The ornamental design for a personal carrier, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front view of a personal carrier.

FIG. 2 is a rear view of a personal carrier.

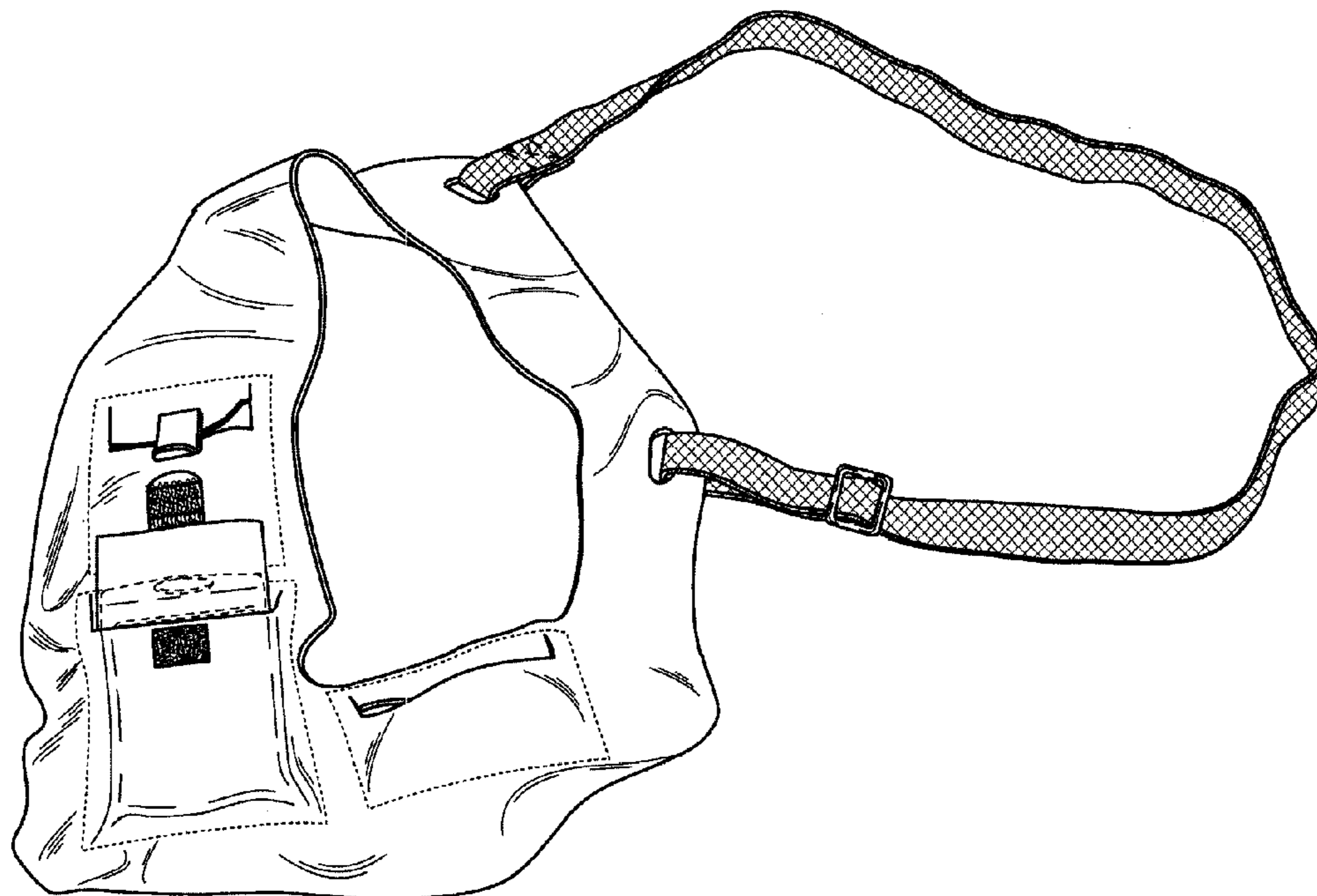
FIG. 3 is a front and side perspective view of a wearer wearing the personal carrier.

