The ornamental design for a golf shoe upper, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a rear perspective view of a golf shoe upper showing my new design;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof;

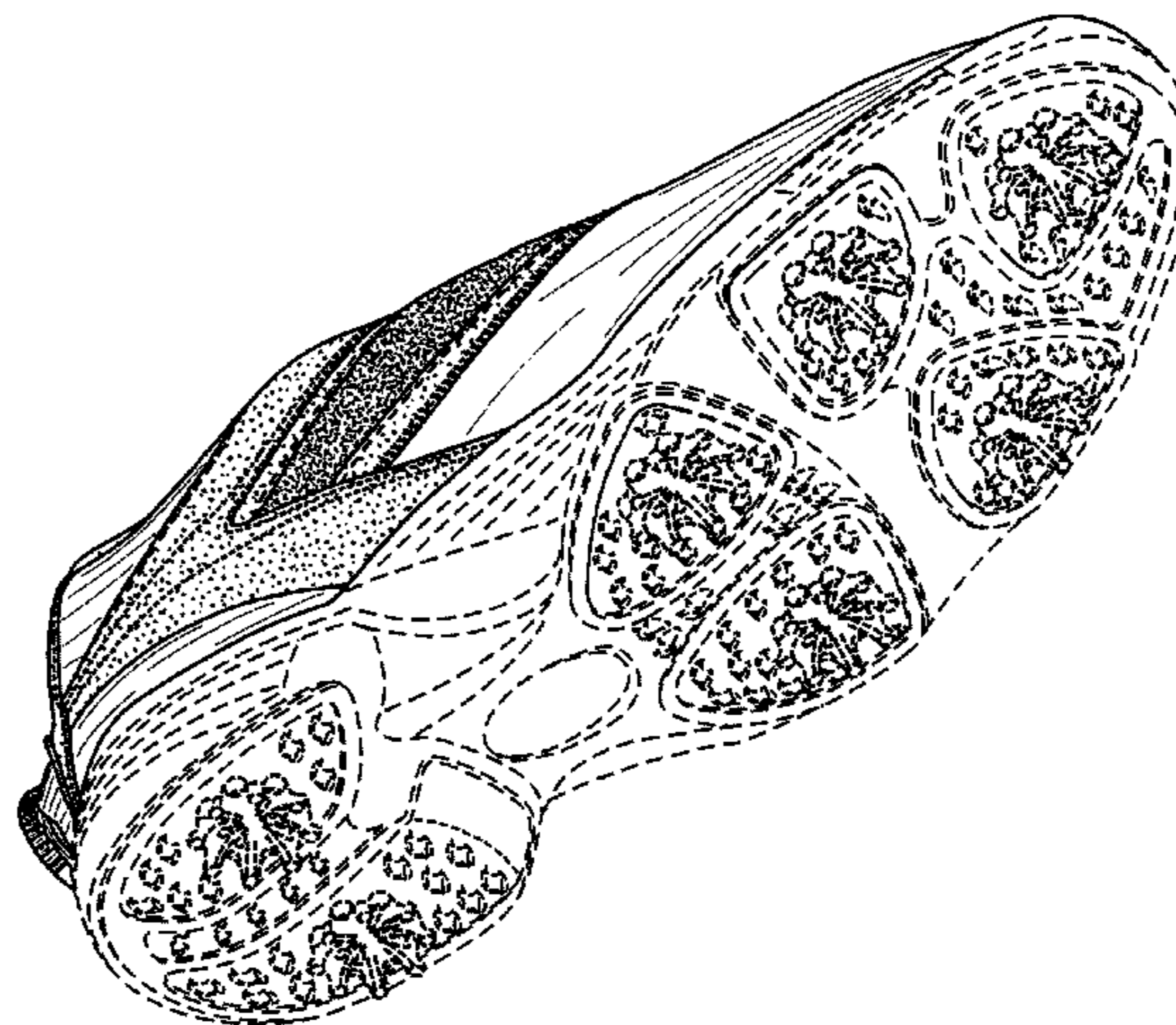
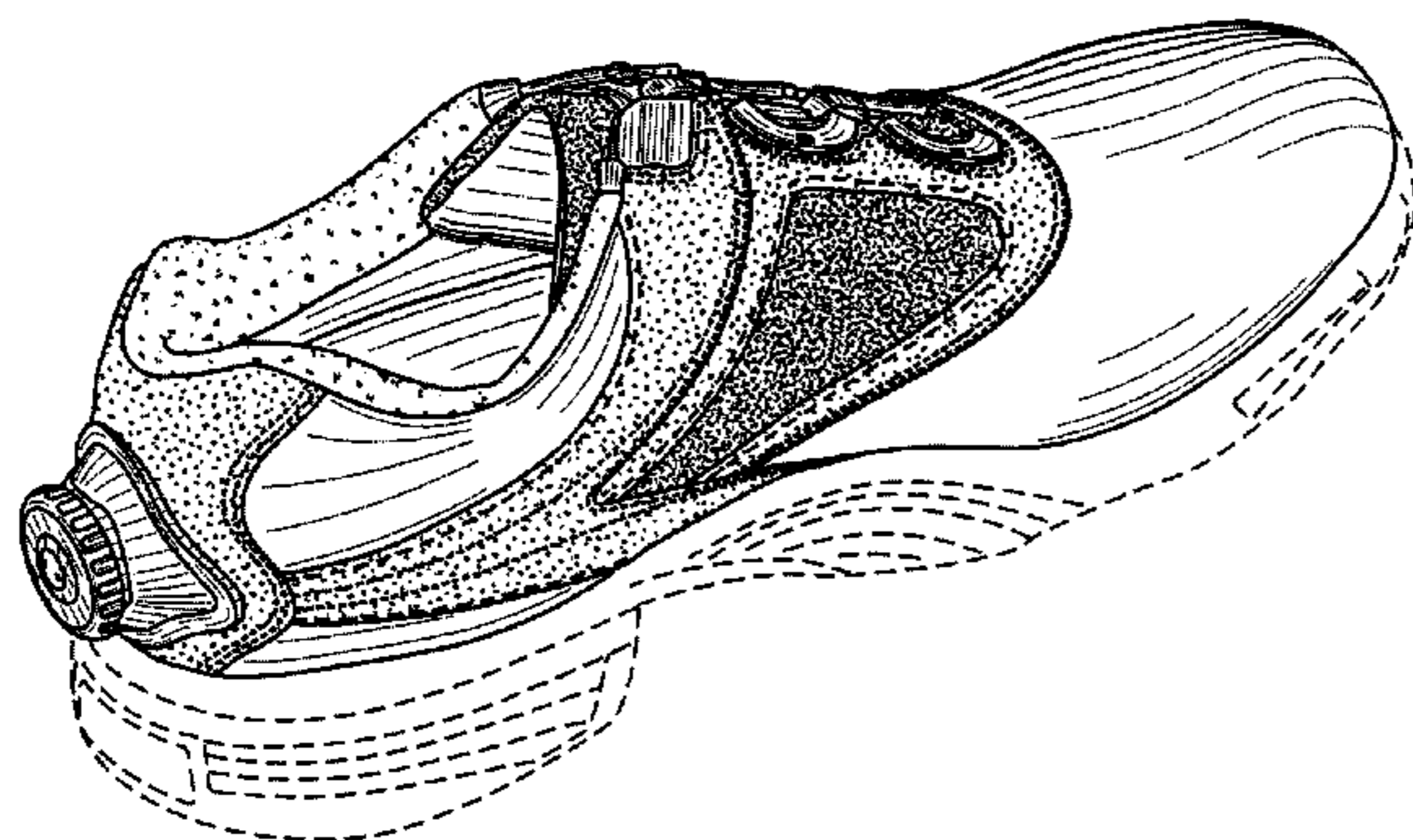
FIG. 6 is a left