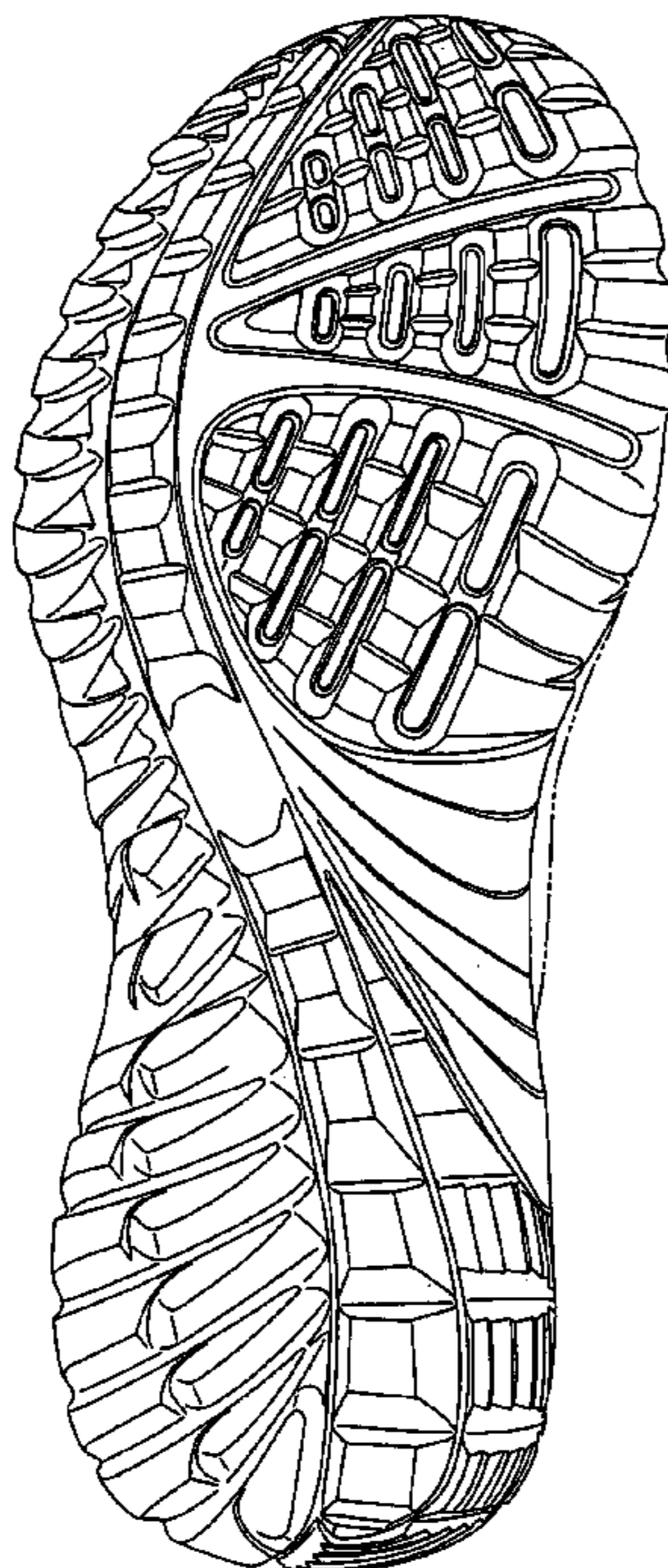
FIG. 4 is a left