DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a debris shield showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a bottom perspective view thereof, with the debris shield rotated 180 degrees;

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side being a mirror image;

FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof; and,

FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof.

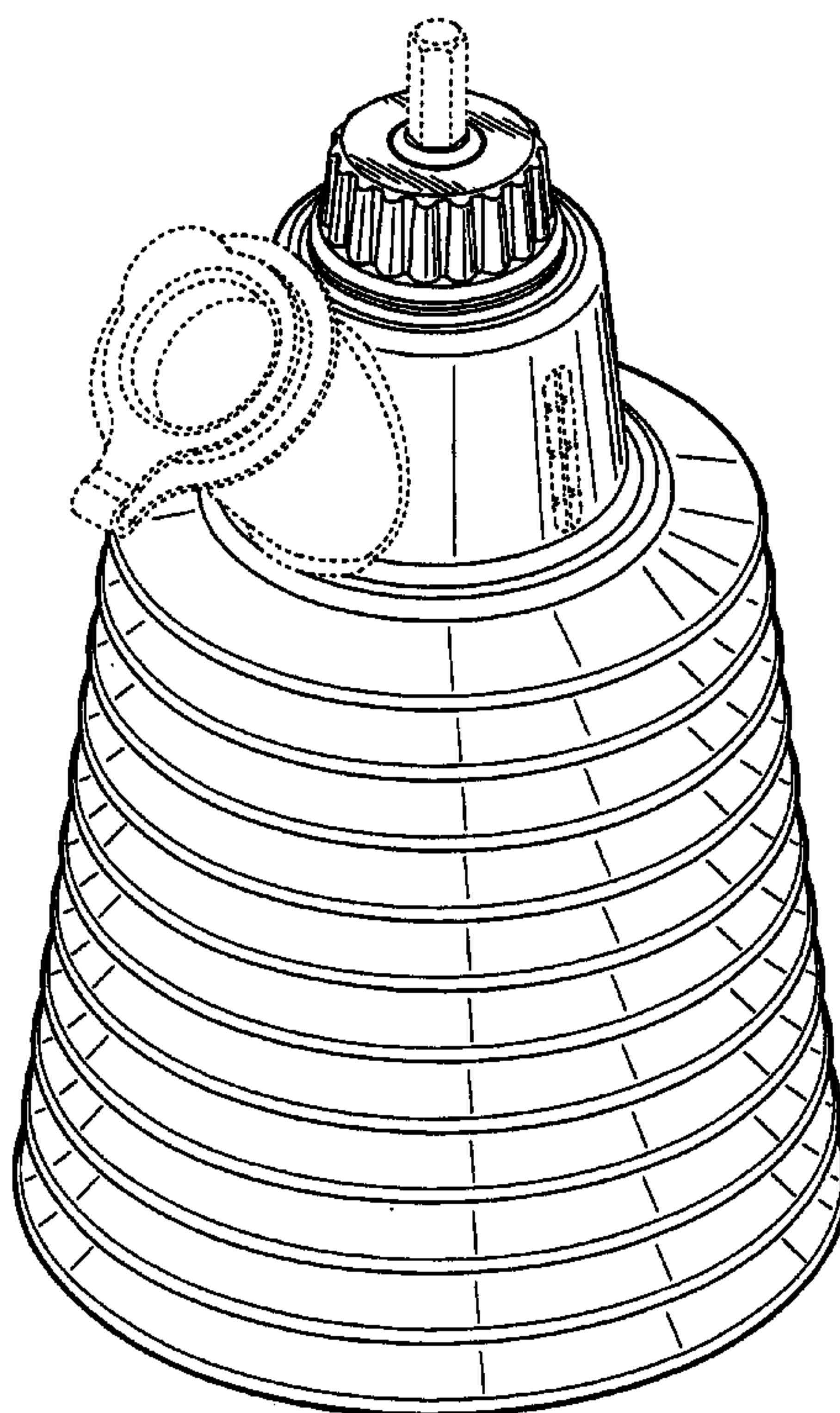

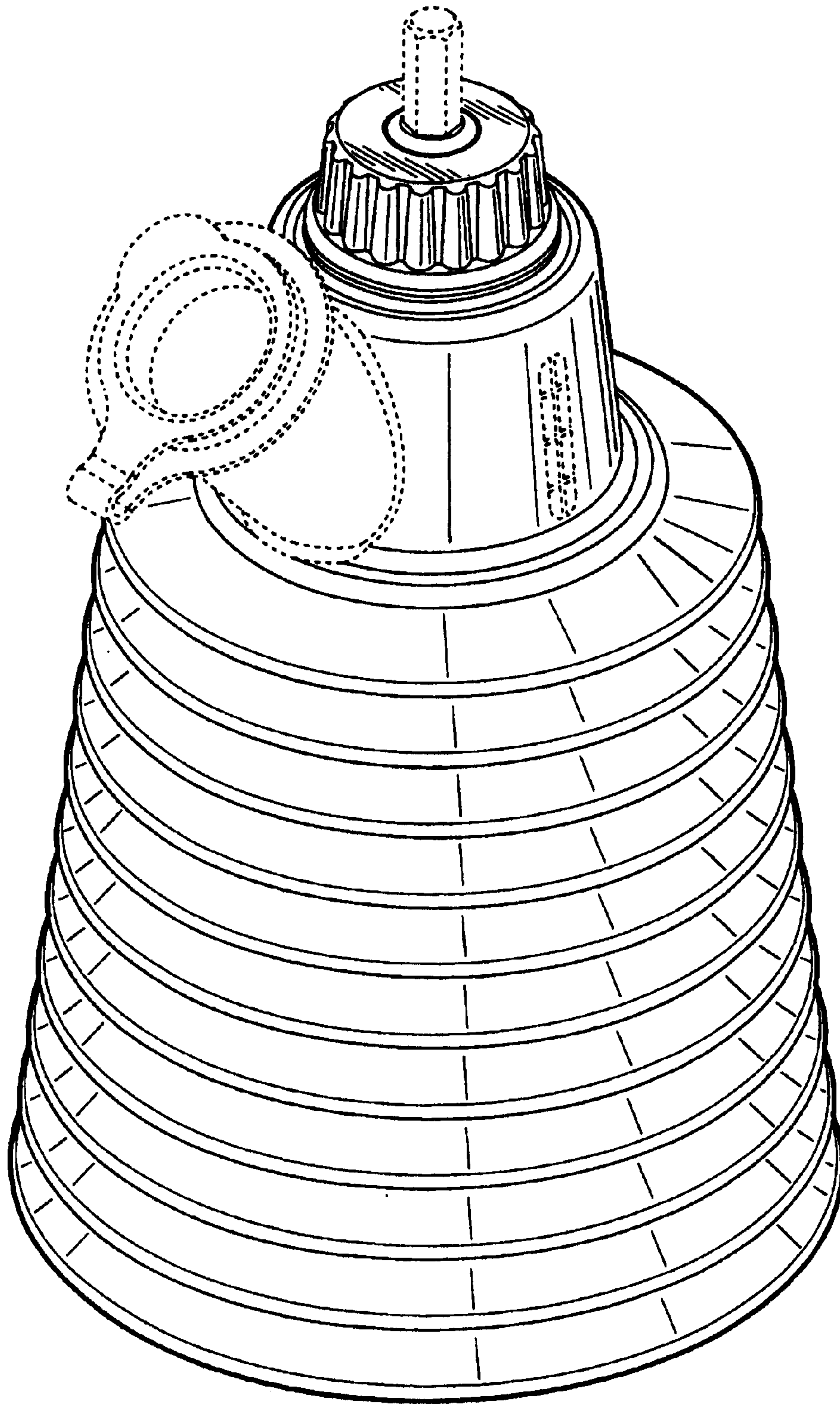

