The ornamental design for a chuck sleeve, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a chuck sleeve embodying the design of the present invention;

FIG. 4 is a left side view of the chuck sleeve shown in FIG. 8;

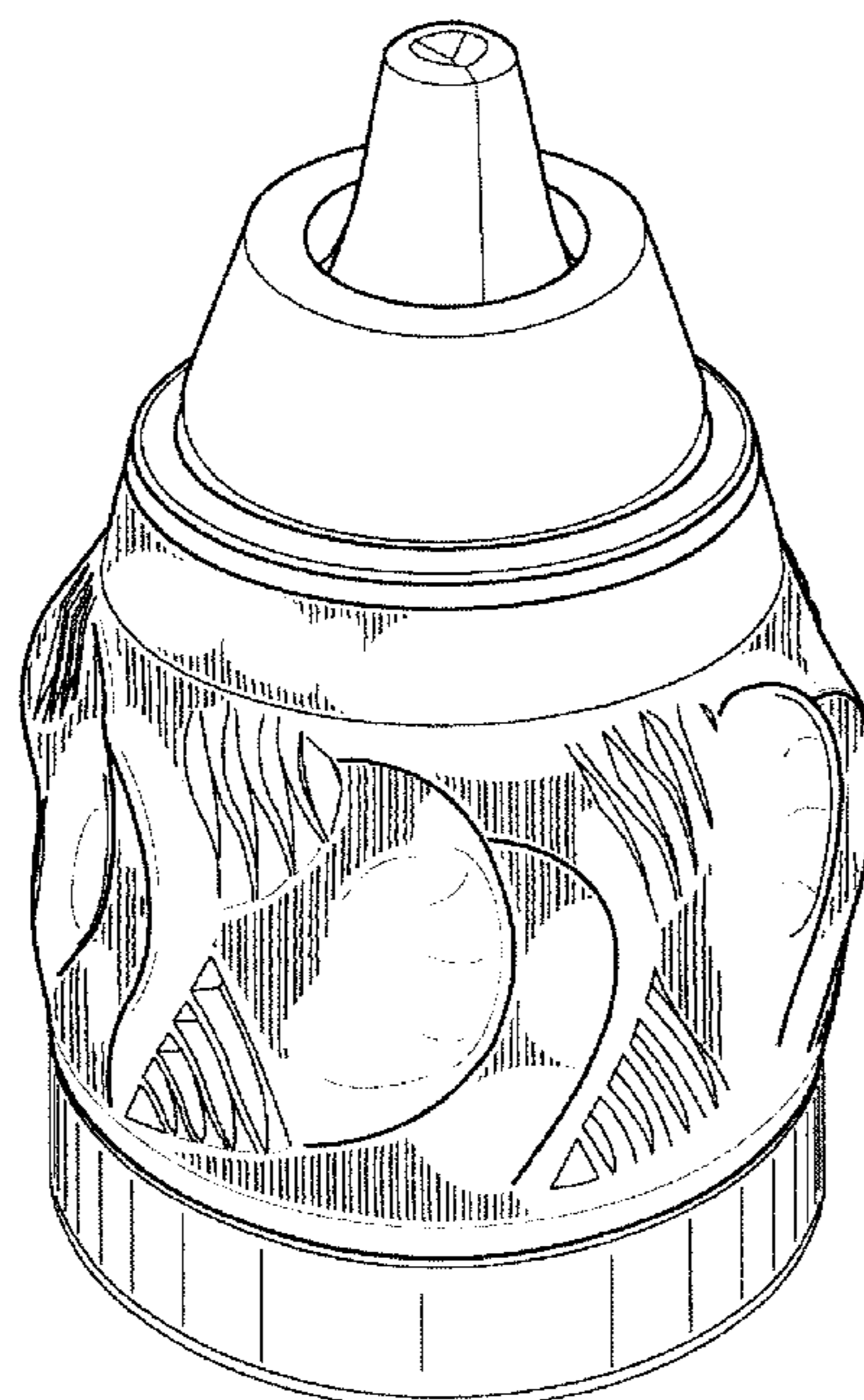
