(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a decorating kit case, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front, right side perspective view of a decorating kit case showing my new invention, shown in an opened condition;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof, shown in a closed condition;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof; and,

FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof.

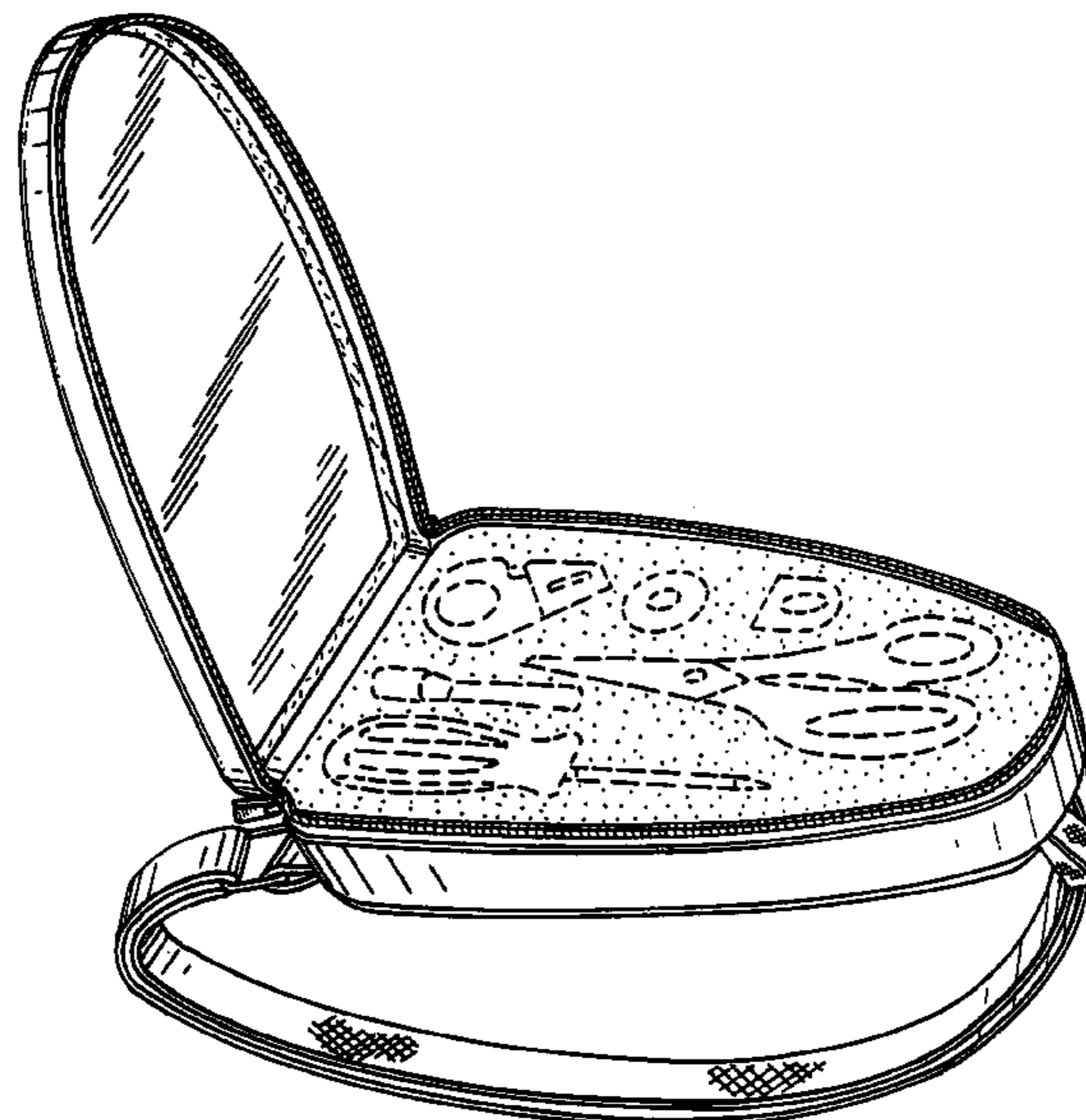
The dash-dash-dash broken lines shown in the drawings are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design.

