The ornamental design for a portion of furniture, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a first embodiment of a portion of furniture showing my new design;

FIG. 9 is a perspective view of a third embodiment of a portion of furniture showing my new design;

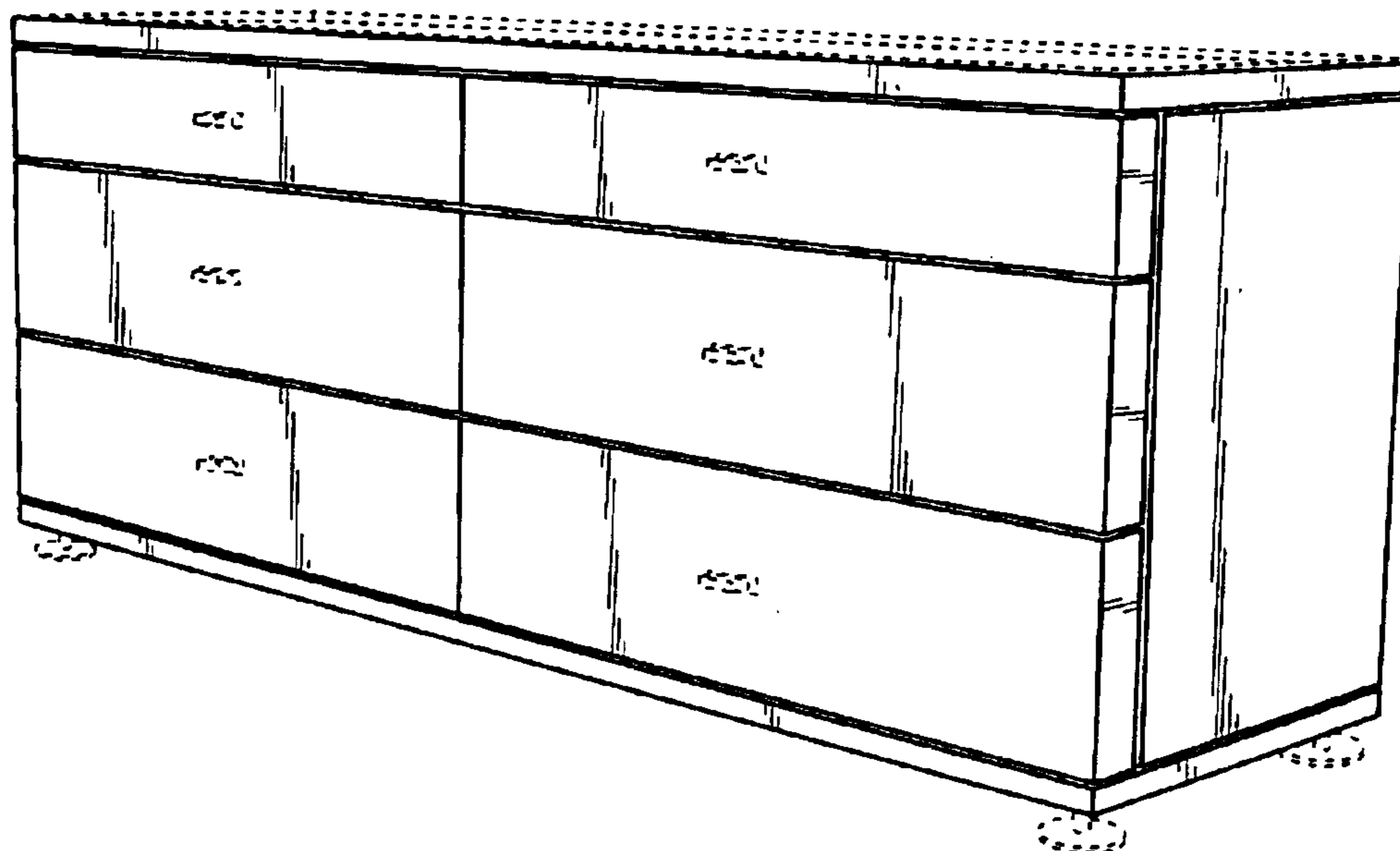
