FIG. 3 is a right elevational view thereof.

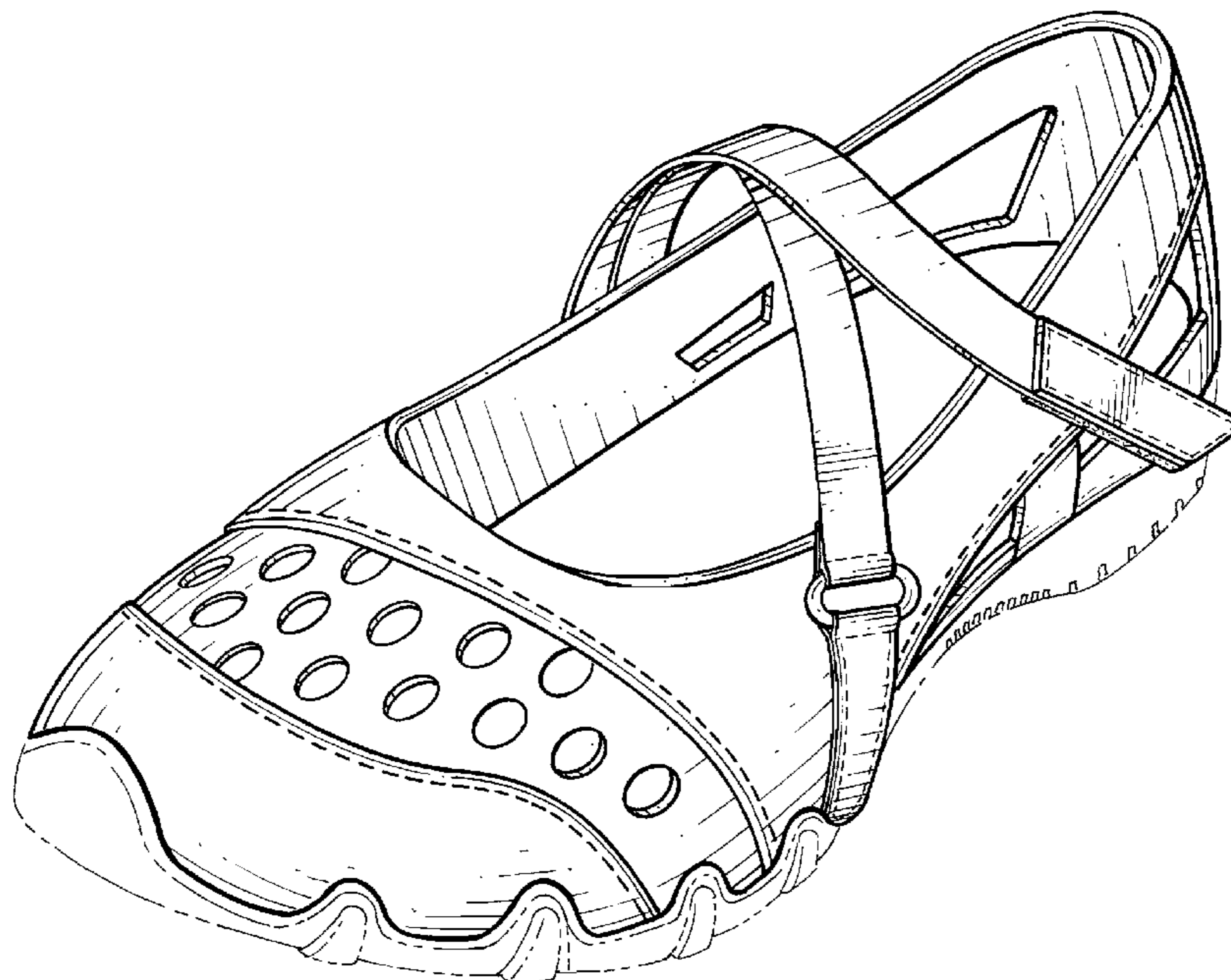
FIG. 4 is a left elevational view thereof.

