 new design;

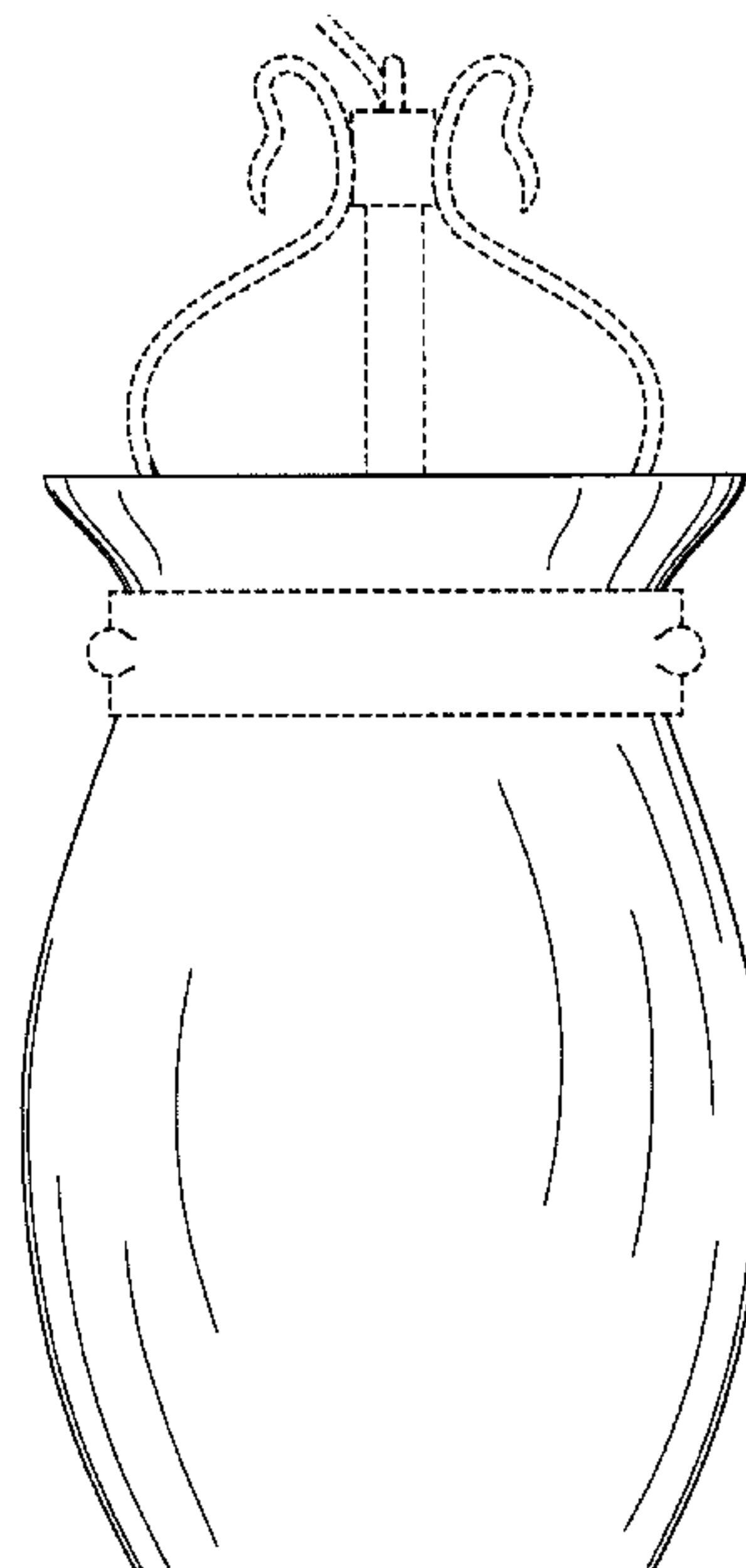
