FIG. 1 is an elevational view illustrating a handle of the present invention;

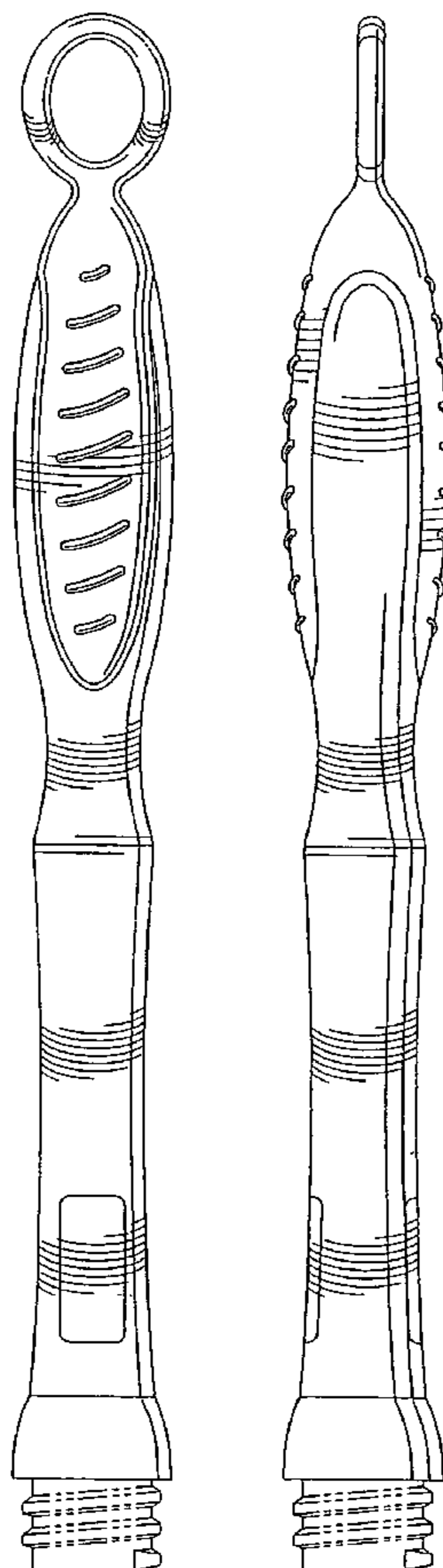
FIG. 2 is a front view thereof, the back view being a mirror image thereof;

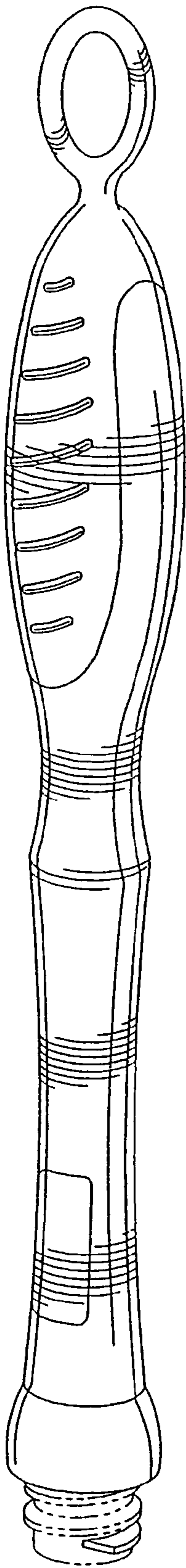

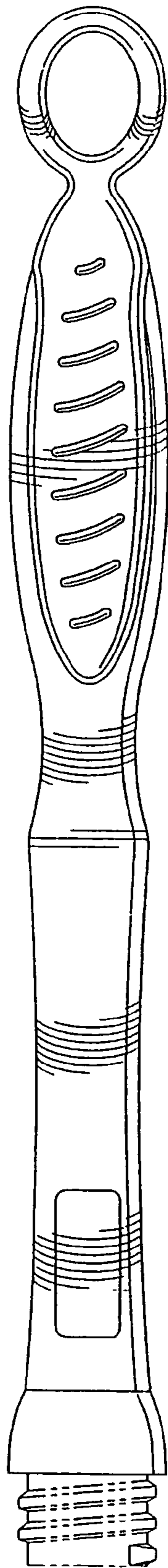

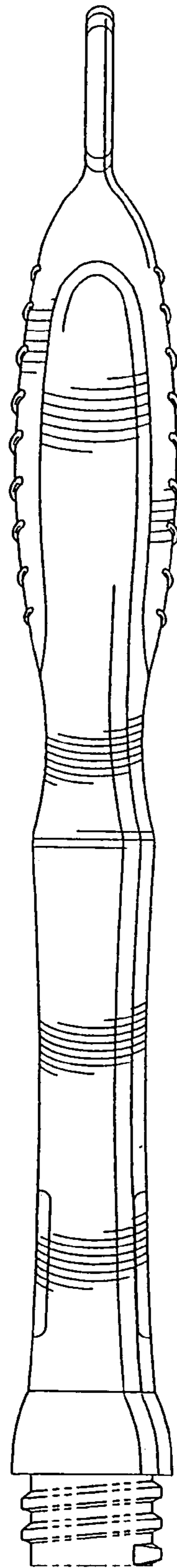

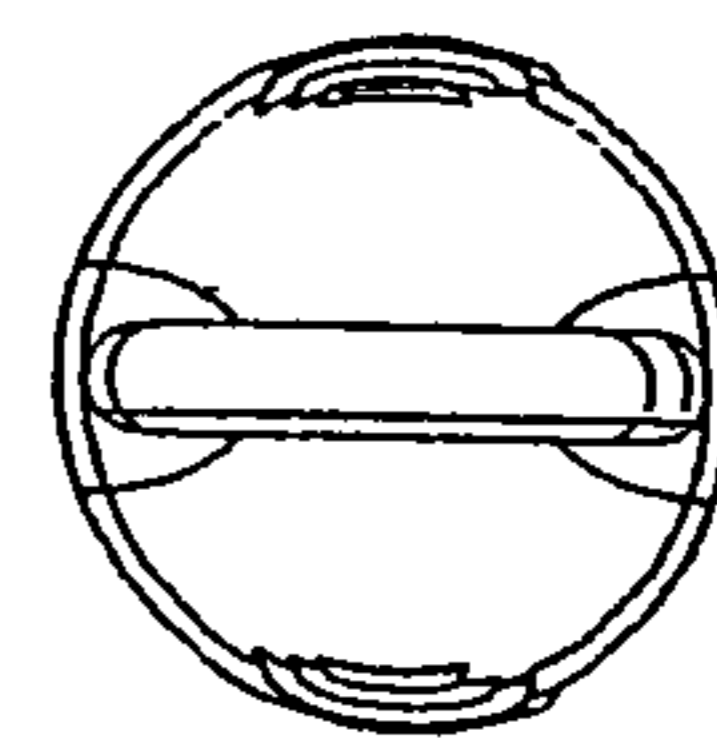
