
The ornamental design for a motorcycle floorboard cover, as shown and described.


DESCRIPTION

- FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the motorcycle floorboard cover of the present invention.
- FIG. 2 is an elevational view of the side of the motorcycle floorboard cover not shown in FIG. 1.
- FIG. 3 is an elevational view of the side of the motorcycle floorboard cover shown in FIG. 1.
- FIG. 4 is an elevational view of the end of the motorcycle floorboard cover not shown in FIG. 1.
- FIG. 5 is an elevational view of the end of the motorcycle floorboard cover shown in FIG. 1.
- FIG. 6 is a top plan view of the motorcycle floorboard cover of FIG. 1; and,













