The ornamental design for a supporter for monitor or television, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 10 is a left side elevational view thereof, wherein a back face portion of a supporter for monitor or television is lifted up;

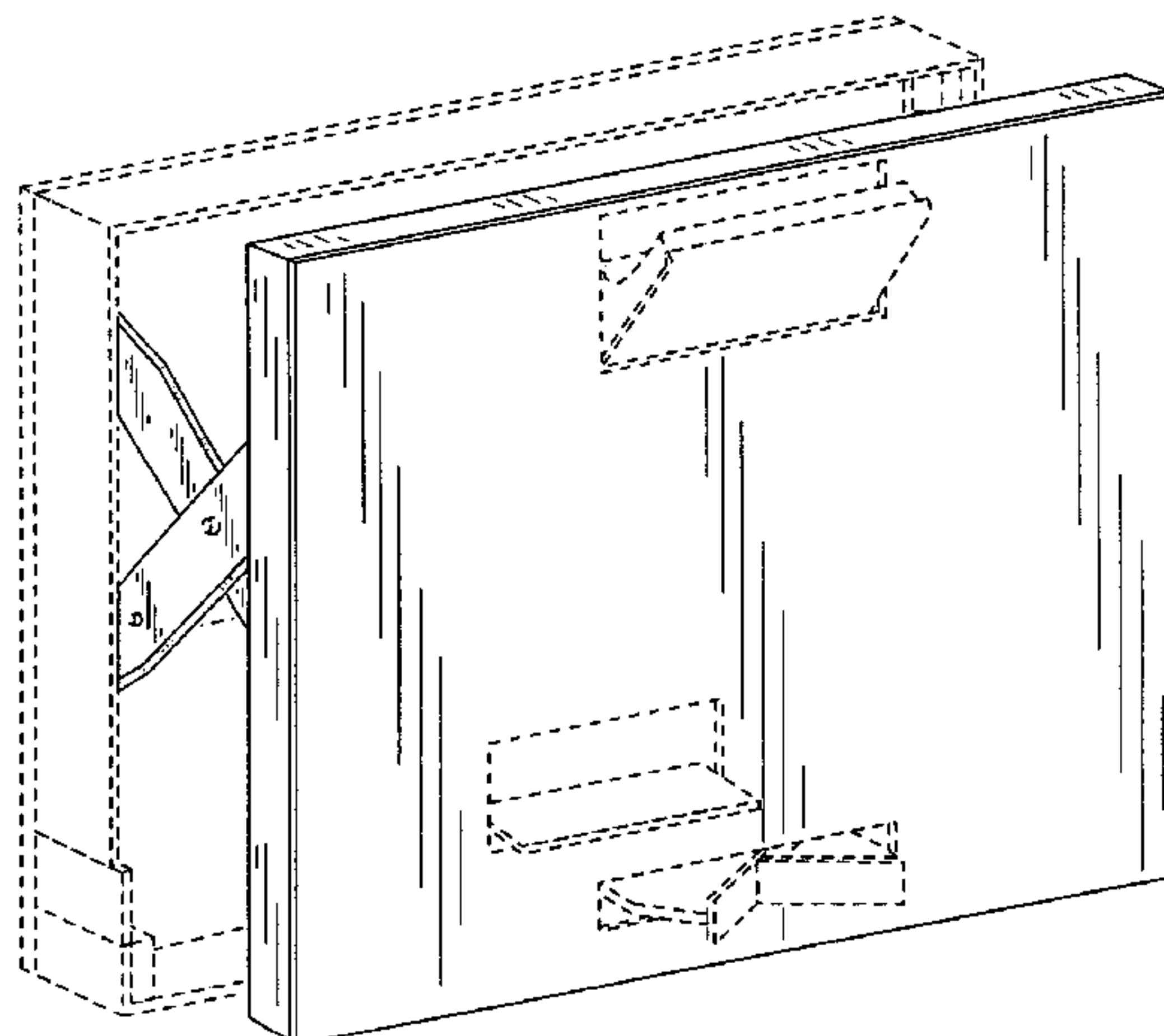


FIG. 11 is a top plan view thereof, wherein a back face portion of a supporter for monitor or television is lifted up;

