(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a ribbed heart shaped cremation urn, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of the ribbed heart shaped cremation urn of this invention;

FIG. 2 is a front view of the ribbed heart shaped cremation urn shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a back view of the ribbed heart shaped cremation urn shown in FIG. 1;

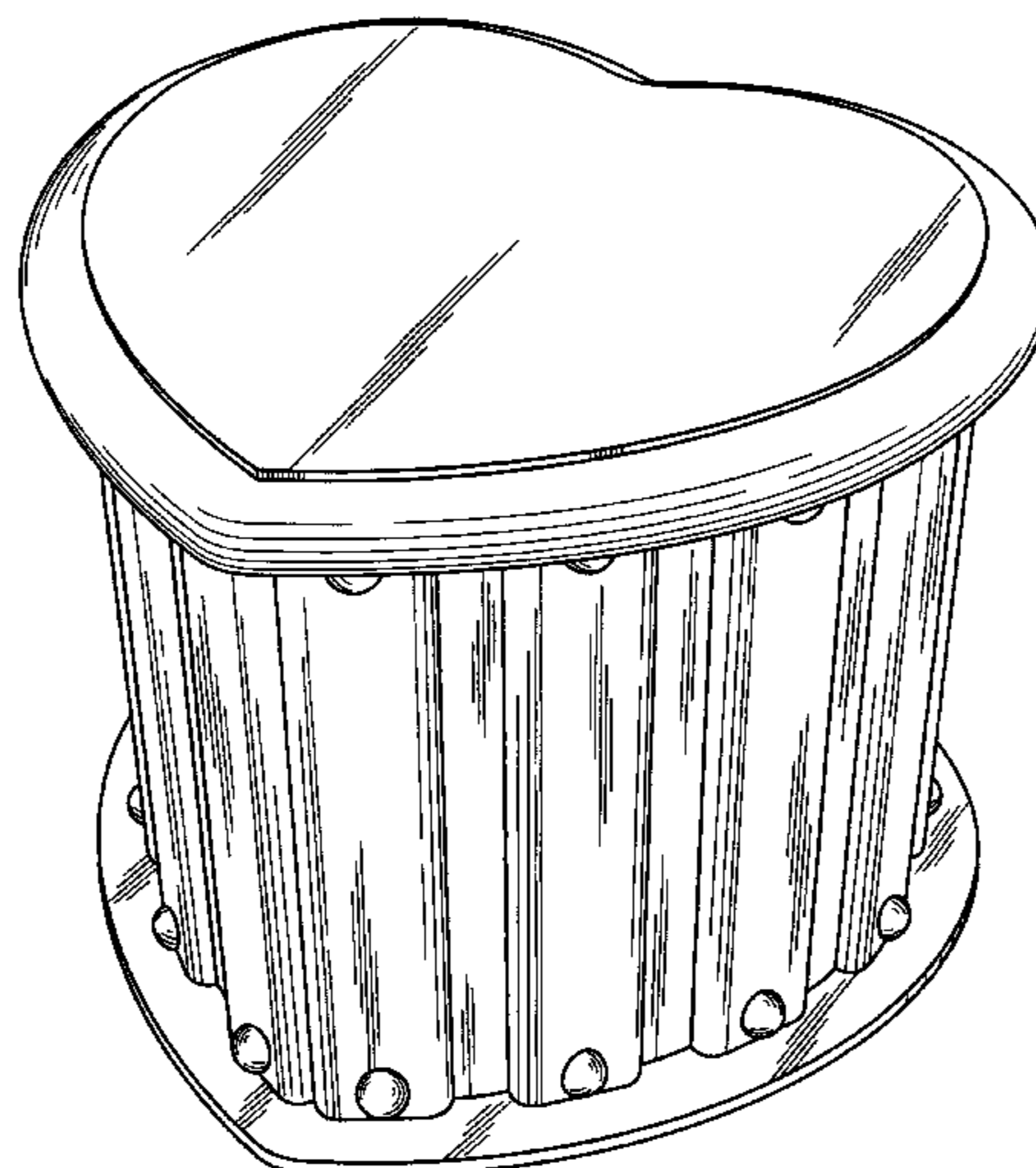
FIG. 4 is a left side view of the ribbed heart shaped cremation urn shown in FIG. 1;

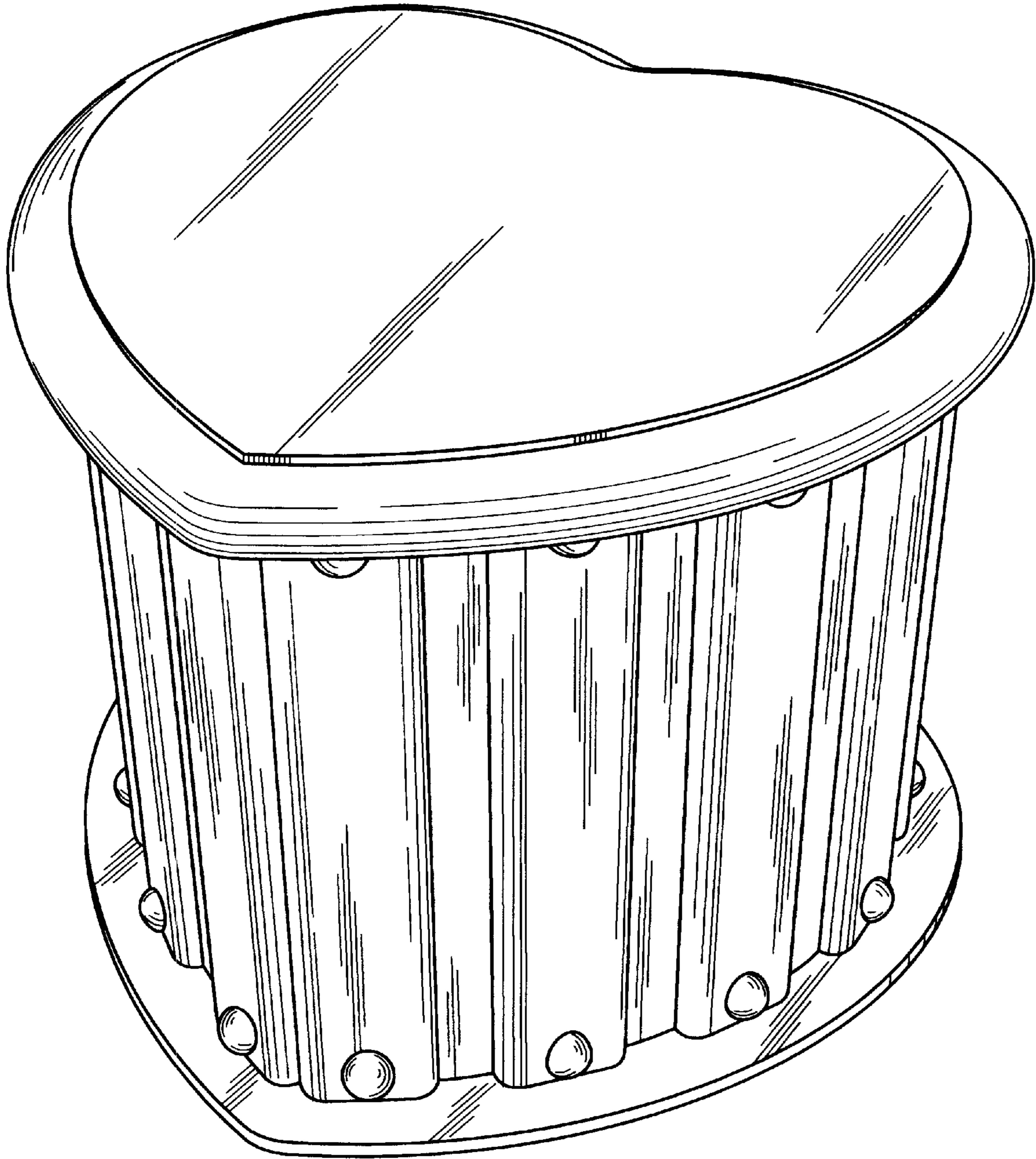