side elevational view thereof;

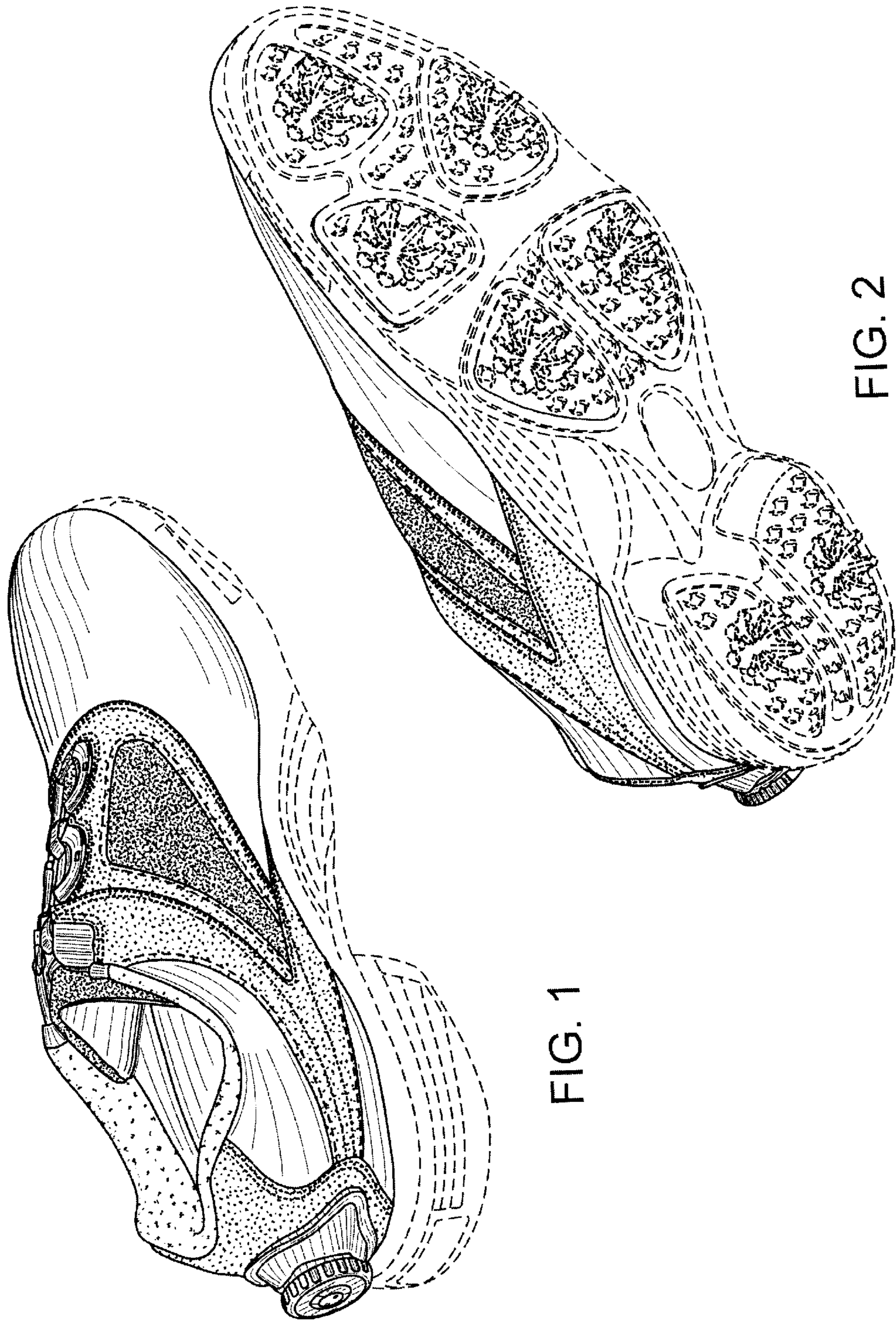