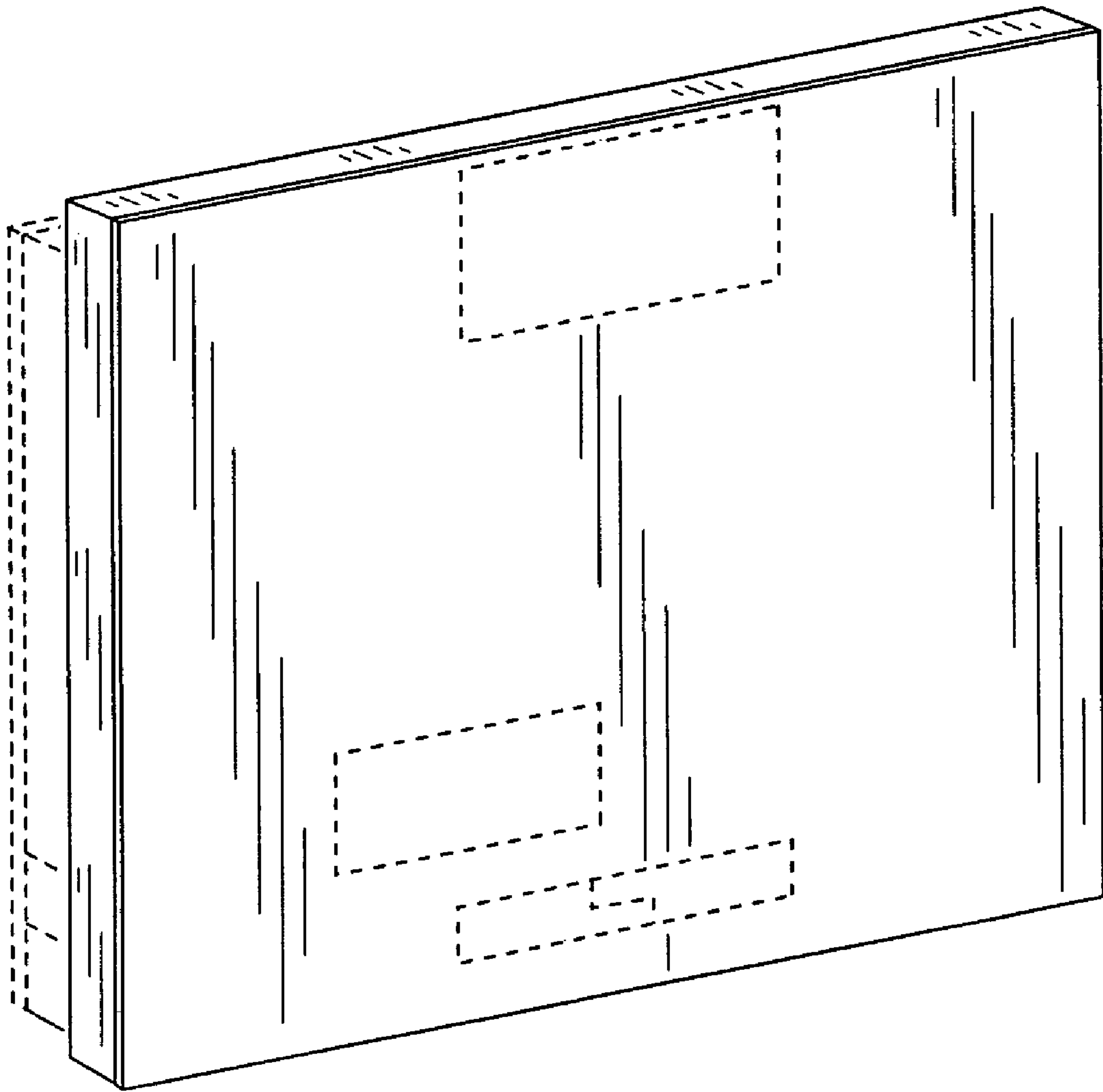

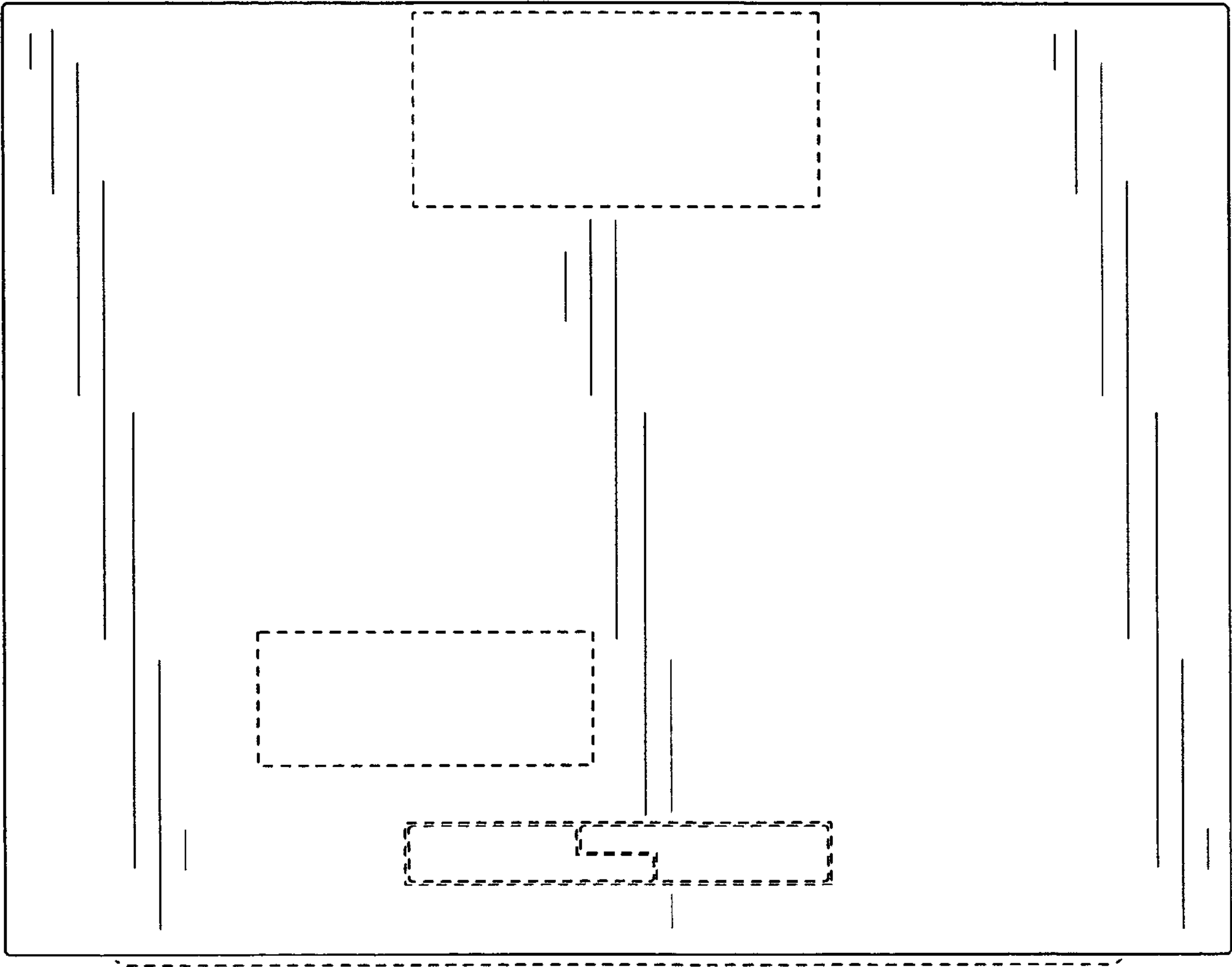

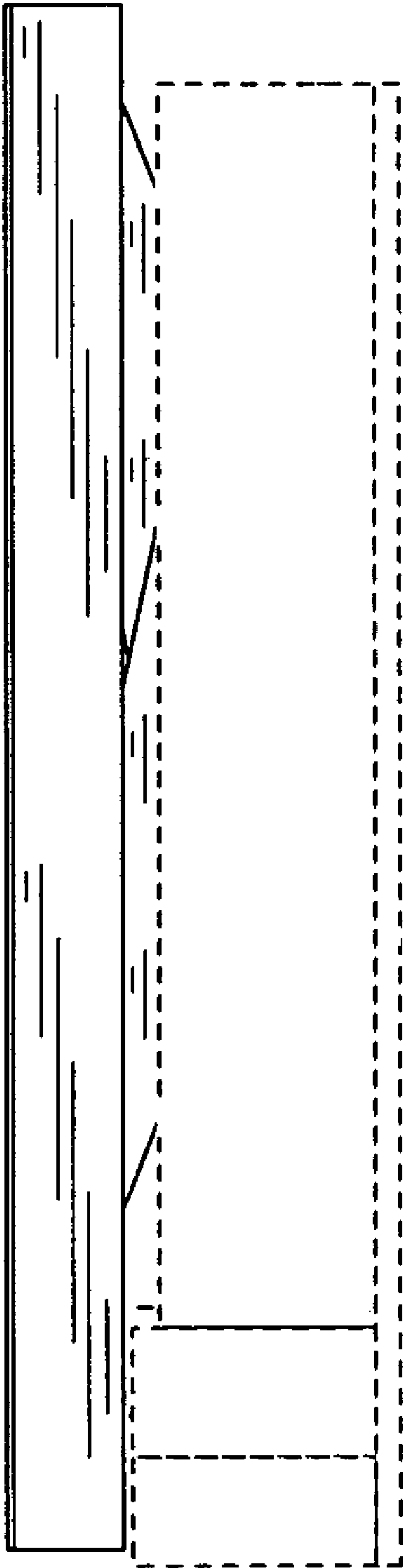

