**DESCRIPTION**

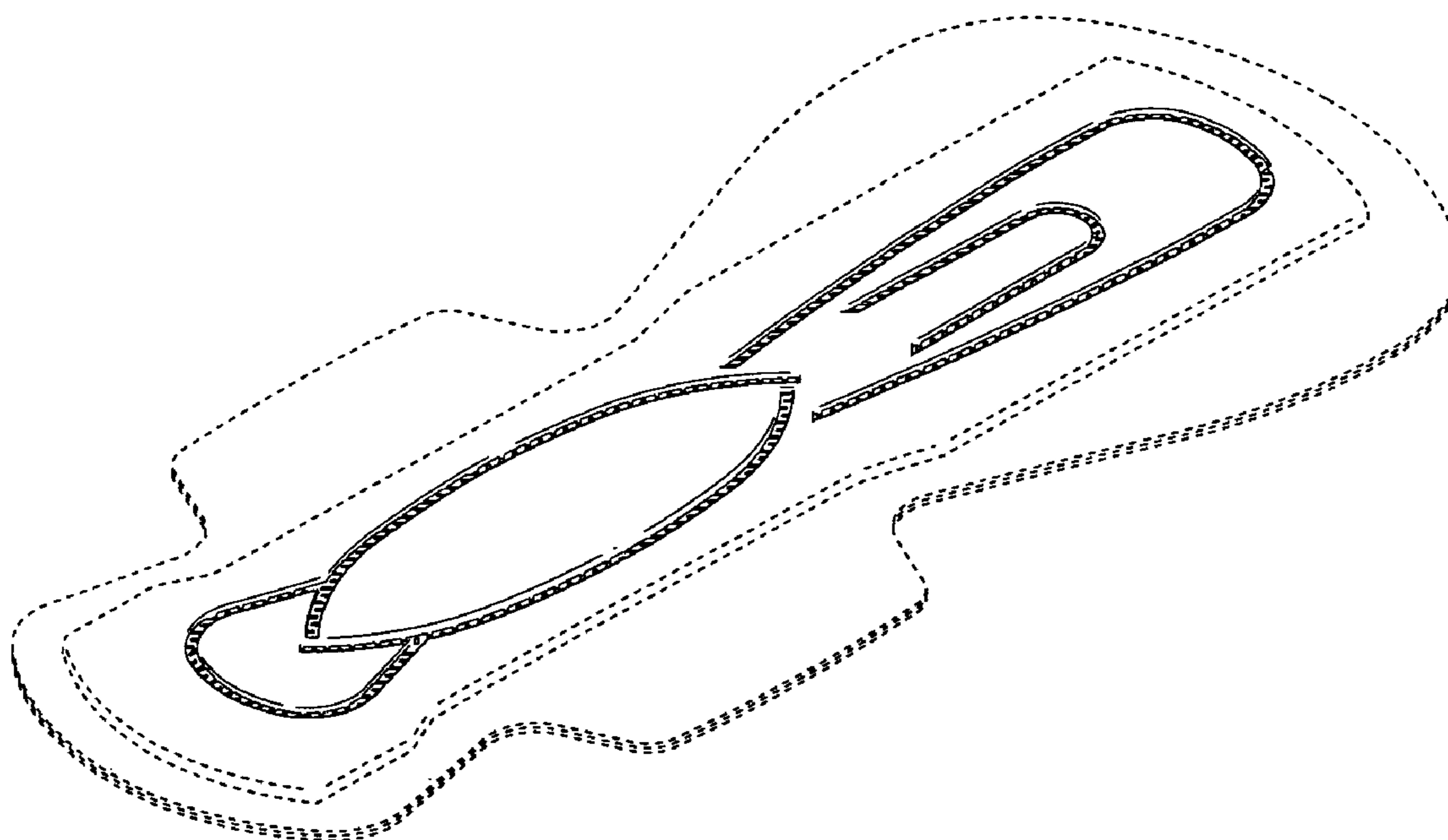

FIG. 2 is a front view thereof. The broken line showing of the sanitary napkin is included for the purpose of illustrating portions of the “article” and forms no part of the claimed design;

FIG. 3 is a back view thereof. The broken line showing of the sanitary napkin is included for the purpose of illustrating portions of the “article” and forms no part of the claimed design; and,

FIG. 4 is an enlarged cross sectional view taken along A-A, and between B-B and B'-B'. The broken line showing of the sanitary napkin is included for the purpose of illustrating portions of the “article” and forms no part of the claimed design.

