FIG. 4 is a top view thereof;

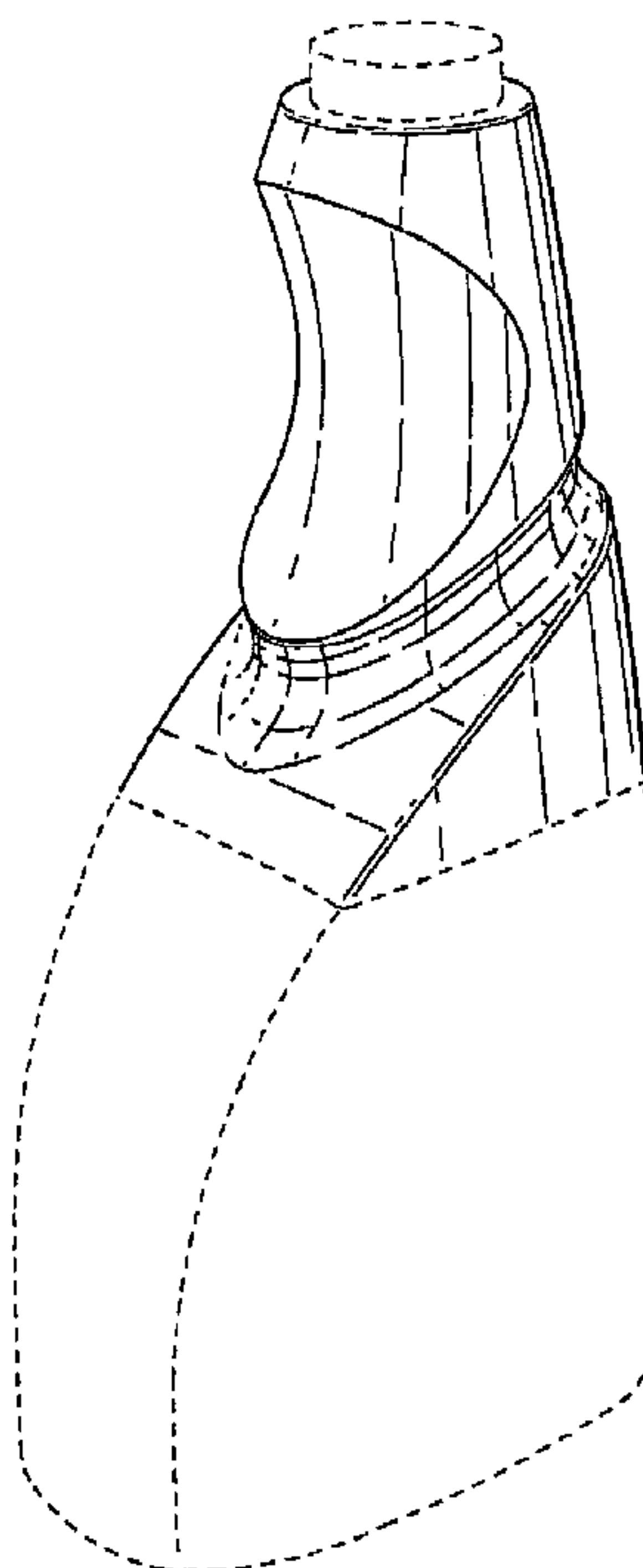