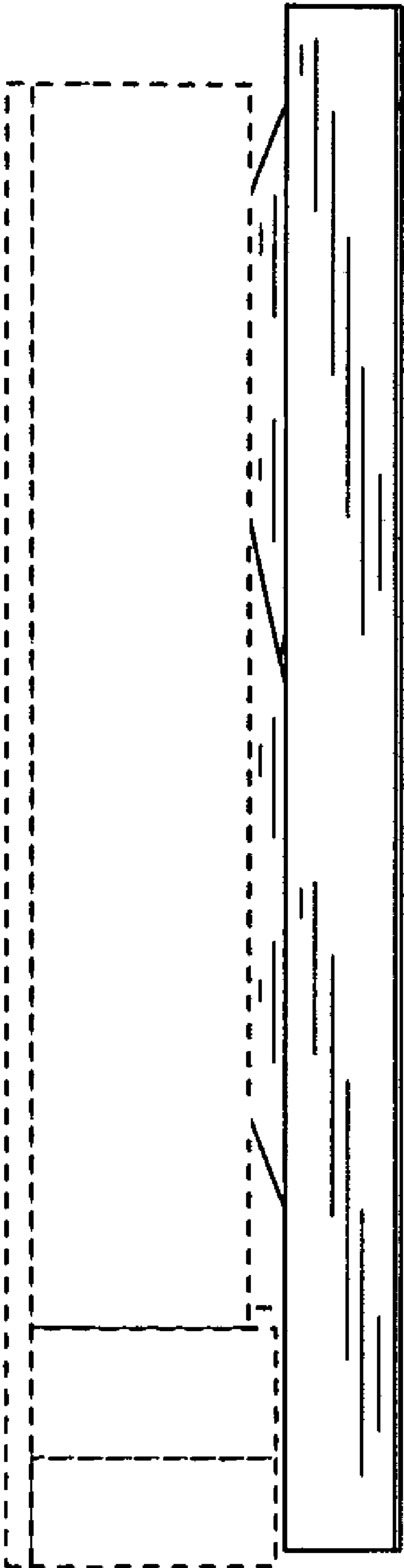

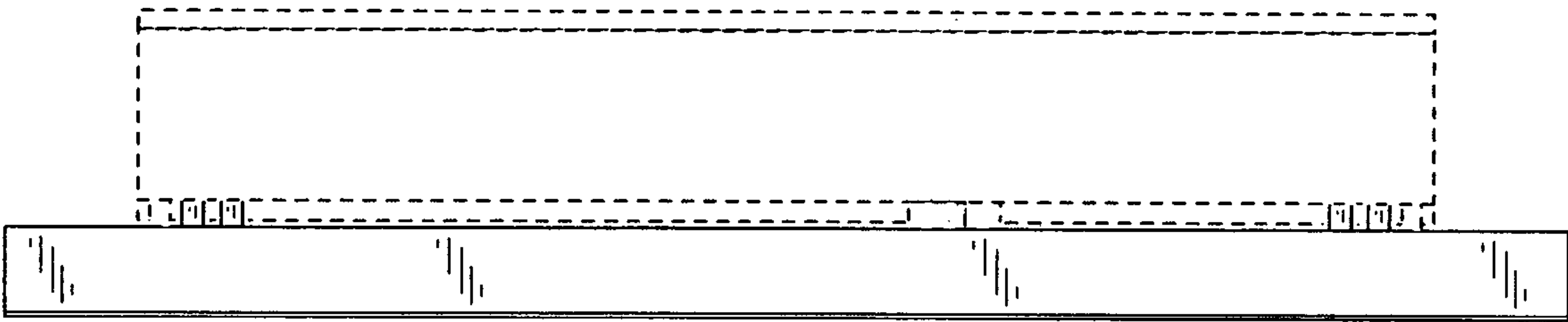

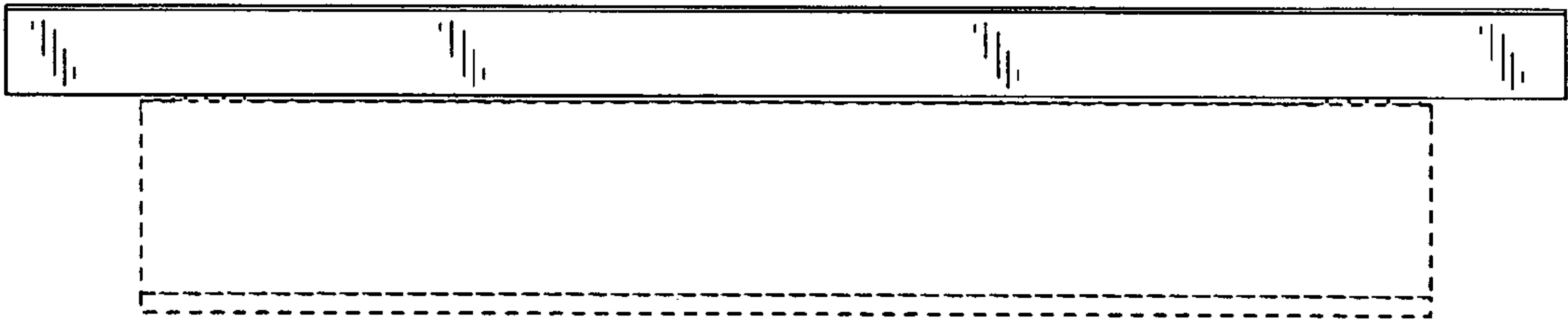

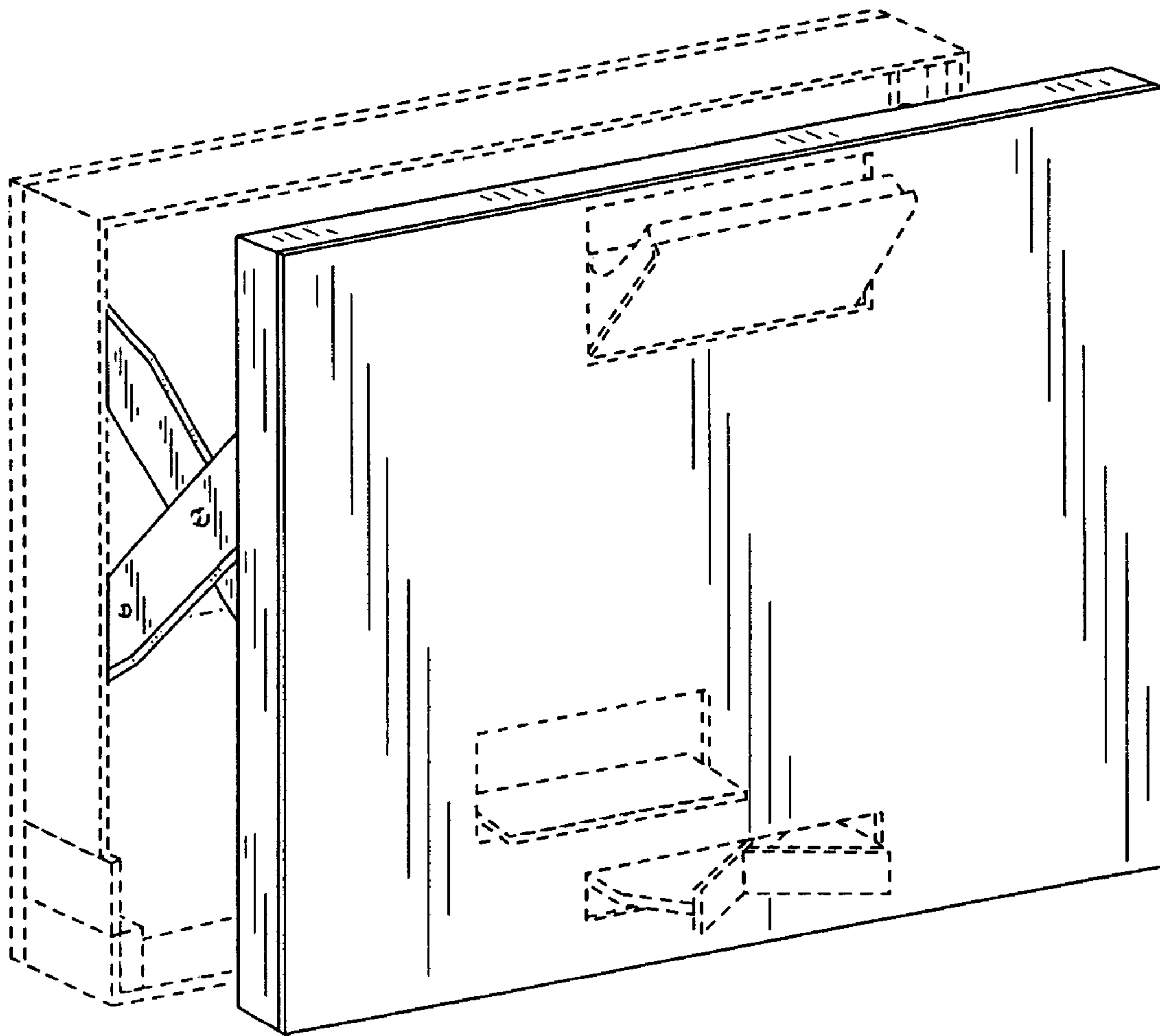