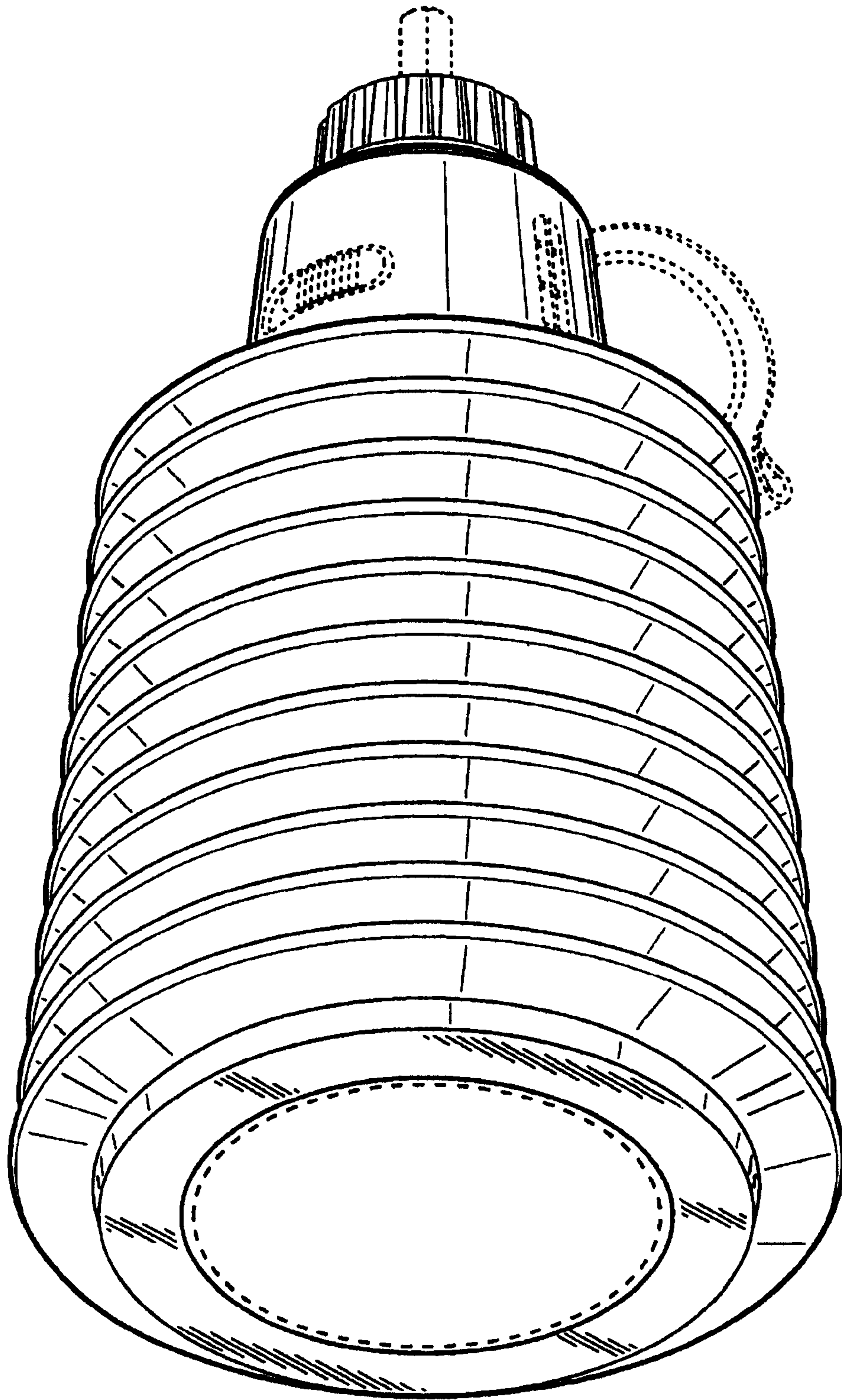

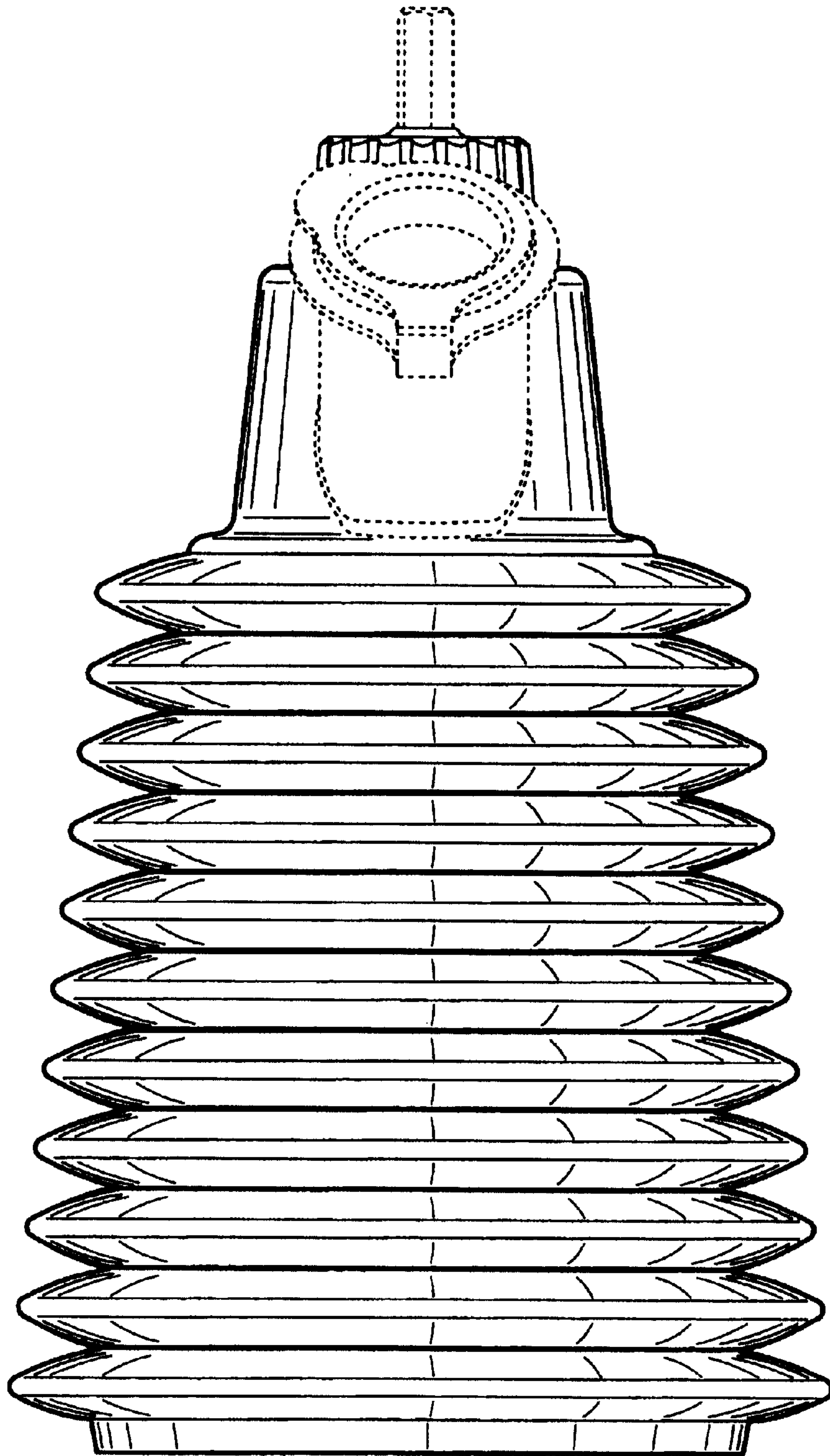

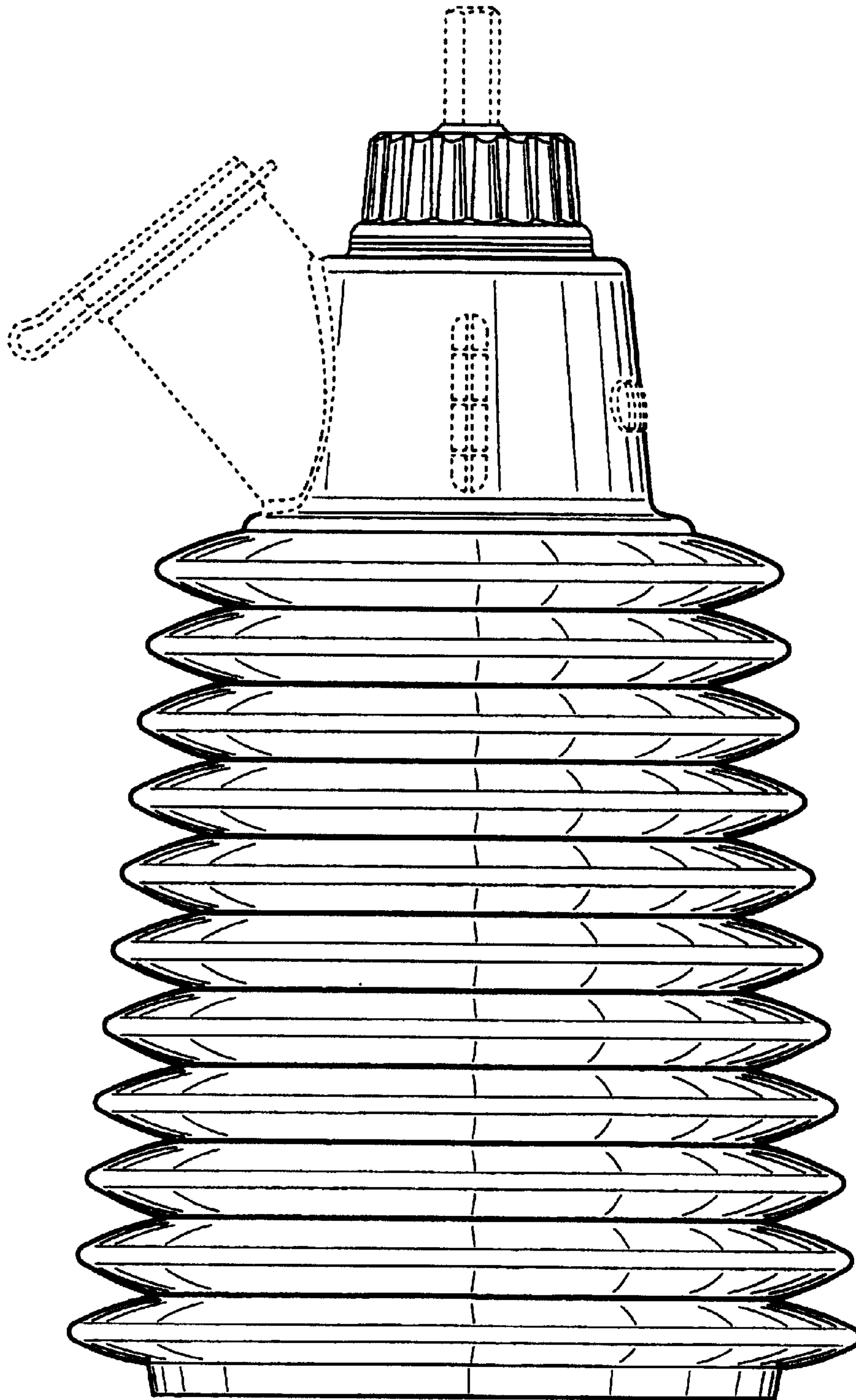