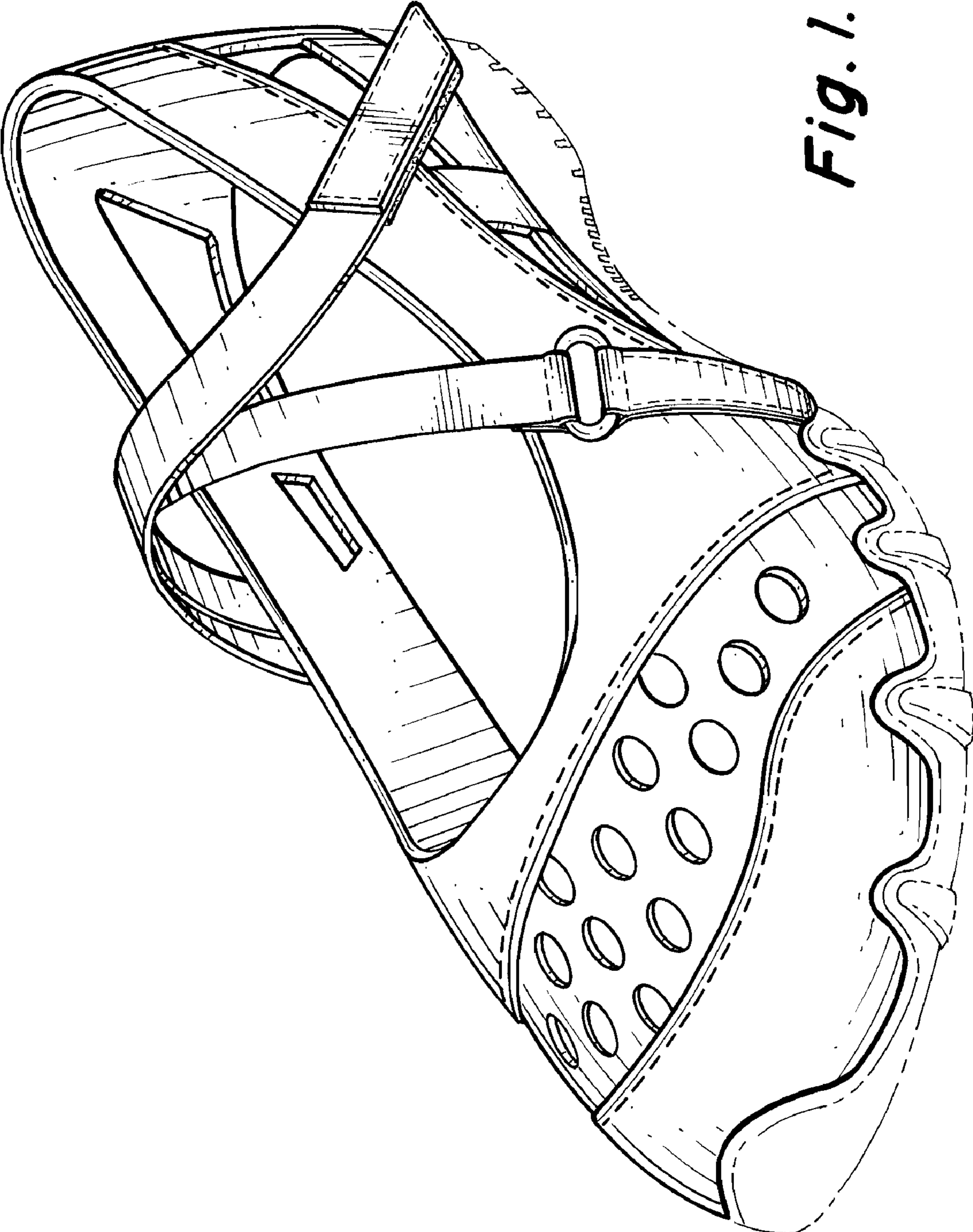