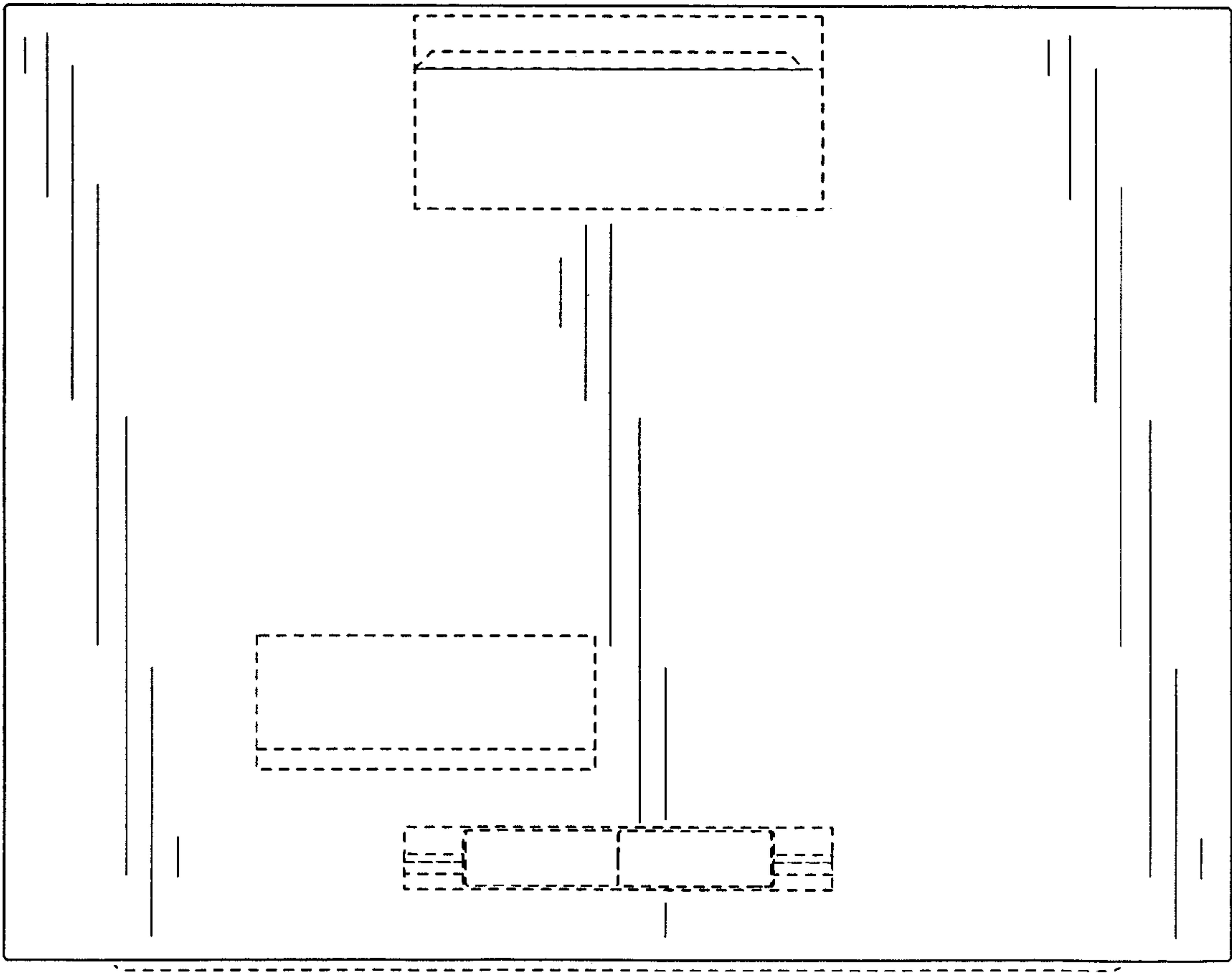

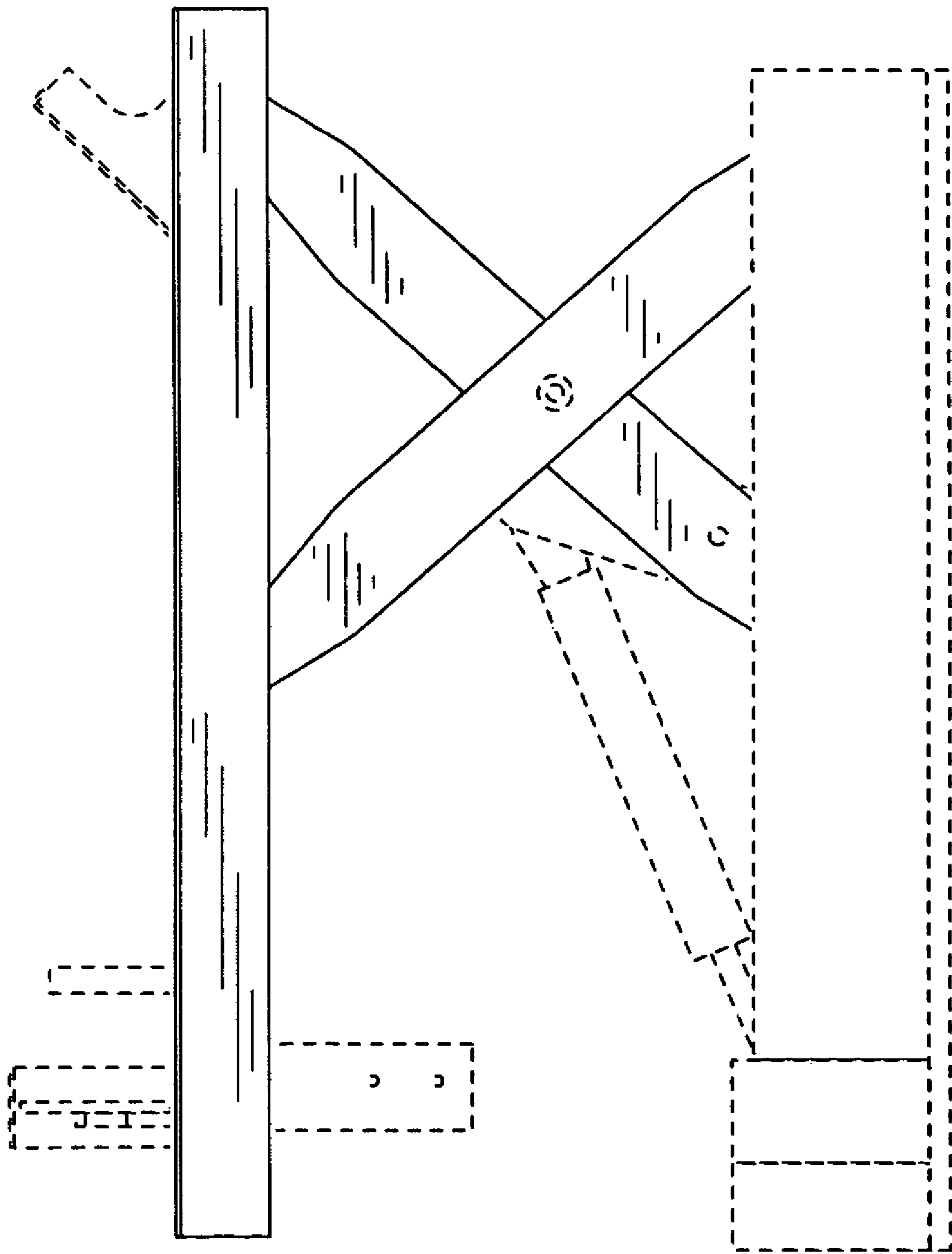

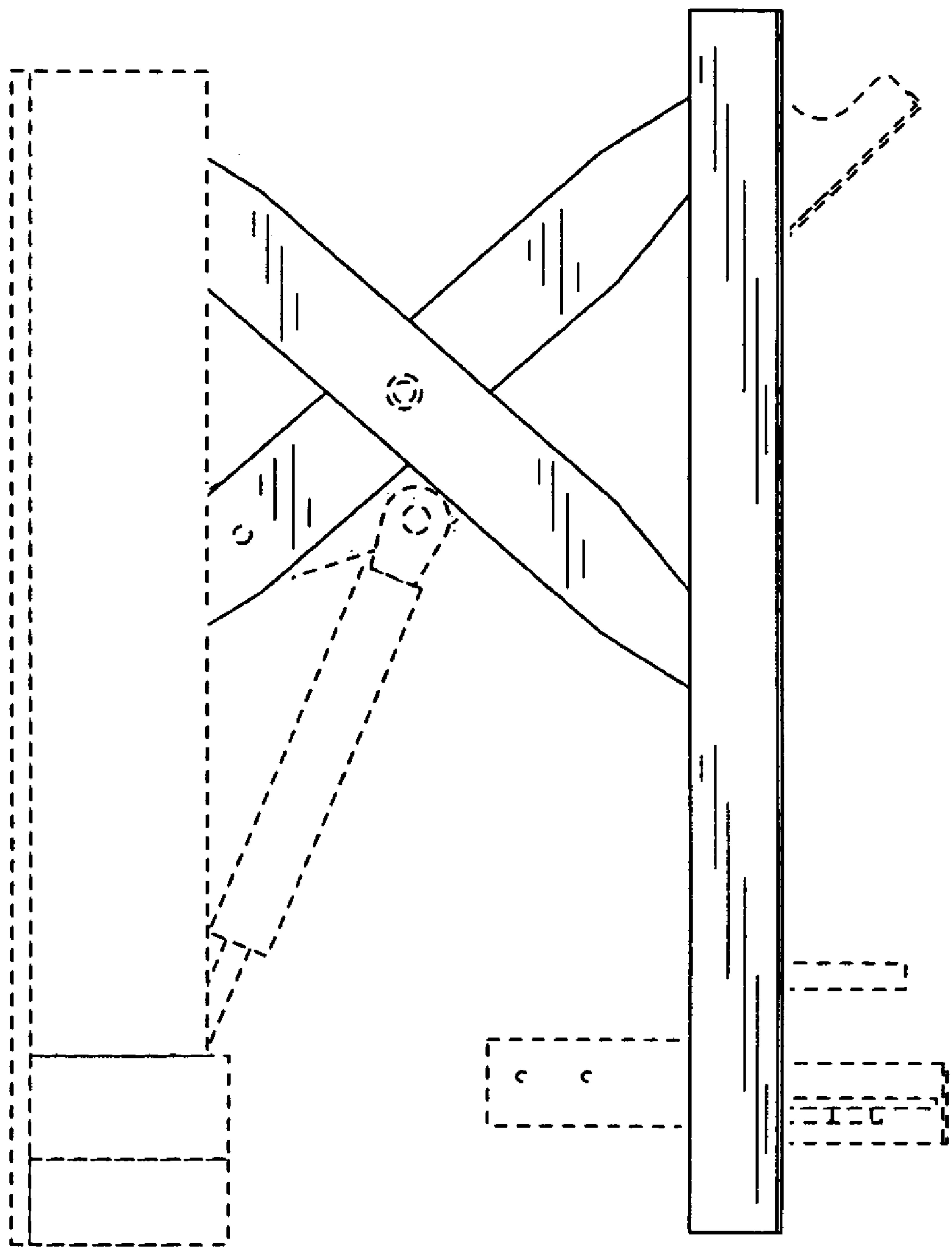

