FIG. 6 is a side elevational view of the bow tie of FIG. 5;

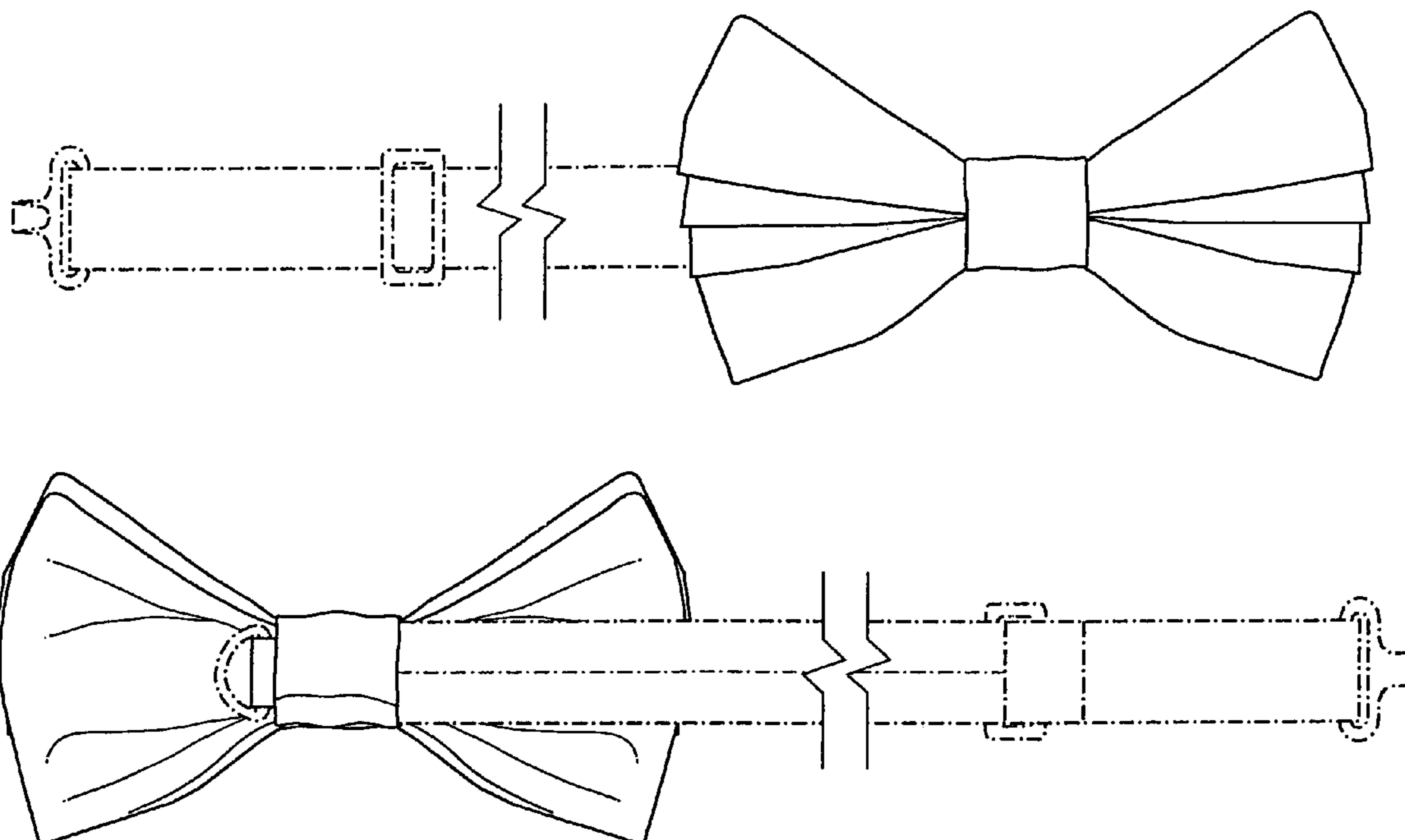