FIG. 4 is an alternative front and side perspective view of a wearer wearing the personal carrier; and,

FIG. 5 is a rear perspective view of a wearer wearing the personal carrier.

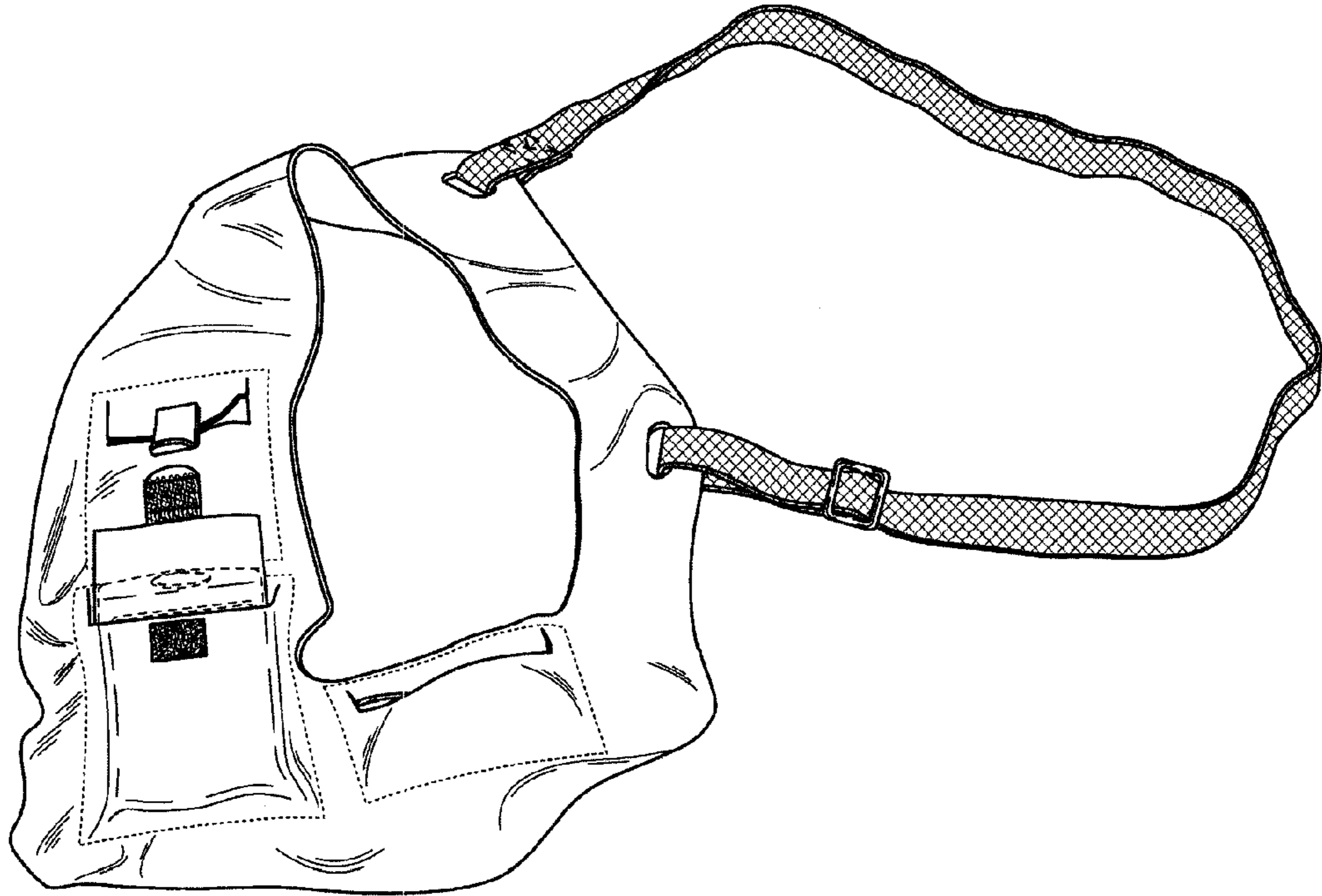

