DESCRIPTION

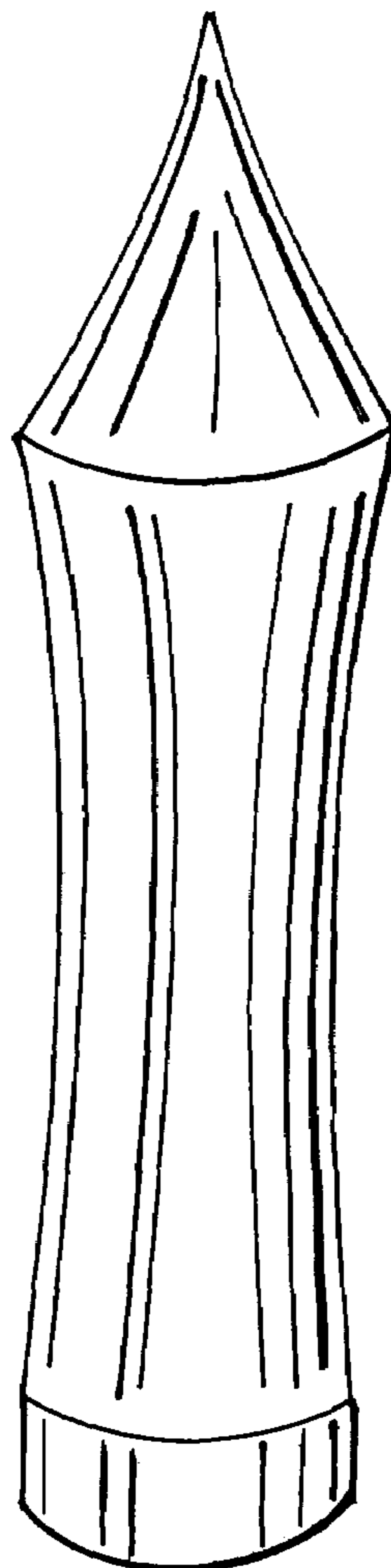
FIG. 1 is an isometric view of a motorcycle handlebar grip

