(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a pallet leg, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top left front perspective view of a pallet leg showing my new design, broken away to indicate indeterminate height and length;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof, broken away to indicate indeterminate length;

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof, broken away to indicate indeterminate height and length;

FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof, broken away to indicate indeterminate height and length;

FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof, which is a mirror image of the left side elevational view thereof, broken away to indicate indeterminate height;

FIG. 6 is a top left front perspective view of an alternative embodiment thereof, broken away to indicate indeterminate height and length;

FIG. 7 is a top plan view of the embodiment shown in FIG. 6, broken away to indicate indeterminate length;

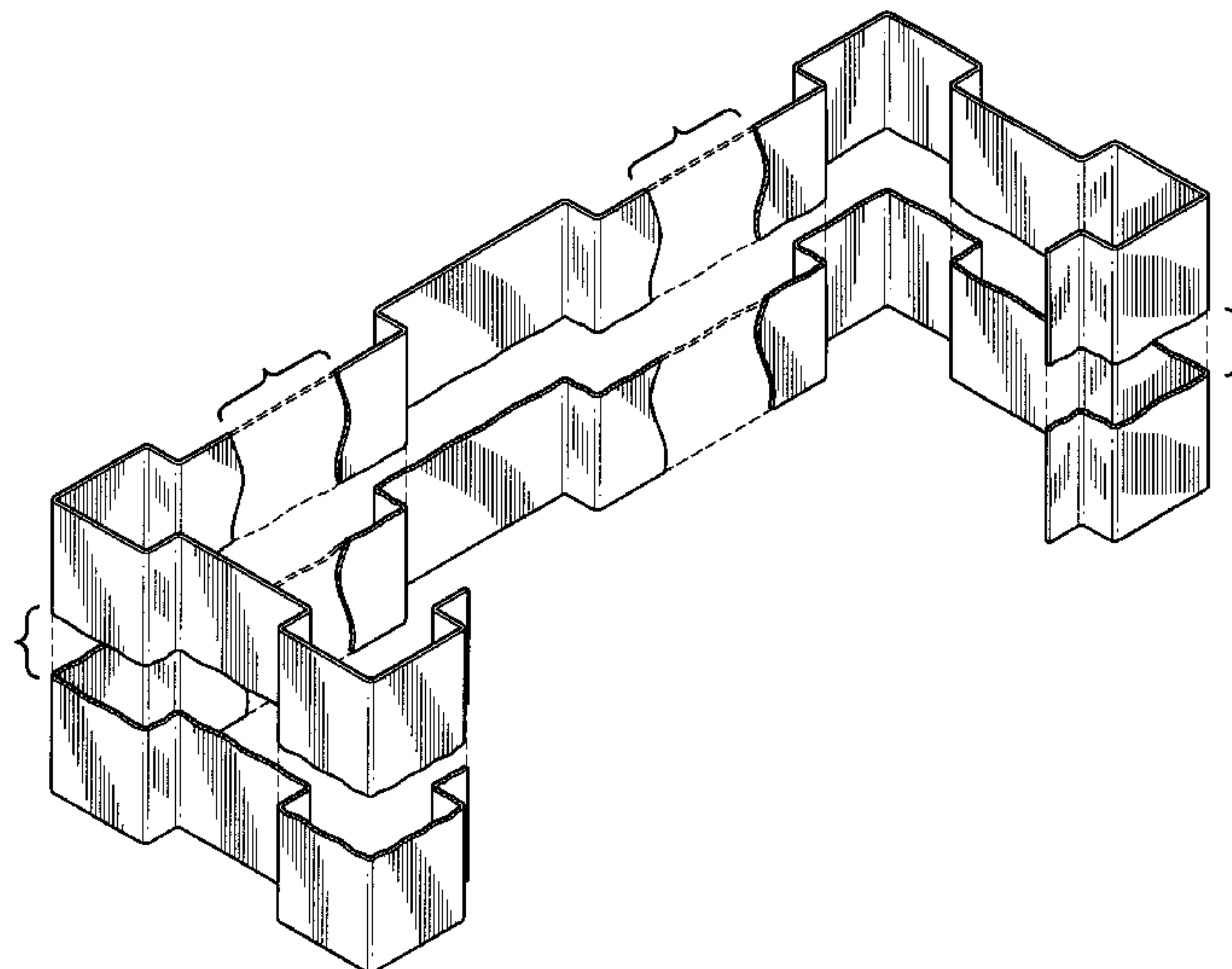
FIG. 8 is a front elevational view of the embodiment shown in FIG. 6, broken away to indicate indeterminate height and length;

FIG. 9 is a rear elevational view of the embodiment shown in FIG. 6, broken away to indicate indeterminate height and length; and,

FIG. 10 is a right side elevational view of the embodiment shown in FIG. 6, which is a mirror image of the left side elevational view thereof, broken away to indicate indeterminate height.

The broken lines are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design.

