FIG. 6 is an enlarged perspective view of the area labeled "6" in FIG. 1.

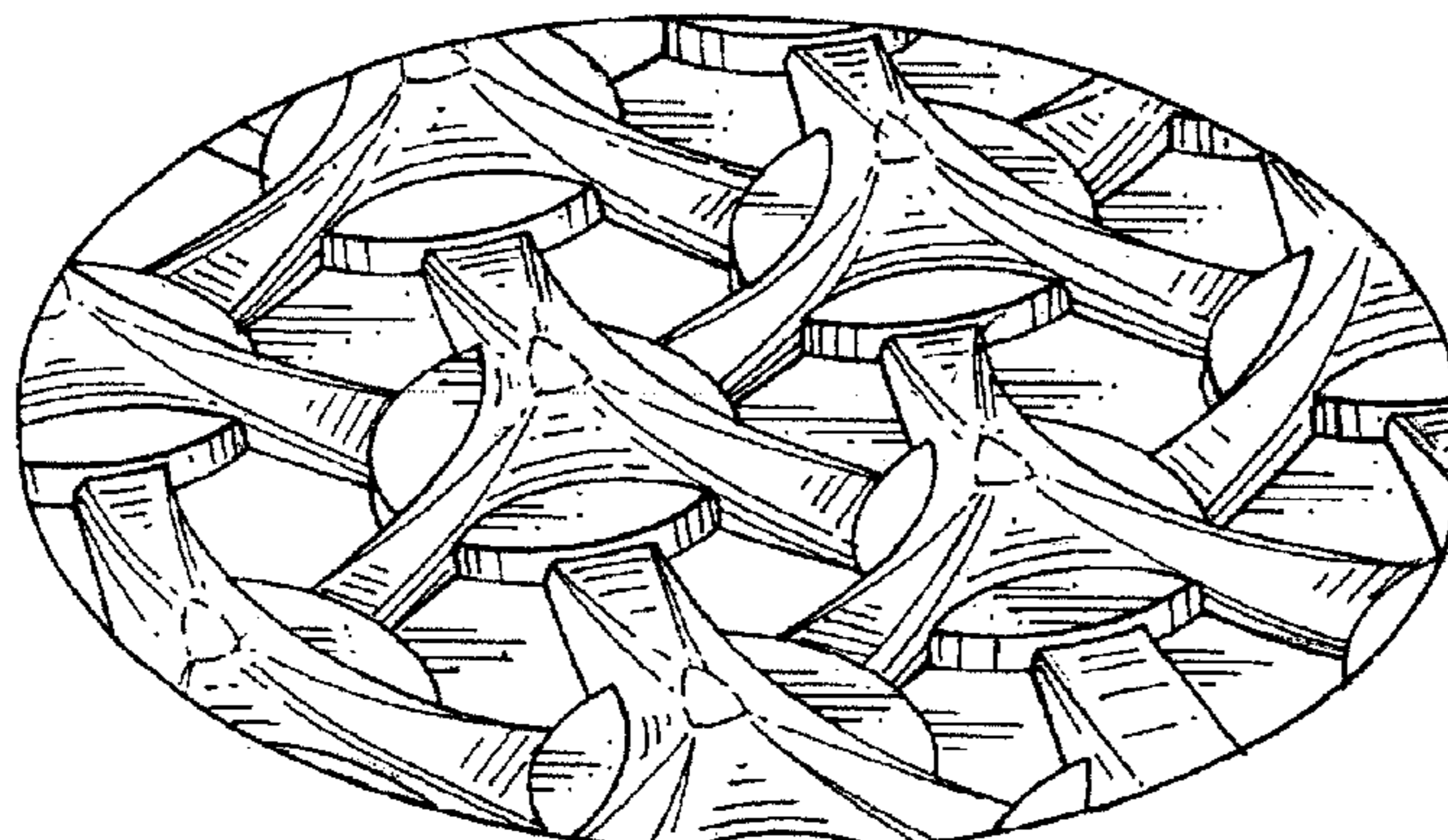