FIG. 5 is a right side view of the chuck sleeve shown in FIG. 8;

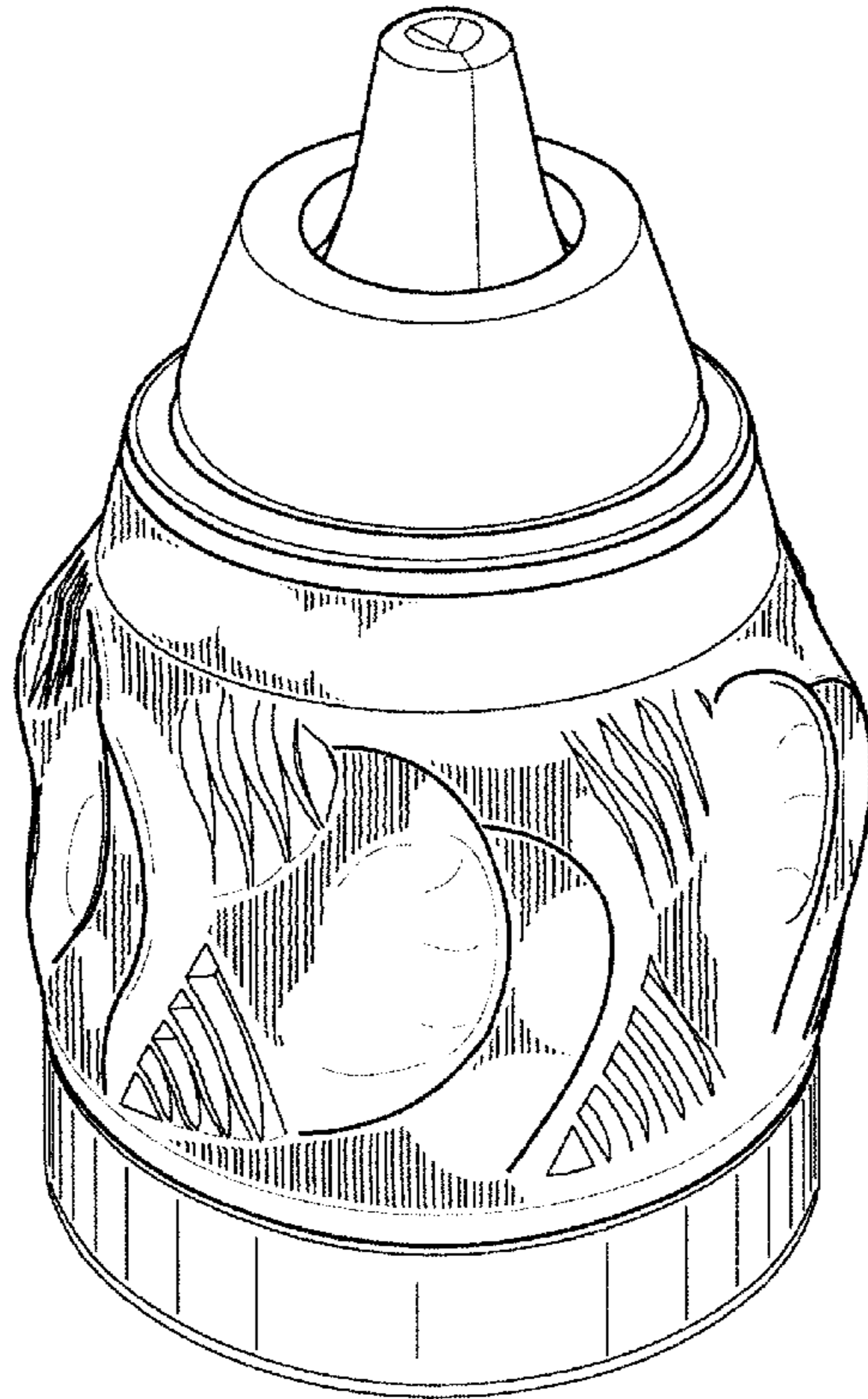
FIG. 6 is a top view of the chuck sleeve shown in FIG. 8; and,

FIG. 7 is a bottom view of the chuck sleeve shown in FIG. 8.

