**DESCRIPTION**

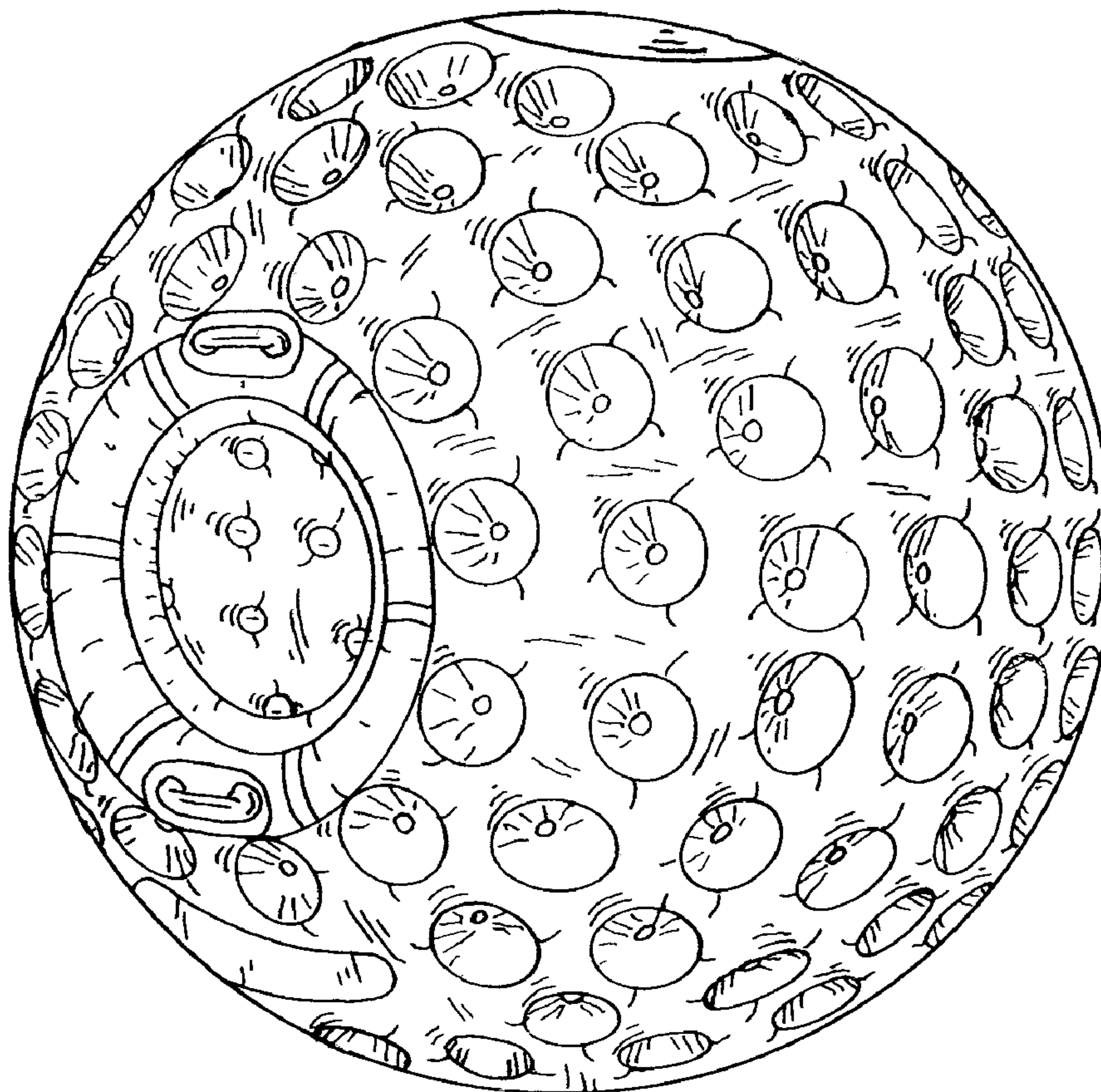
