FIG. 2 is a reduced top plan view of a chair thereof.

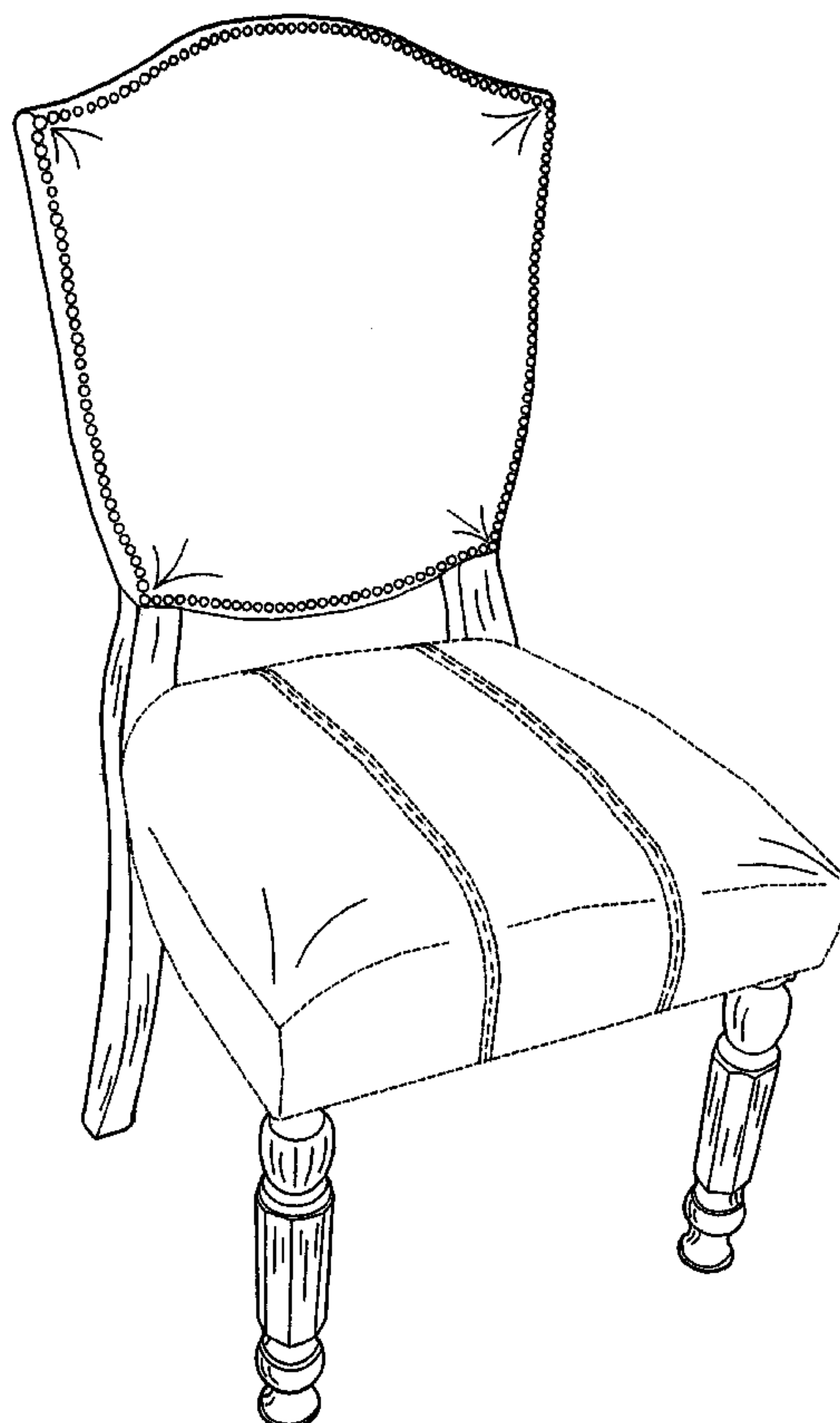
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view of a reduced chair thereof.

