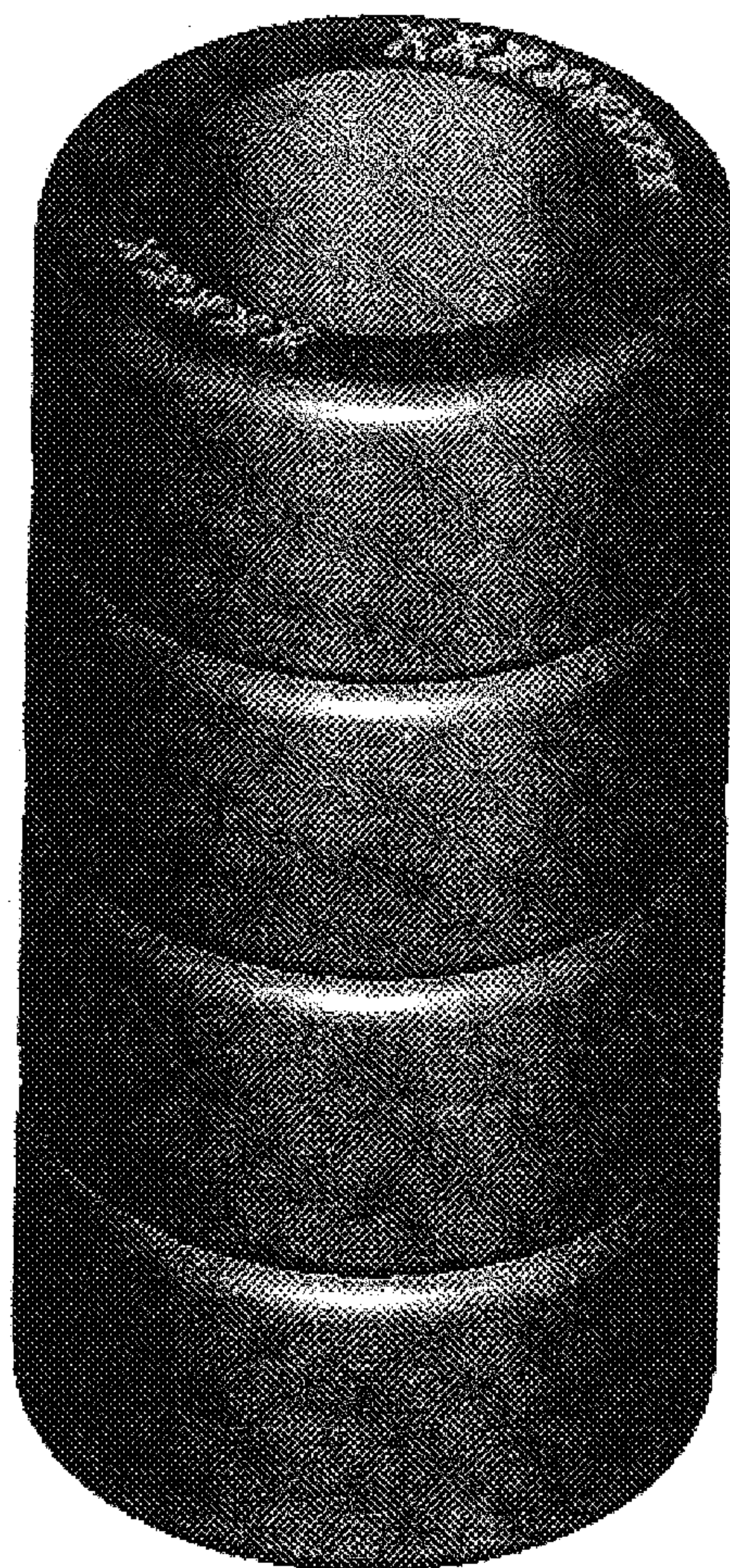
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view of the beverage holder of FIG.

