FIG. 1 is a perspective view of an accessory holder with a female end of the holder being fixed to a bag or other object; FIG. 2 is a front view of the holder; FIG. 3 is a rear view of the holder; FIG. 4 is a side view of the holder; FIG. 5 is a top view of the holder; FIG. 6 is a bottom view of the holder; and, FIG. 7 is a perspective view of the holder with a male end of the holder removed from the female end of the holder. The portions shown in broken lines are included for illustrative purpose only and form no part of the claimed design.