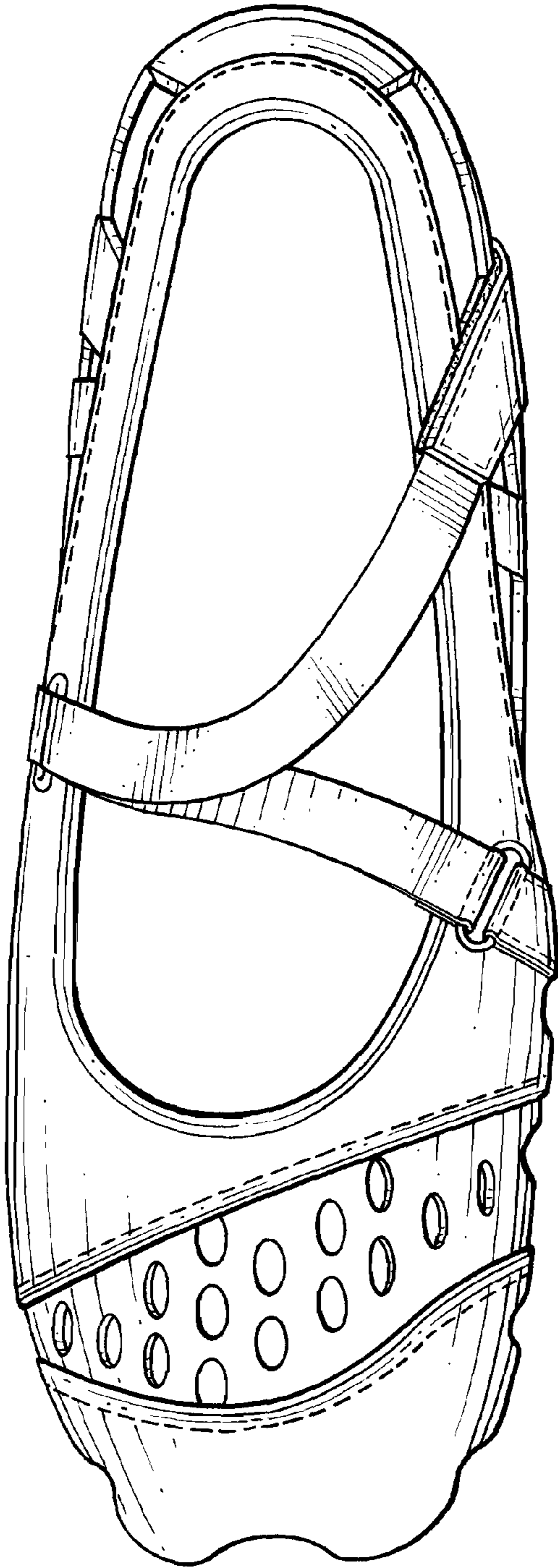