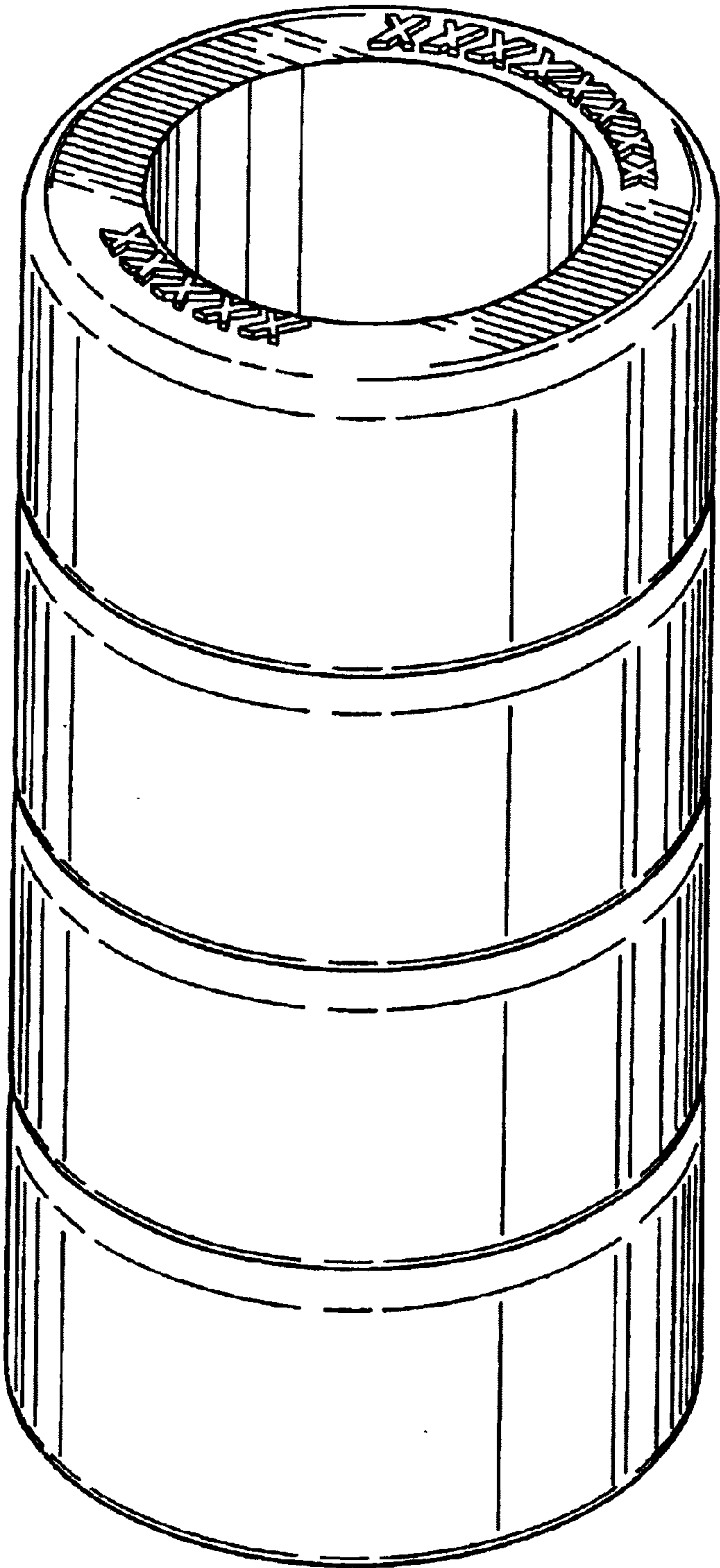