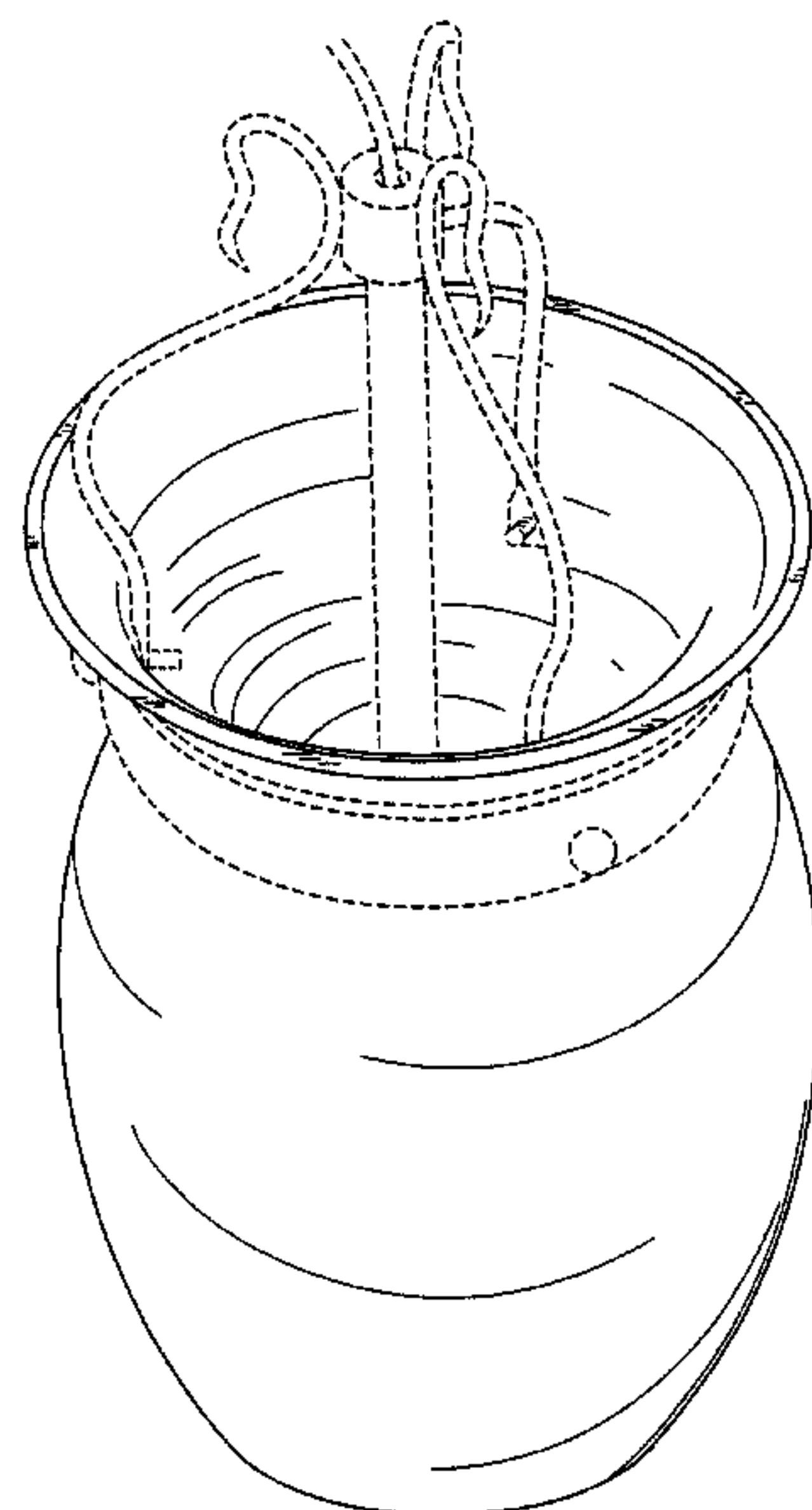