FIG. 7 is a top elevational view of the bow tie of FIG. 5; and,

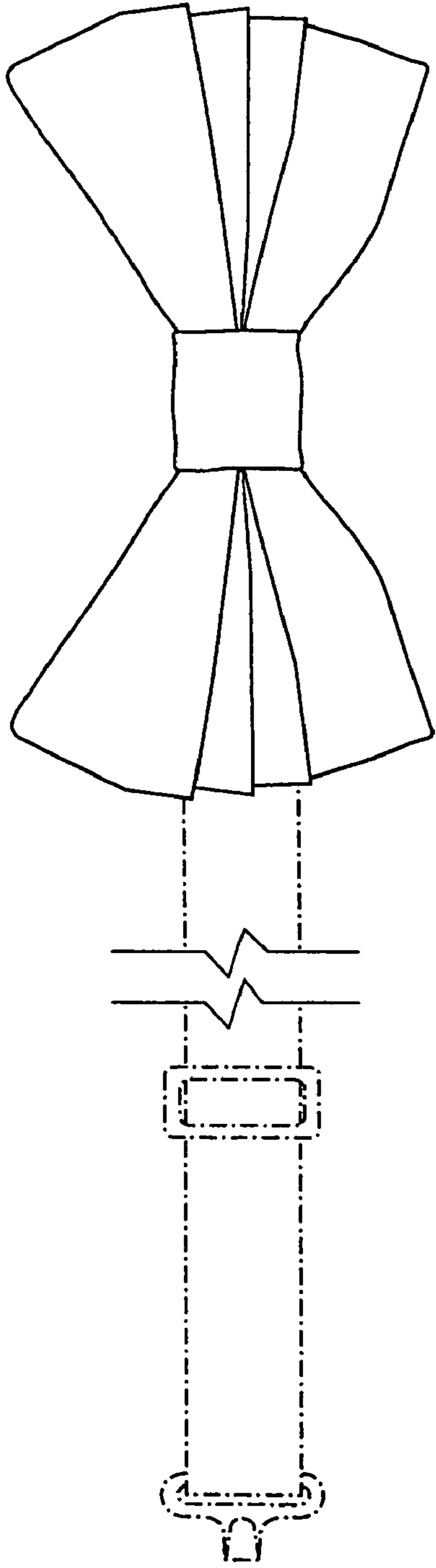

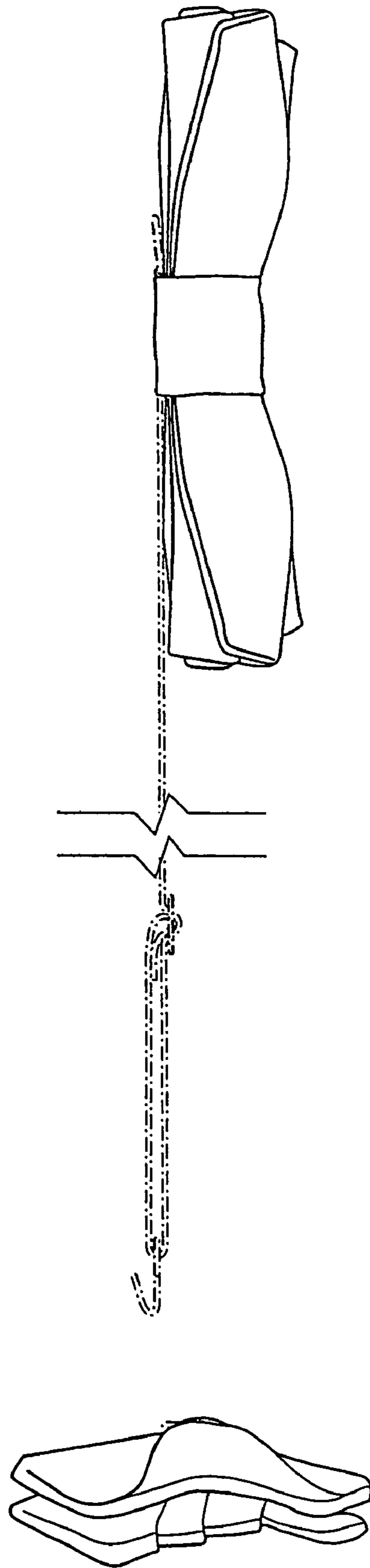
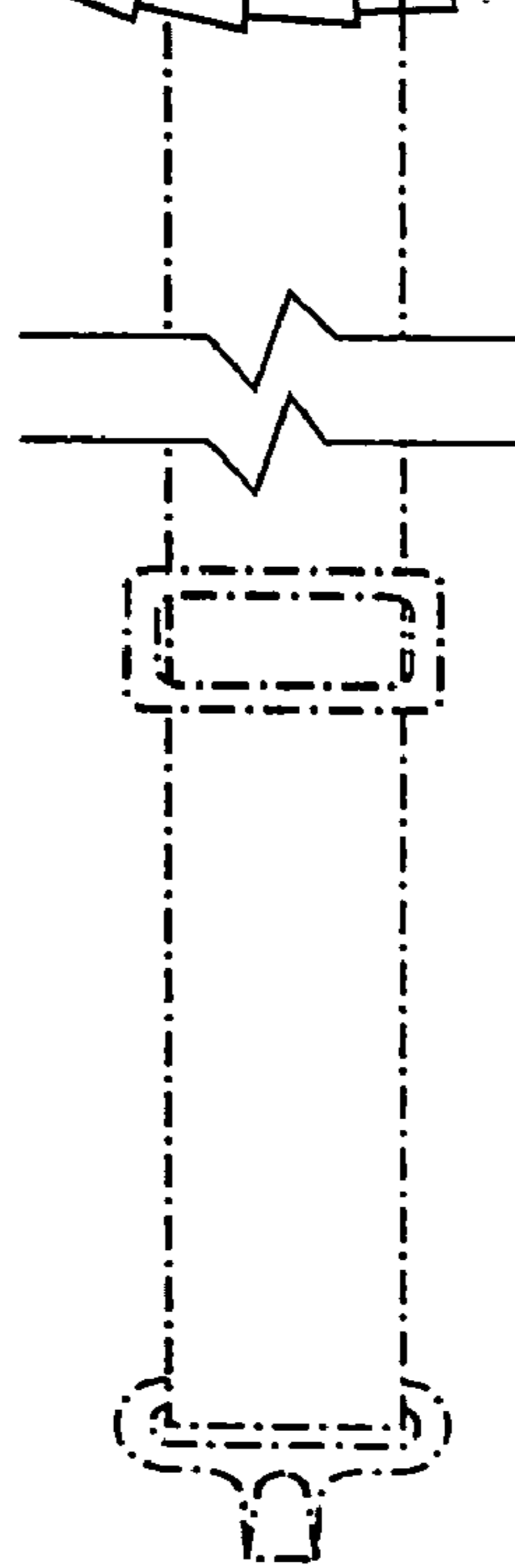