side view thereof;

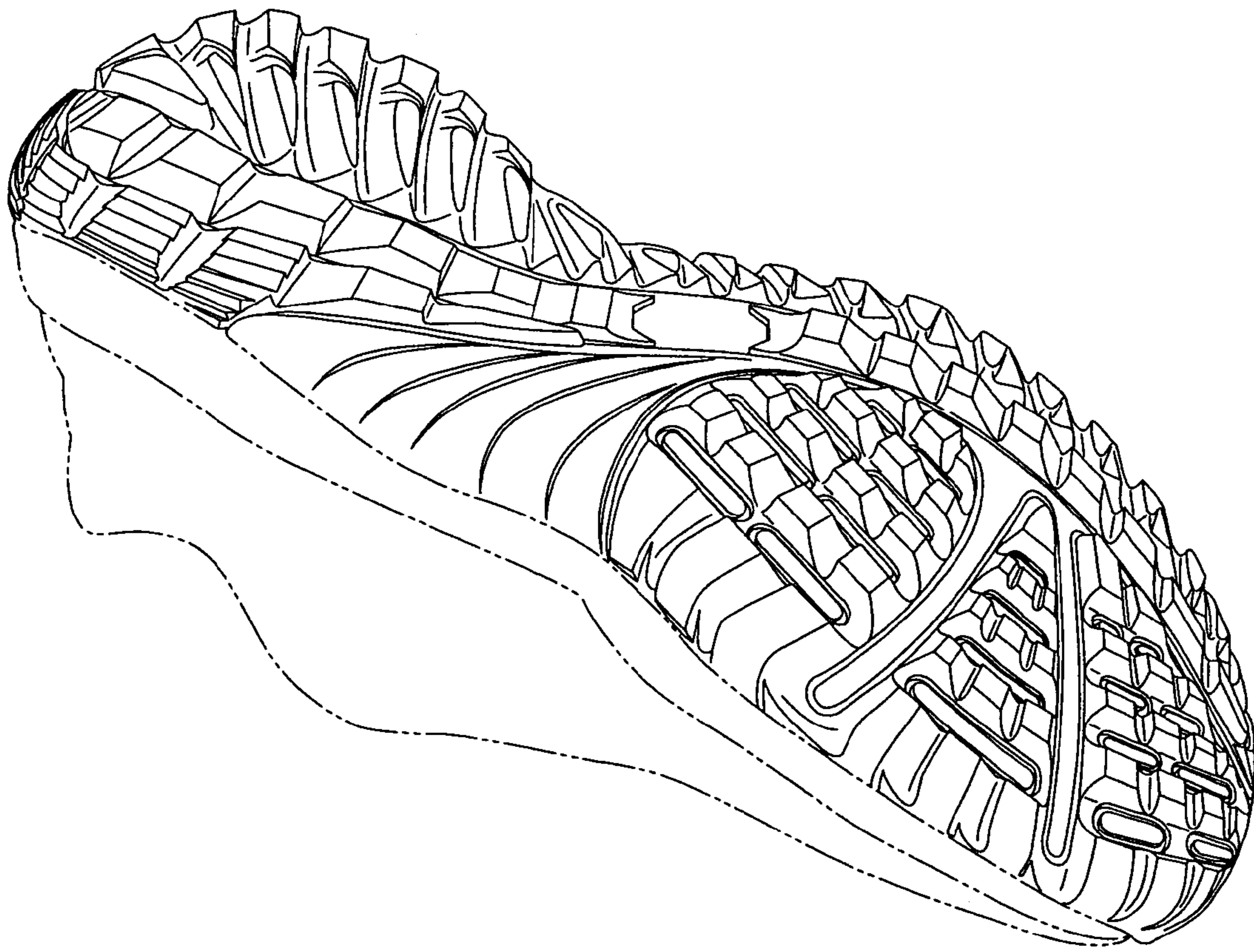