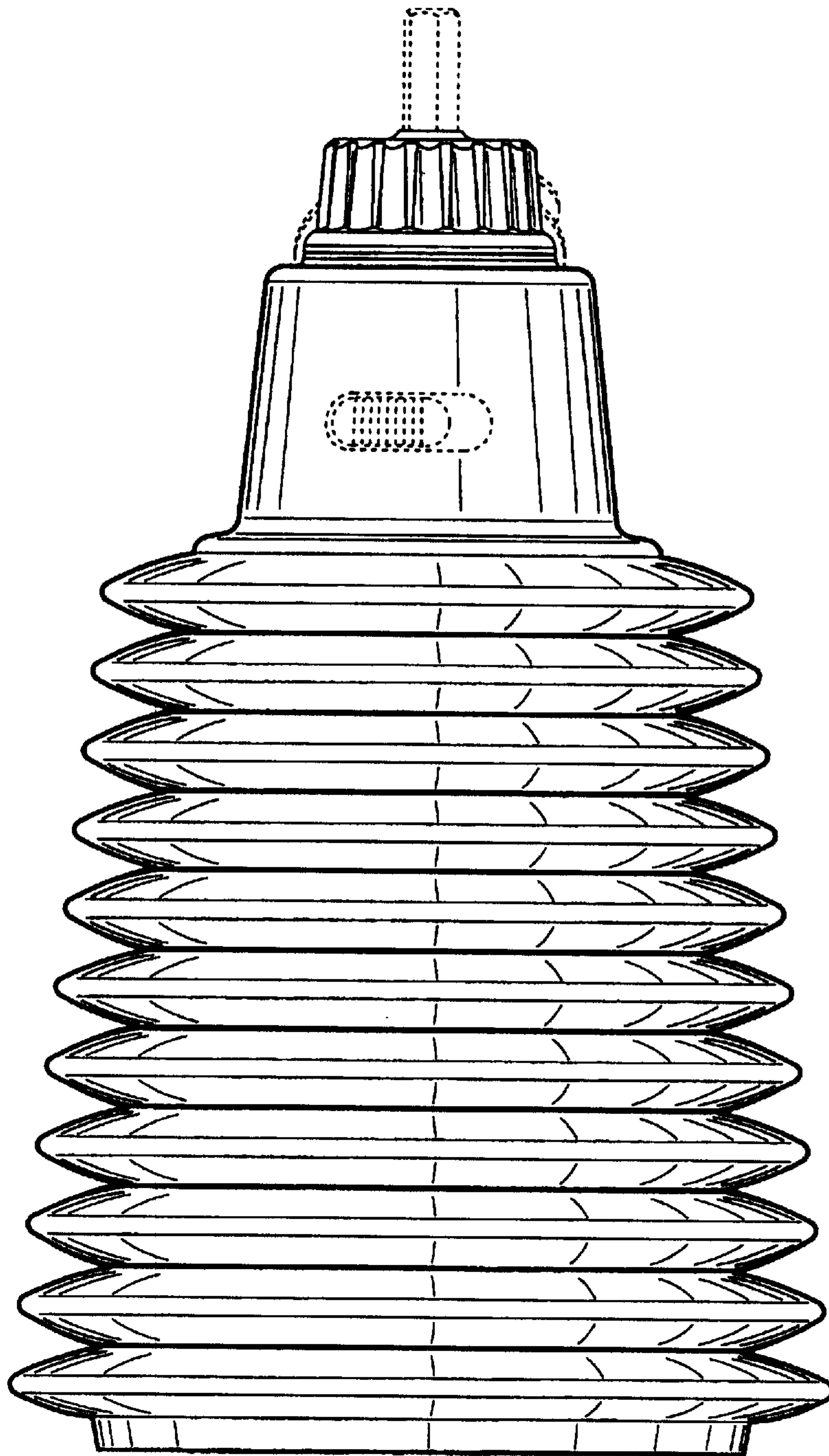

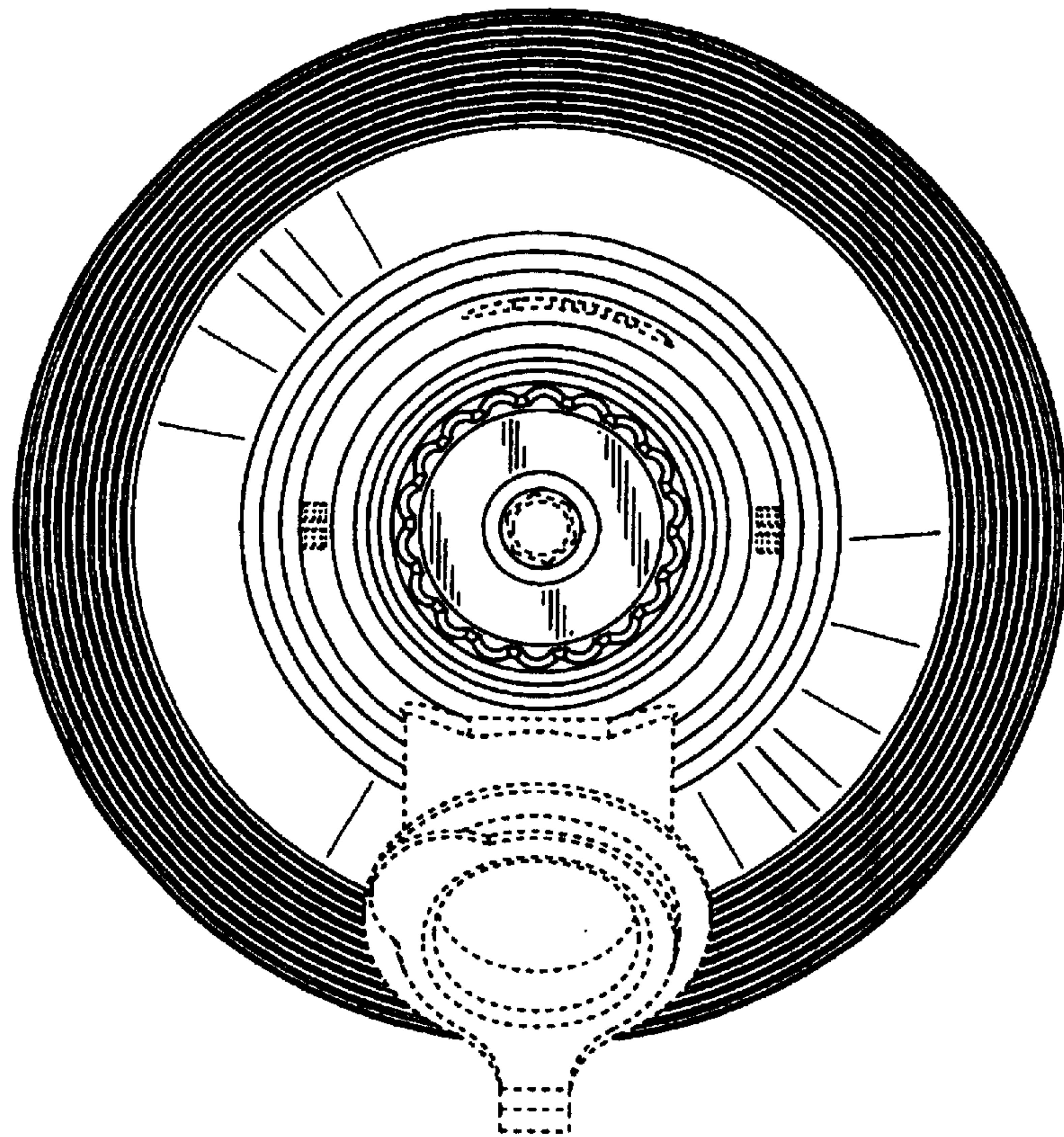