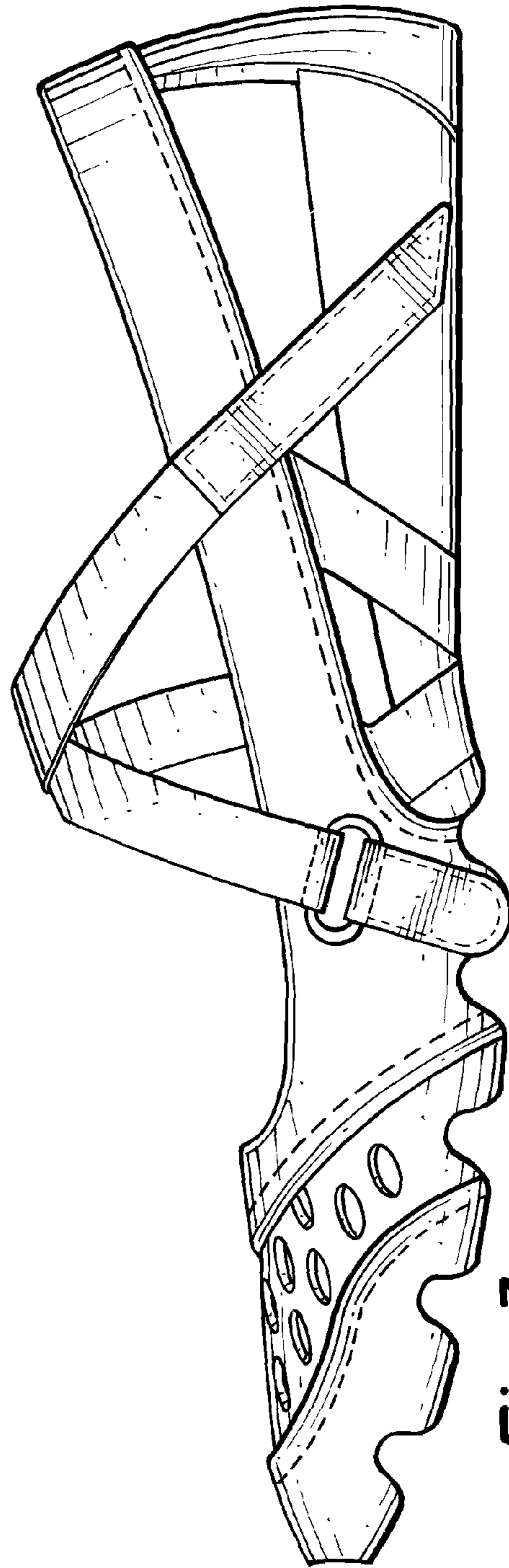


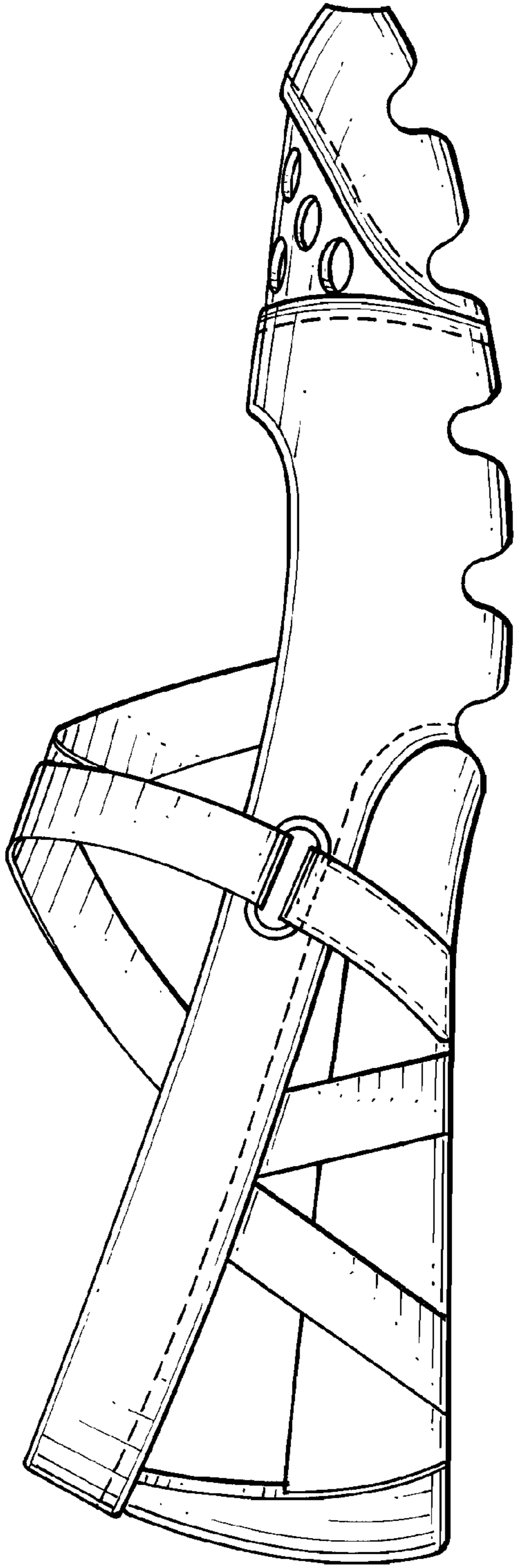

