(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a daily desk calendar and memo pad box, shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view for a daily desk calendar and memo pad box showing my new design.

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevation view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a front elevation view thereof;

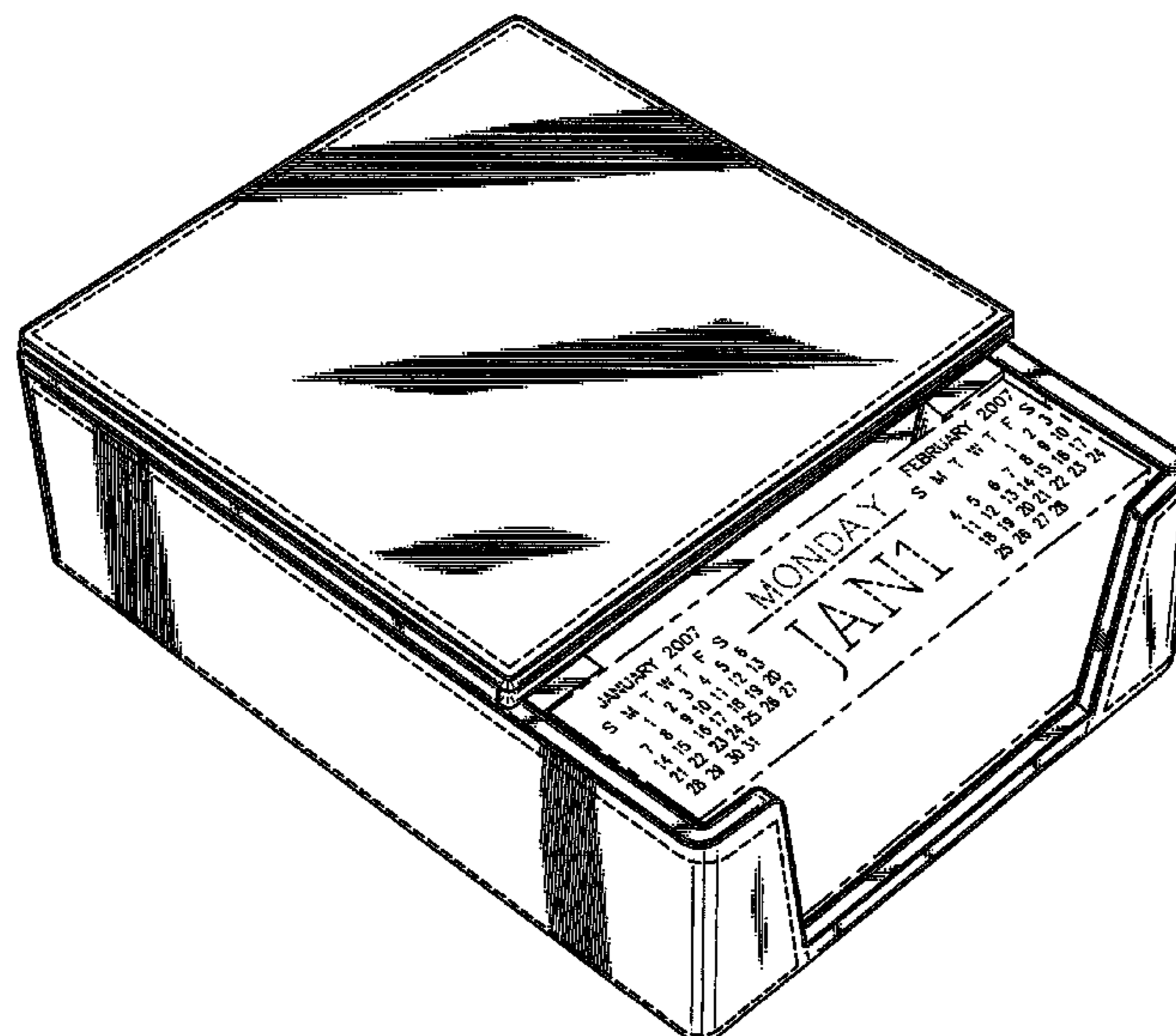
FIG. 5 is a side elevation view thereof, the other side being a mirror image; and,

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.

