FIG. 1 is a top, front perspective view of an opaque cosmetic container showing my new design;

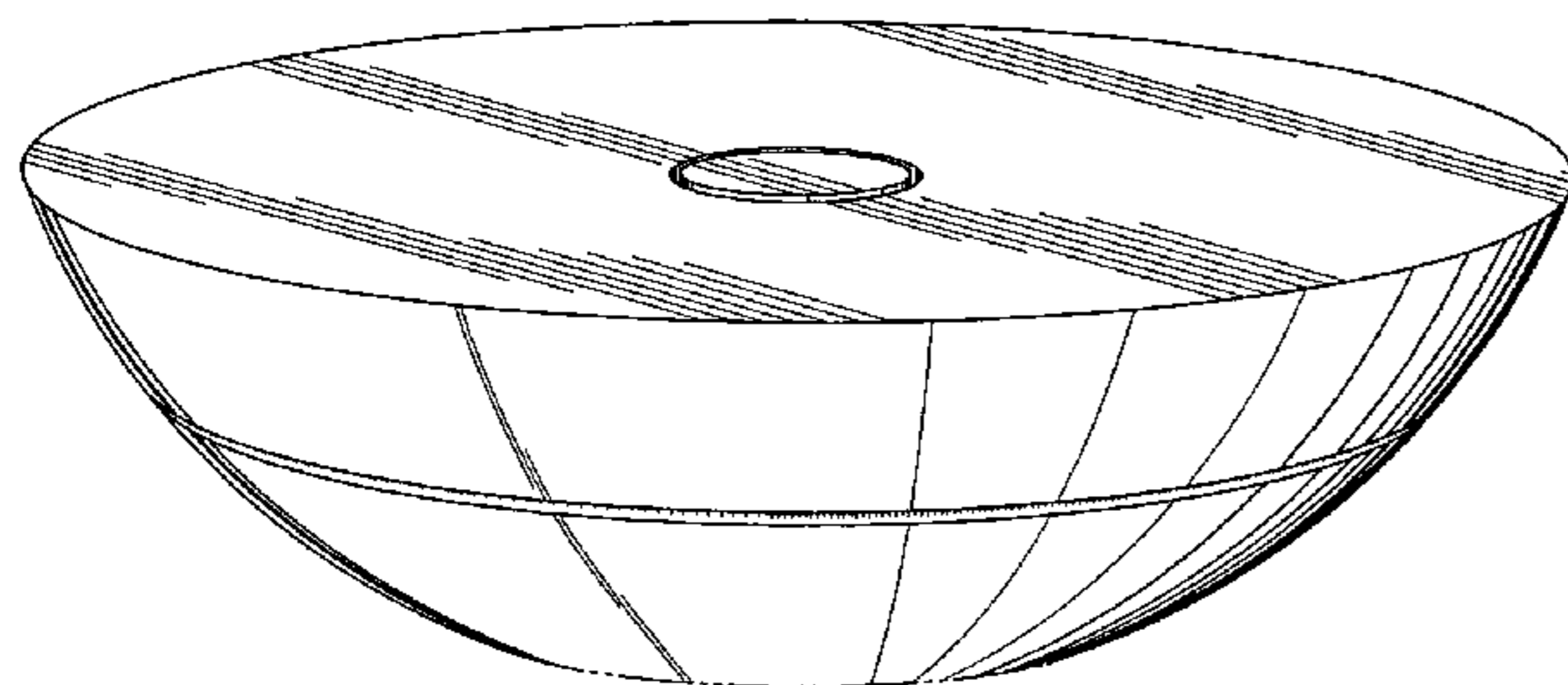


FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 21 is a top, front perspective view of a sixth embodiment showing my new design as being translucent;

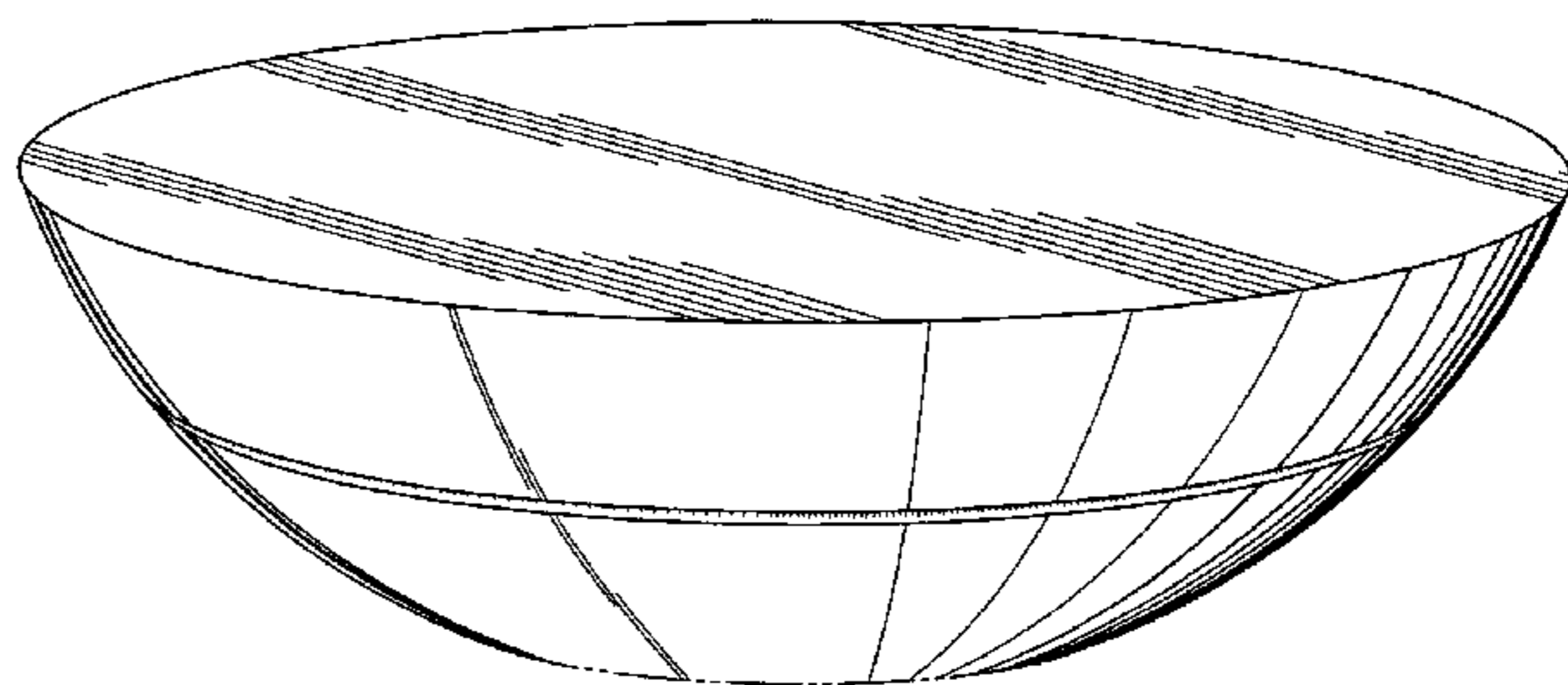
FIG. 22 is a rear elevational view thereof;