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view of the pendant light as

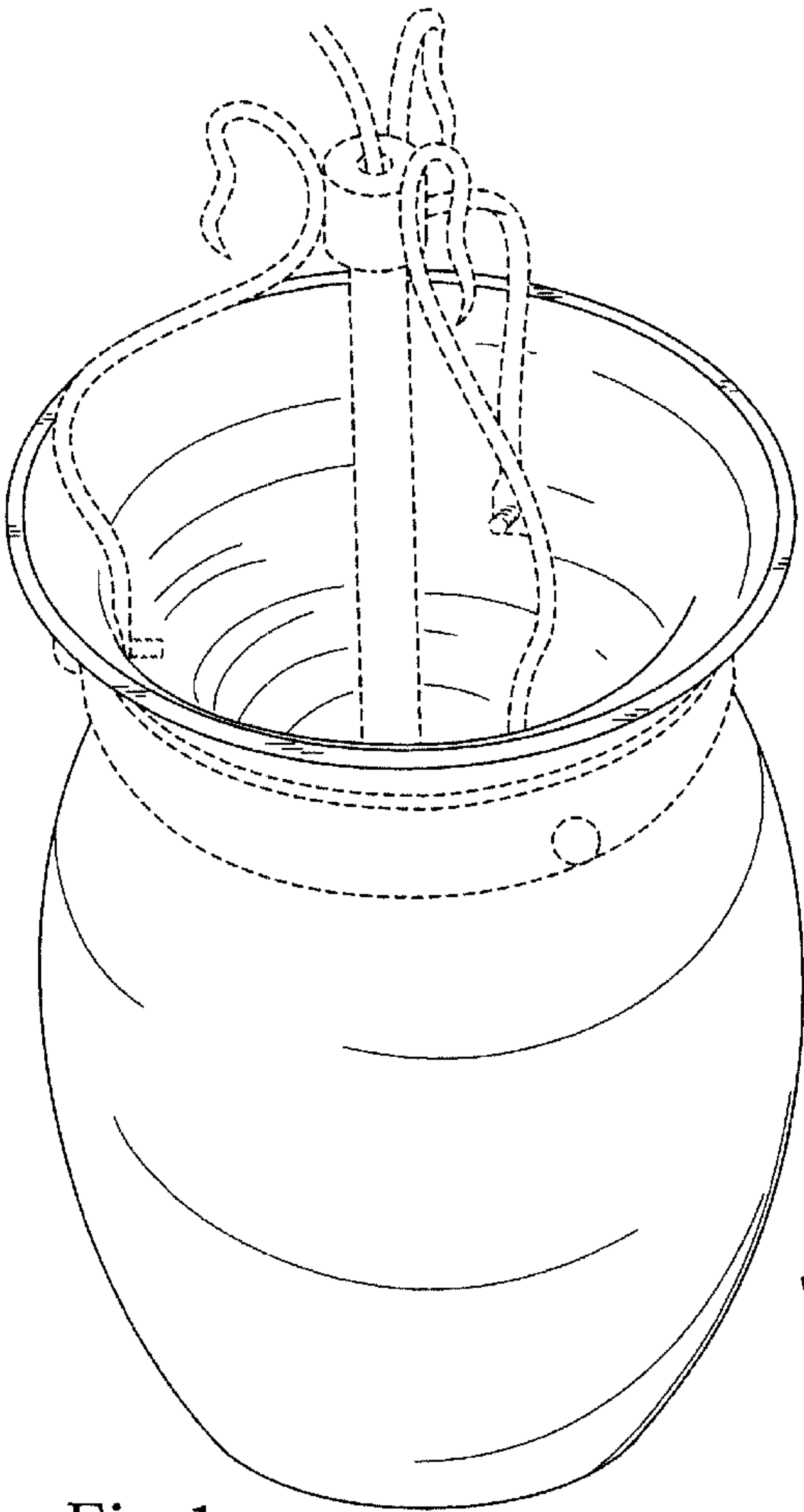