FIG. 10 is a top view thereof;

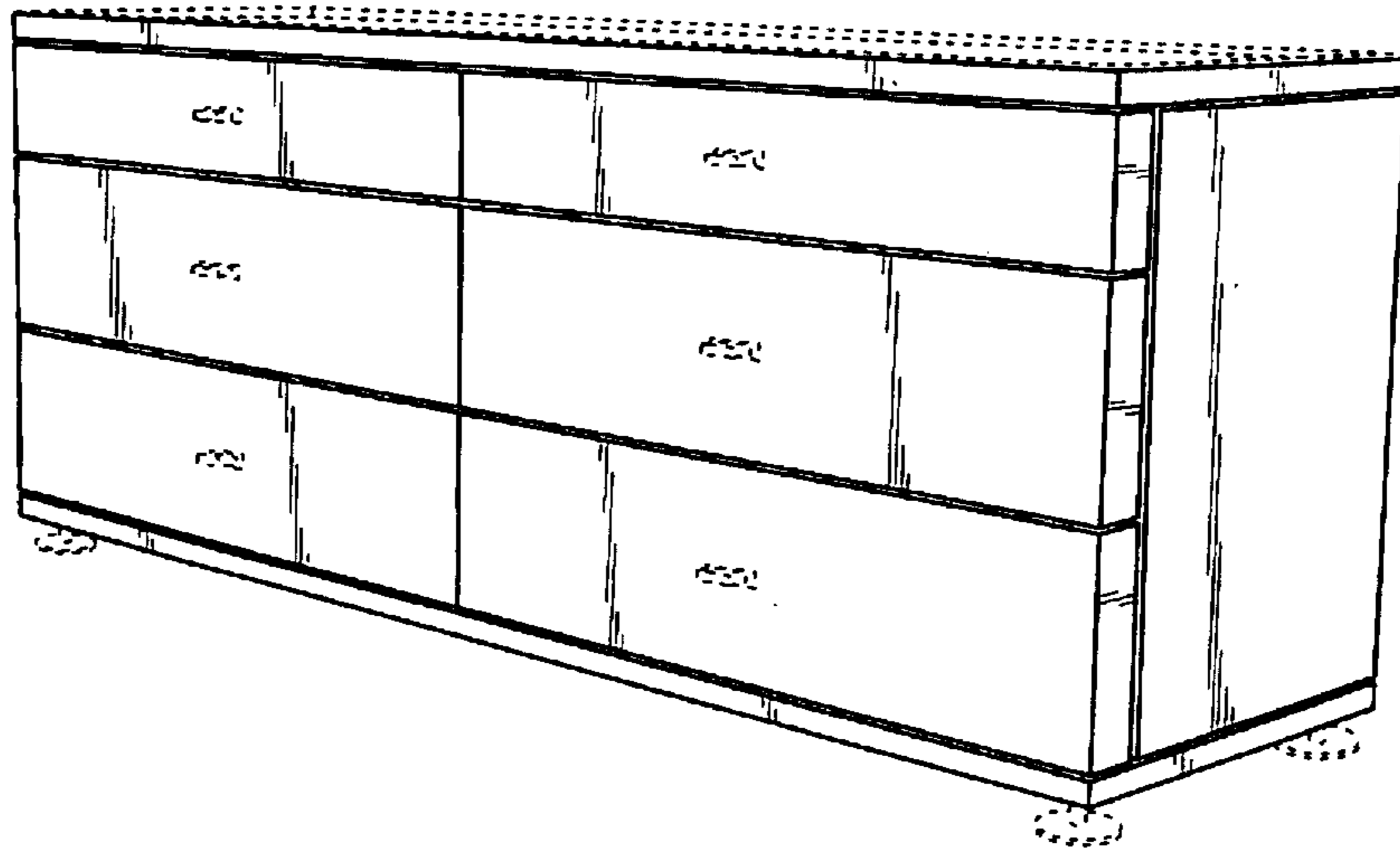

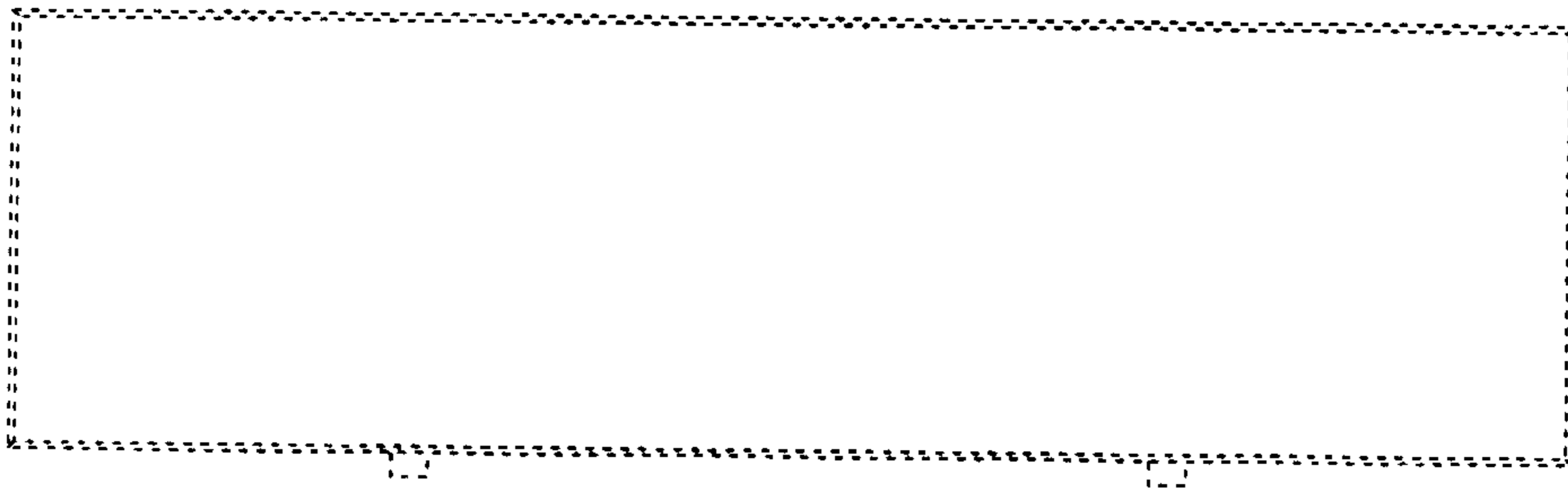