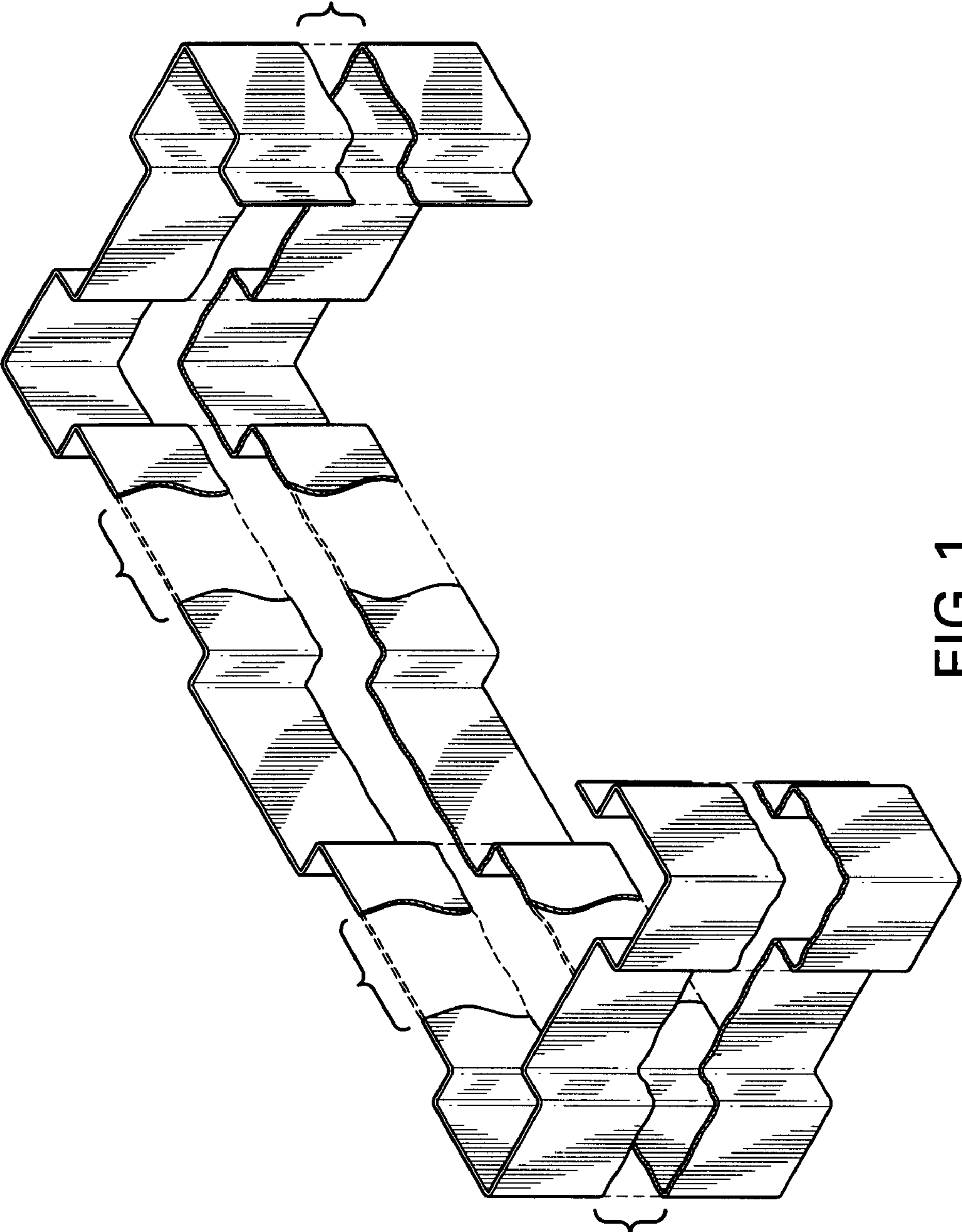