FIG. 5 is a left side view thereof; and,

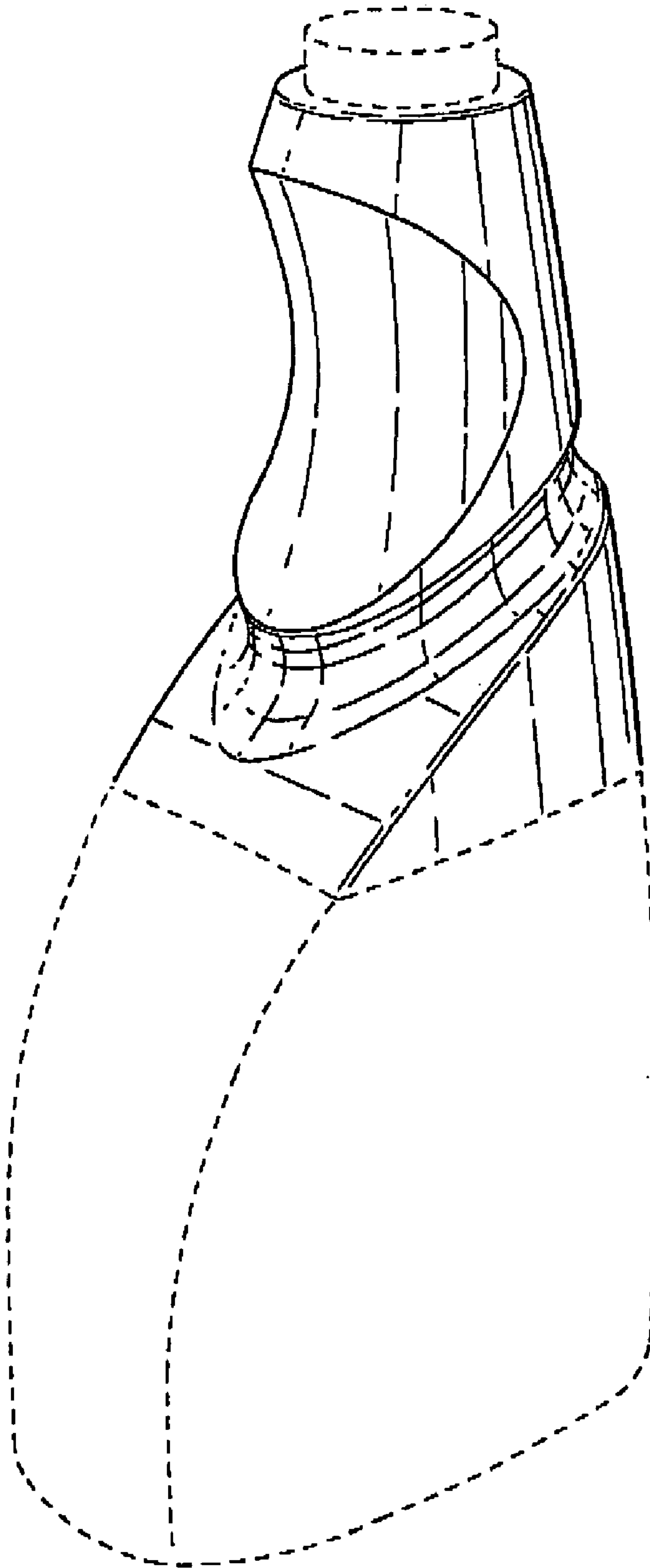

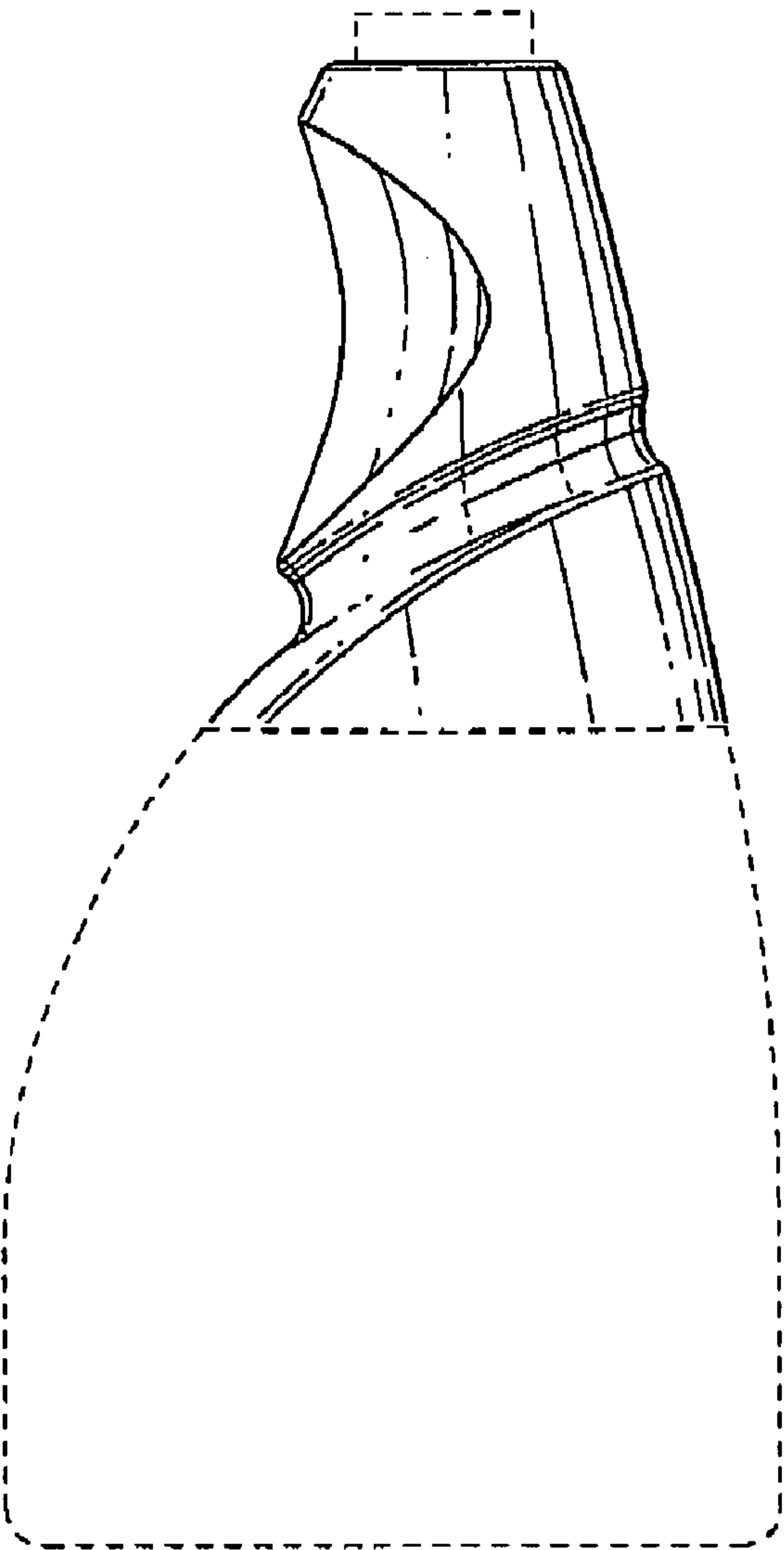

