present invention.

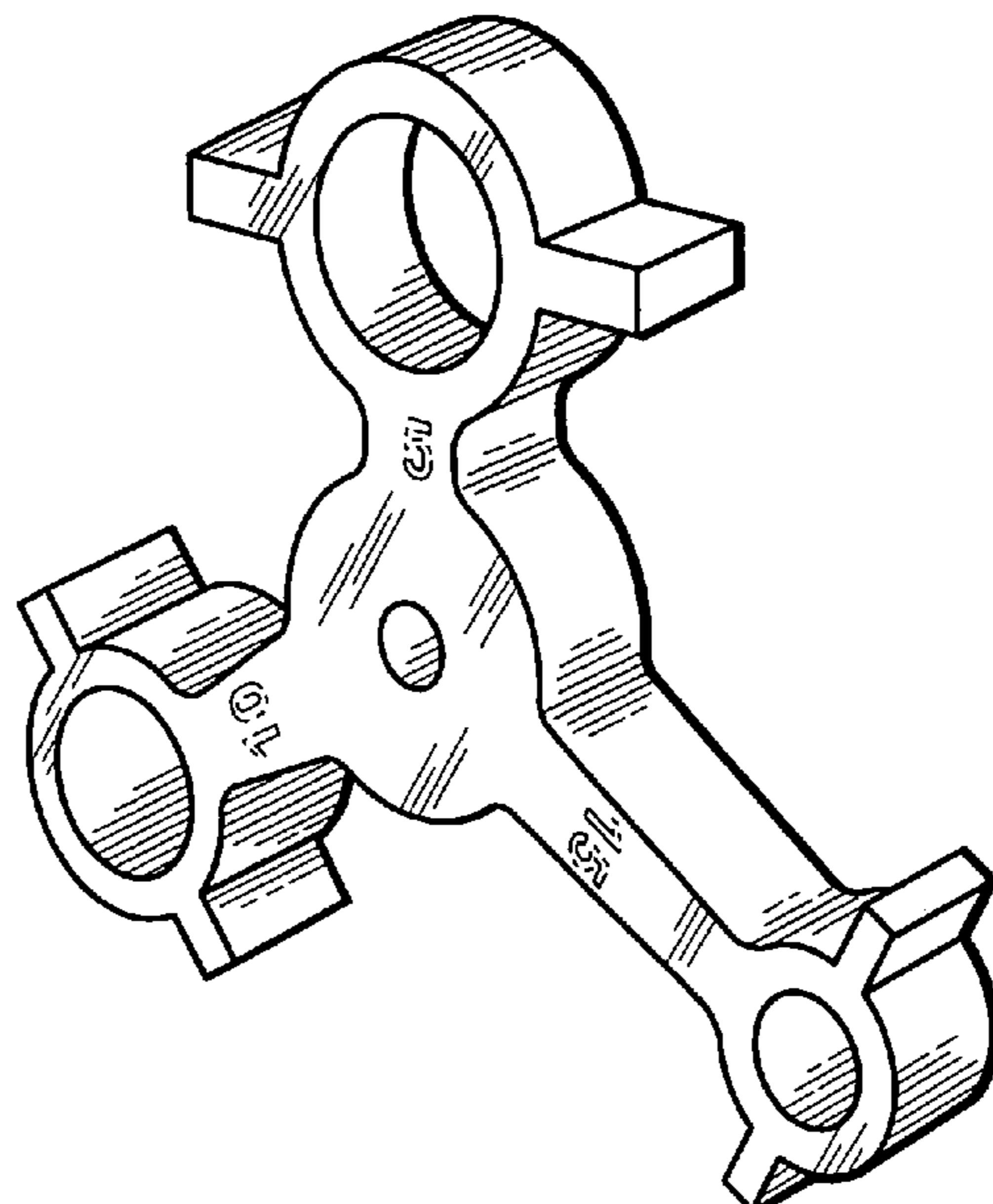