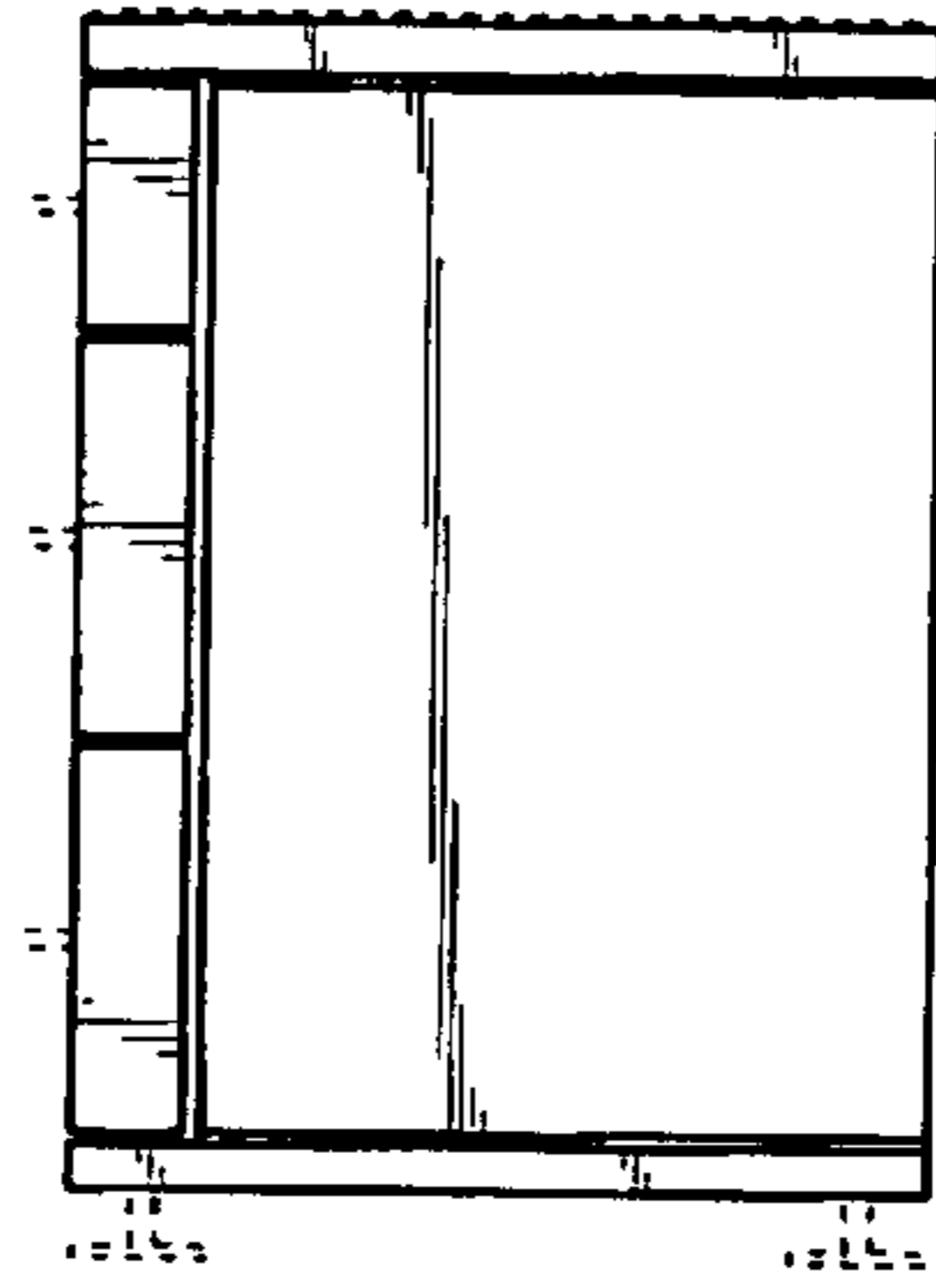

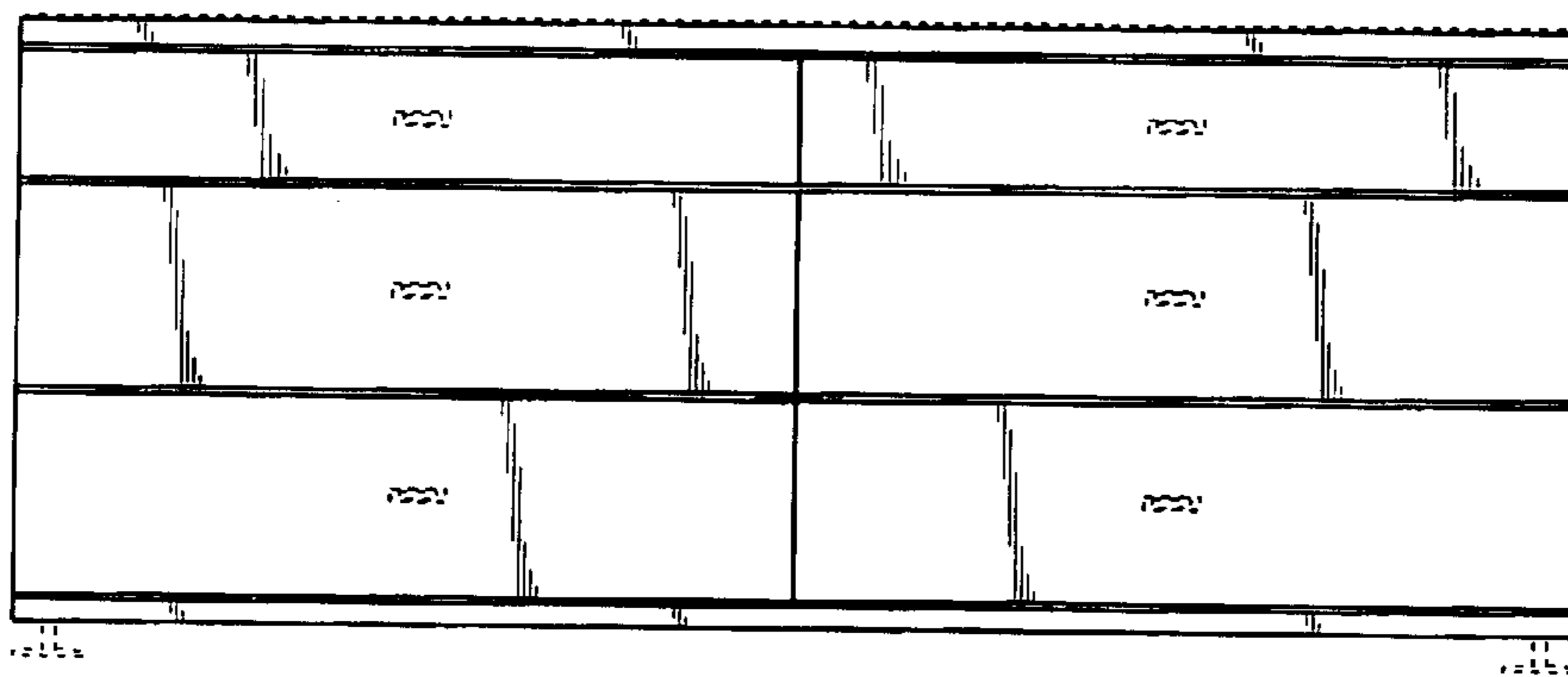