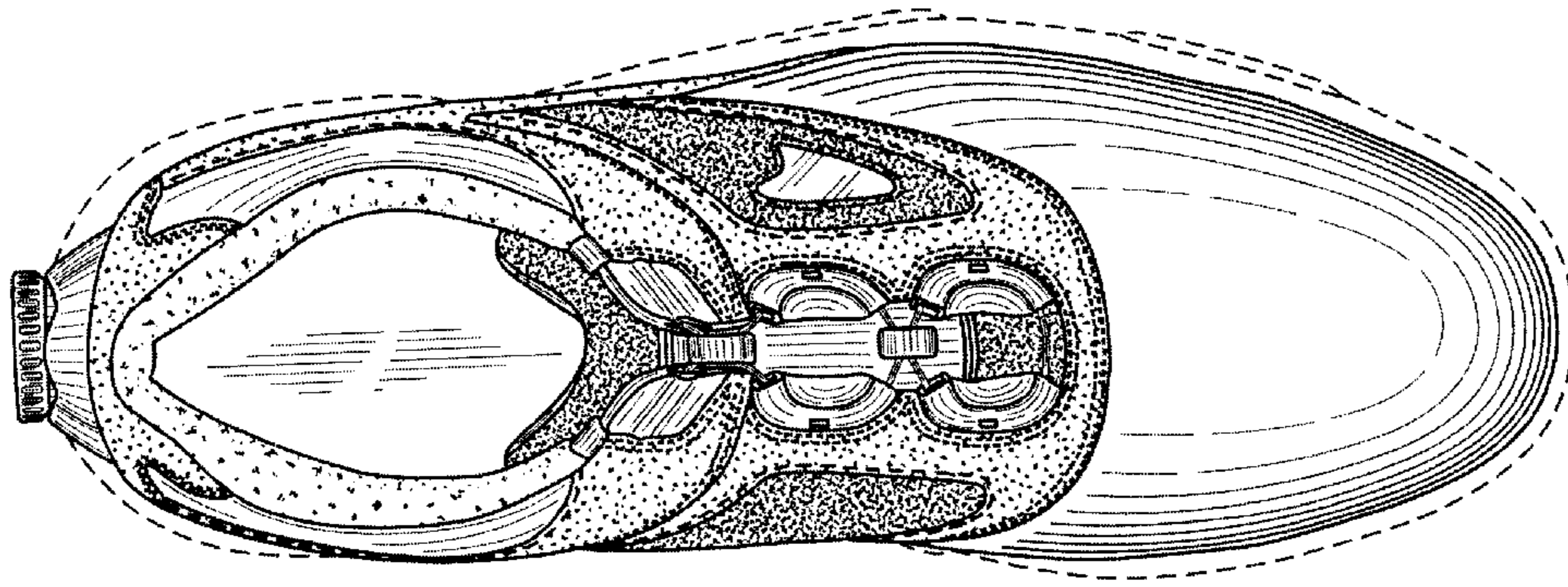

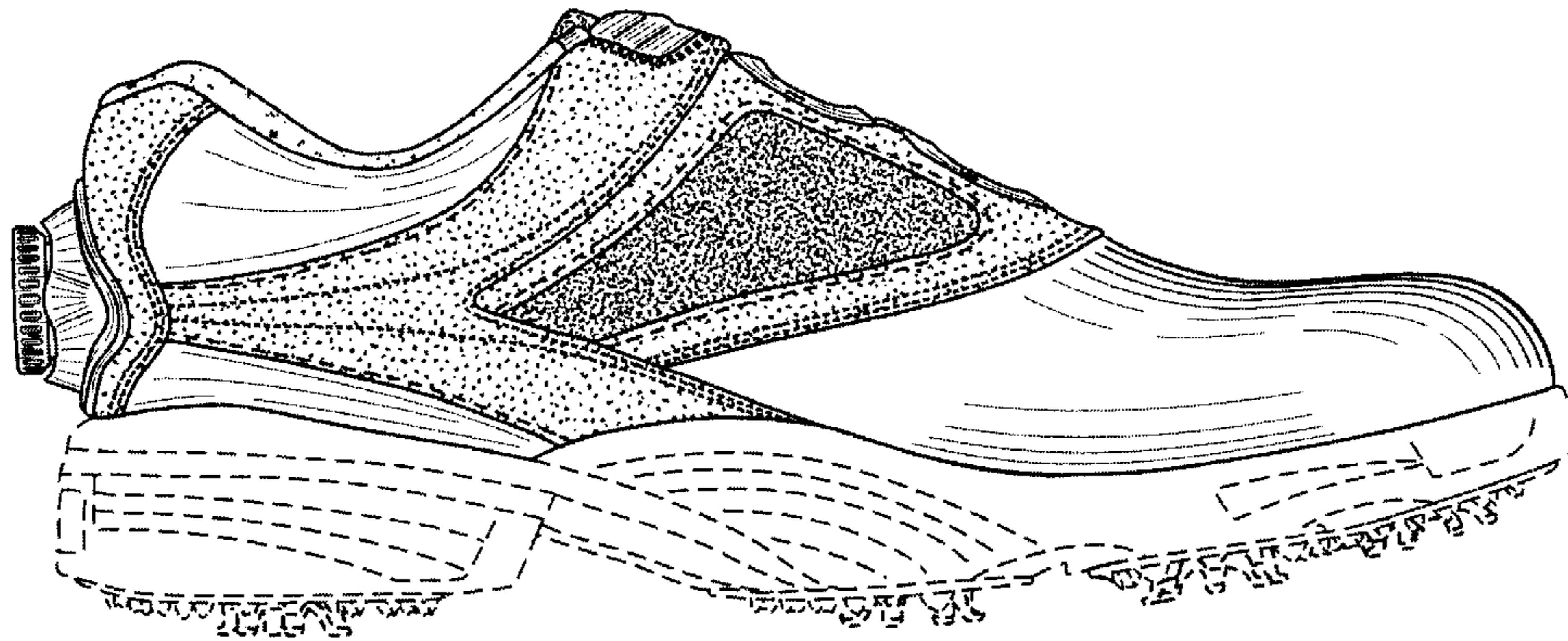