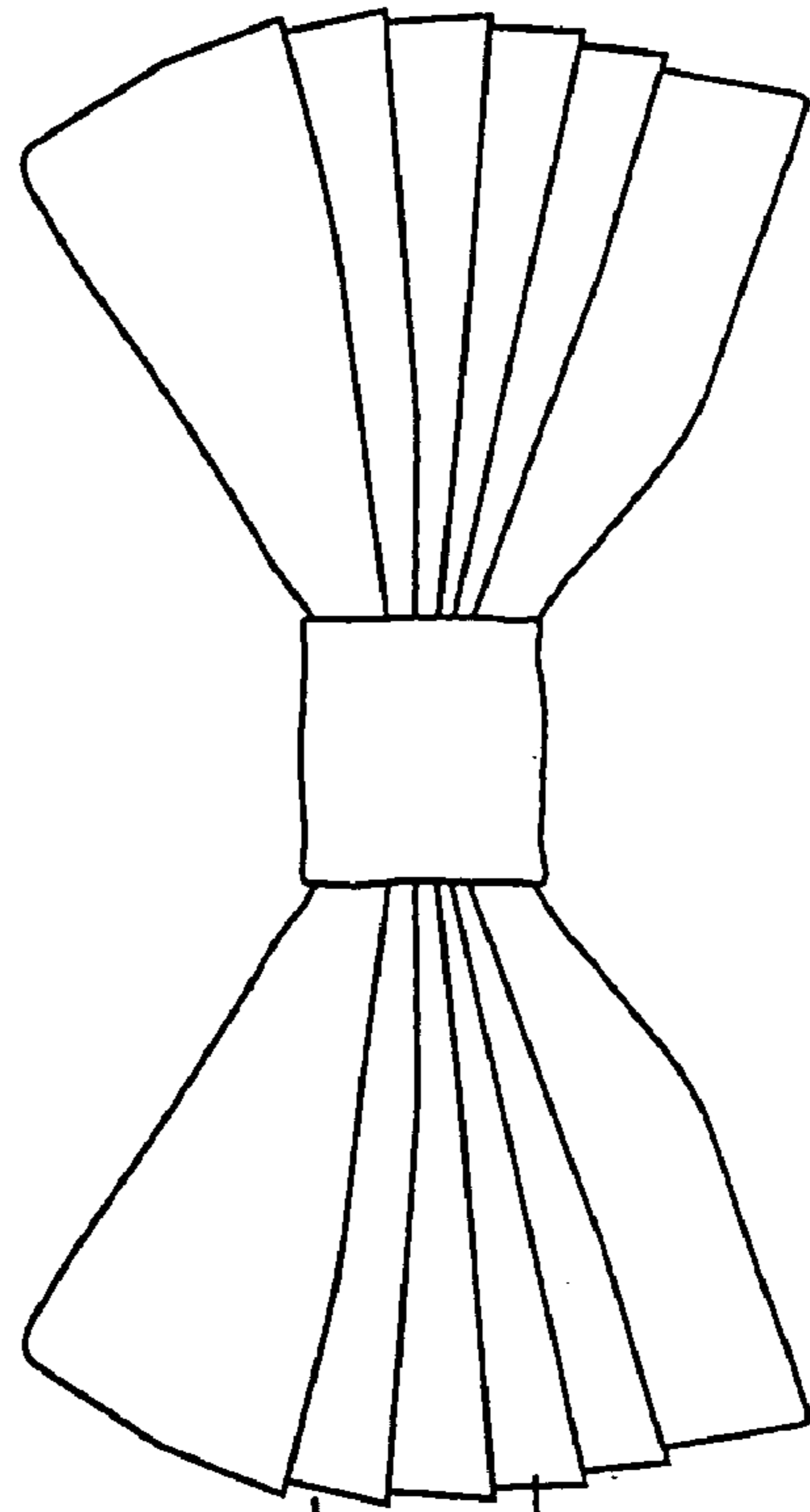
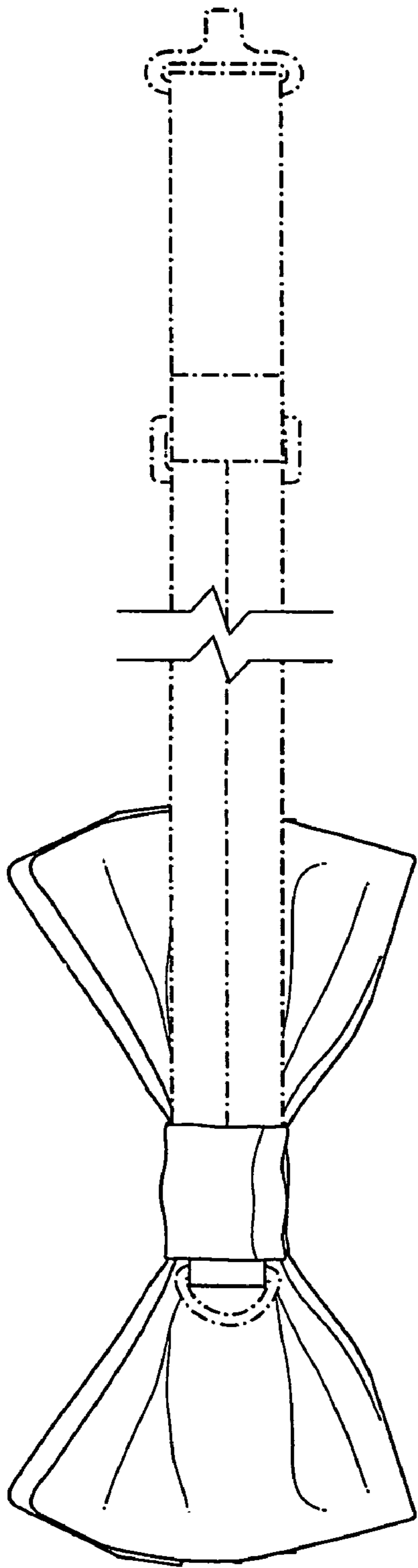