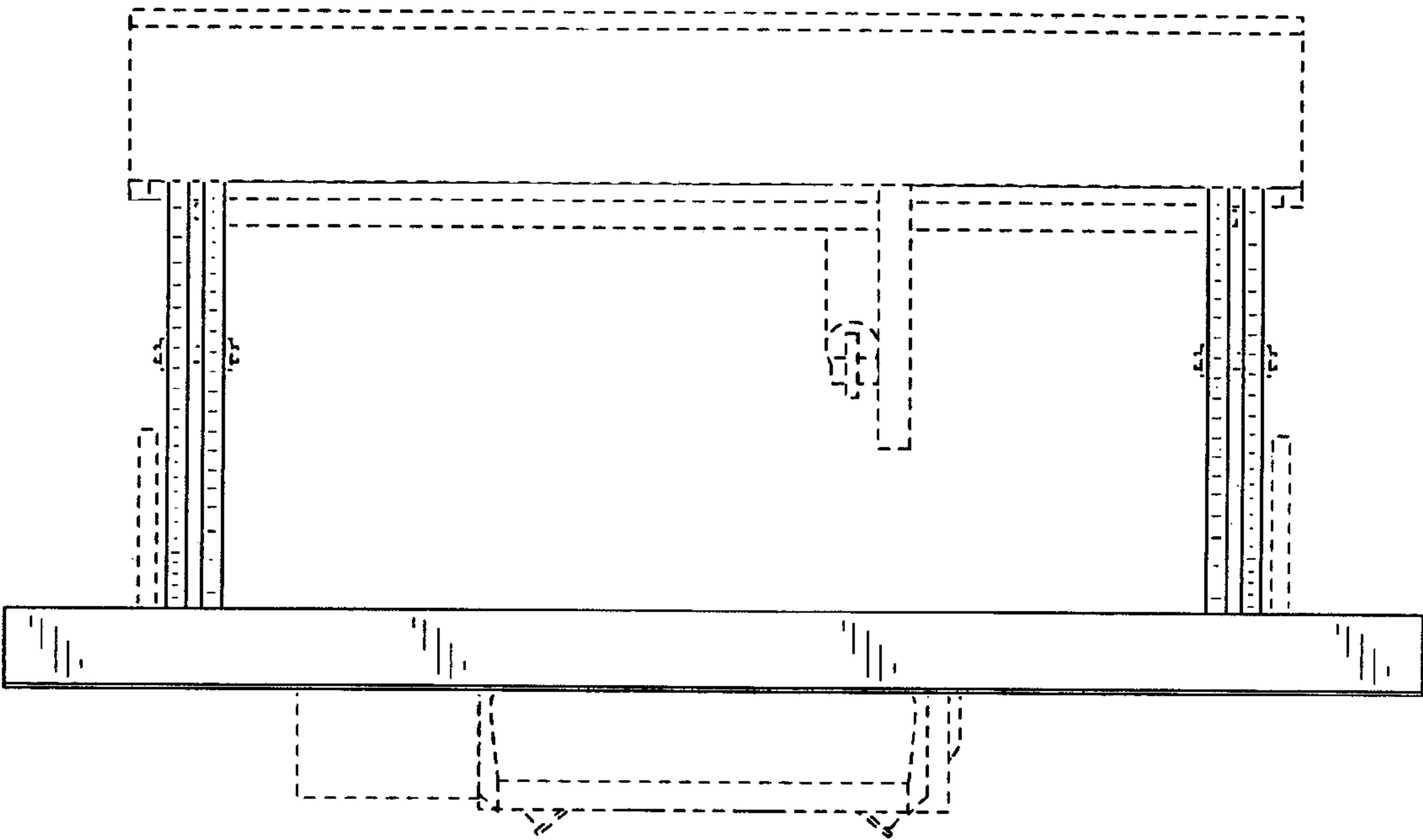

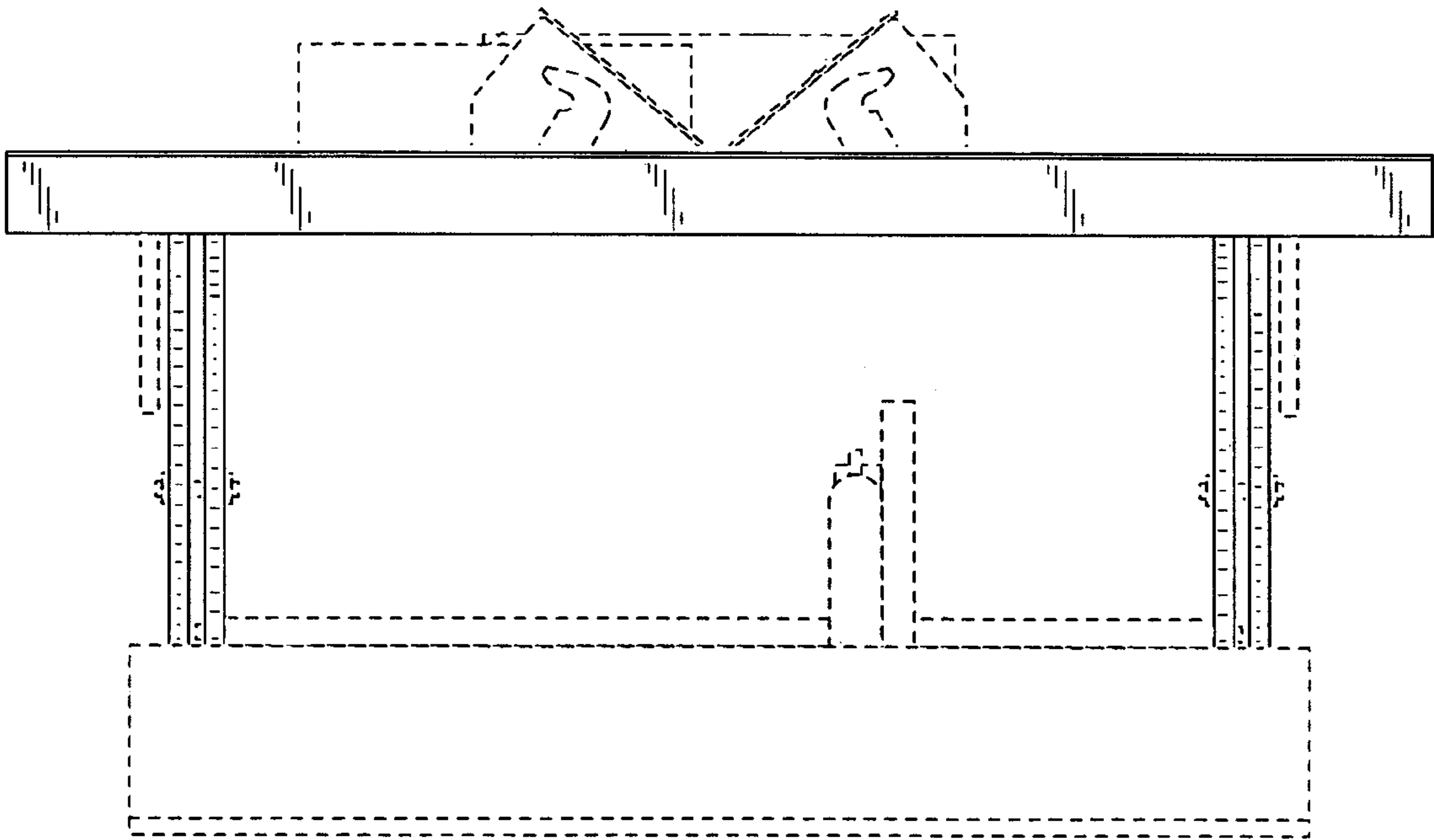

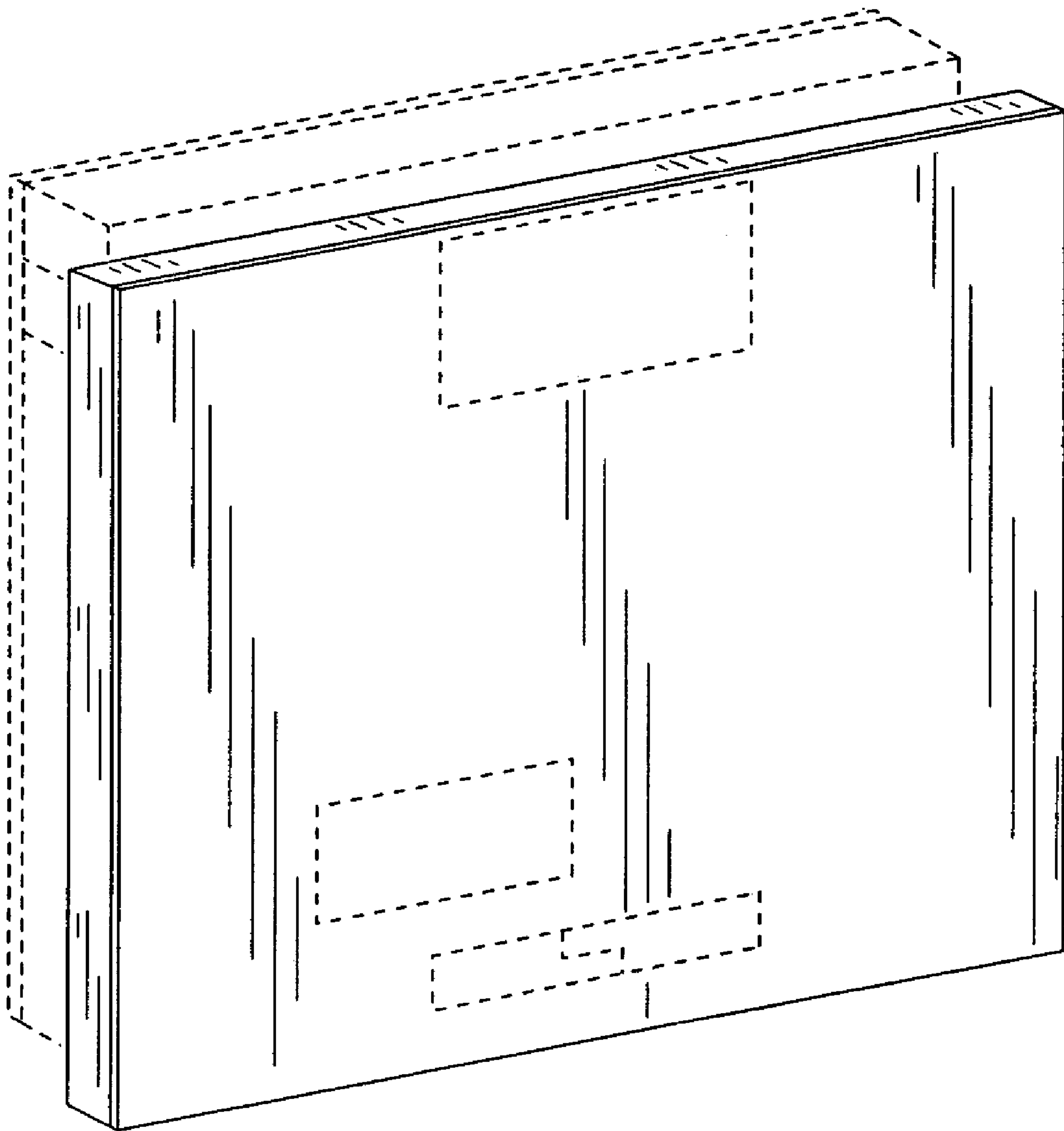