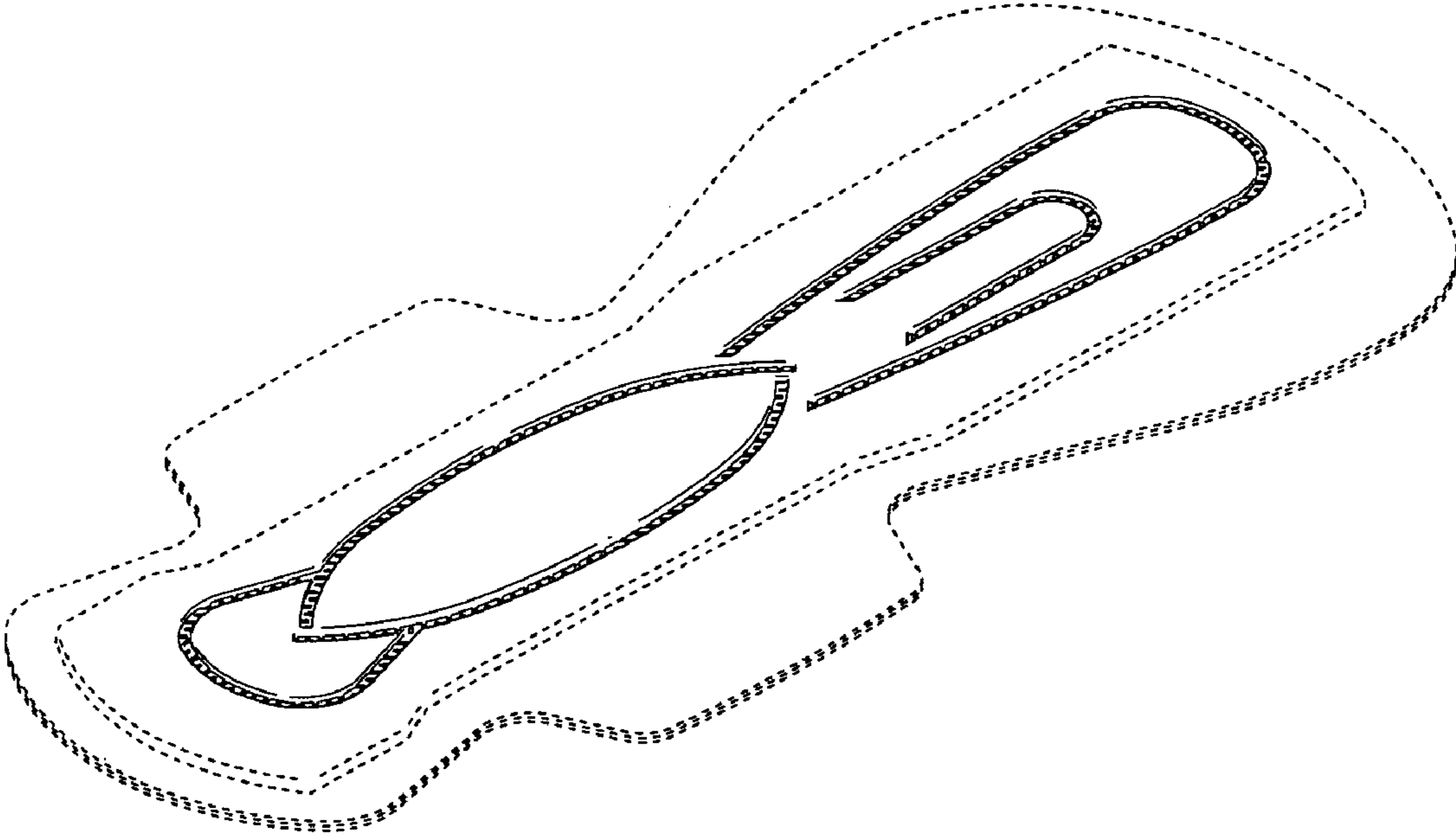

