(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a textured duffel, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the textured duffel embodying my new design.

FIG. 2 is a front view of the textured duffel shown in FIG. 1.

FIG. 3 is a left side view thereof.

FIG. 4 is a right side view thereof.

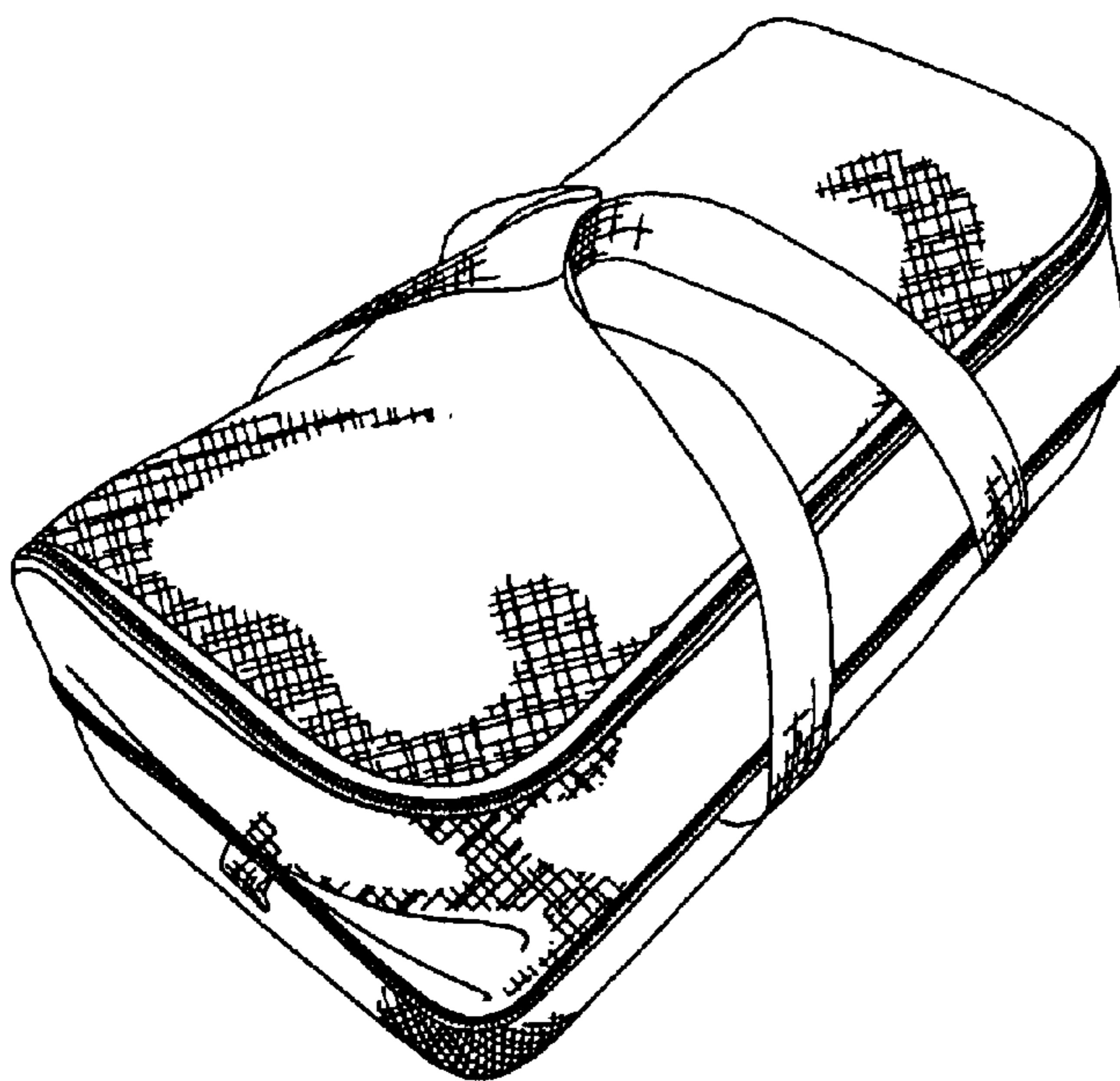
FIG. 5 is a rear view thereof.

