FIG. 8 is a front elevational view thereof;

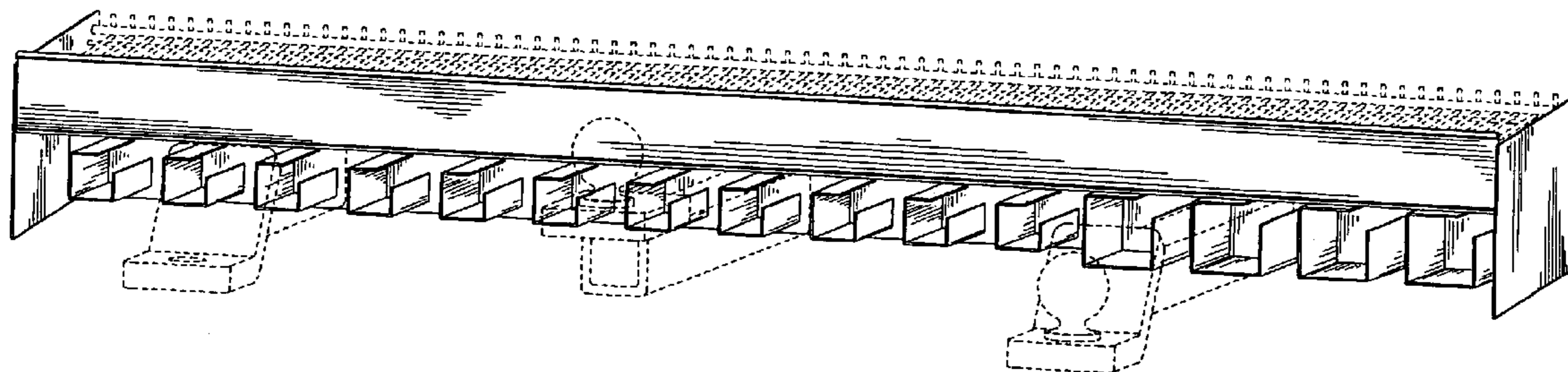
FIG. 9 is a top, front, and right side perspective view of a