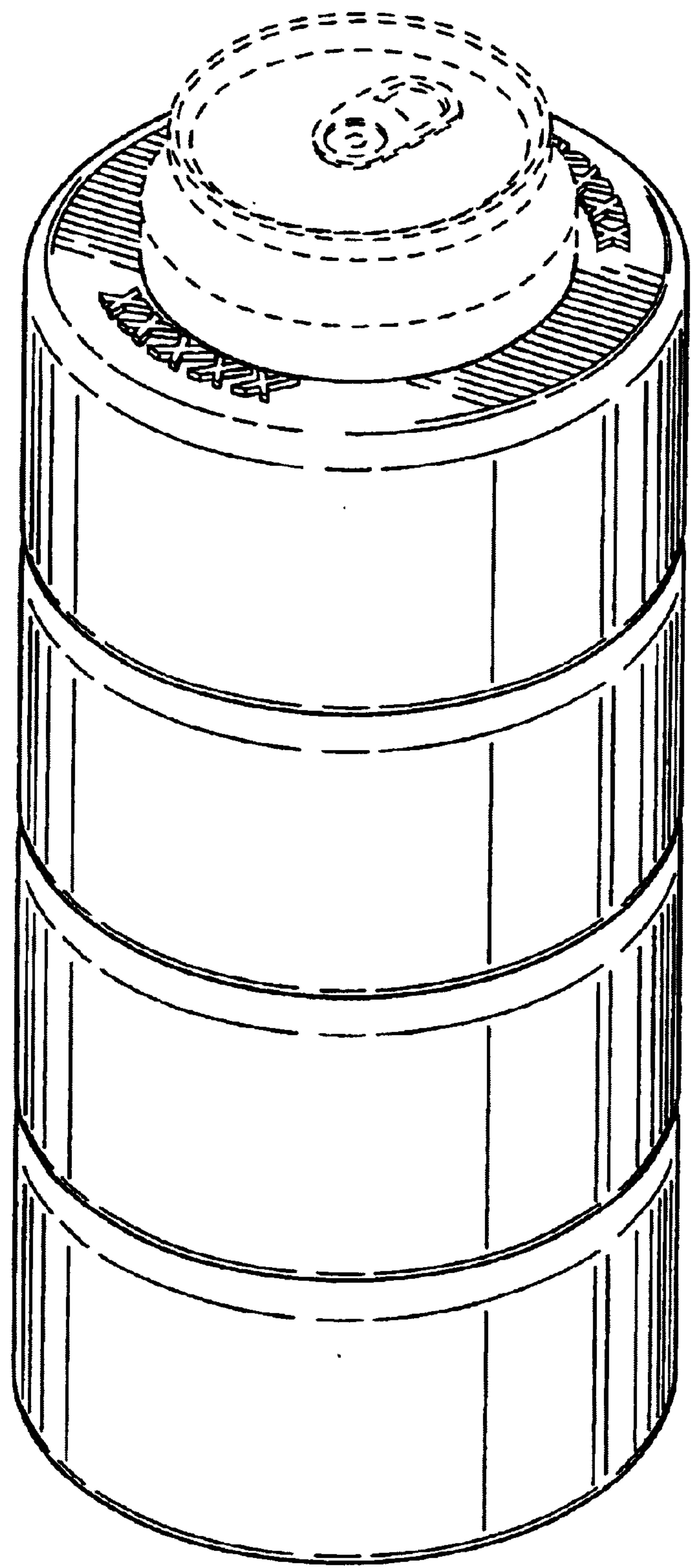

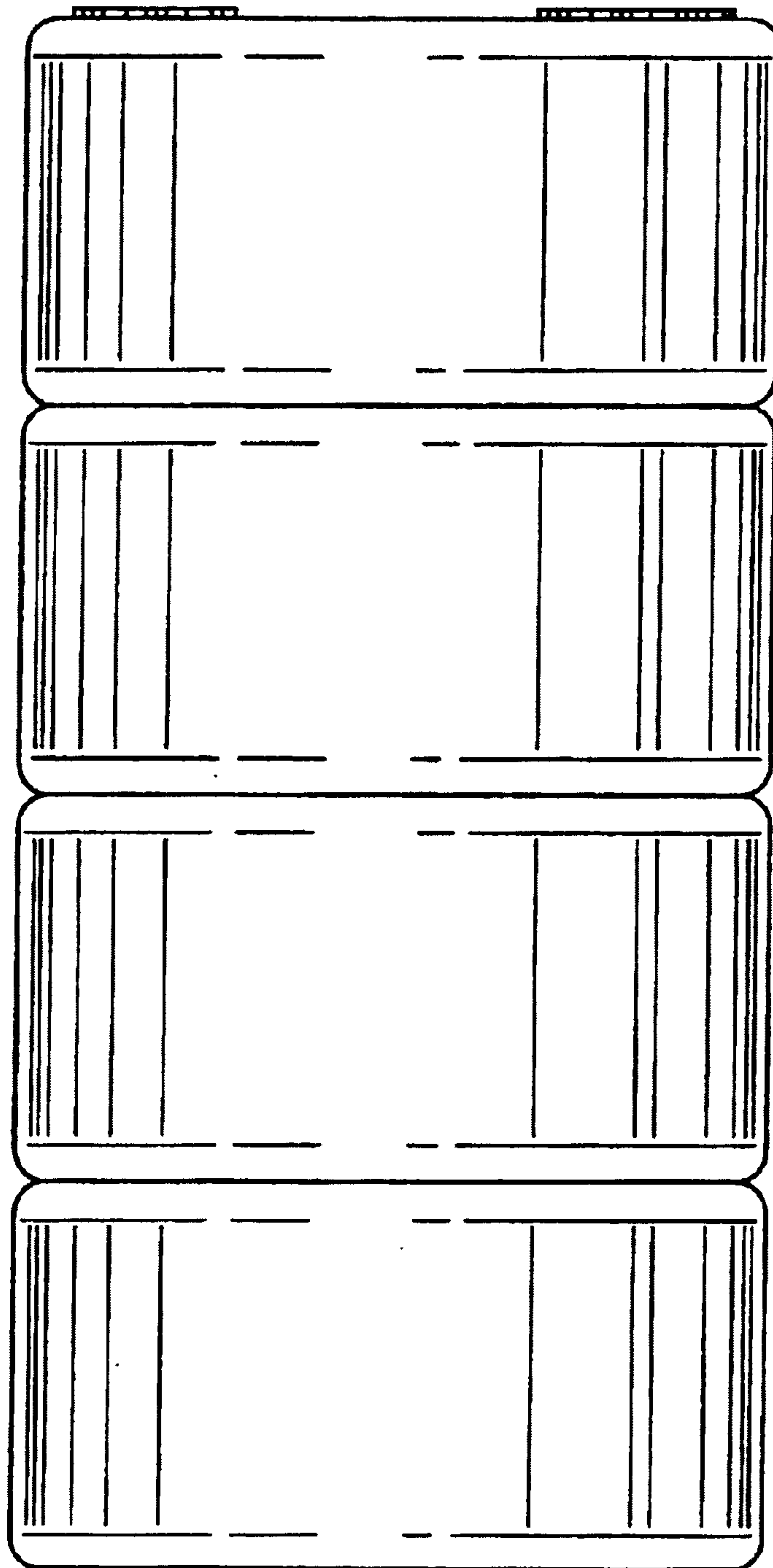