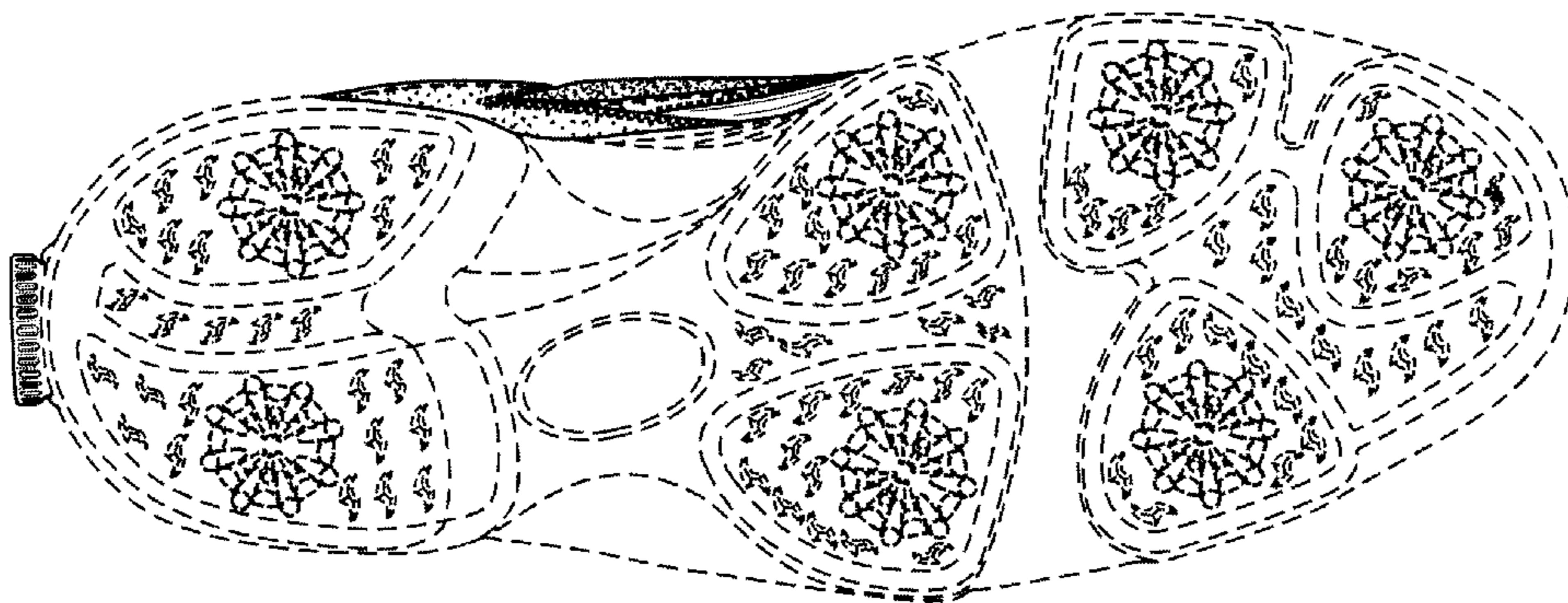

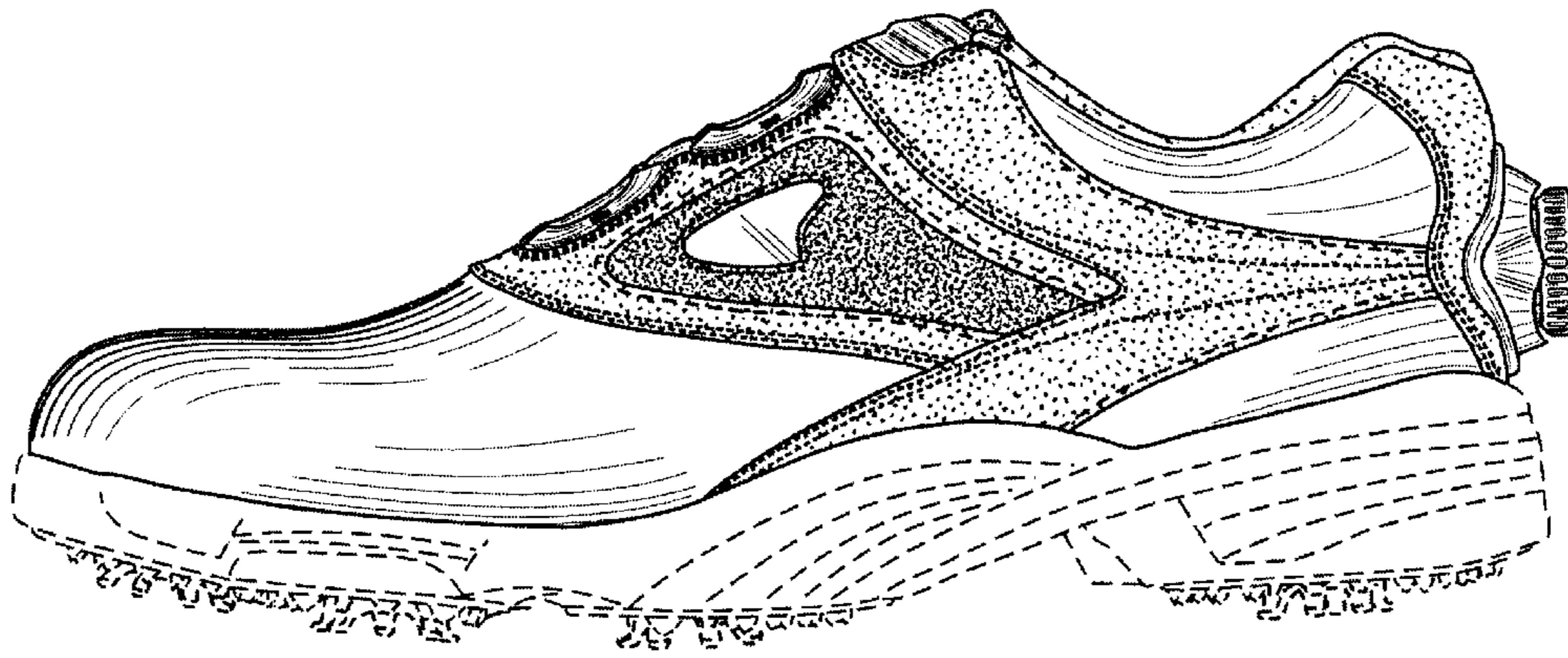