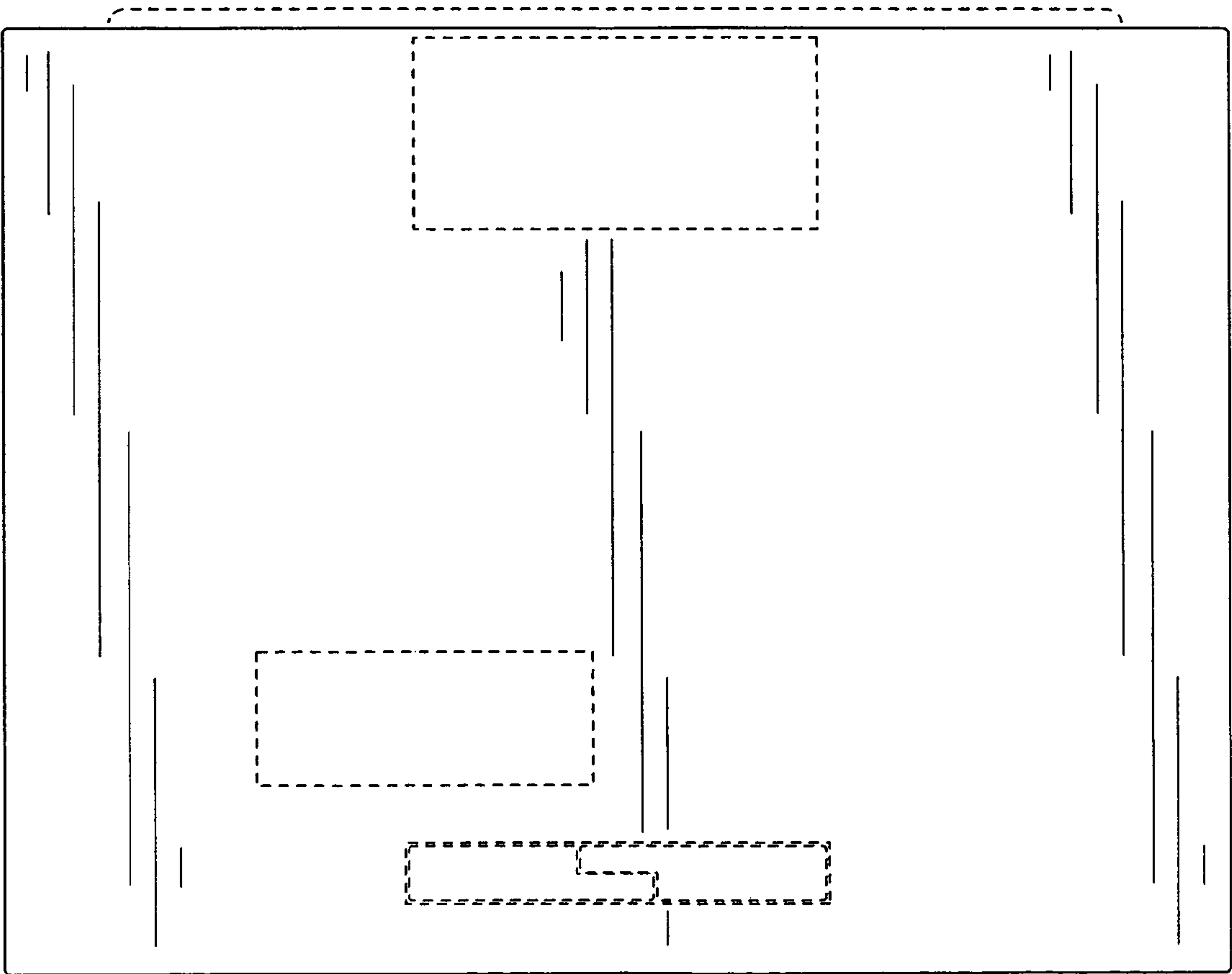

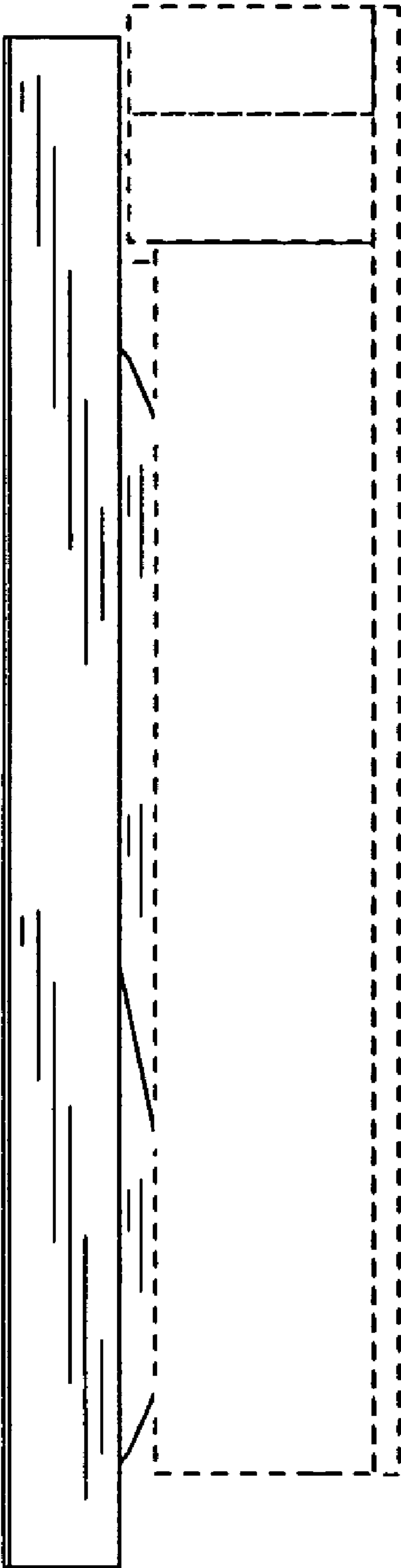

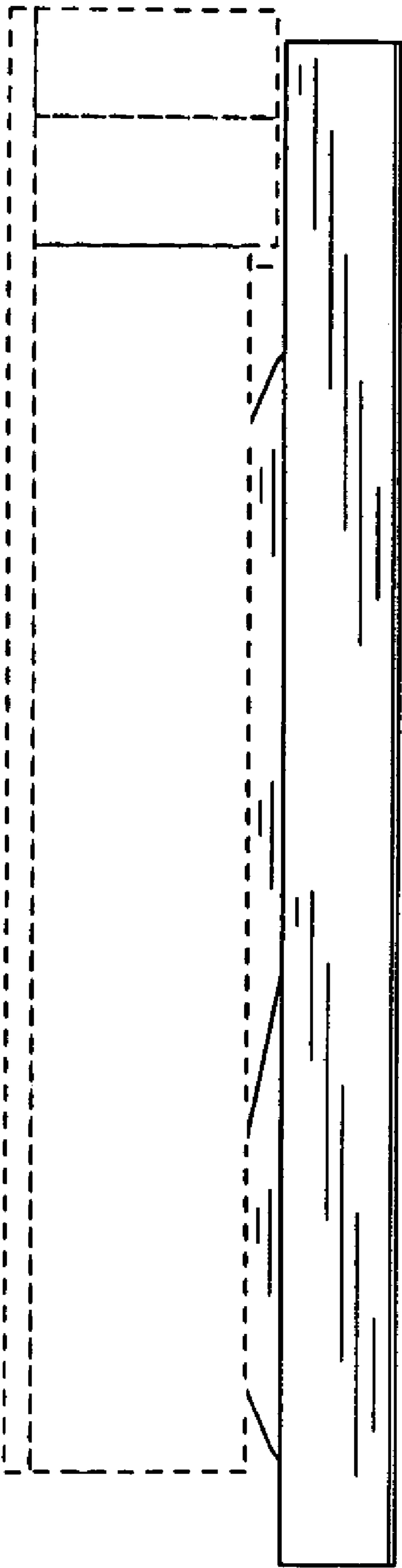