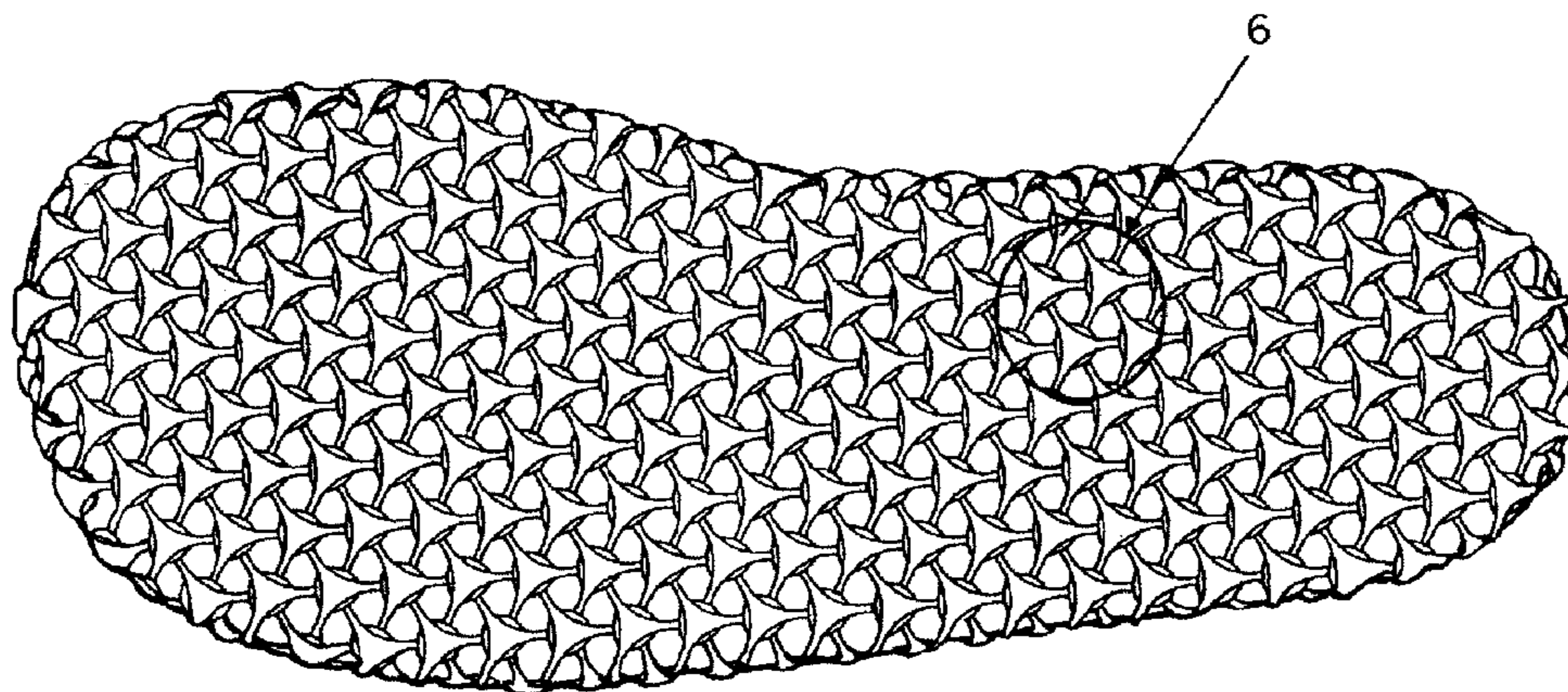