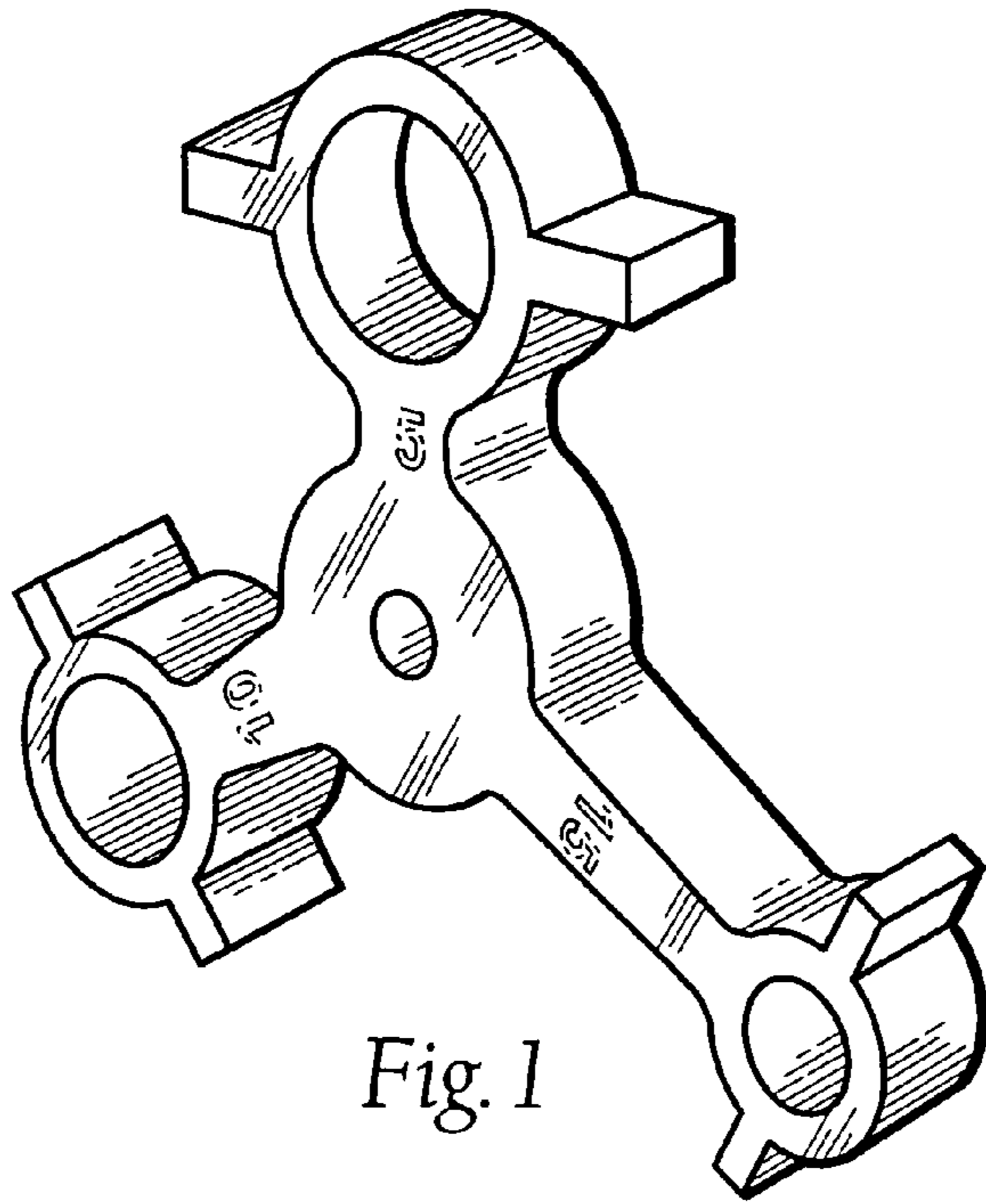