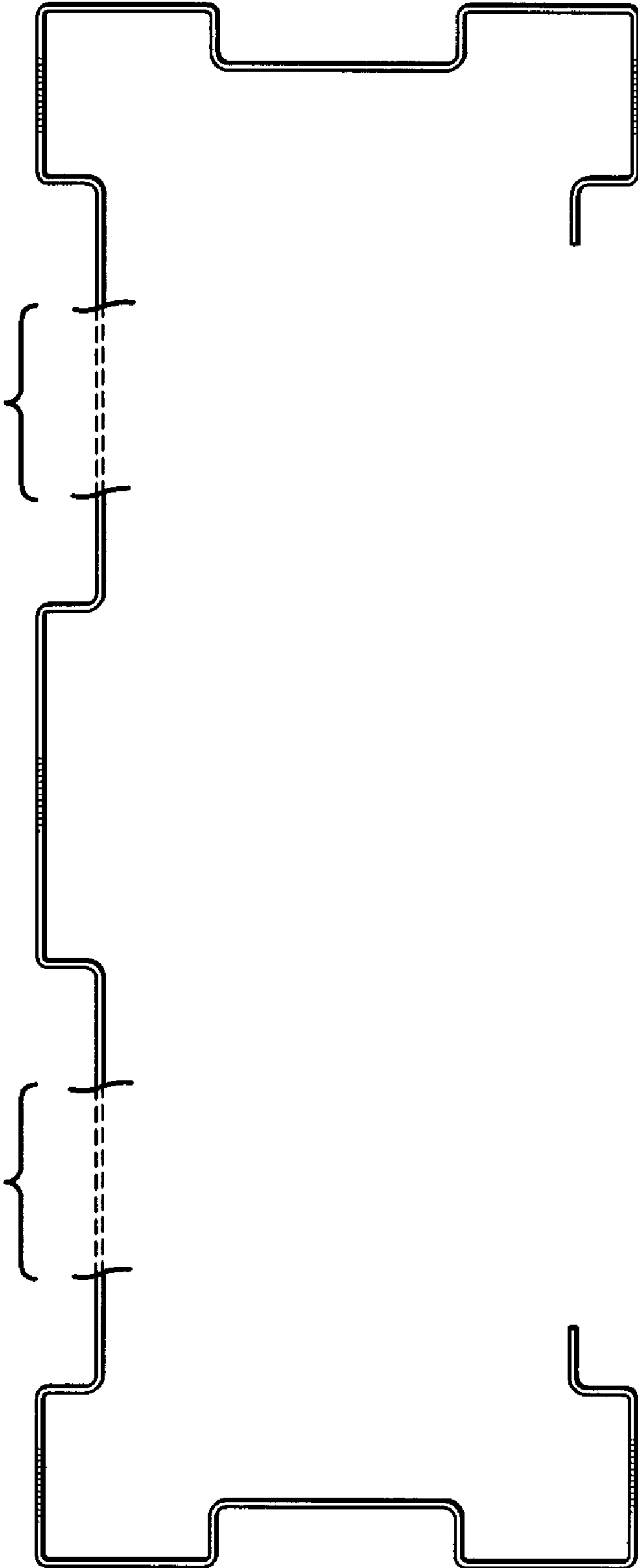

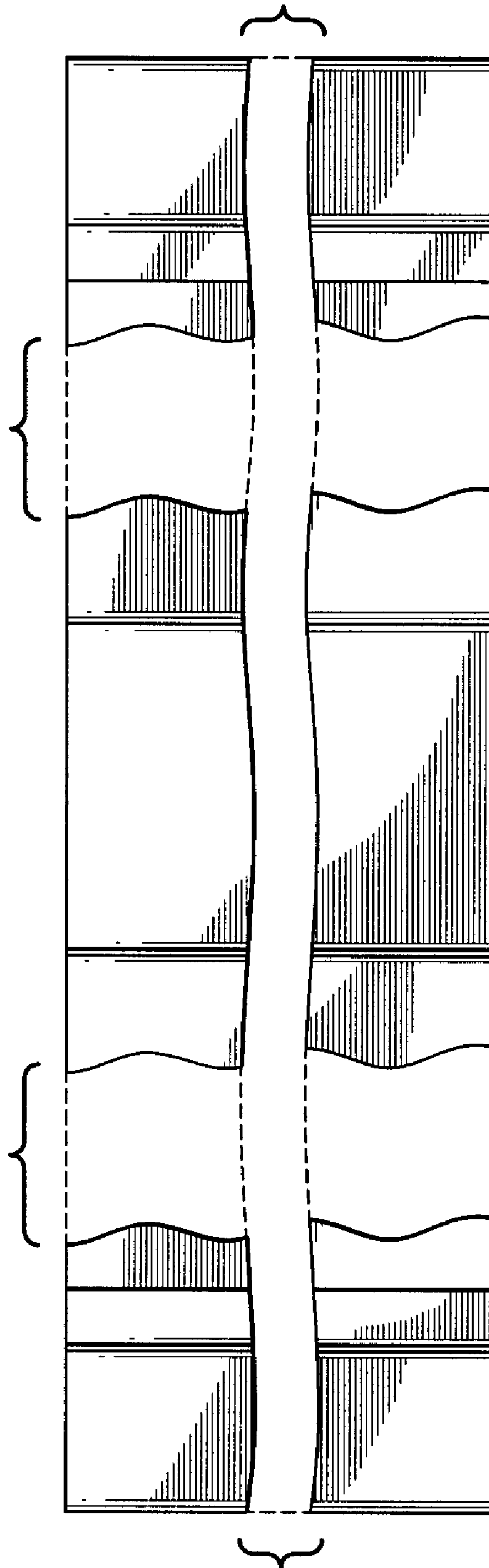