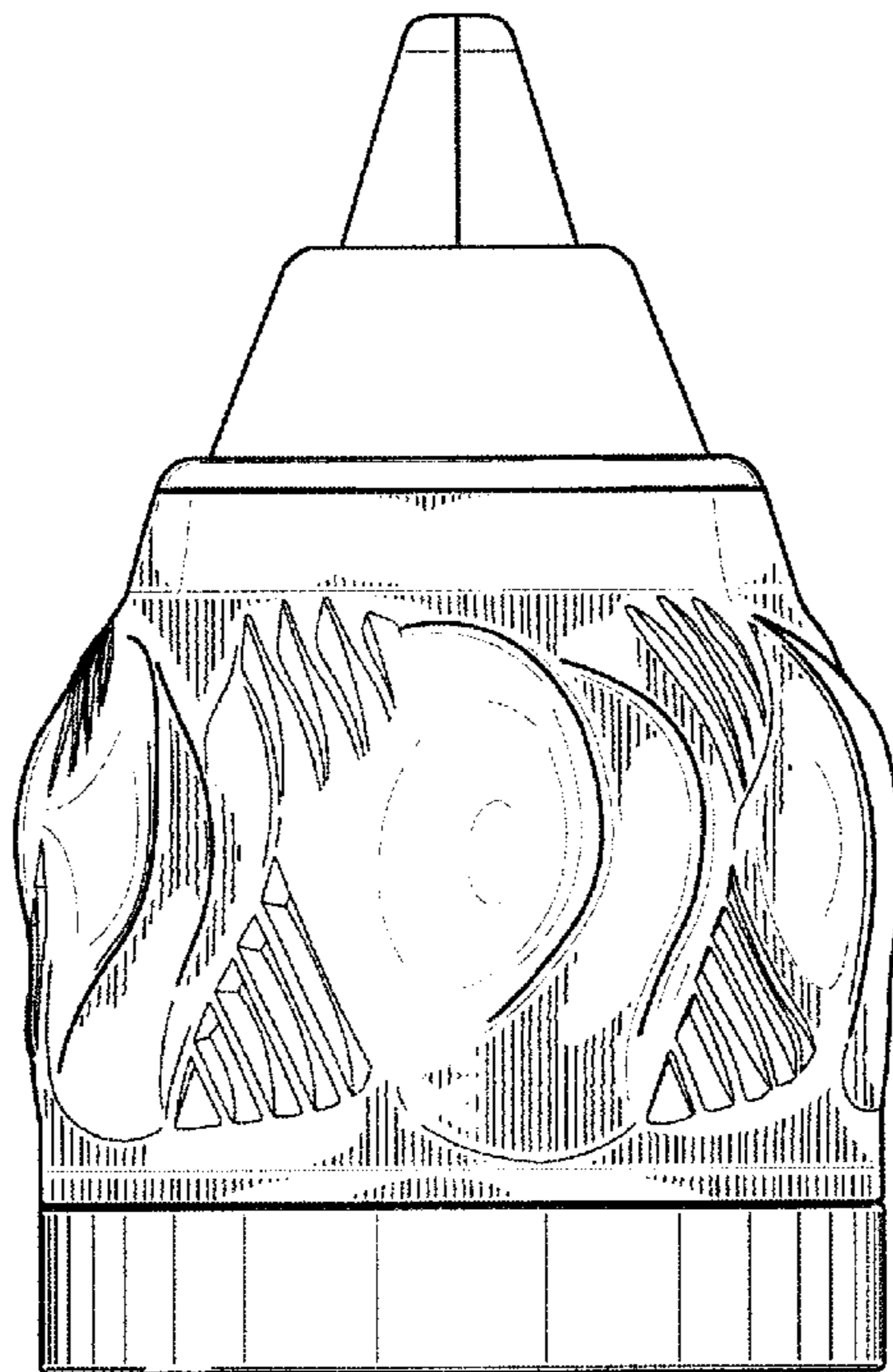