FIG. 6 is a top view thereof; and,

FIG. 7 is a bottom view thereof.

For convenience of illustration, the three texture patterned areas—shown on the handles, the top section of the duffel, and the bottom section of the duffel—are understood to represent textures which continue throughout their respective portions of the design.

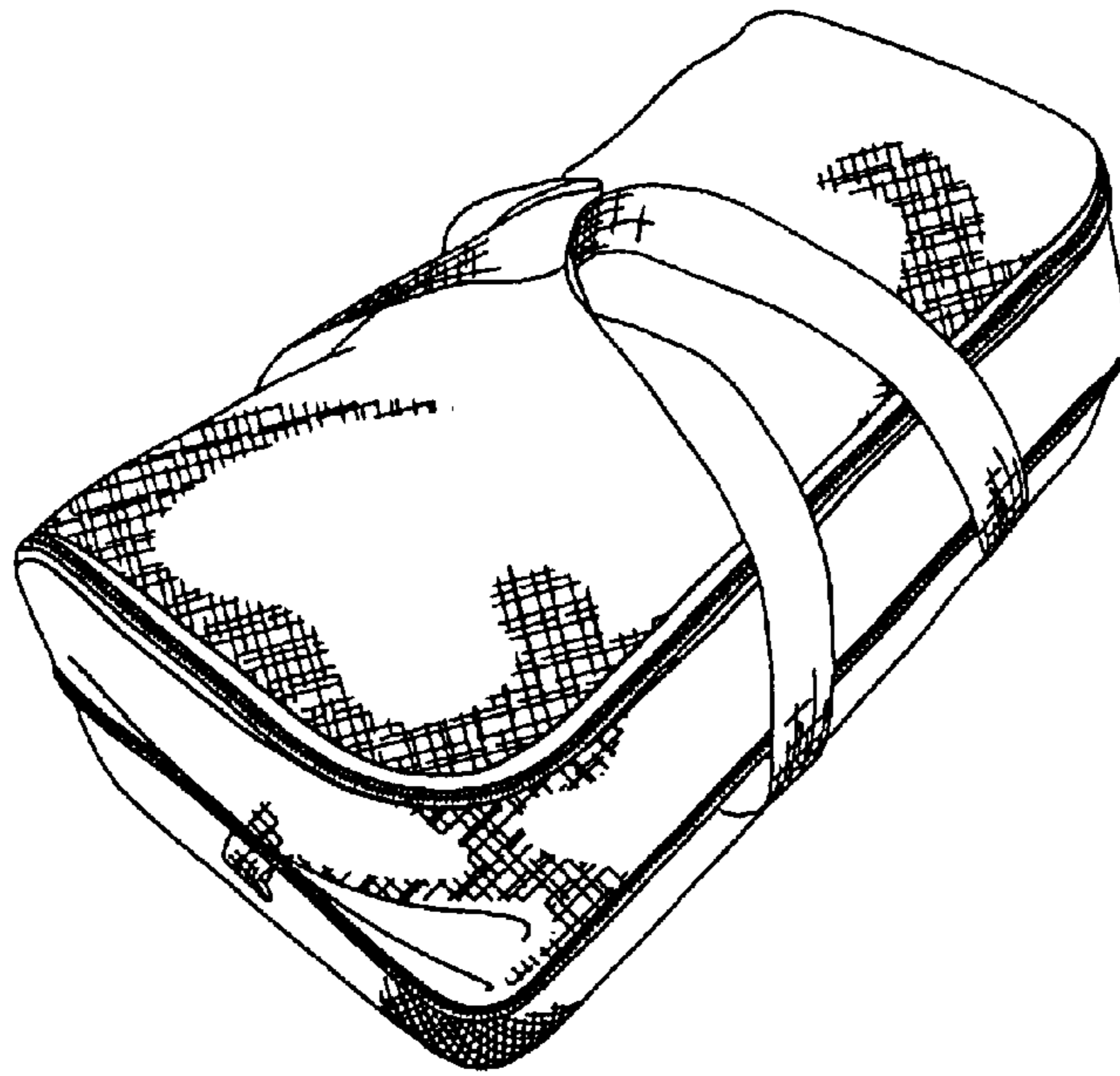