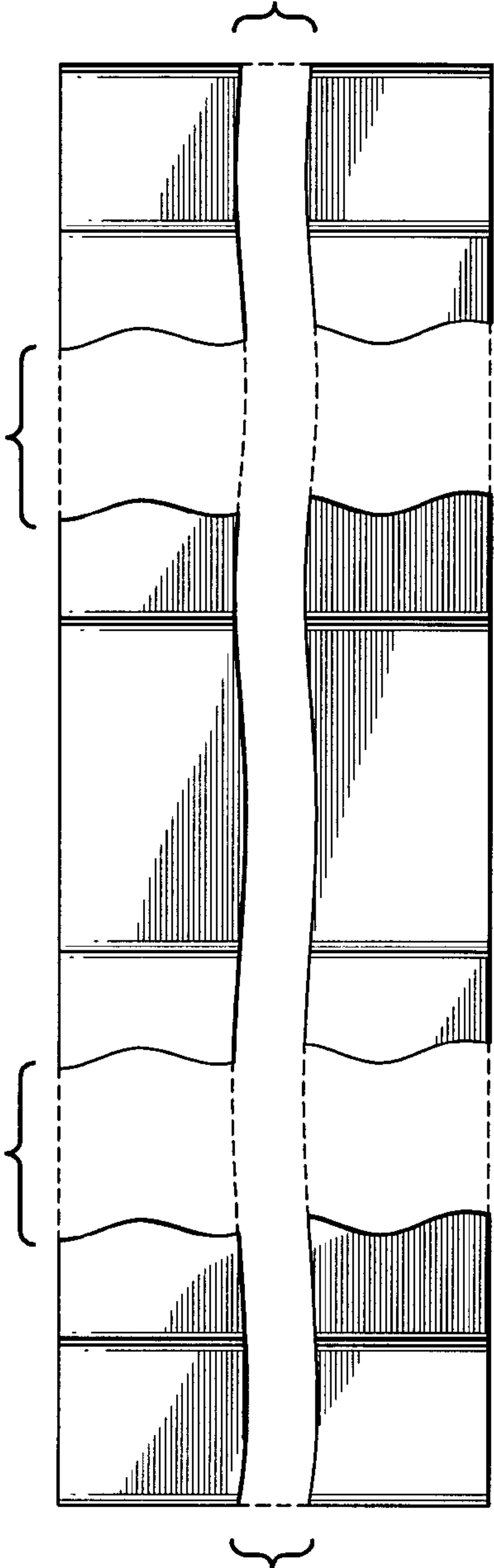