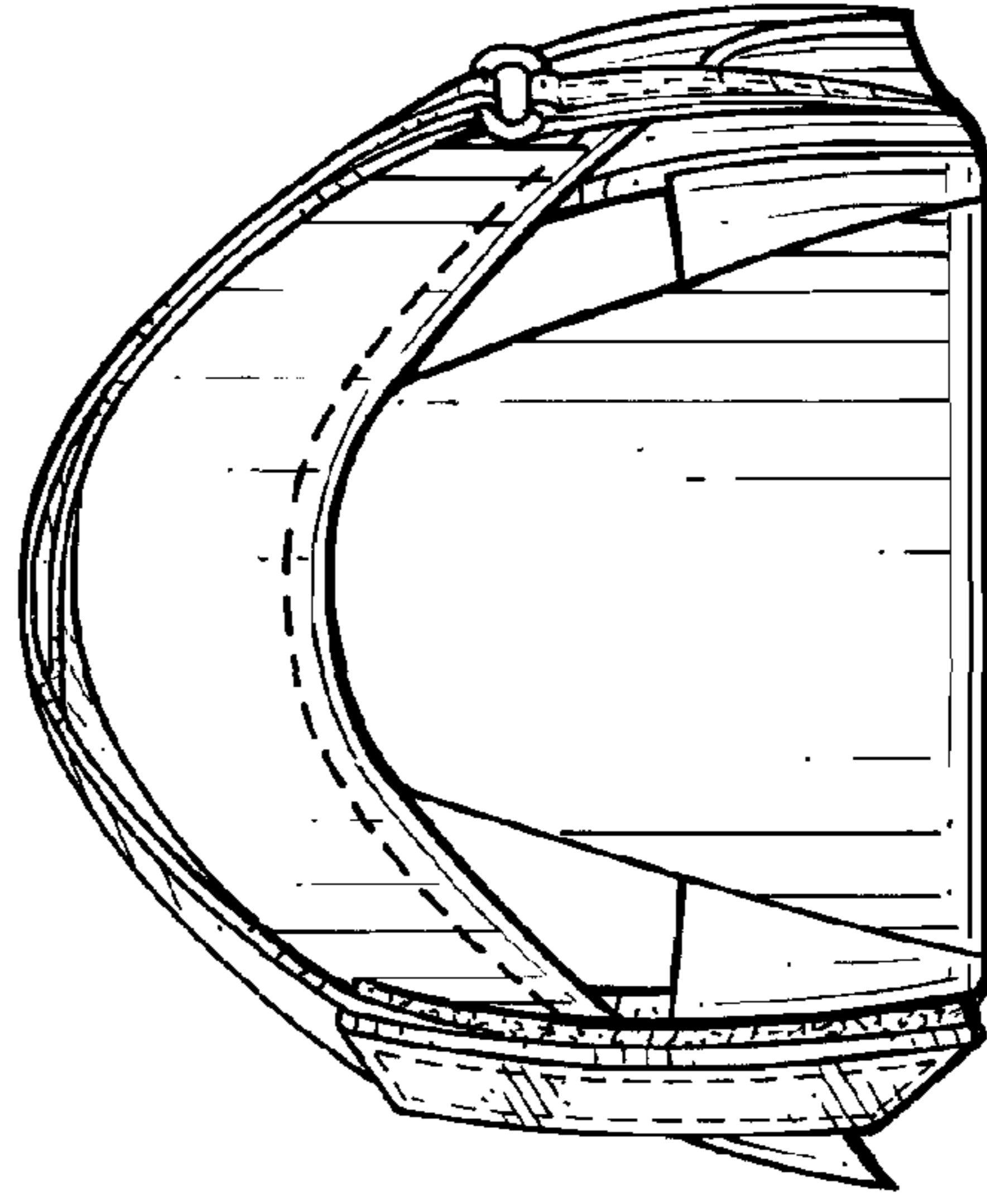