FIG. 5 is a right side view of the ribbed heart shaped cremation urn shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 6 is a top view of the ribbed heart shaped cremation urn shown in FIG. 1; and,

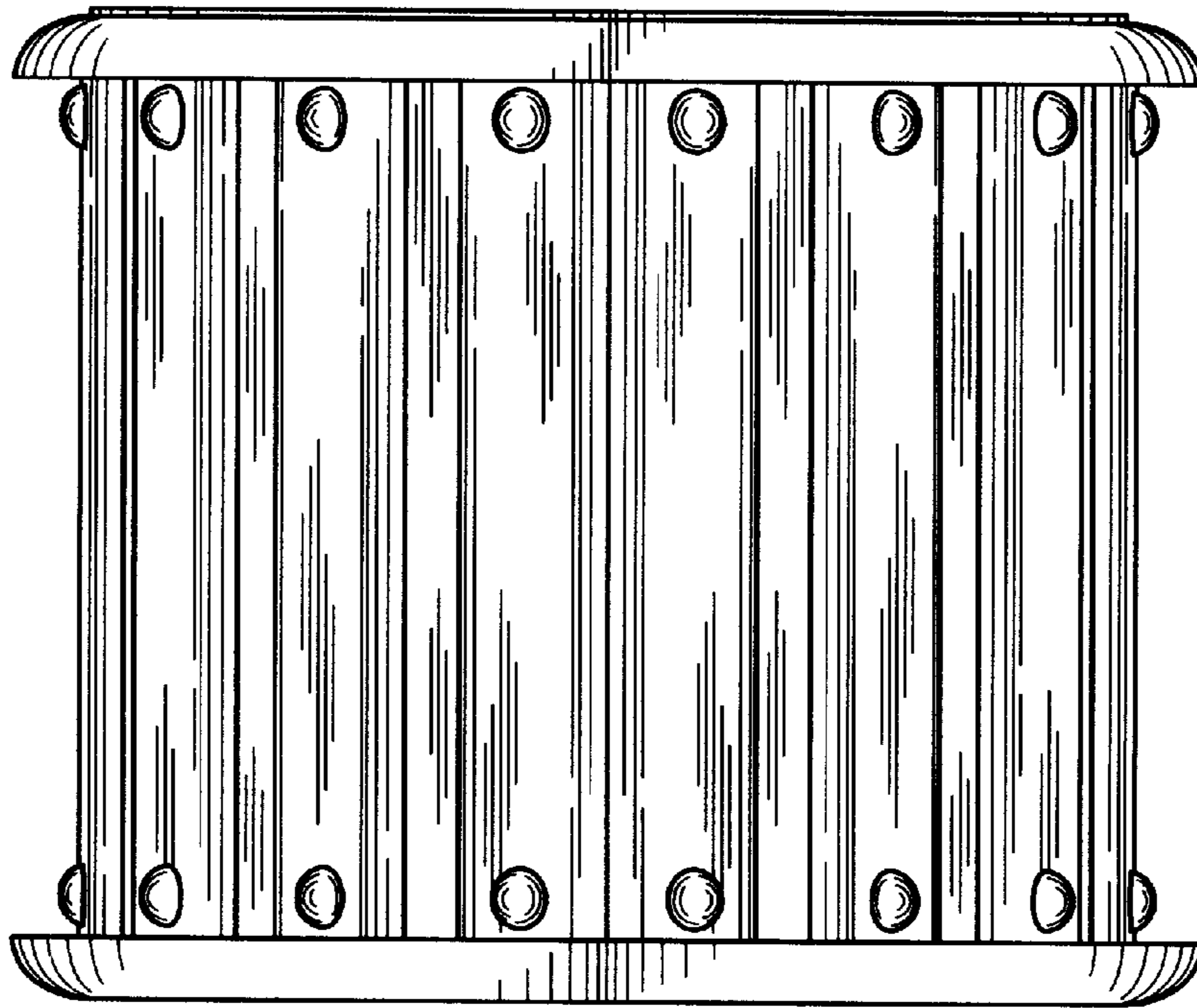
FIG. 7 is a bottom view of the ribbed heart shaped cremation urn shown in FIG. 1.