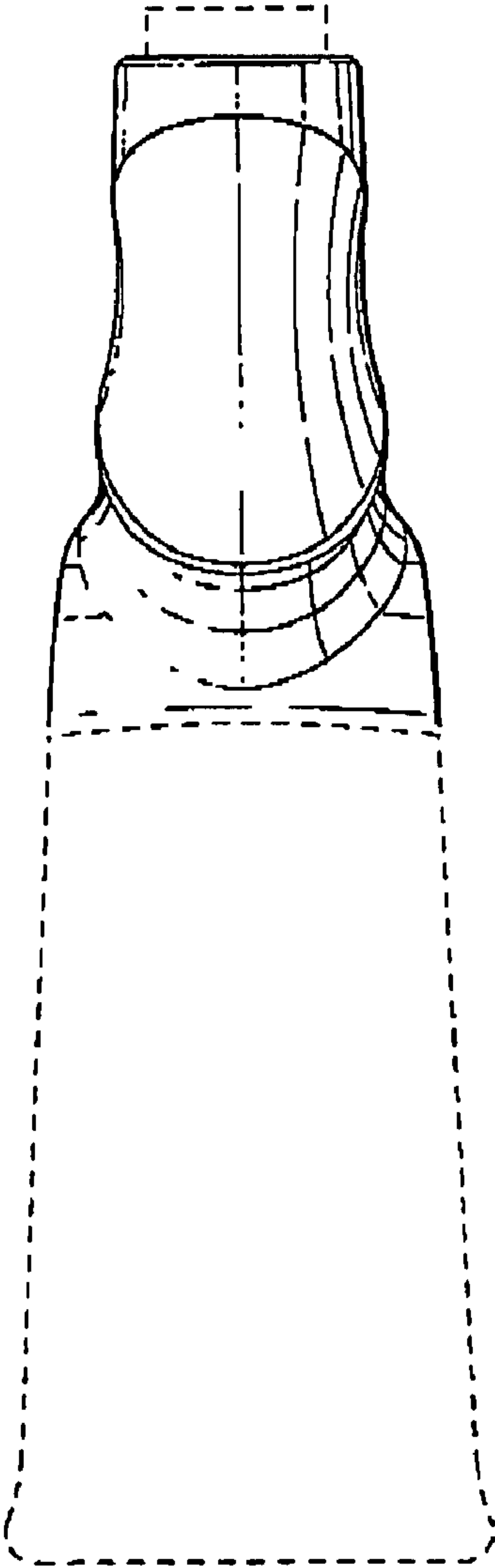