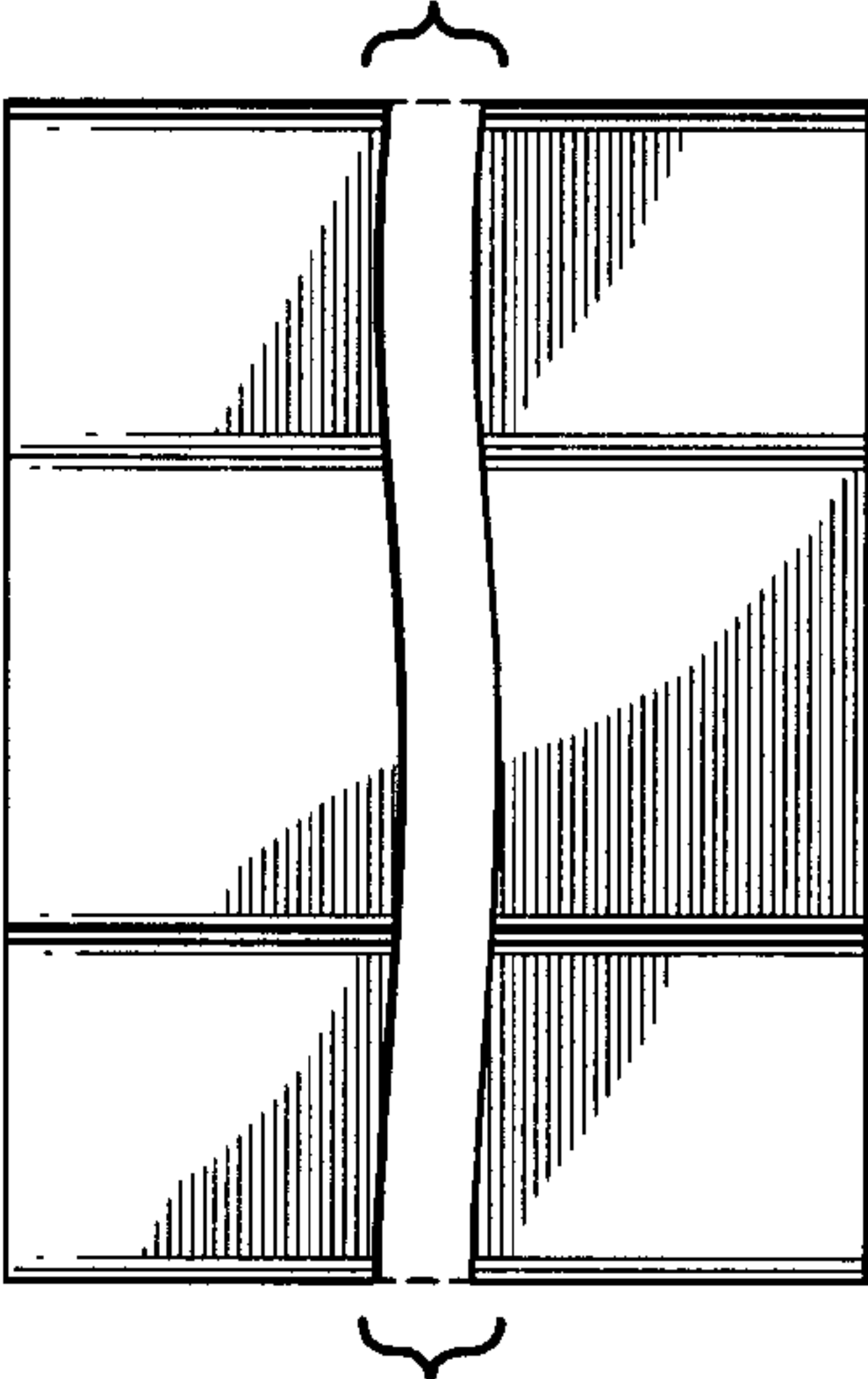

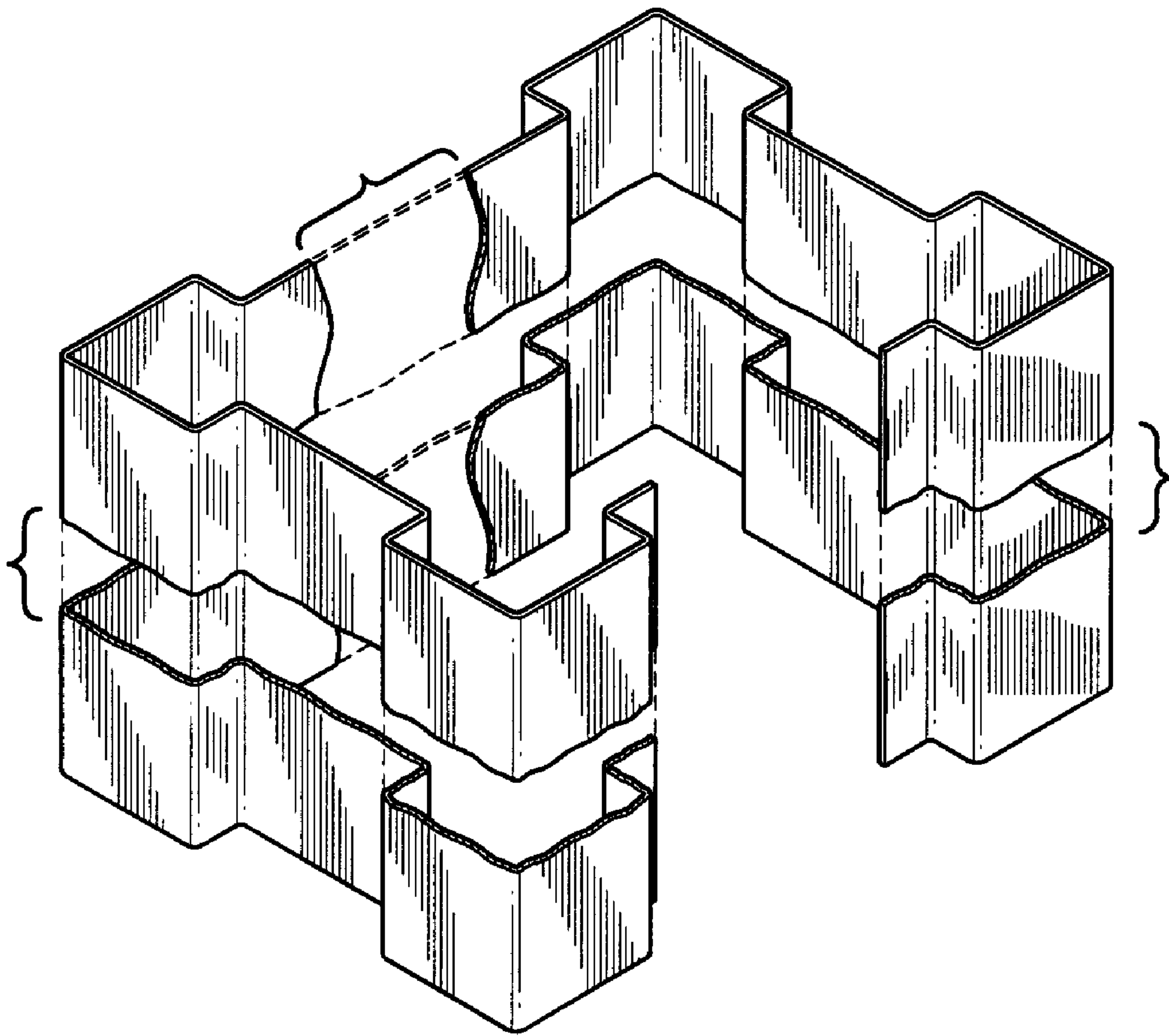