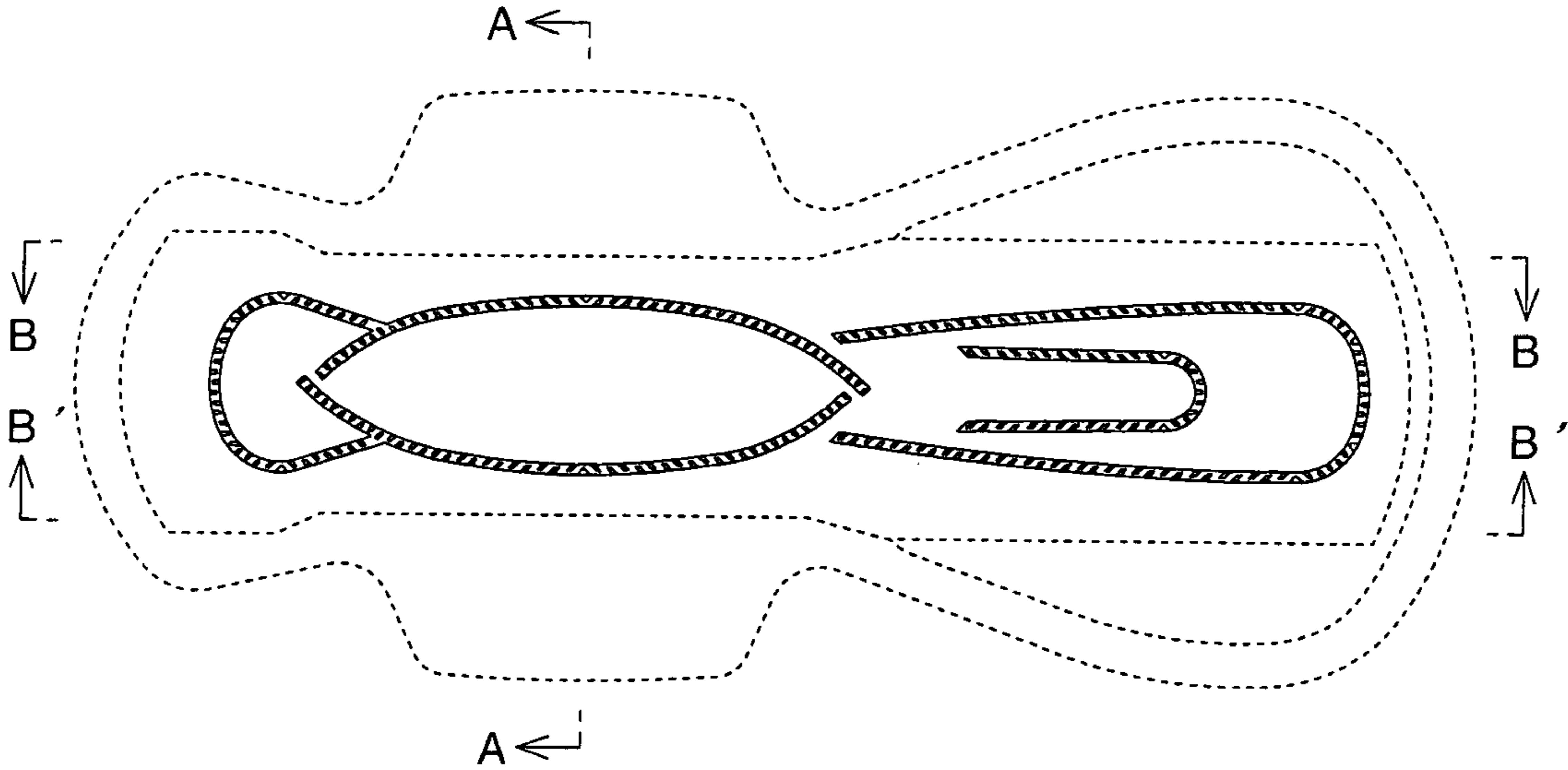

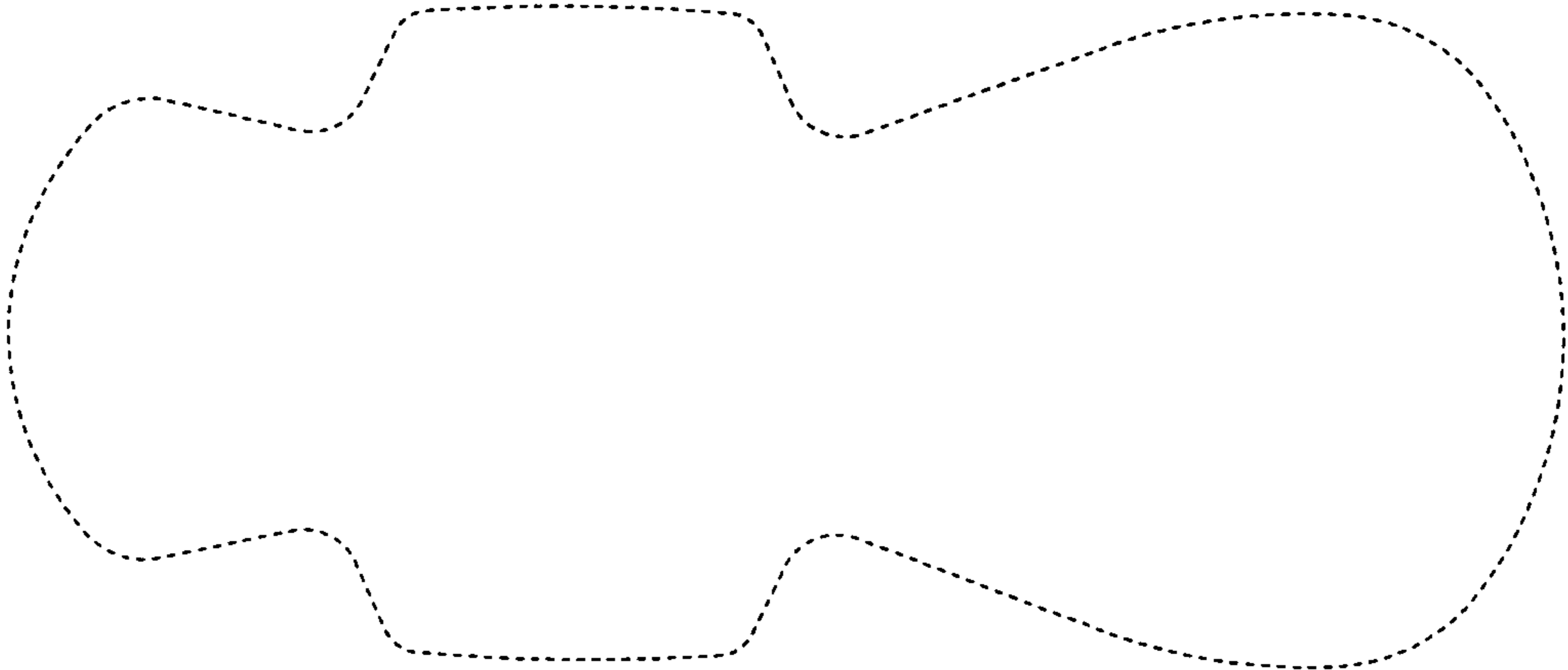