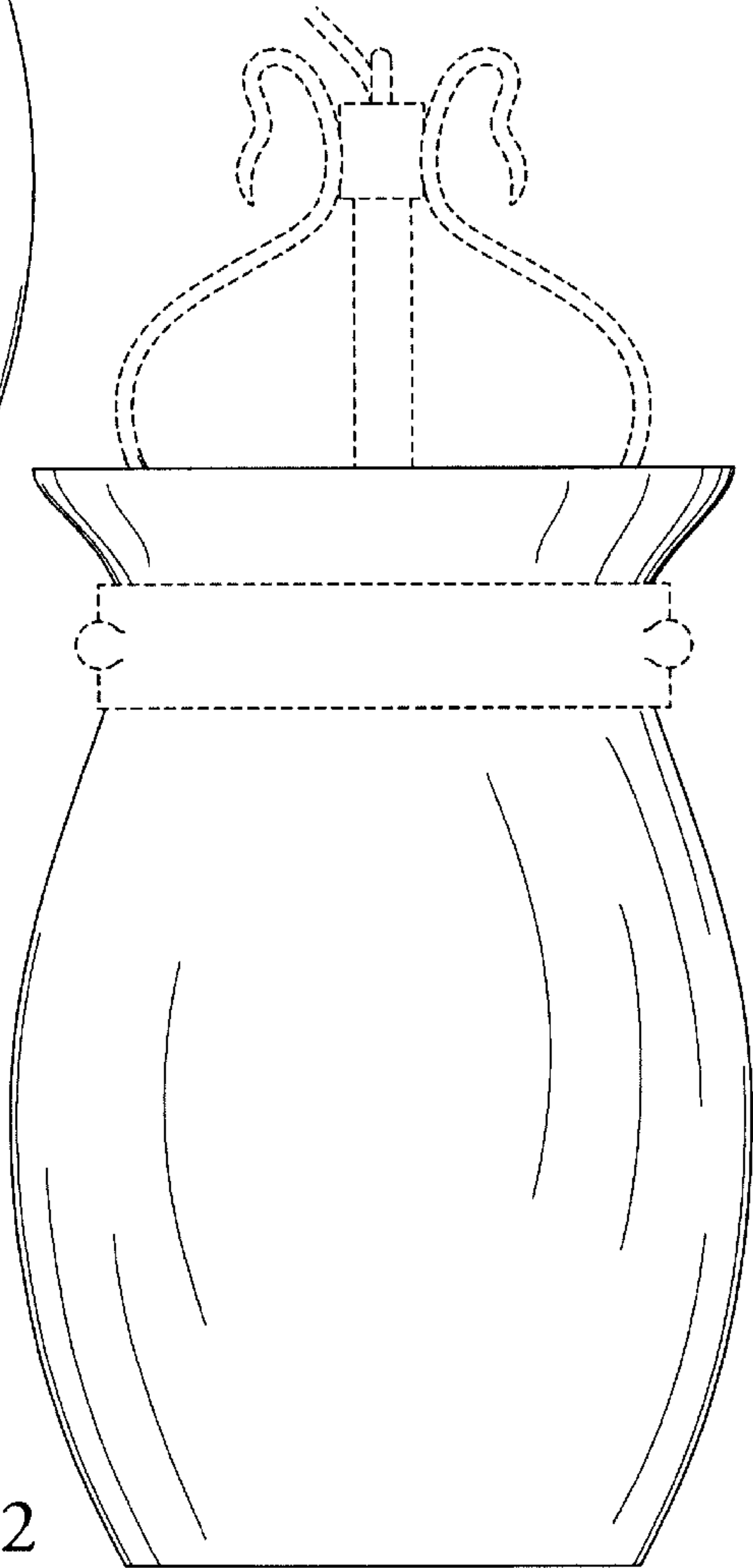

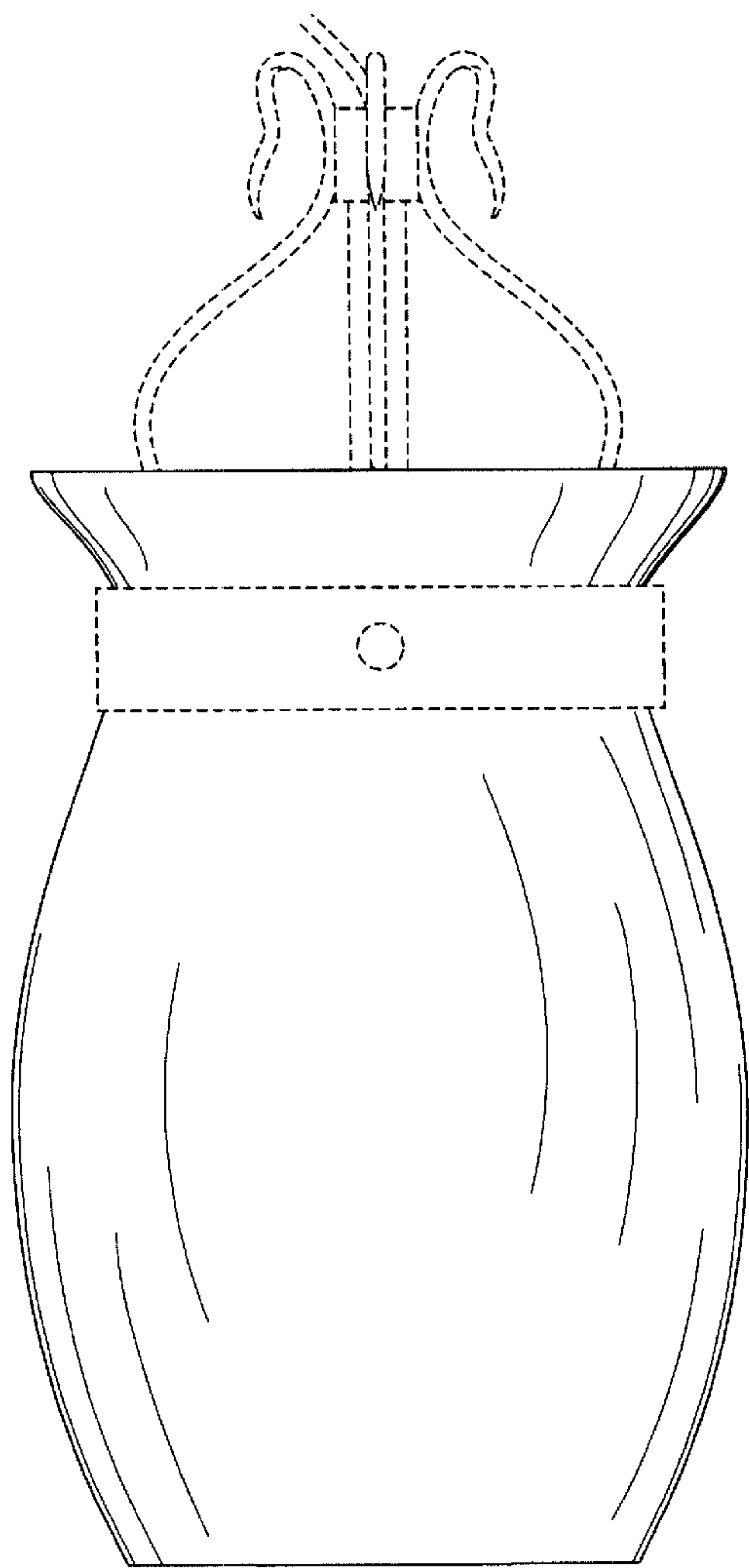