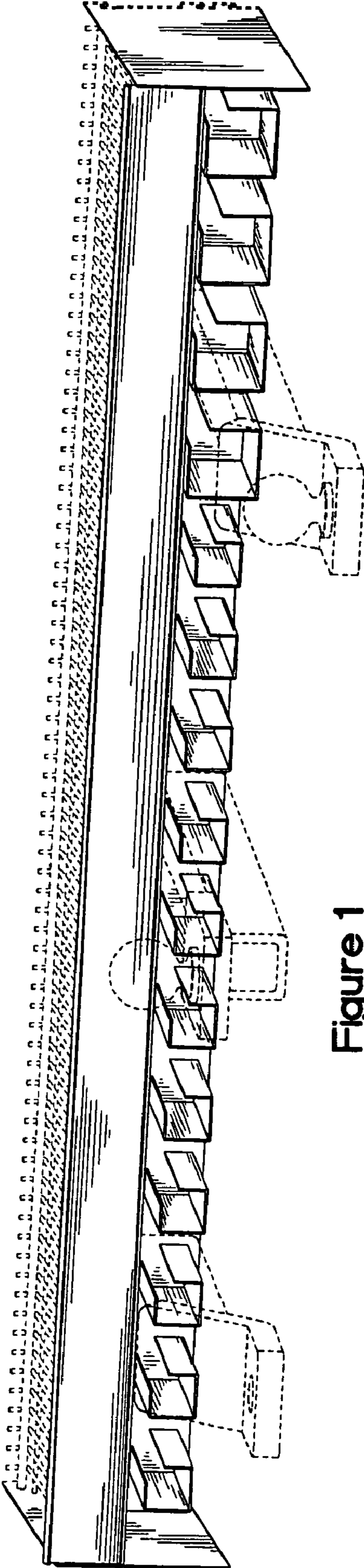

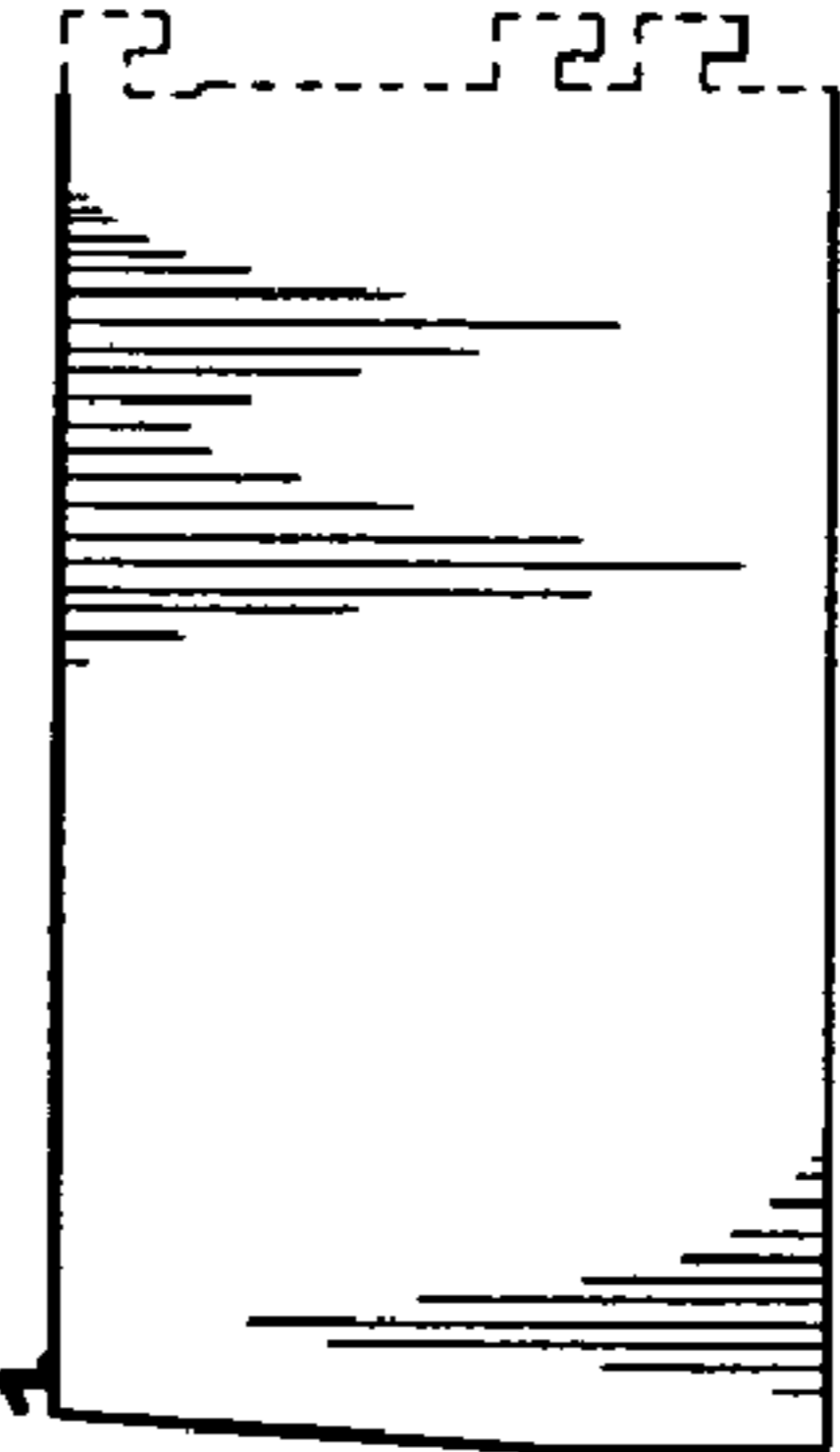

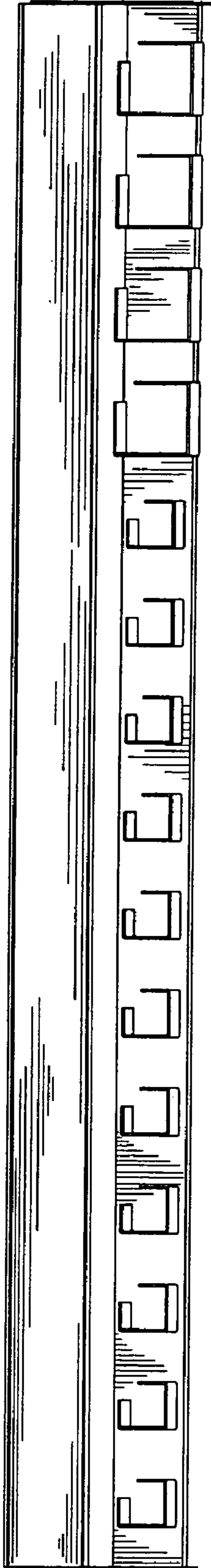