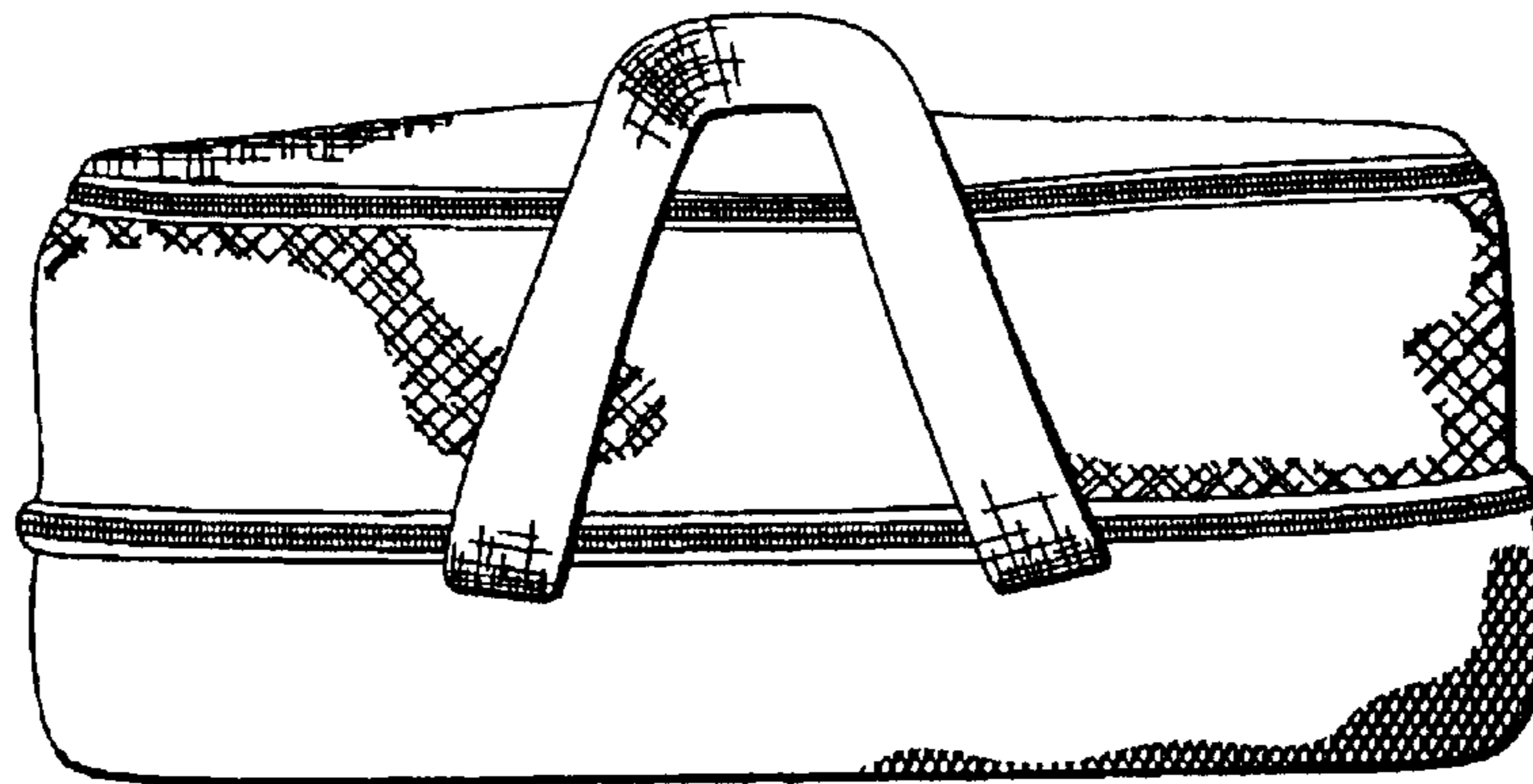

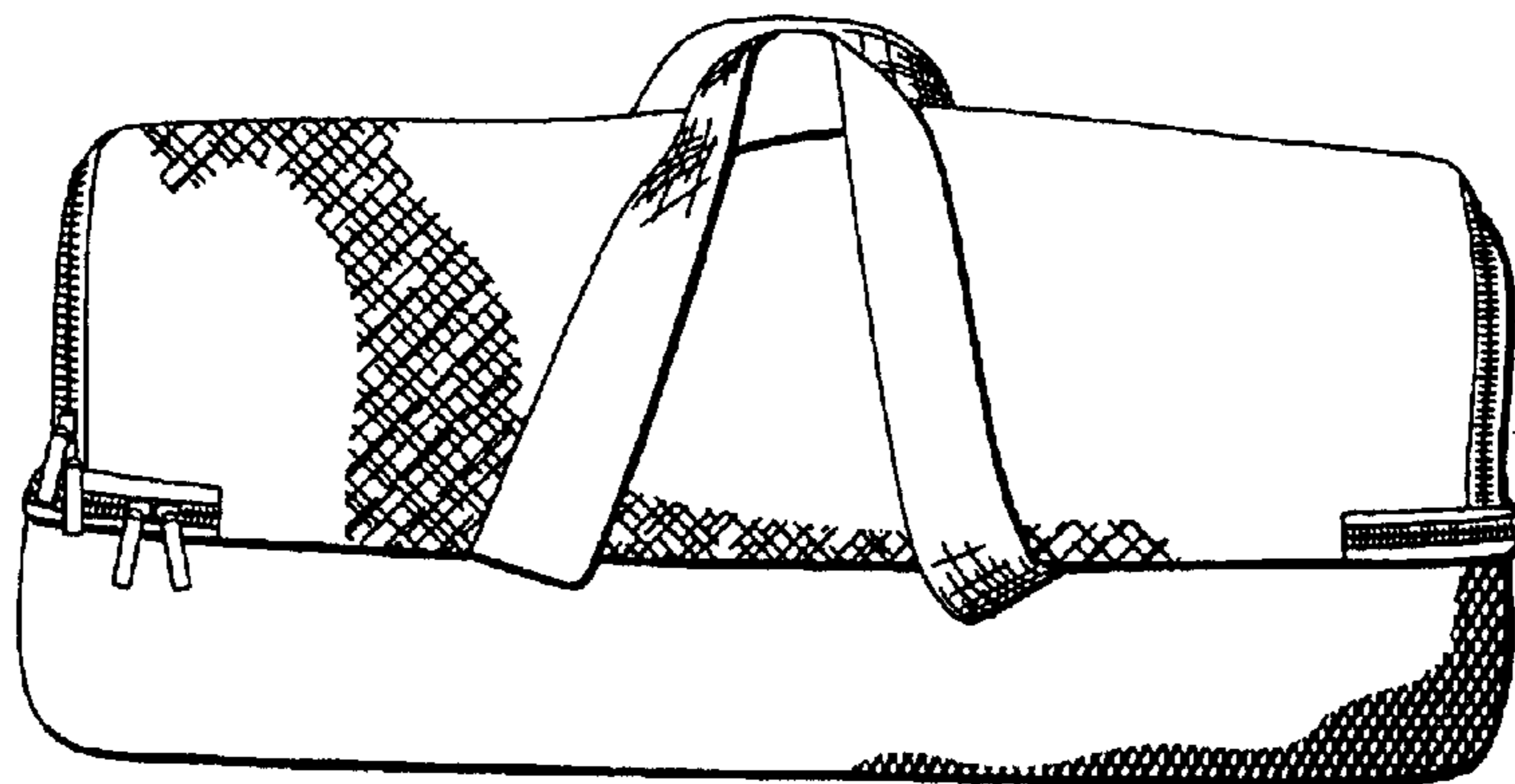

