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(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a golf tee holder, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a bottom plan view of a golf tee holder, according to the invention.

FIG. 2 is a front end view of the golf tee holder thereof.

FIG. 3 is a top plan view of the golf tee holder thereof.

FIG. 4 is a left side elevation view of the golf tee holder thereof, the right side elevation view being a mirror image of the left side elevation view.

FIG. 5 is perspective view of the top side of the golf tee holder thereof.

FIG. 6 is perspective view of the bottom side of the golf tee holder thereof.

FIG. 7 is a front end view of a second embodiment of a golf tee holder, according to the invention.

FIG. 8 is a top plan view of the second embodiment of the golf tee holder thereof.

FIG. 9 is perspective view of the top side of the second embodiment of the golf tee holder thereof.

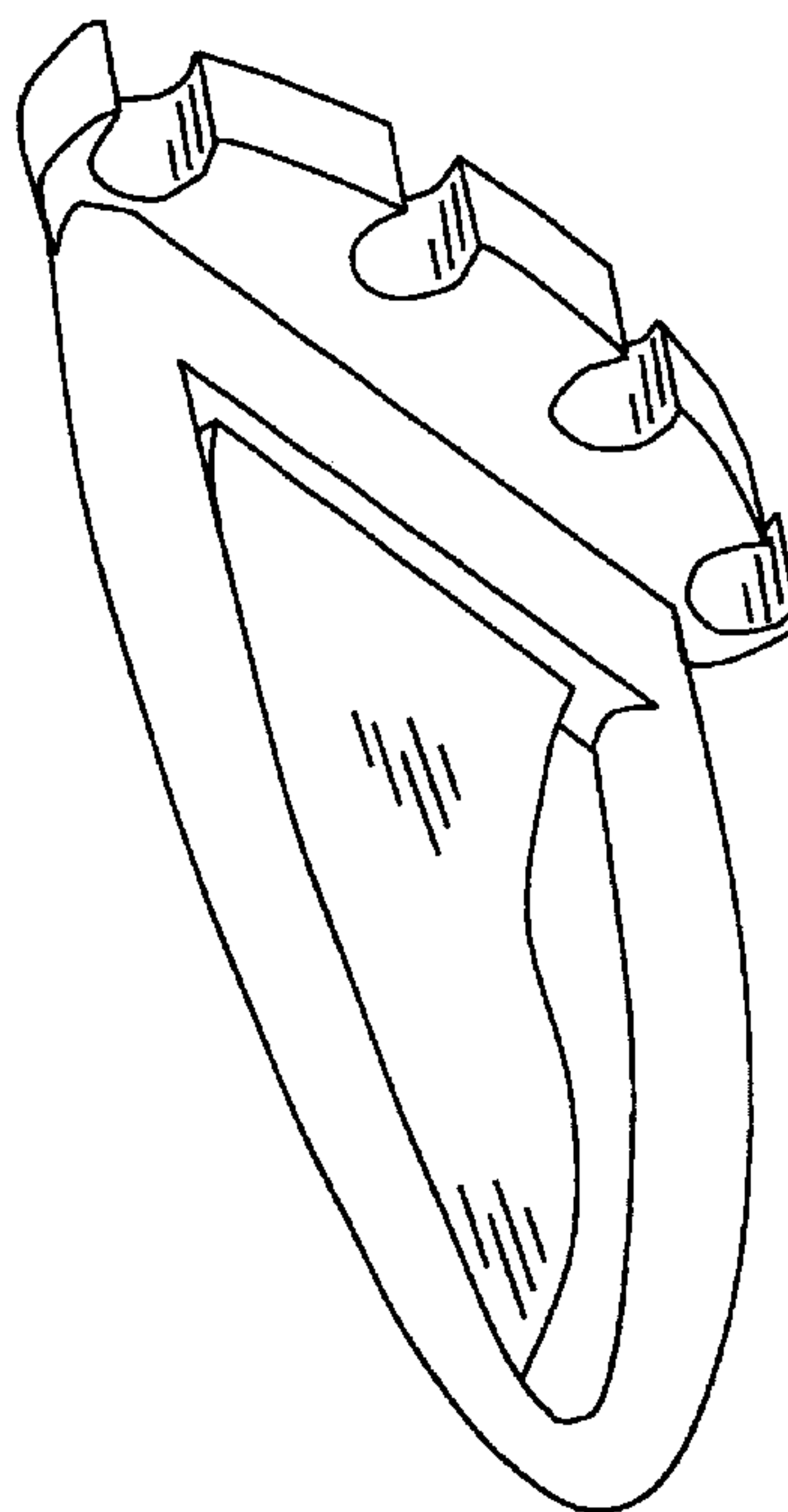
FIG. 10 is perspective view of the bottom side of the second embodiment of the golf tee holder thereof.