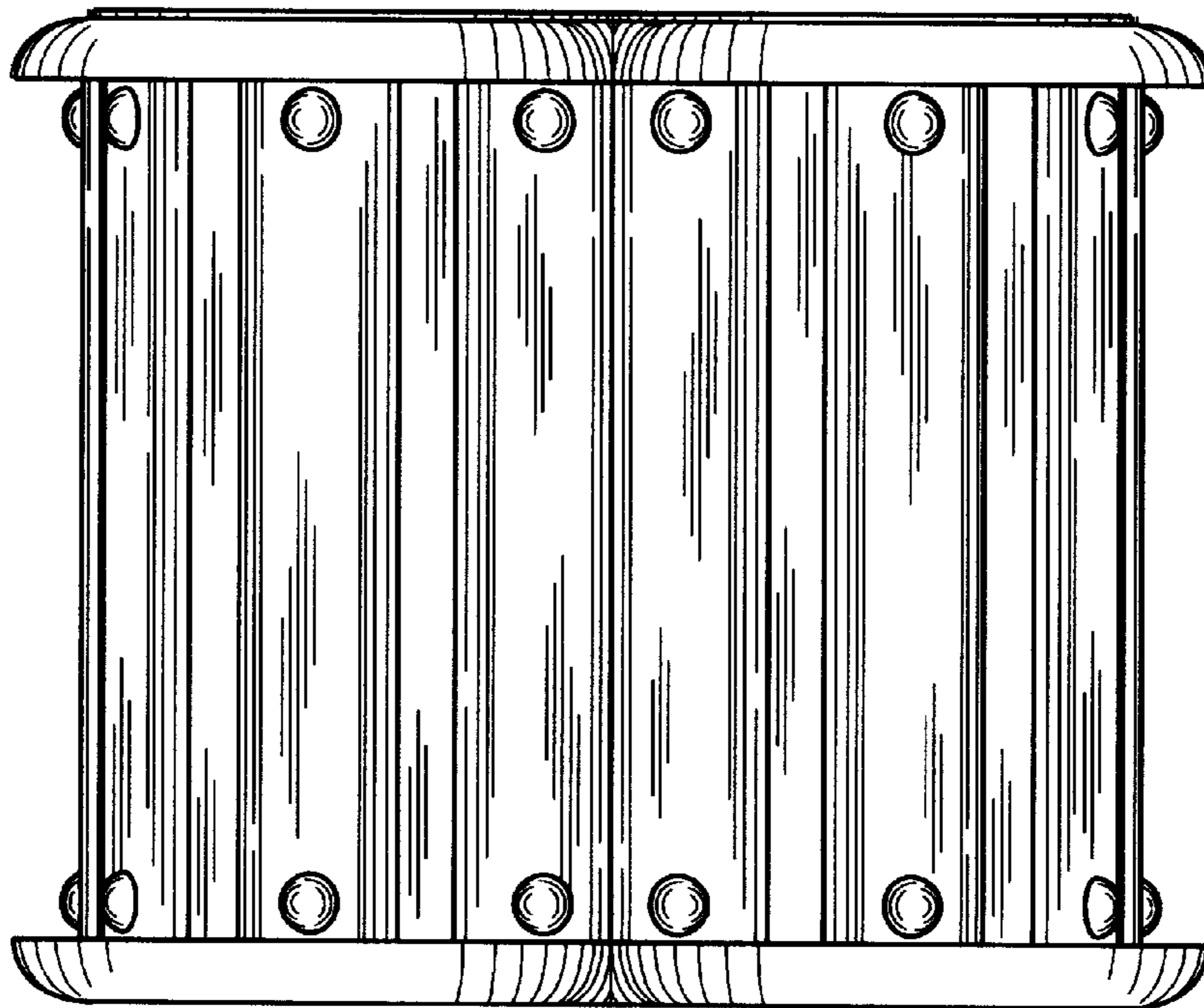




