(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a vanity, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

In a preferred embodiment, the nature of this product is a vanity such as can be used to support a lavatory.

FIG. 1 is a left, top, front perspective view of a vanity embodying my new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof, the right side elevational view thereof being a mirror image of the left side shown;

FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof; and,

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.

The broken line representation of fluting in FIGS. 1, 2 and wall structure in FIGS. 1, 4 and 6, are for the purpose of illustration only, and form no part of the claimed design.

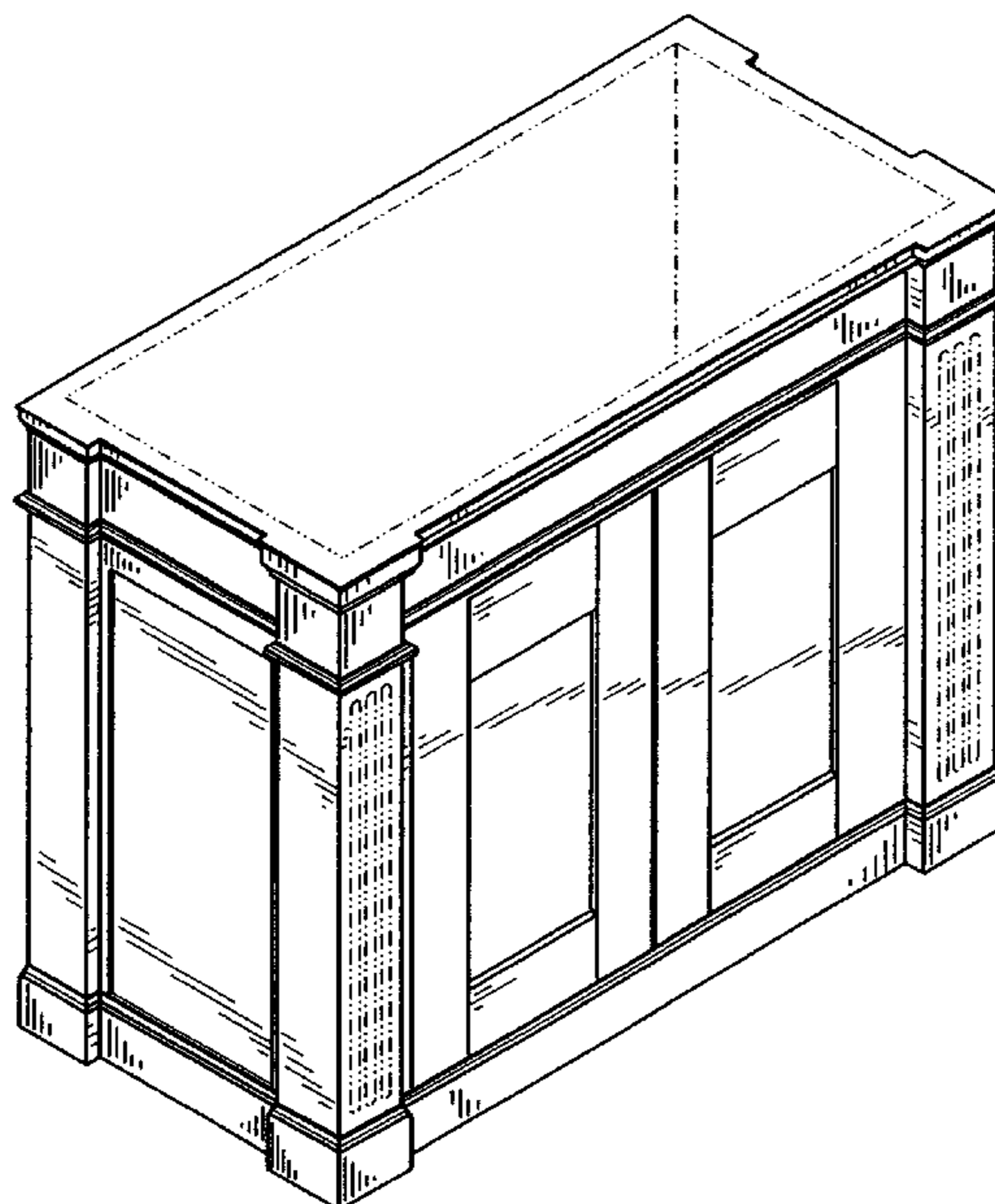
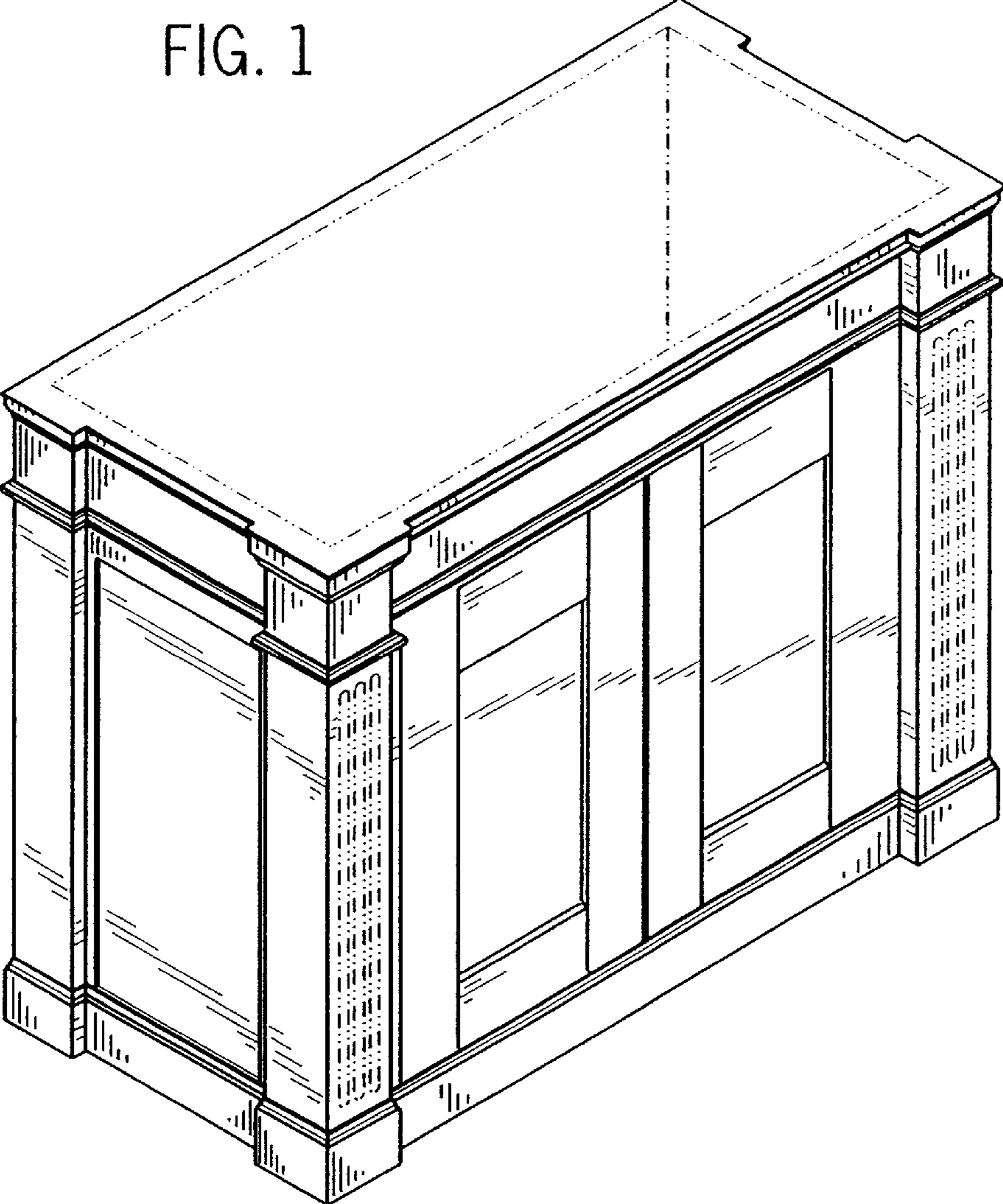

