DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of the jewelry pendant of the present invention;

FIG. 2 is a rear perspective view of the jewelry pendant of the present invention;

FIG. 3 is a front elevation view of the jewelry pendant of the present invention;

FIG. 4 is a left elevation view of the jewelry pendant of the present invention;

FIG. 5 is a right elevation view of the jewelry pendant of the present invention;

FIG. 6 is a rear elevation view of the jewelry pendant of the present invention;


FIG. 7 is a top elevation view of the jewelry pendant of the present invention;

FIG. 8 is a bottom elevation view of the jewelry pendant of the present invention; and,


FIG. 9 is a cross-section view along lines 9—9 shown in FIG. 6 of the present invention.
