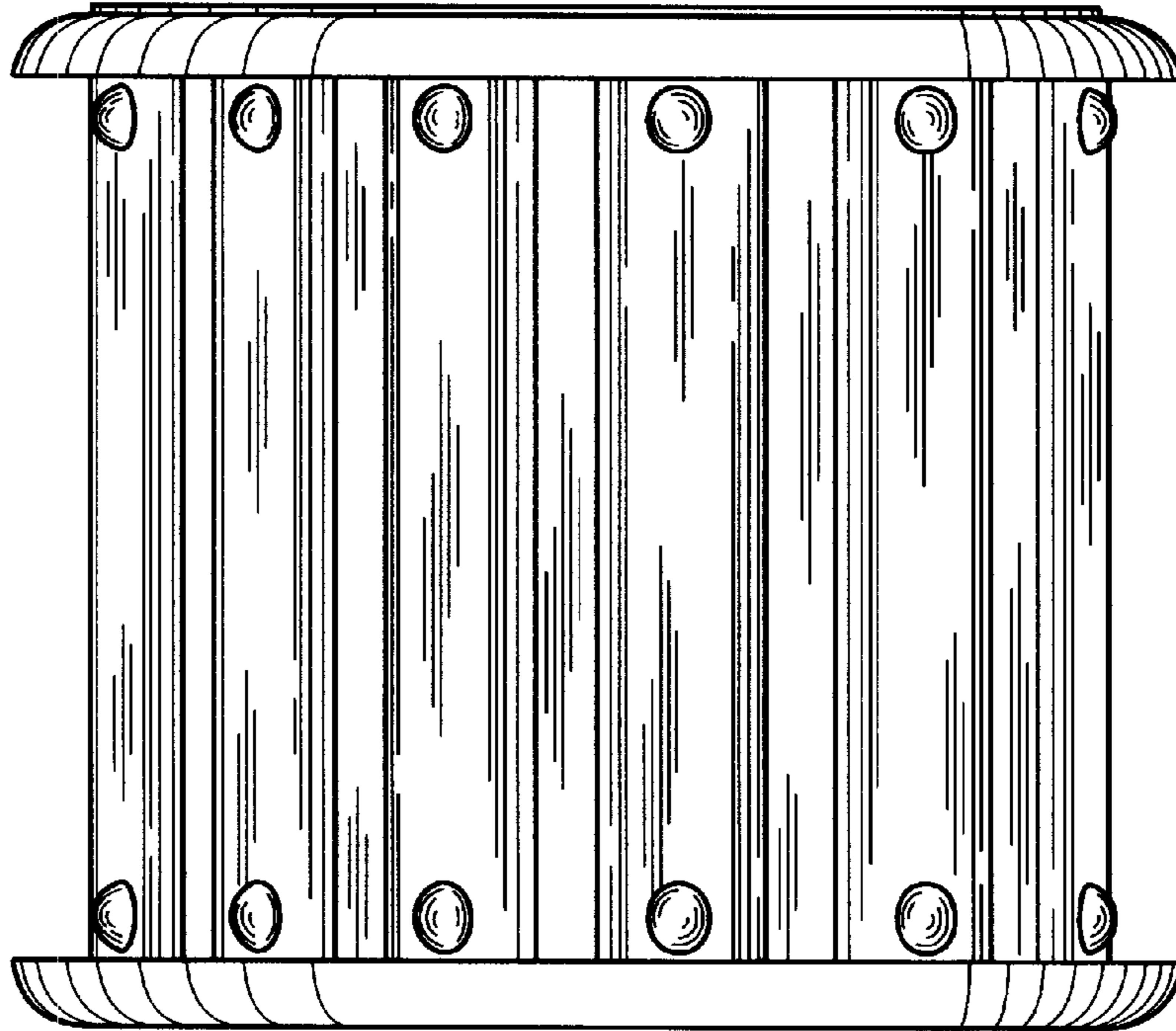