The broken line showing of a calendar pad of paper in FIG. 1 is included for the purpose of illustrating environmental structure and forms no part of the claimed design.

The dashed lines shown directly on the surface of the claimed article, throughout the views, are understood to represent stitching.

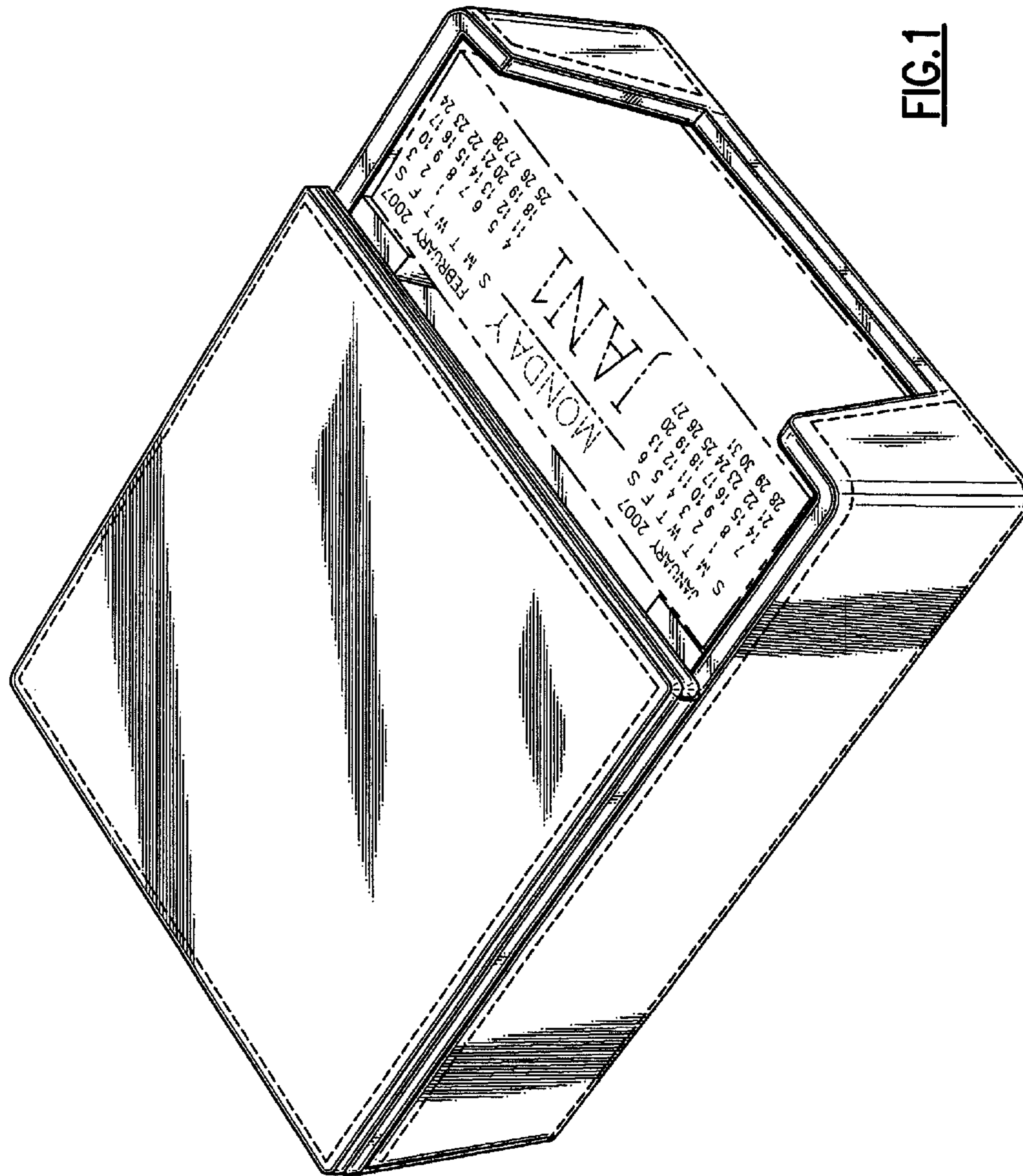

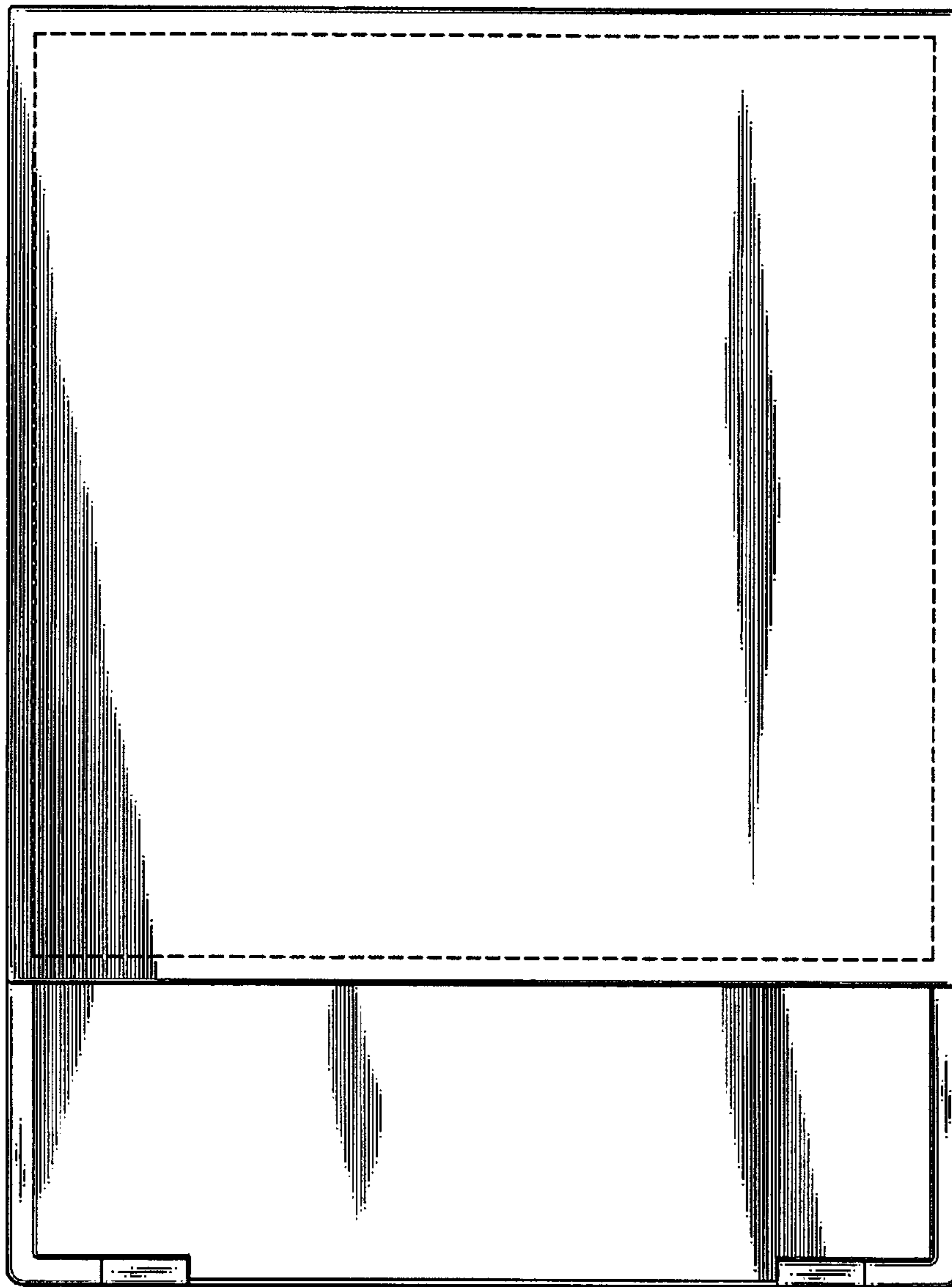

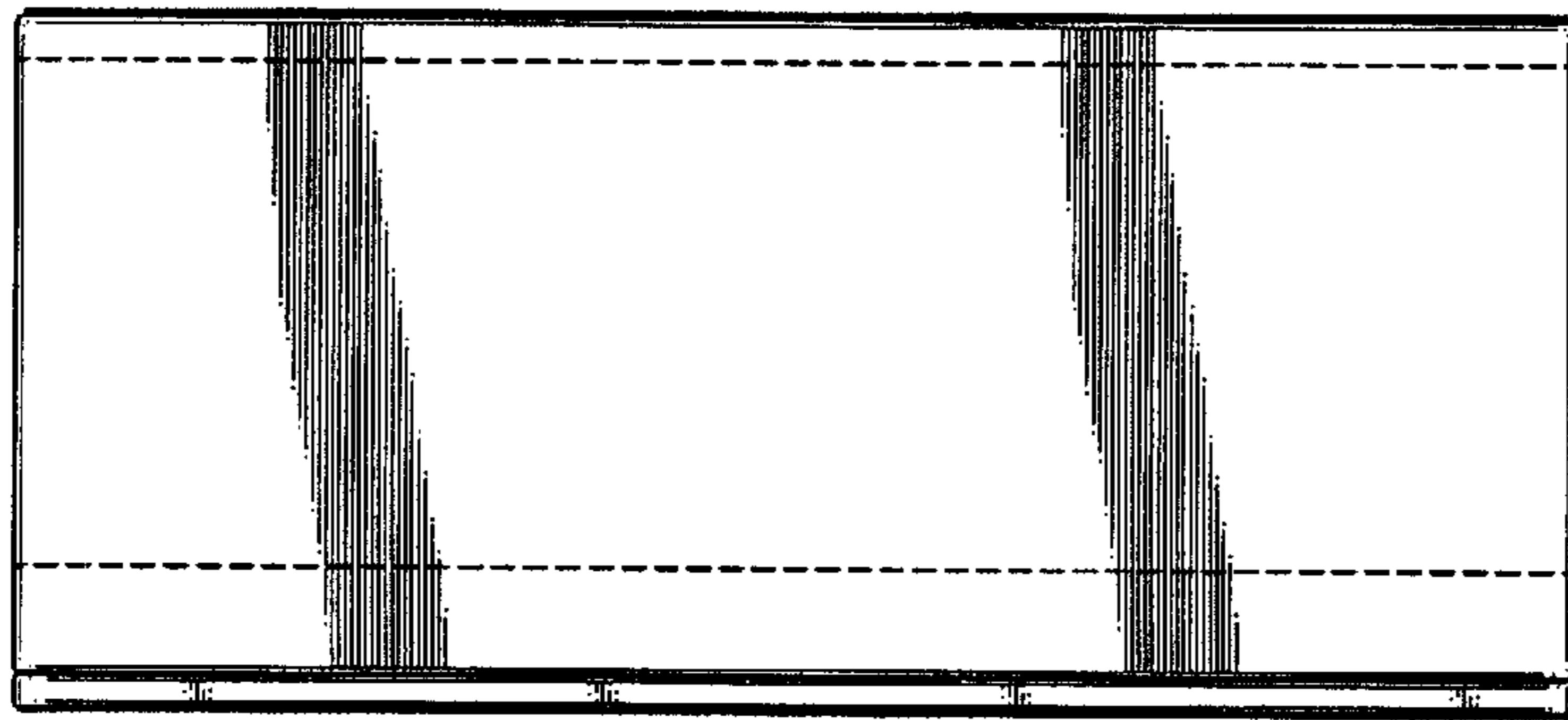