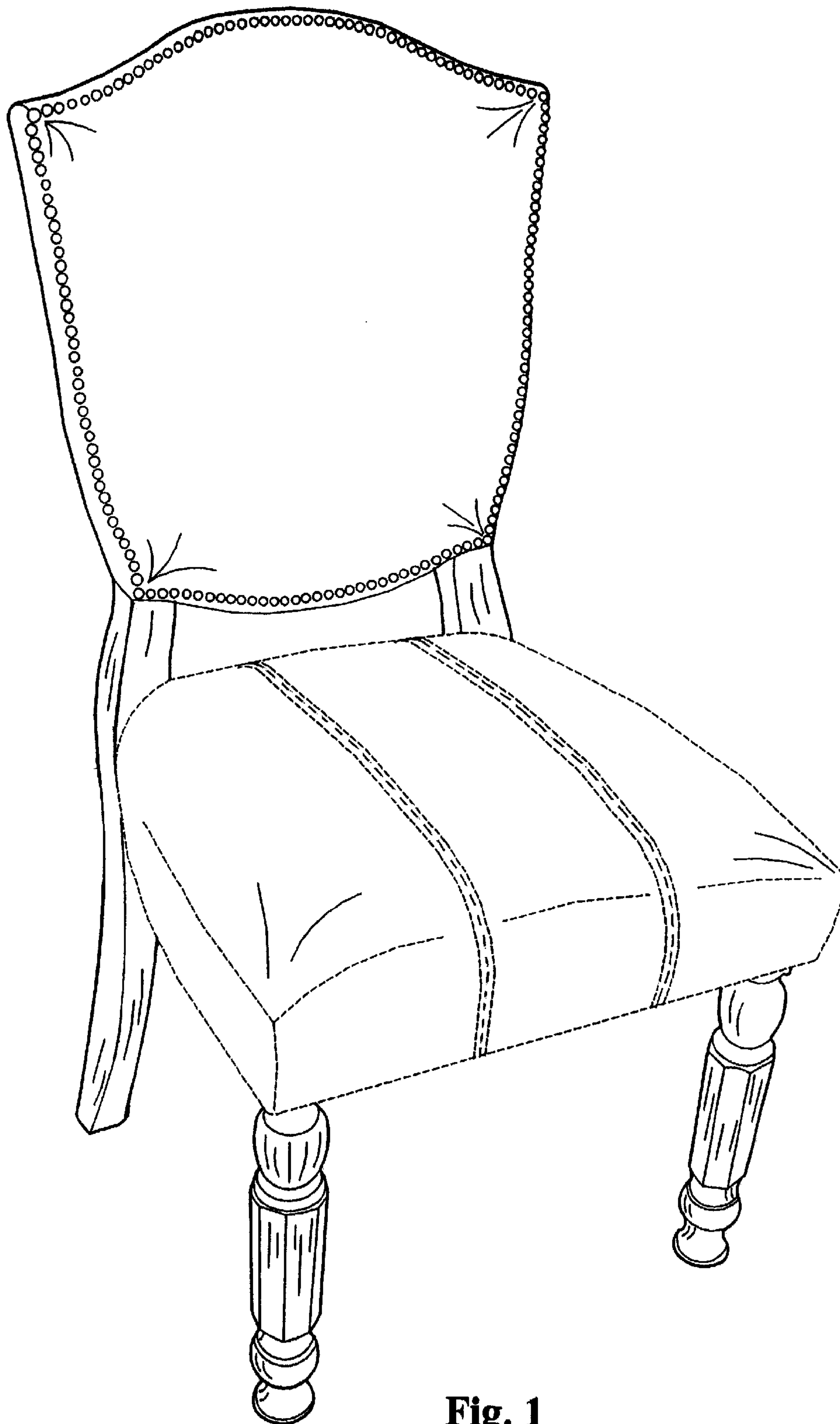