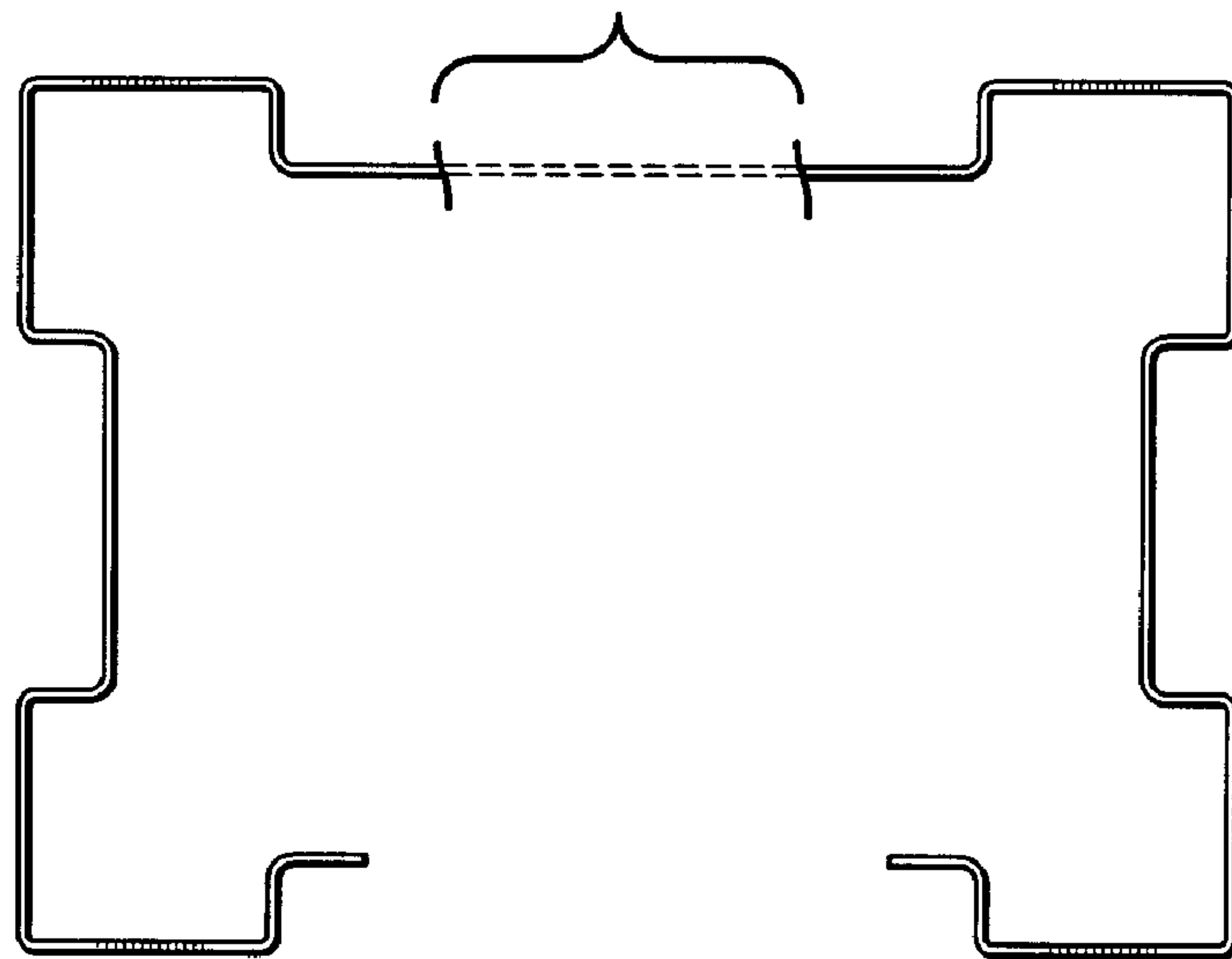

