access opening.

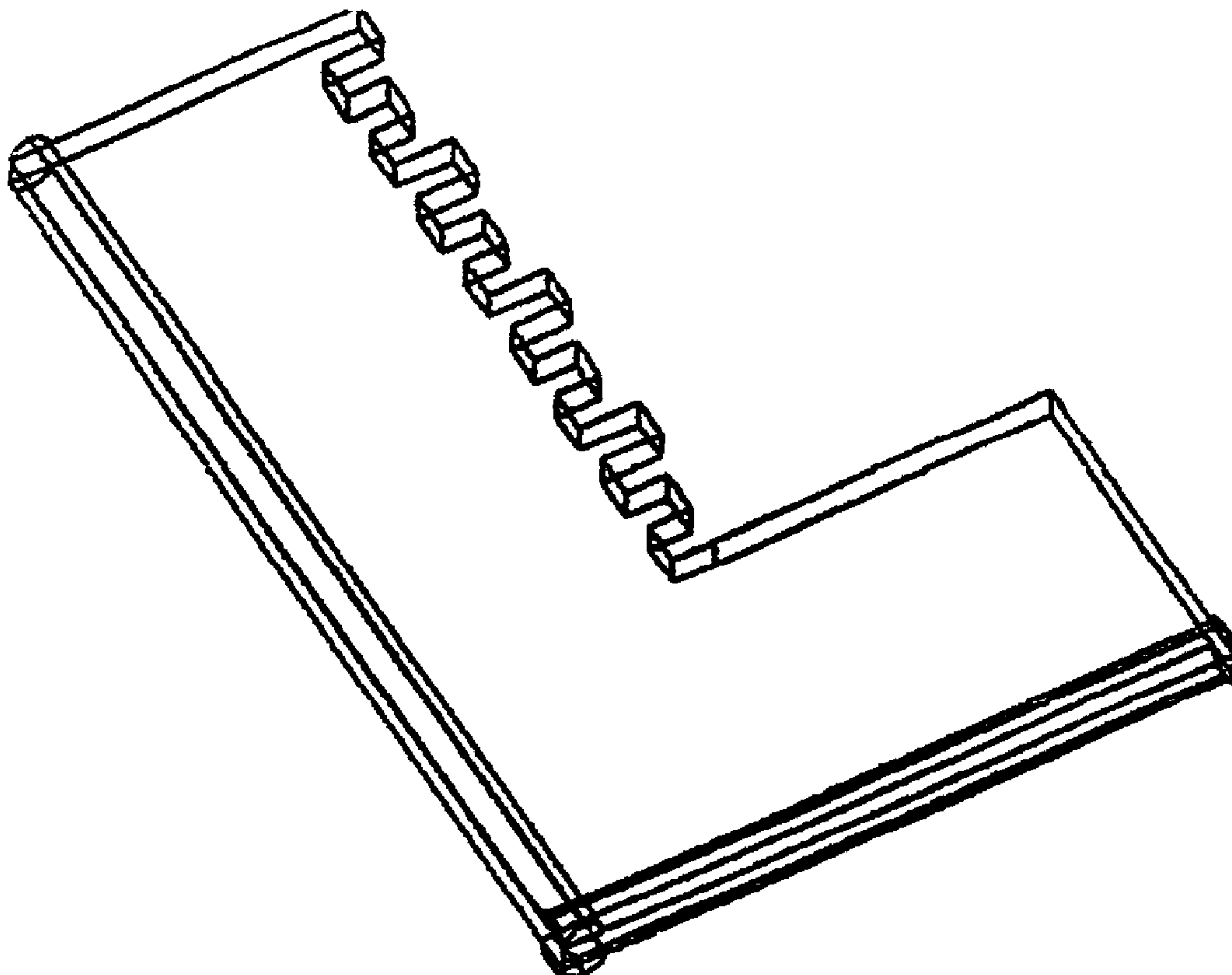