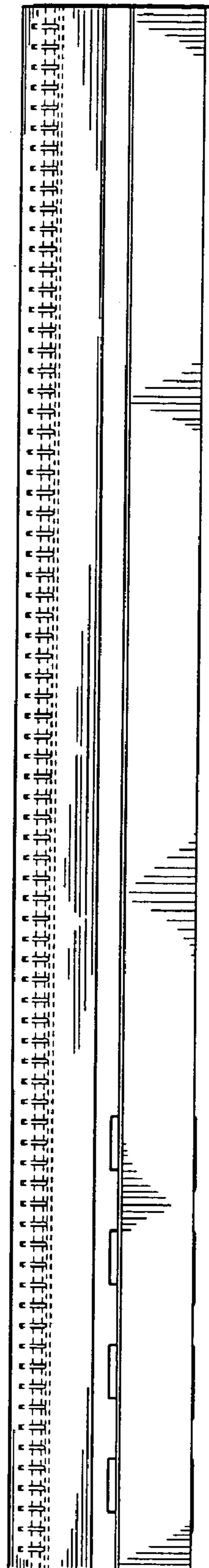

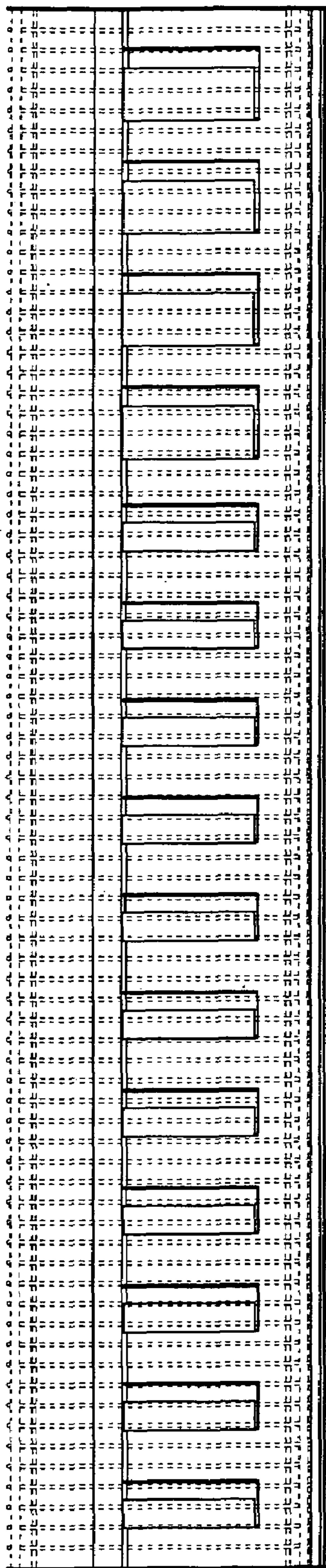