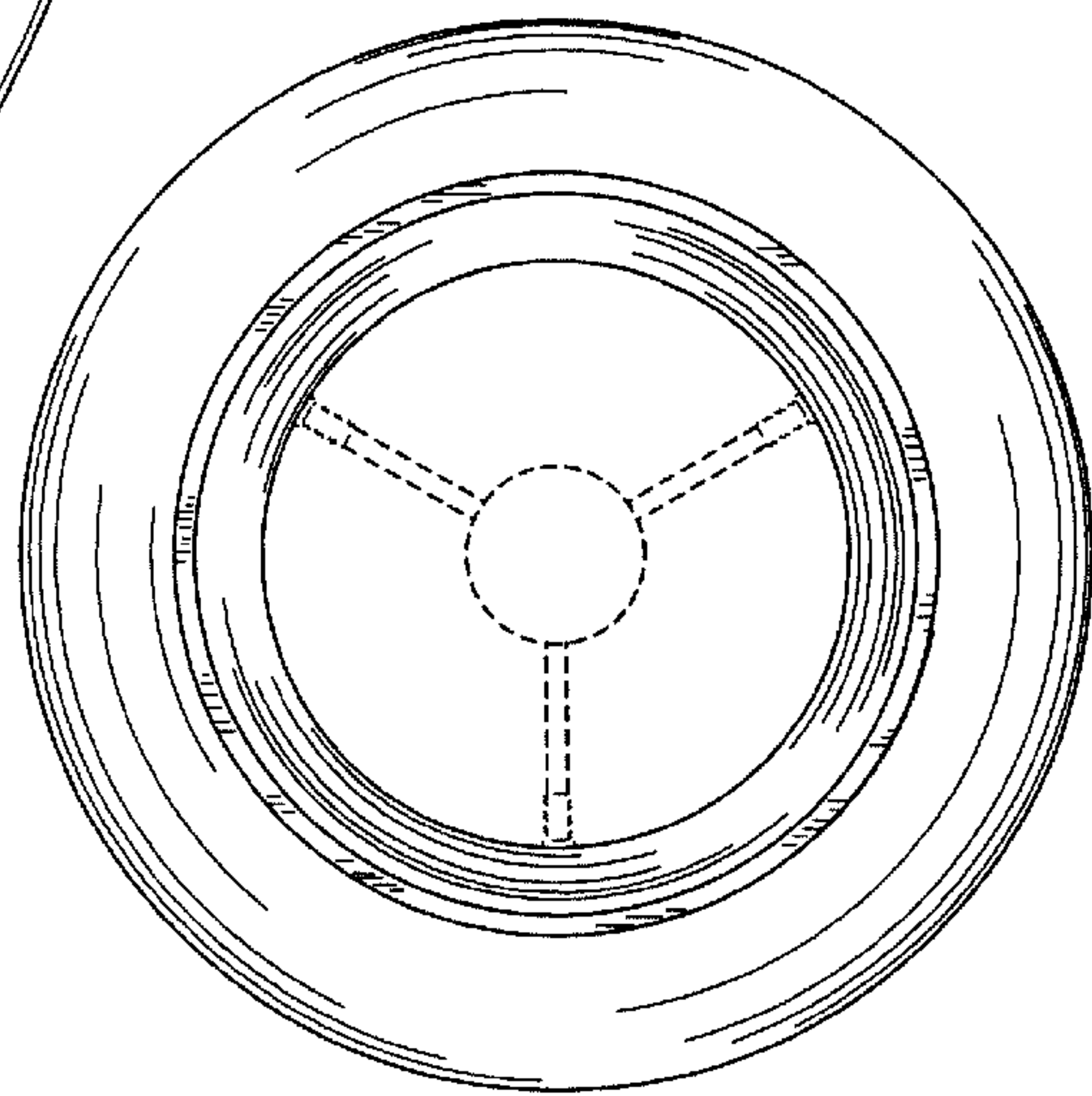