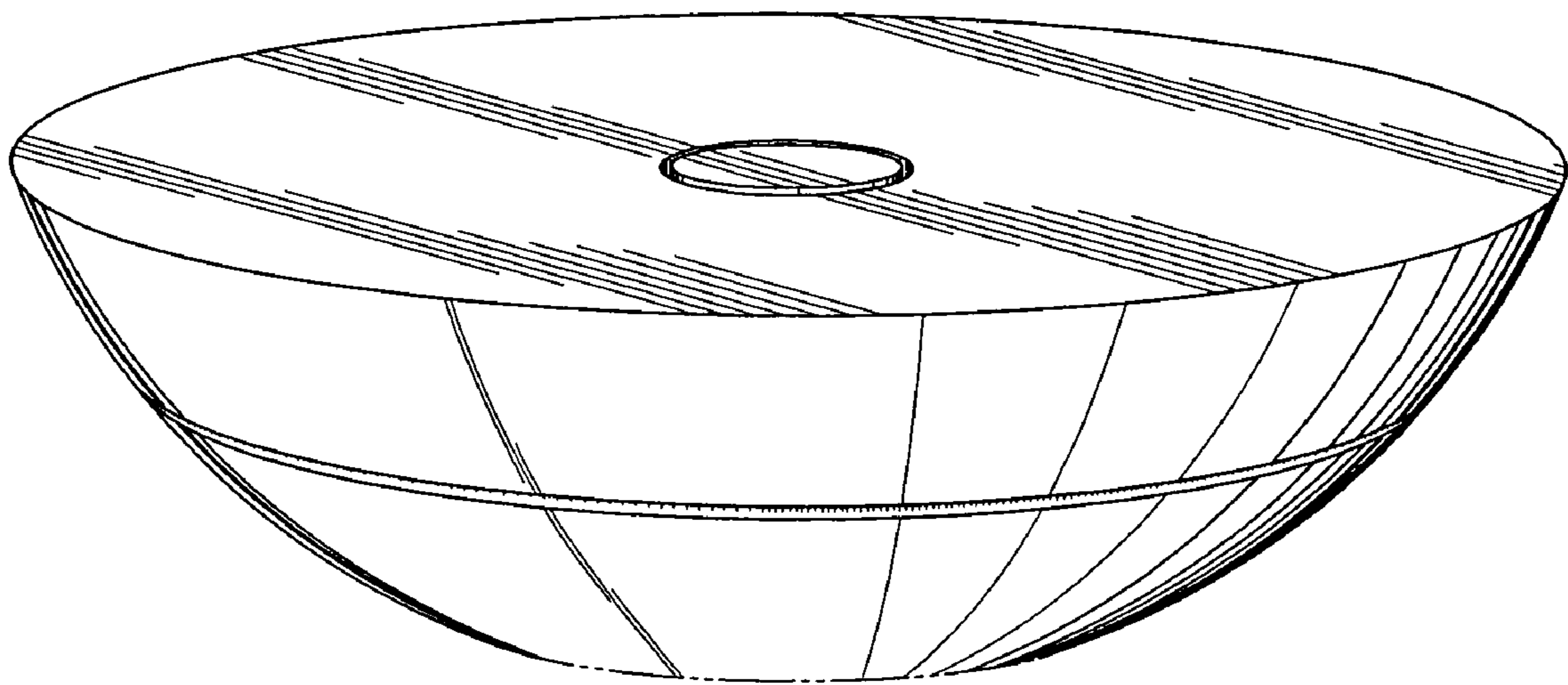

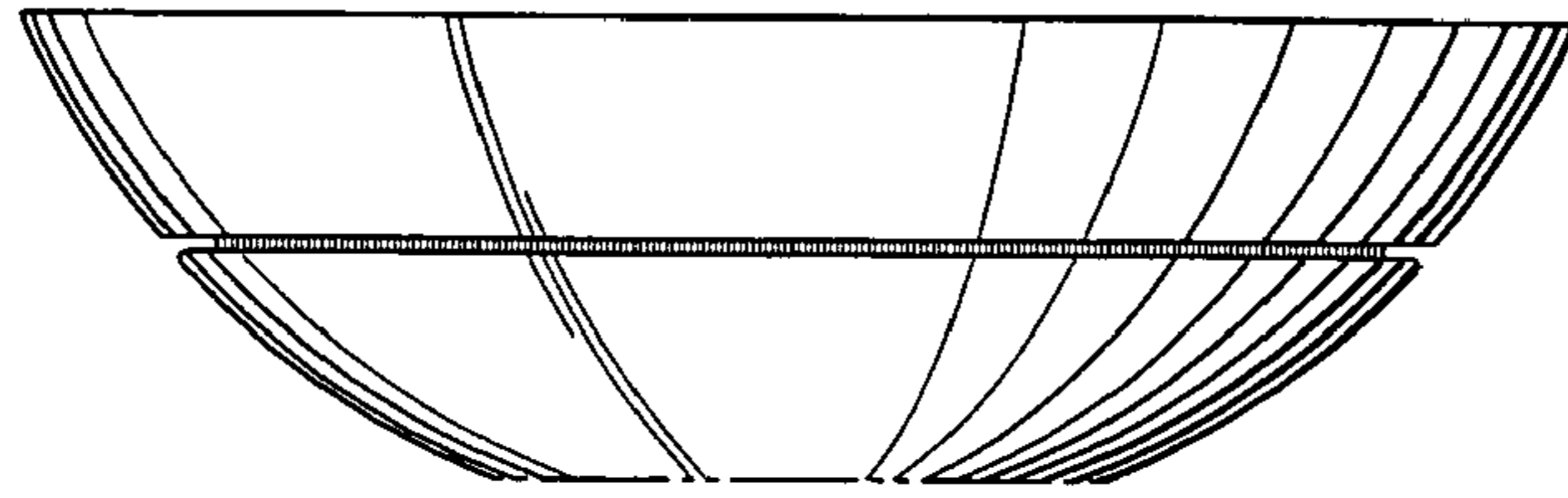

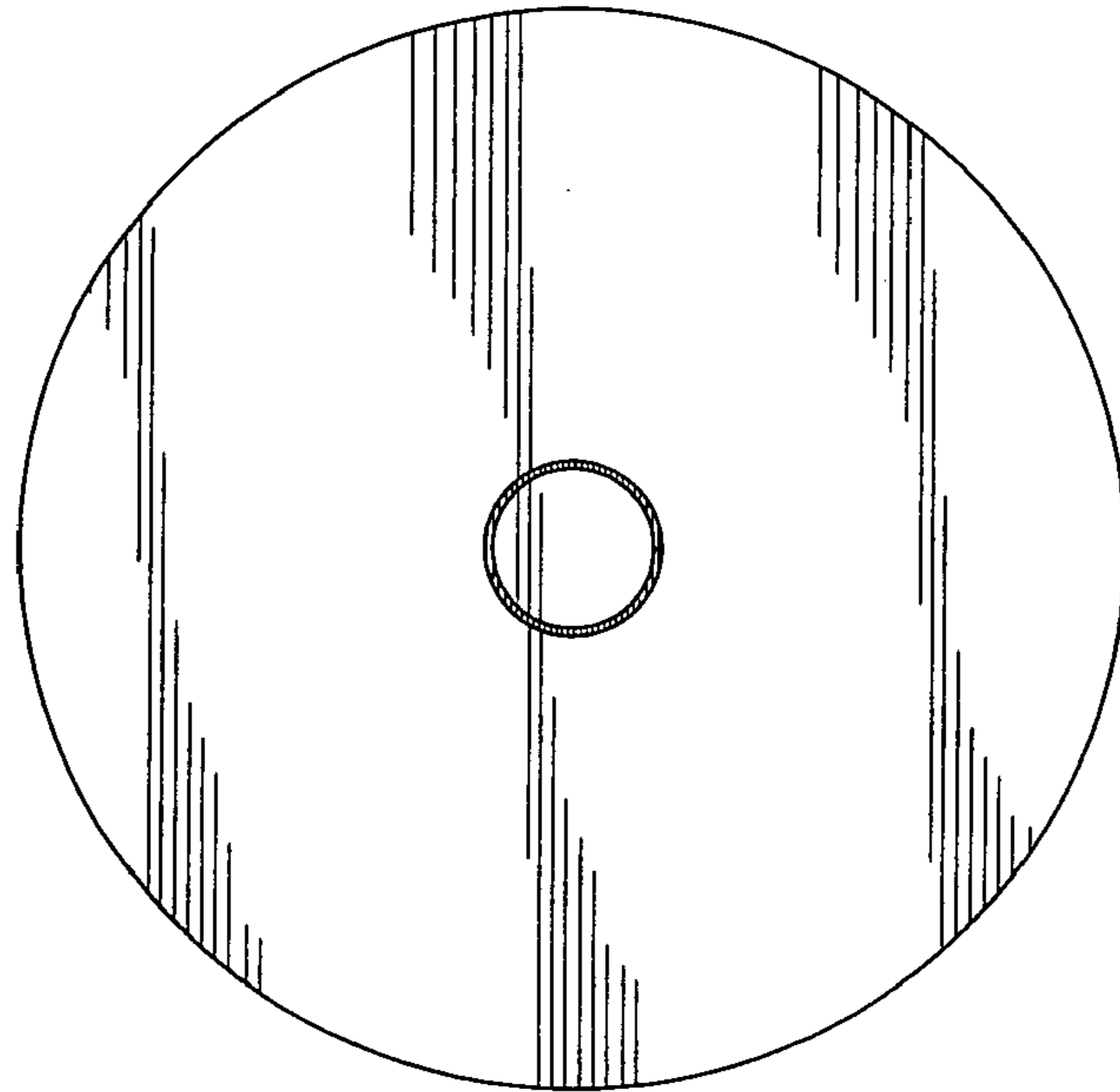