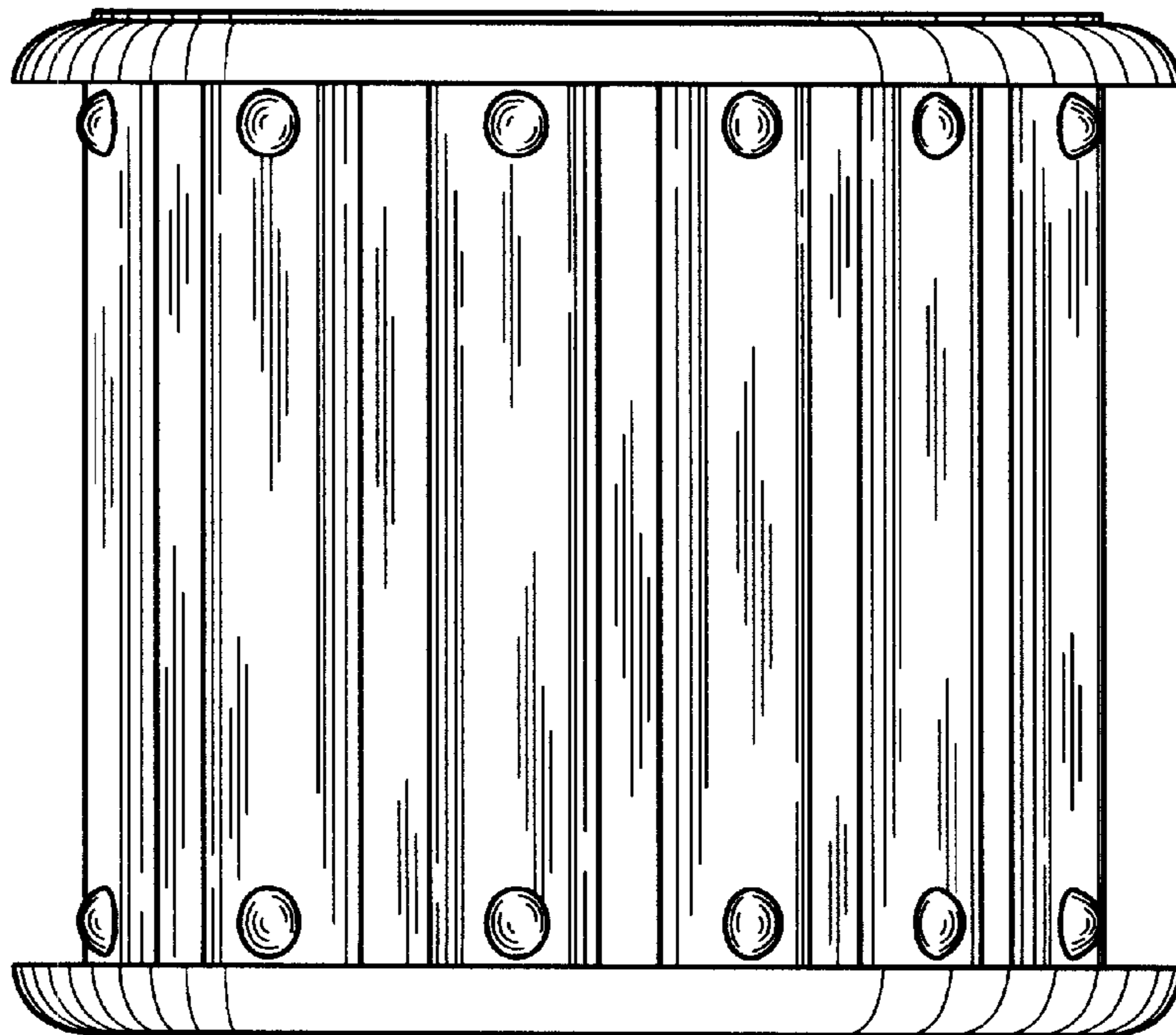

