FIG. 3 is an enlarged right side elevational view thereof;

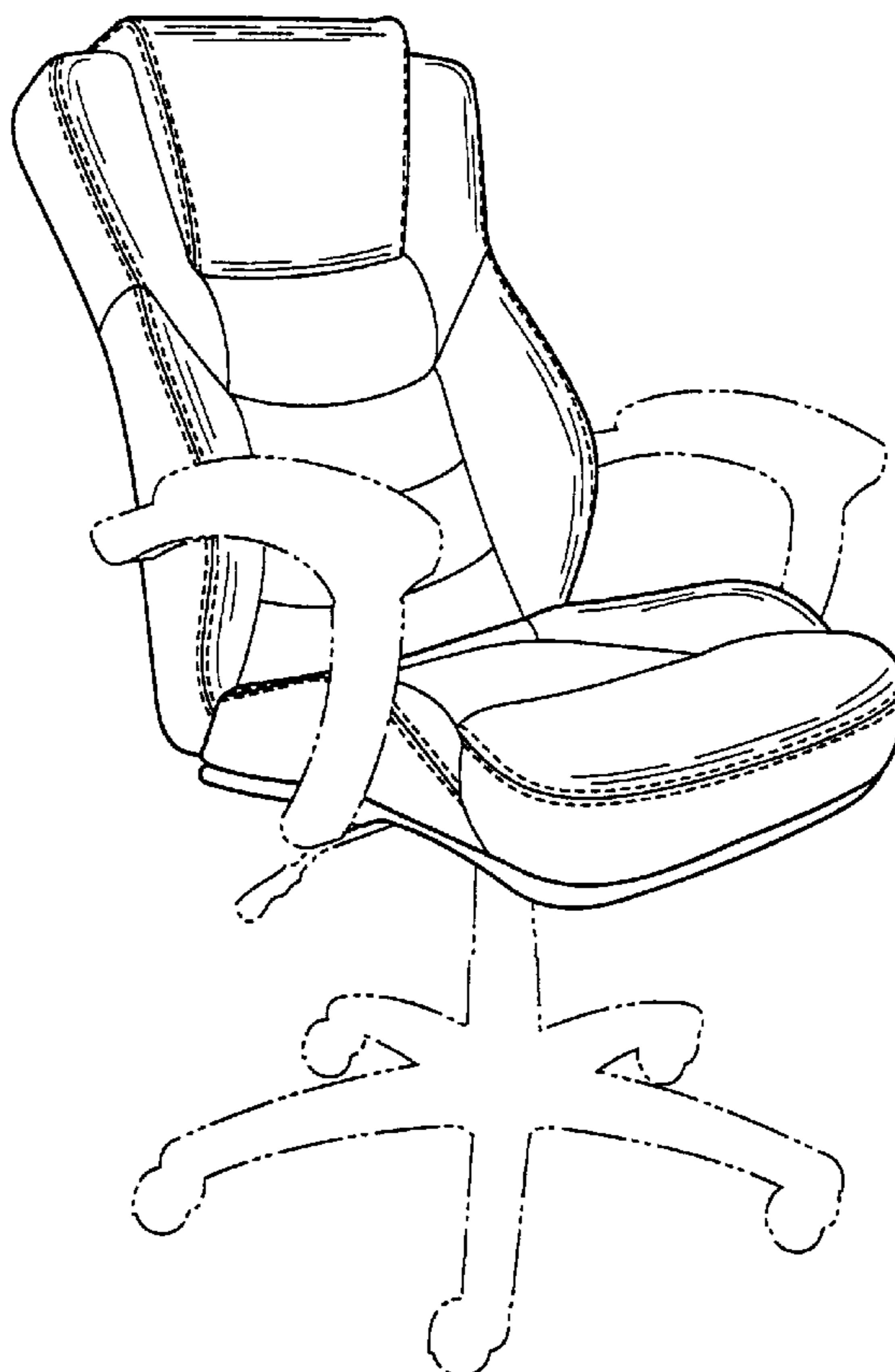
FIG. 4 is an