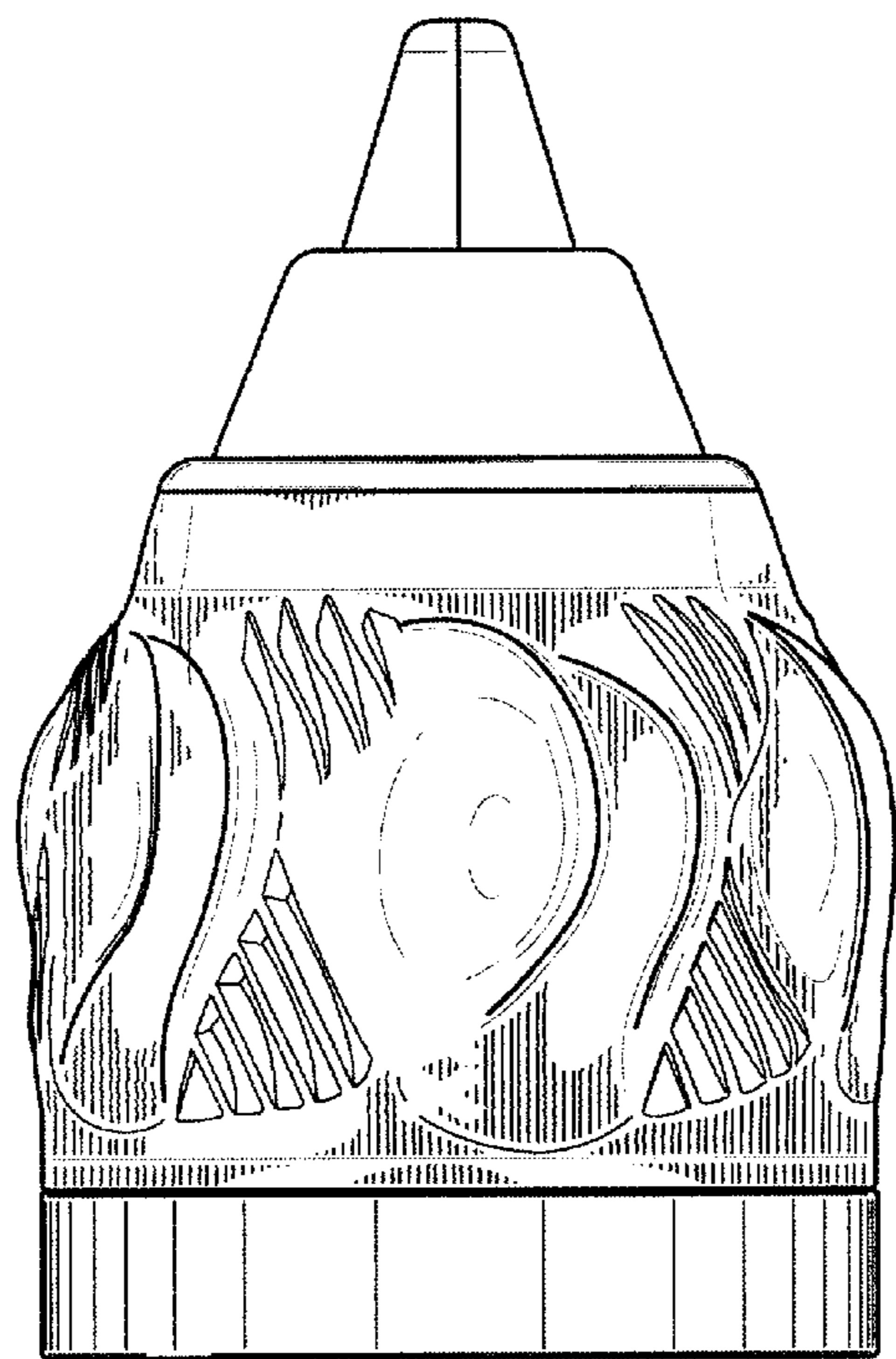




