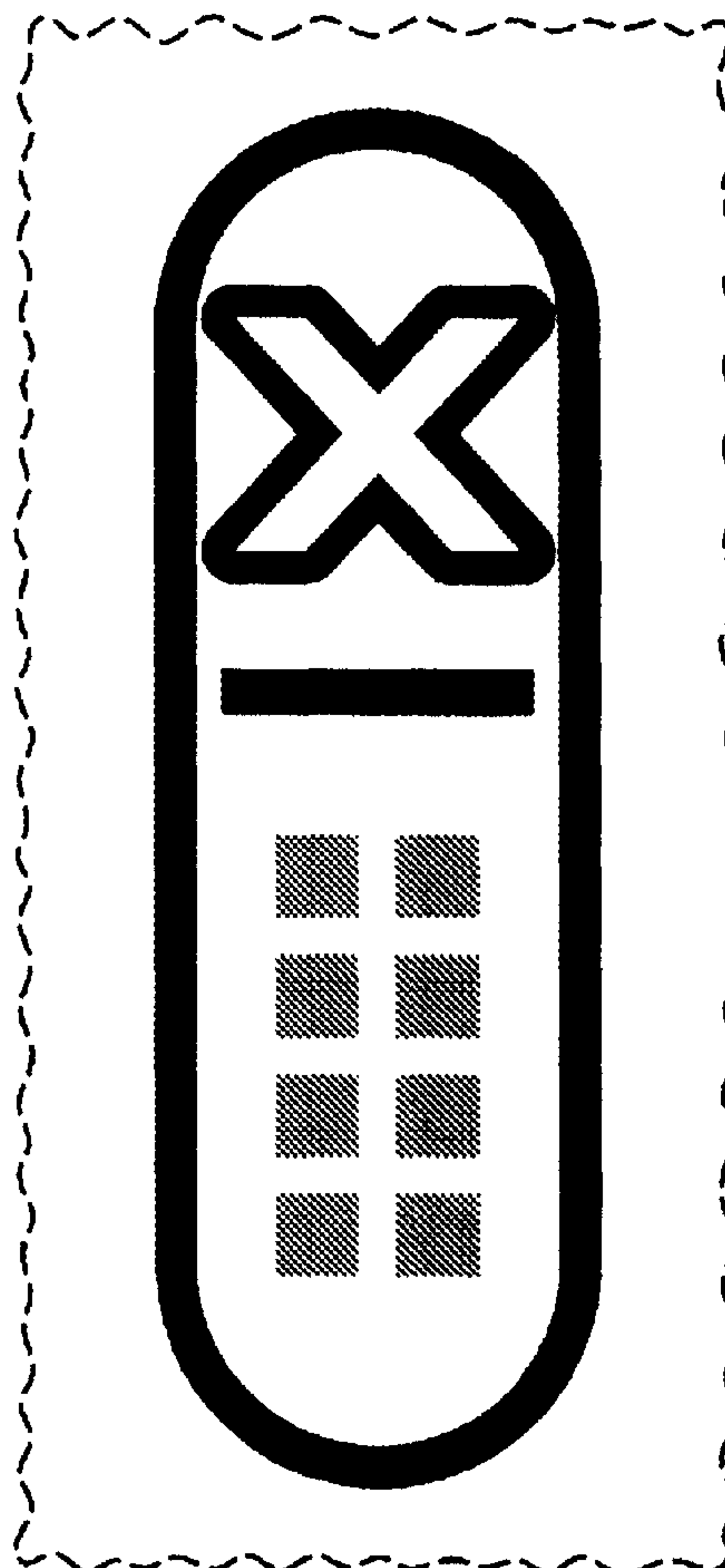
The ornamental design for an icon for a portion of a display screen, as shown and described.