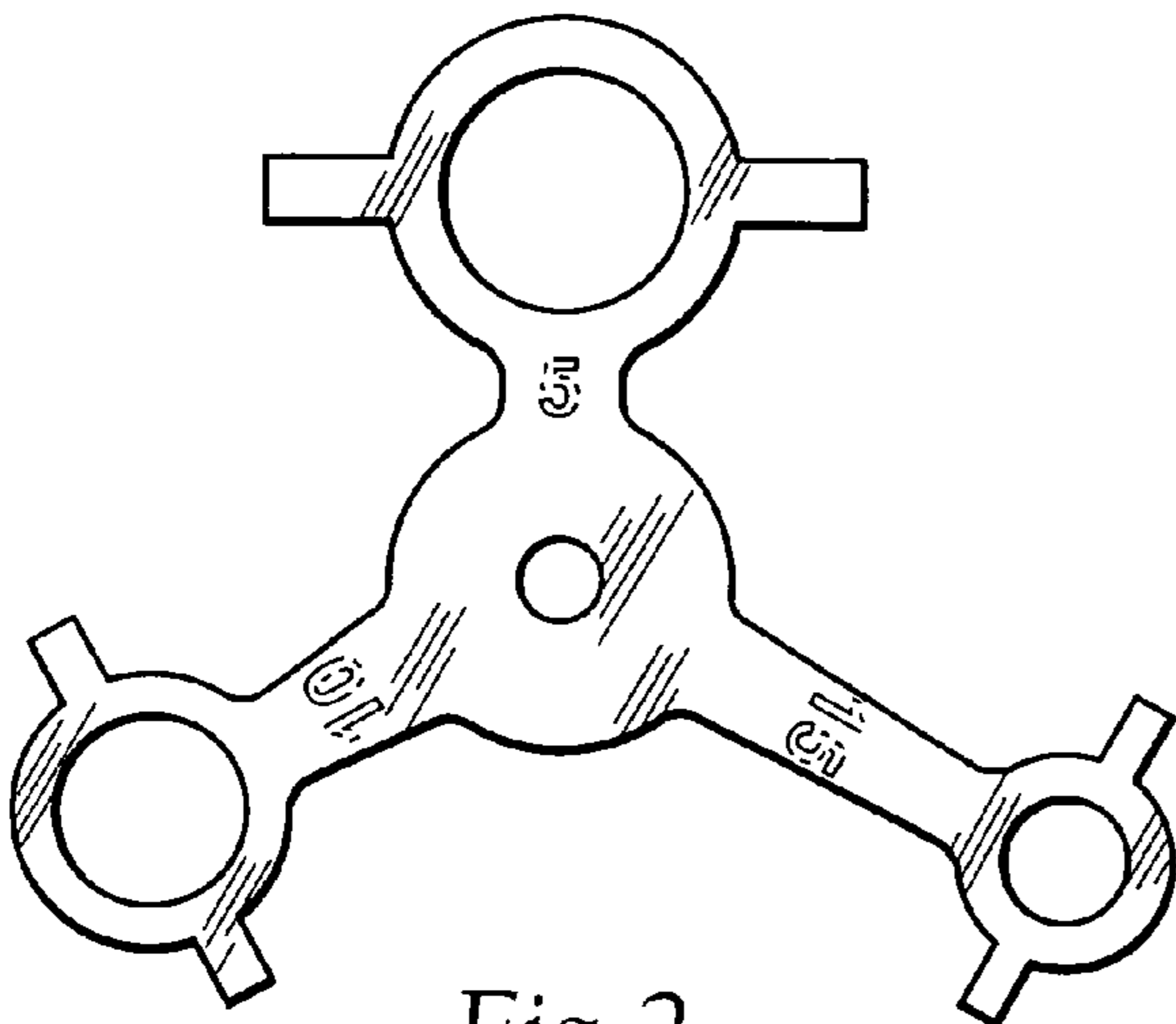

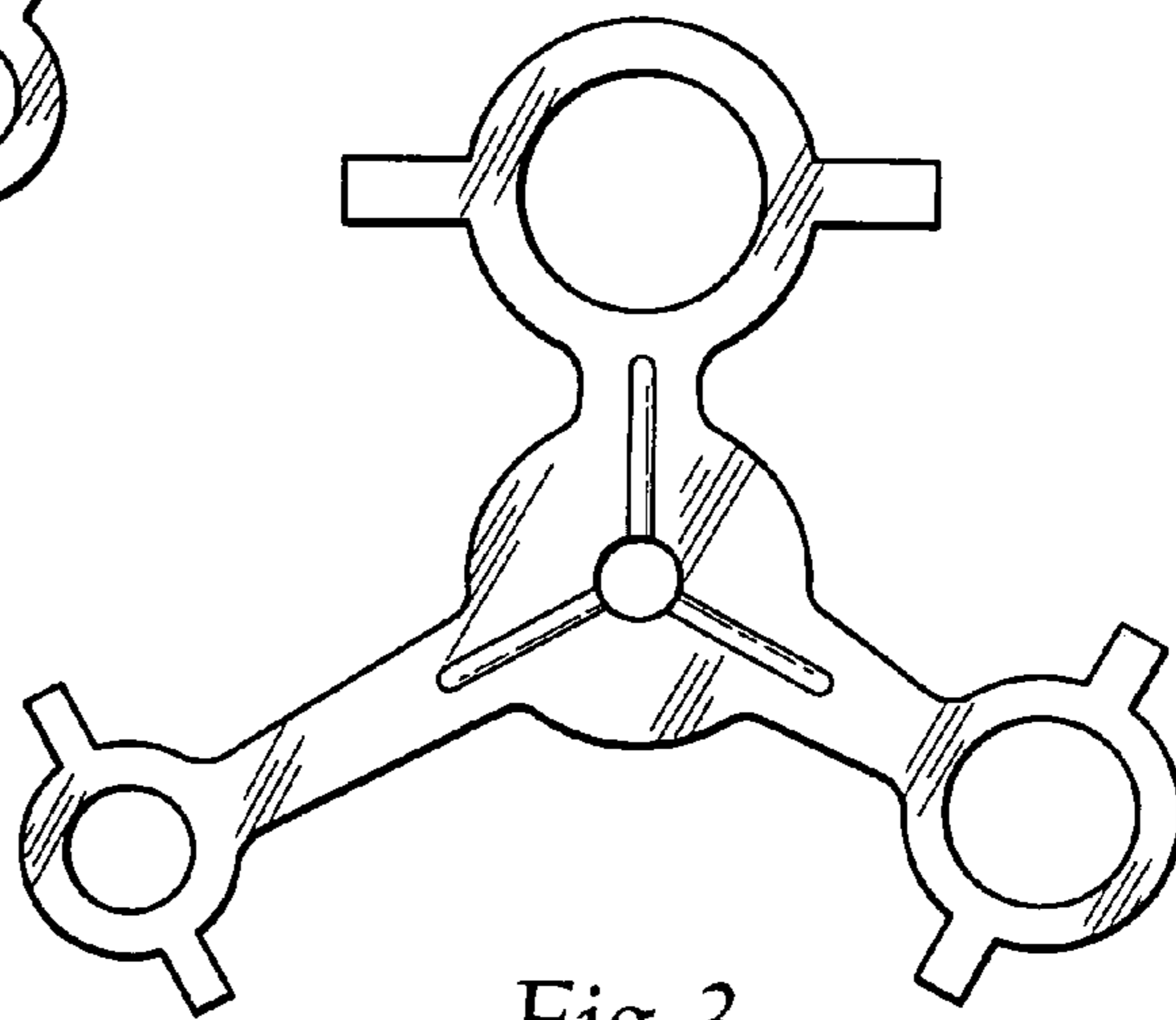
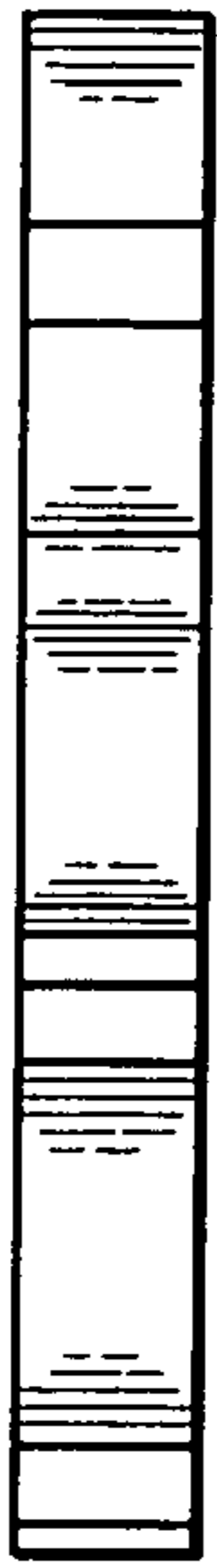