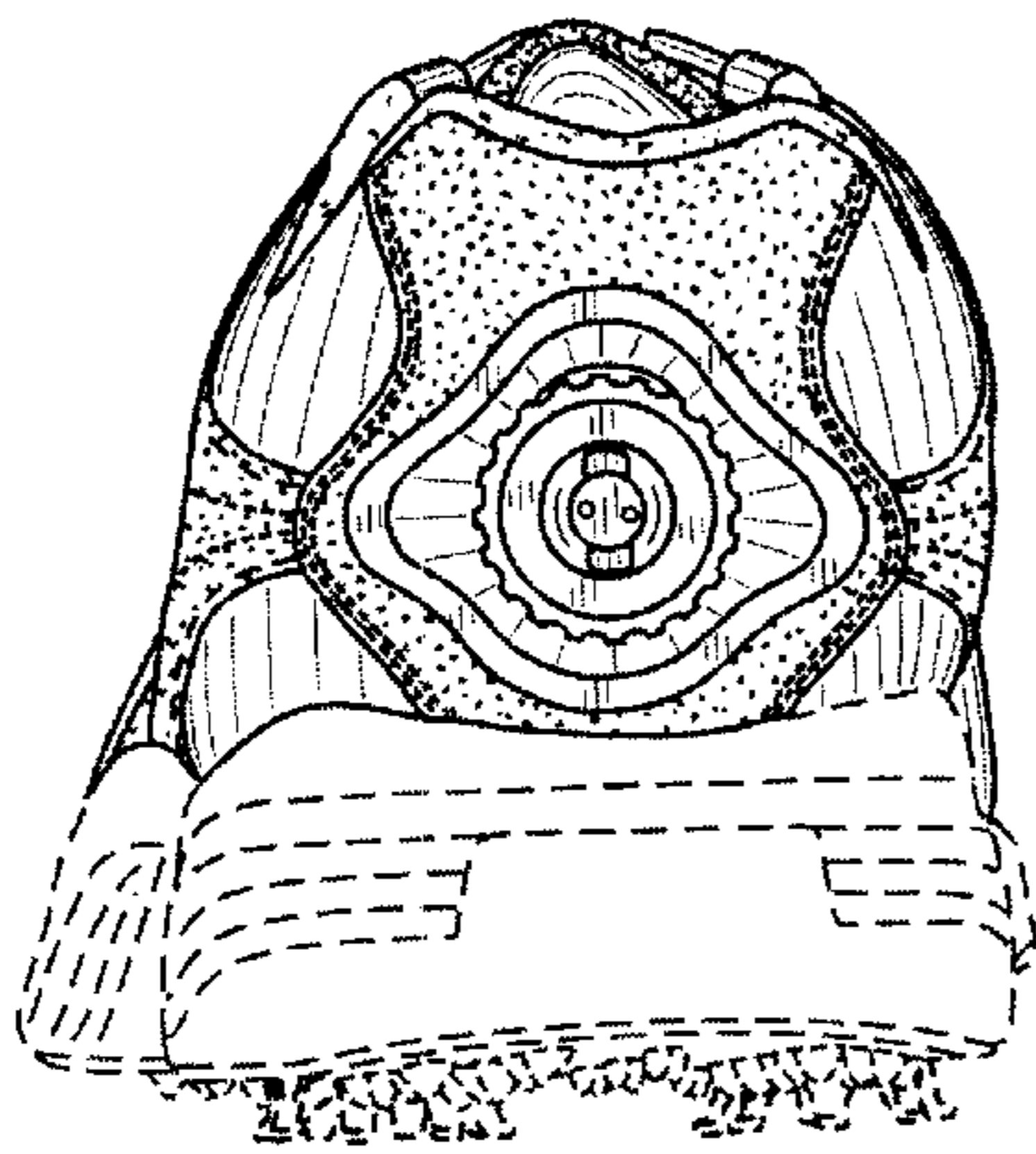

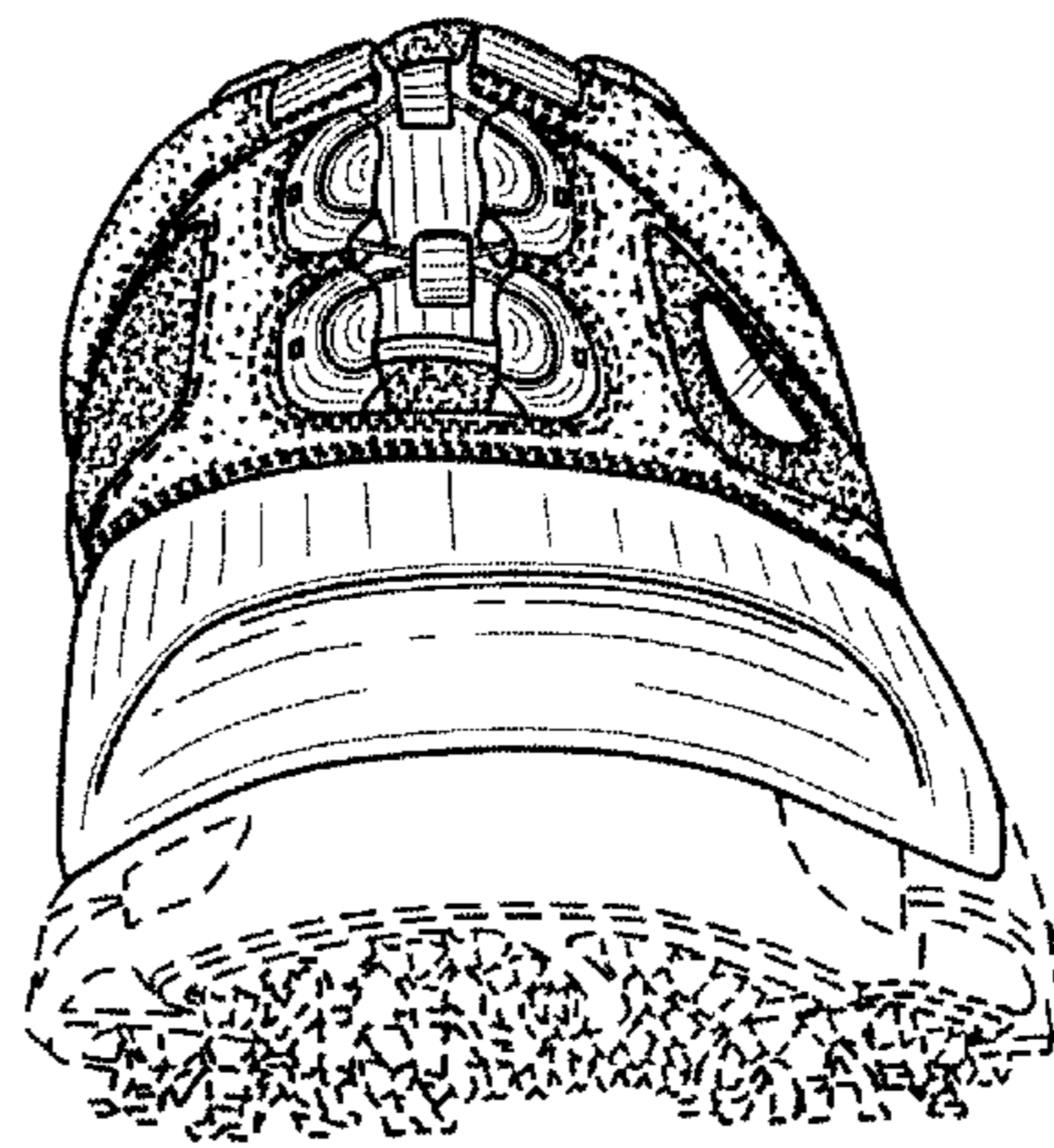