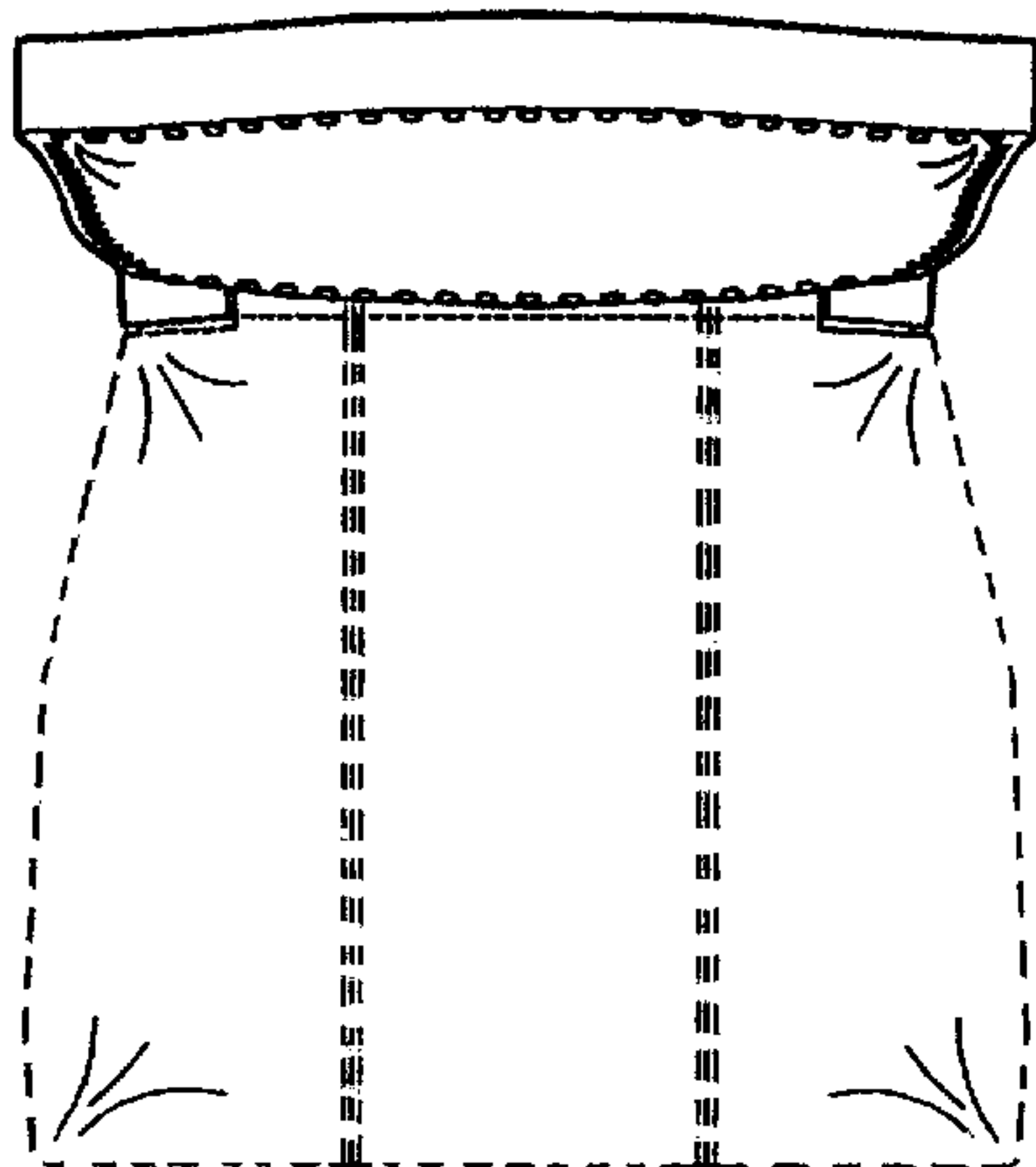