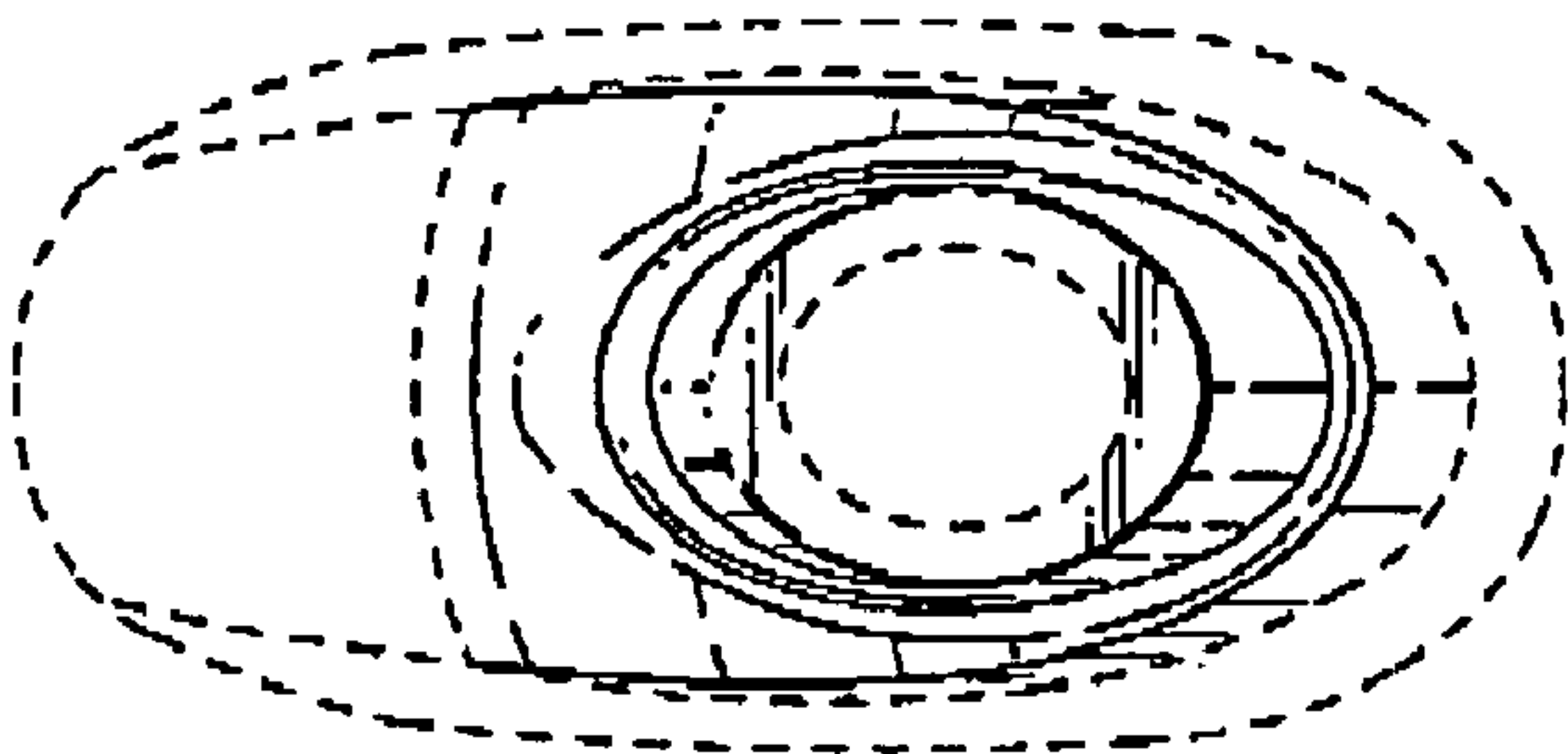

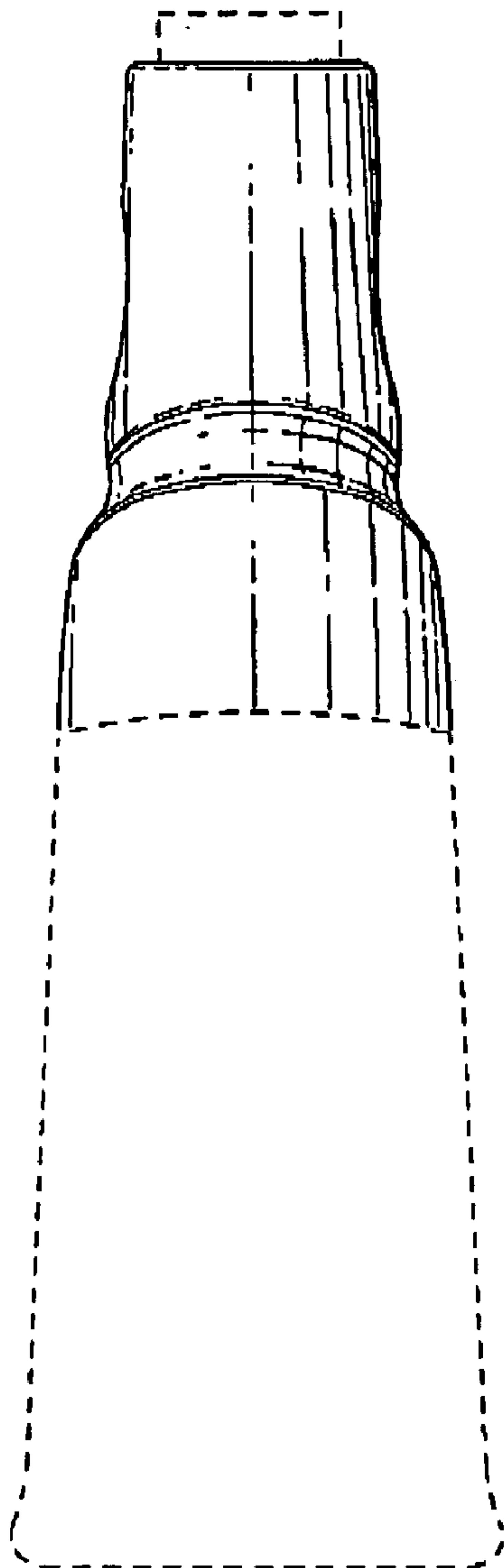