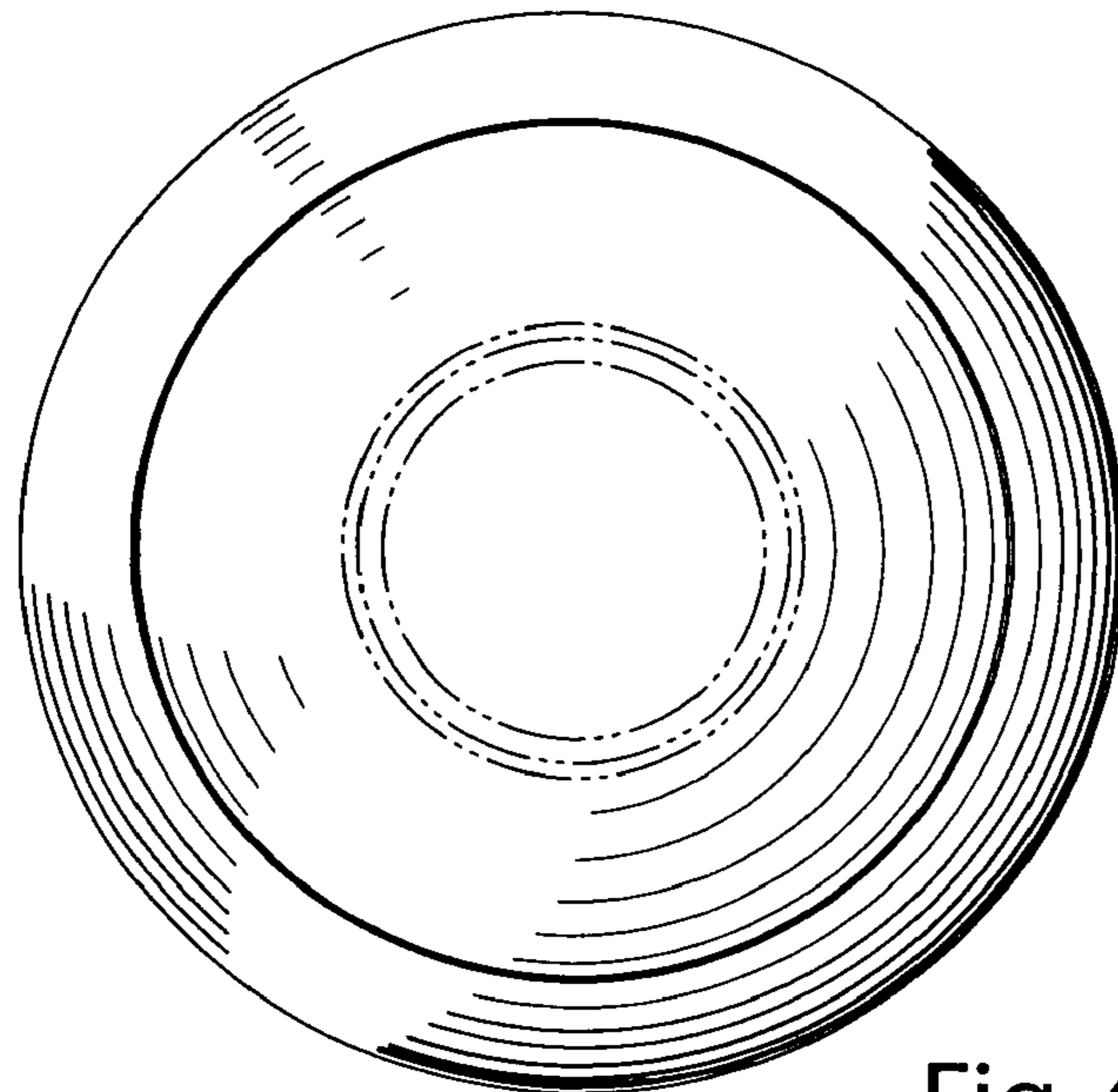

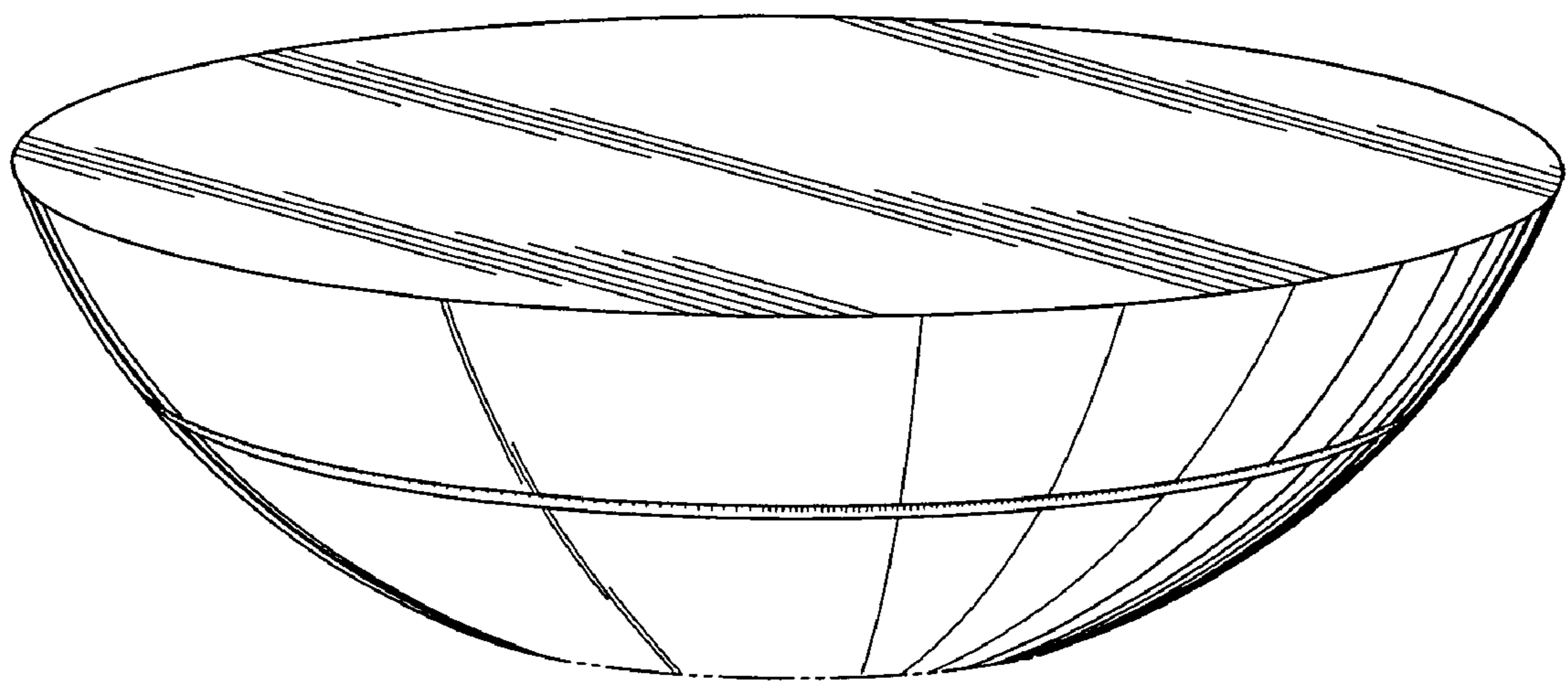

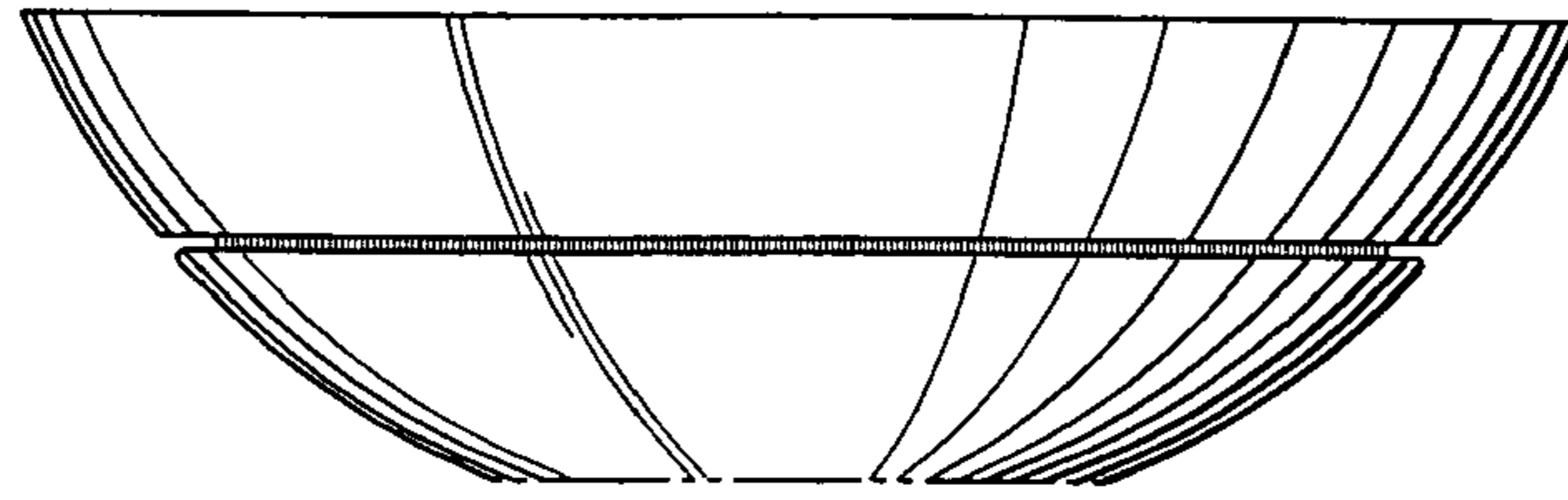

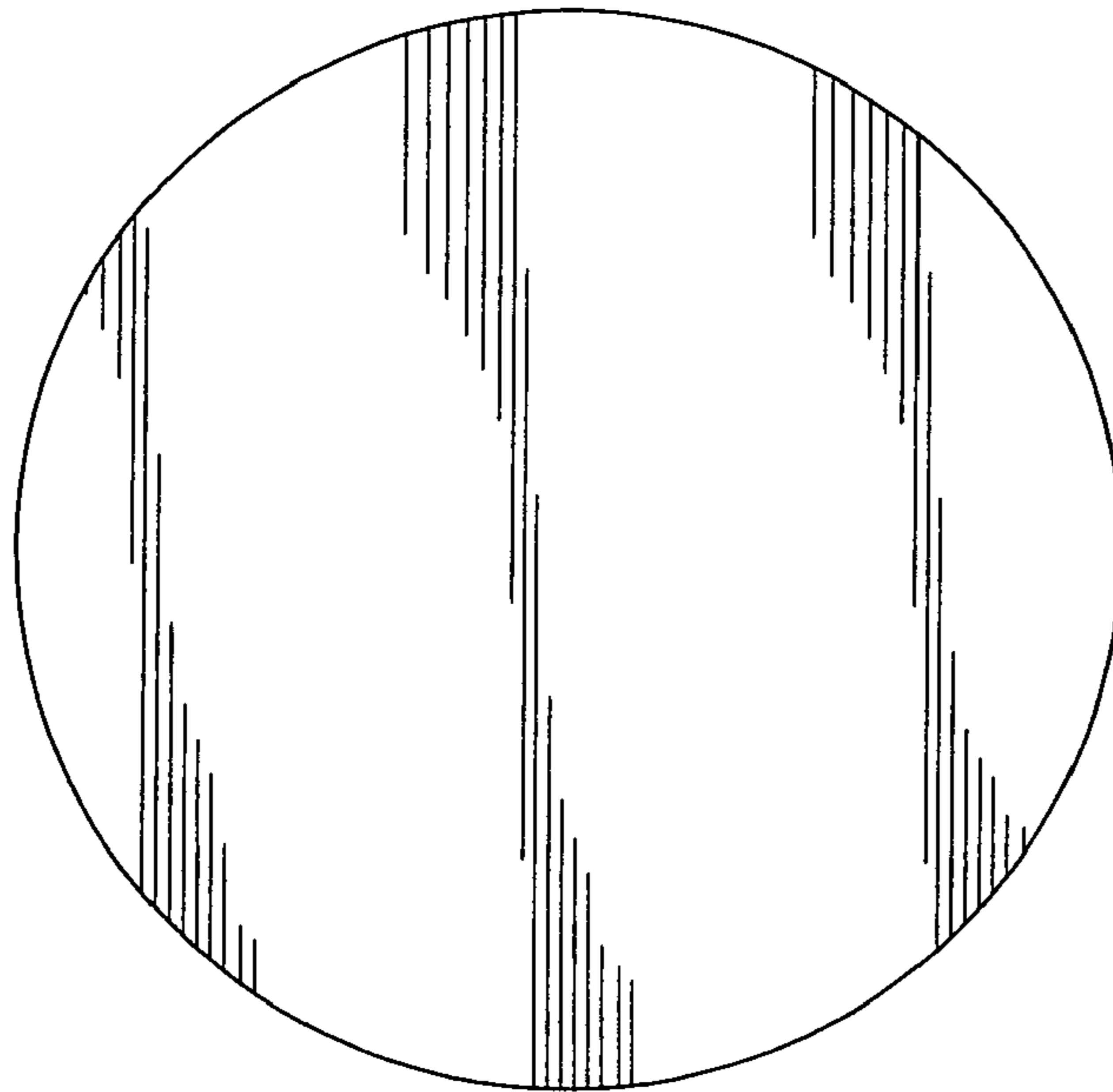