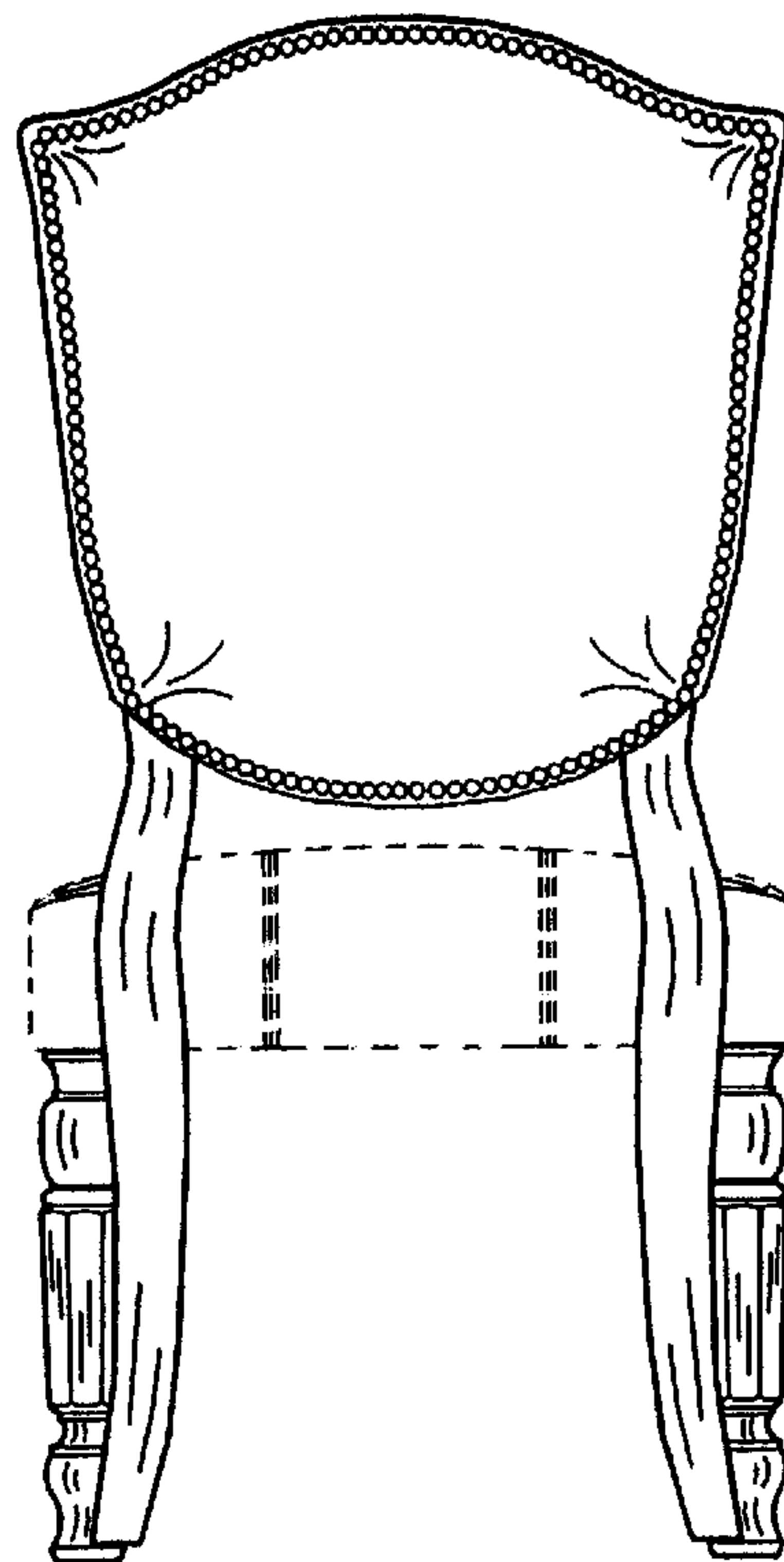