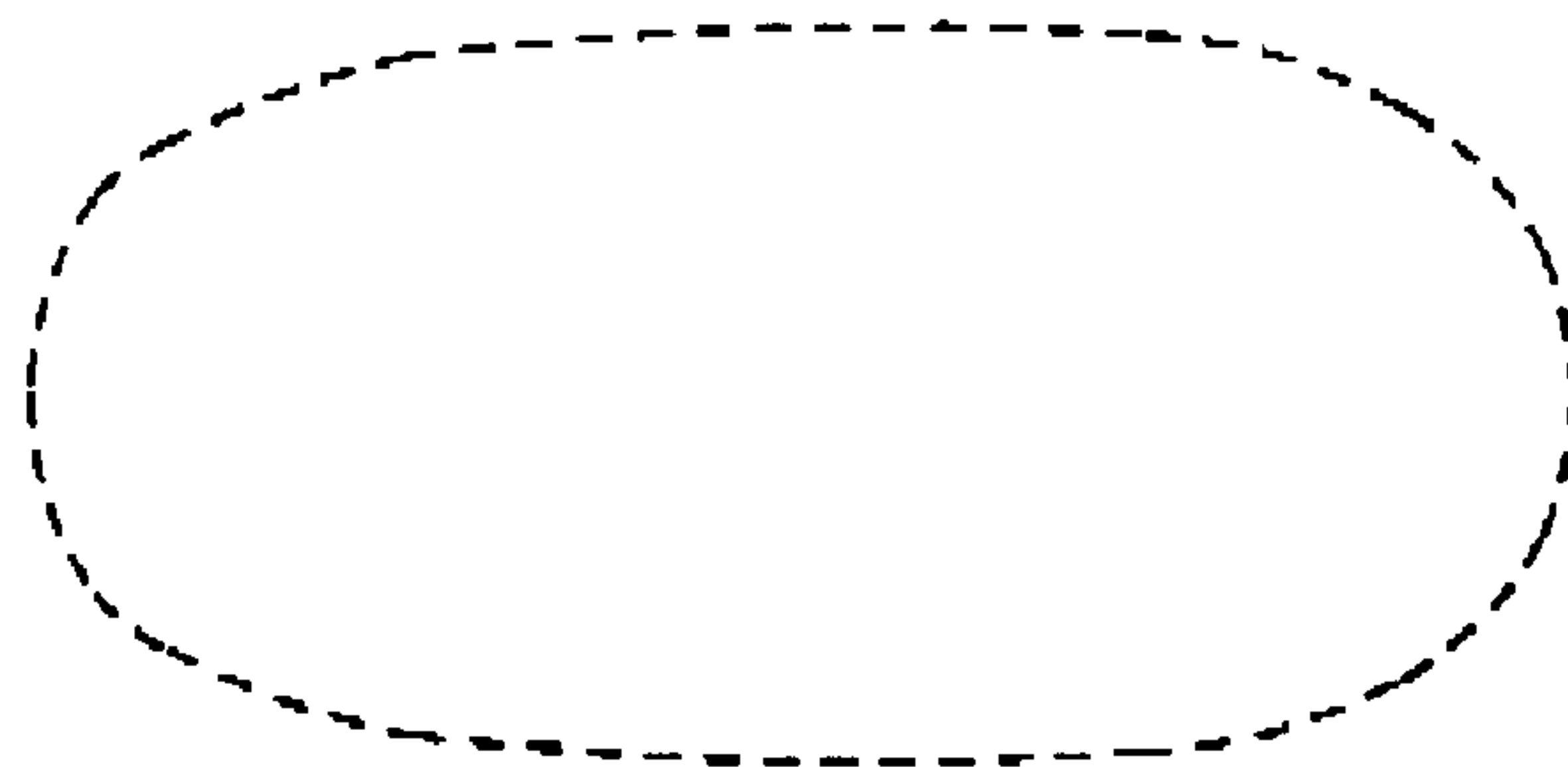