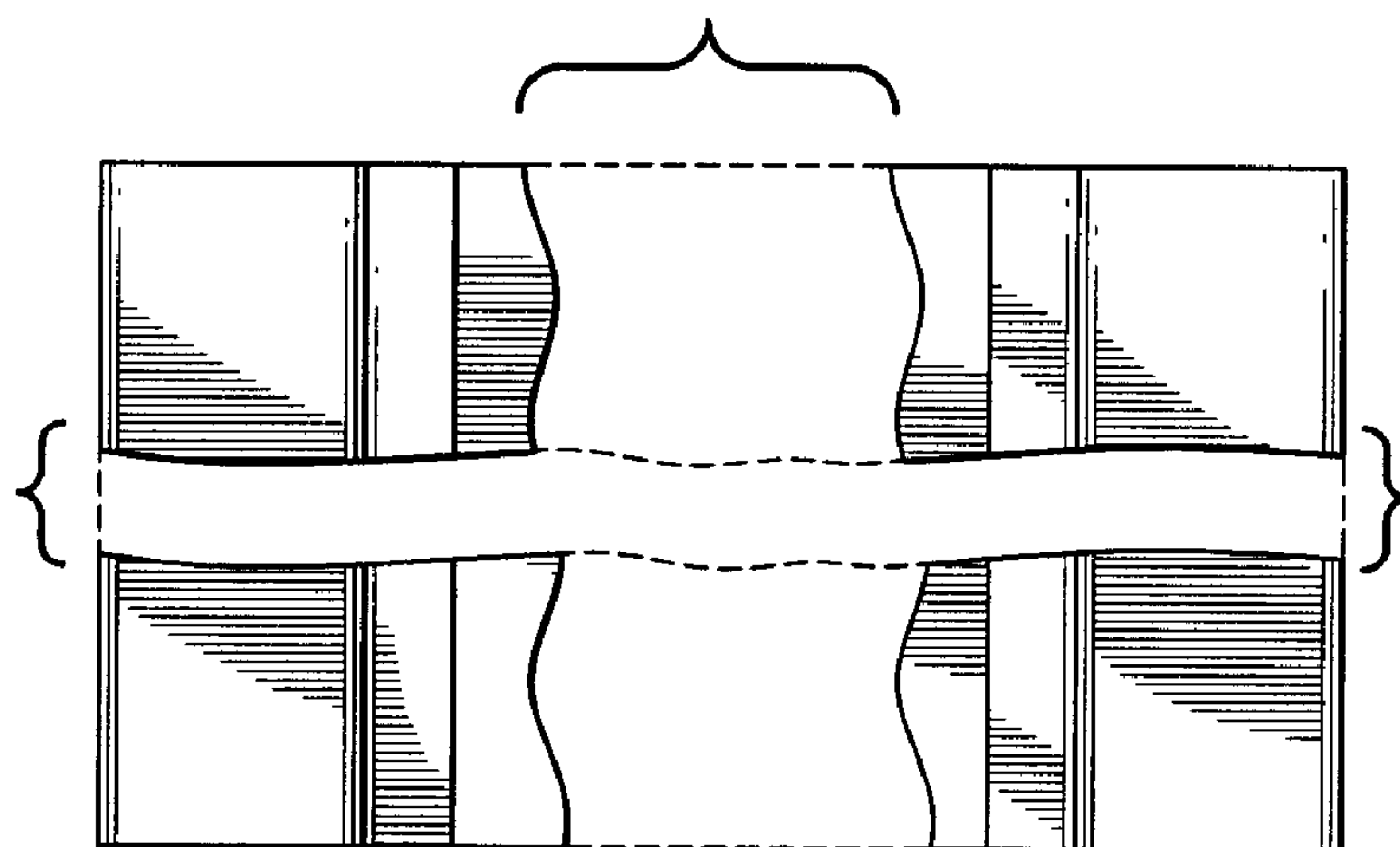

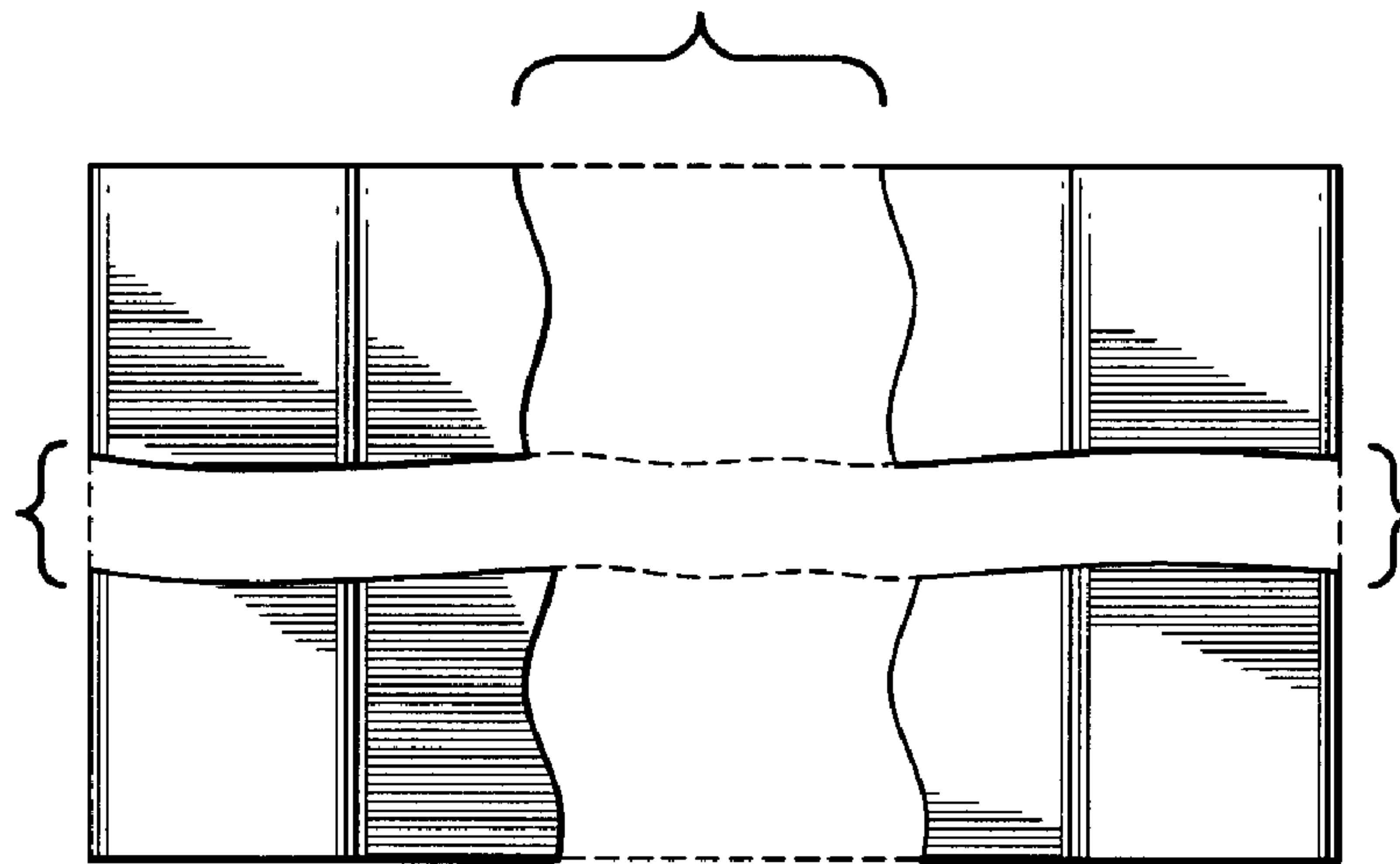