The cross-hatched pattern shown on the drawings represents a textured, fabric surface.

The stippled shading shown in FIG. 1 represents a contrasting surface material.

The randomly placed lines shown on the strip on the inside edge of the opened decorating kit case in FIG. 1 represents a second contrasting surface material.

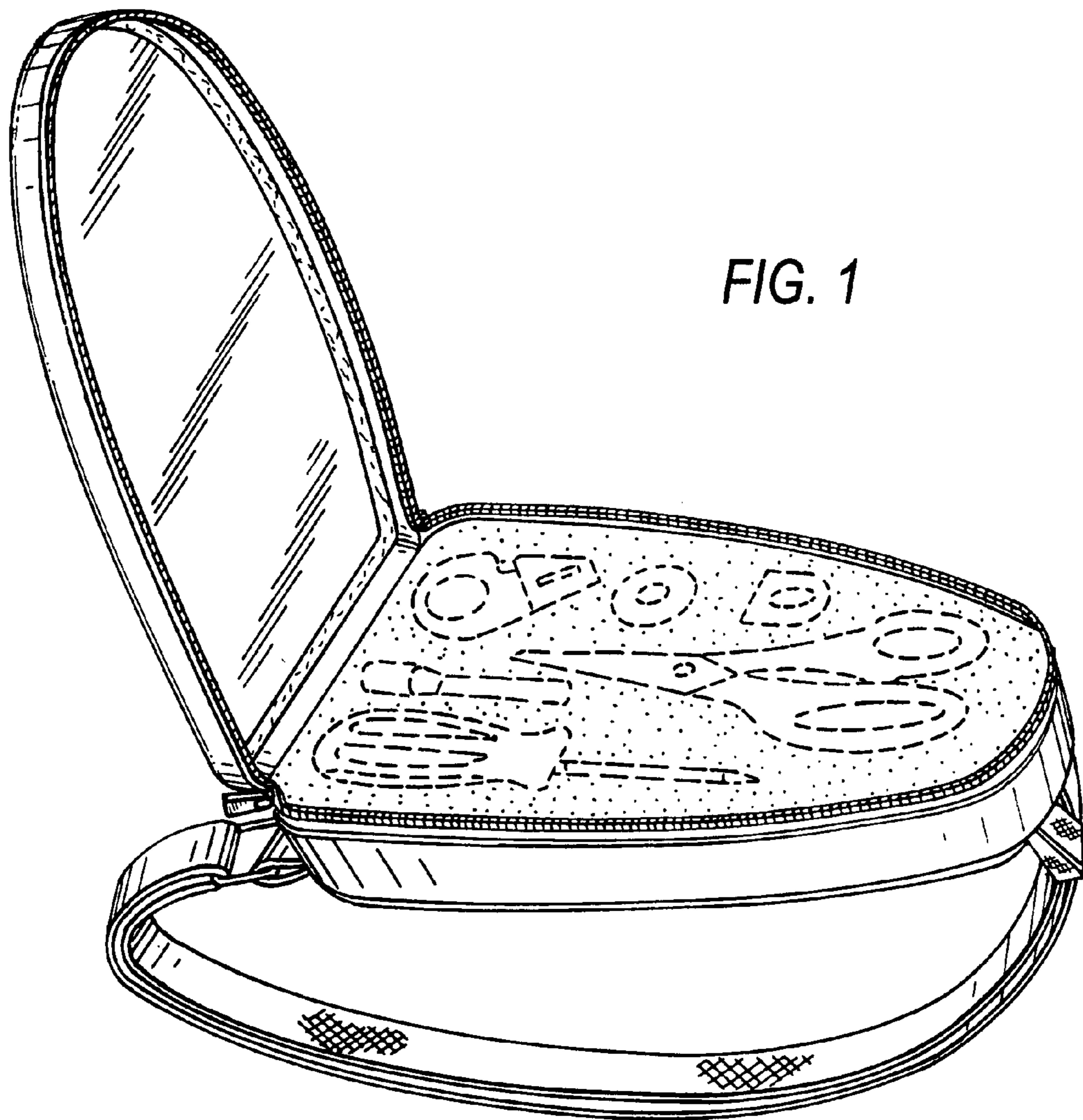

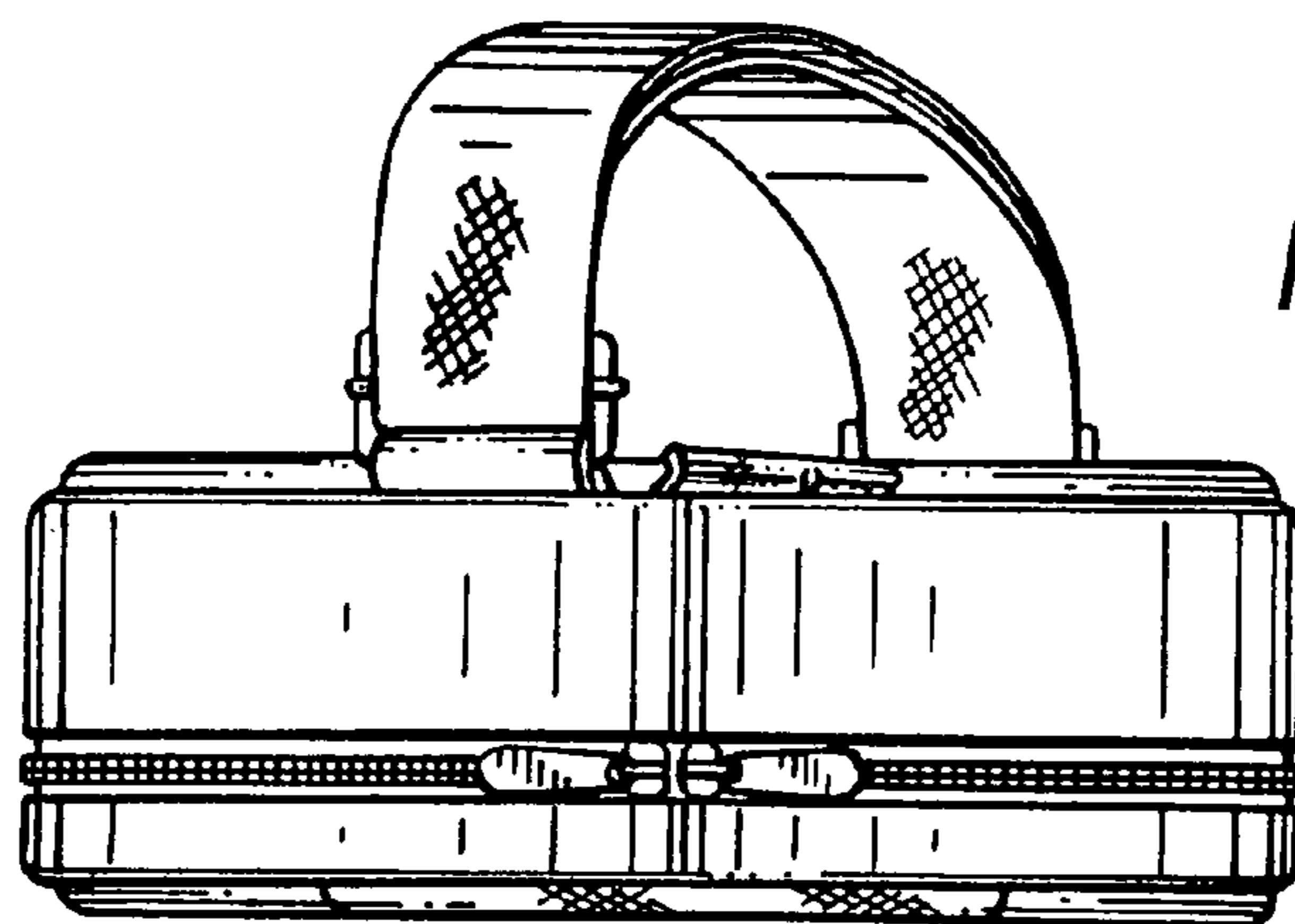

