(57) **CLAIM**

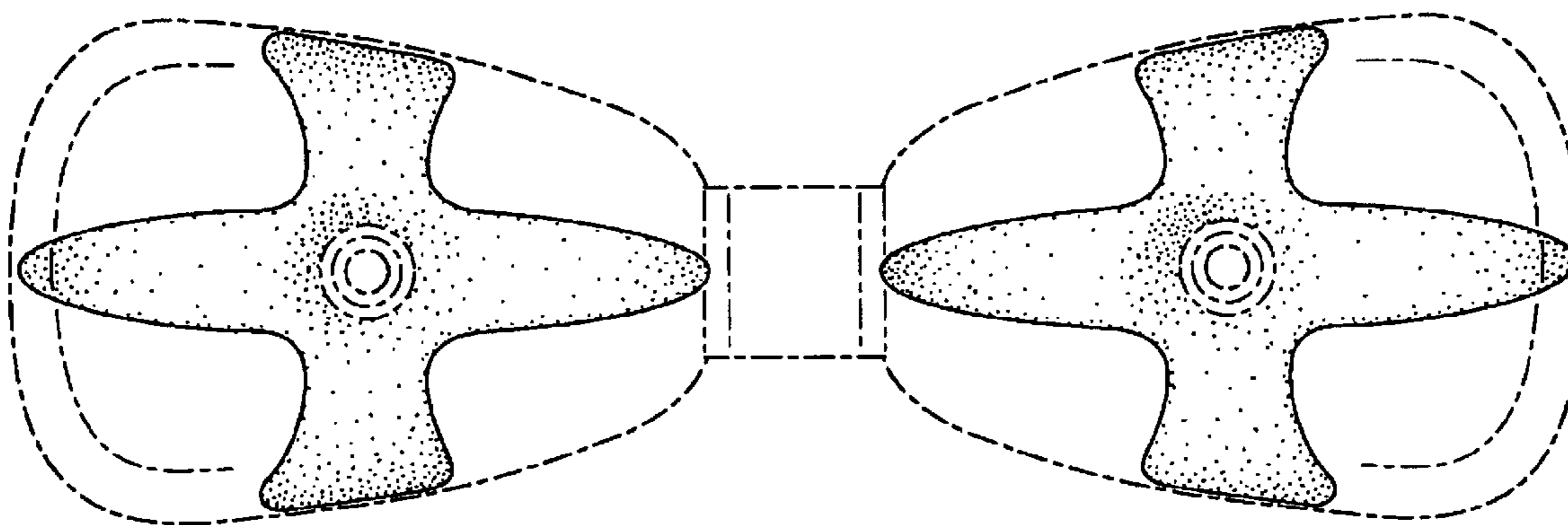
The ornamental appearance for a portion of a forehead pad assembly, as shown and described.

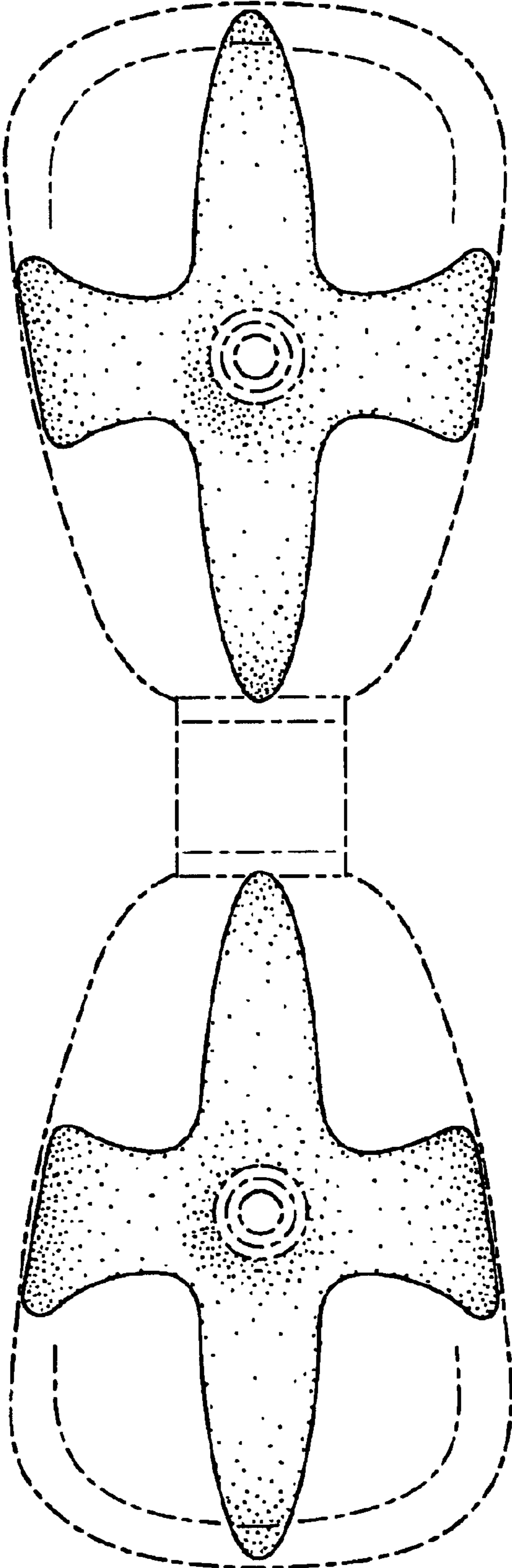