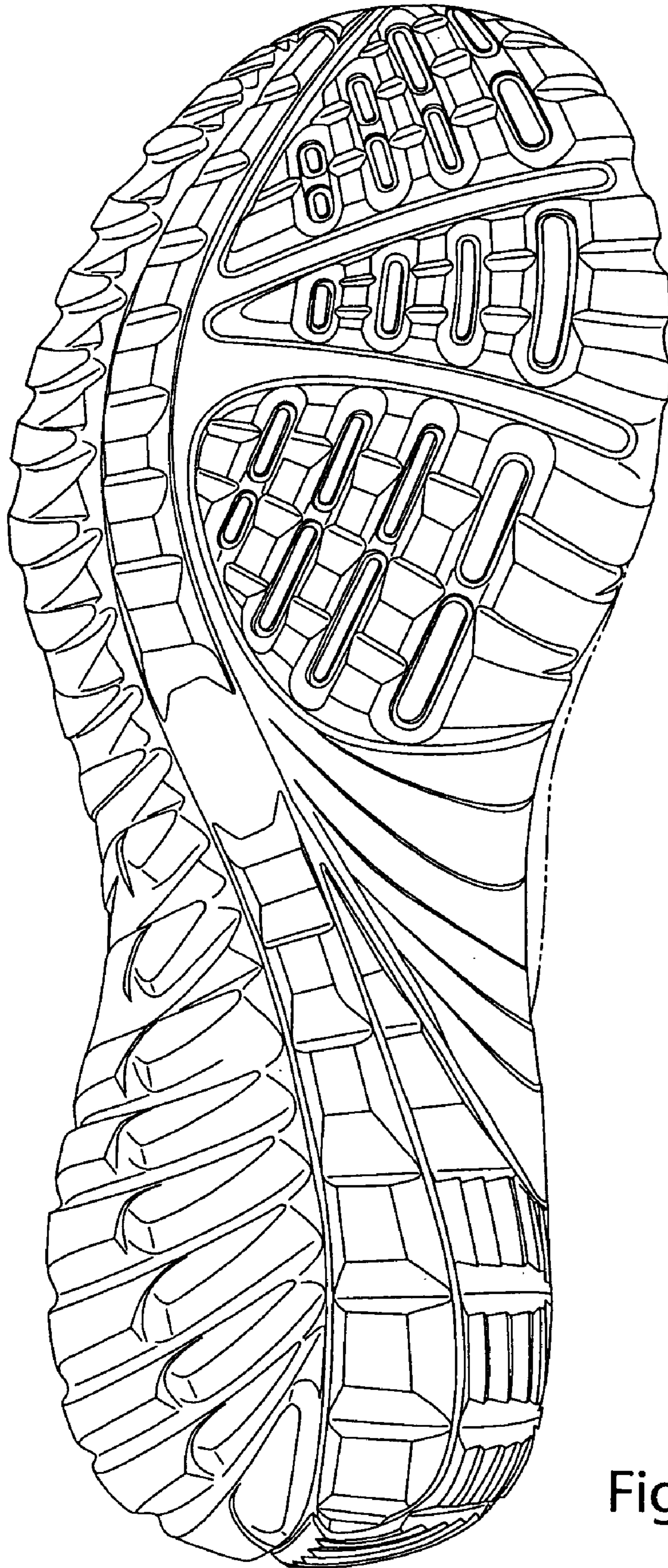