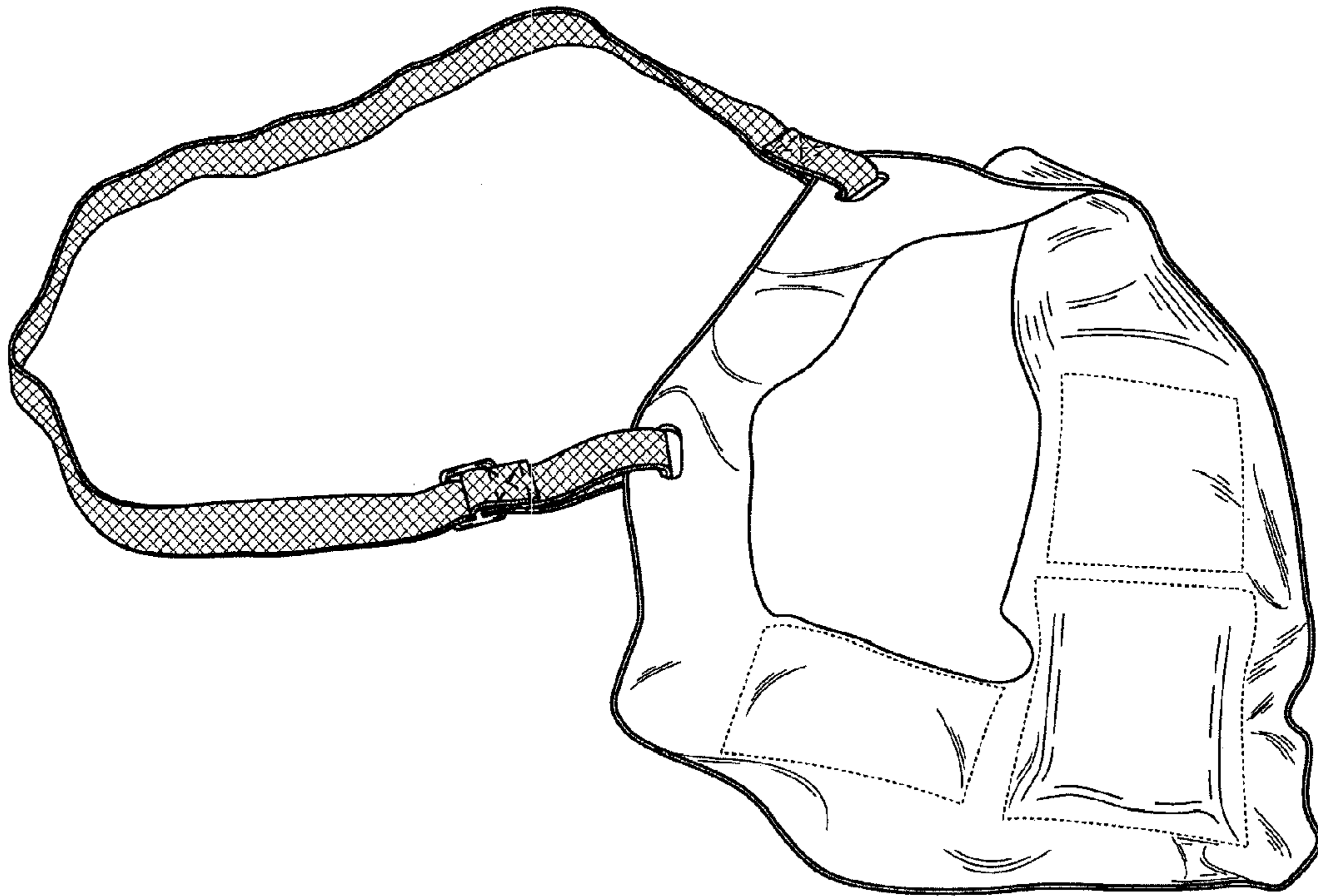

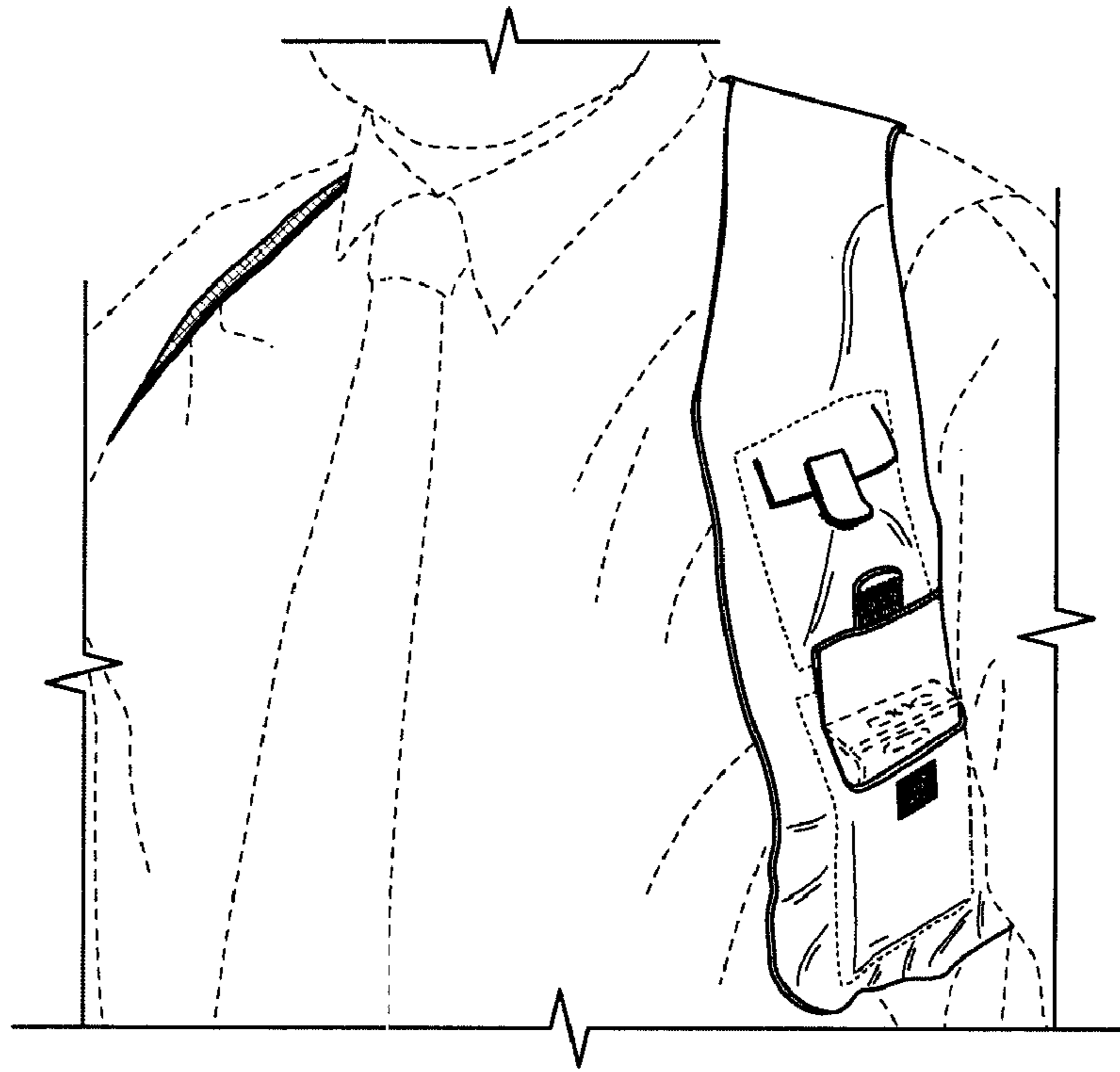