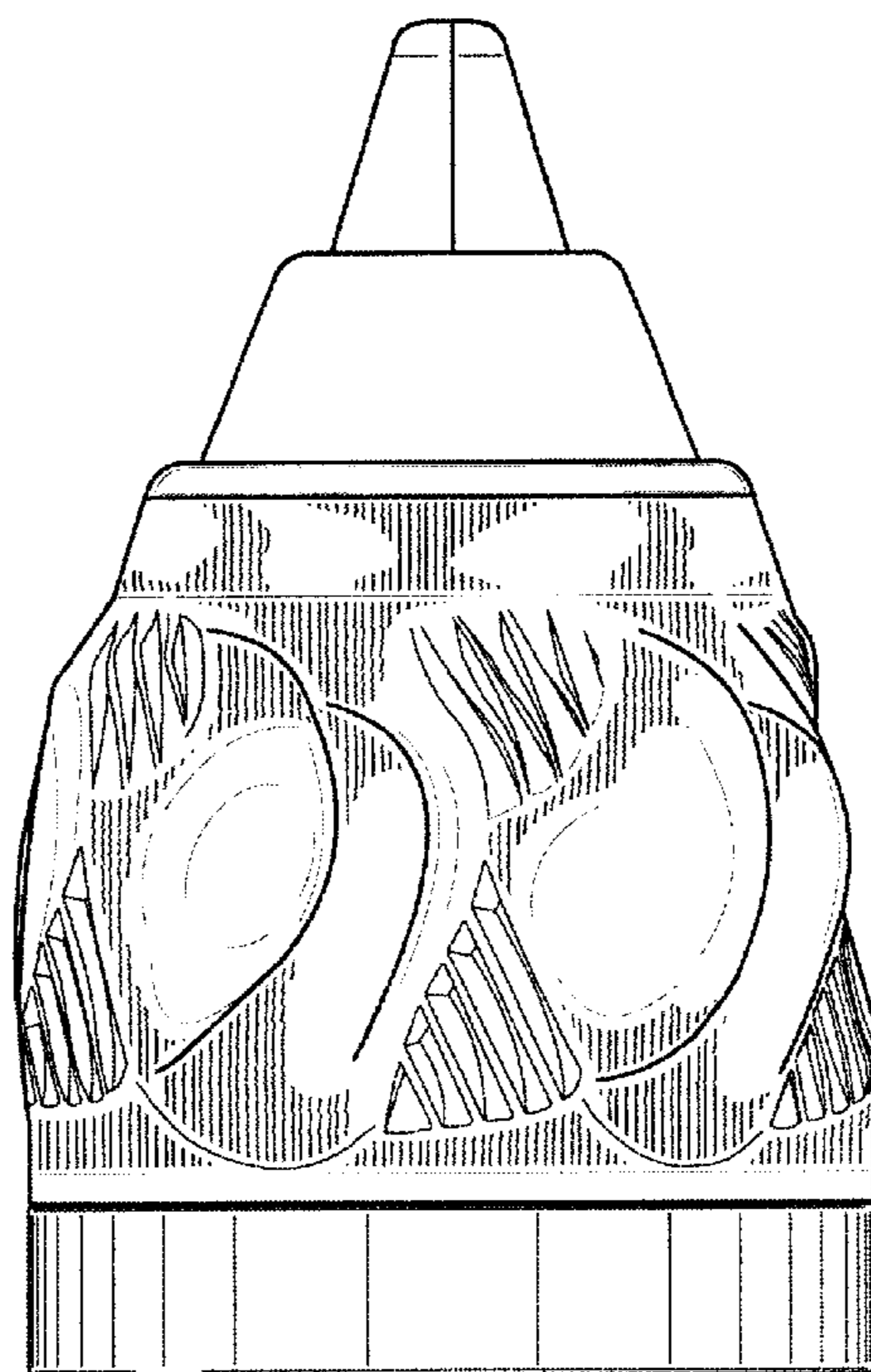