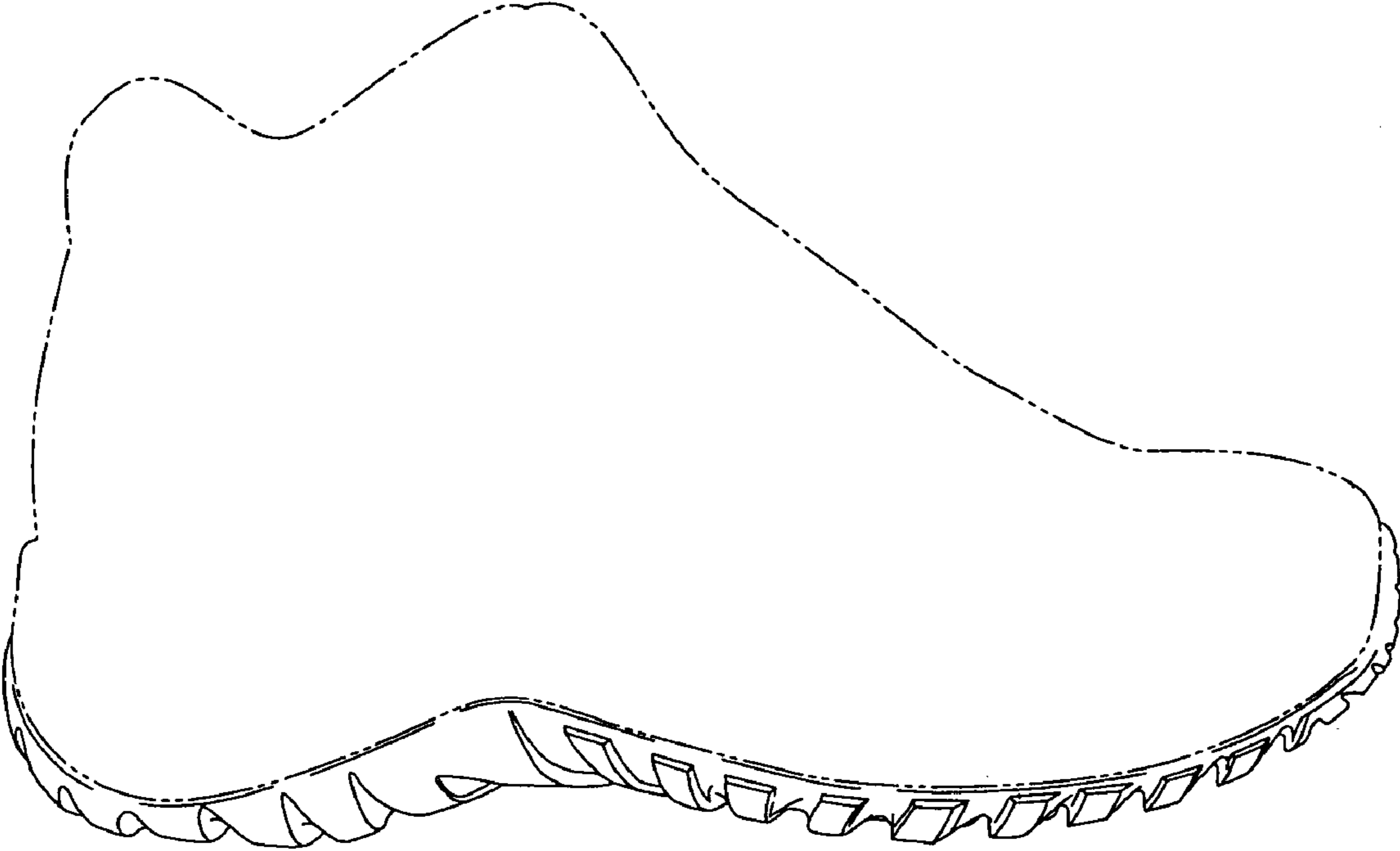

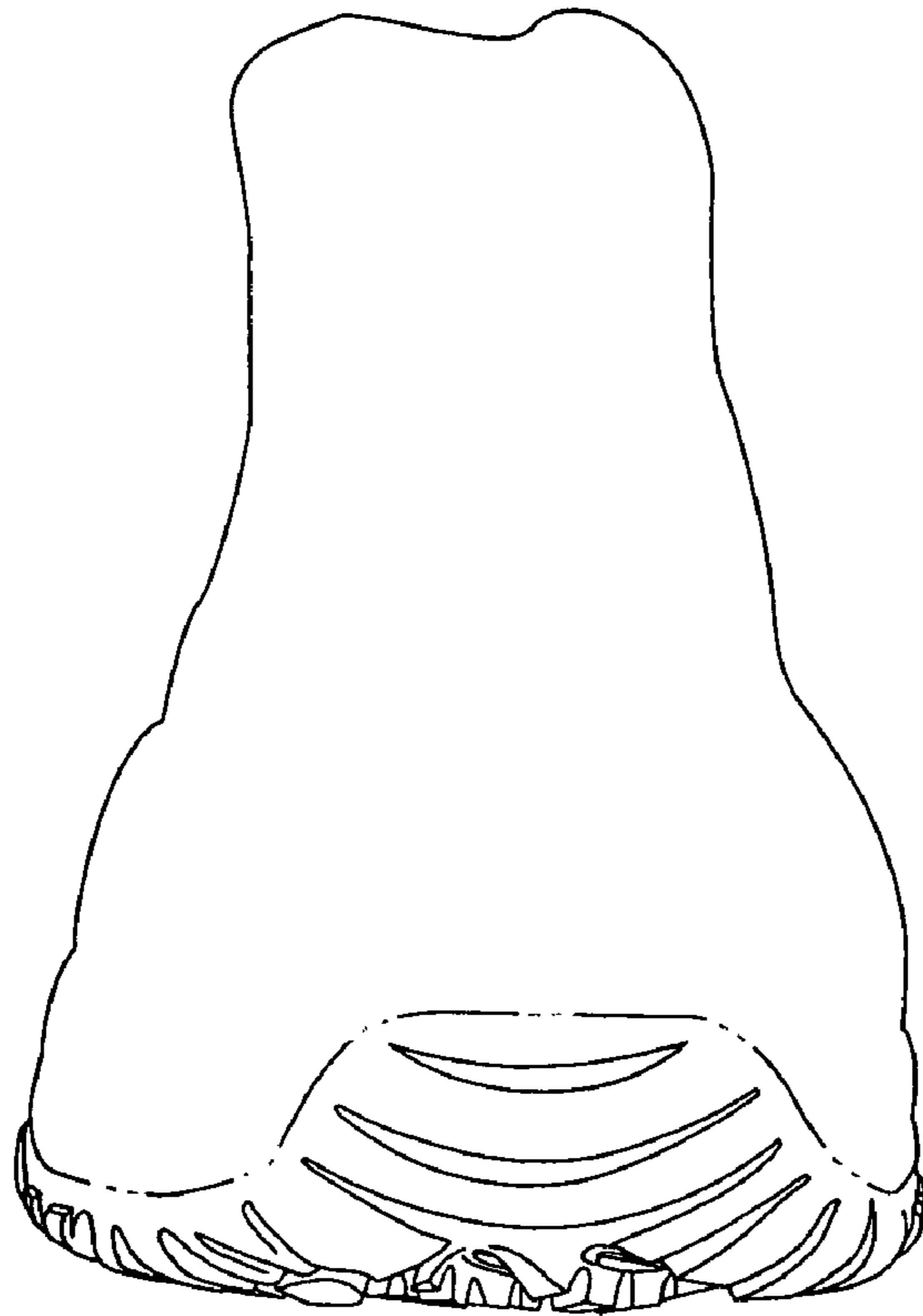

