I claim the ornamental design for holder for carry article, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a top/front/right-side perspective view of a holder for carry article showing my new design;

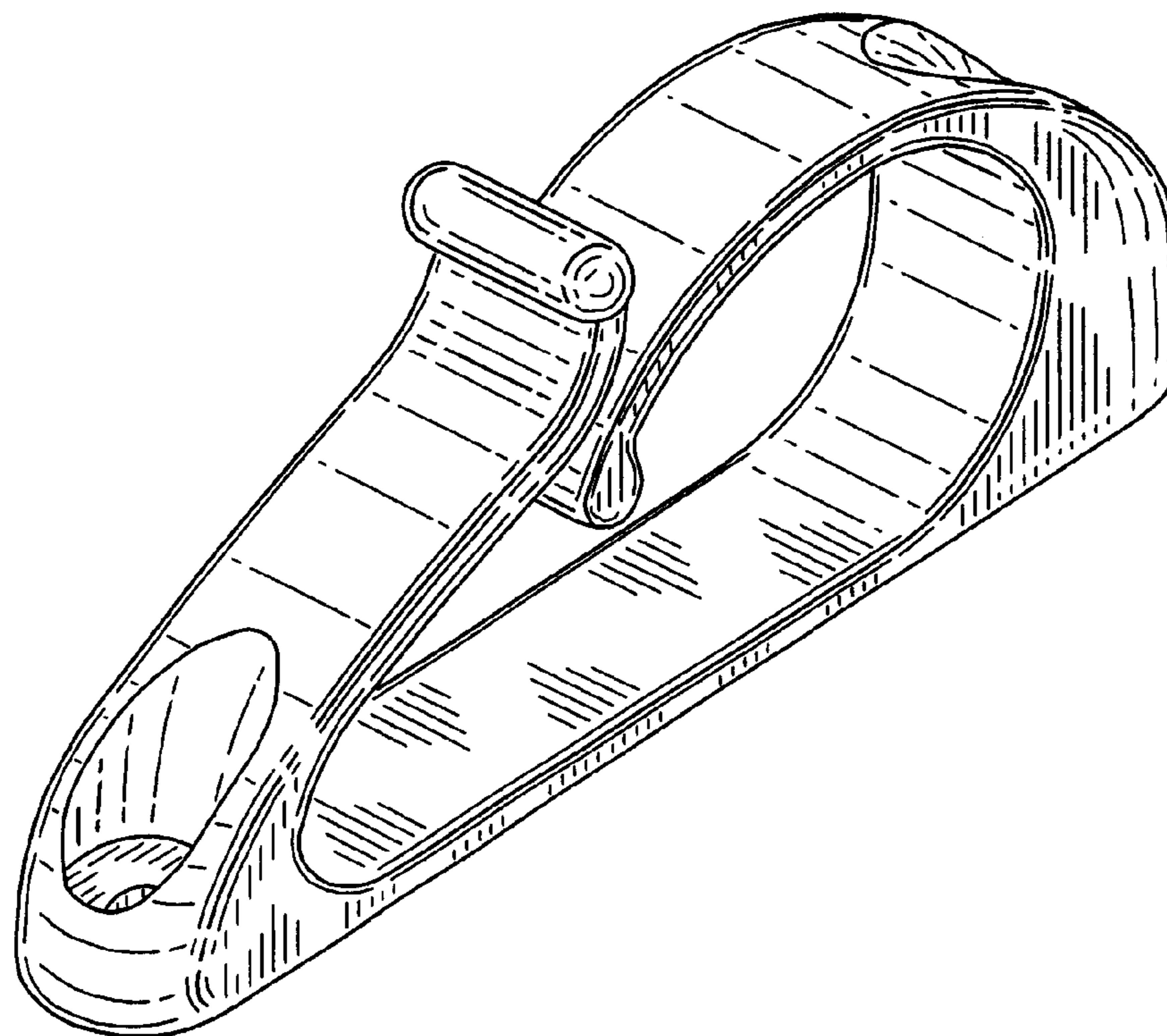