enlarged rear elevational view thereof;

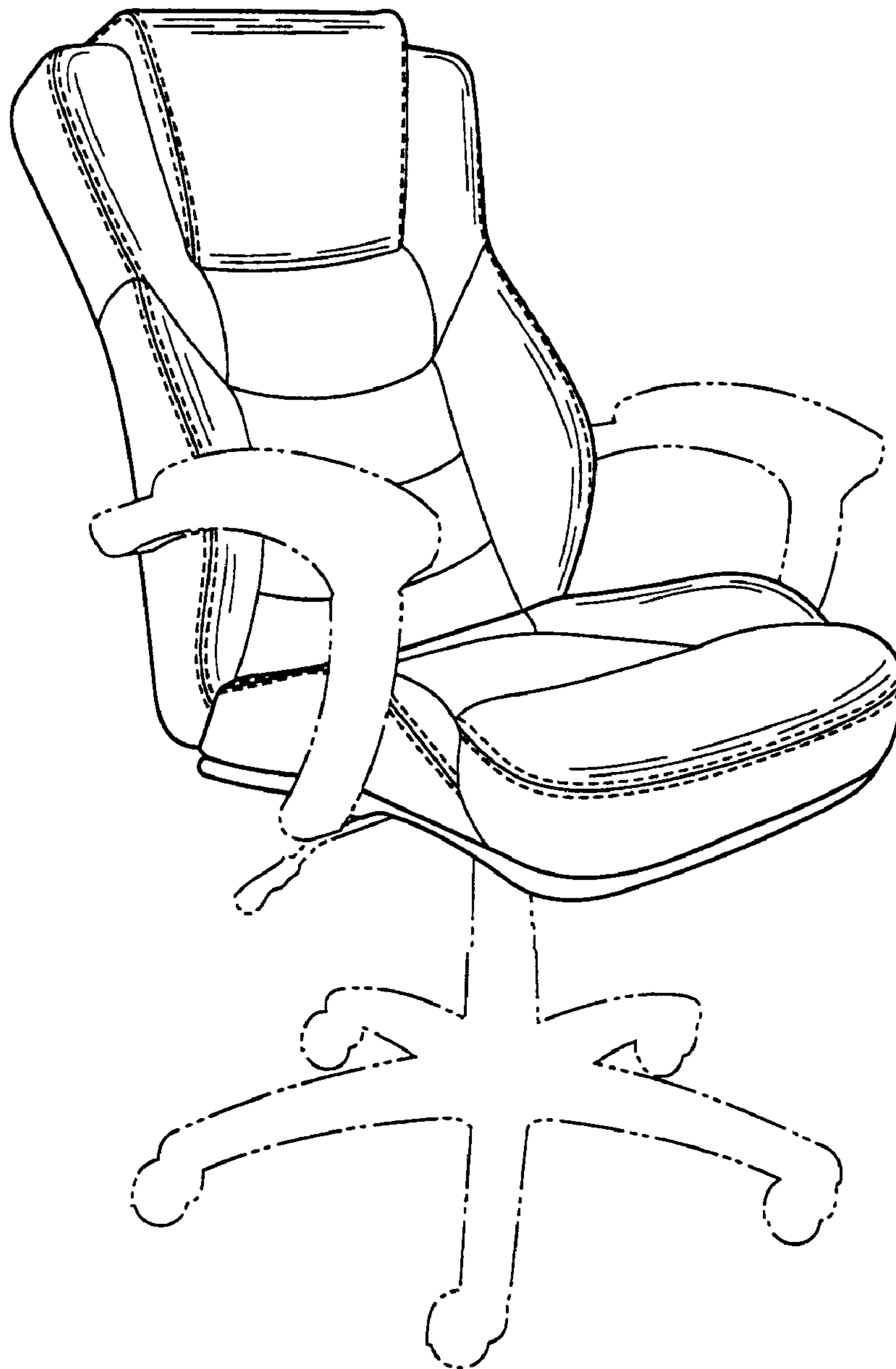

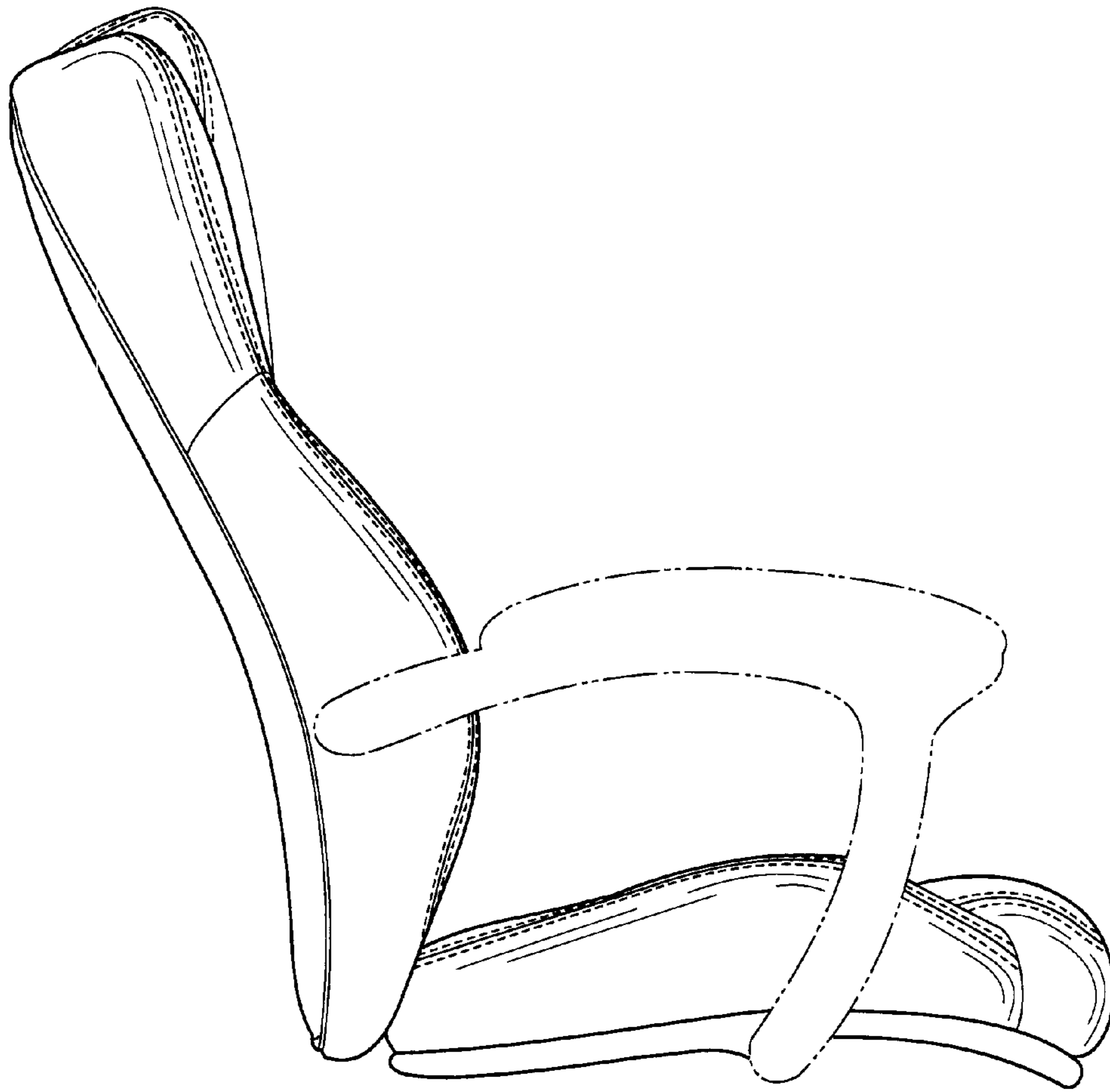