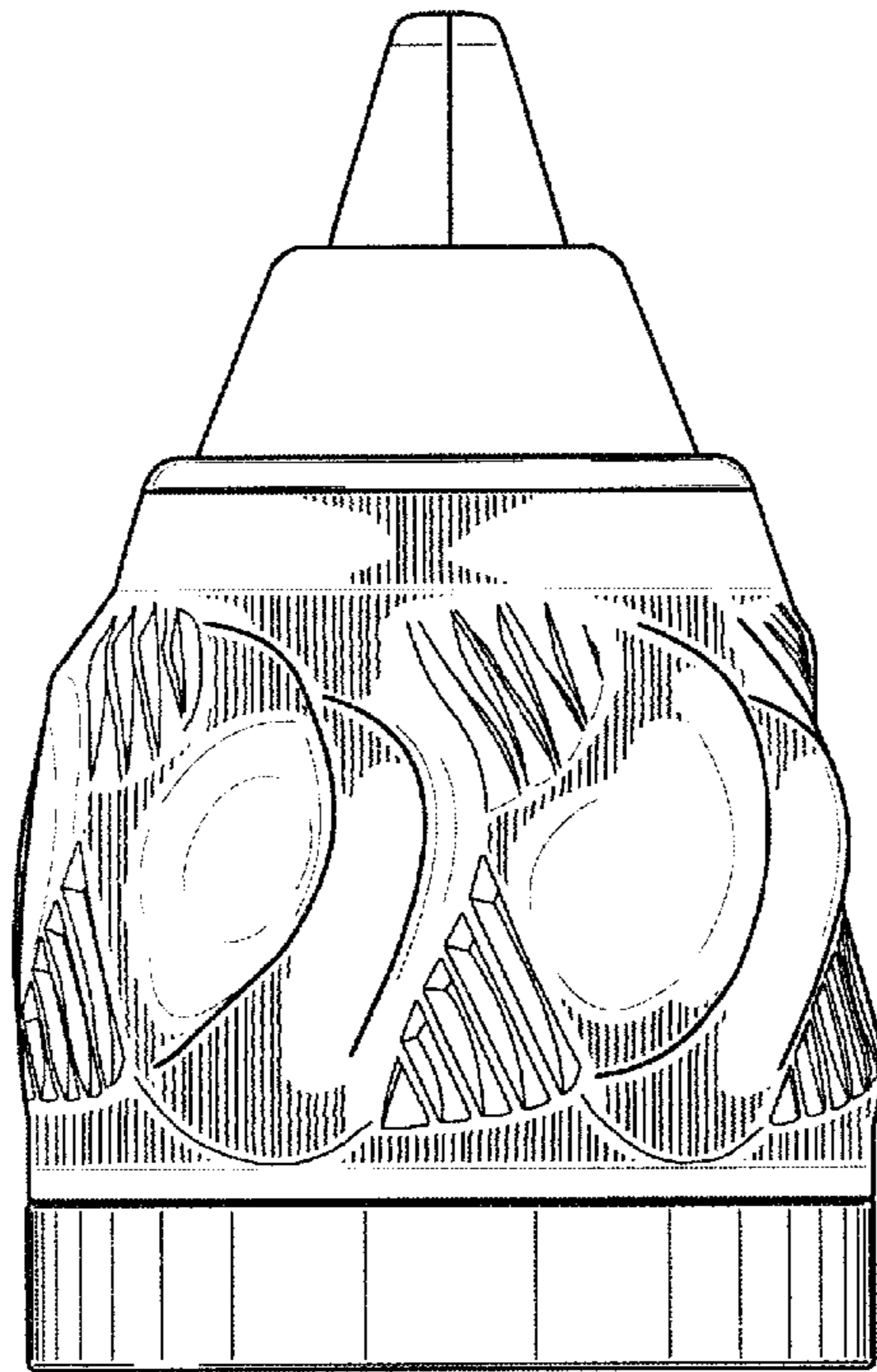

