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(57) **CLAIM**

I claim the ornamental design for a heart-shaped pendant with reverse side having concealed alarm transmitter, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, side and rear perspective view of a heart-shaped pendant with reverse side having concealed alarm transmitter showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;

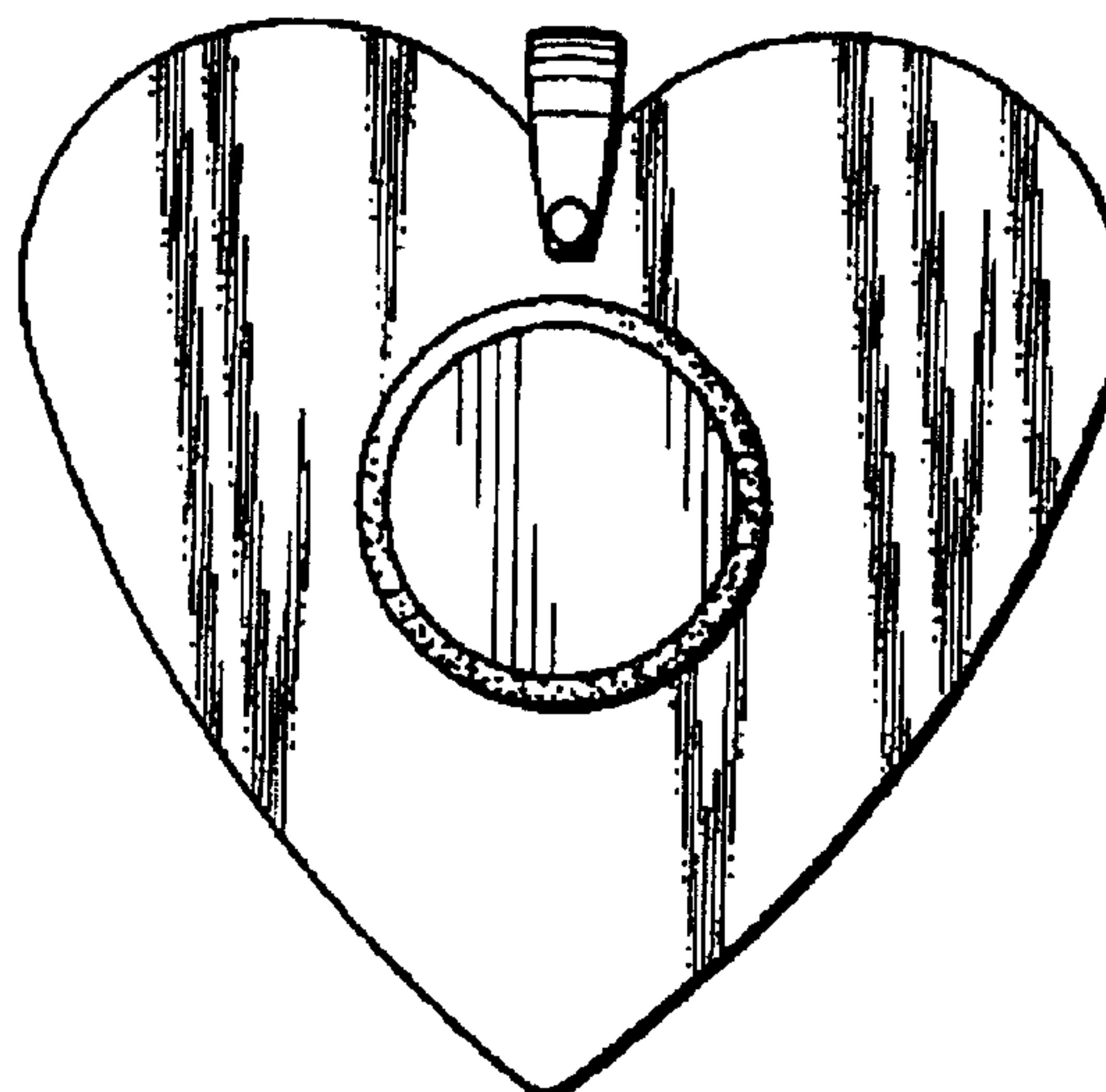