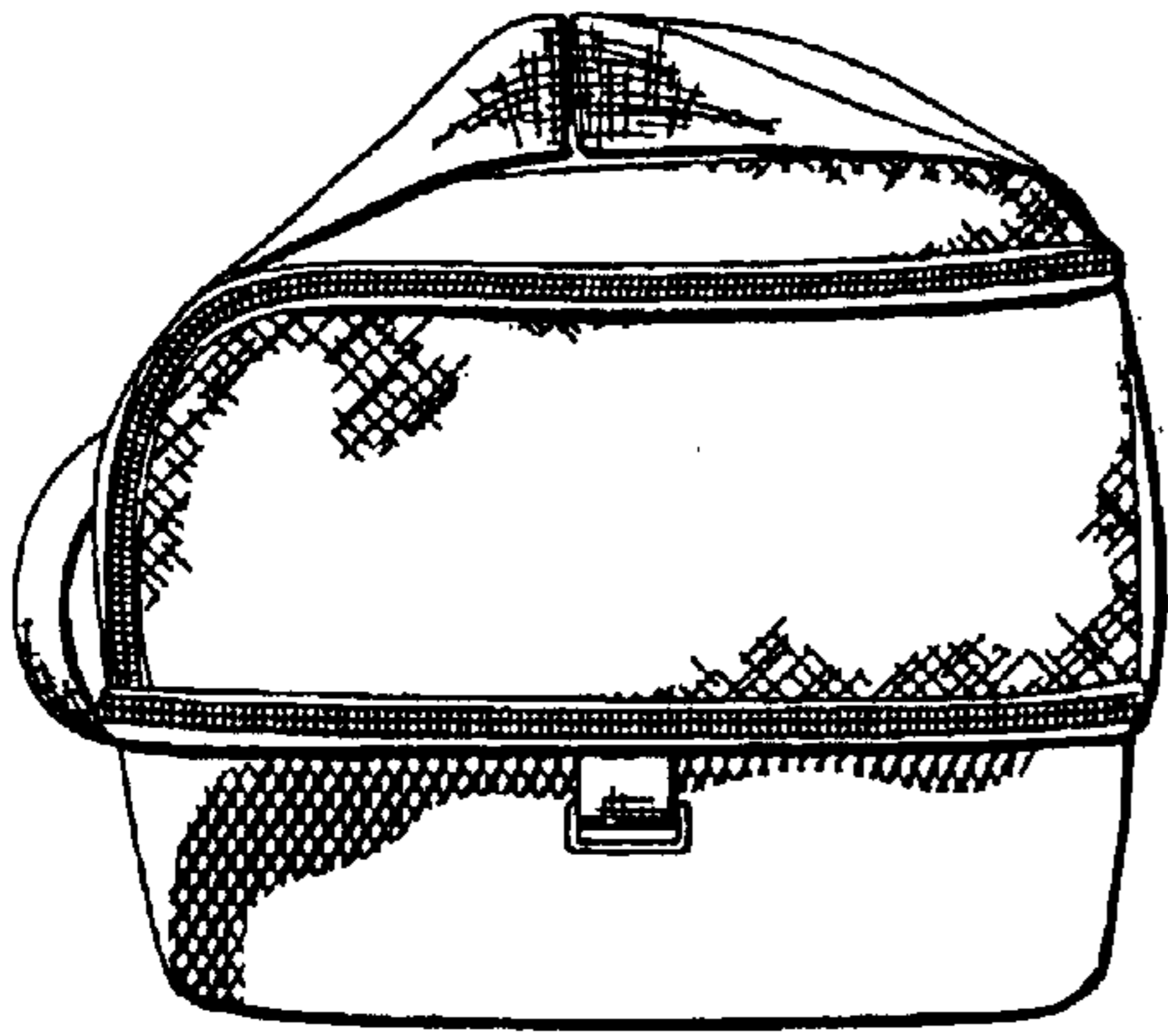

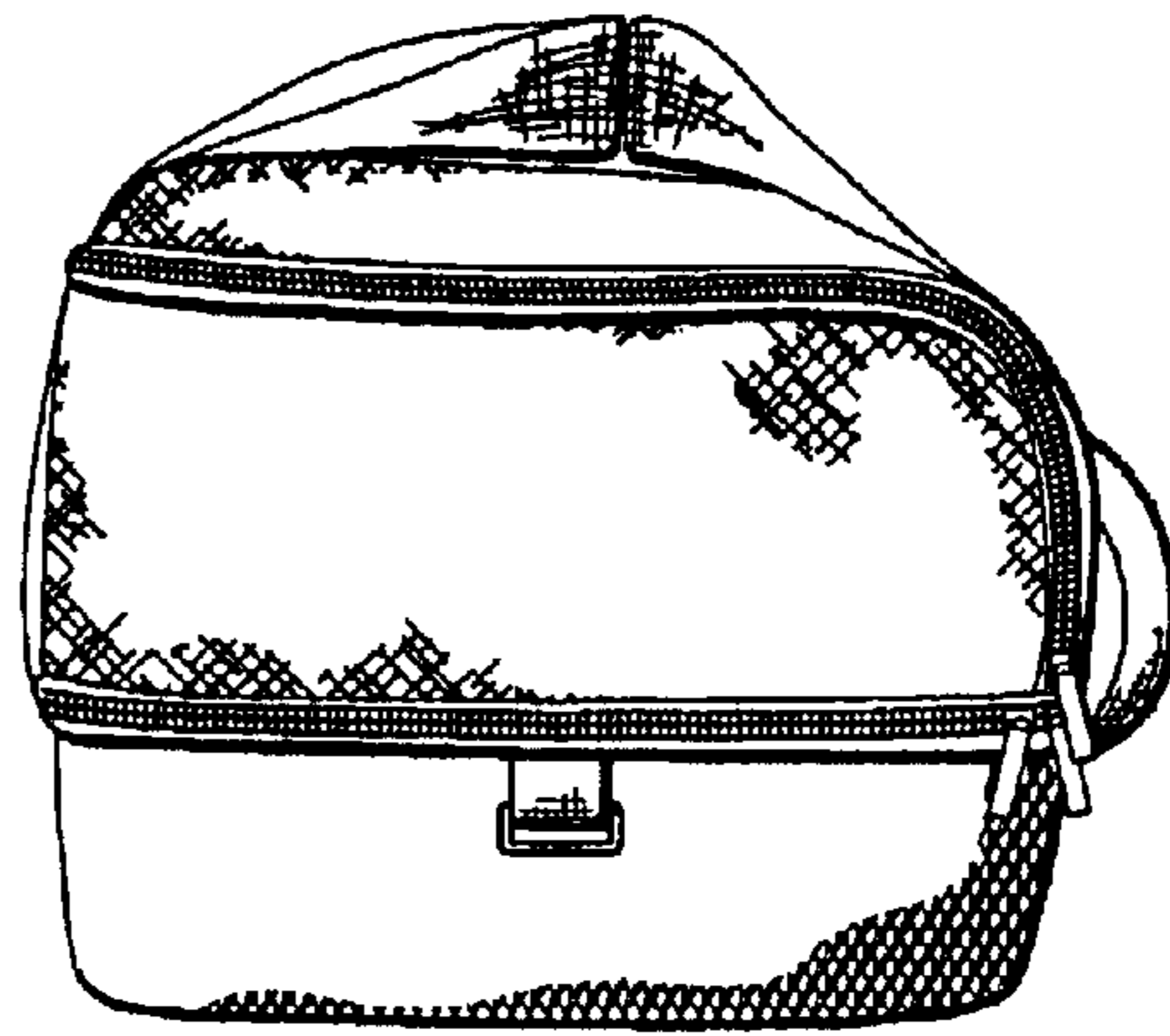