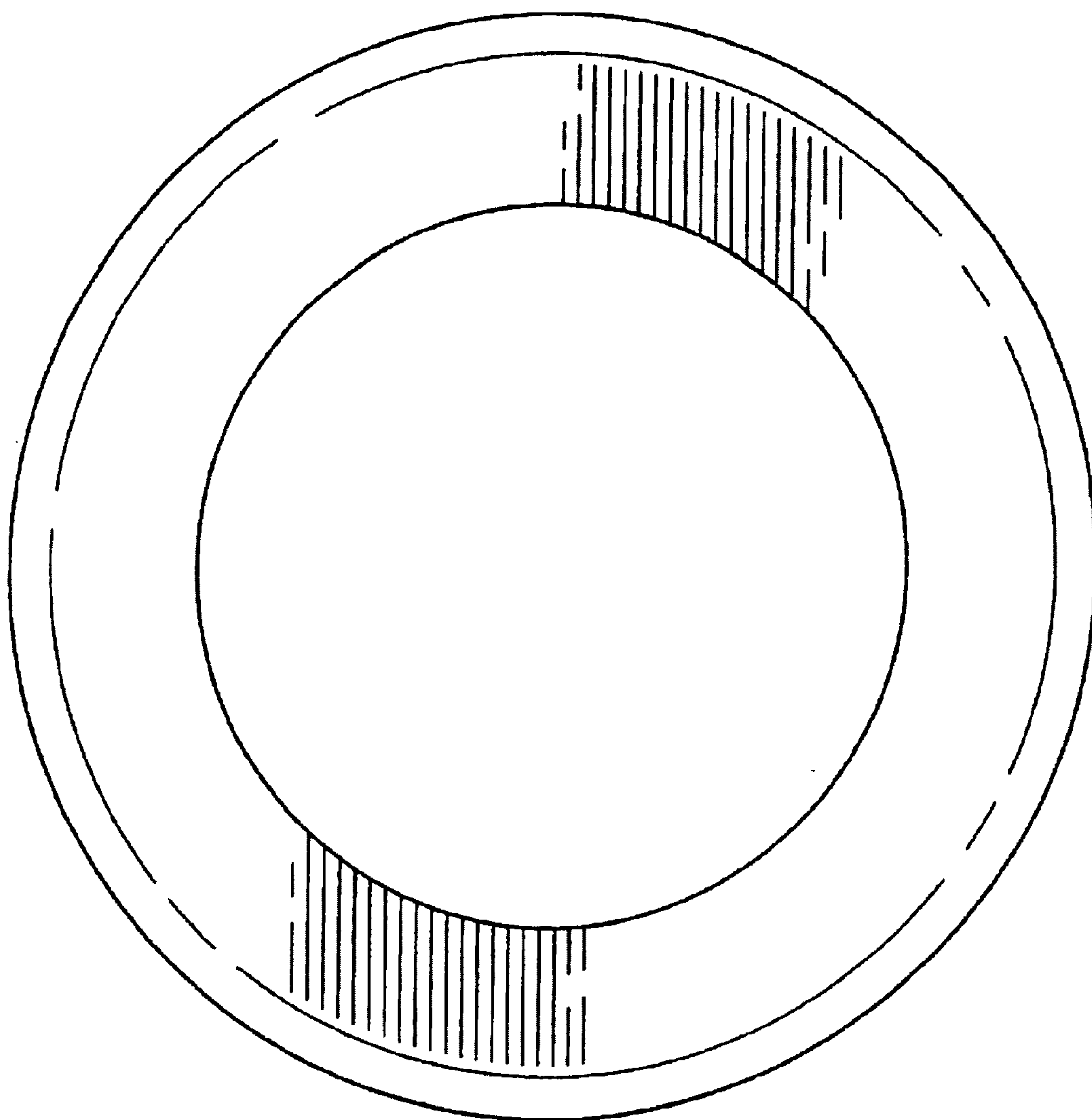