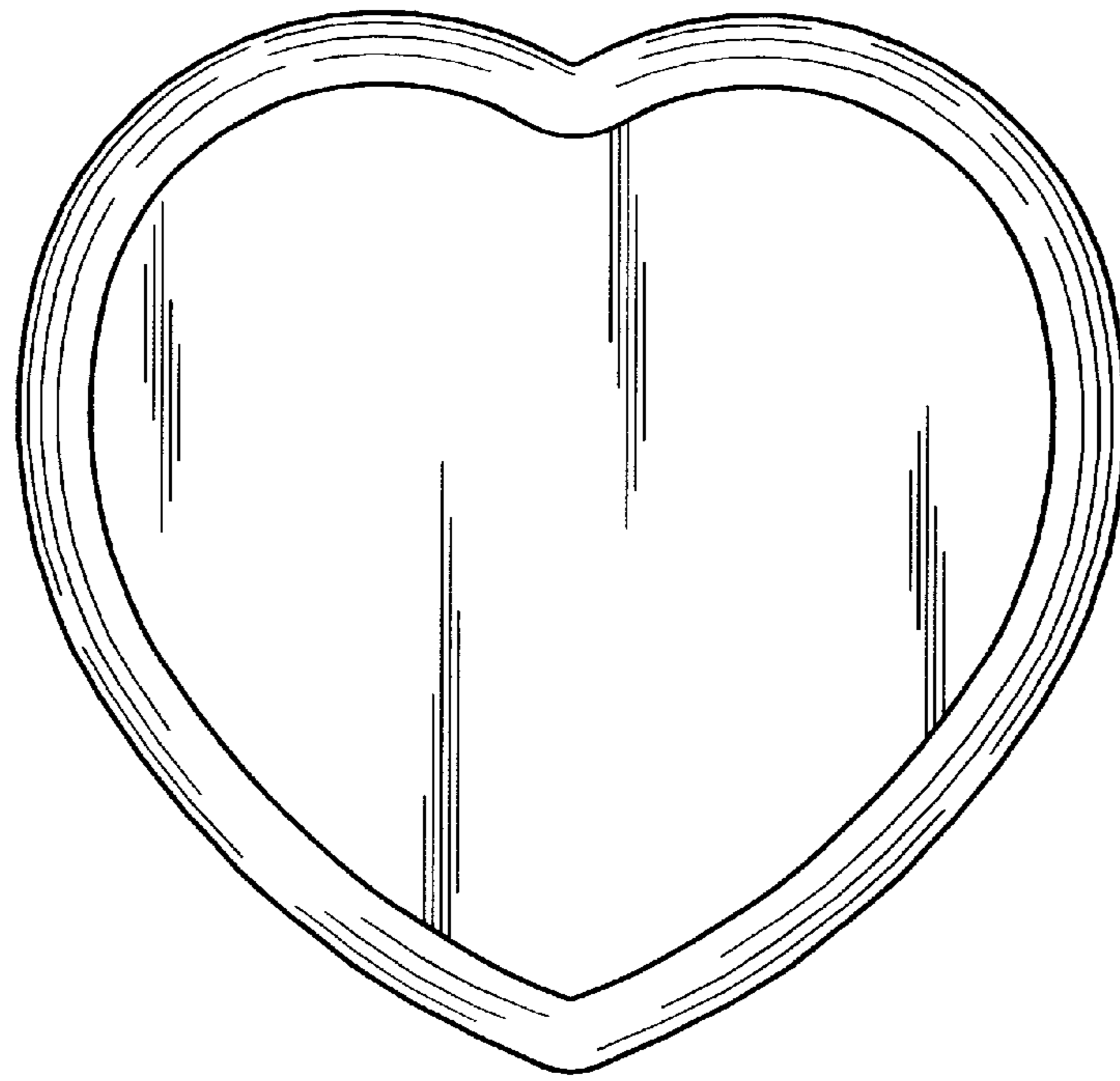