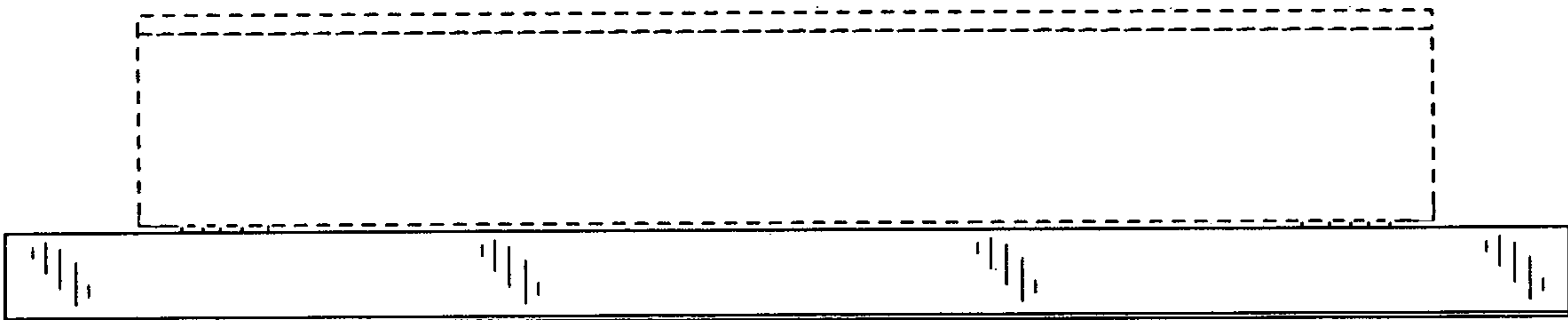

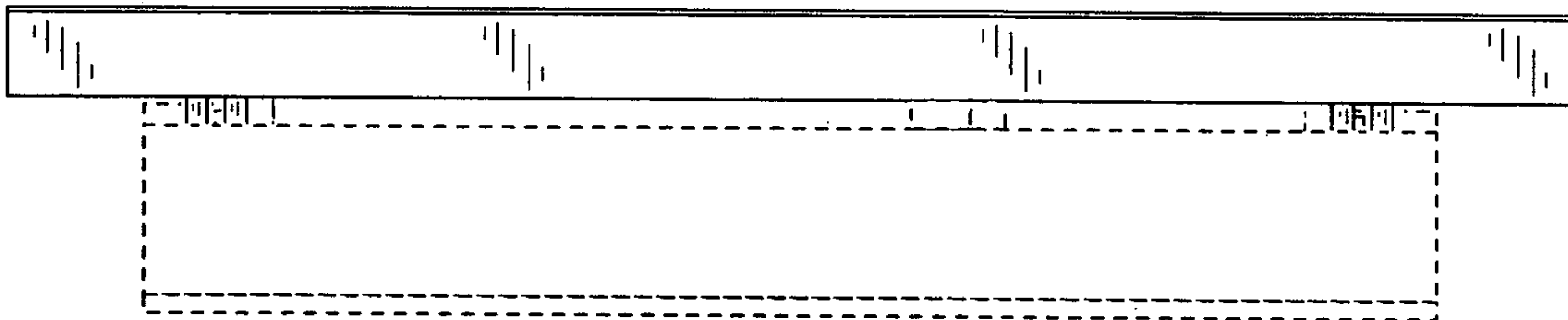

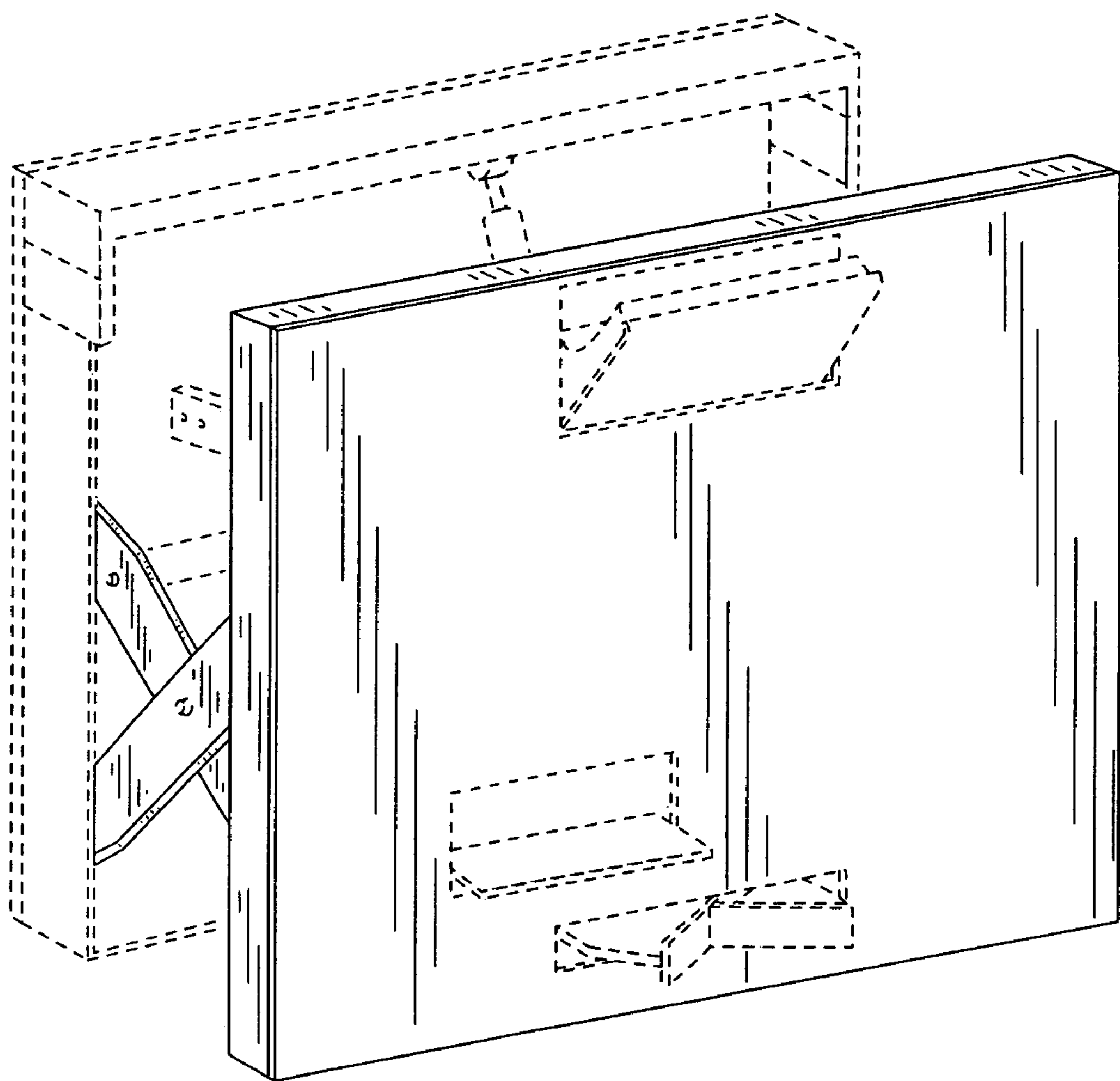

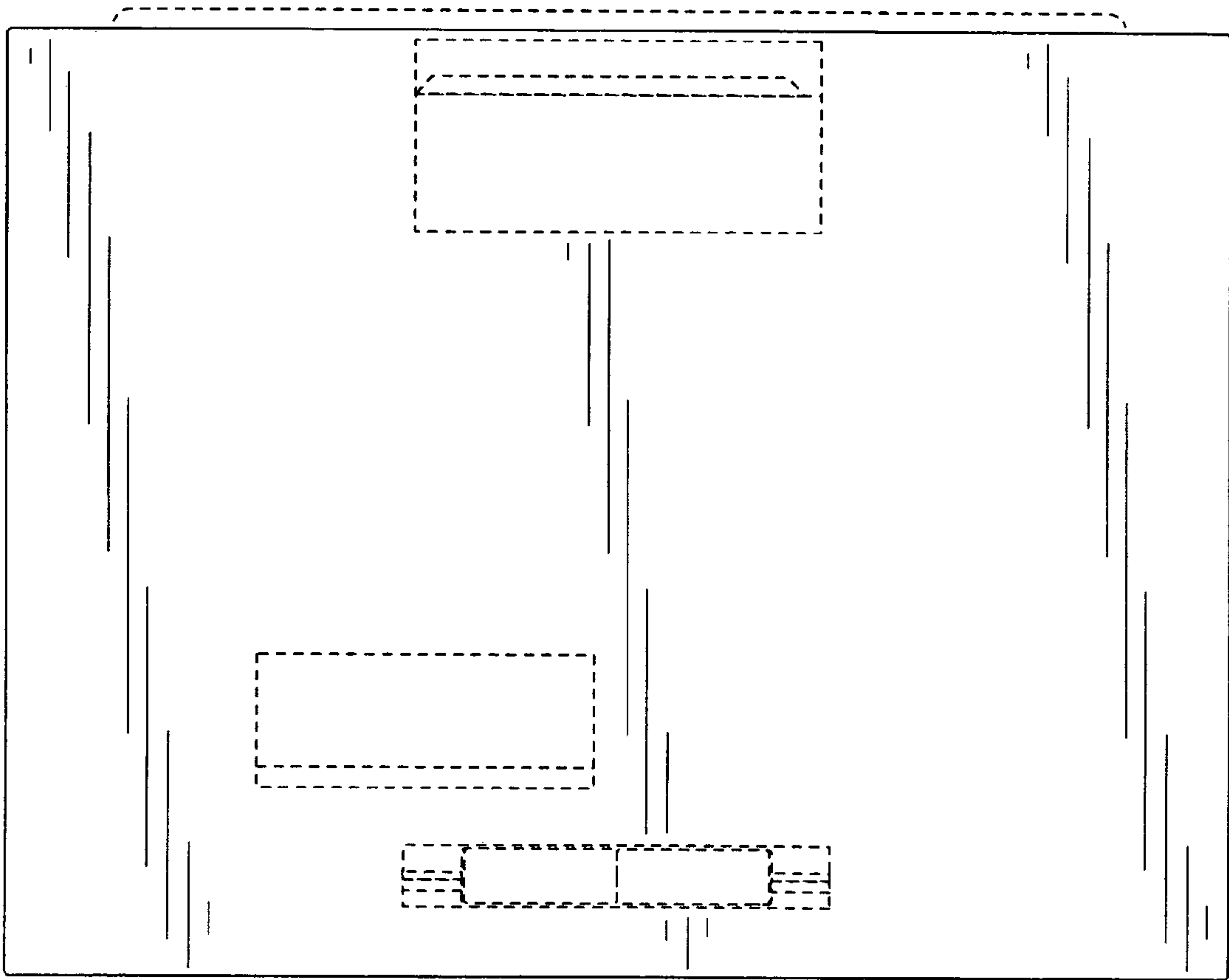