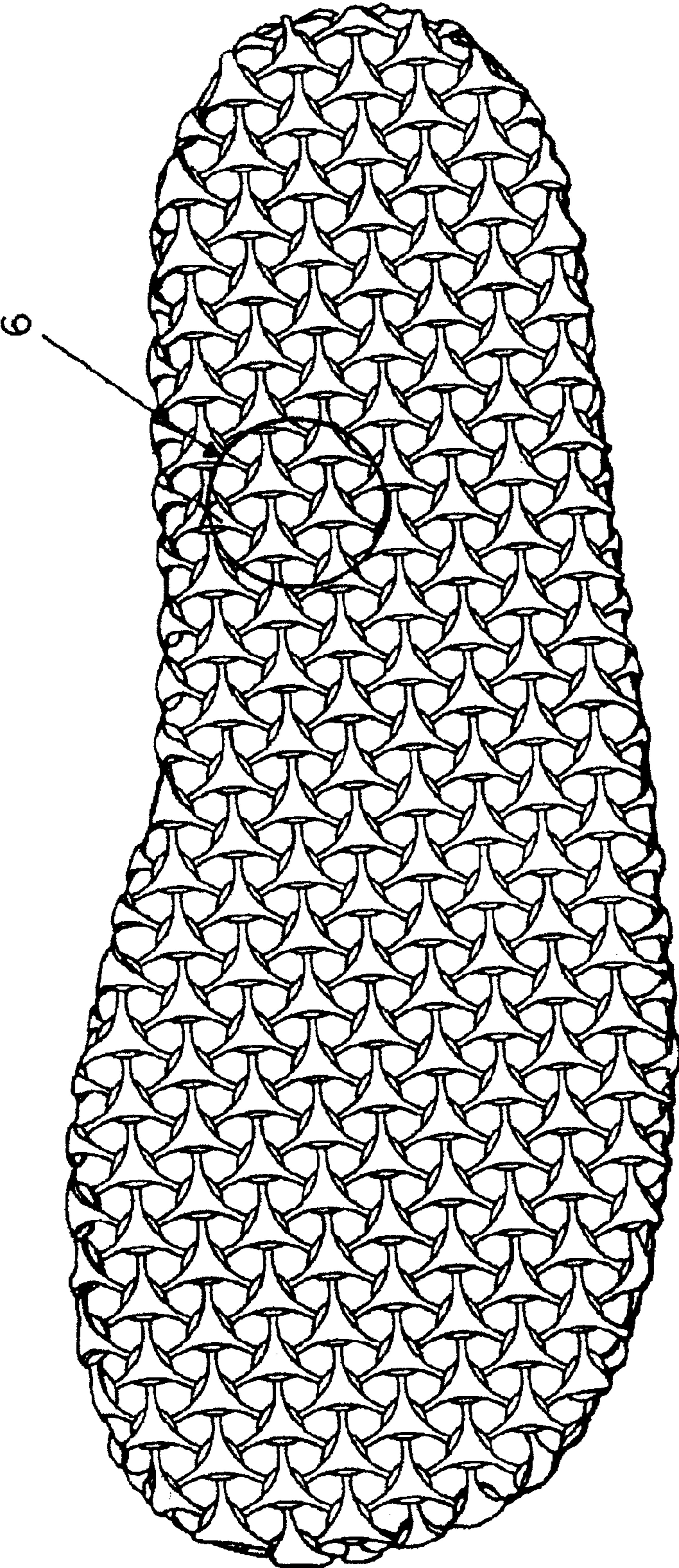
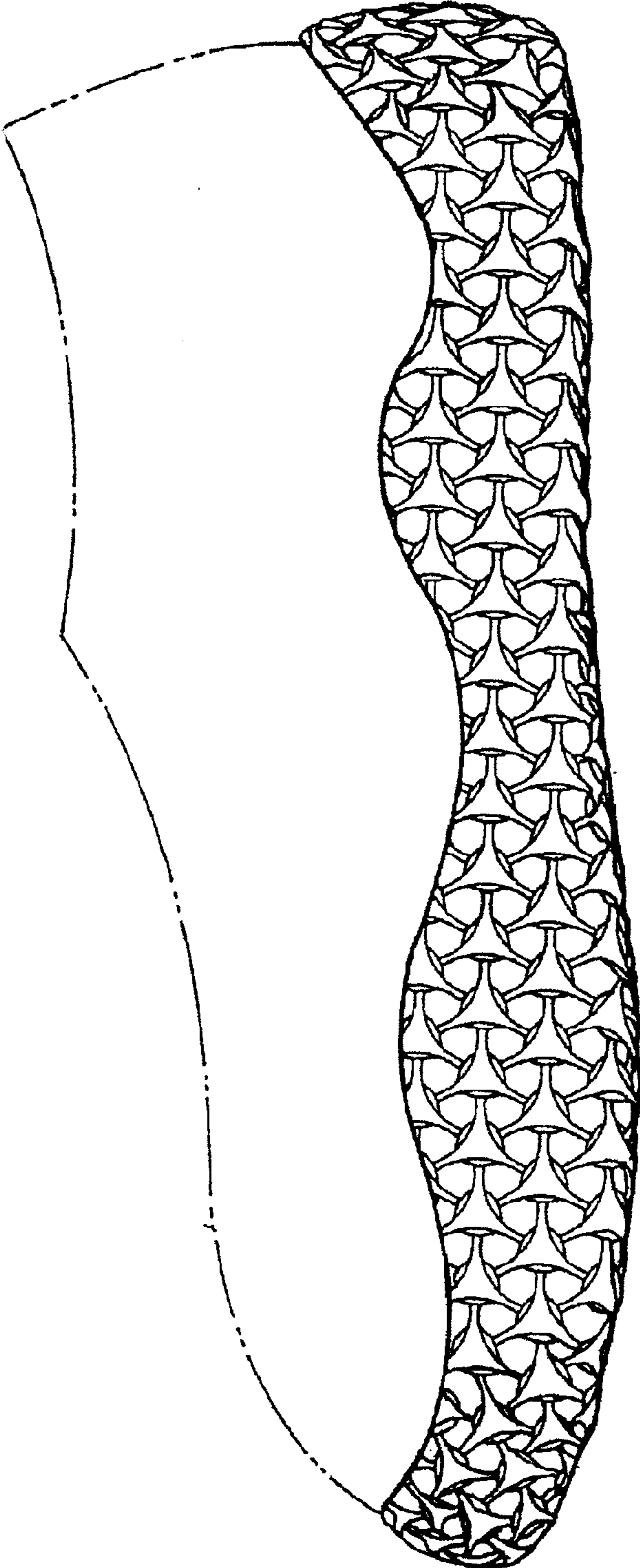