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

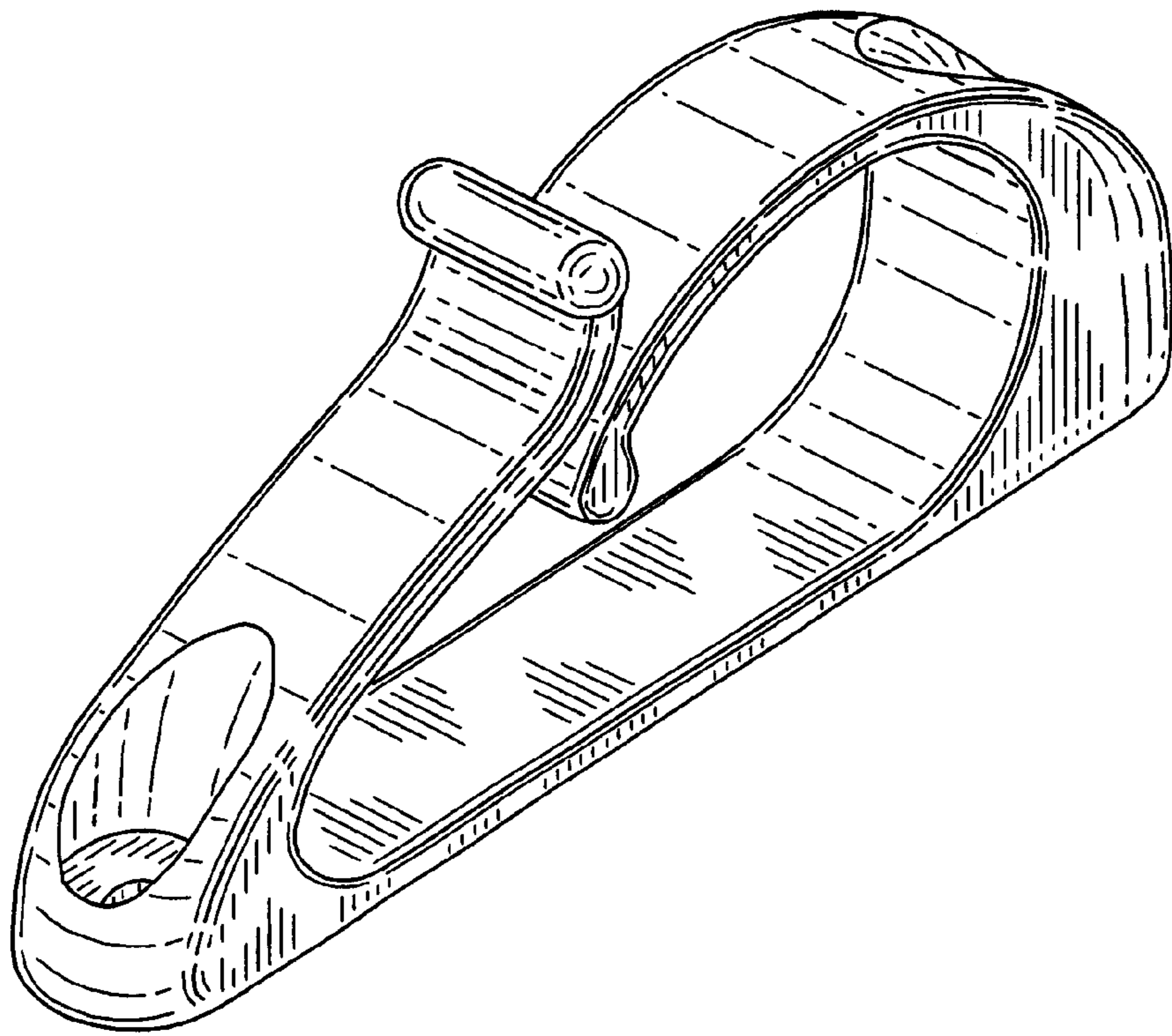

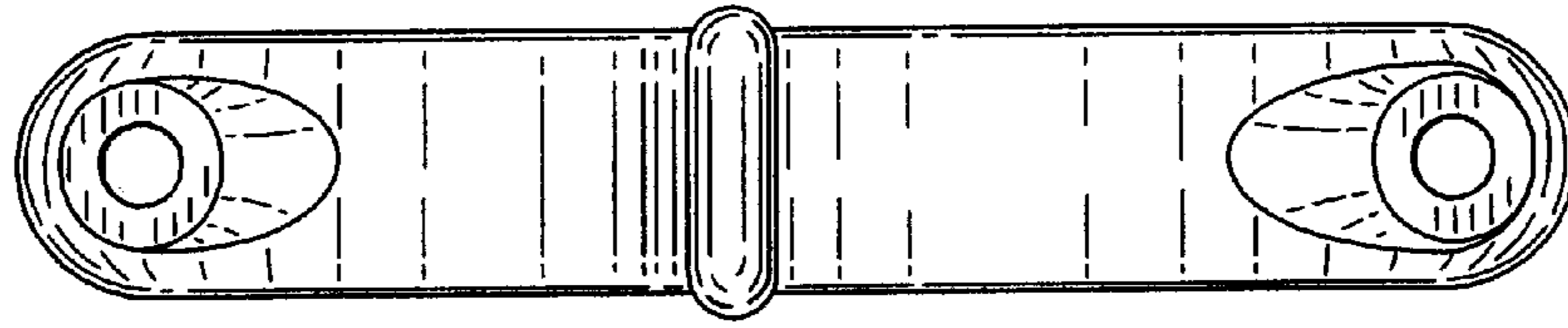