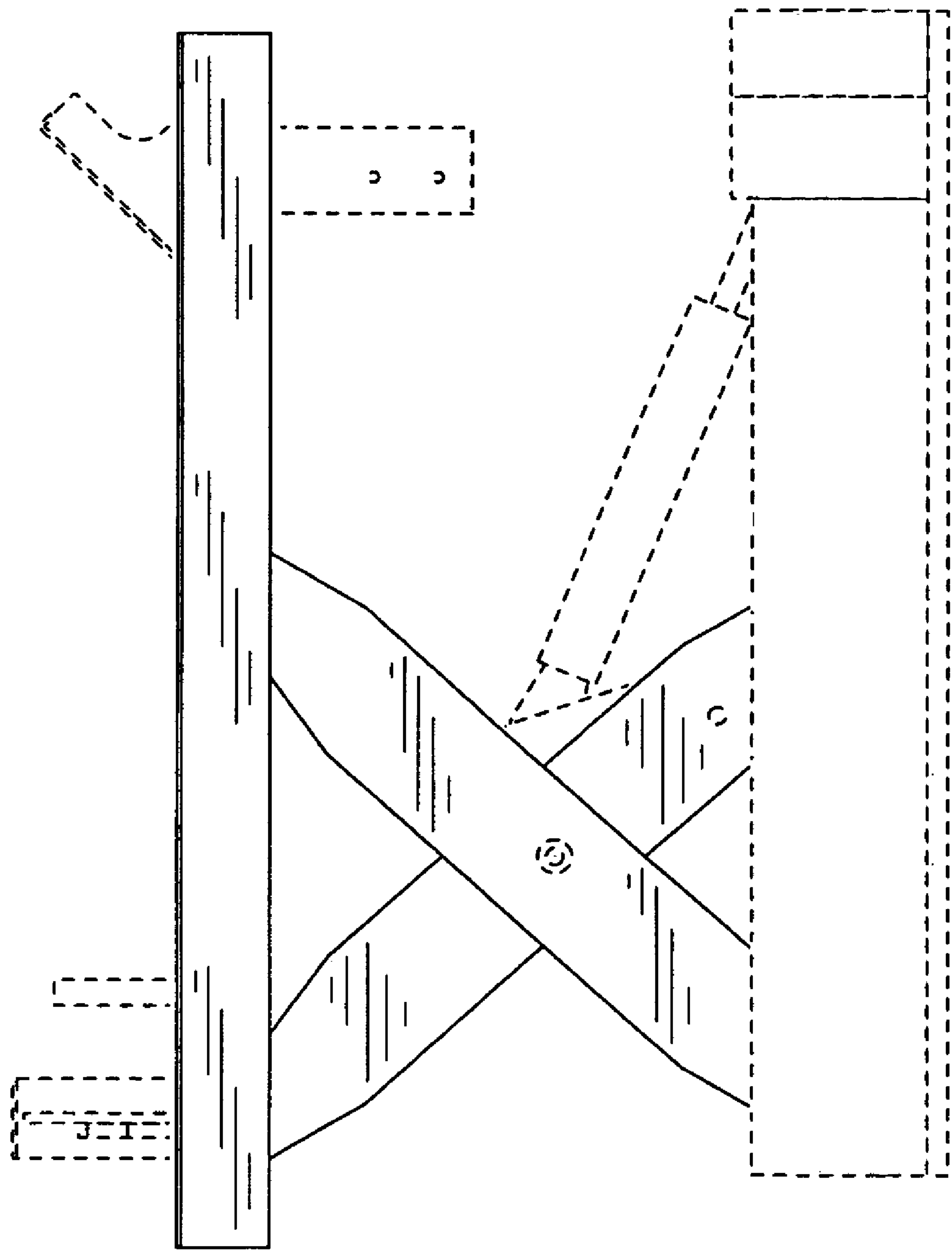

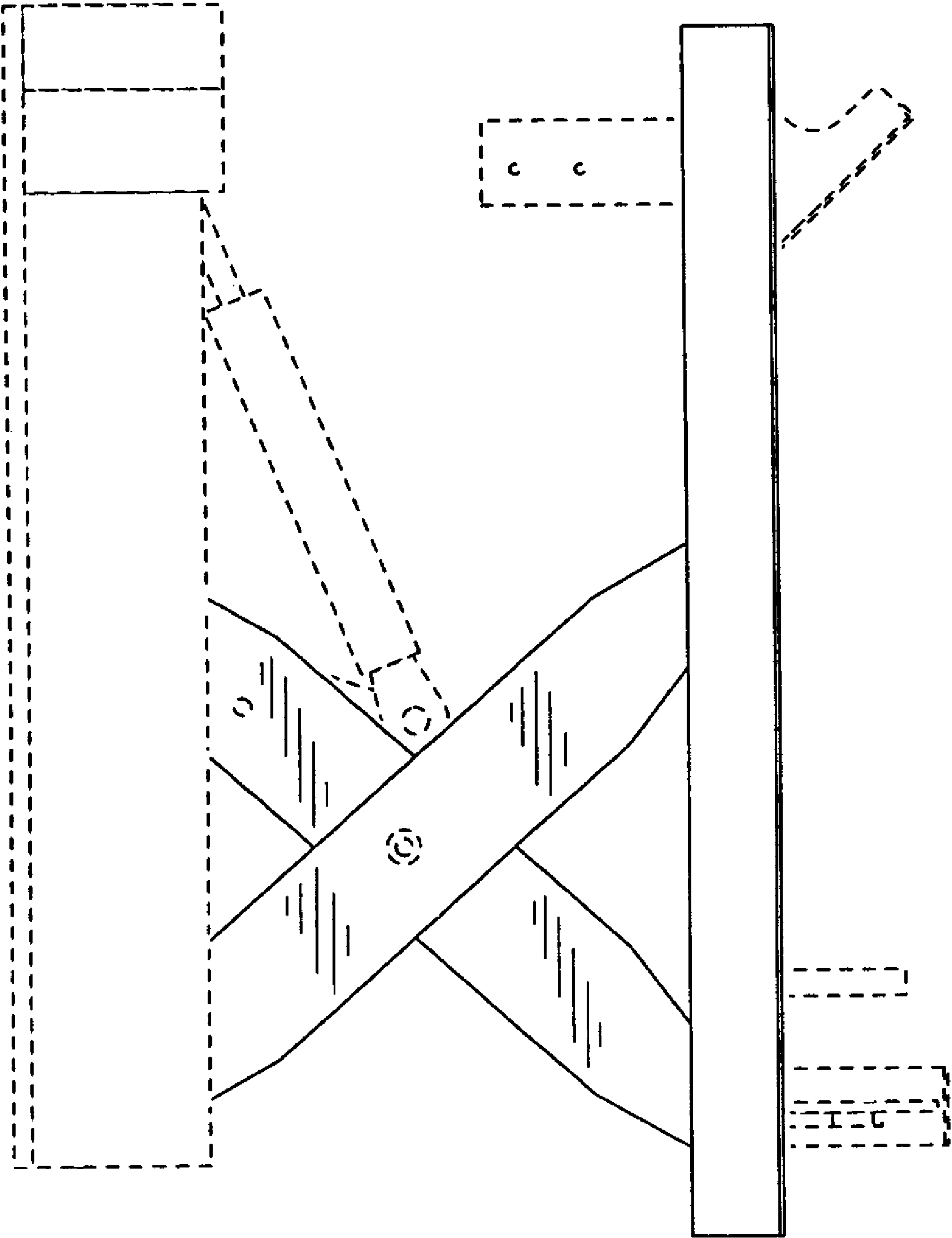

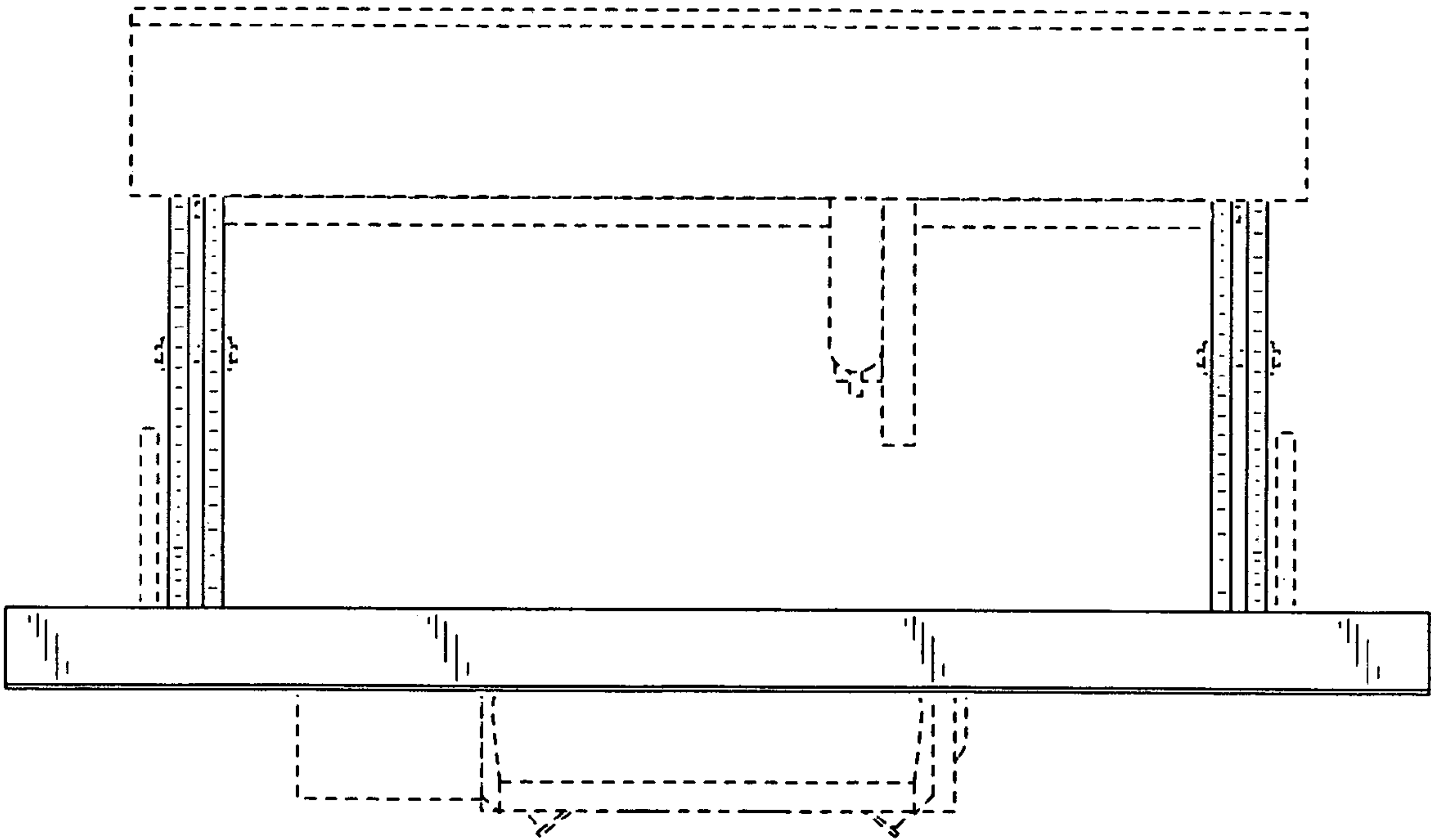