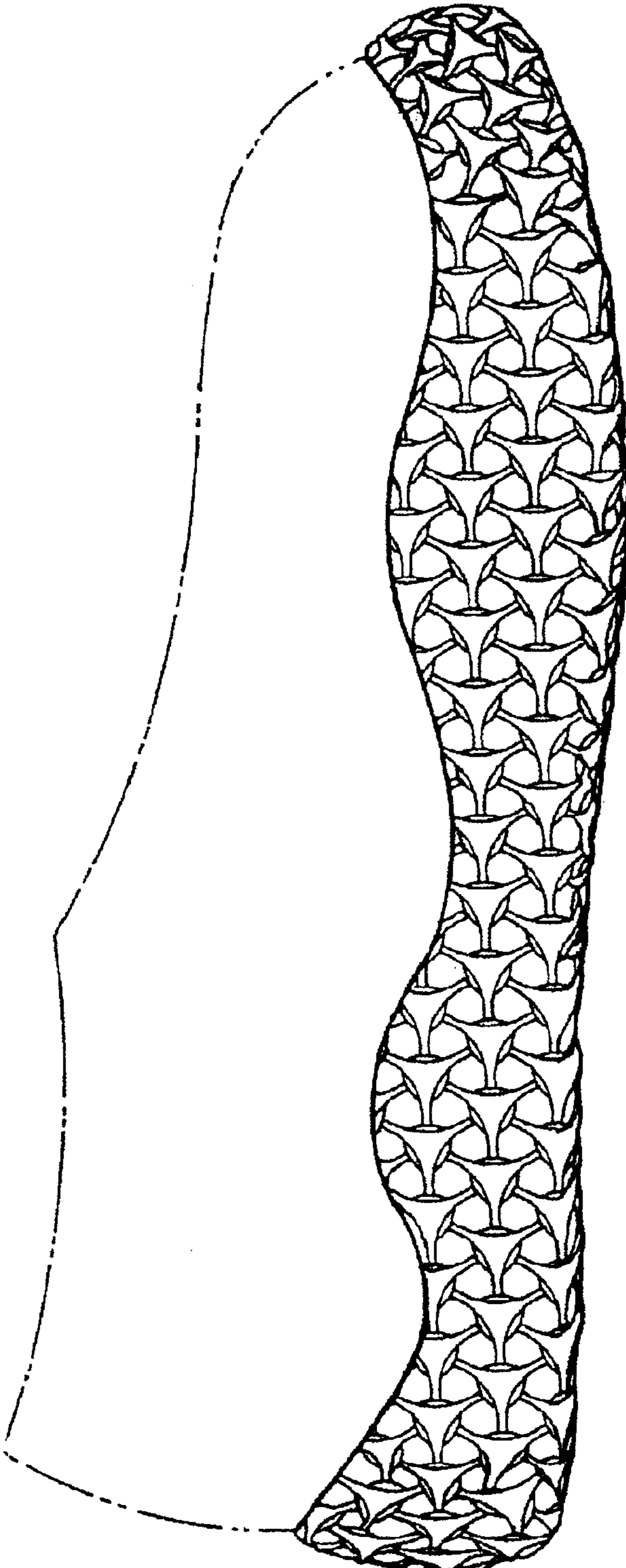