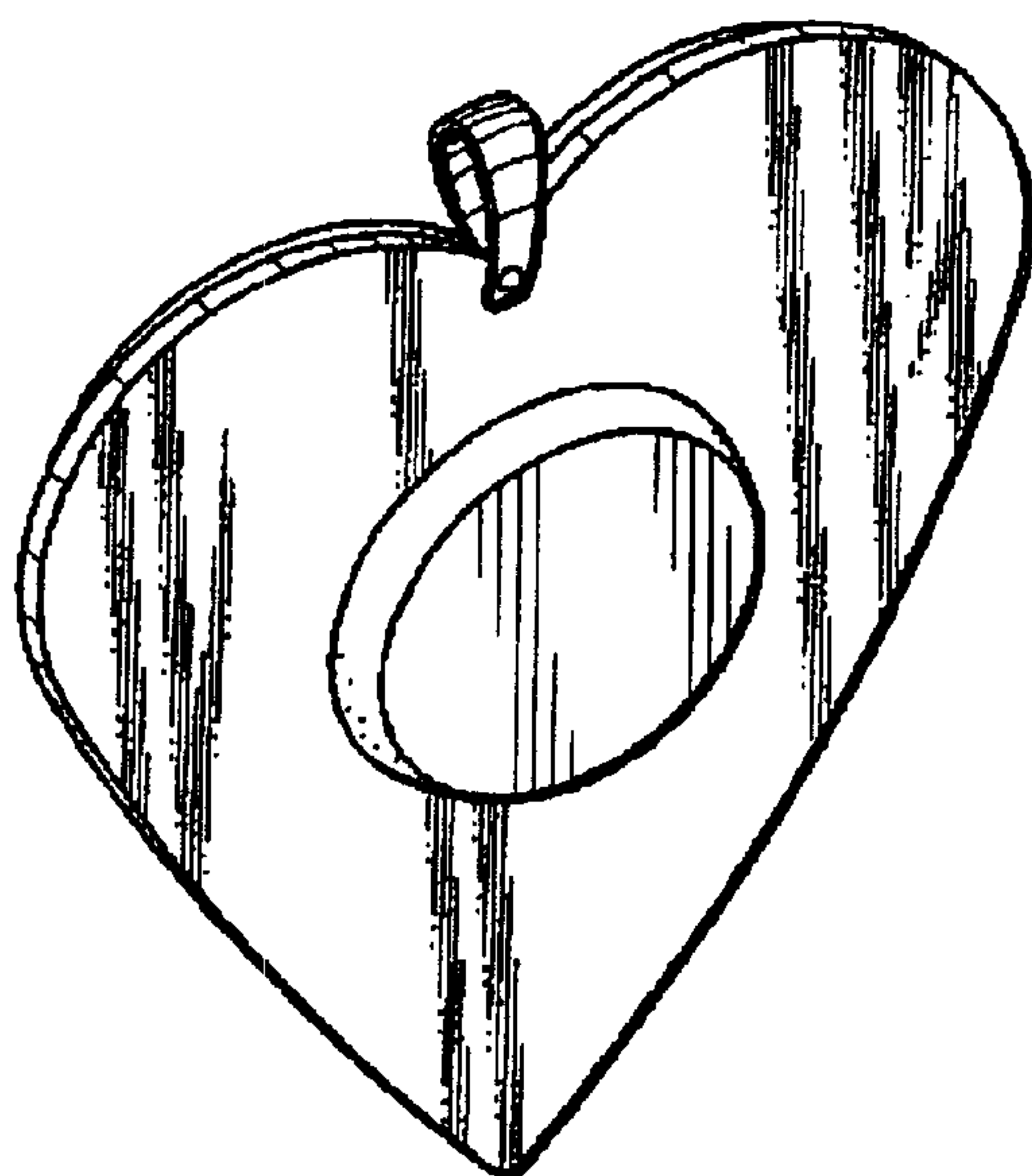
FIG. 4 is a side elevational view thereof, the elevational view of the opposing side being a mirror image thereof;