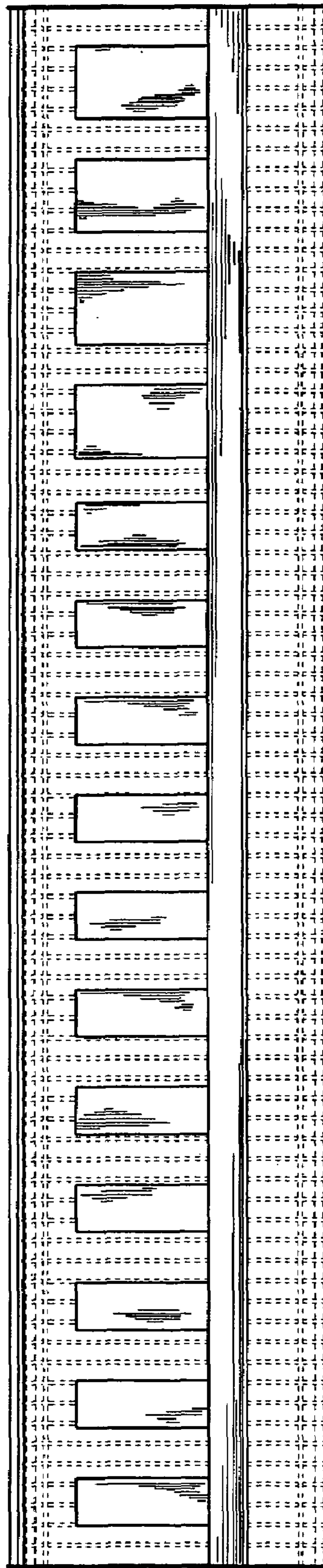

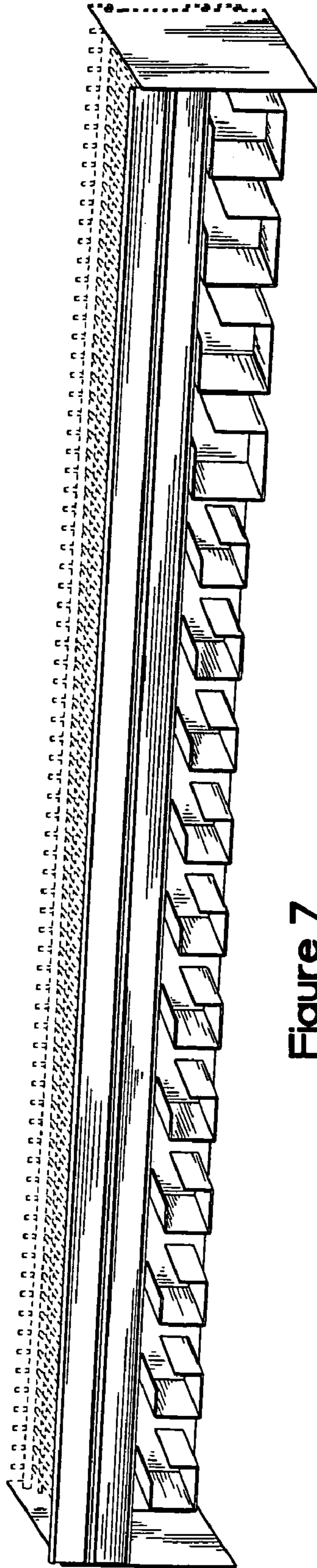

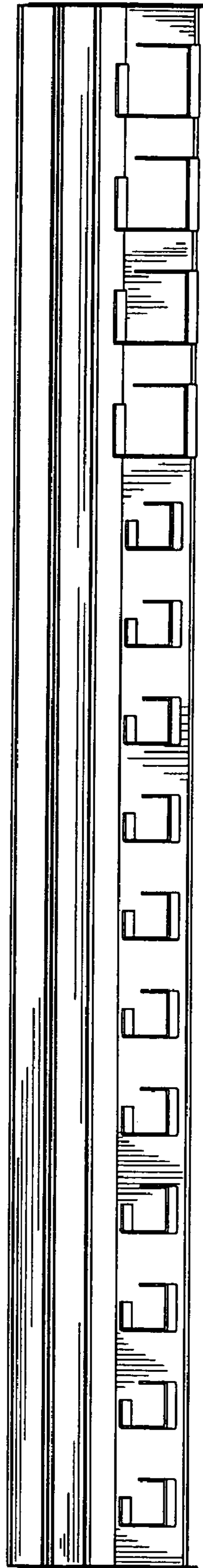