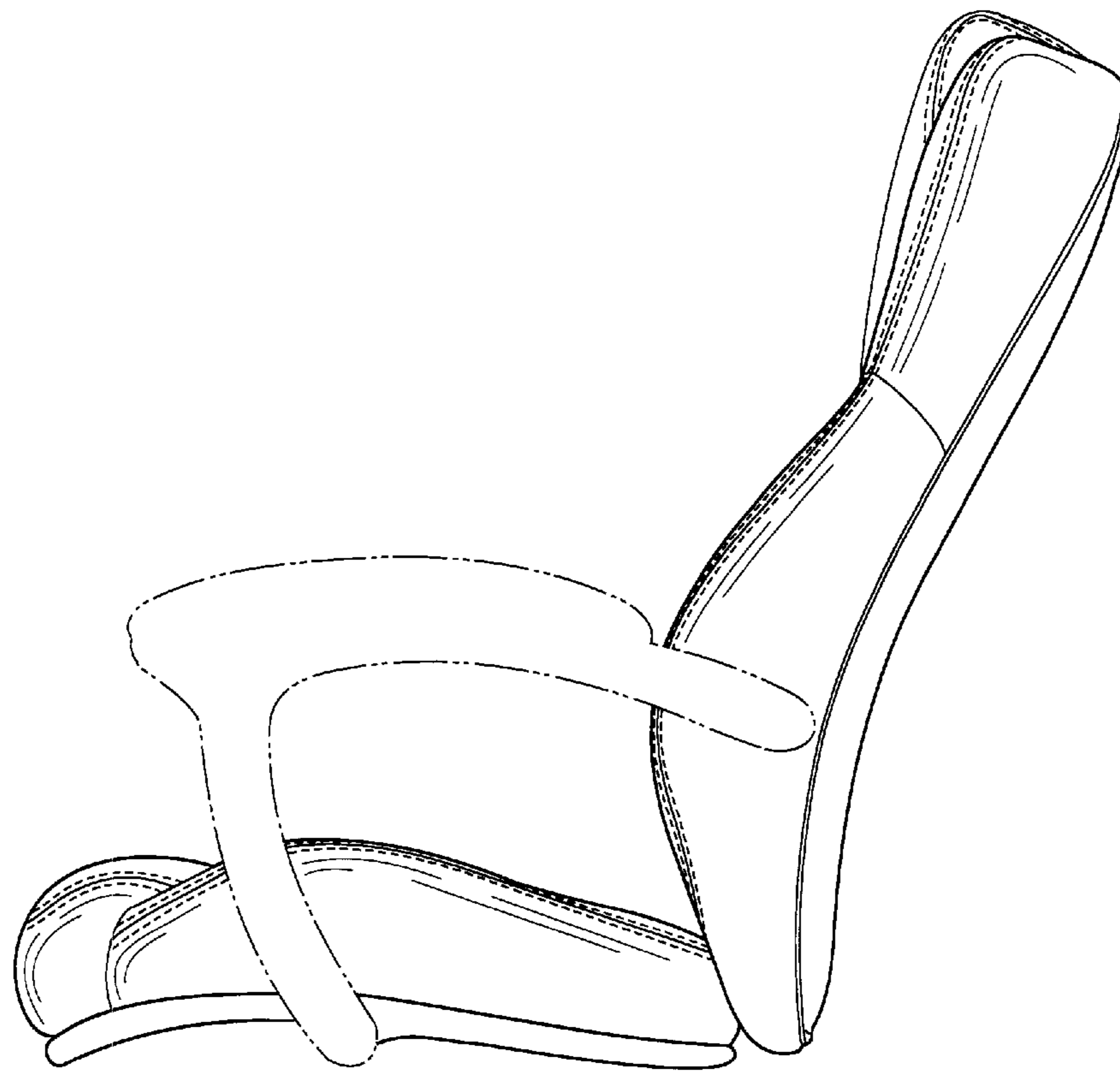