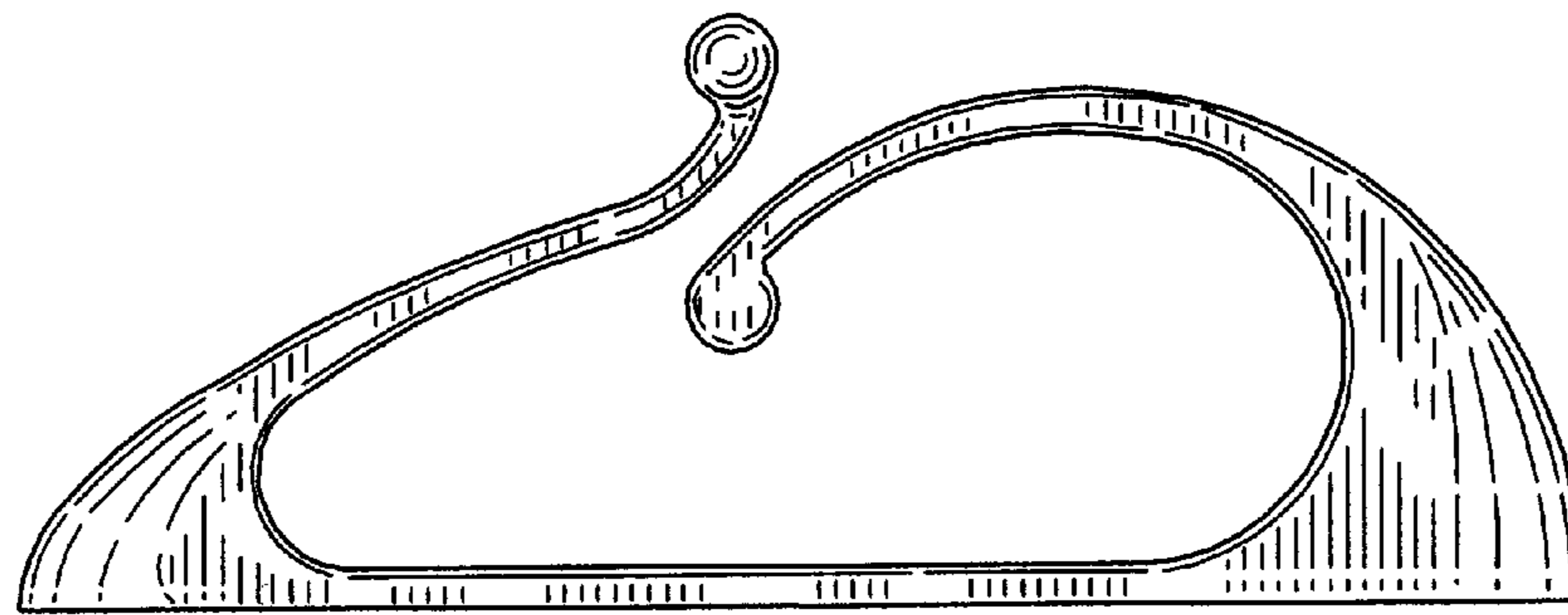

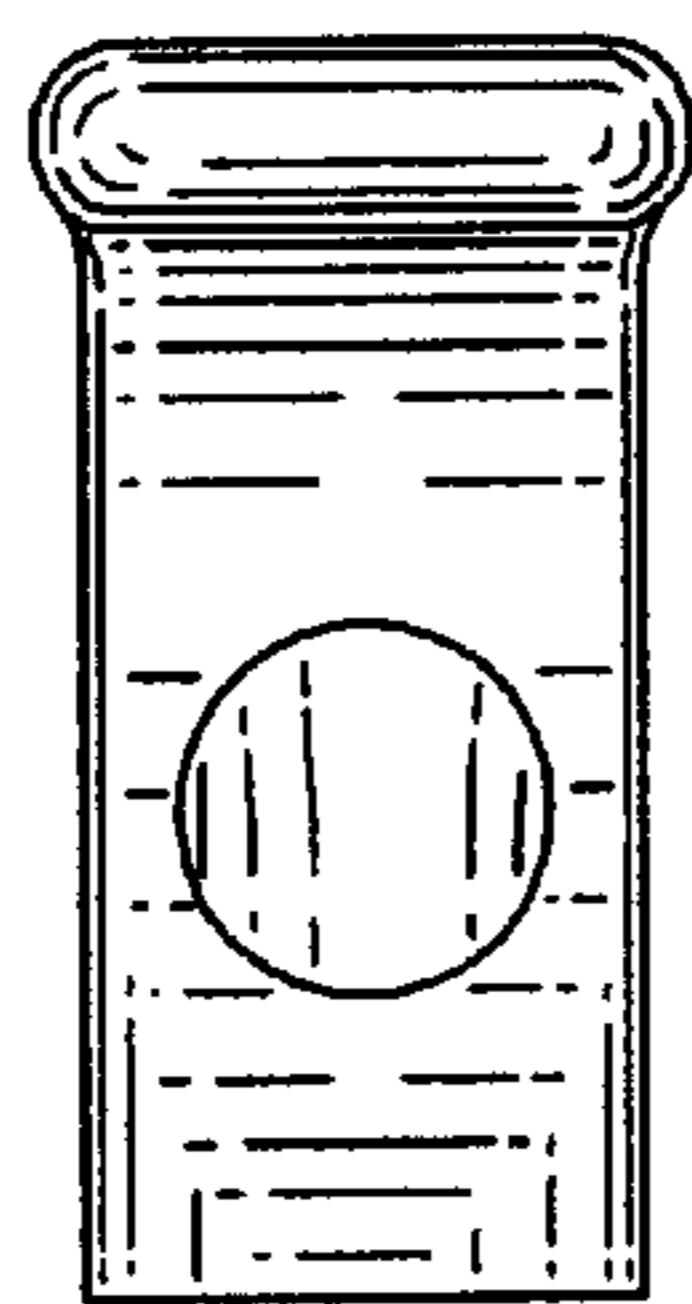

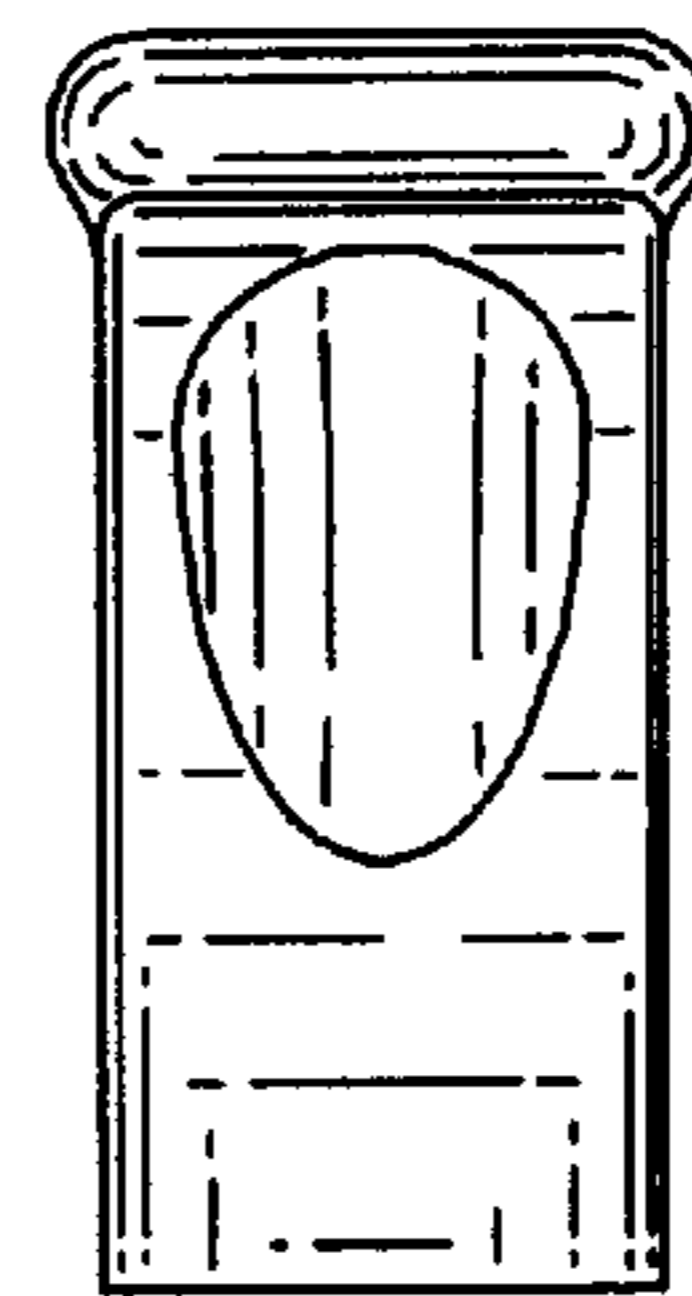