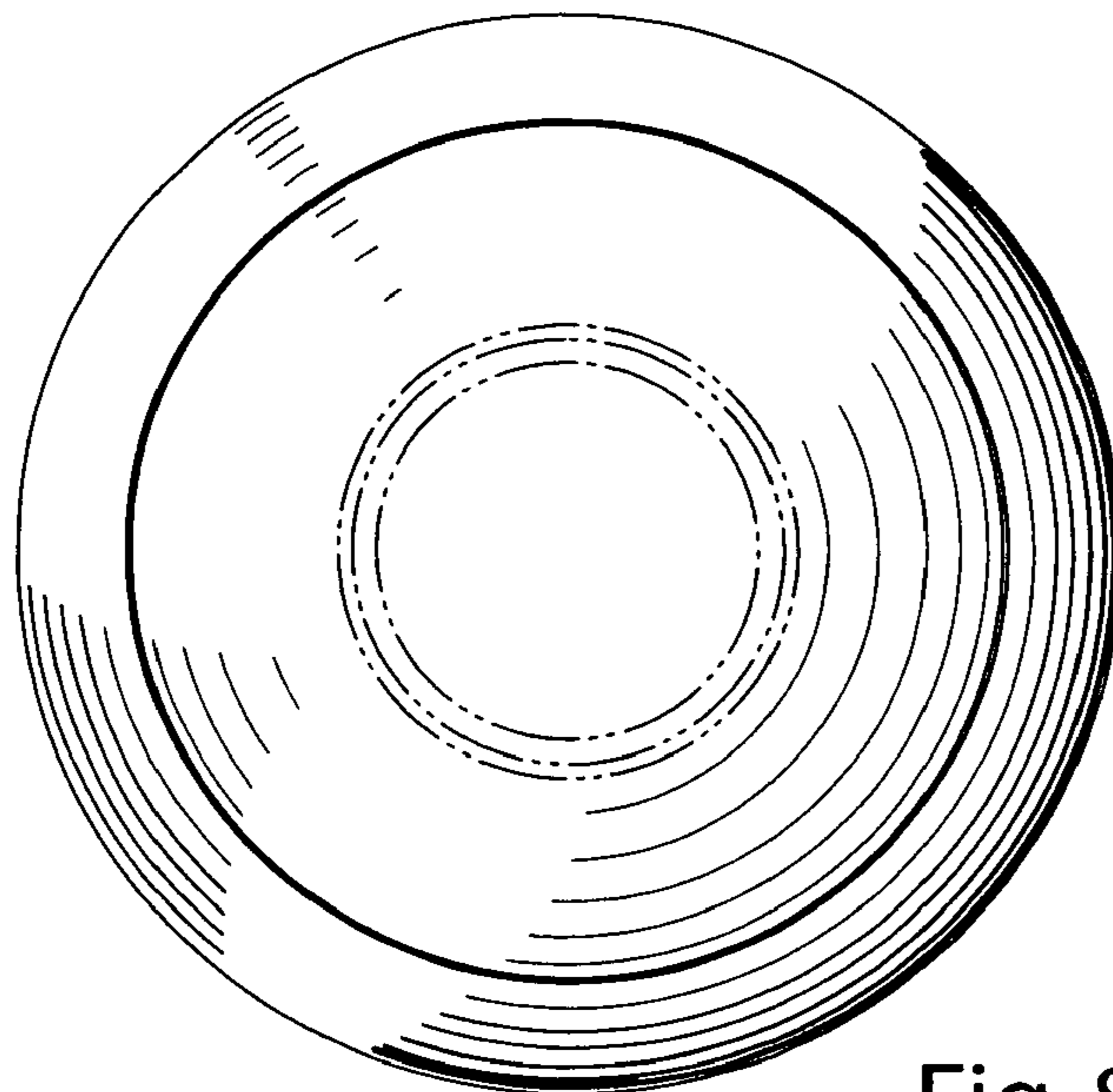

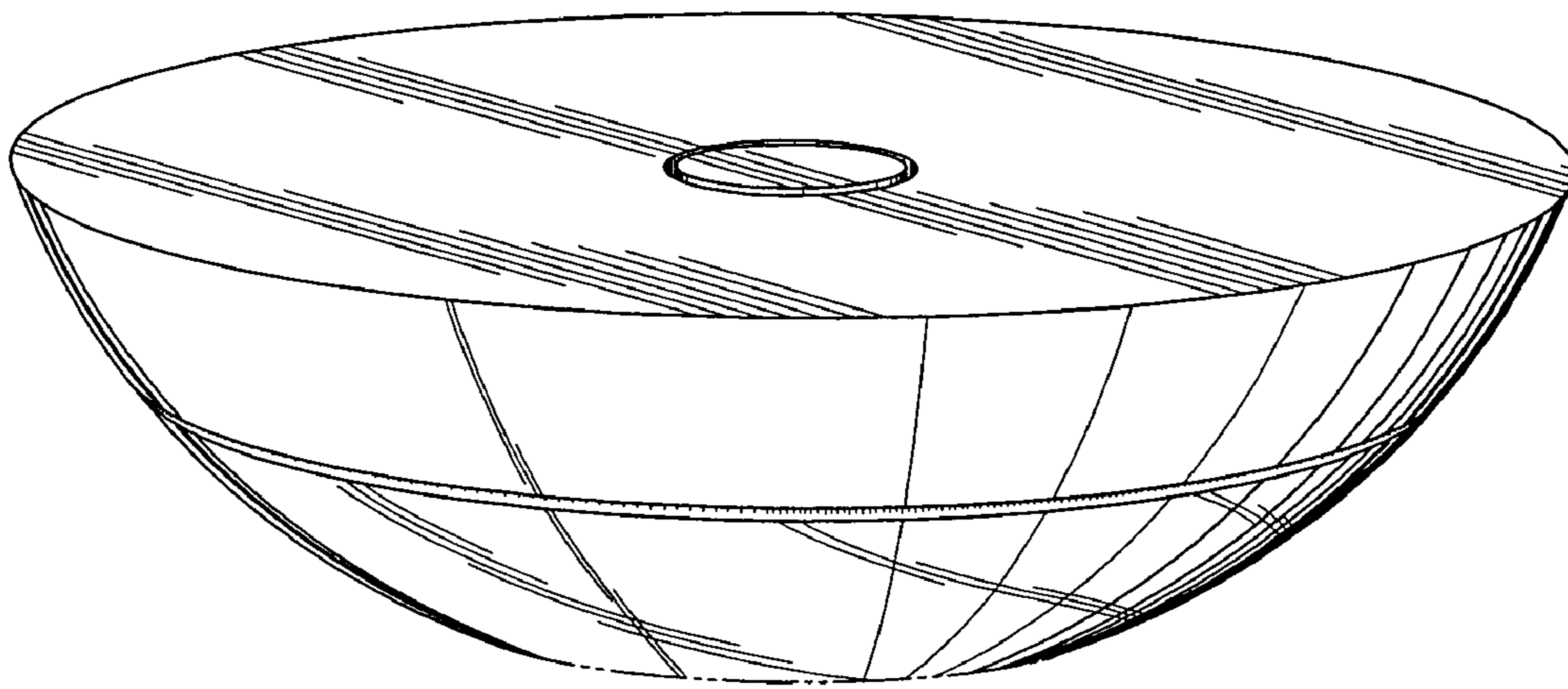

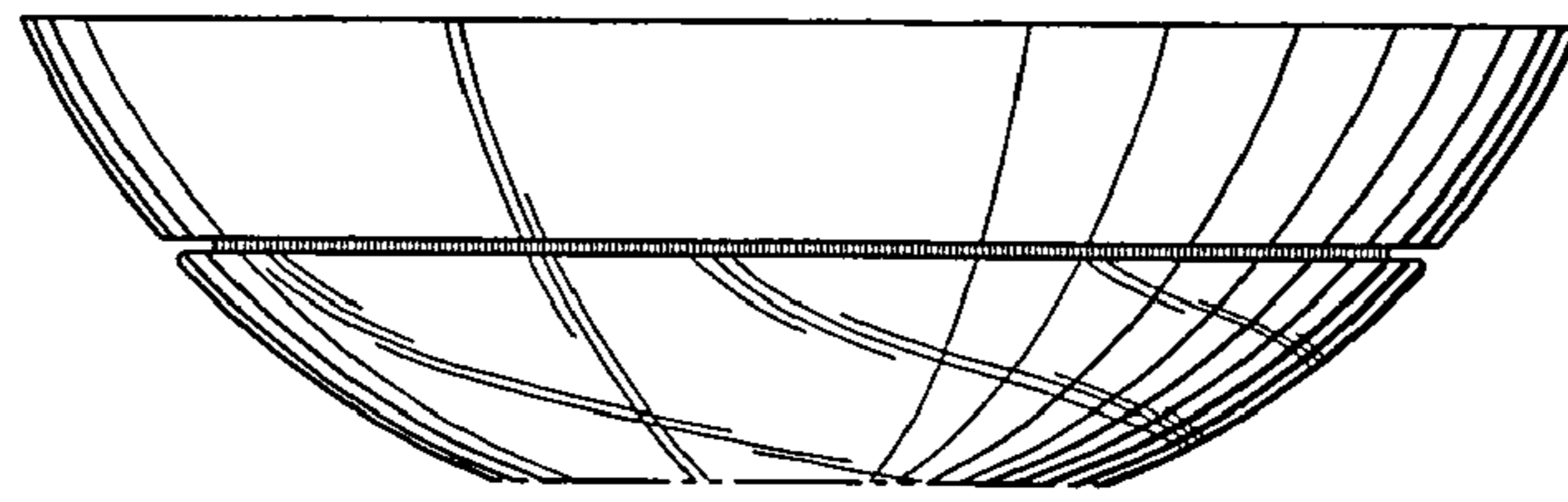