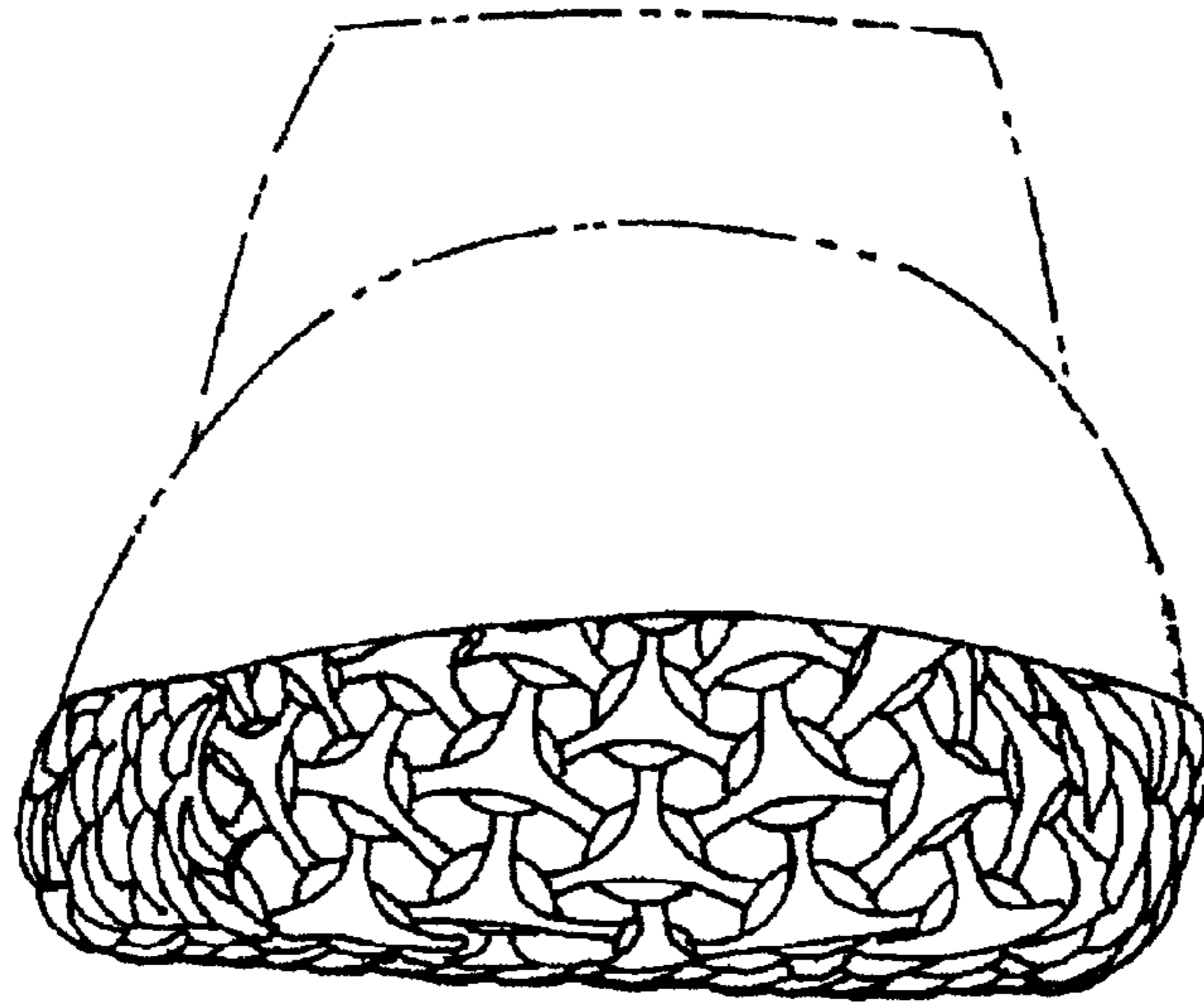
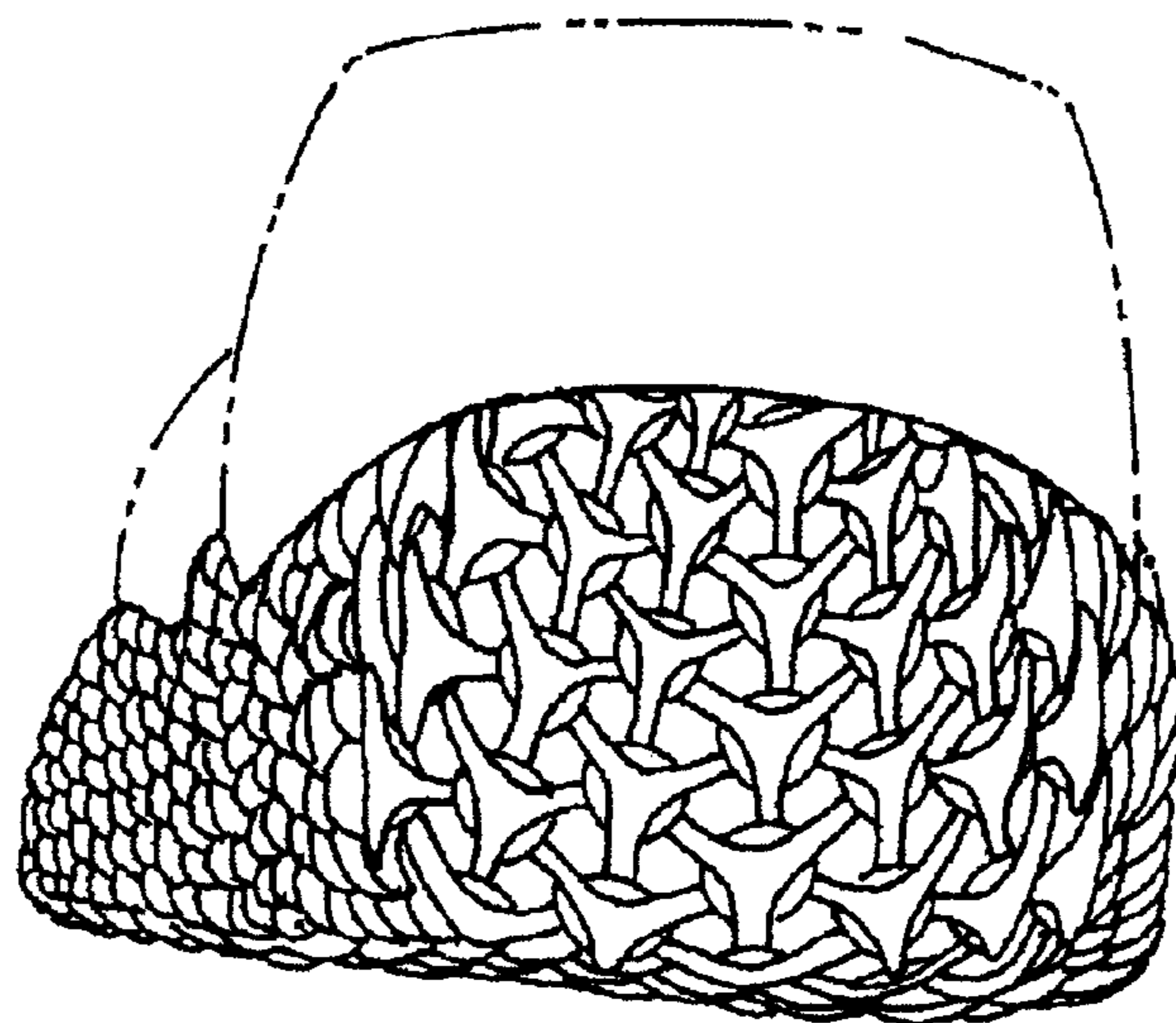