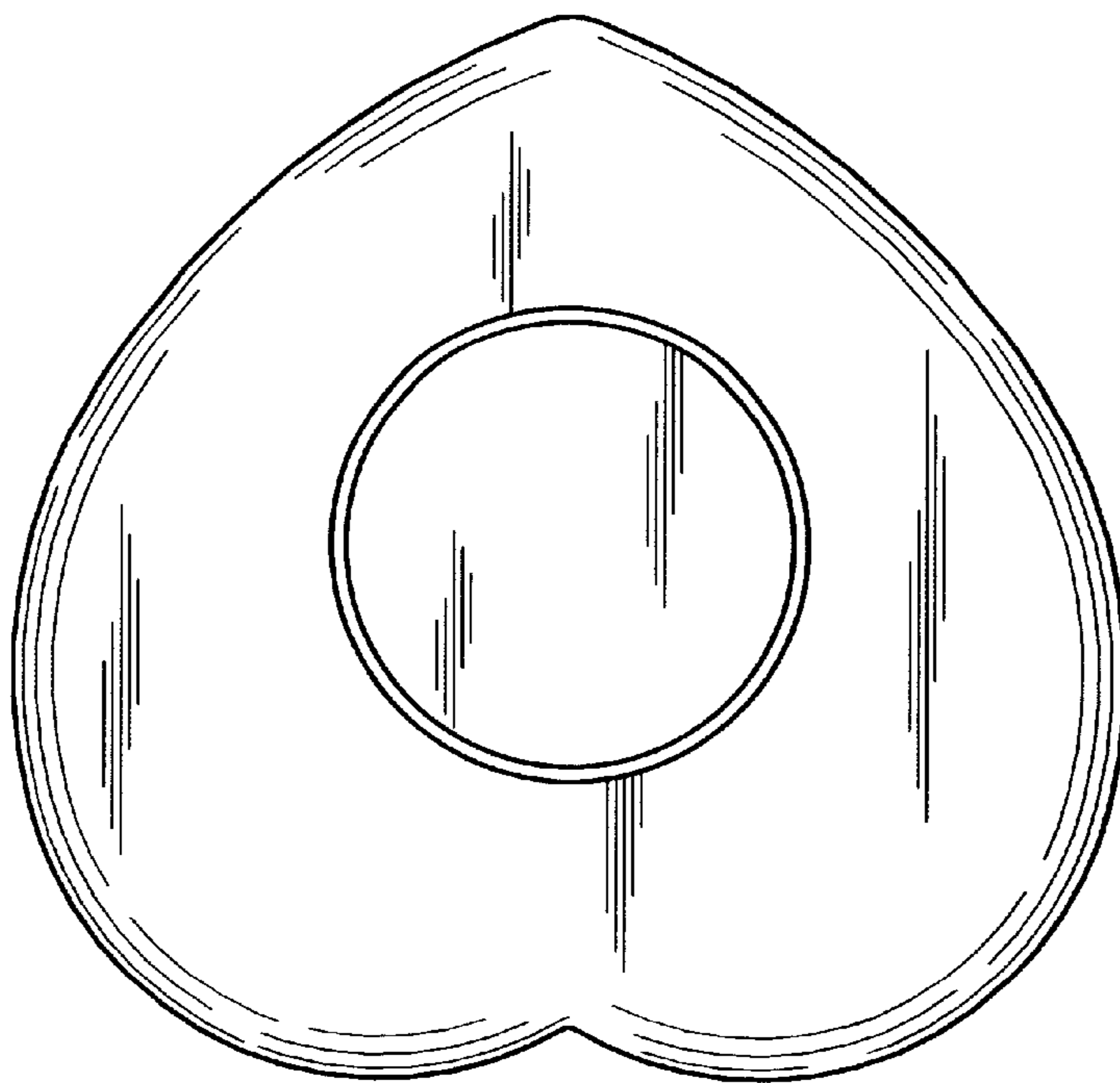