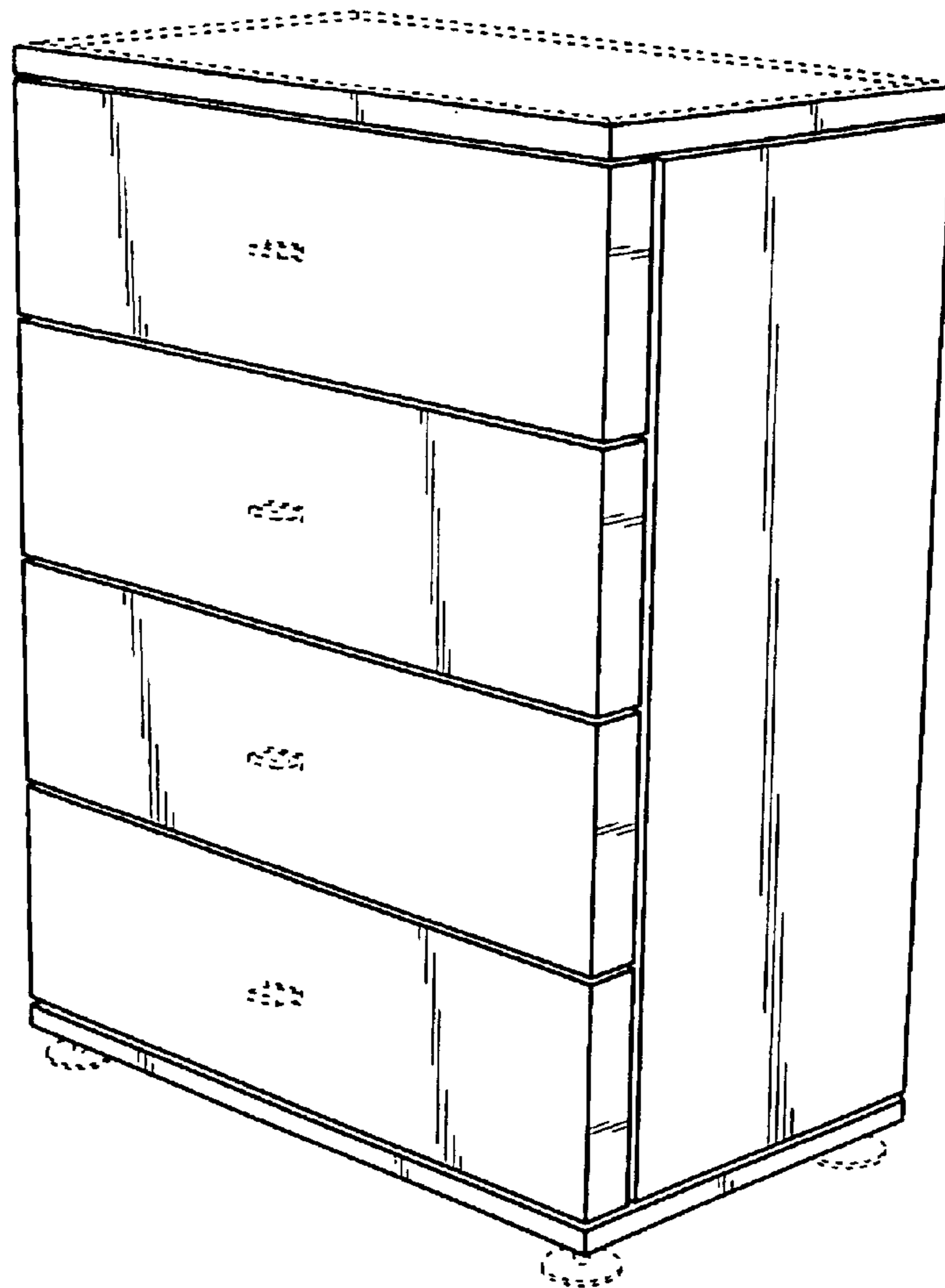

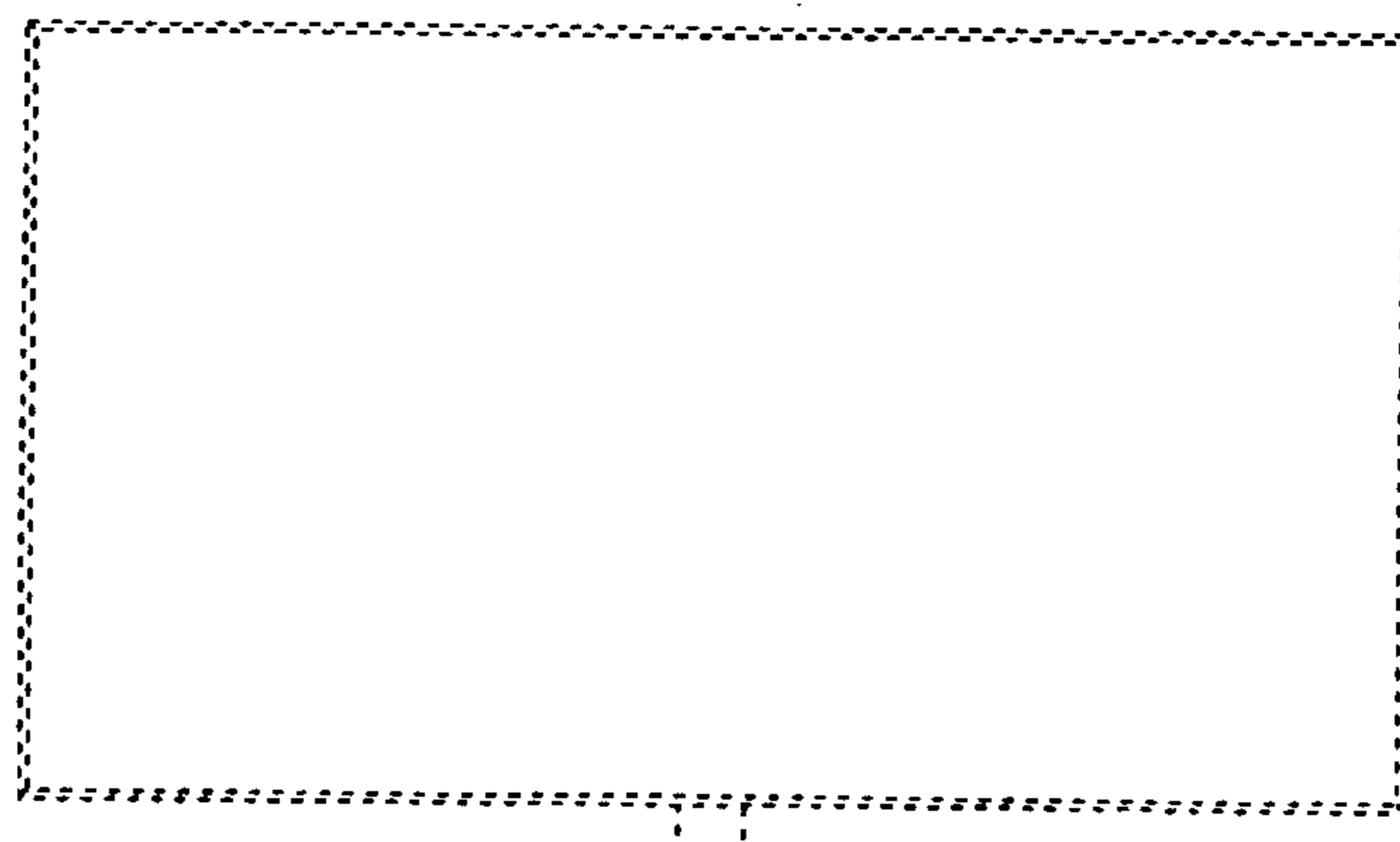

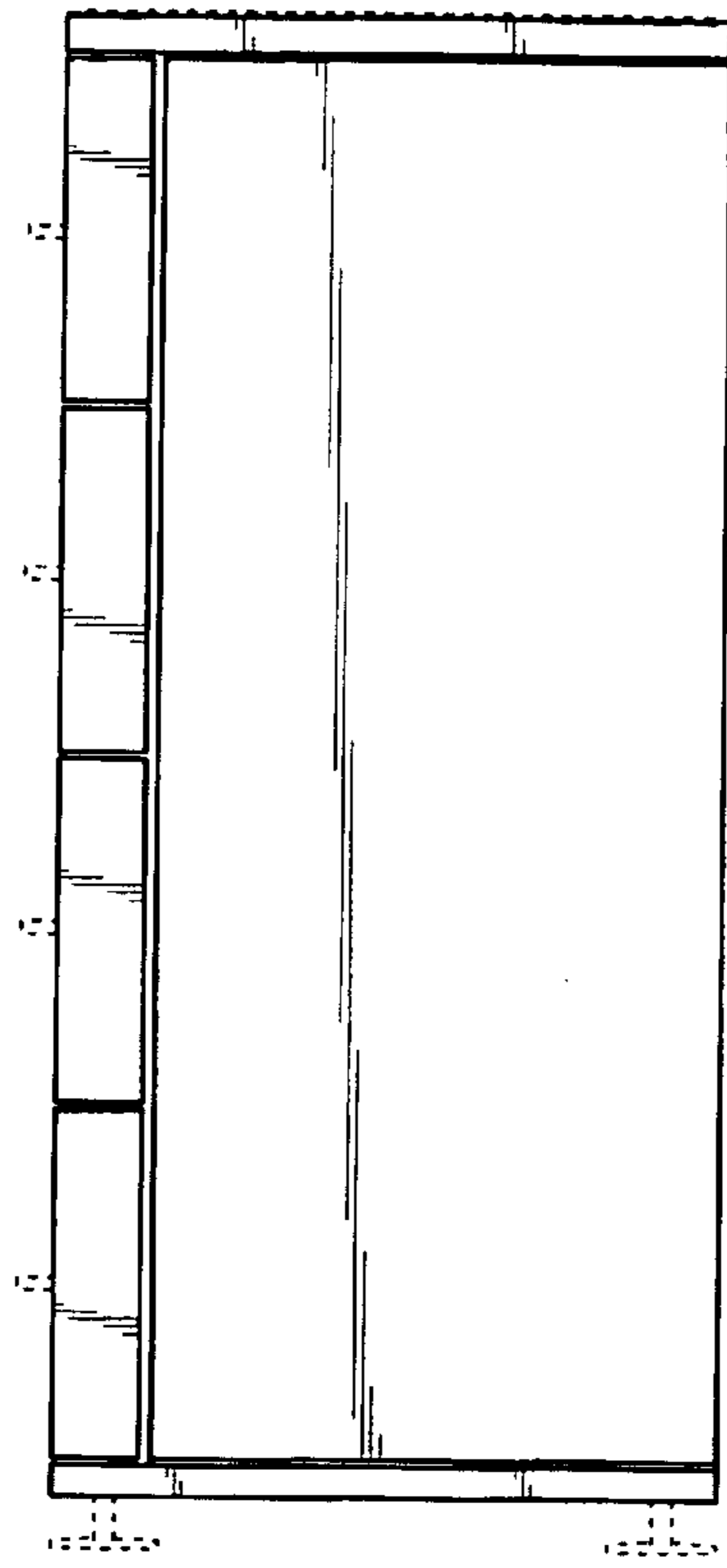