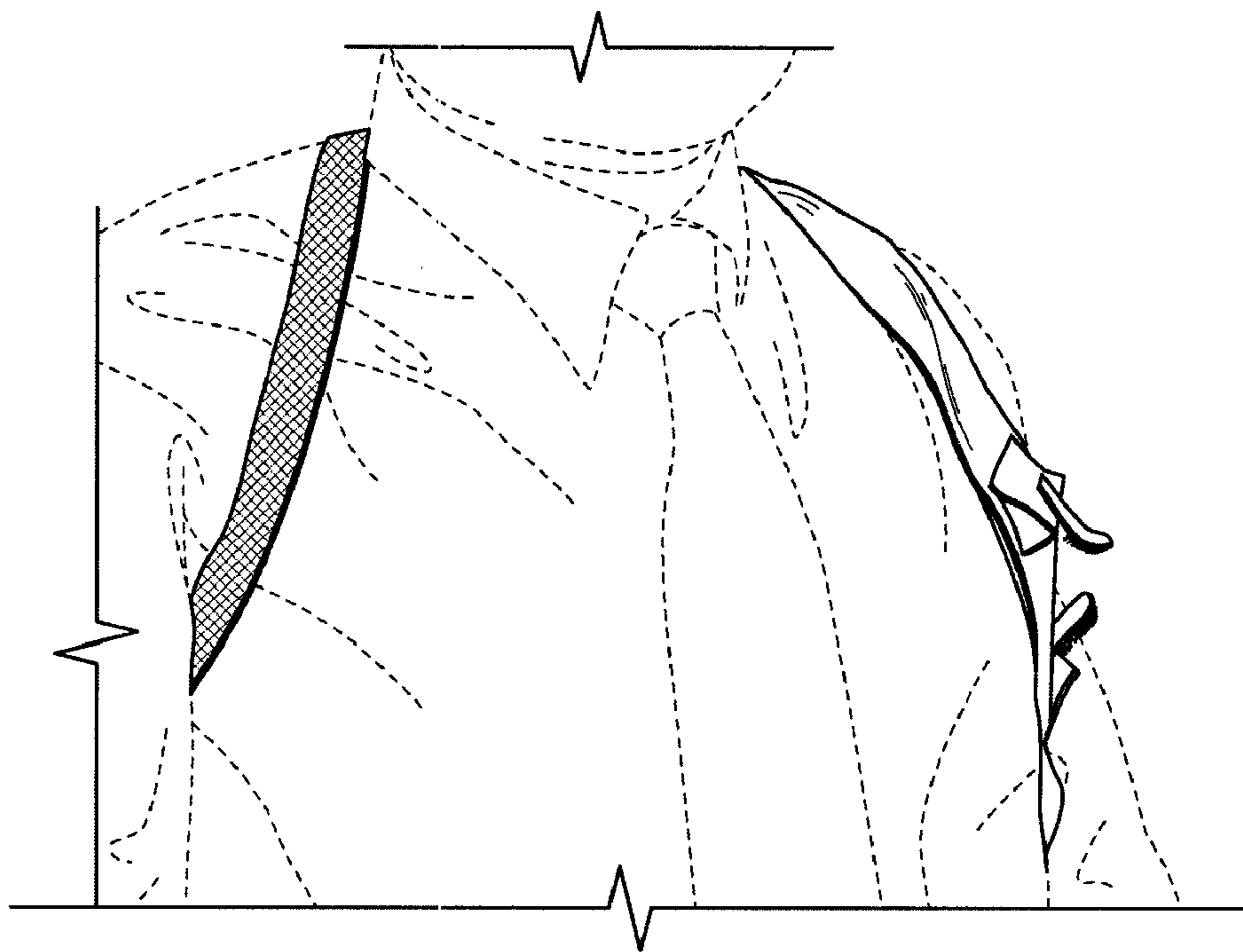

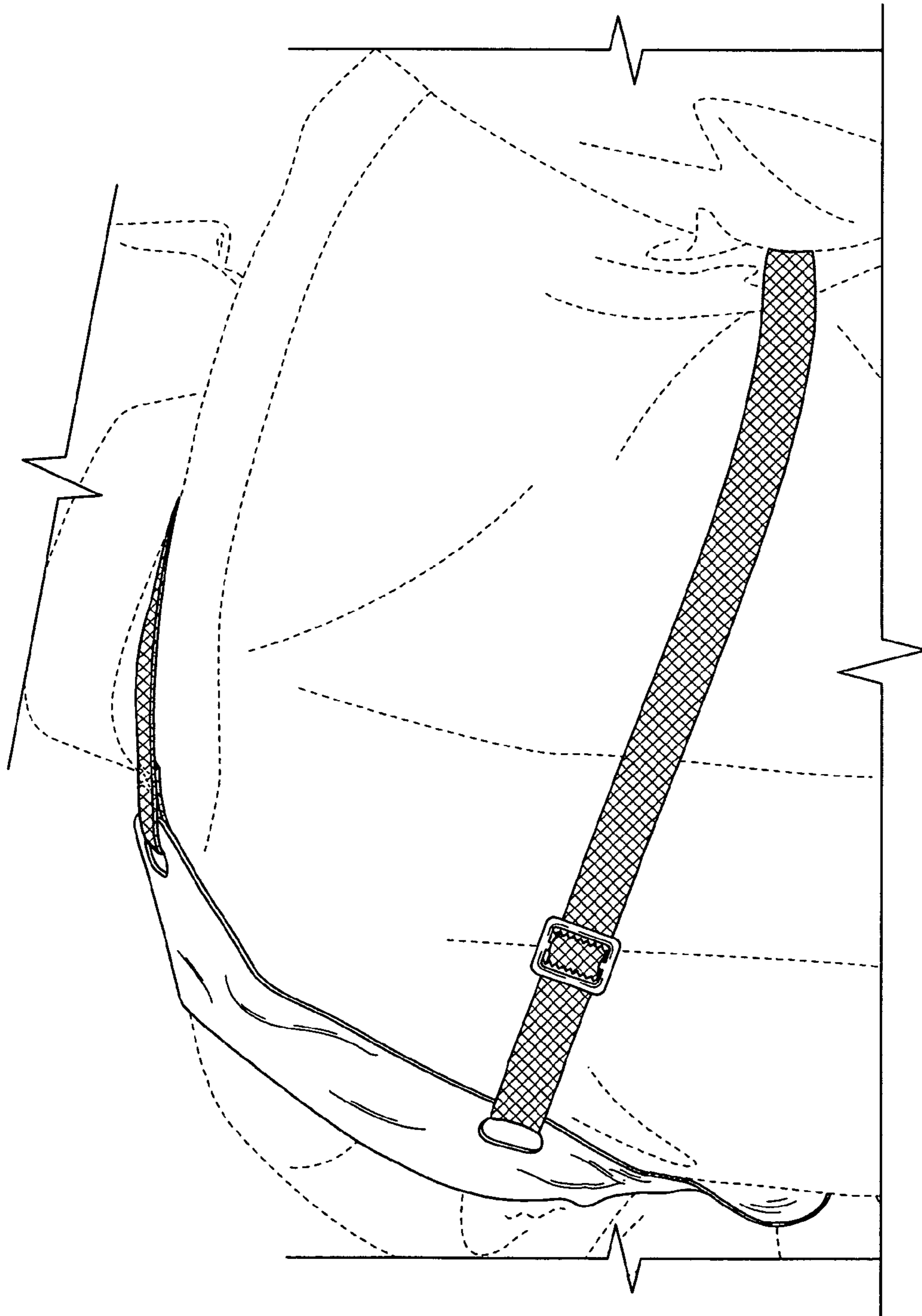