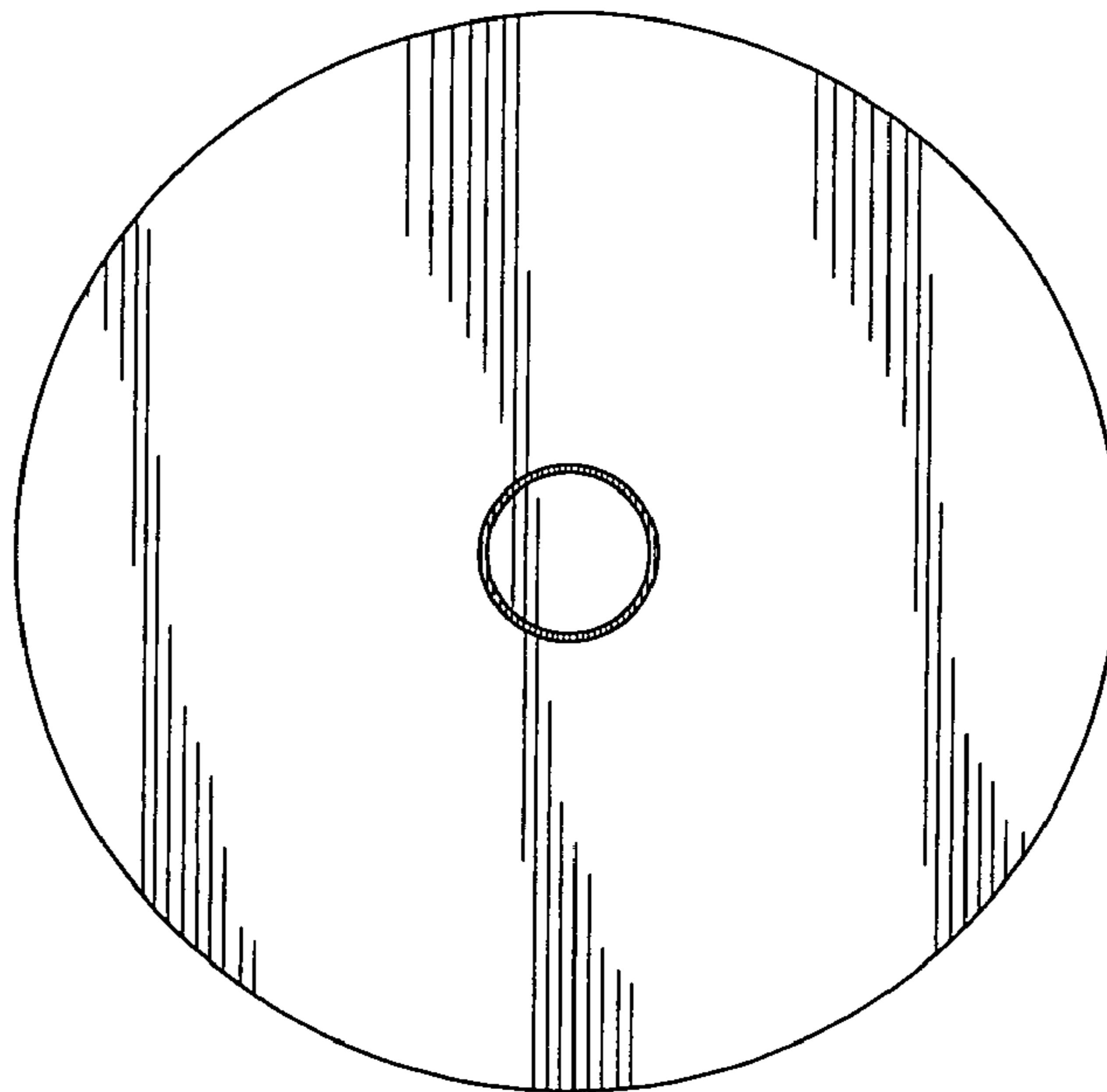

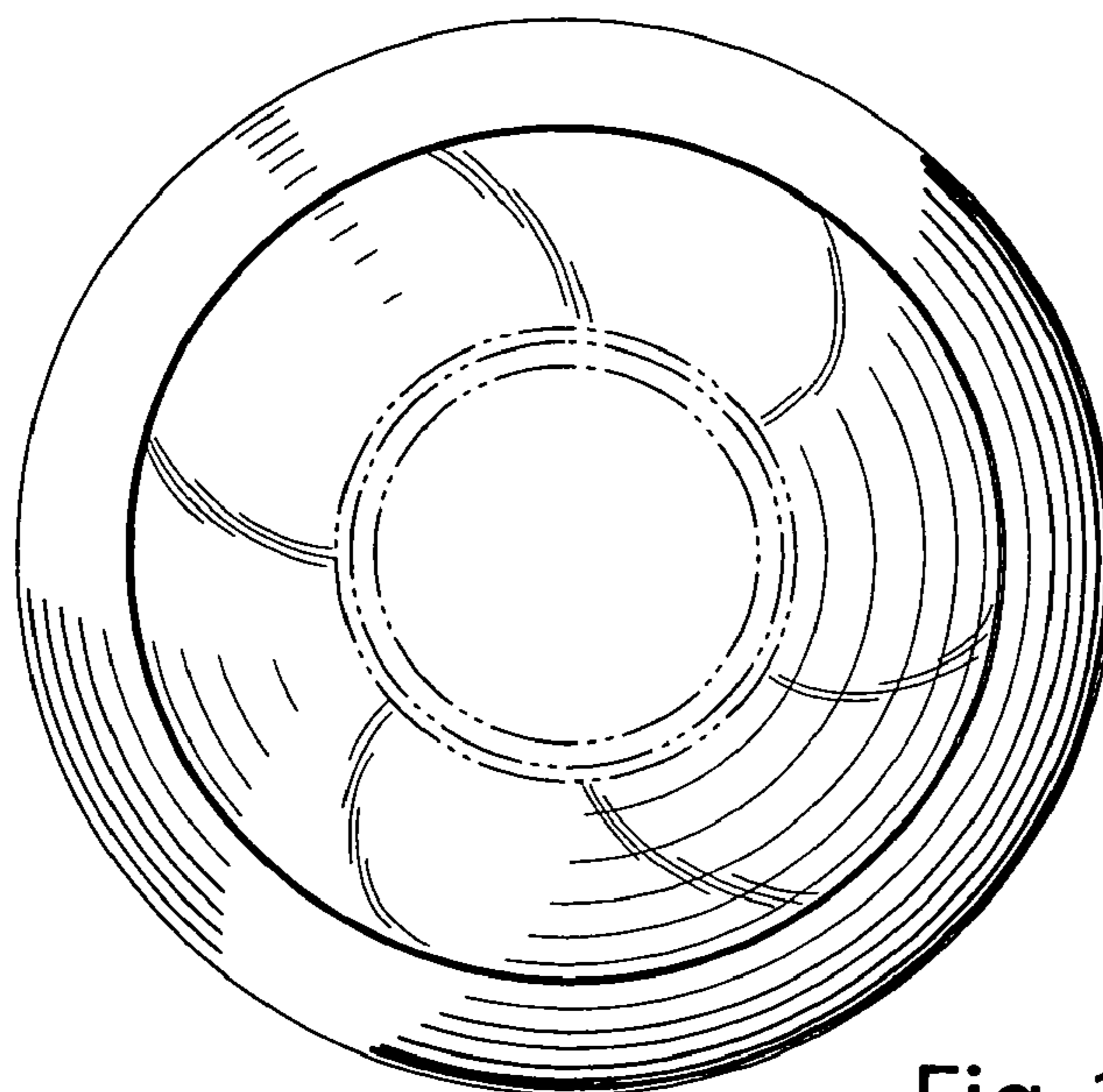

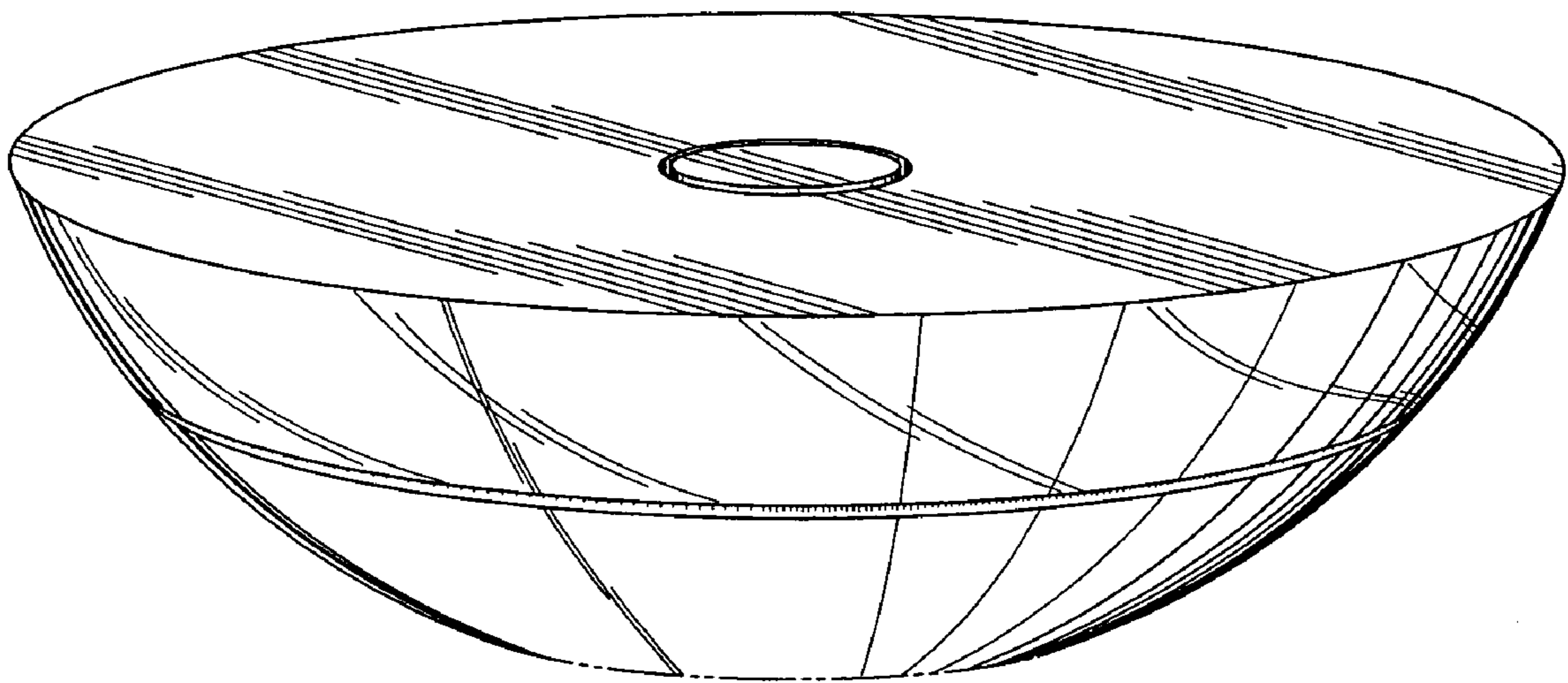

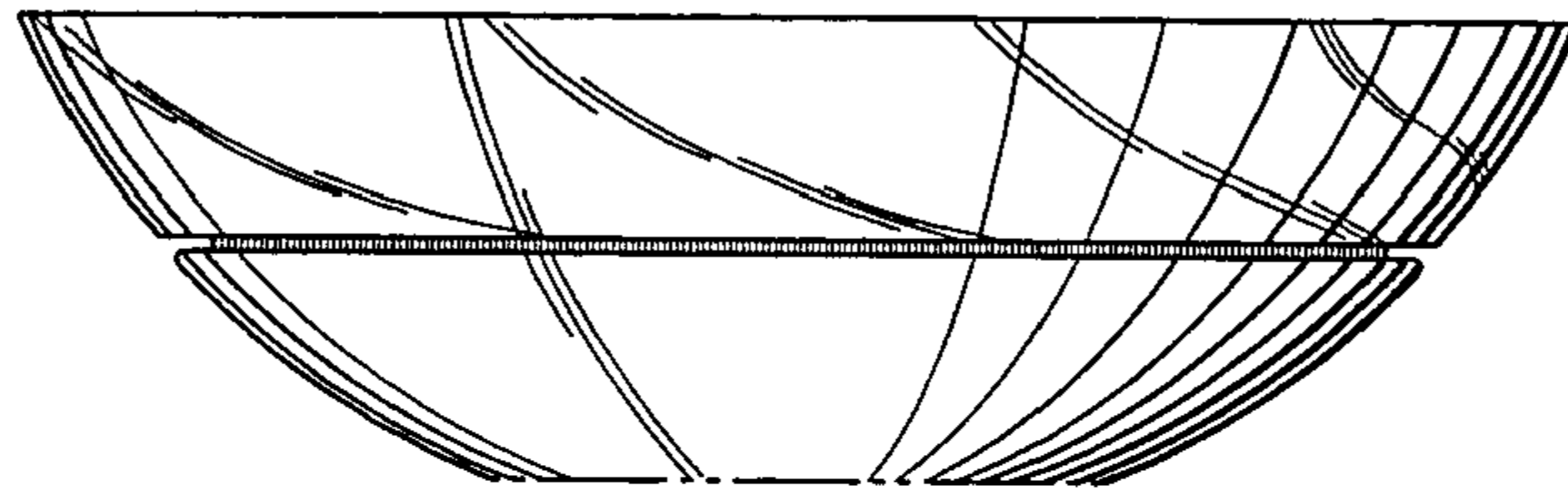