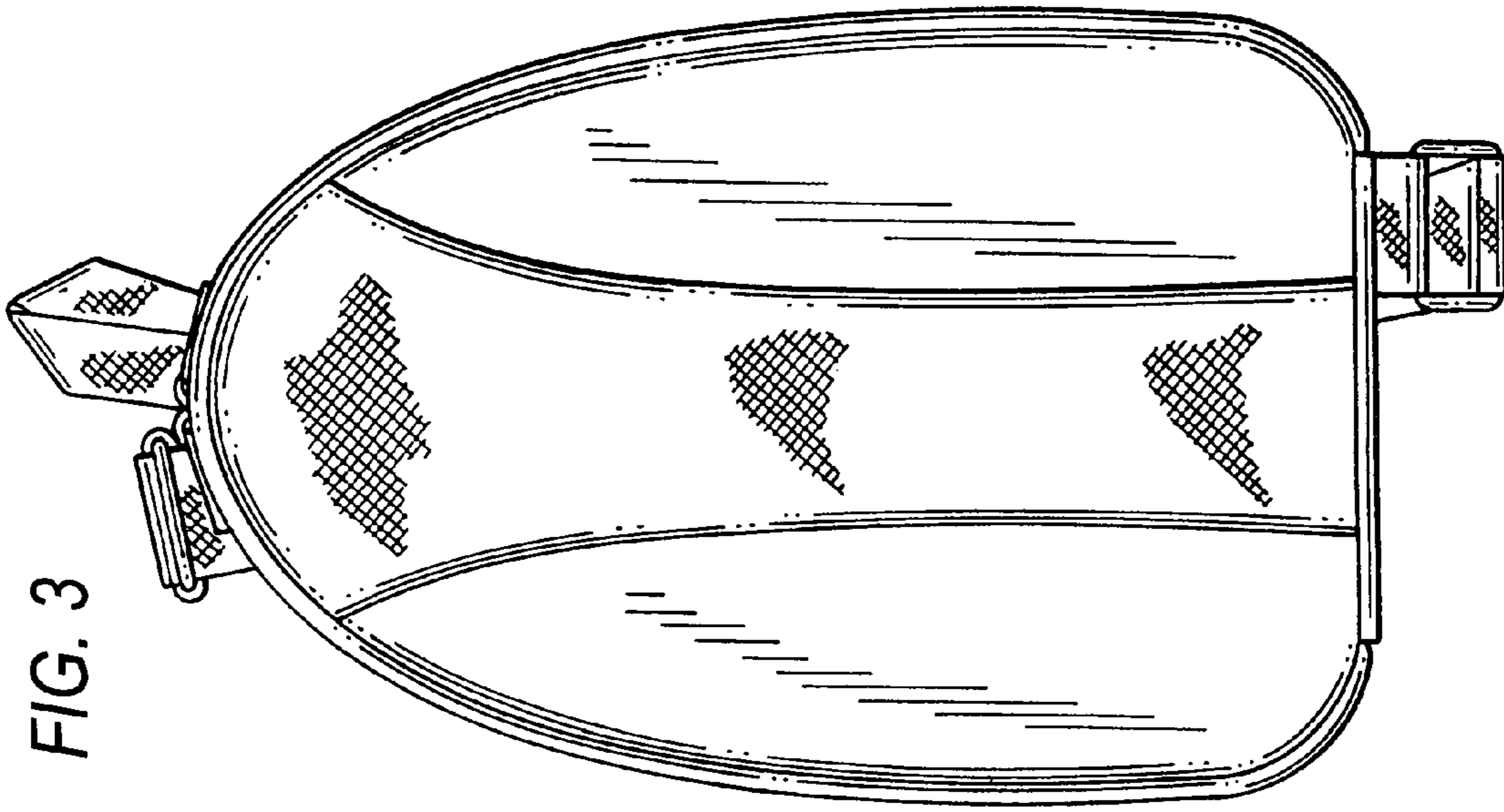

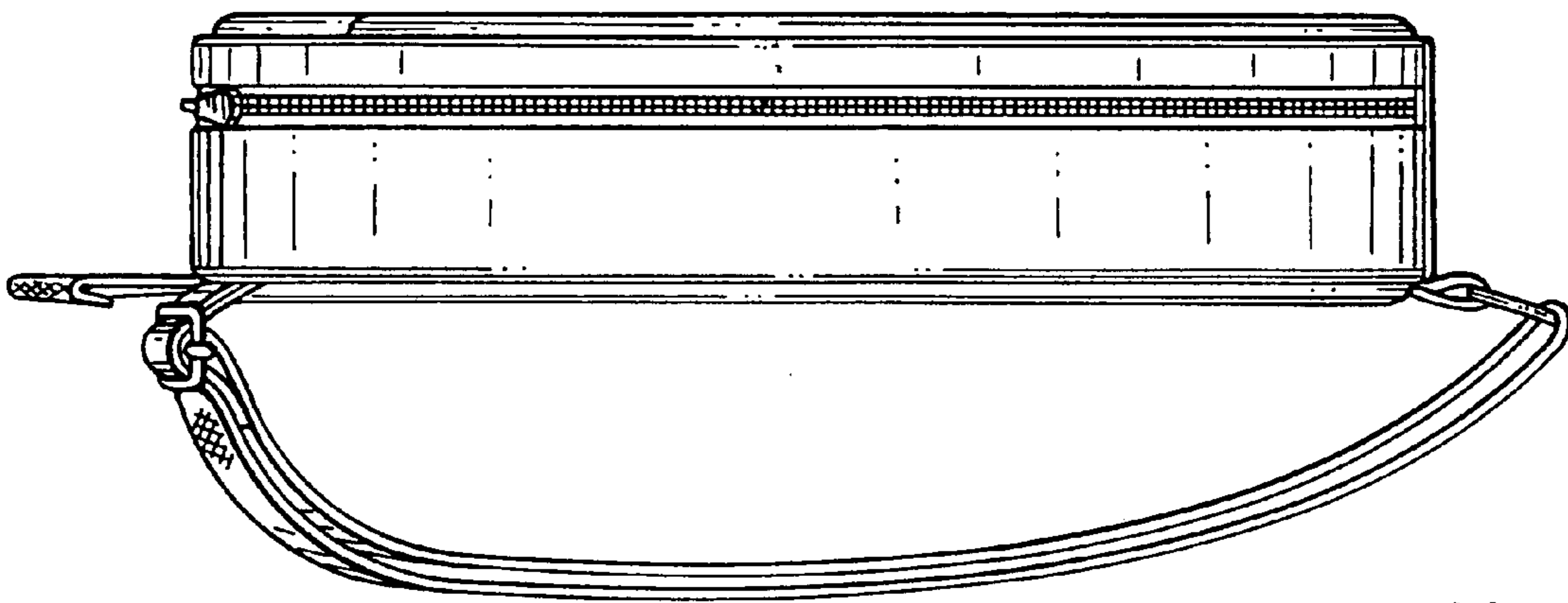

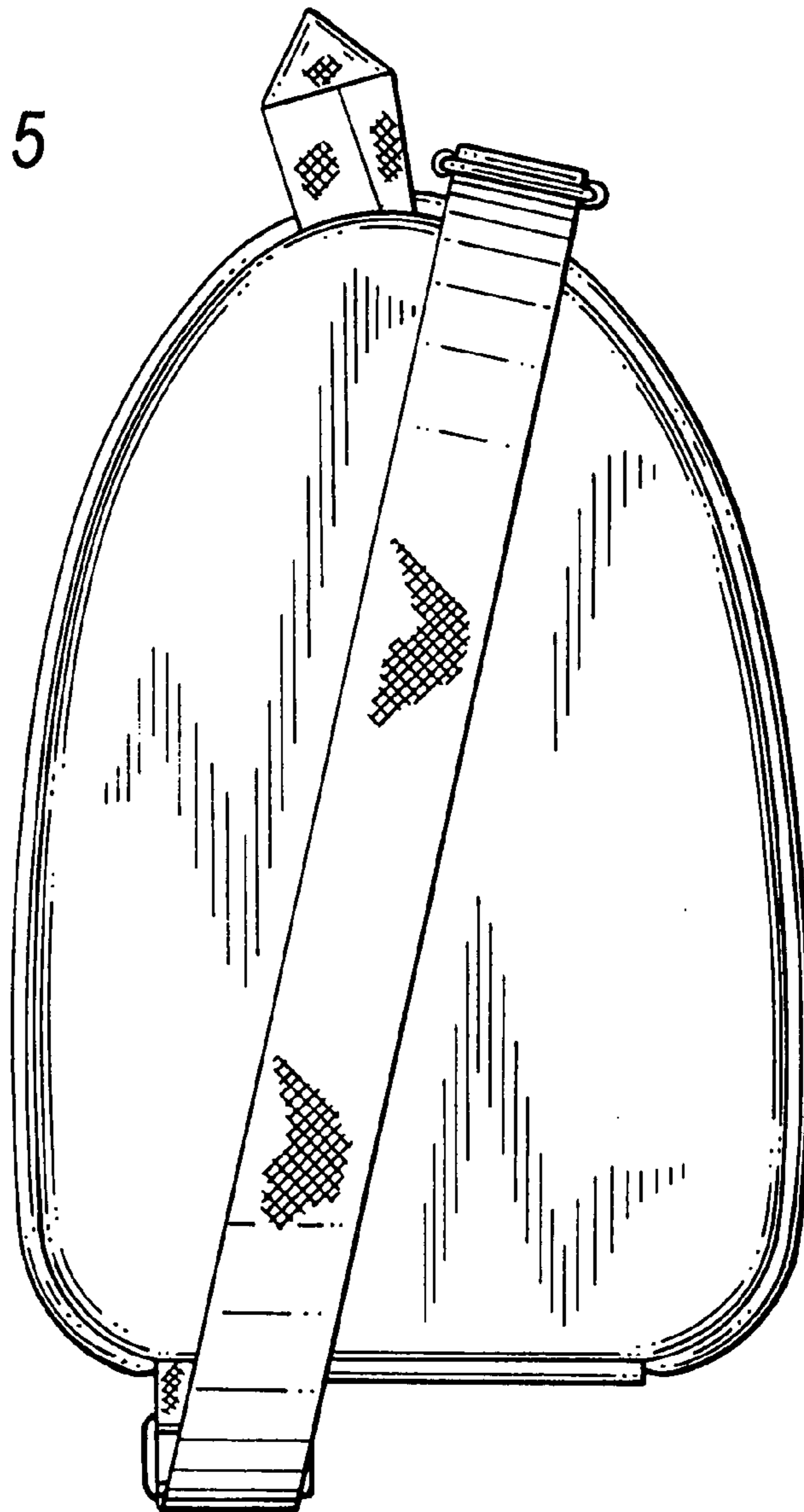