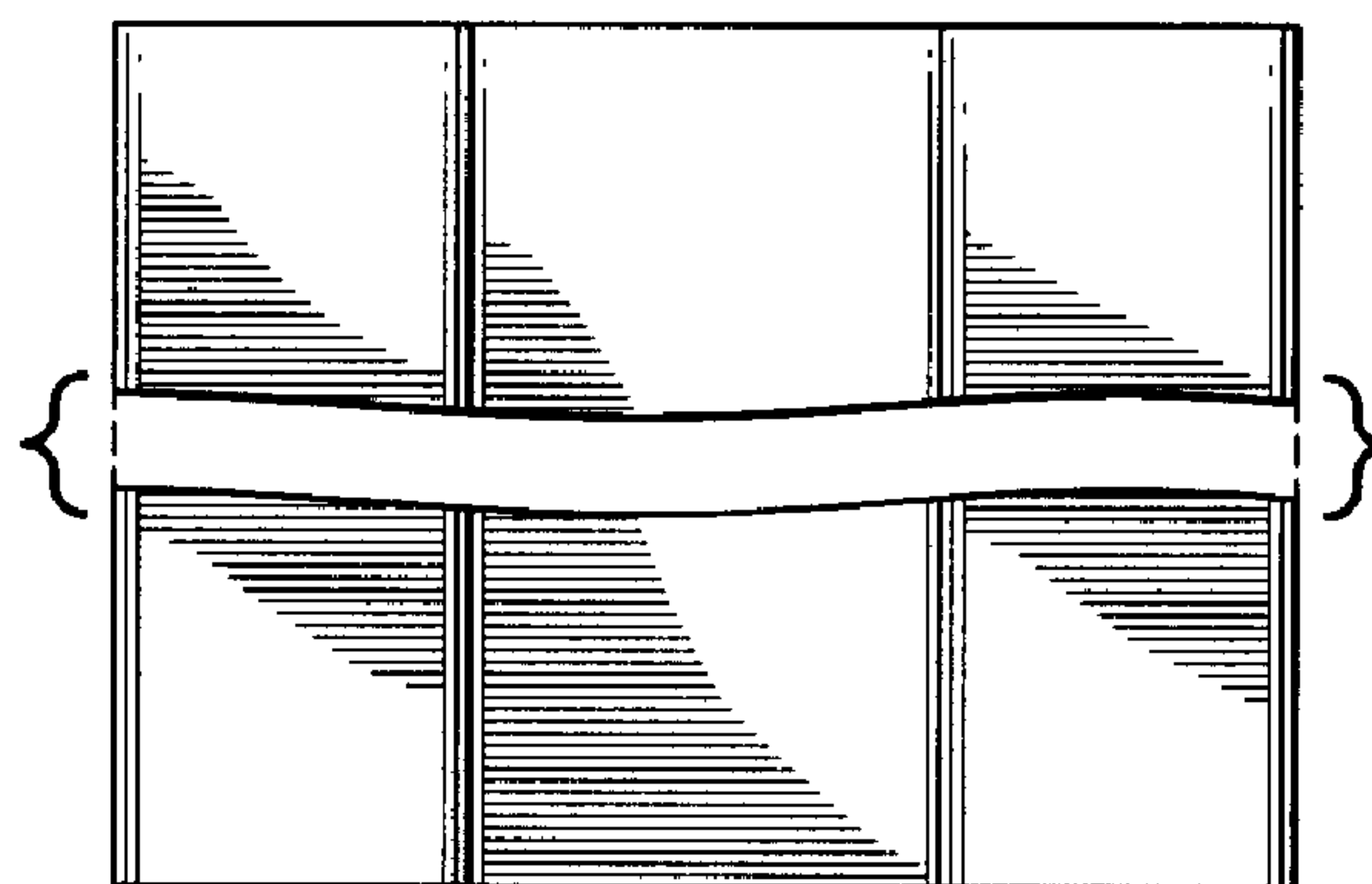