FIG. 11 is a top plan view of the second embodiment of the golf tee holder thereof mounted to a visor of a cap; and,

FIG. 12 is bottom plan view of the bottom side of the second embodiment of the golf tee holder thereof mounted to the visor of the cap of FIG. 11.

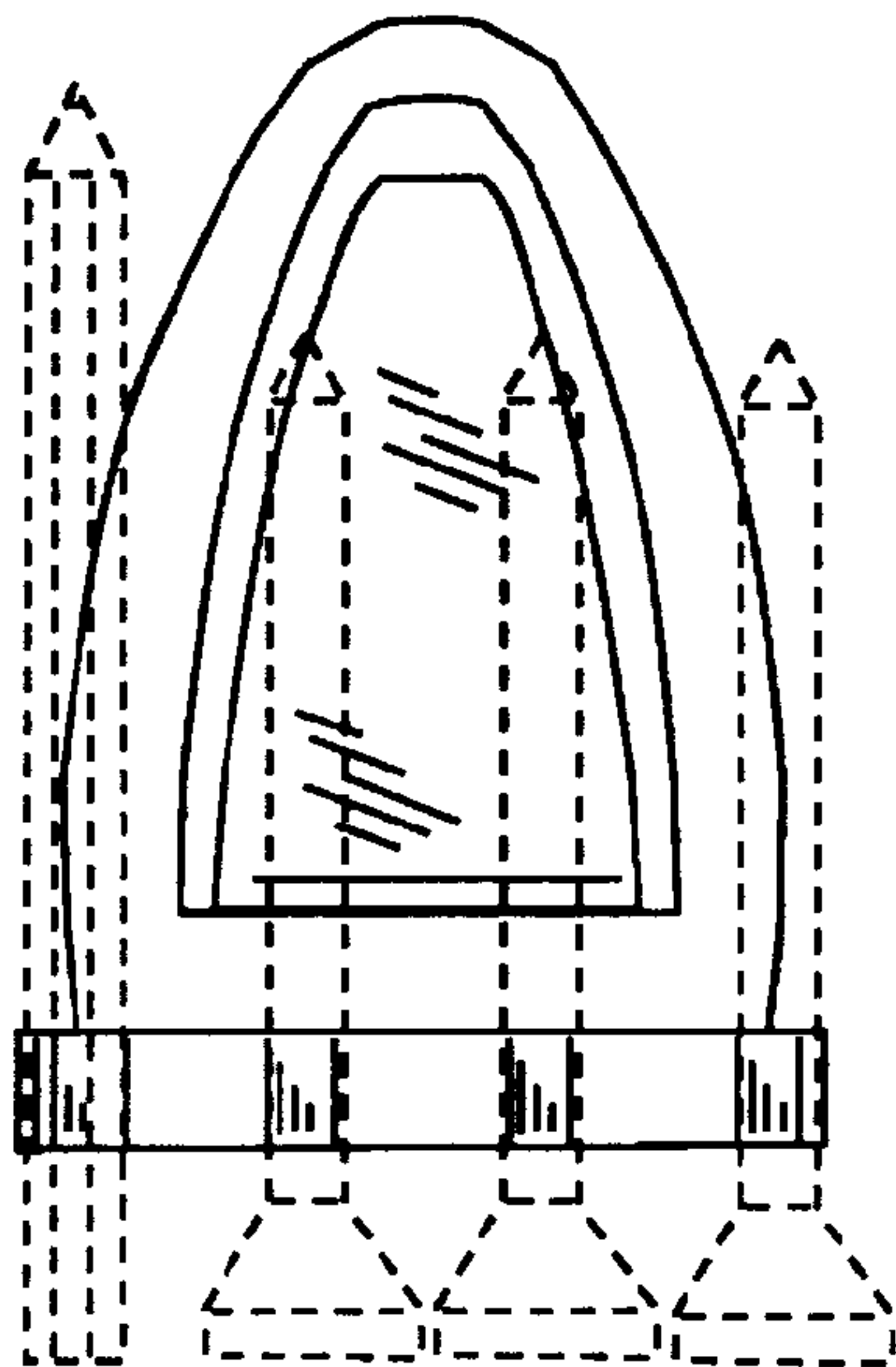

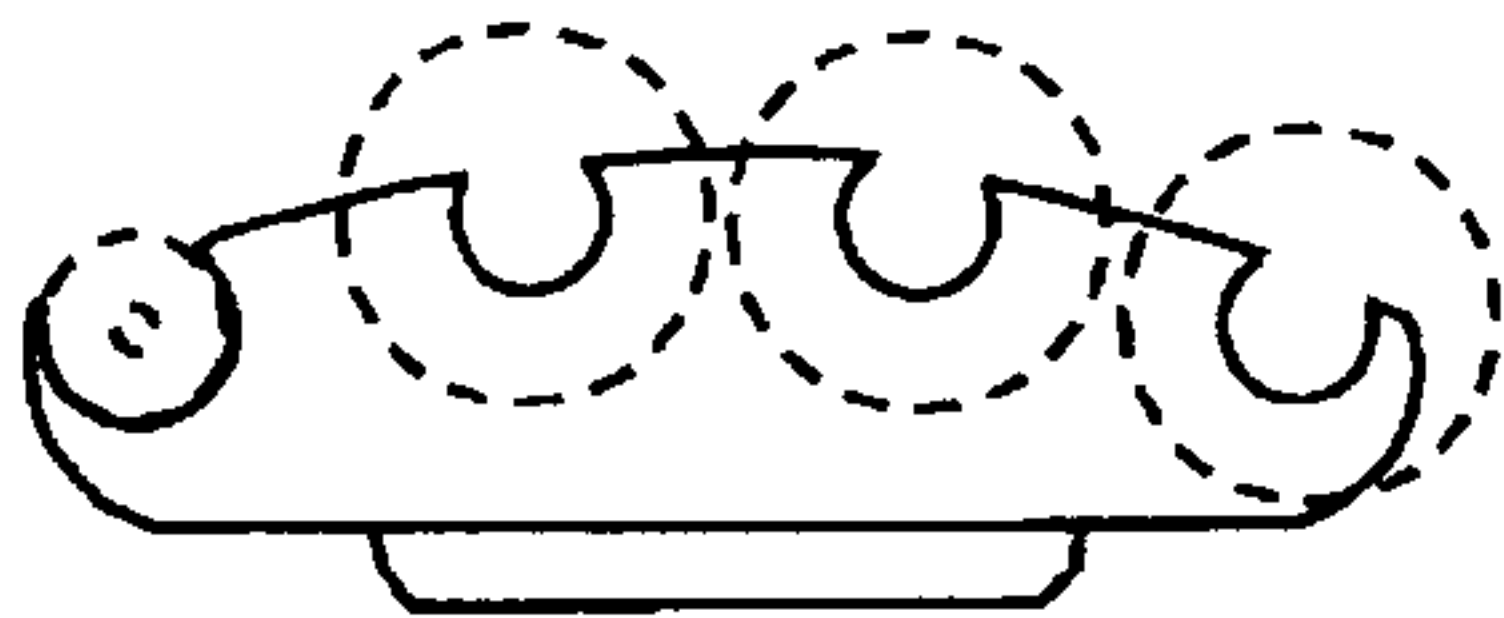