FIG. 1 is a an Isometric View of the tension checking device

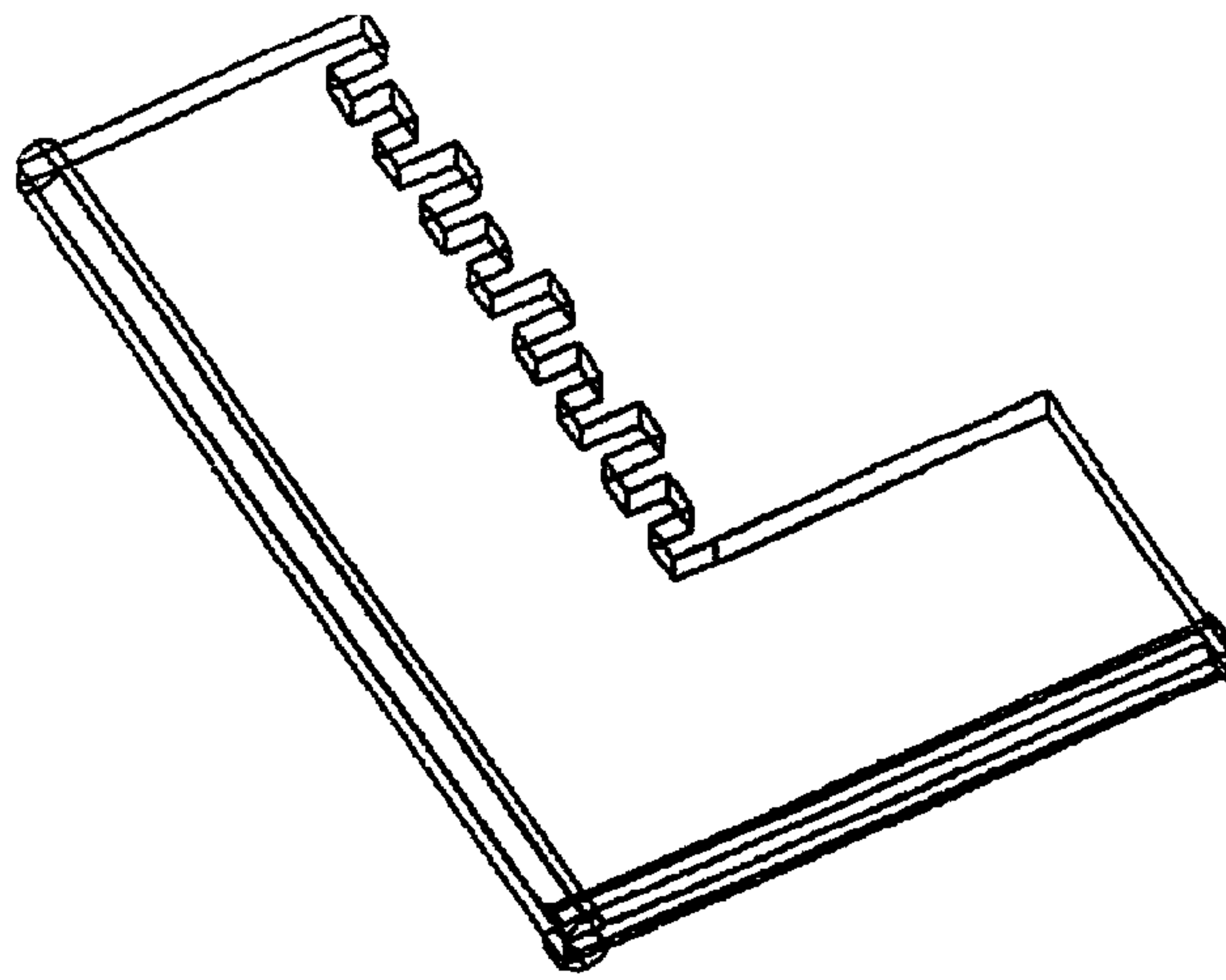

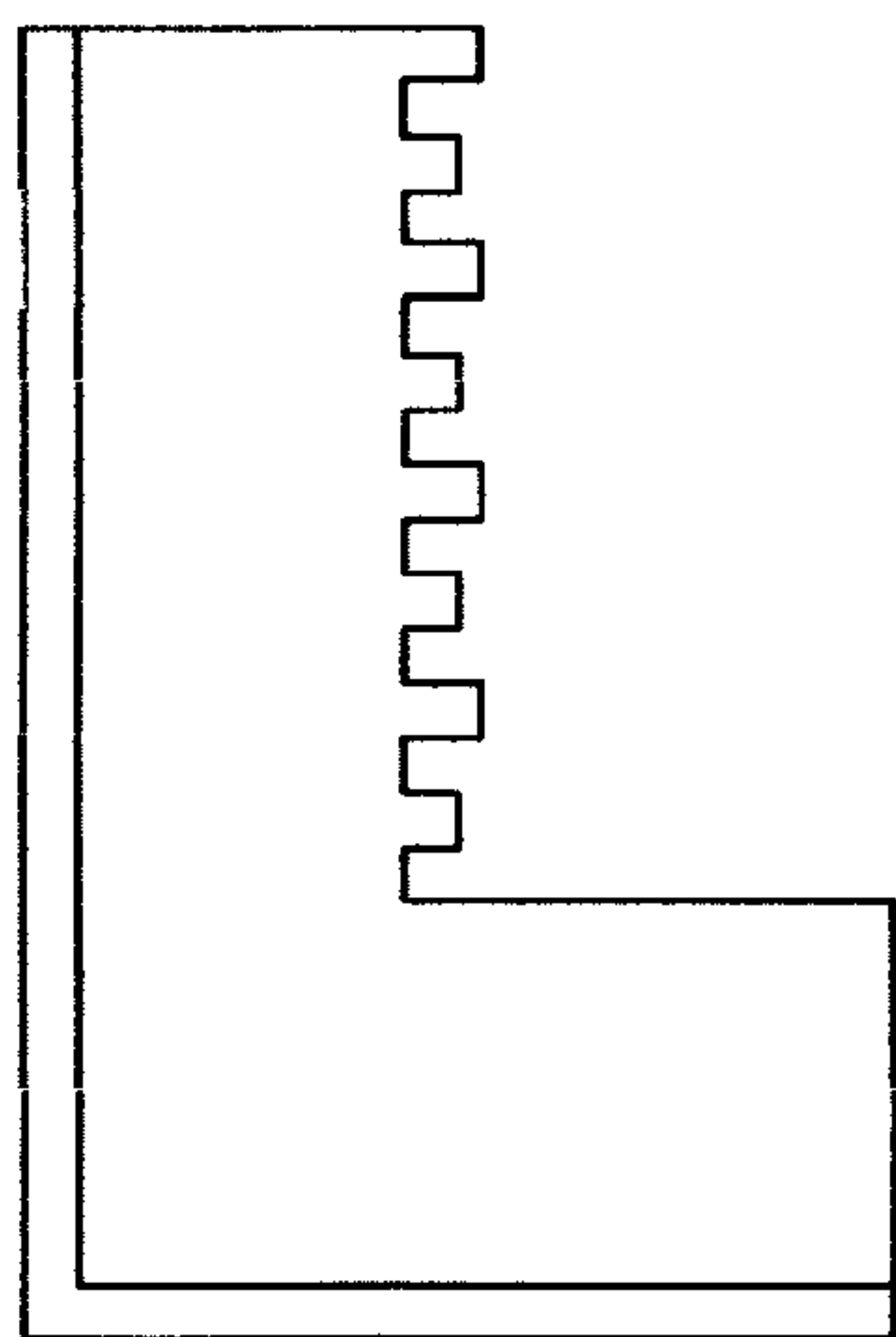