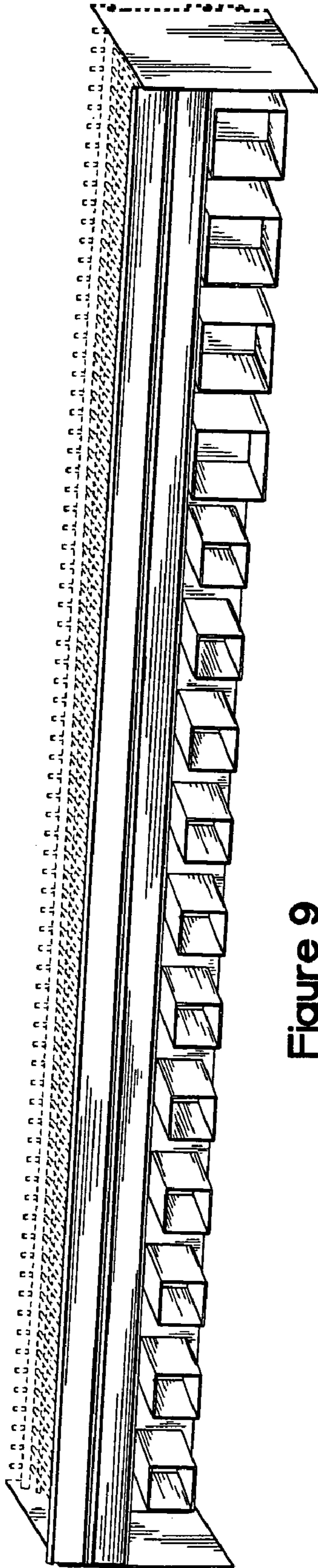

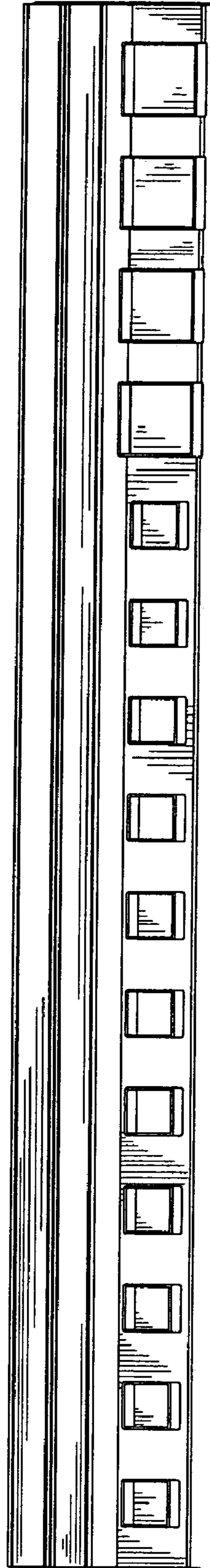

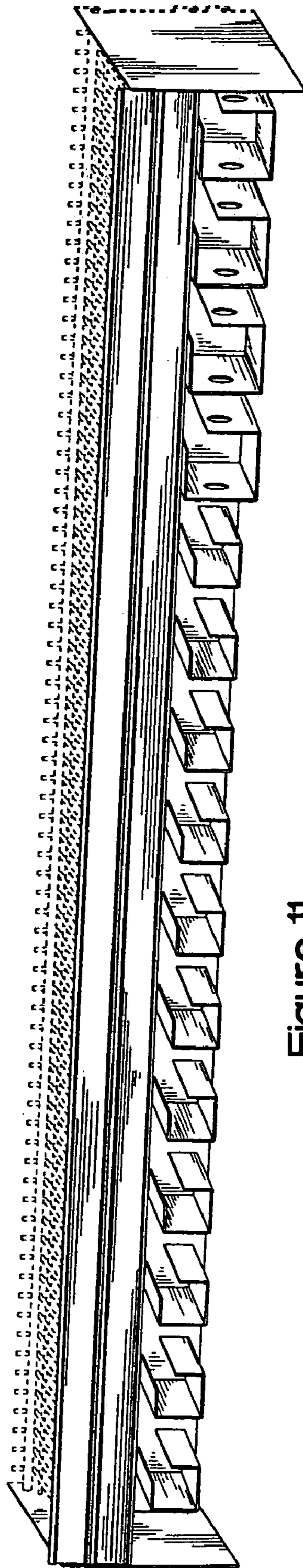