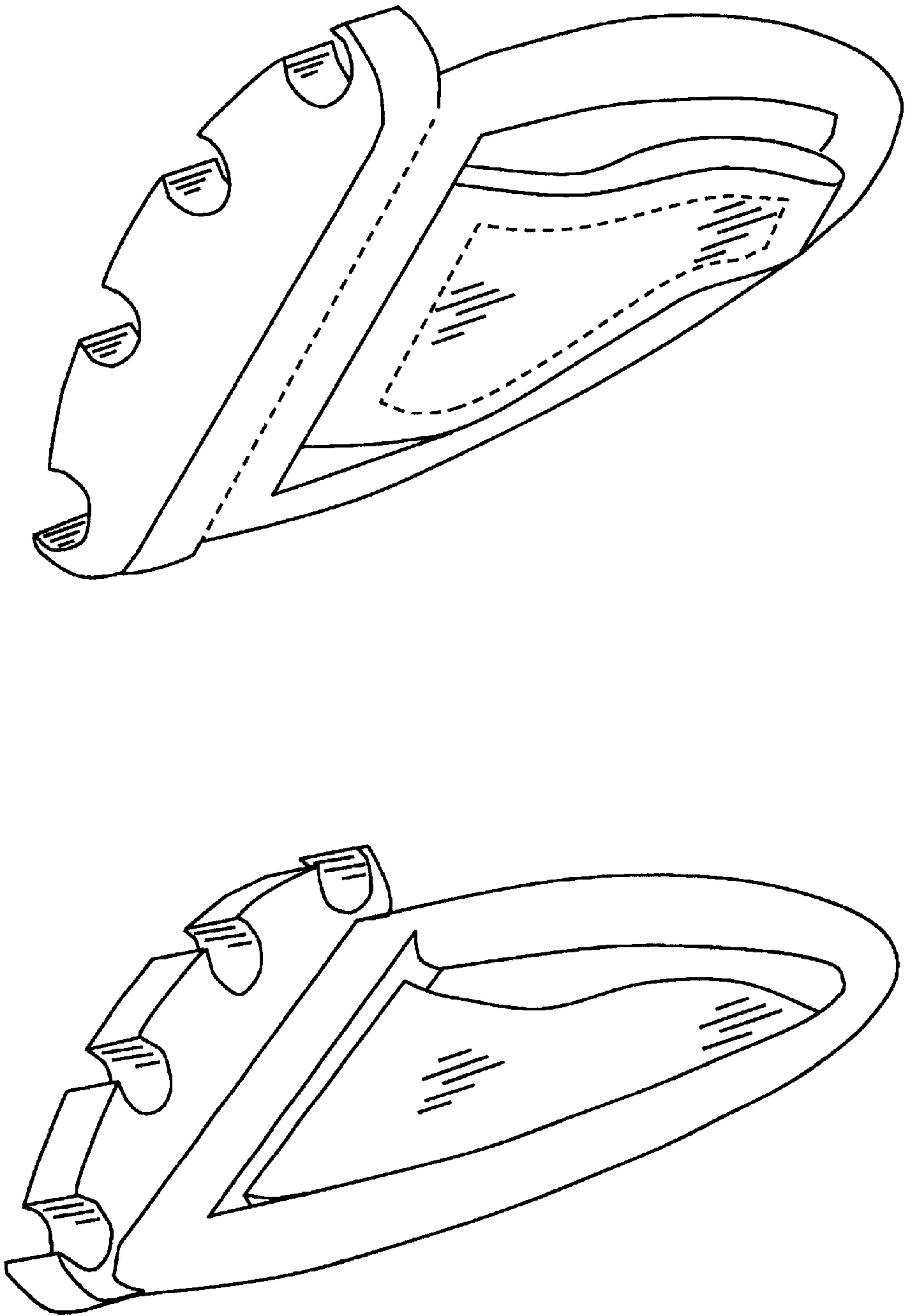

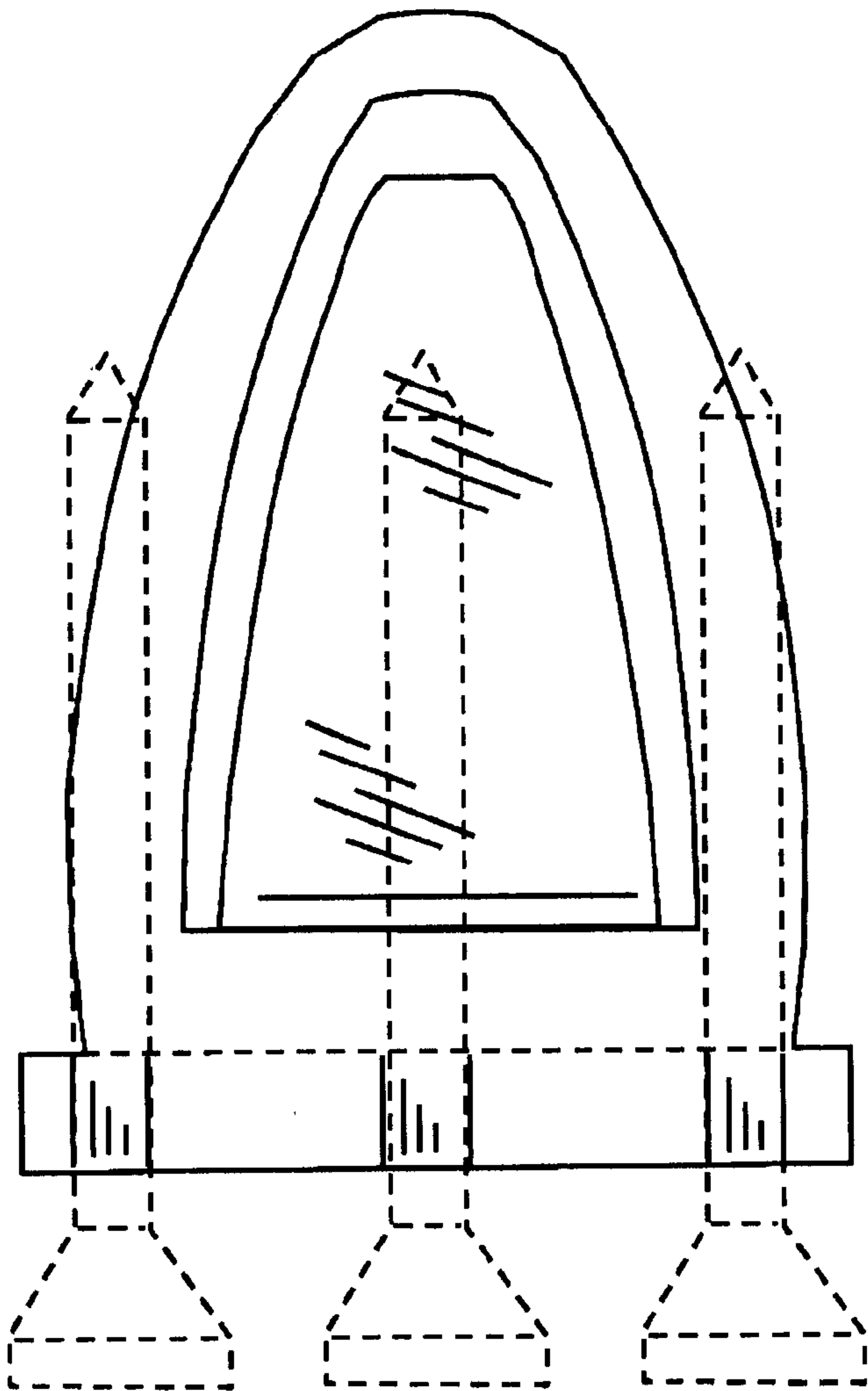

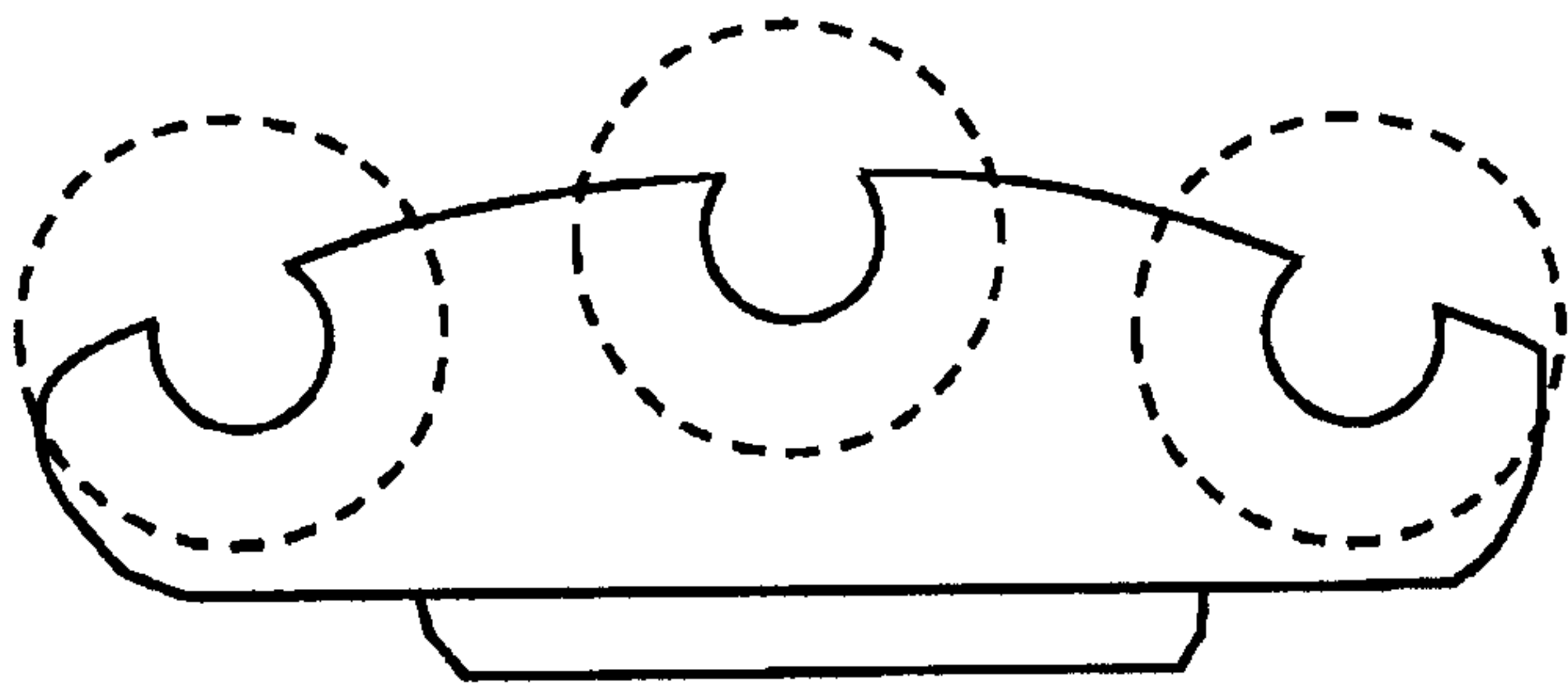