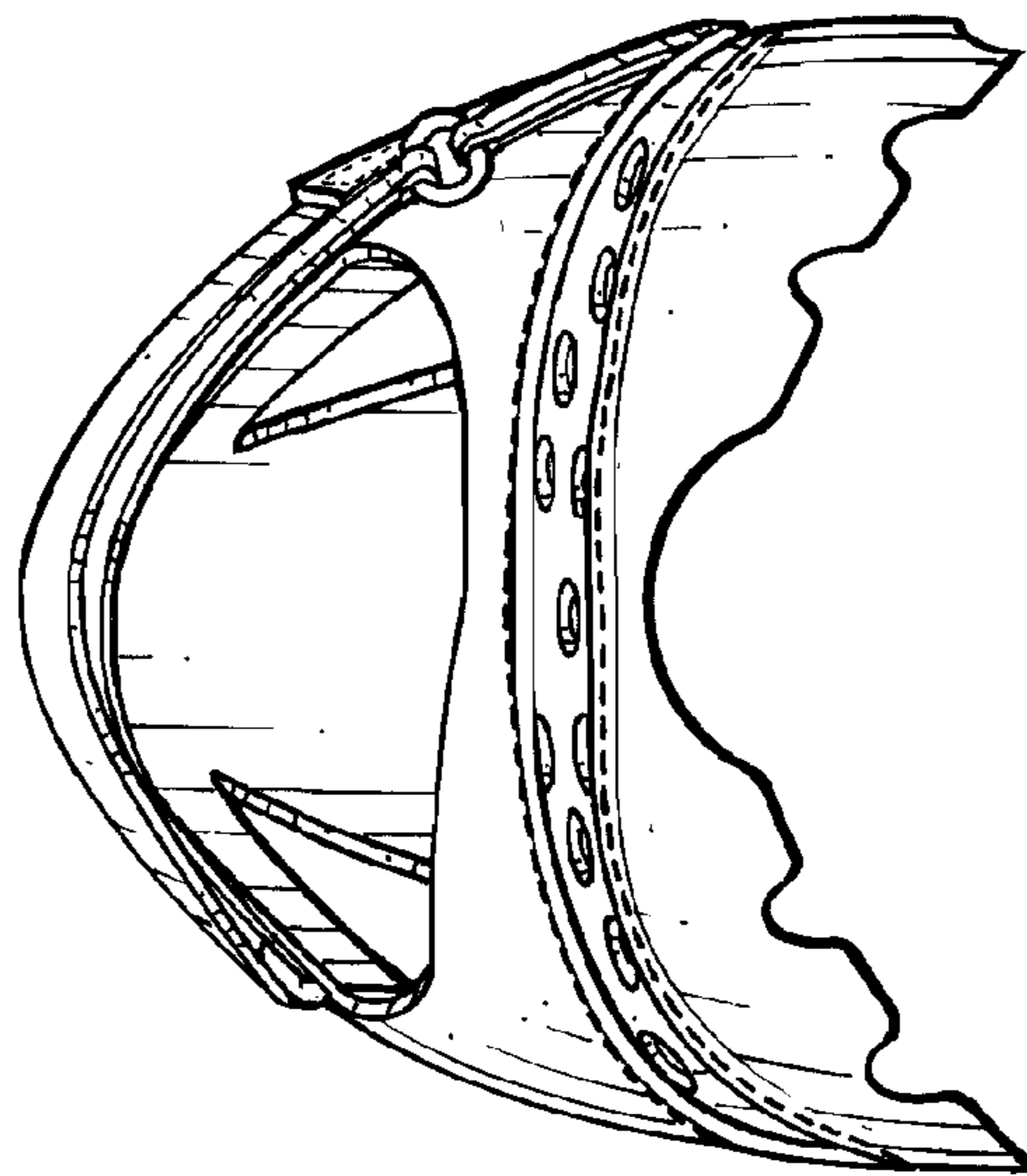