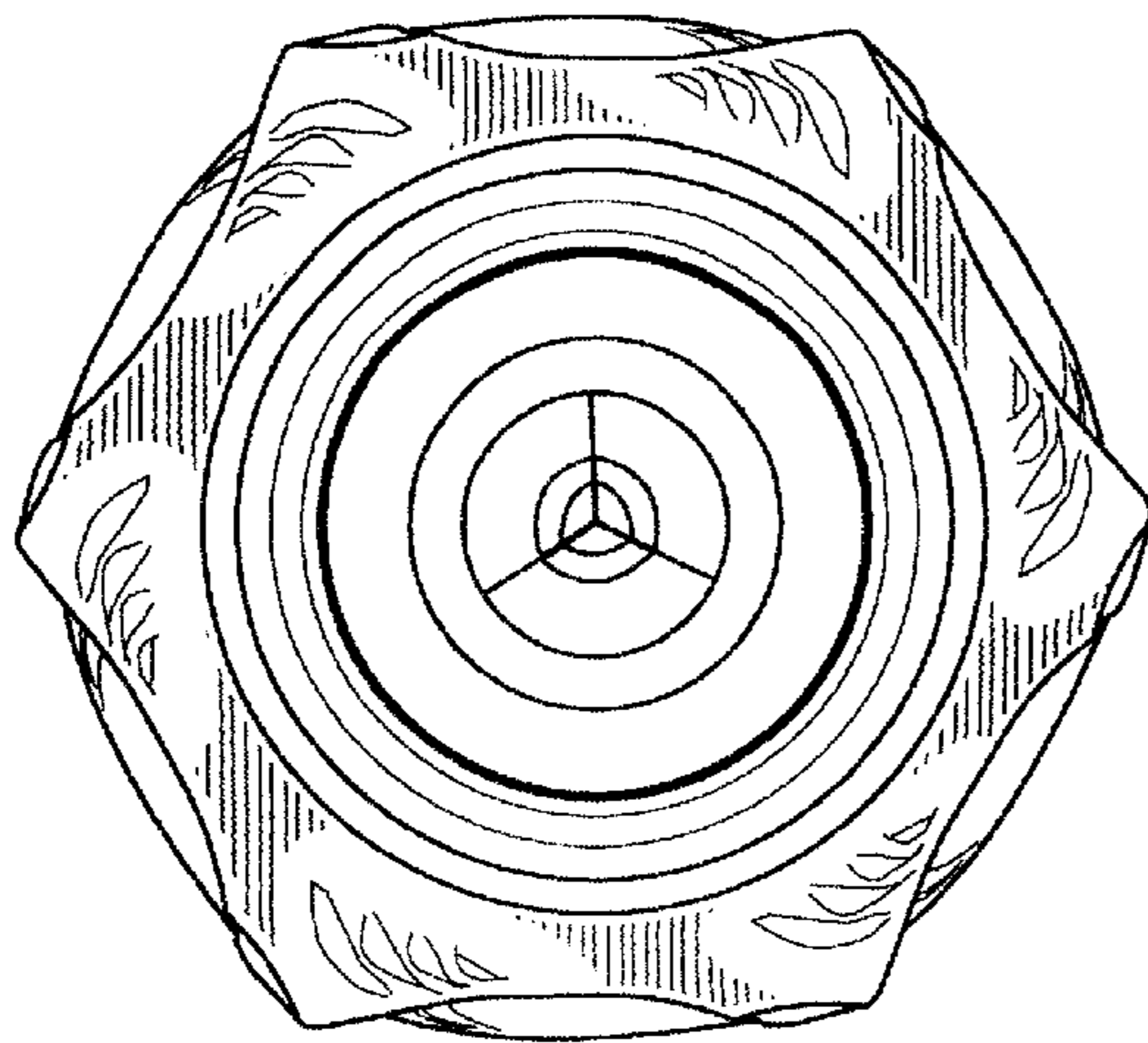