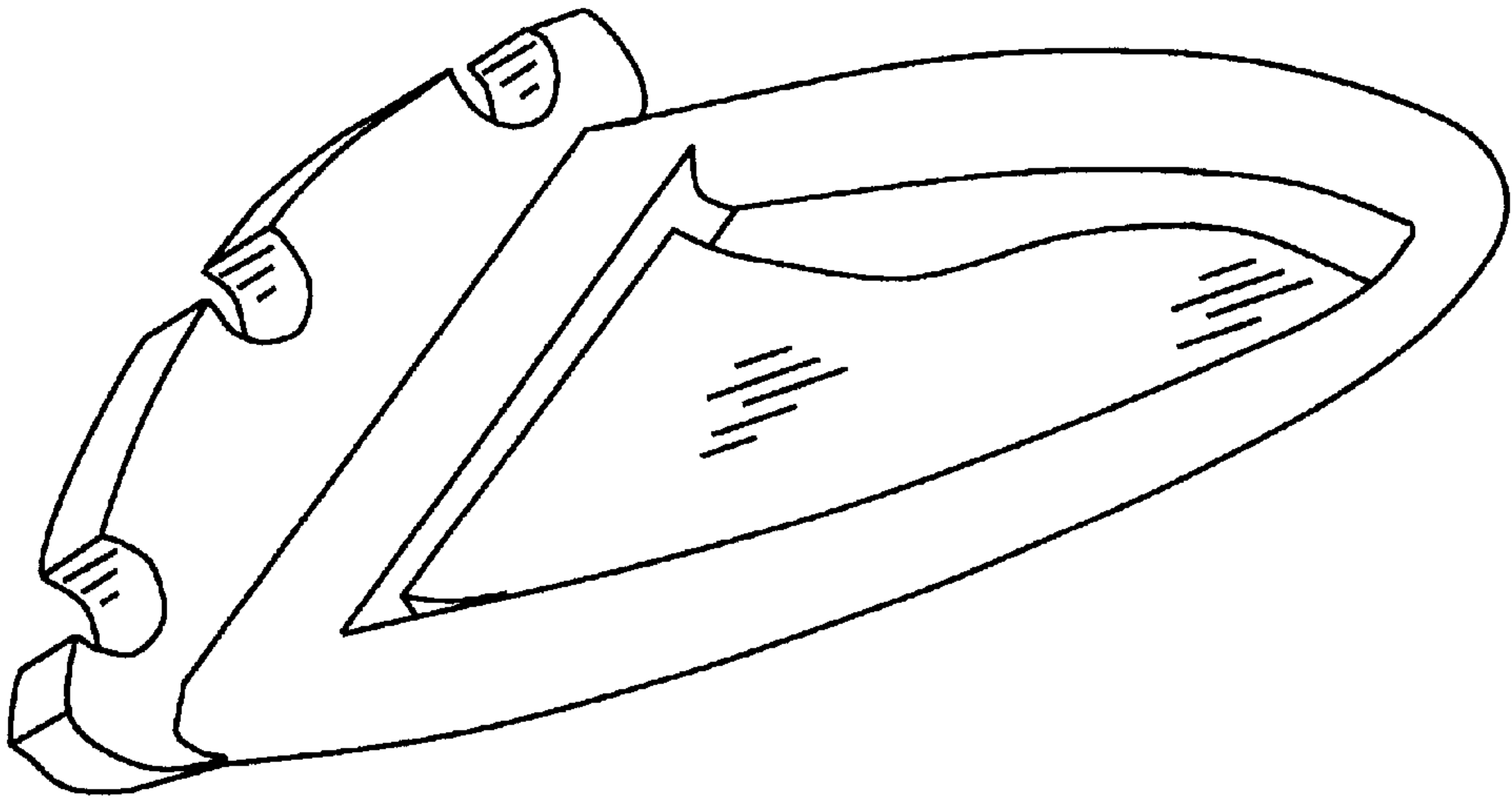

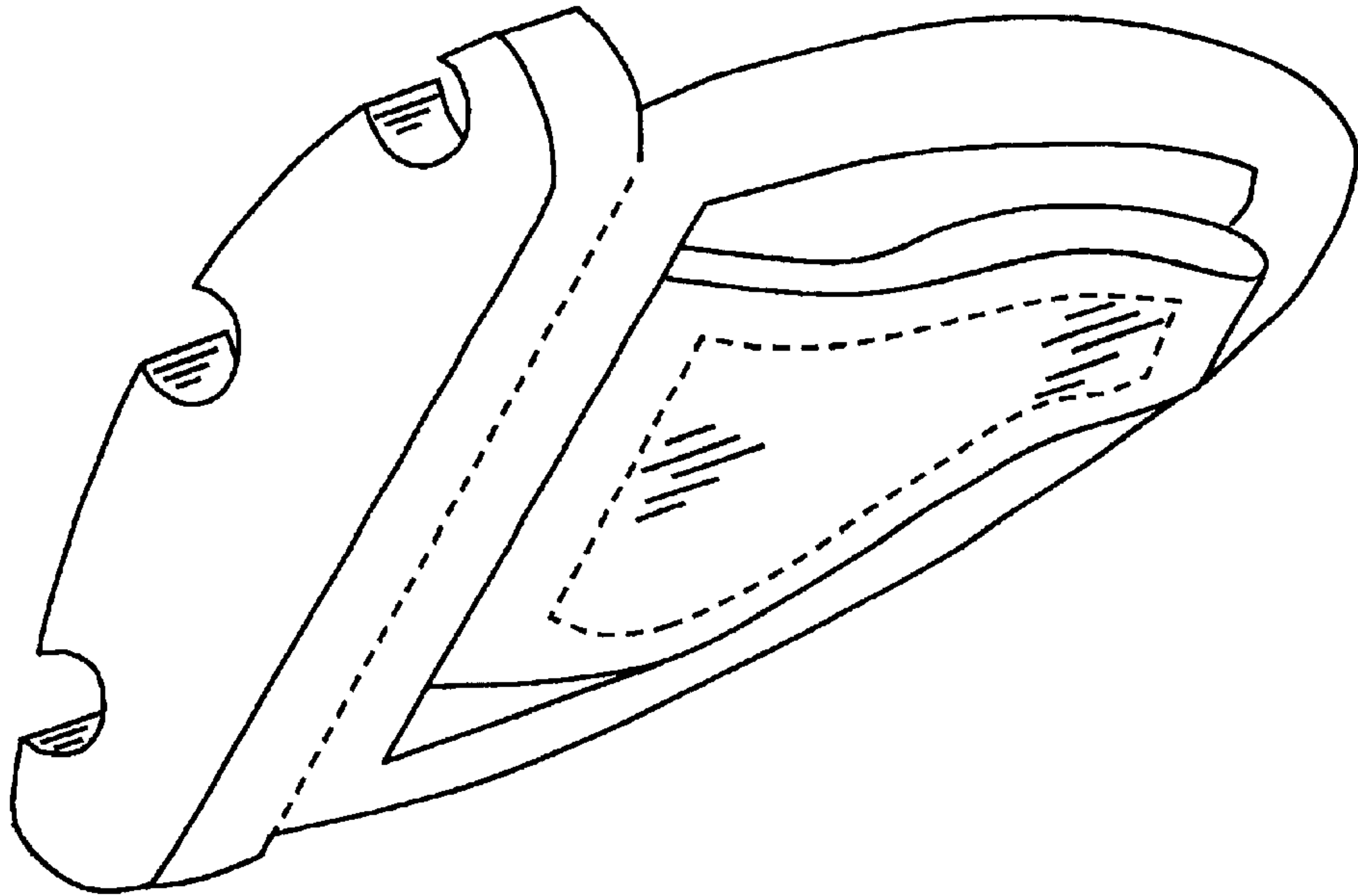