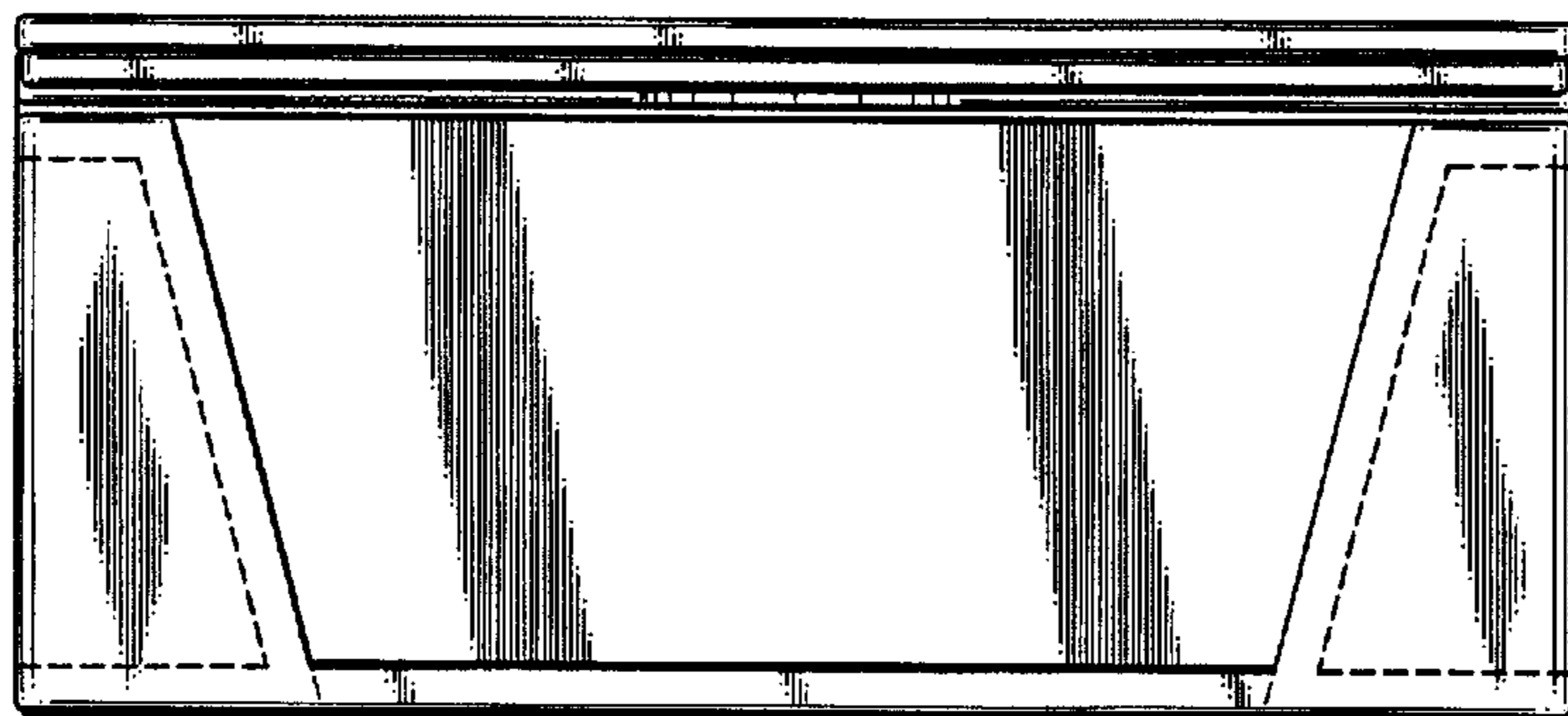

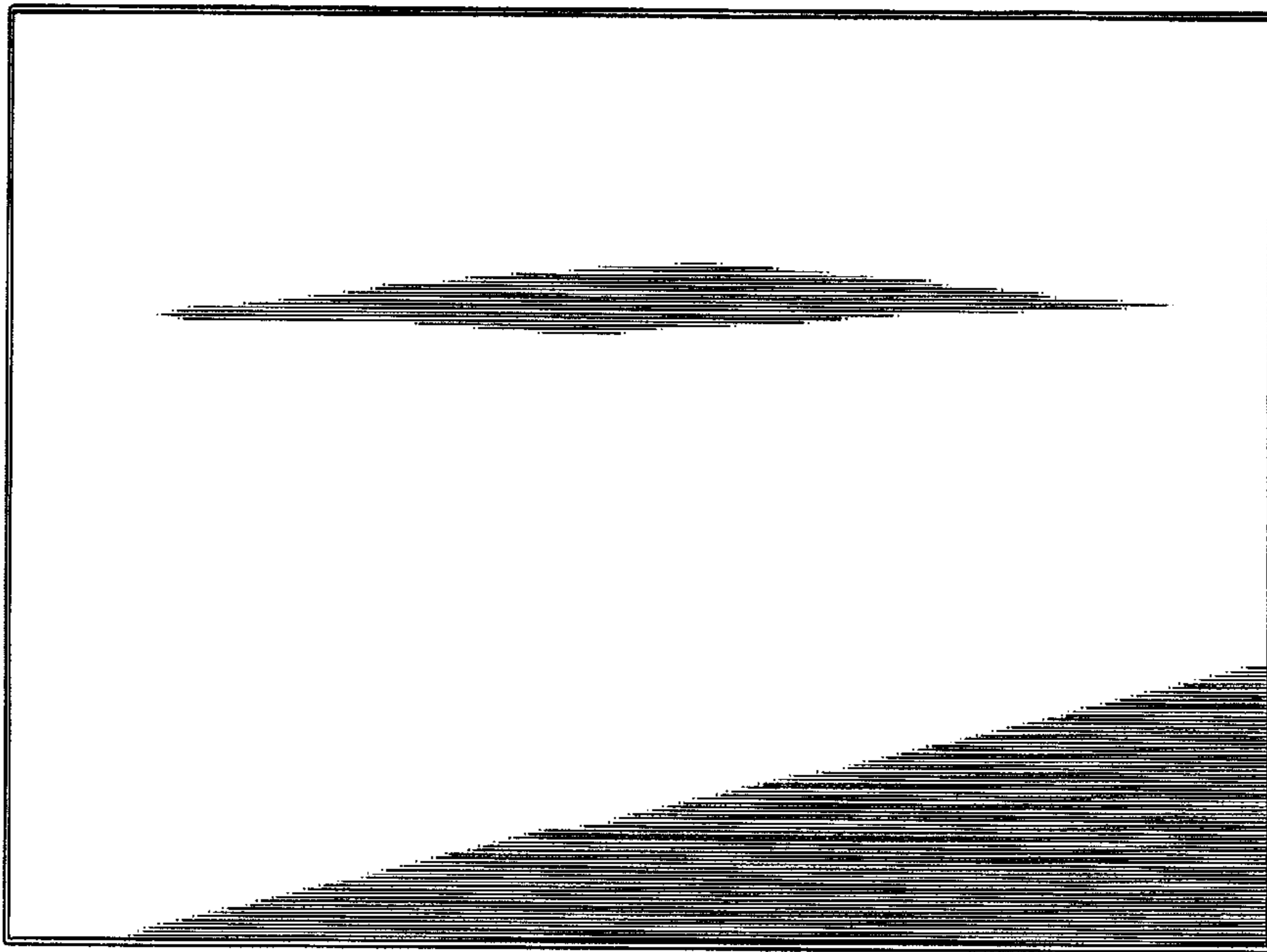