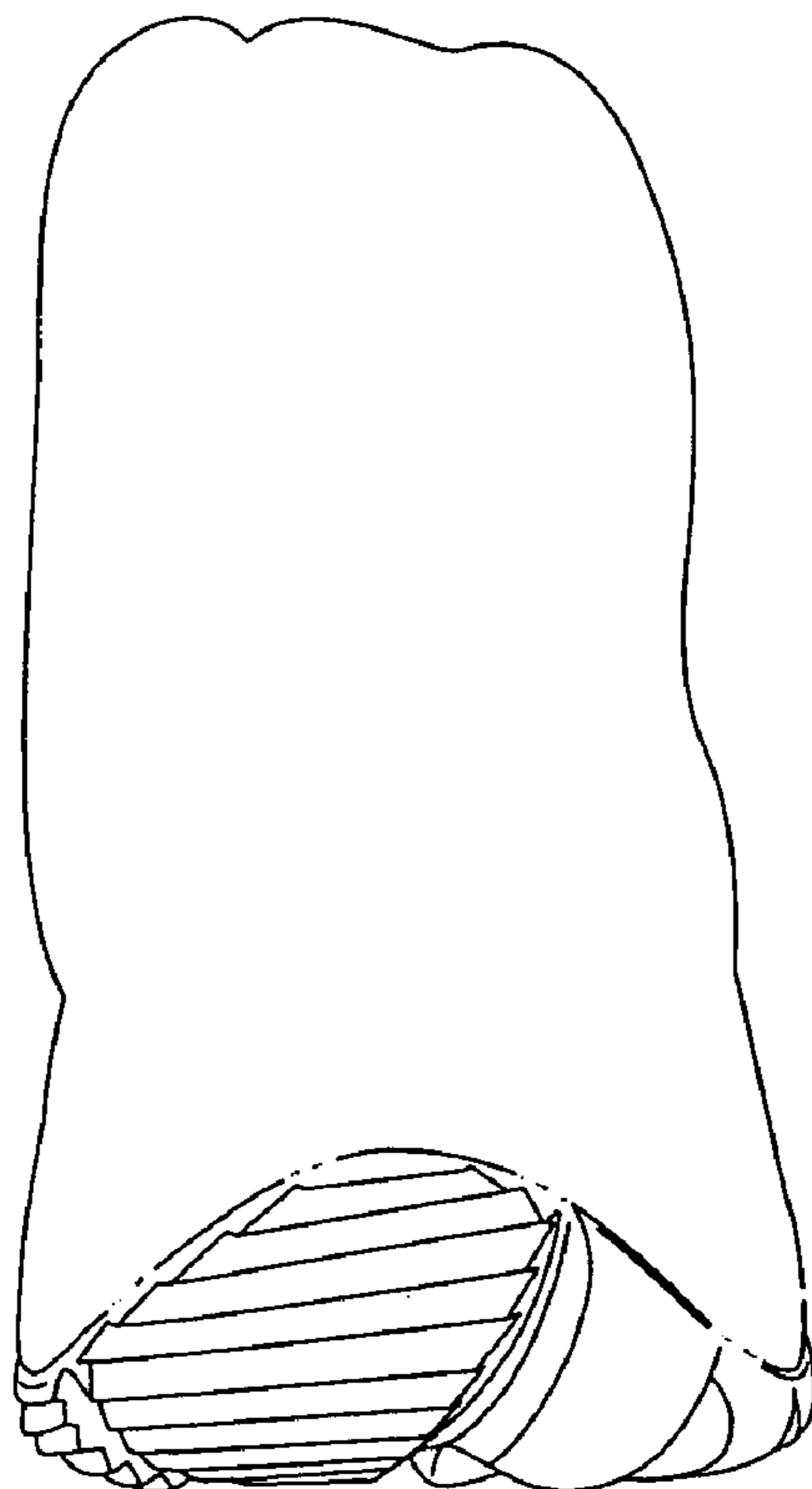
