I claim the ornamental design for a combined pill crusher and drinking tumbler, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a combined pill crusher and drinking tumbler showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof, the elevational view of the opposing side being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 4 is an end elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is an elevational view of the opposing end thereof;

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof; and,

FIG. 7 is an environmental reduced scale side elevational view thereof.

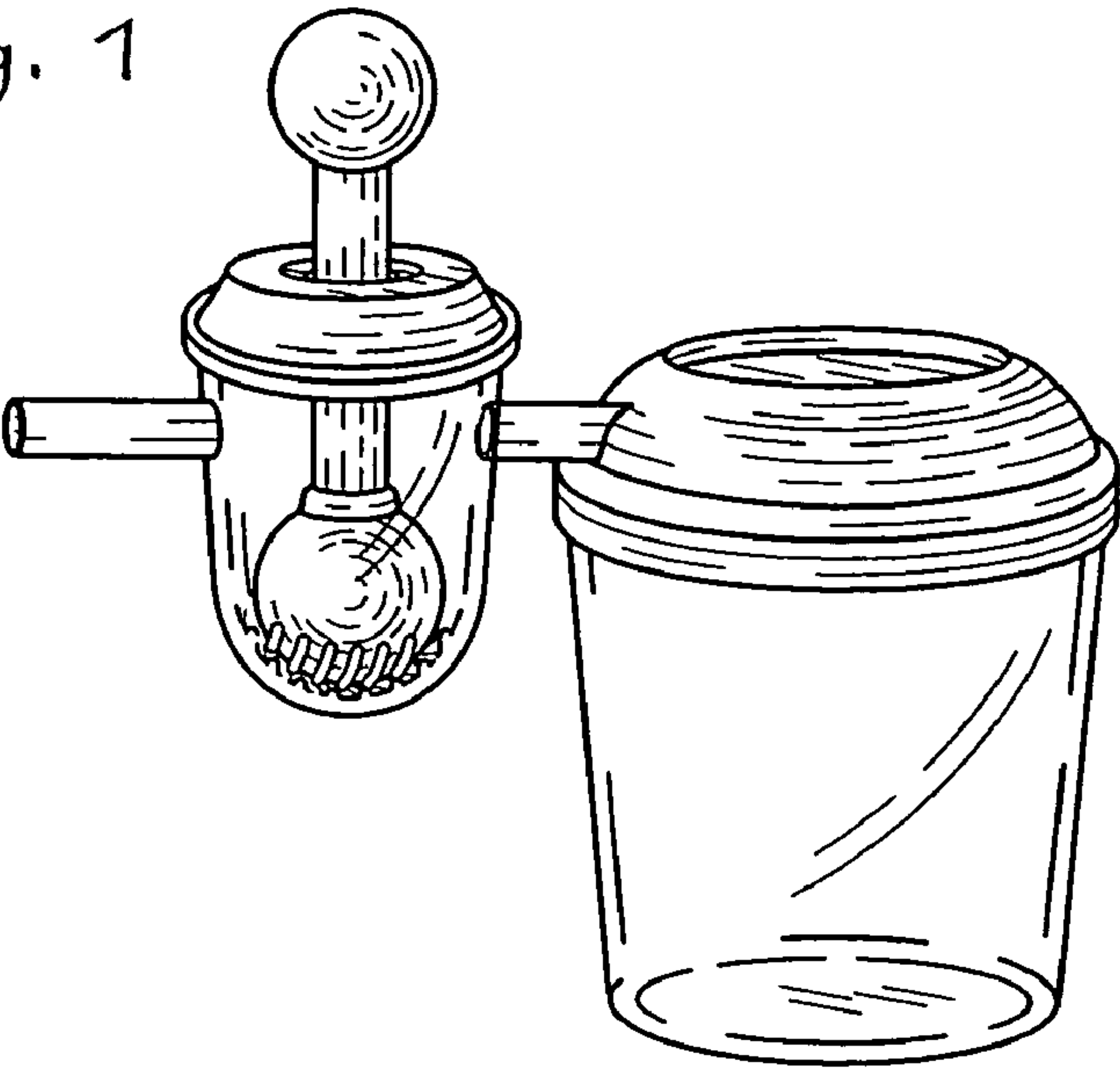

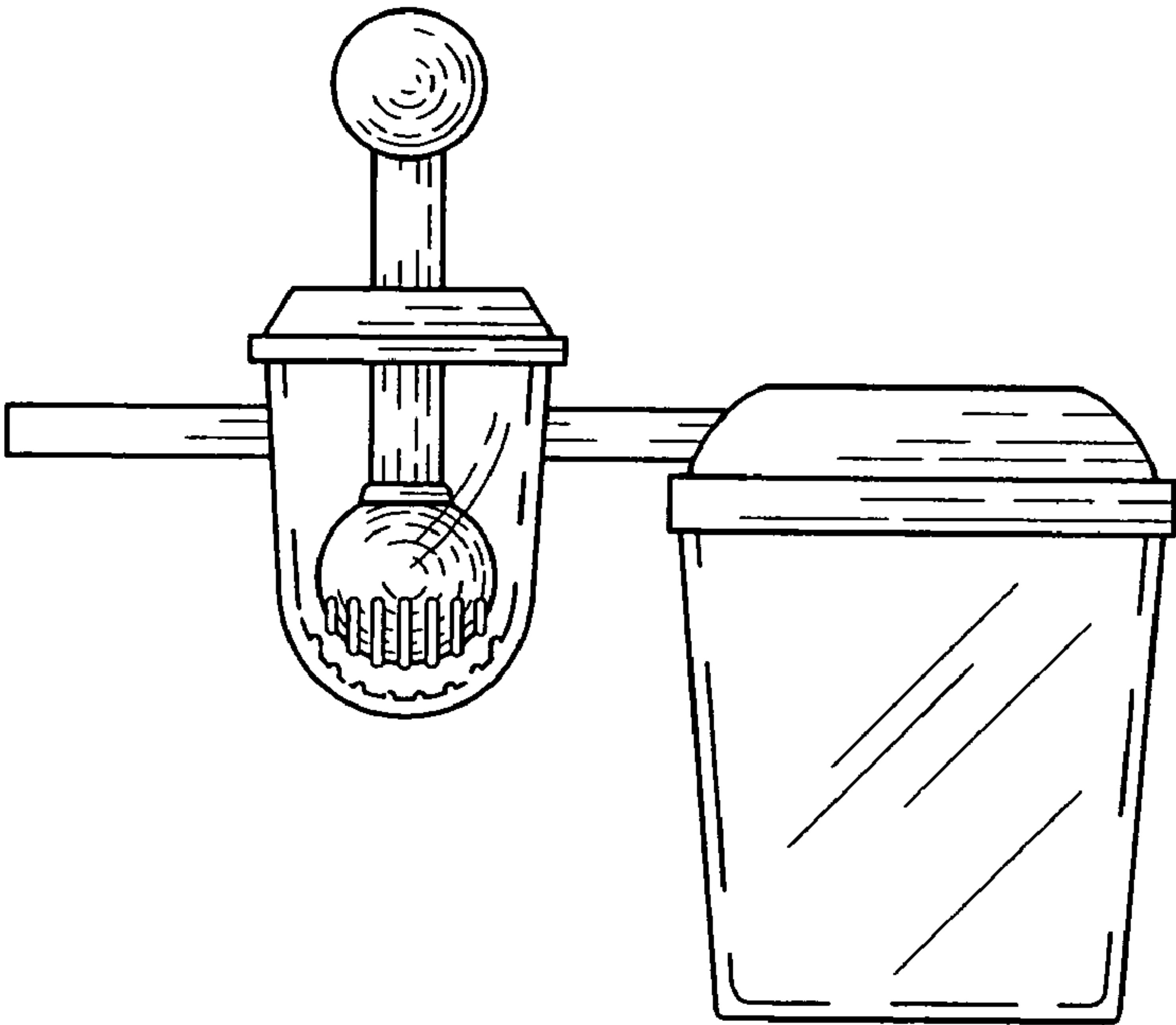