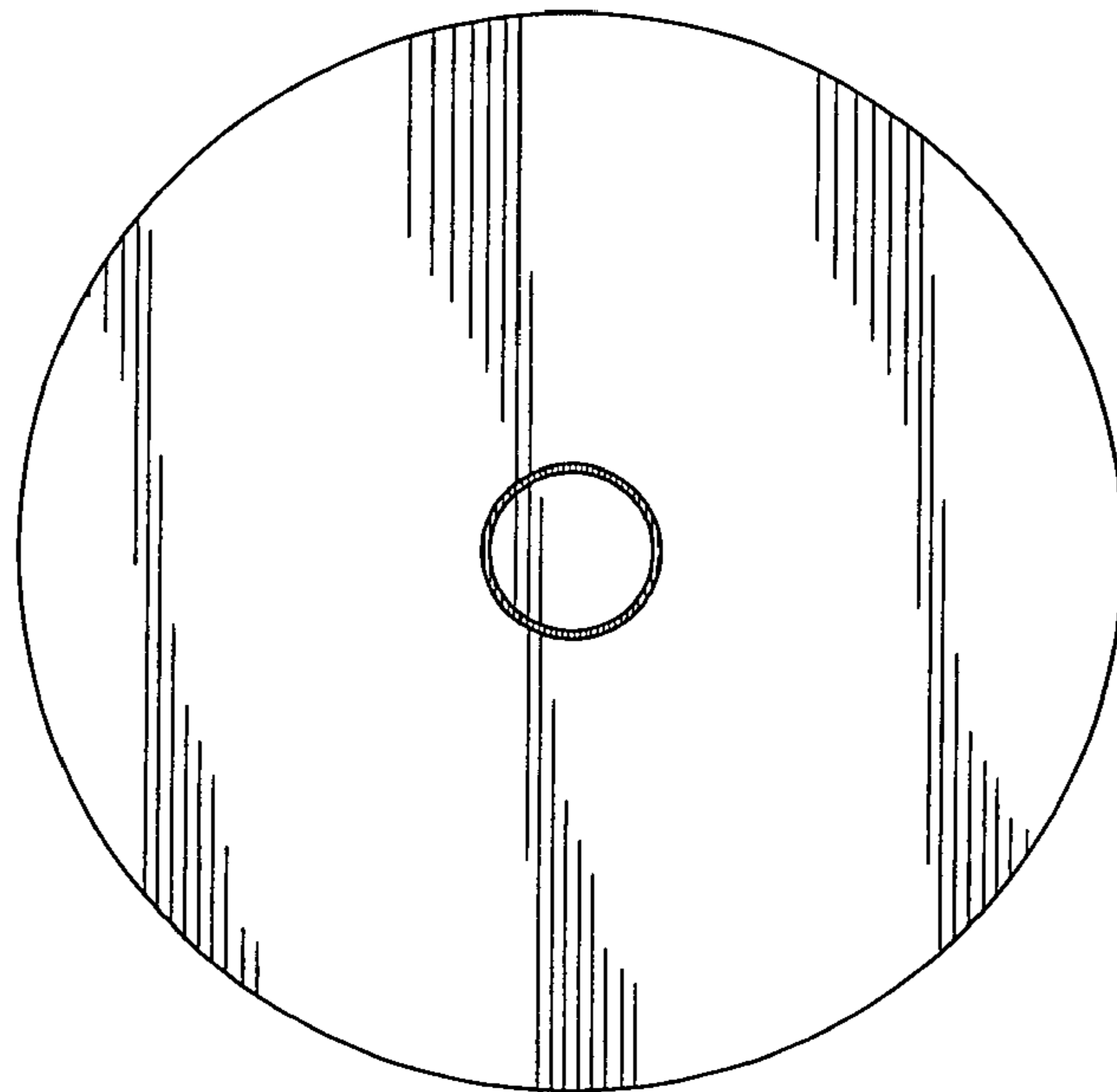

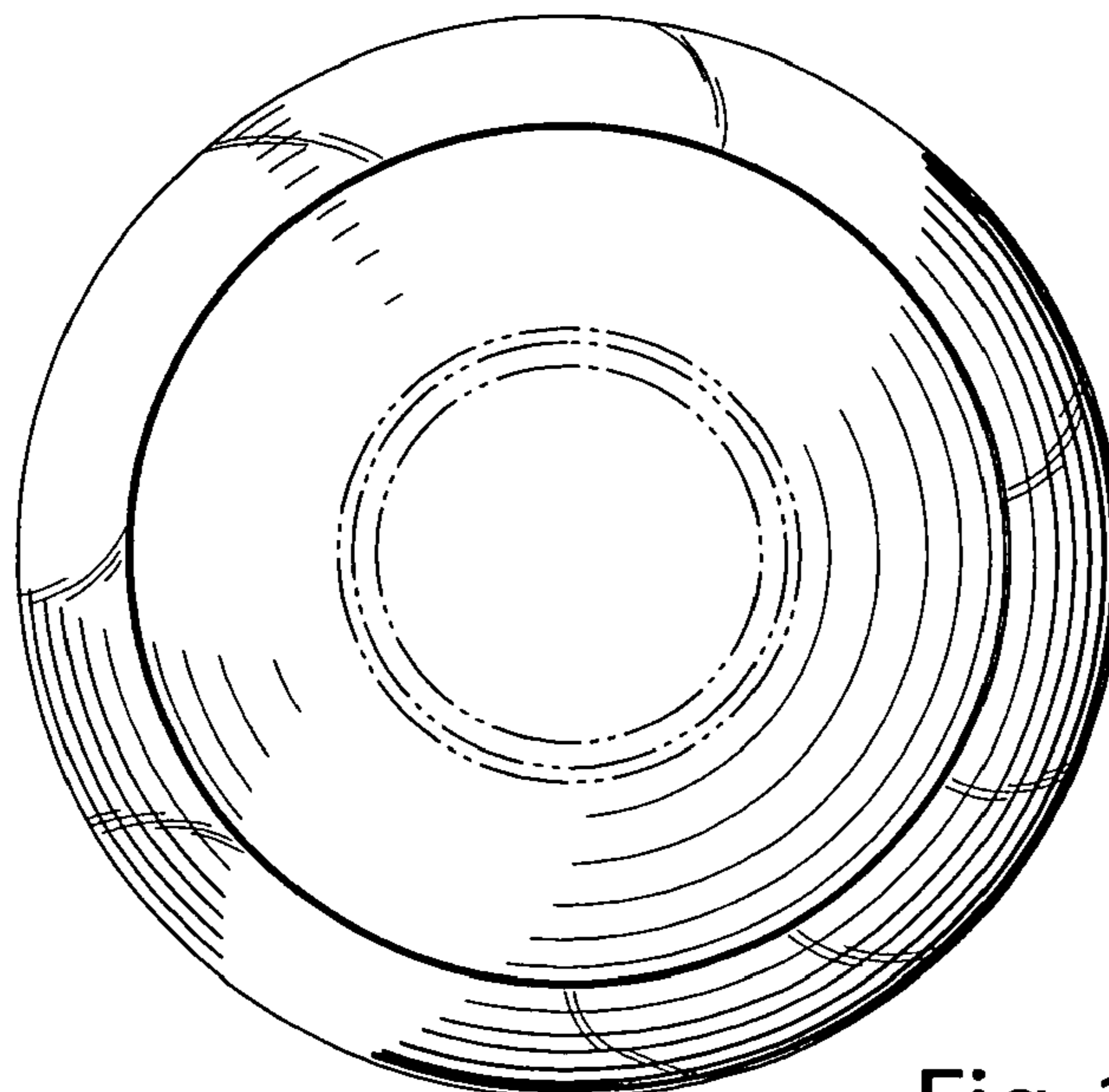

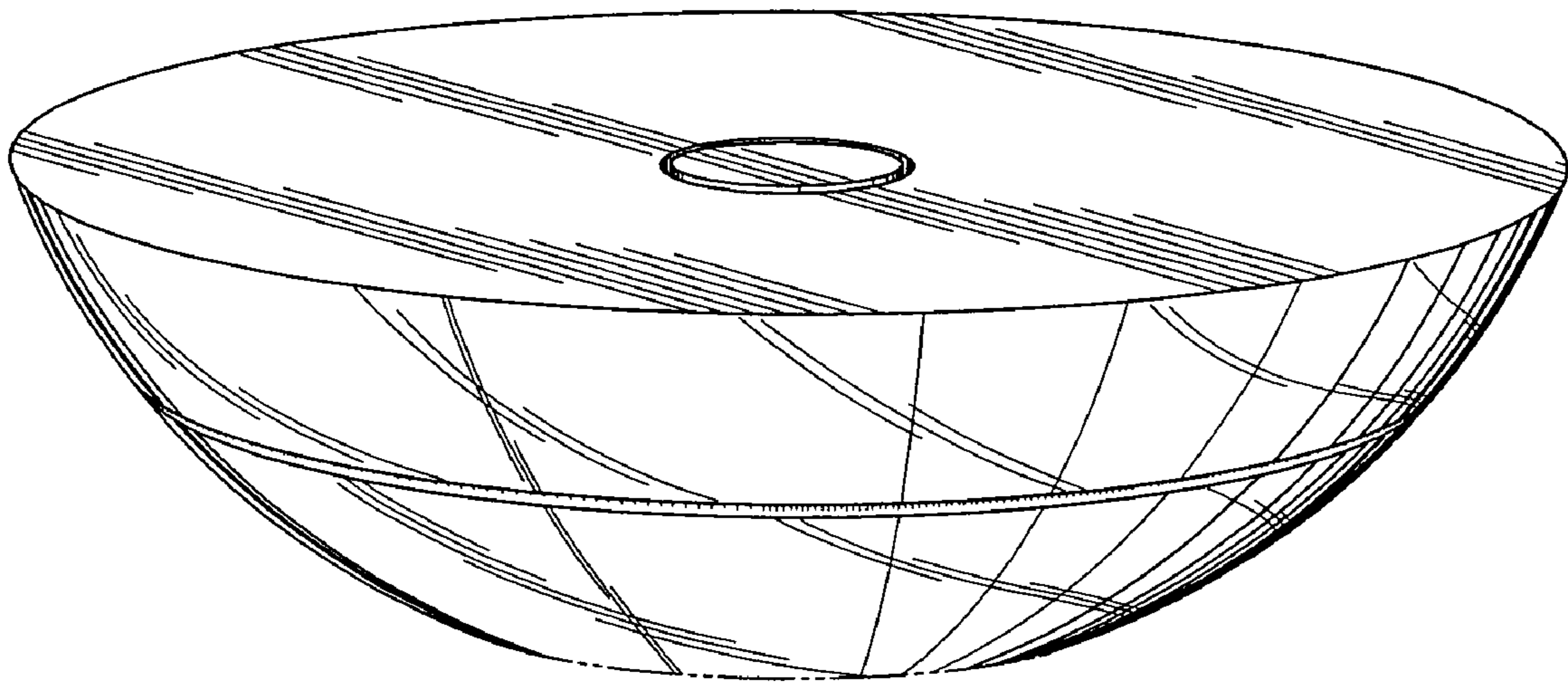