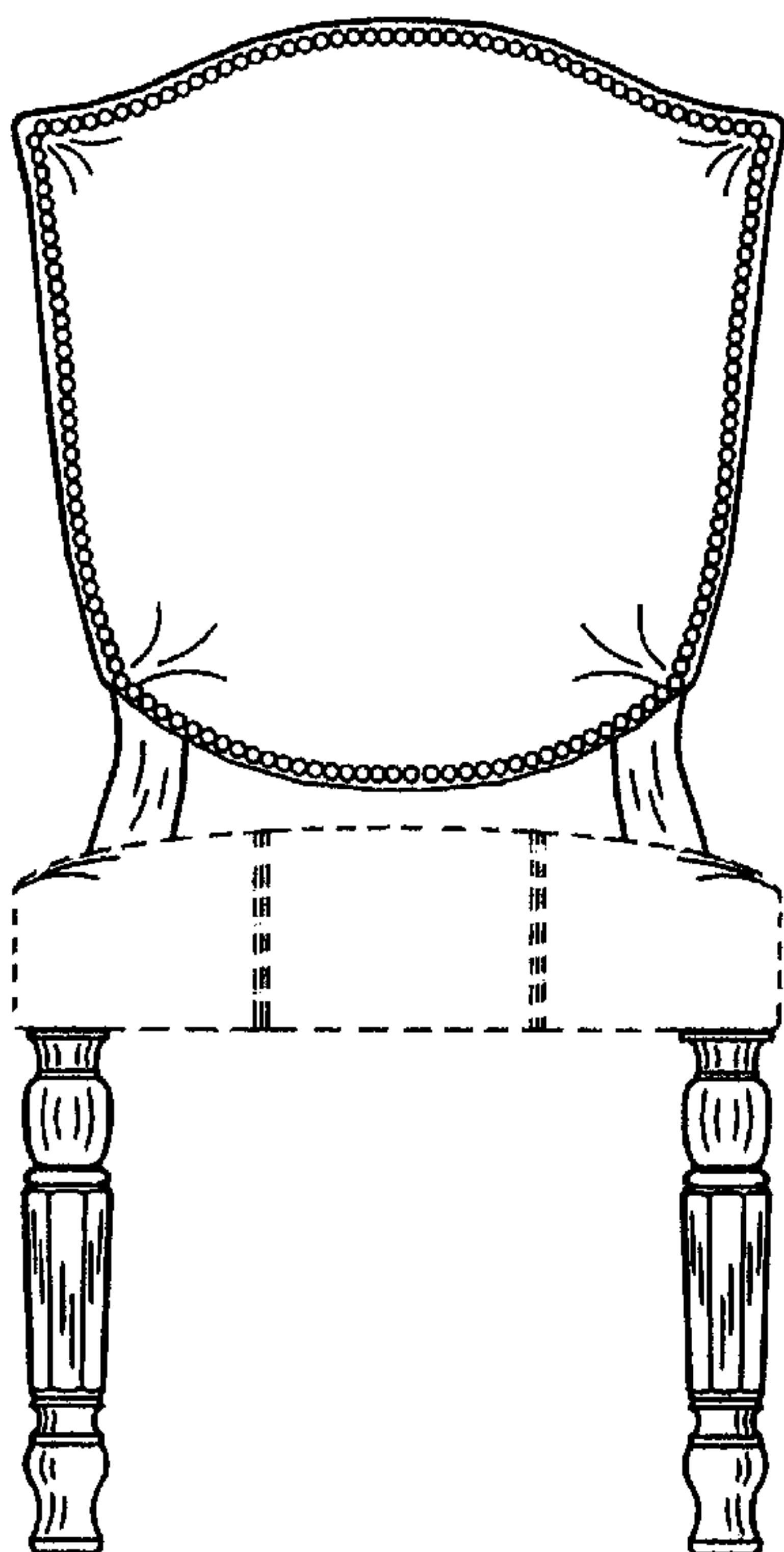