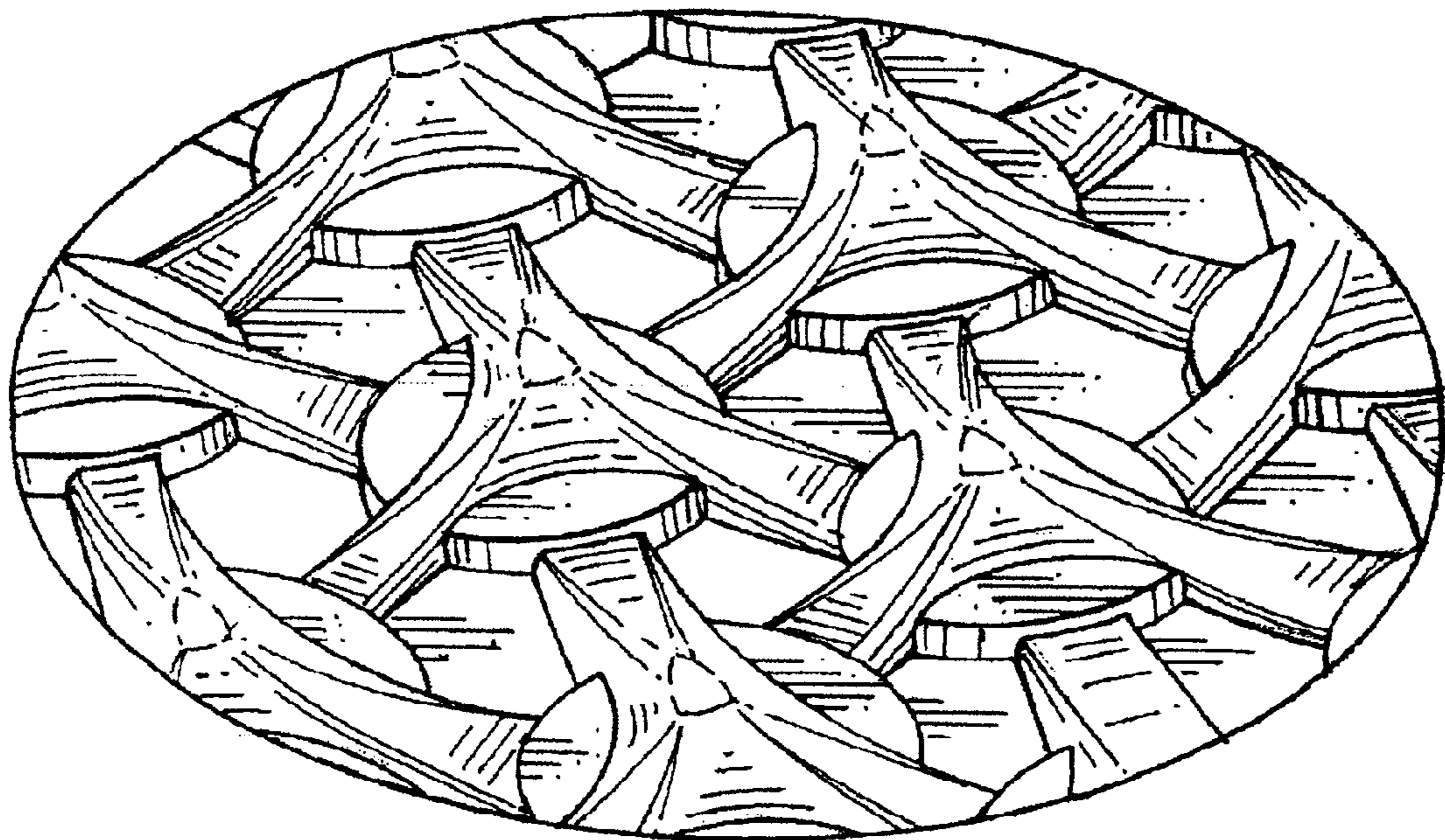