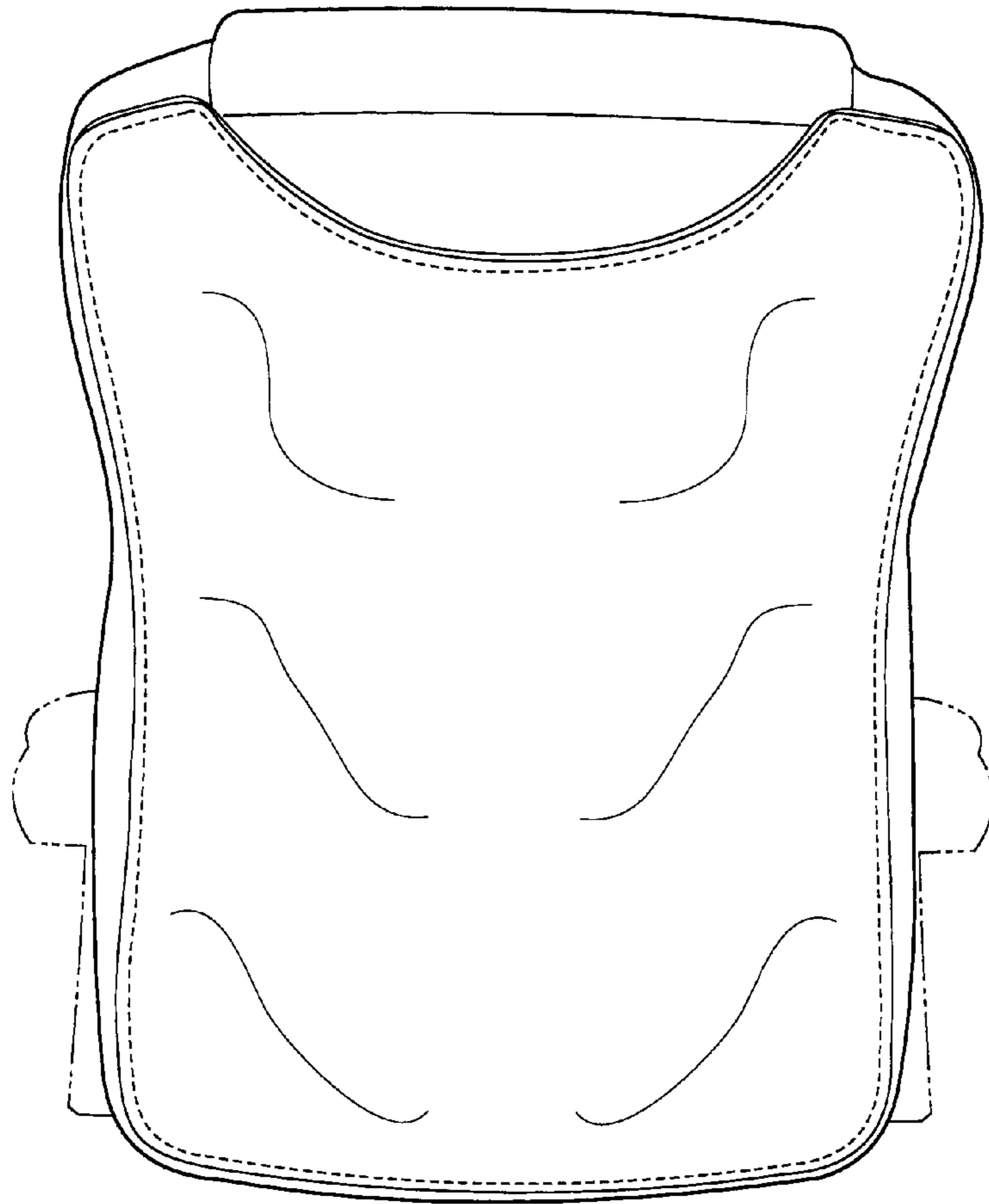

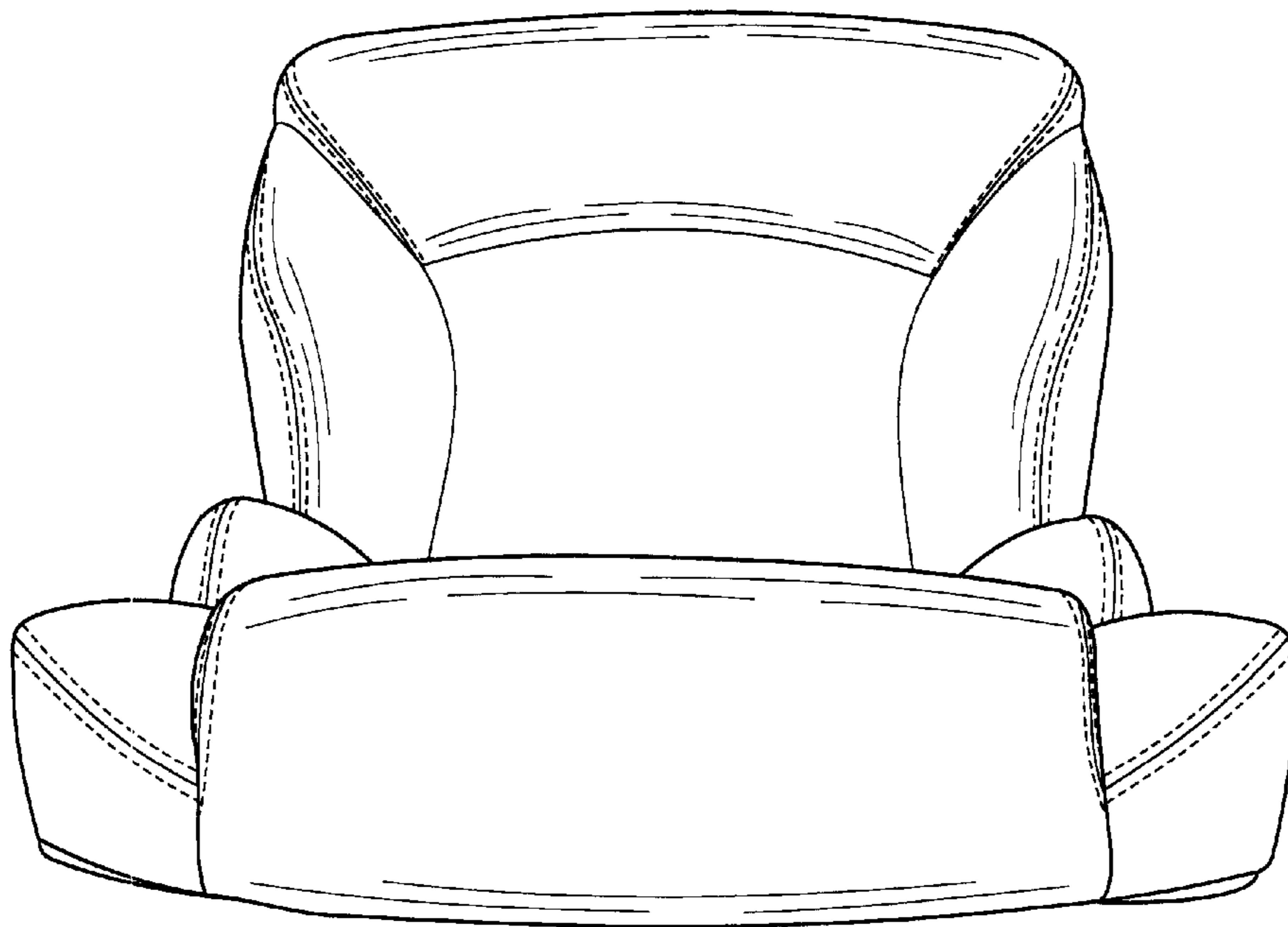