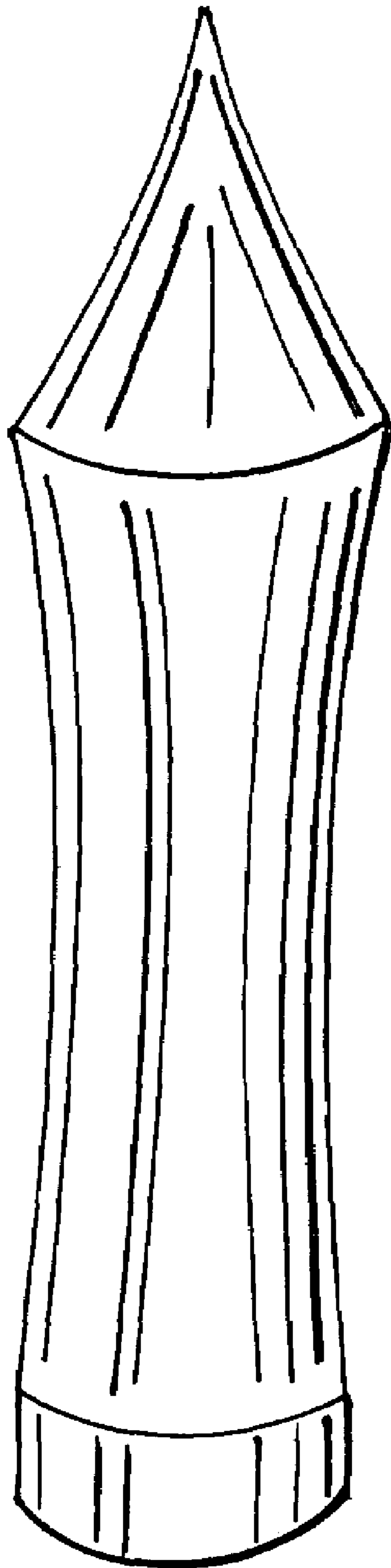

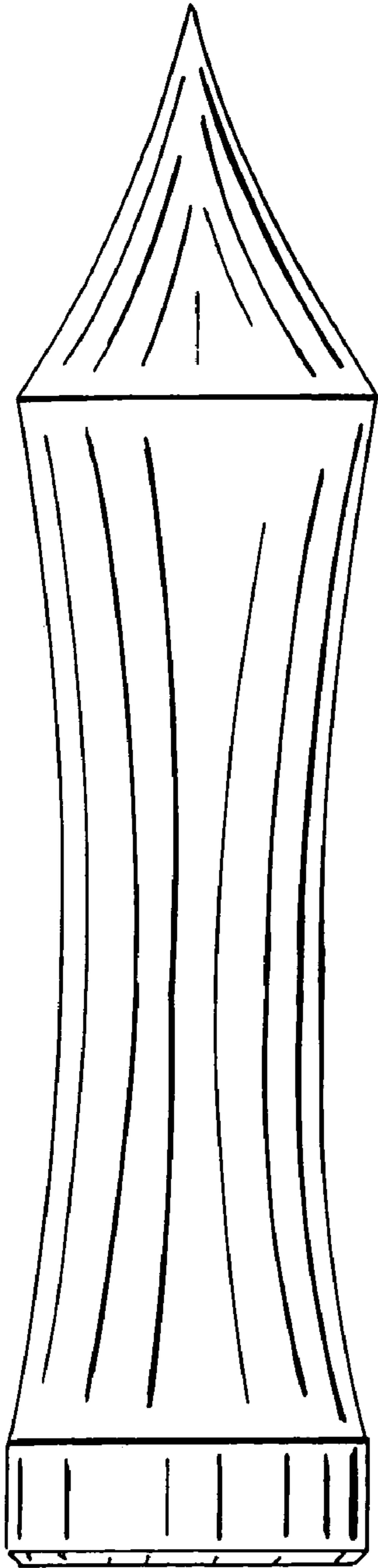