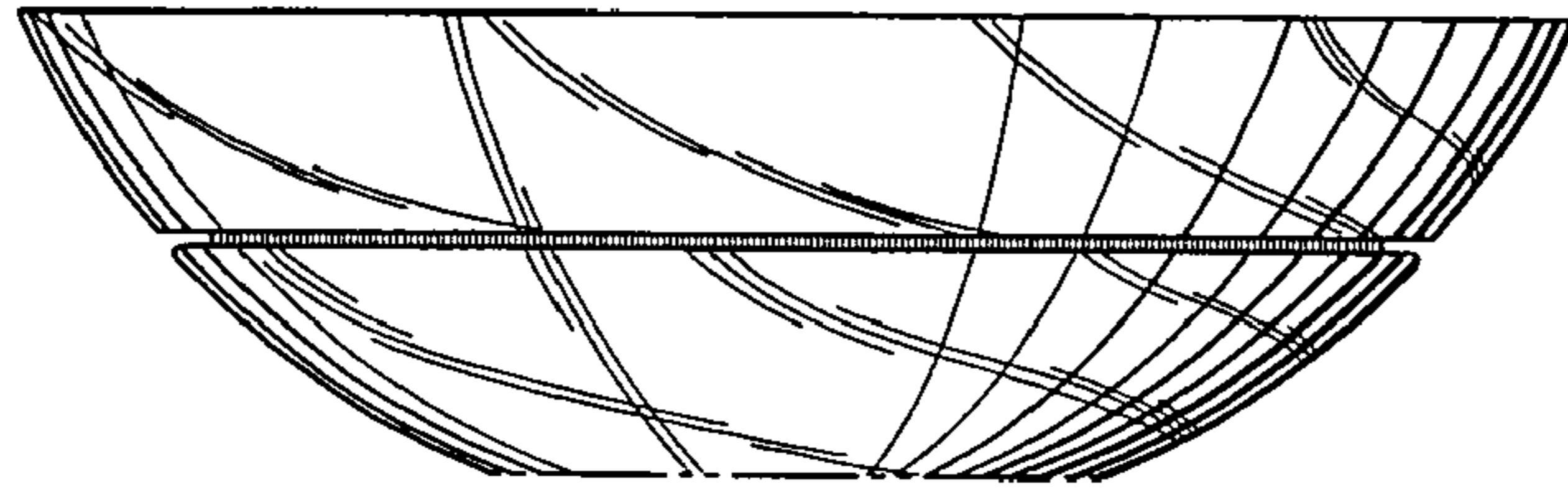

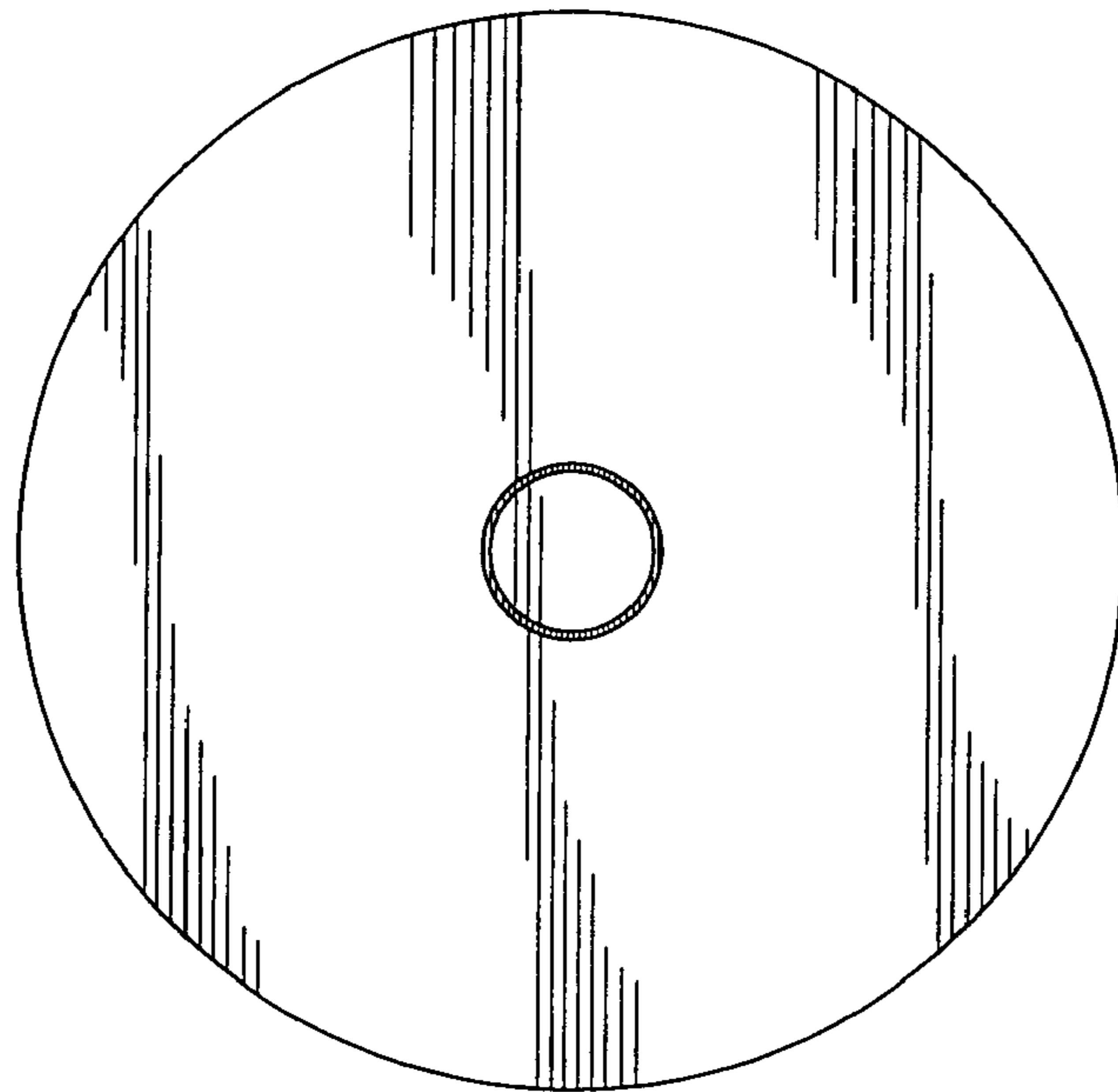

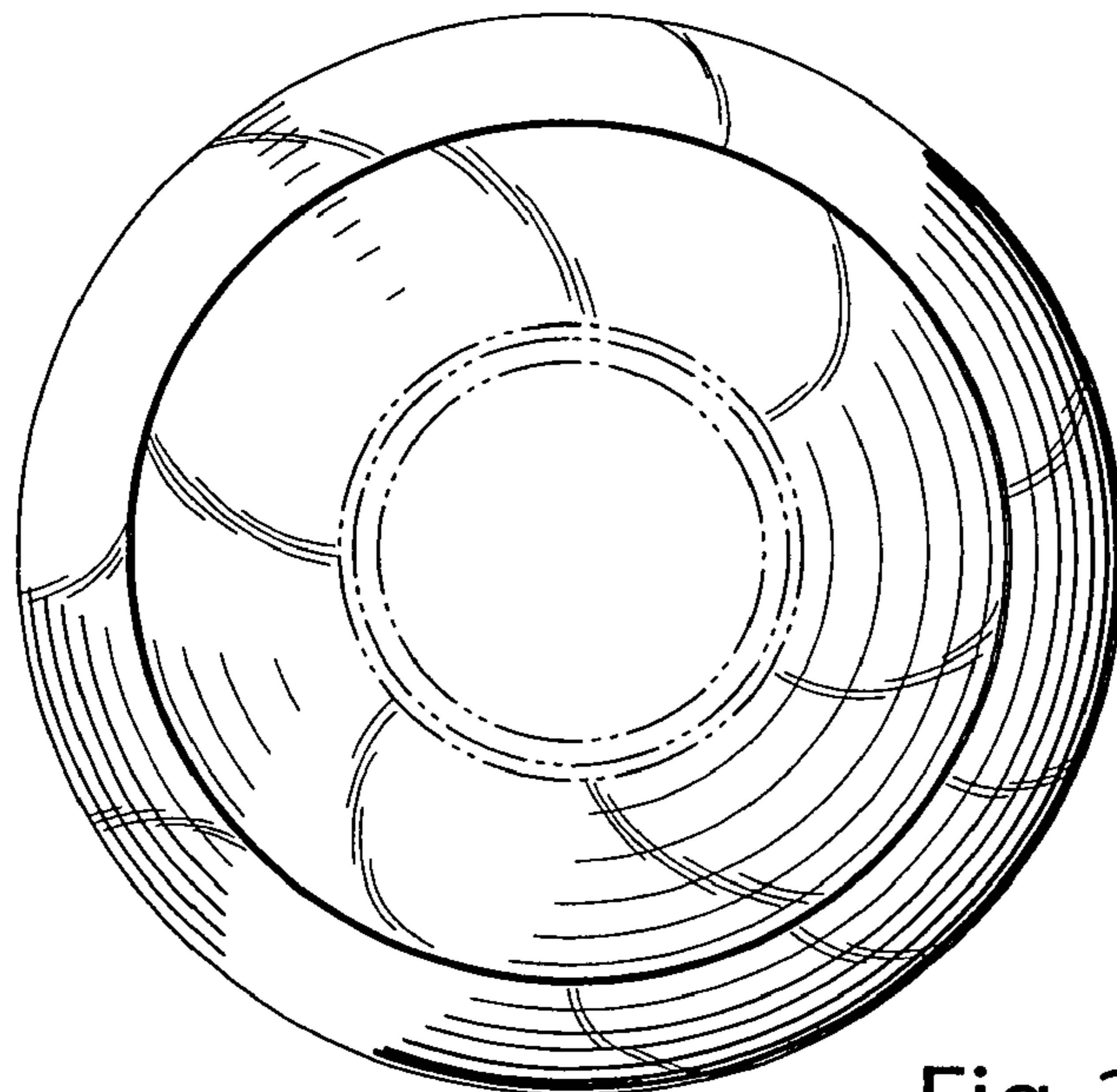

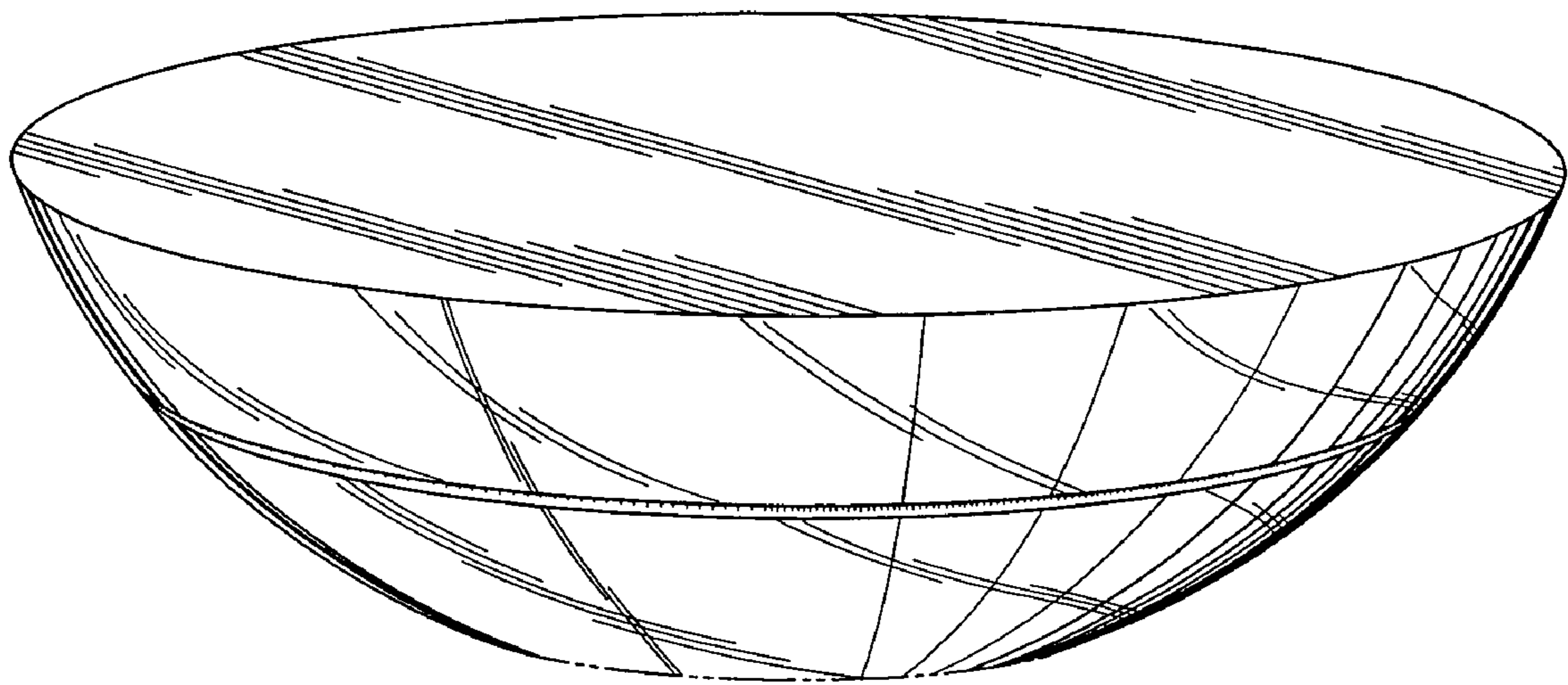