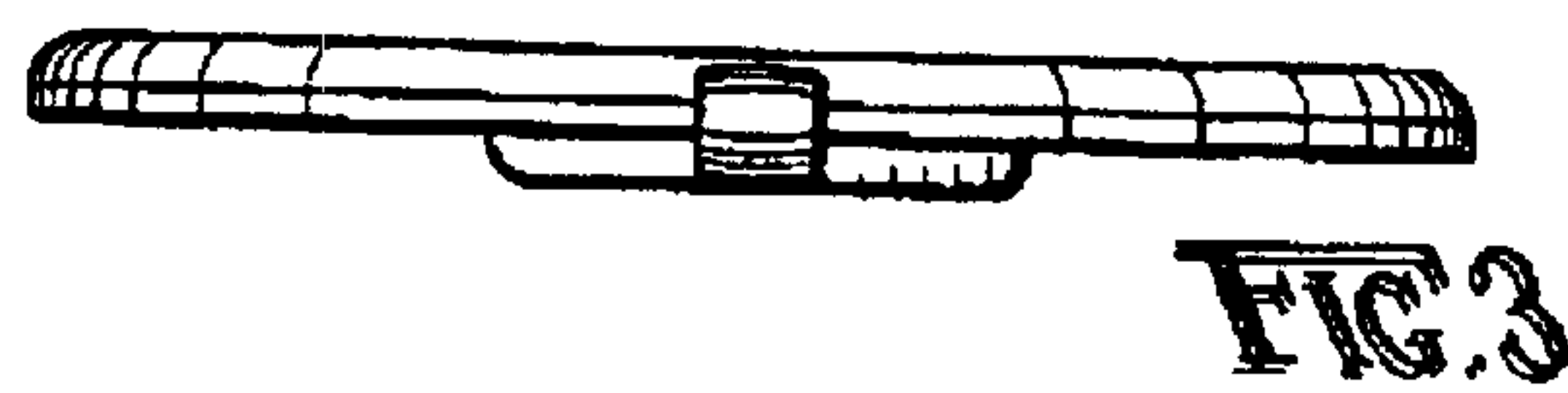
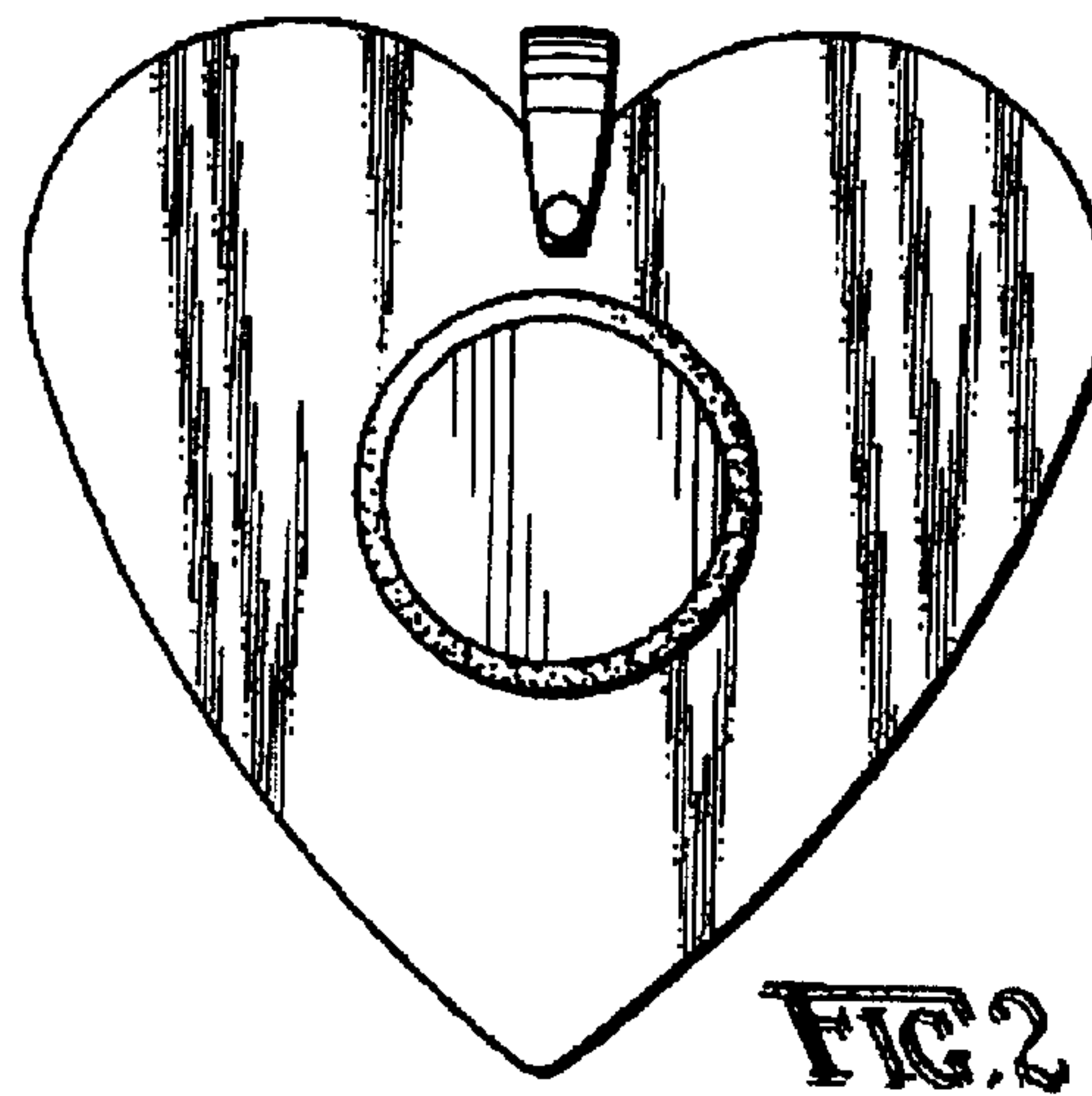
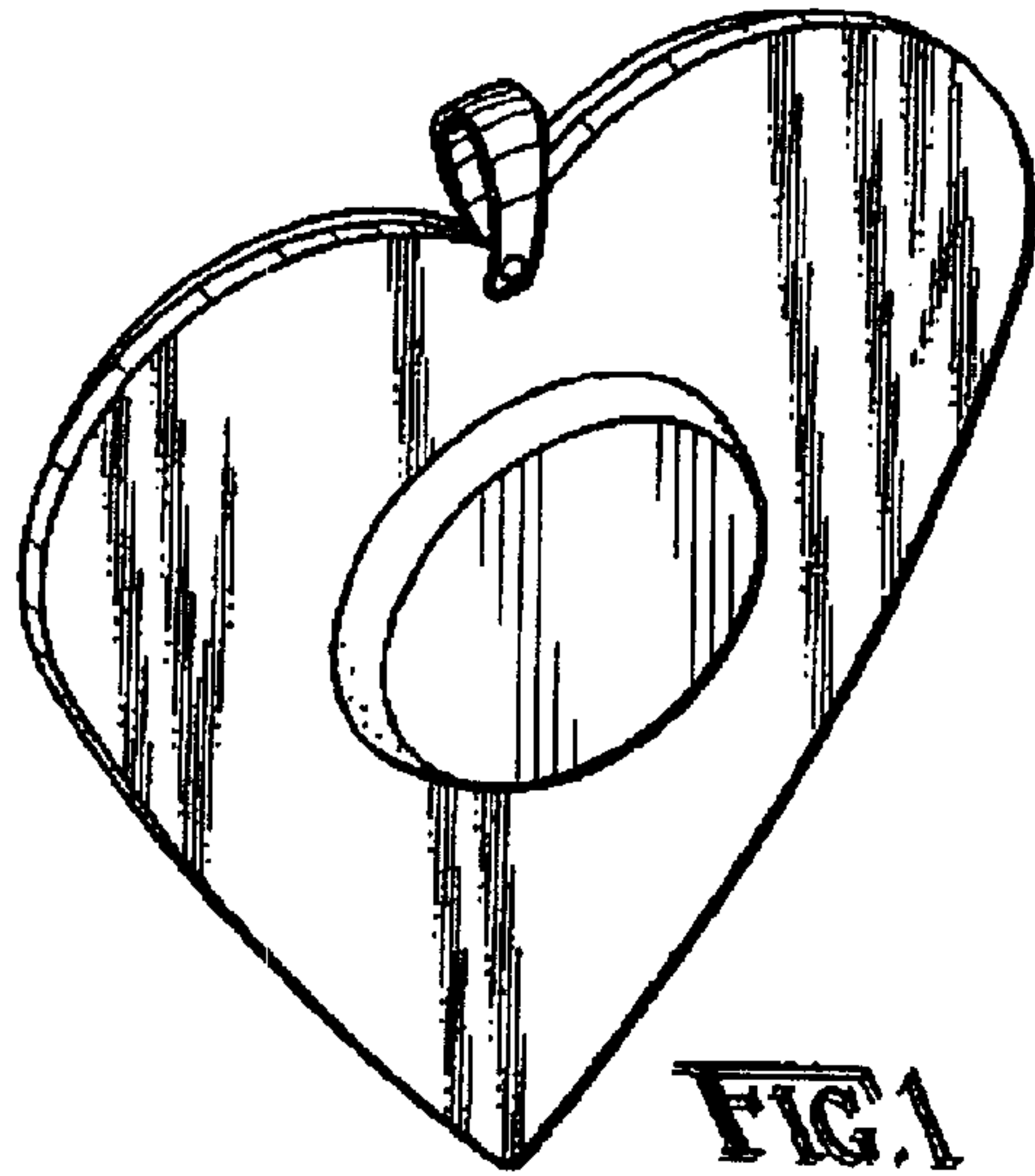

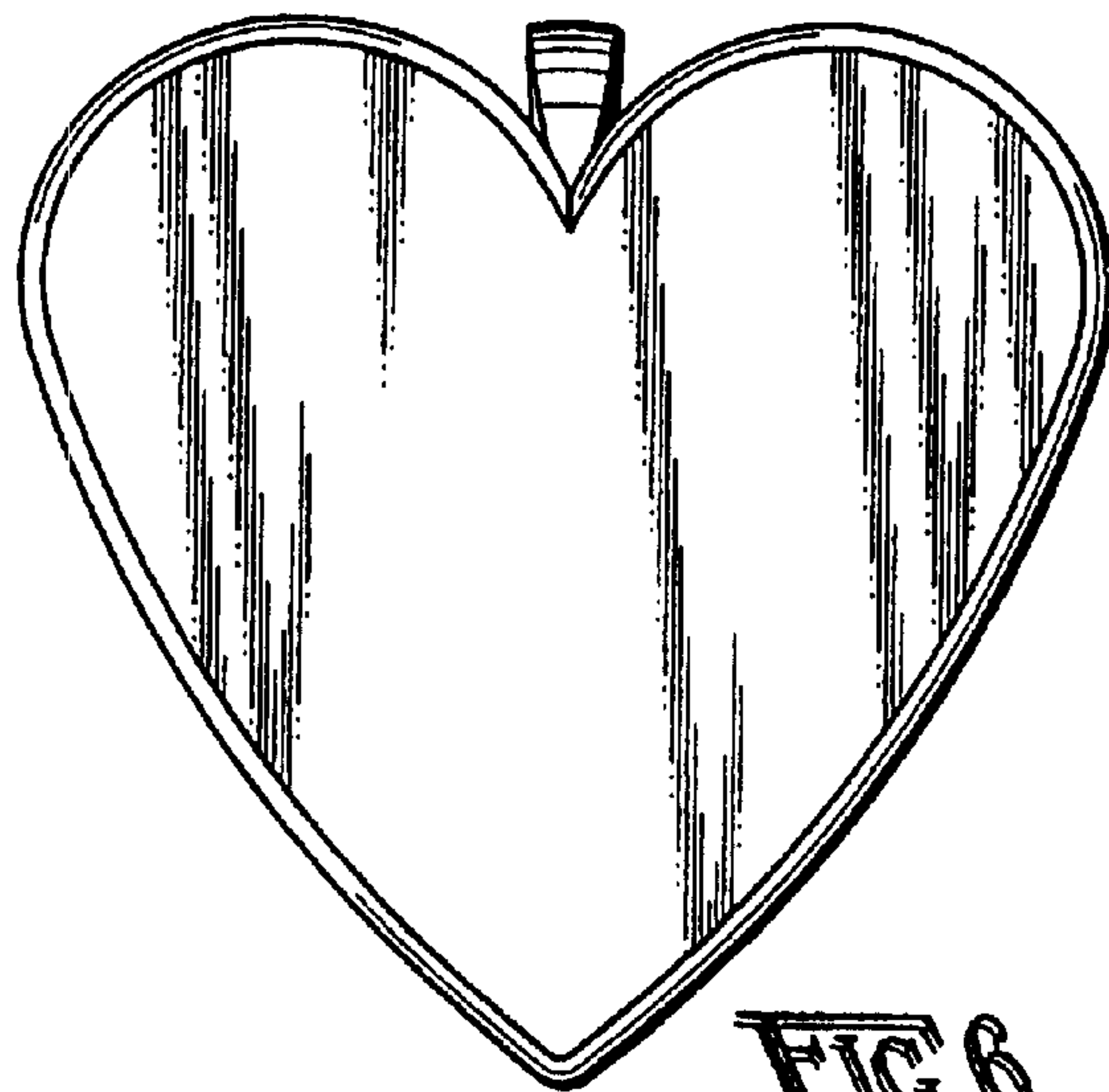