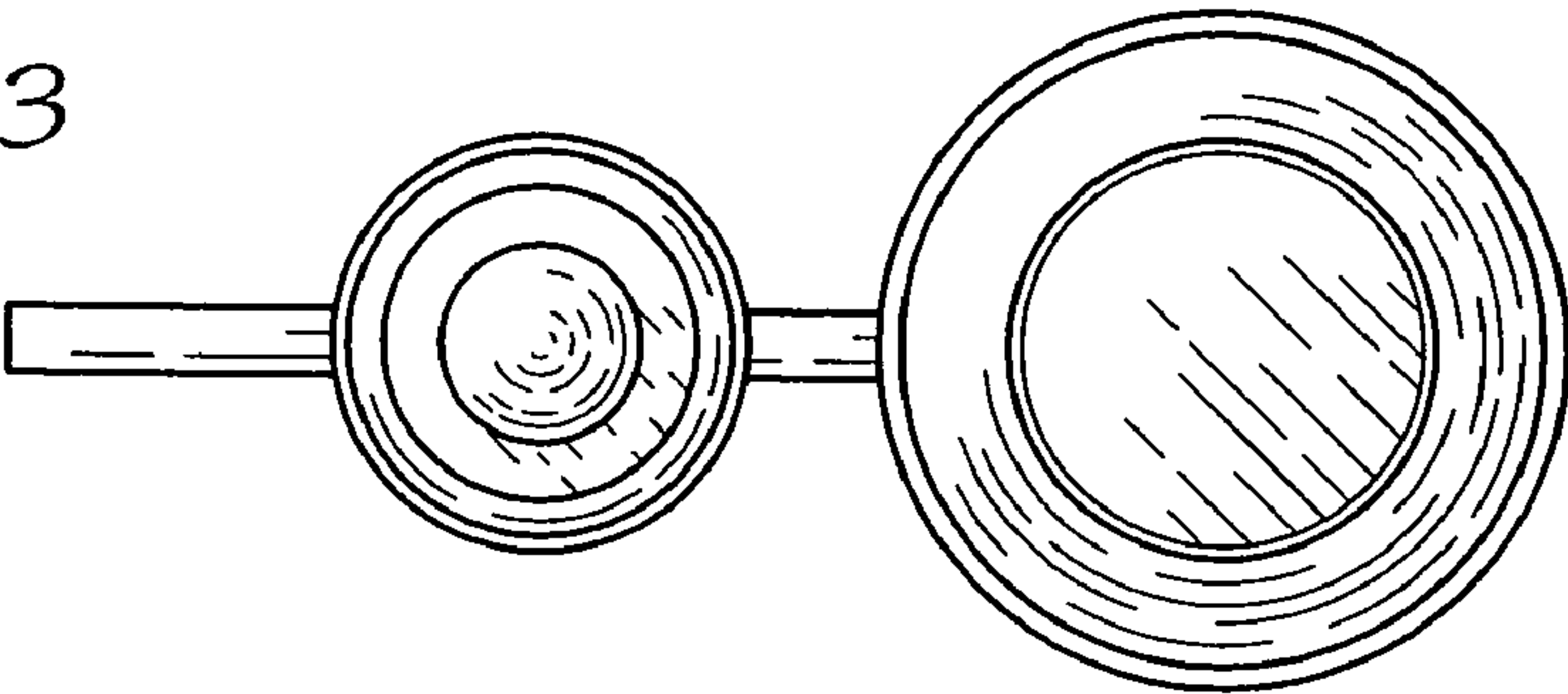

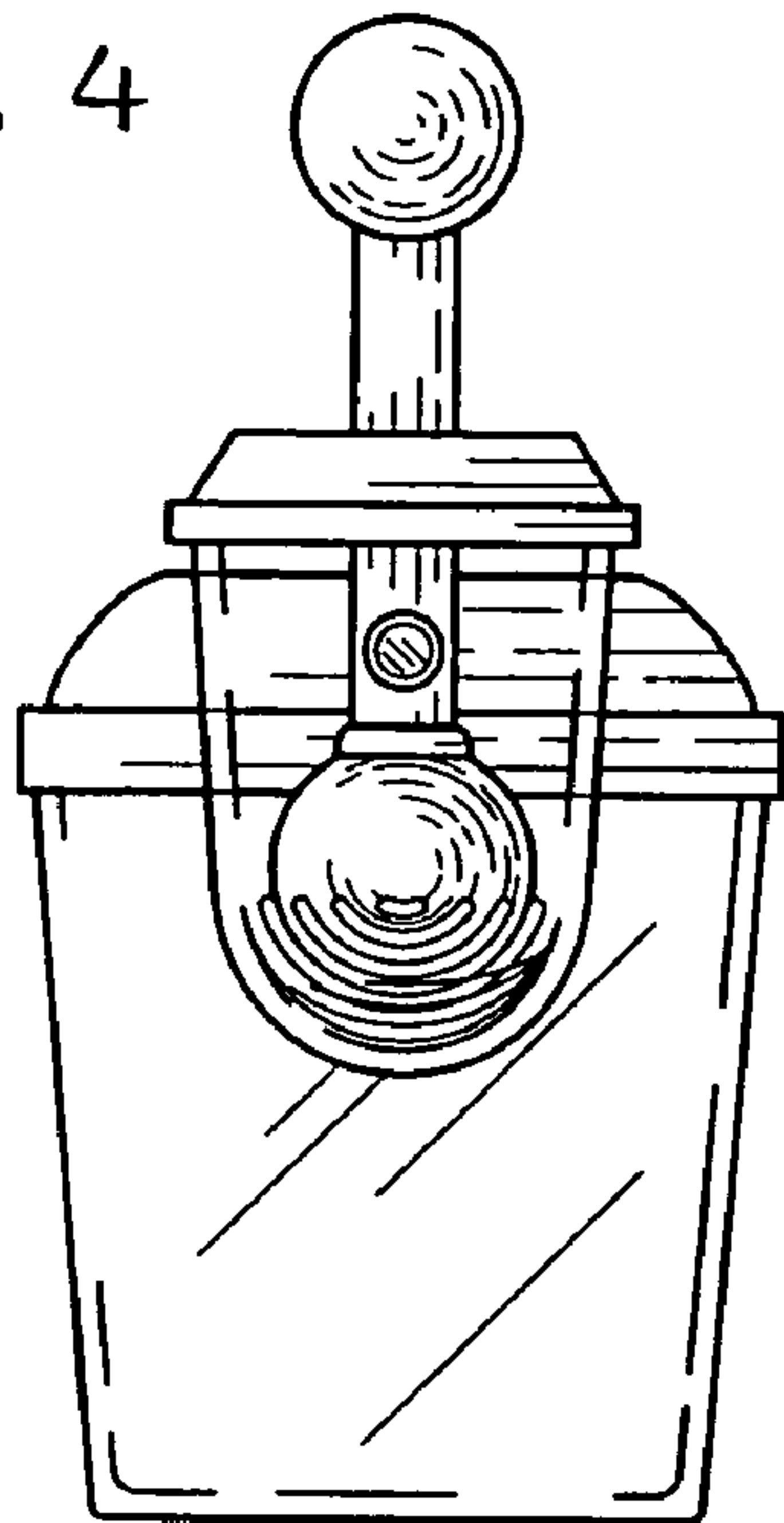

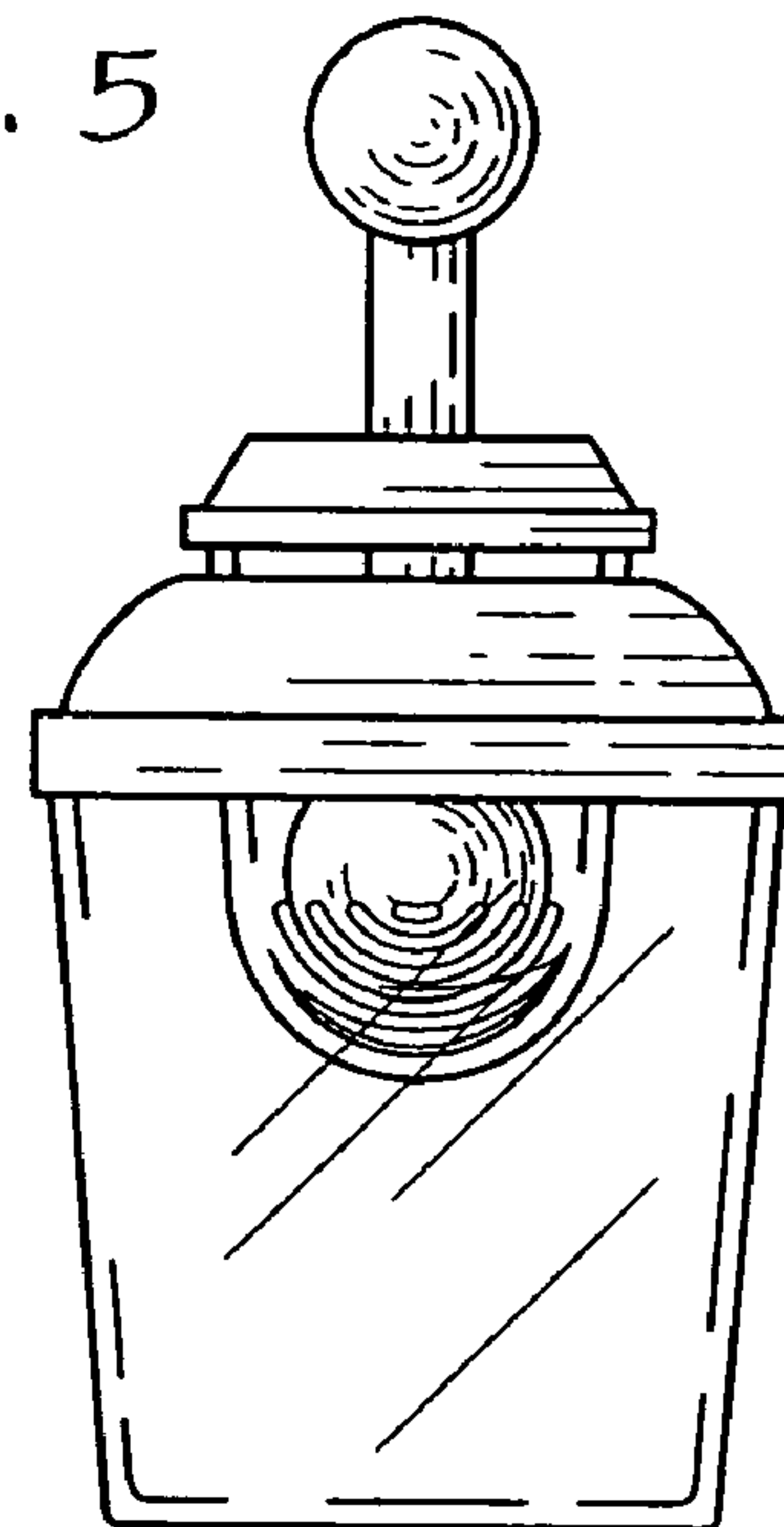

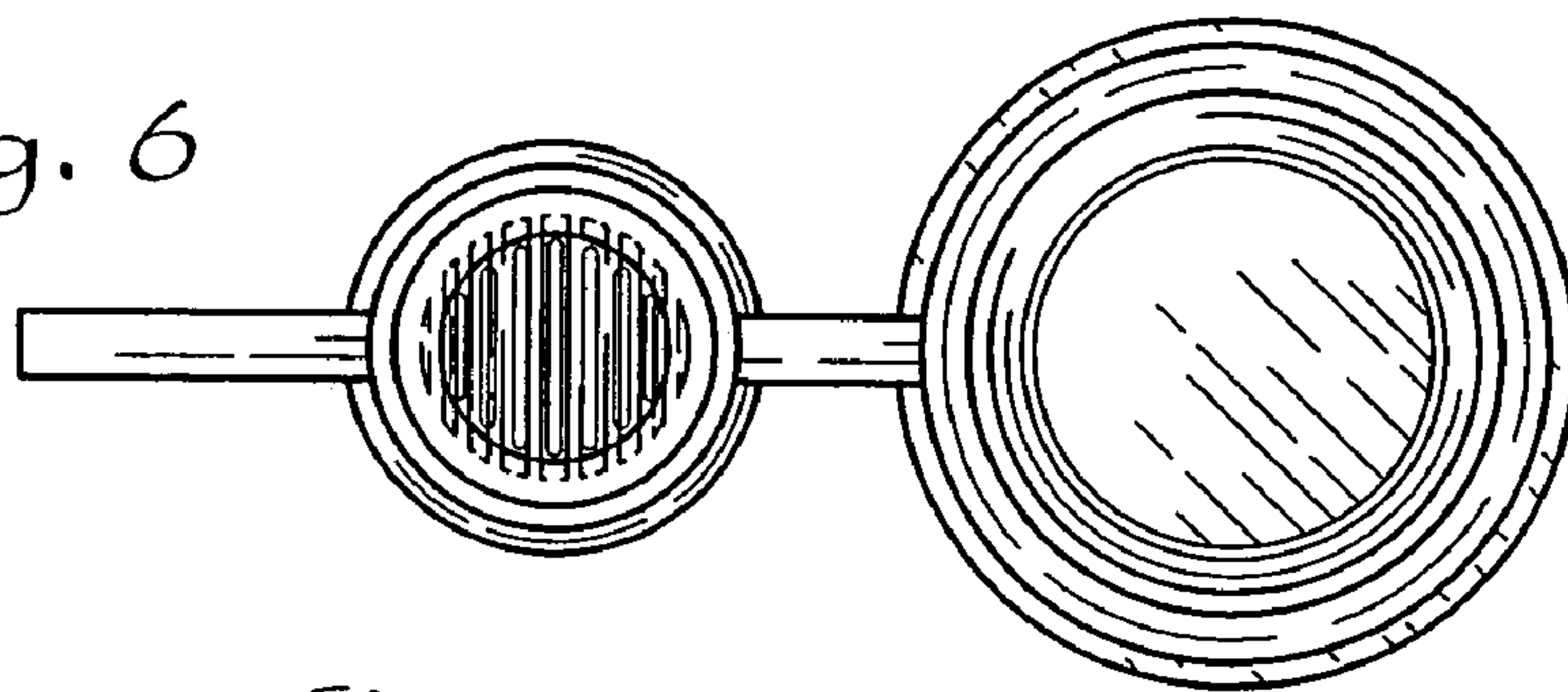