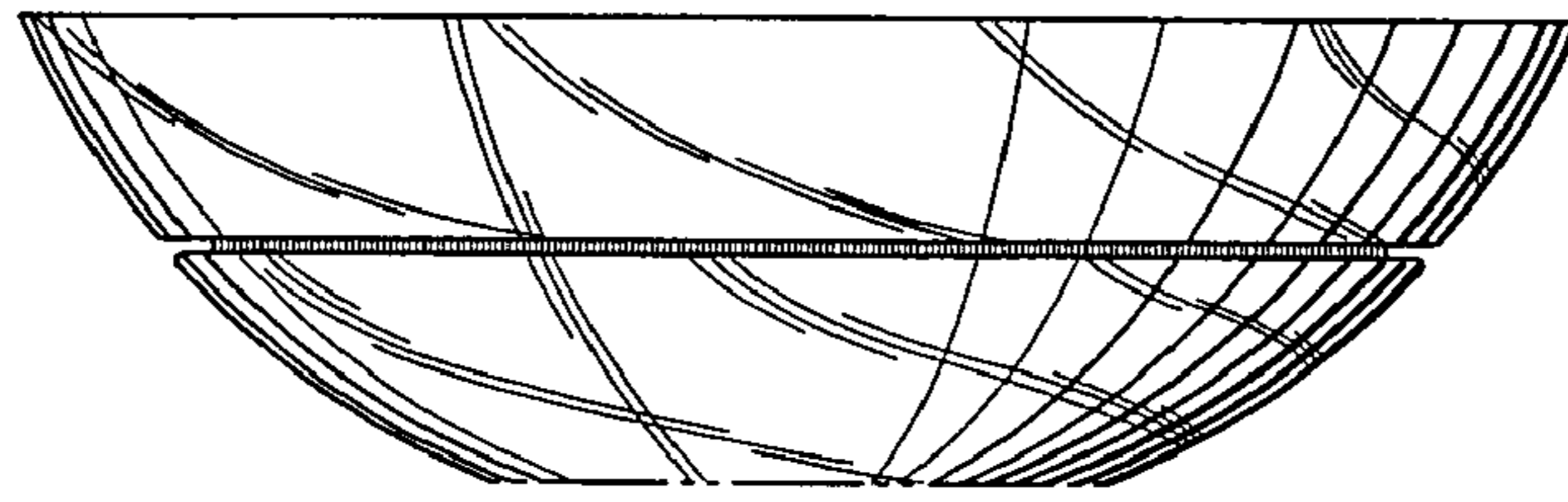

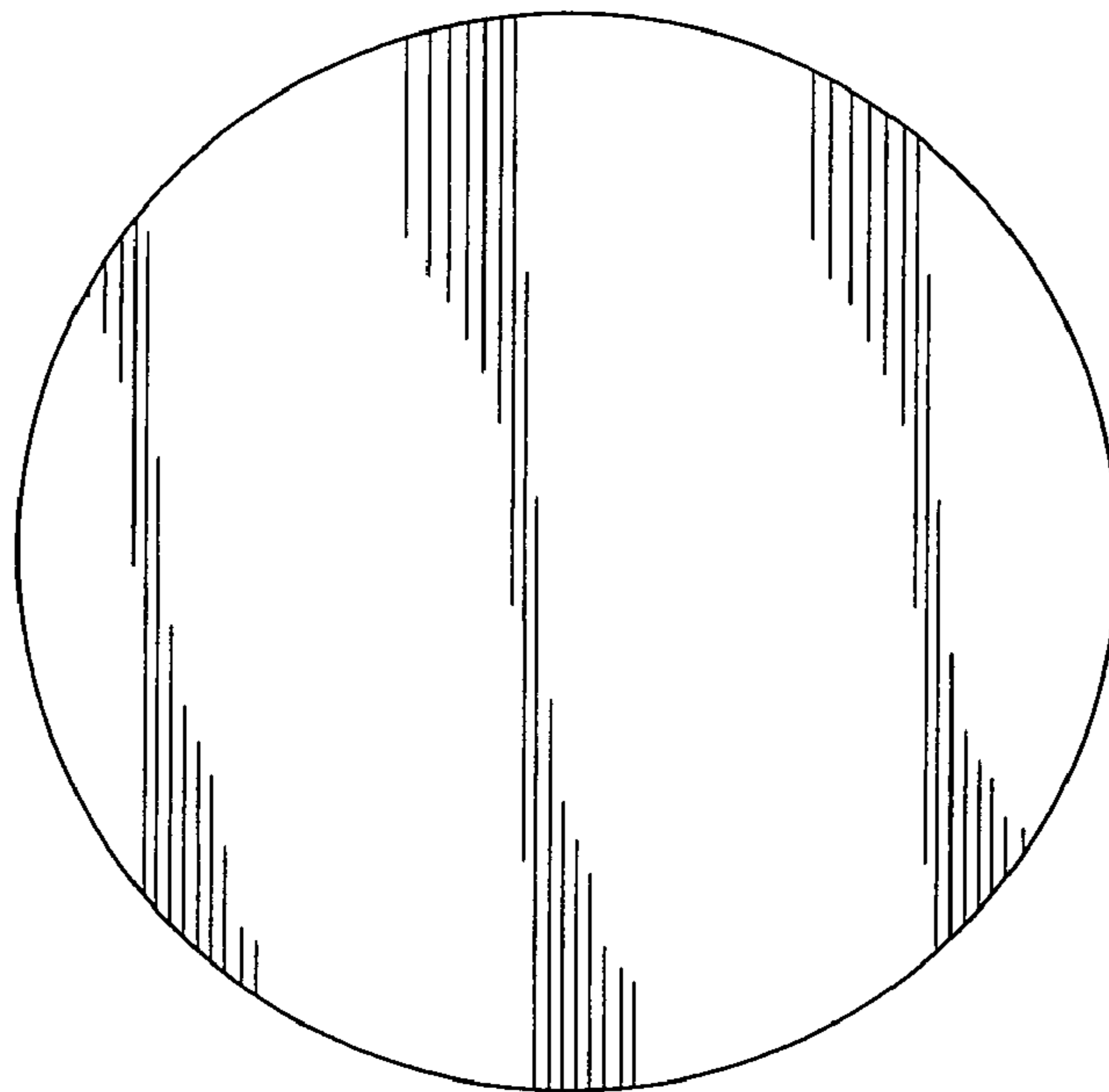

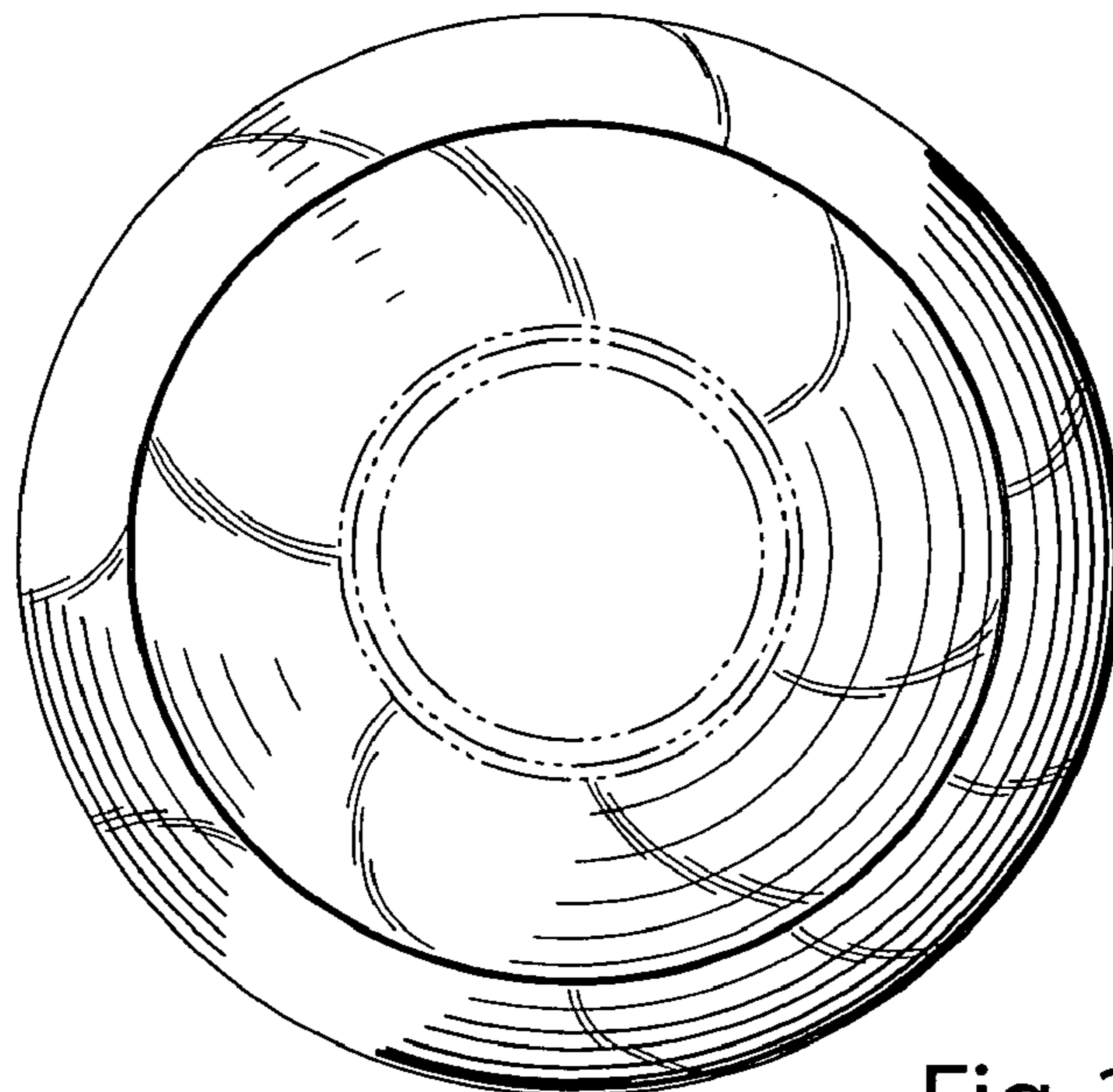