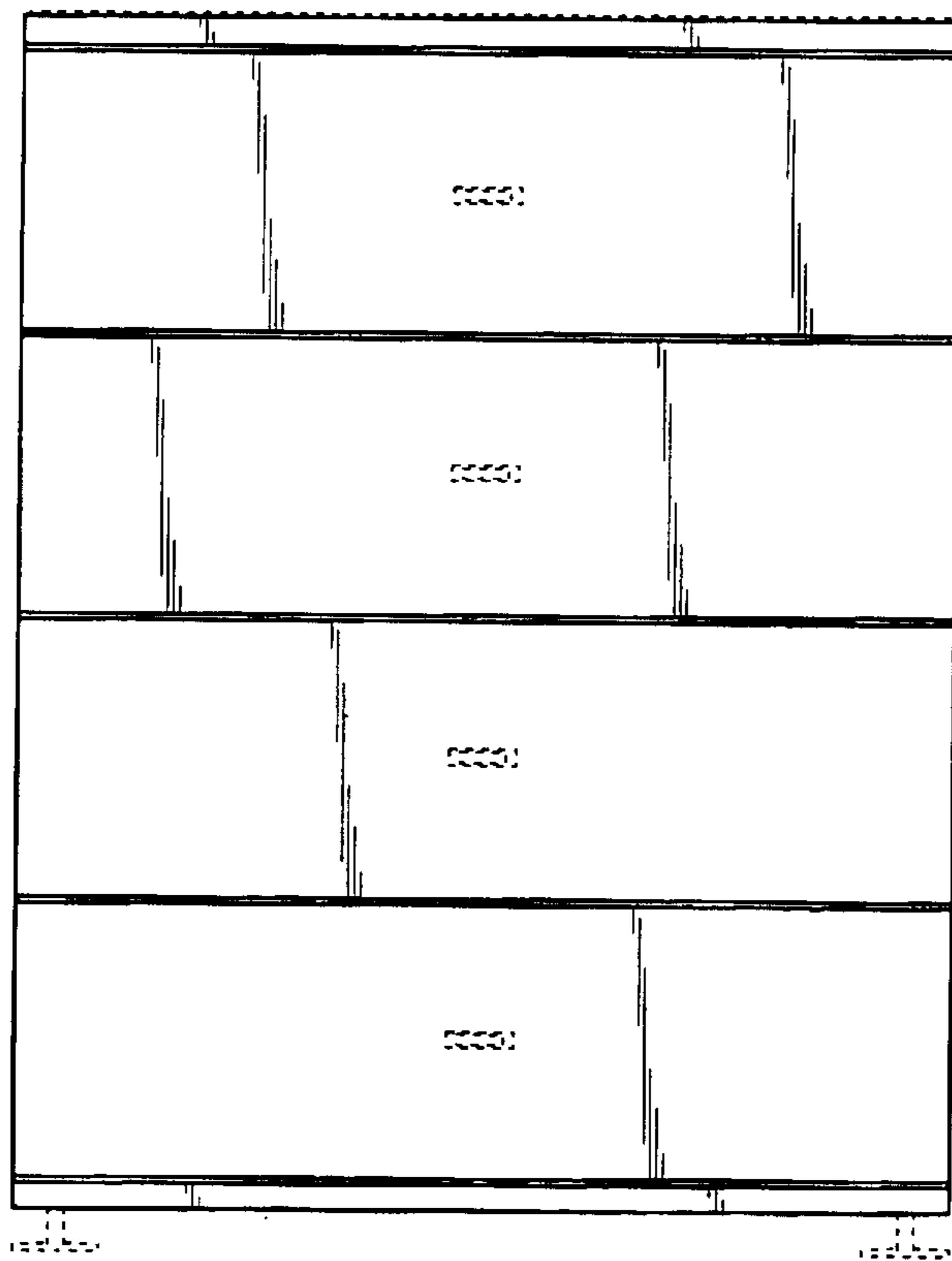

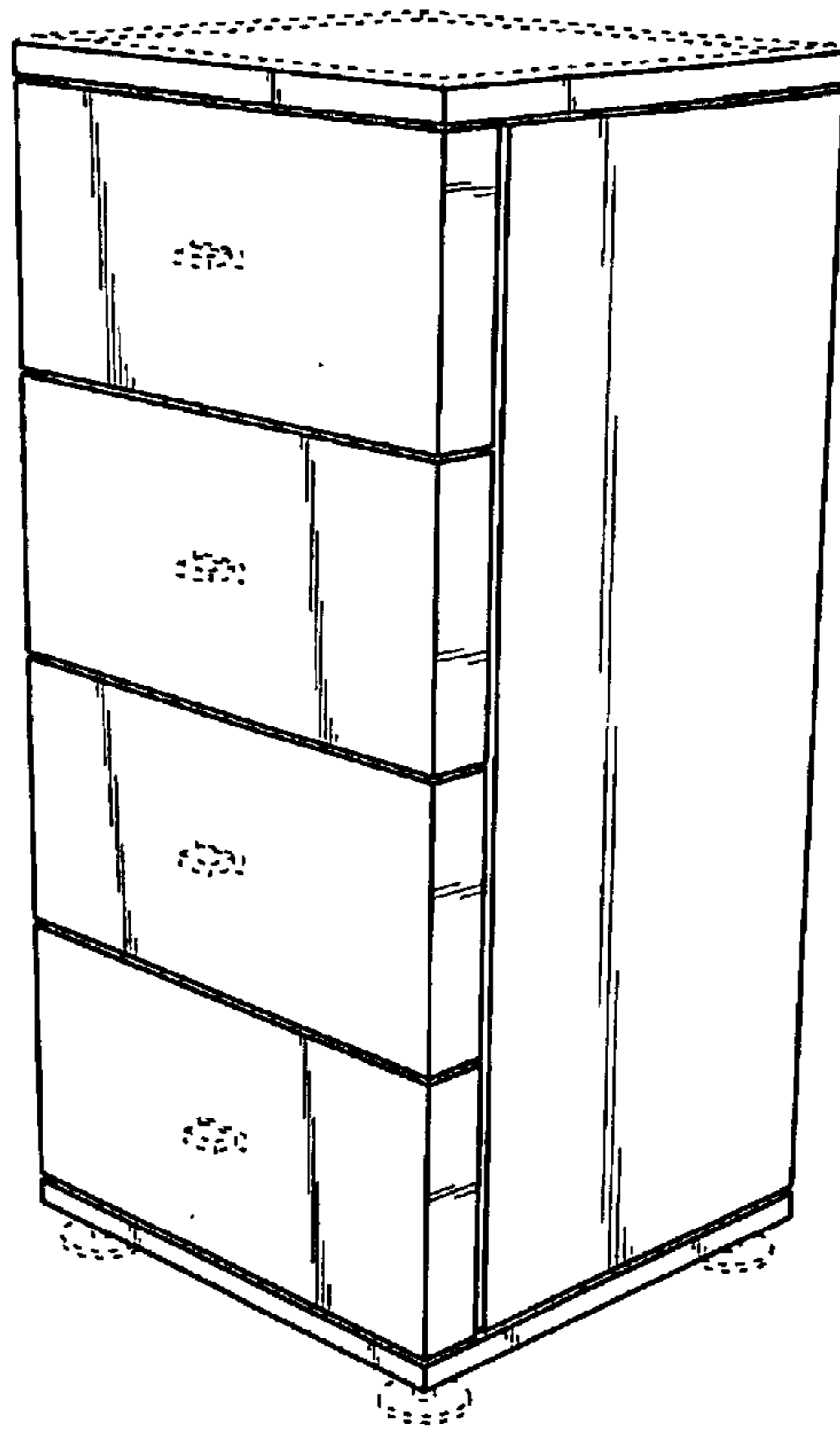