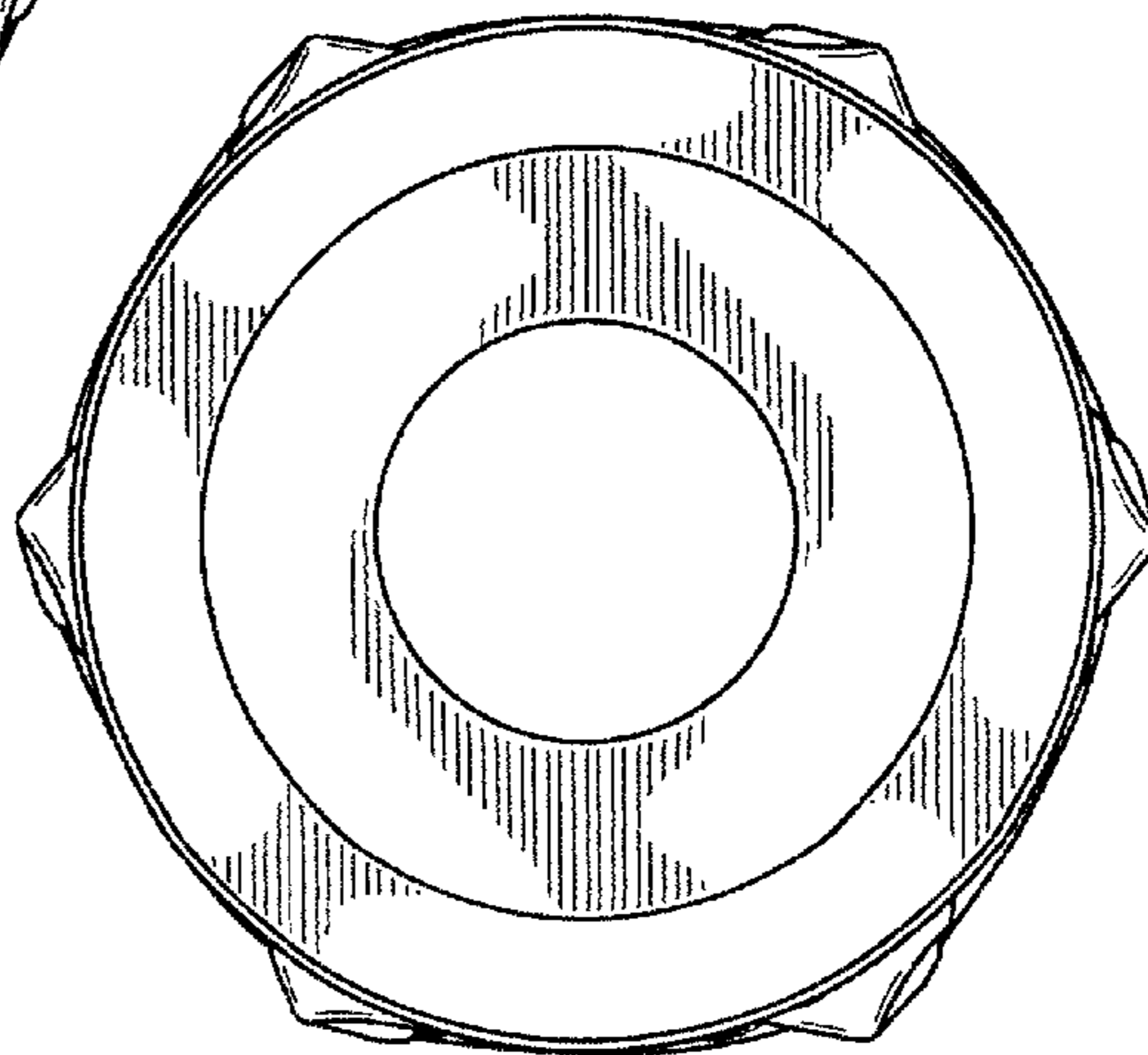