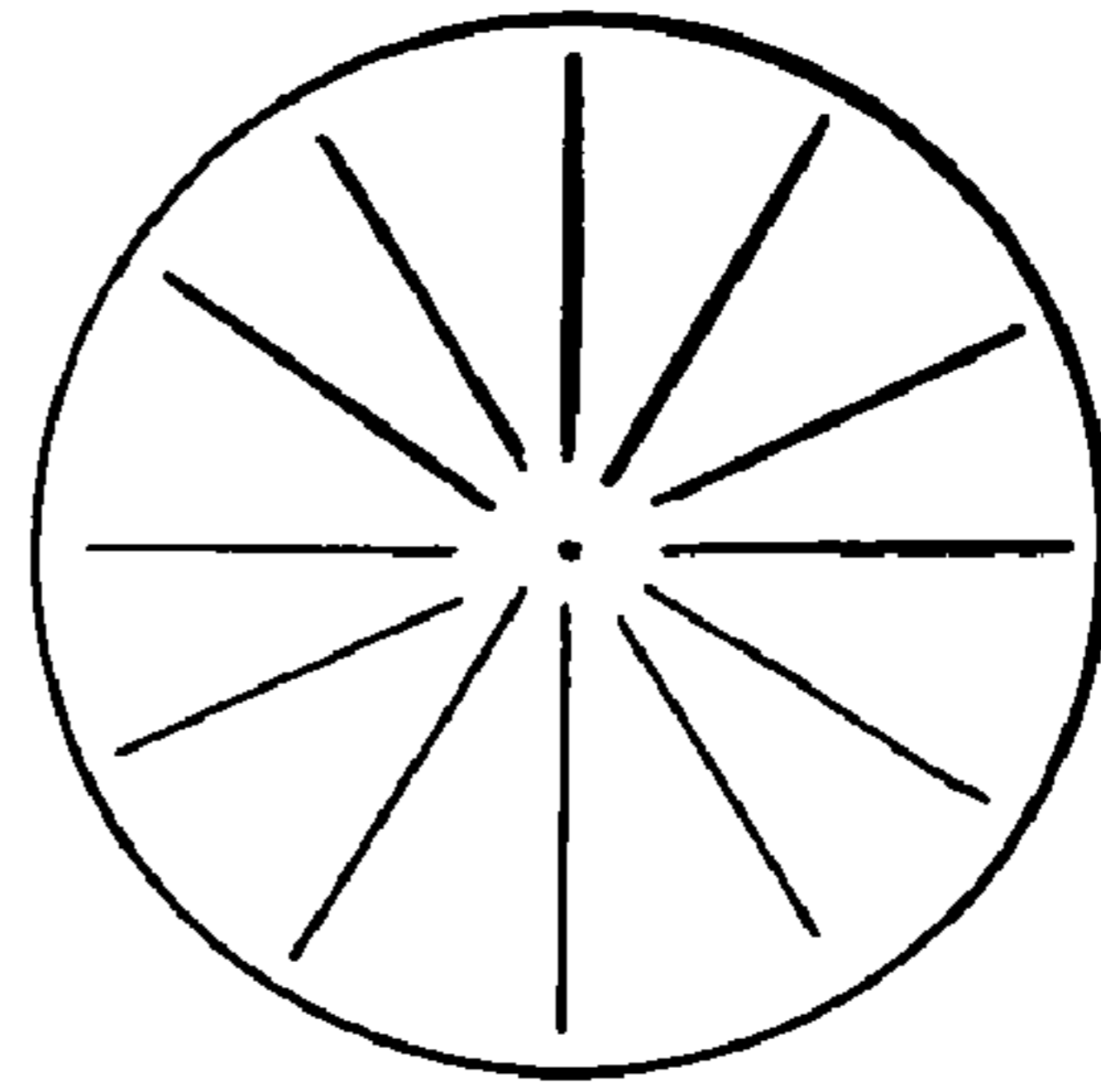

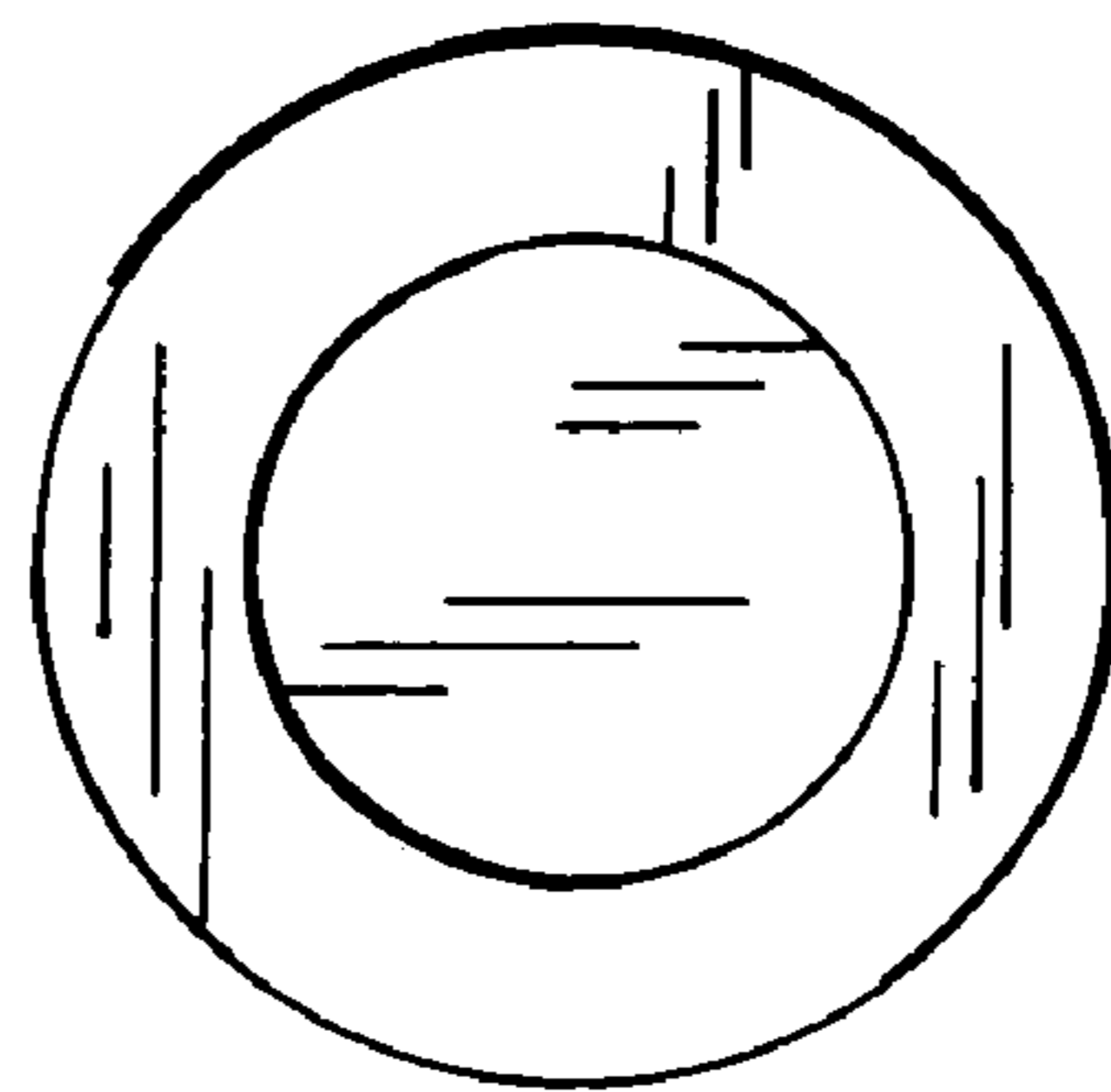