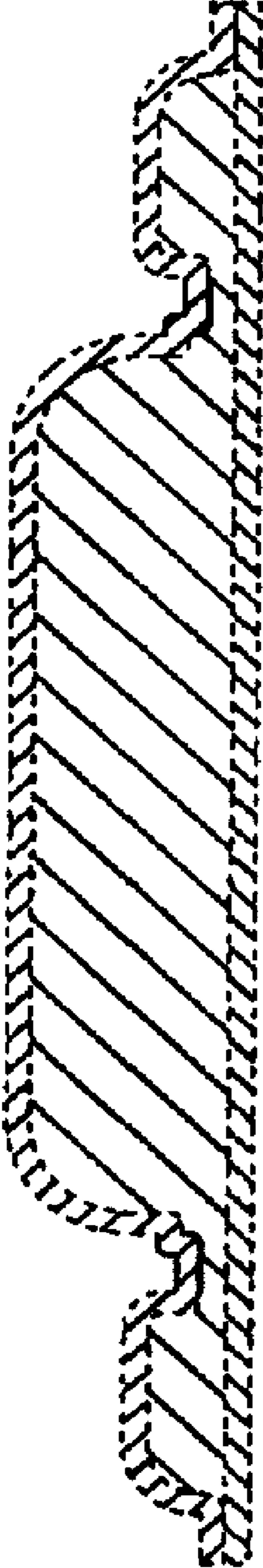