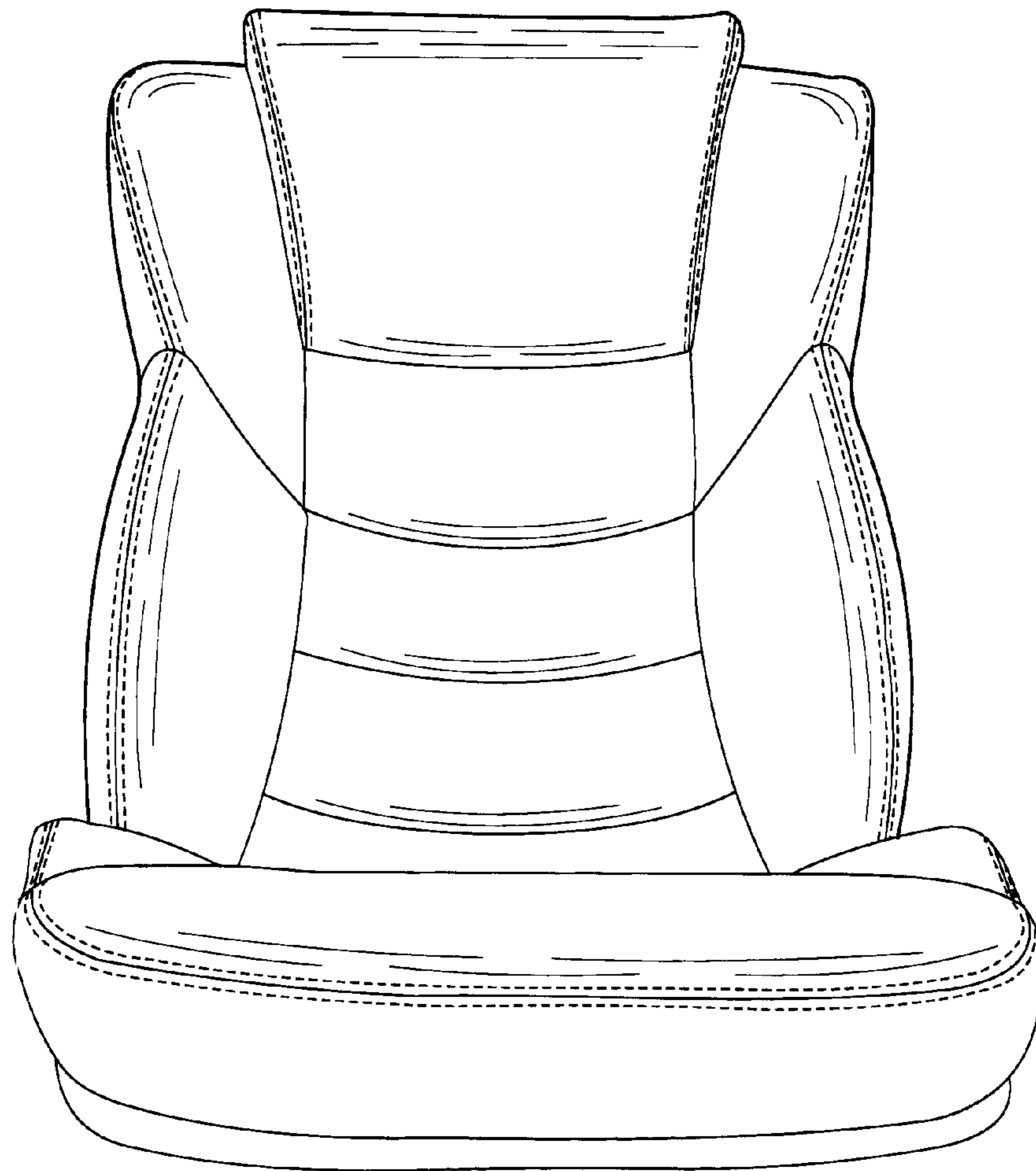