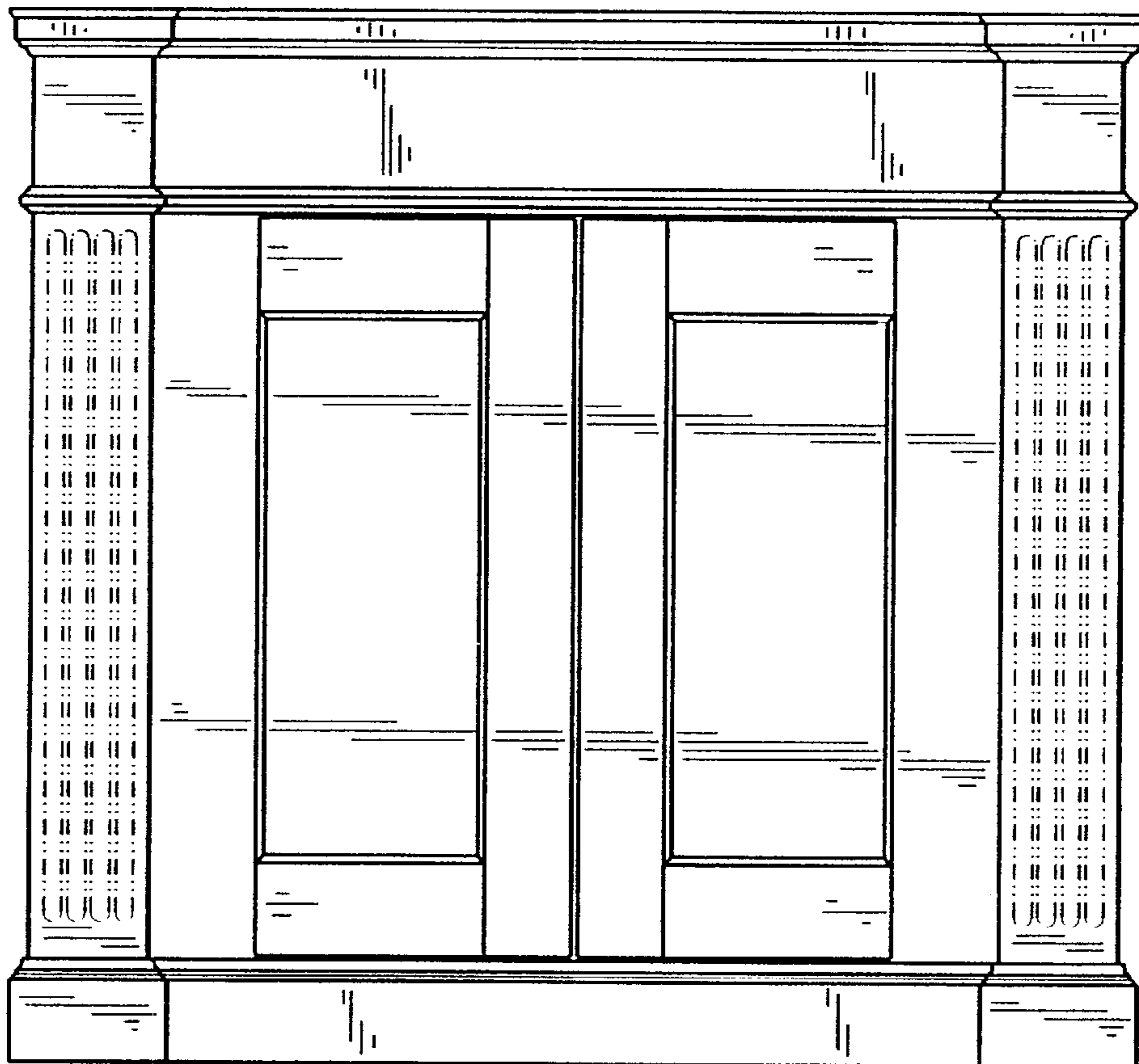

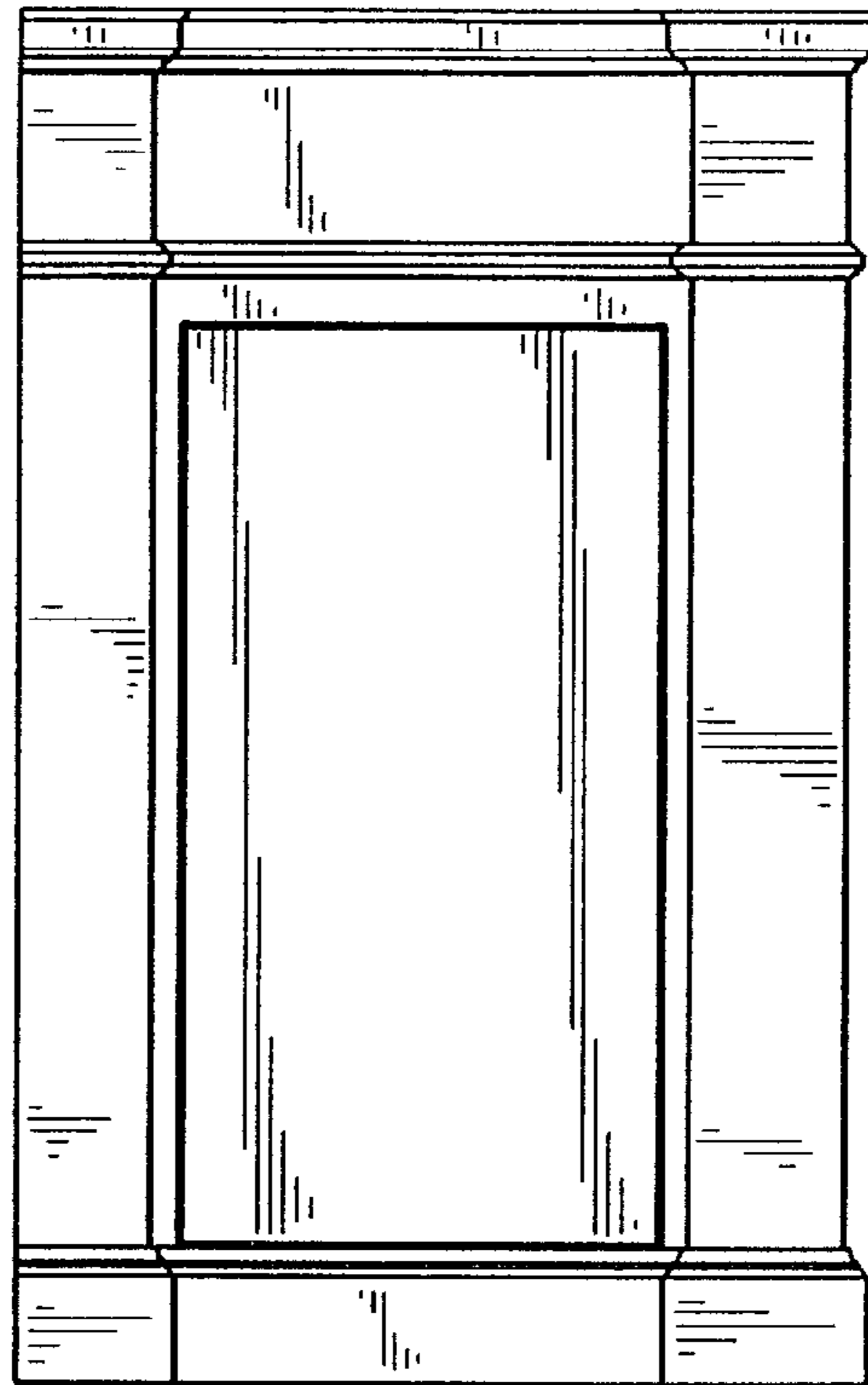

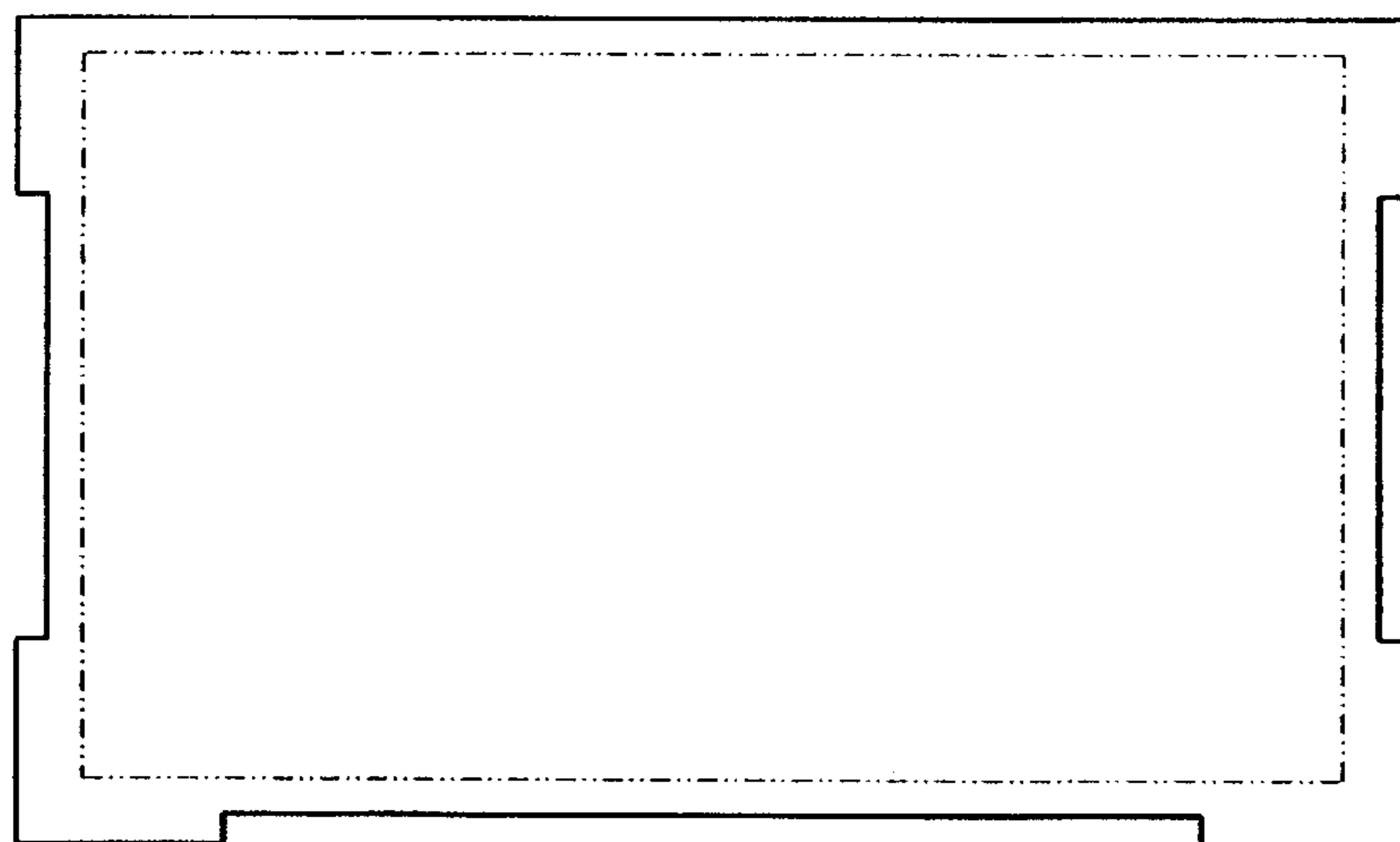

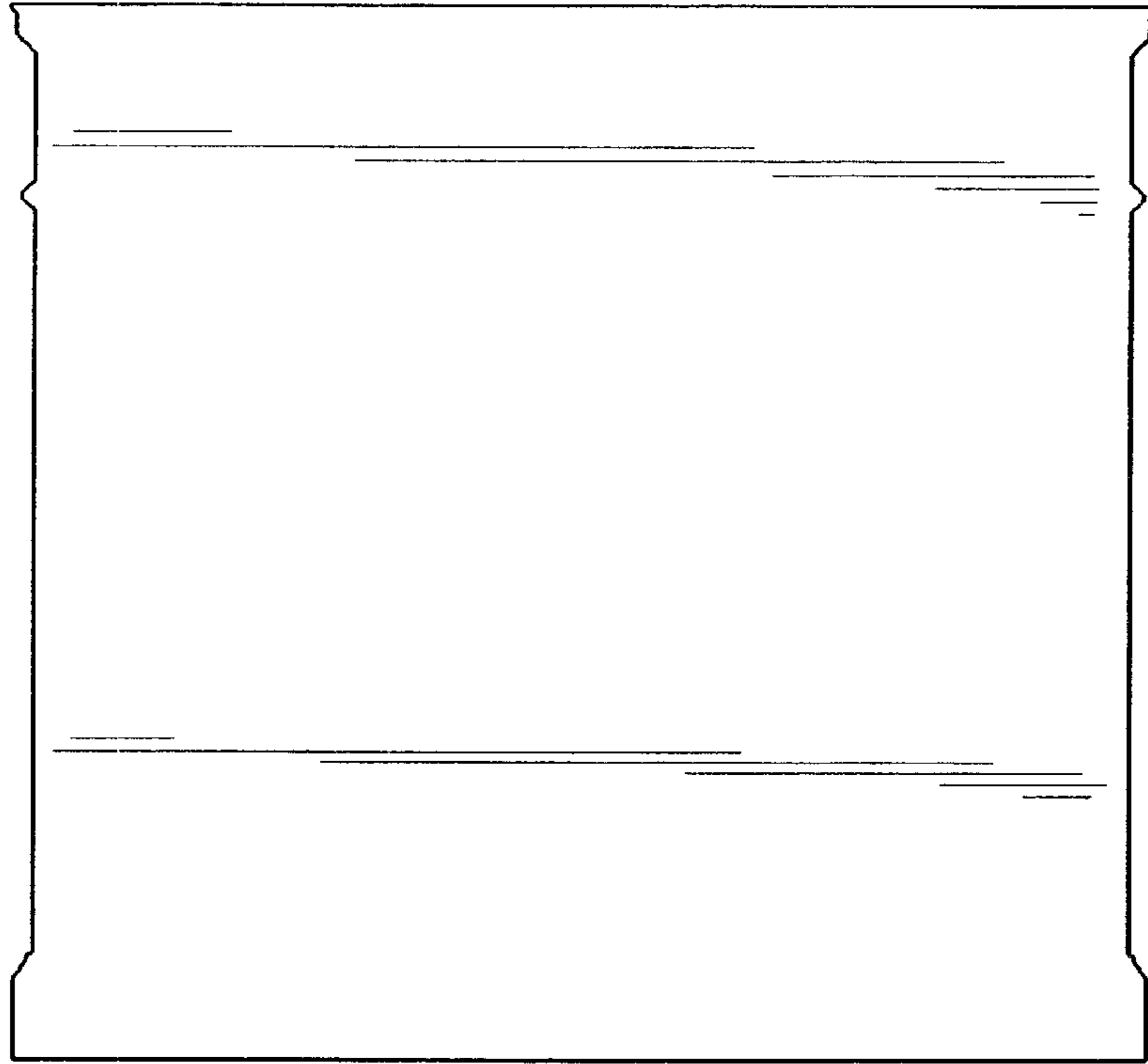