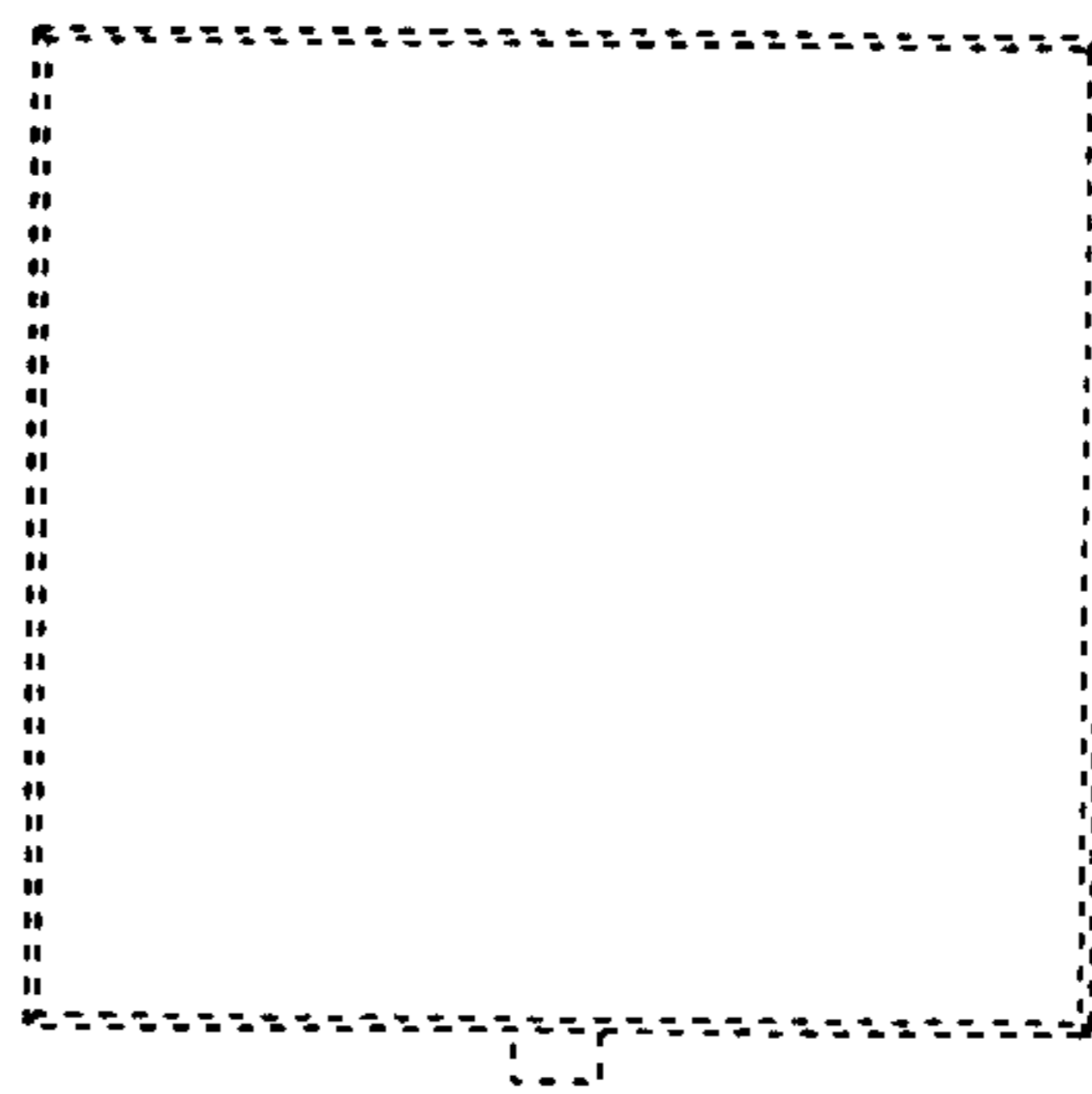

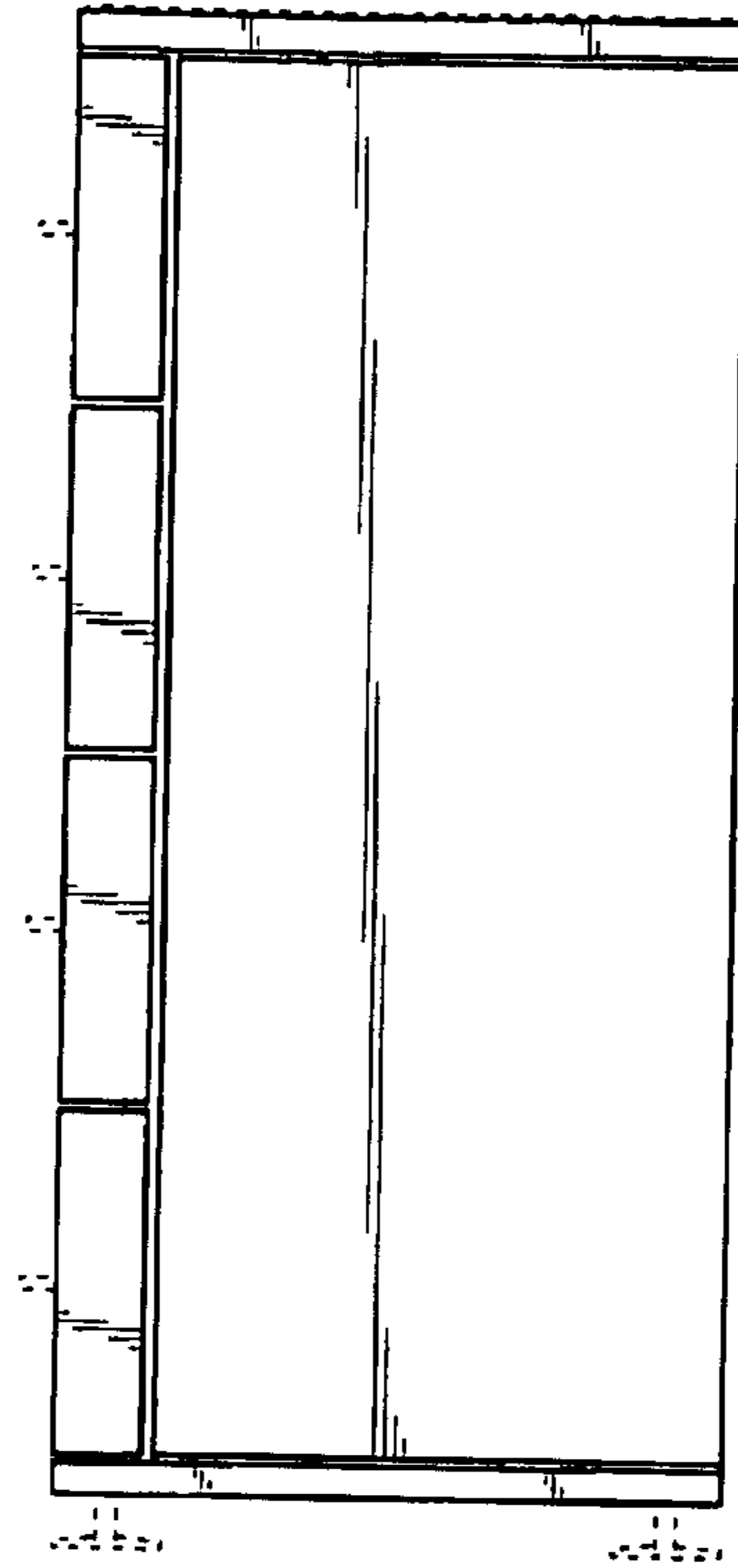

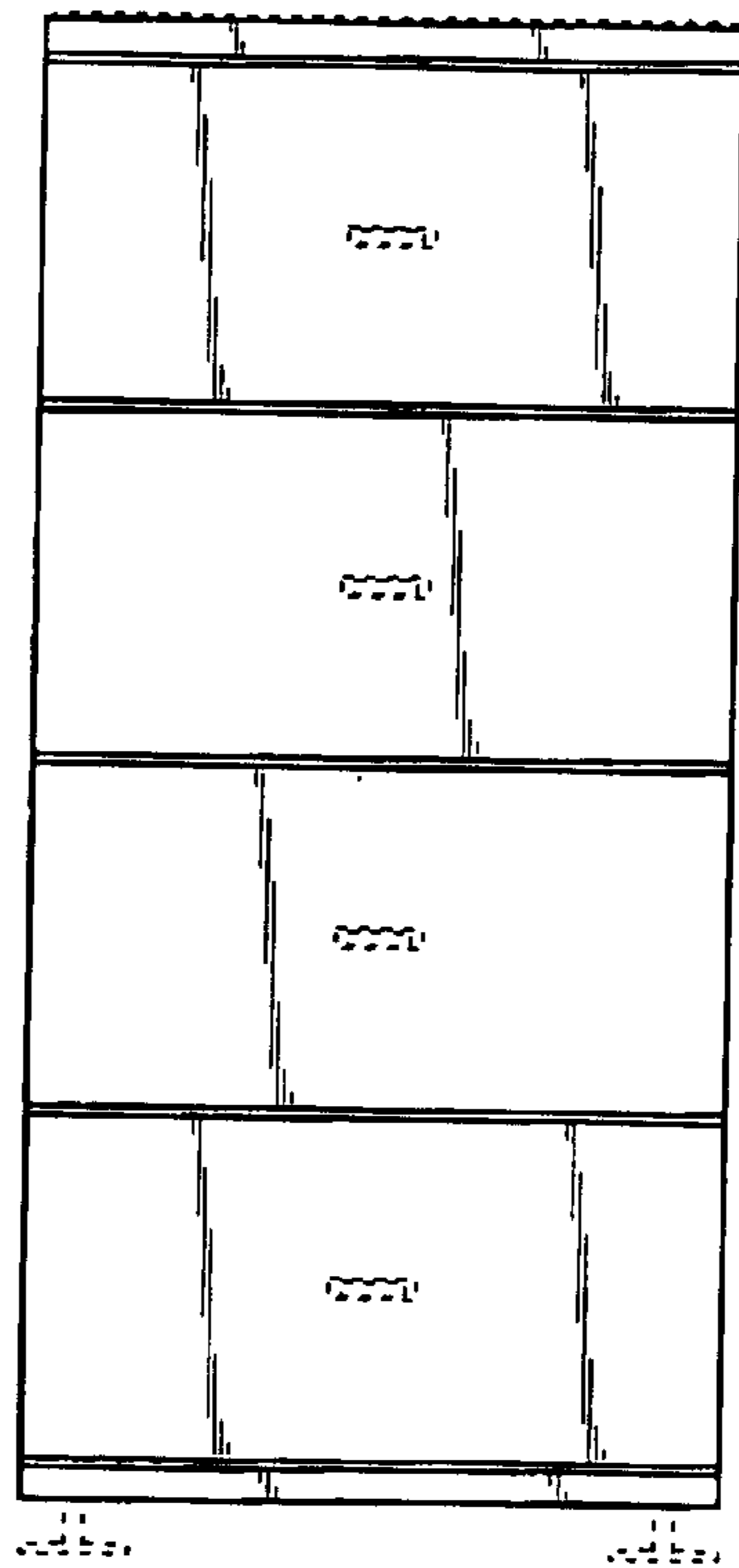