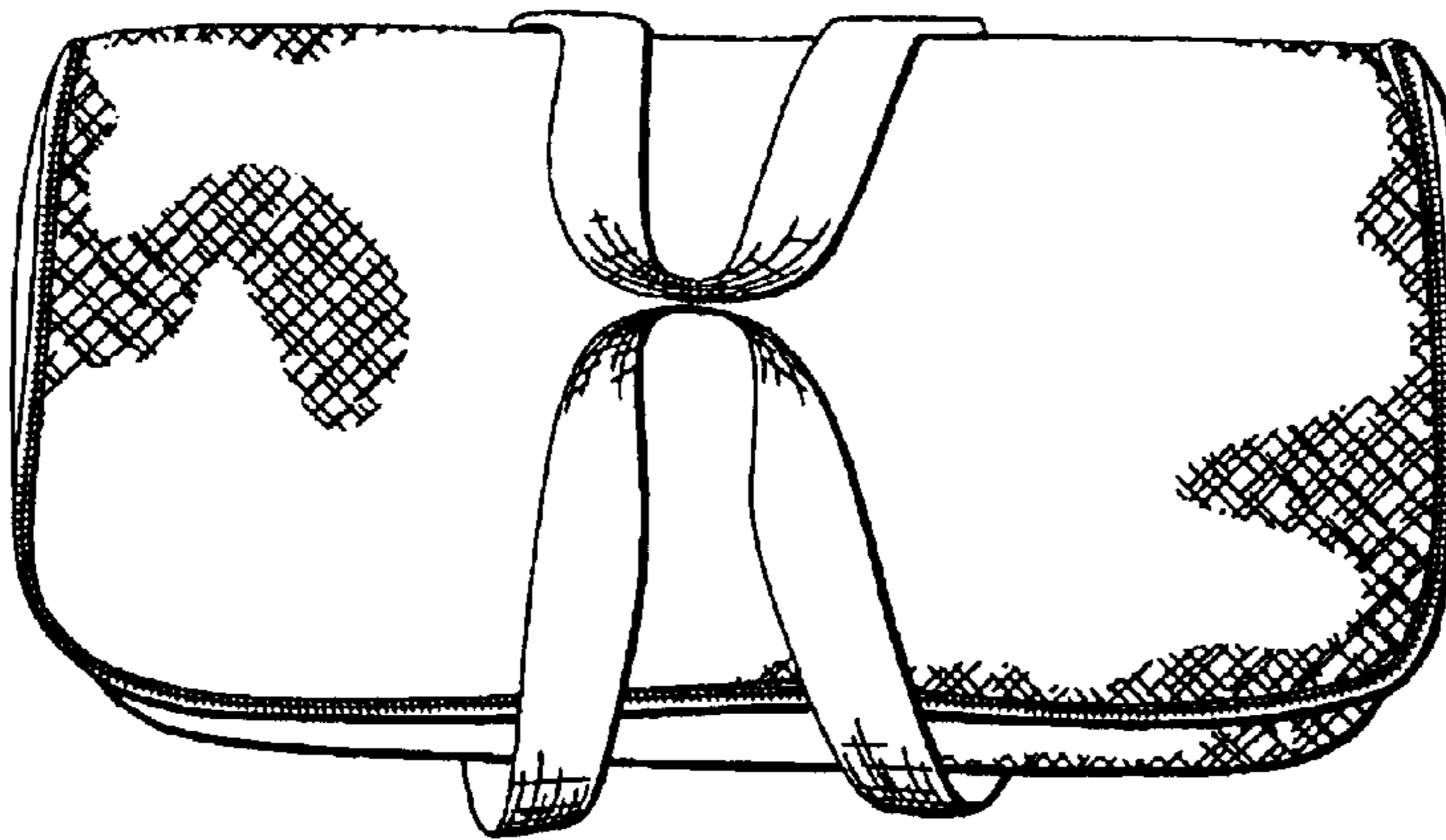

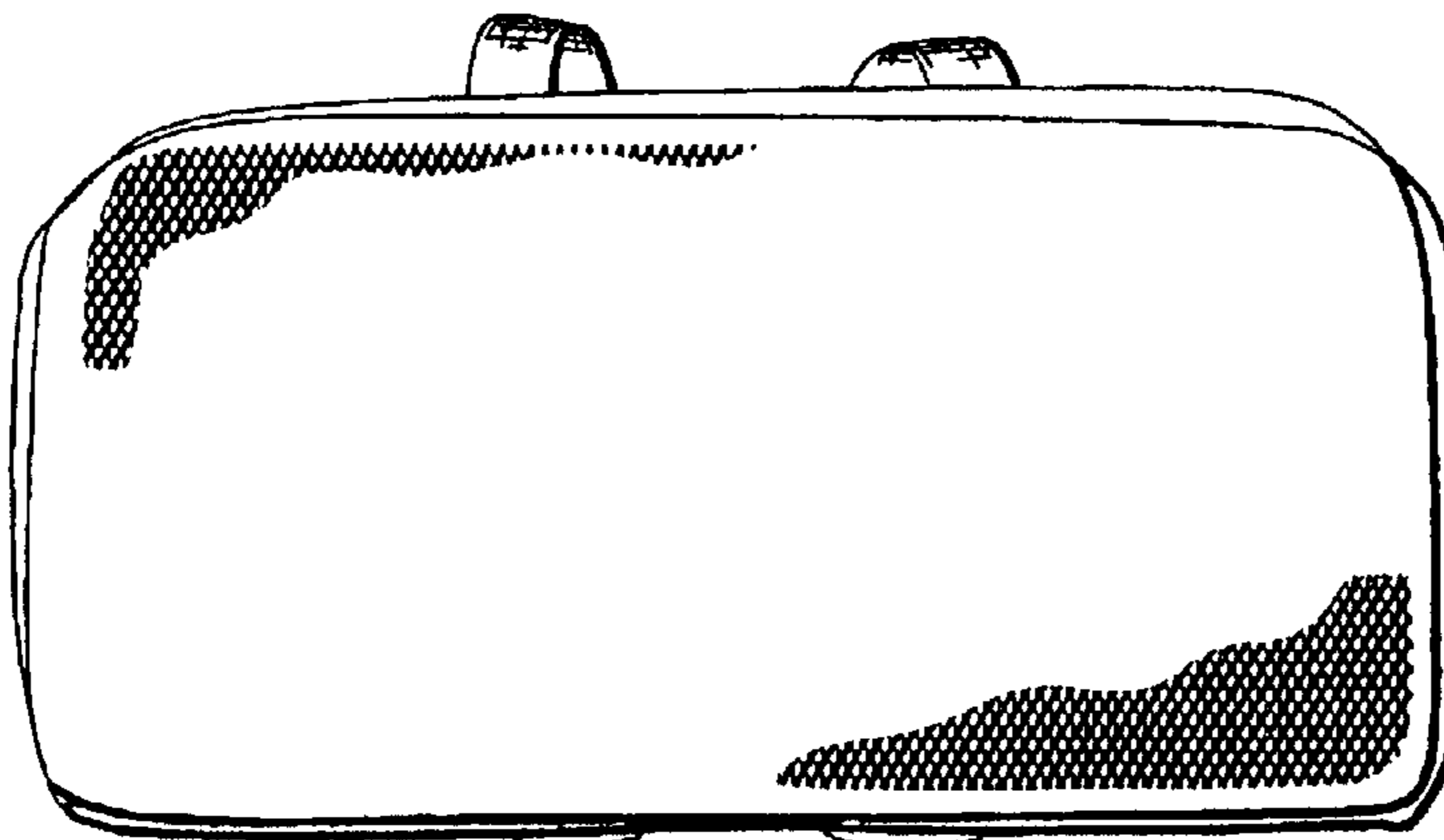