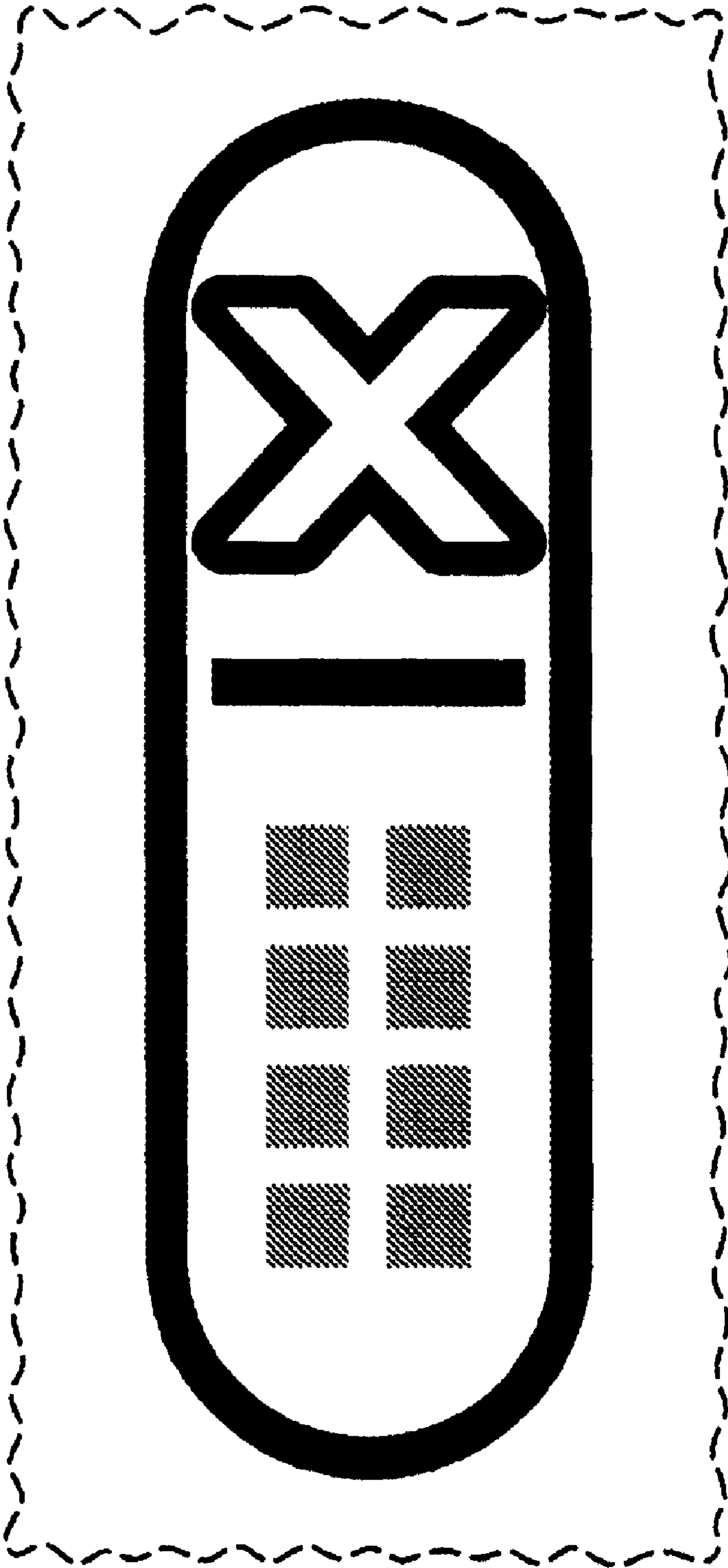
DESCRIPTION

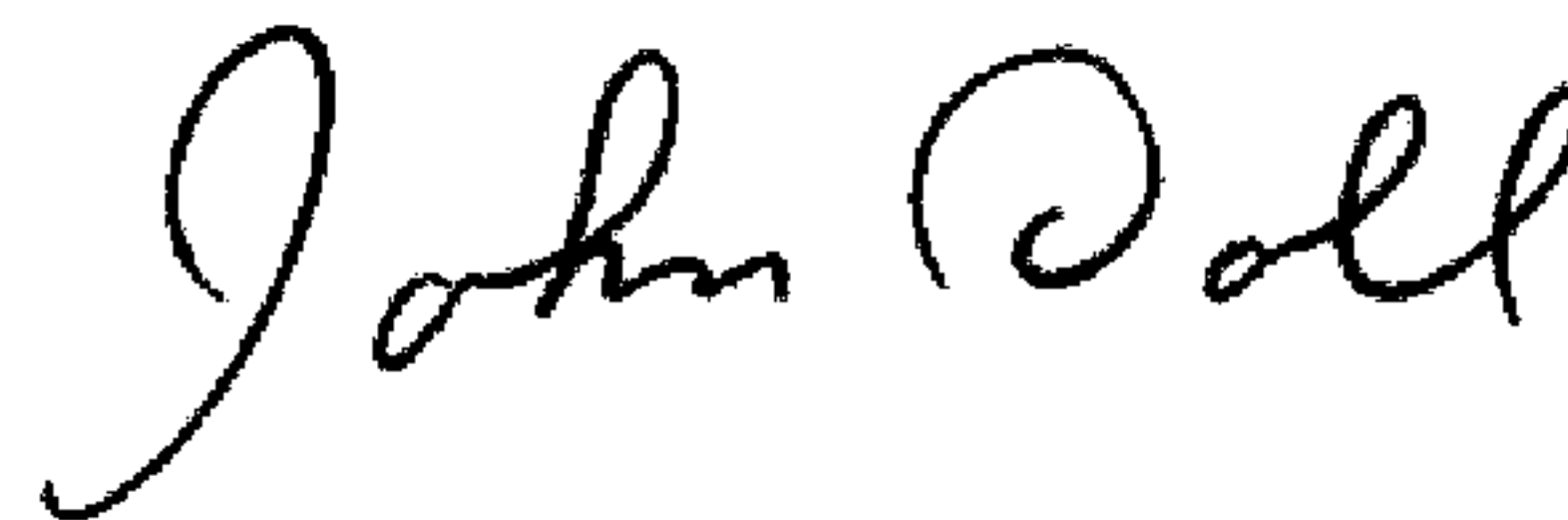