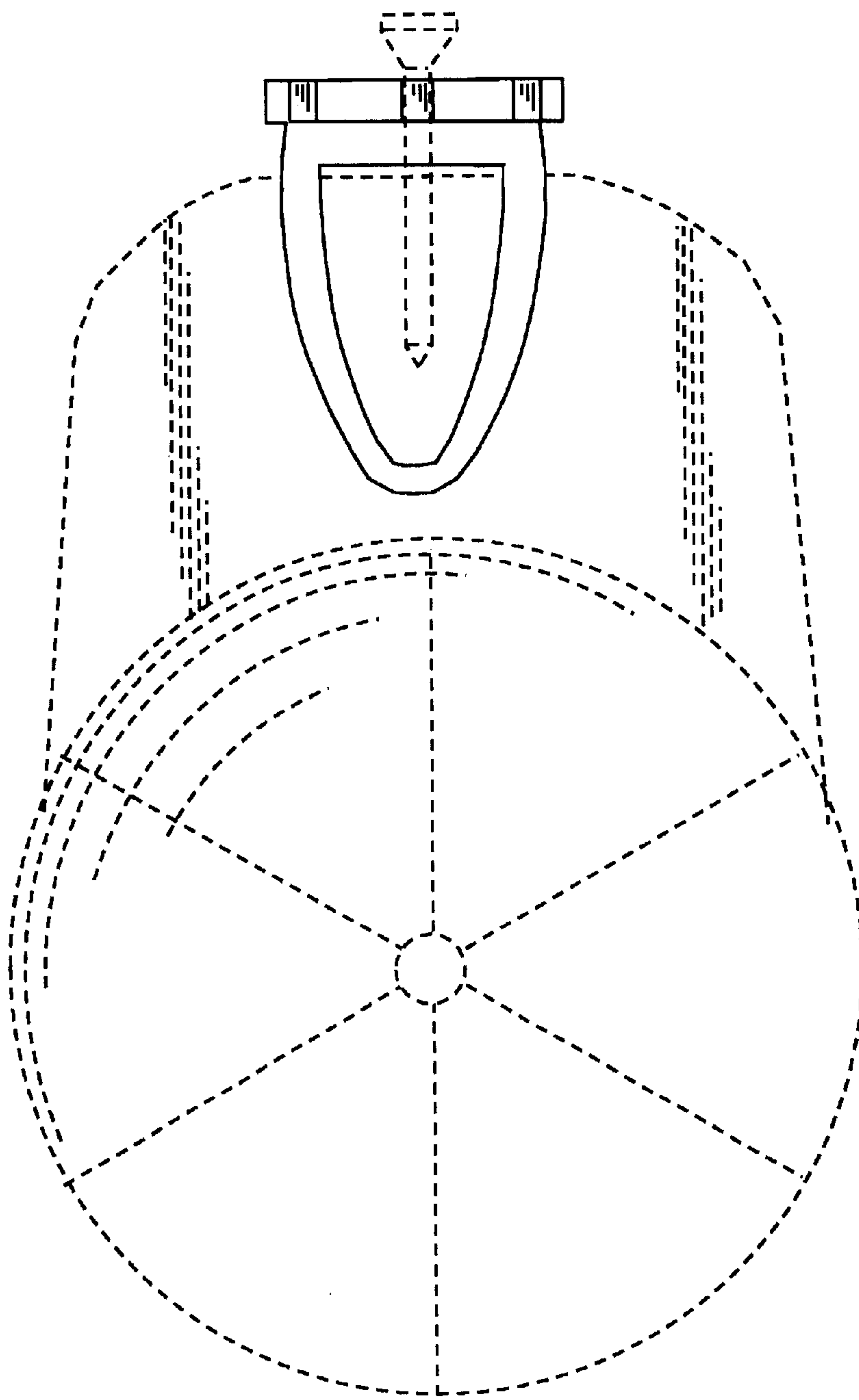

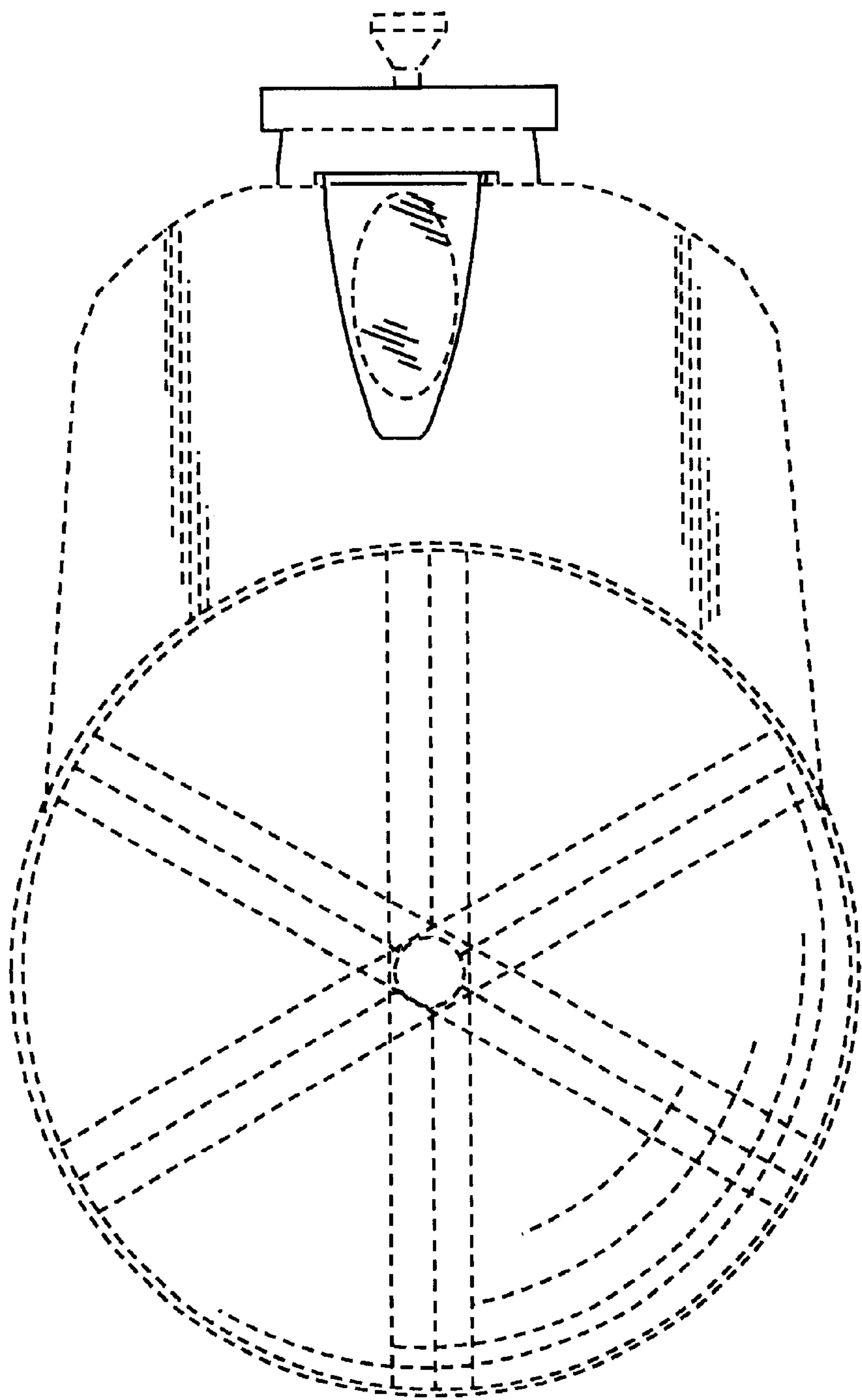