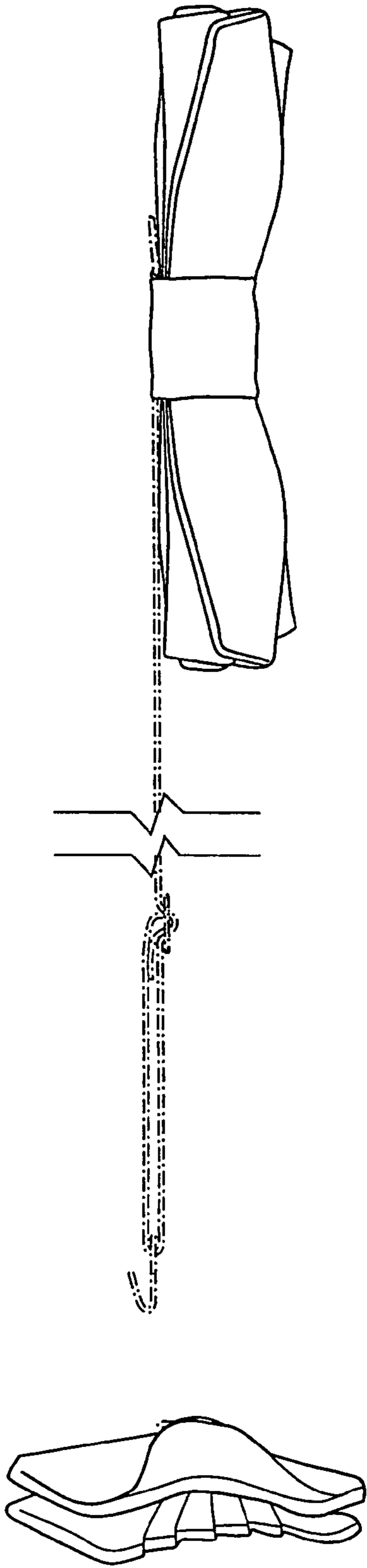

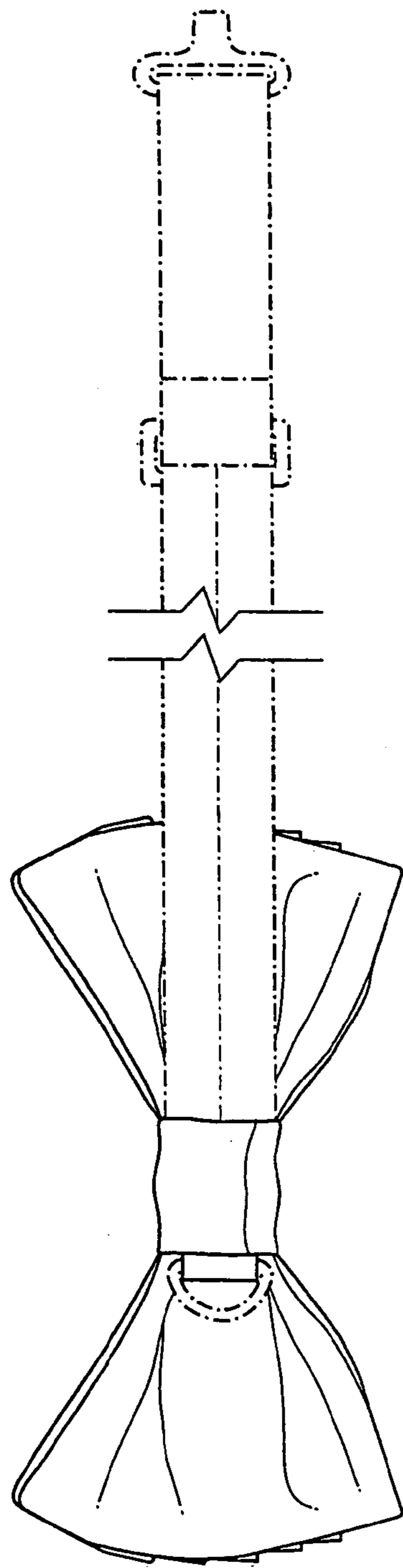