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the inflatable aquatic sphere showing my new design;

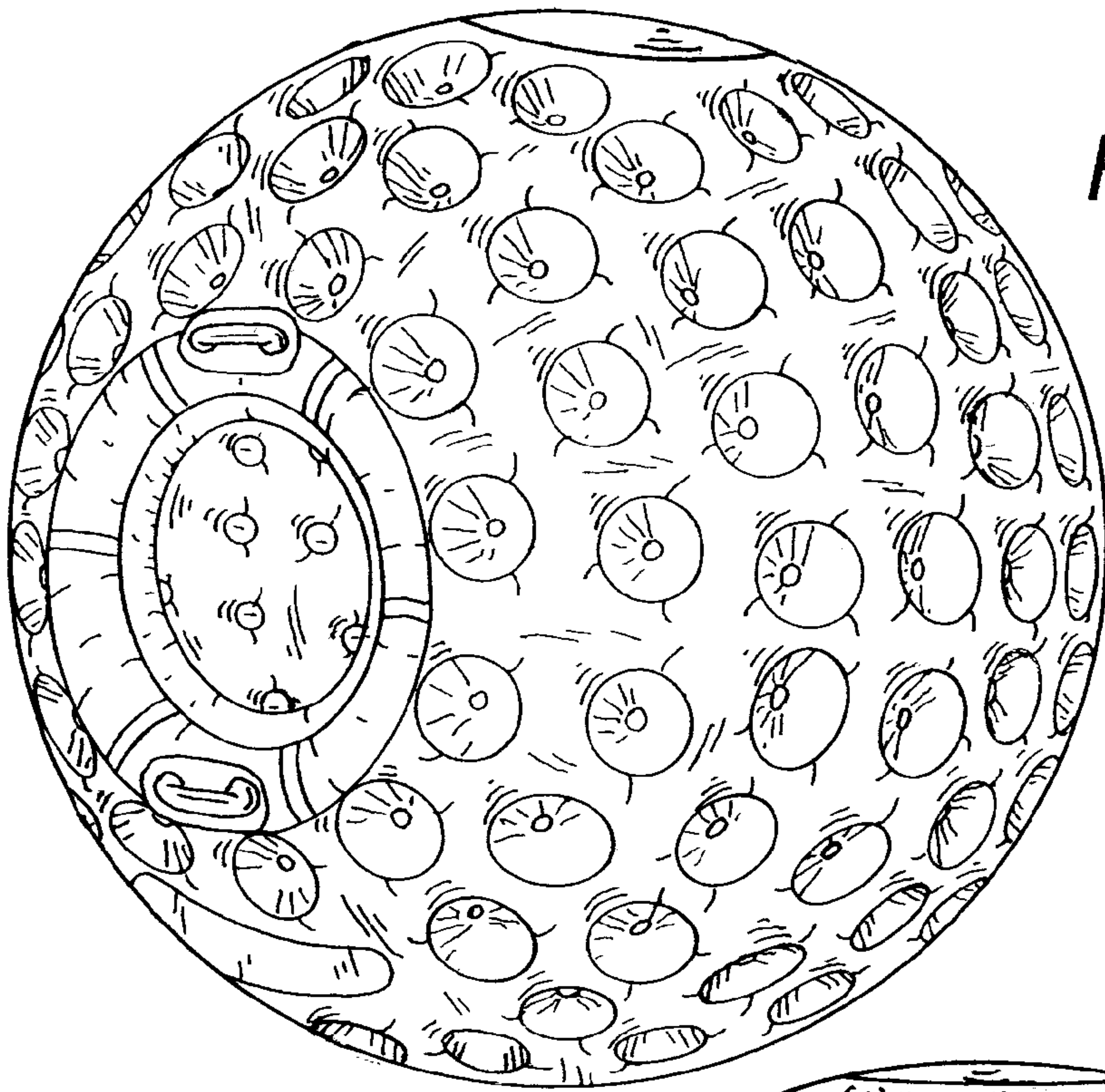

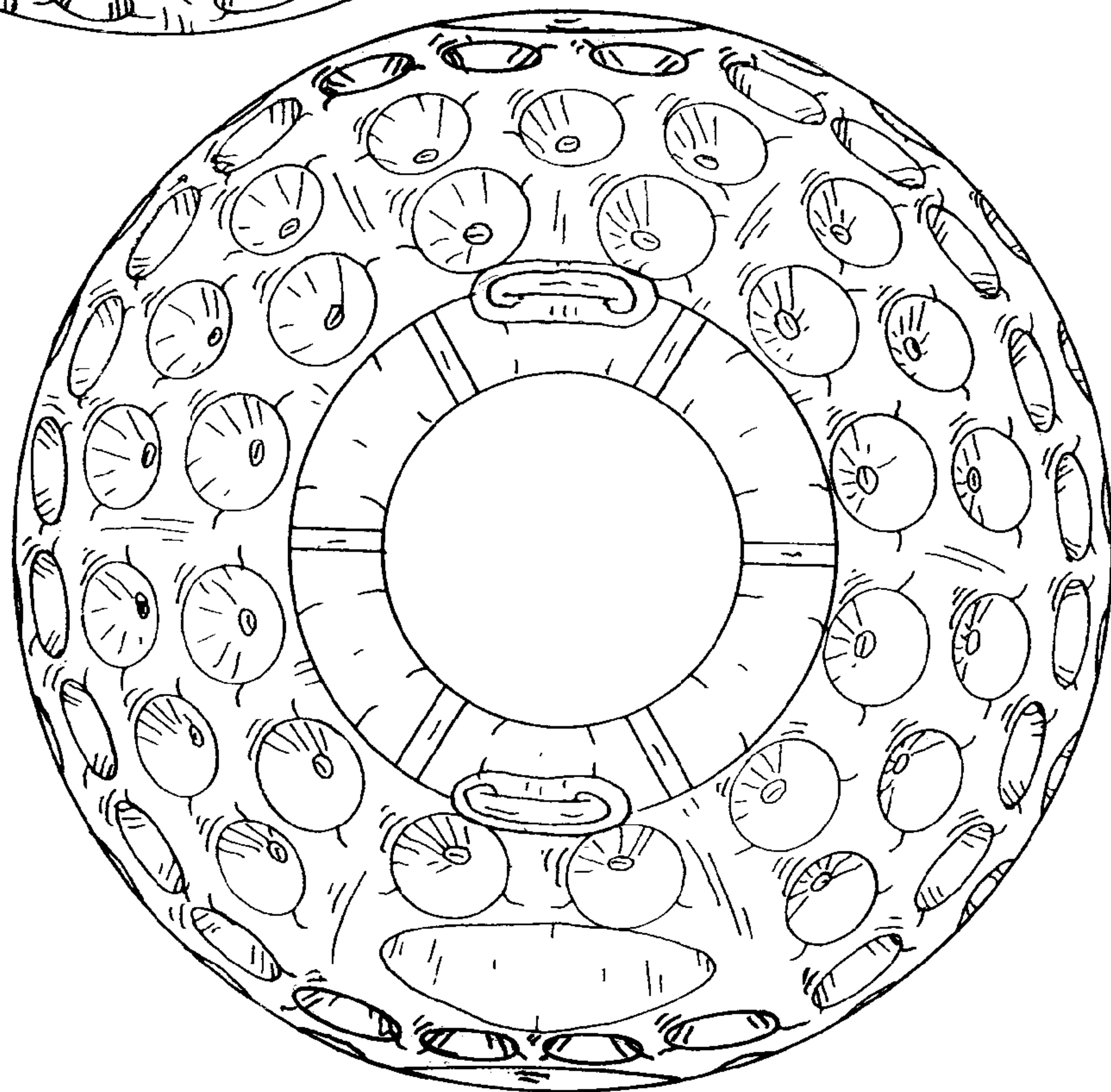
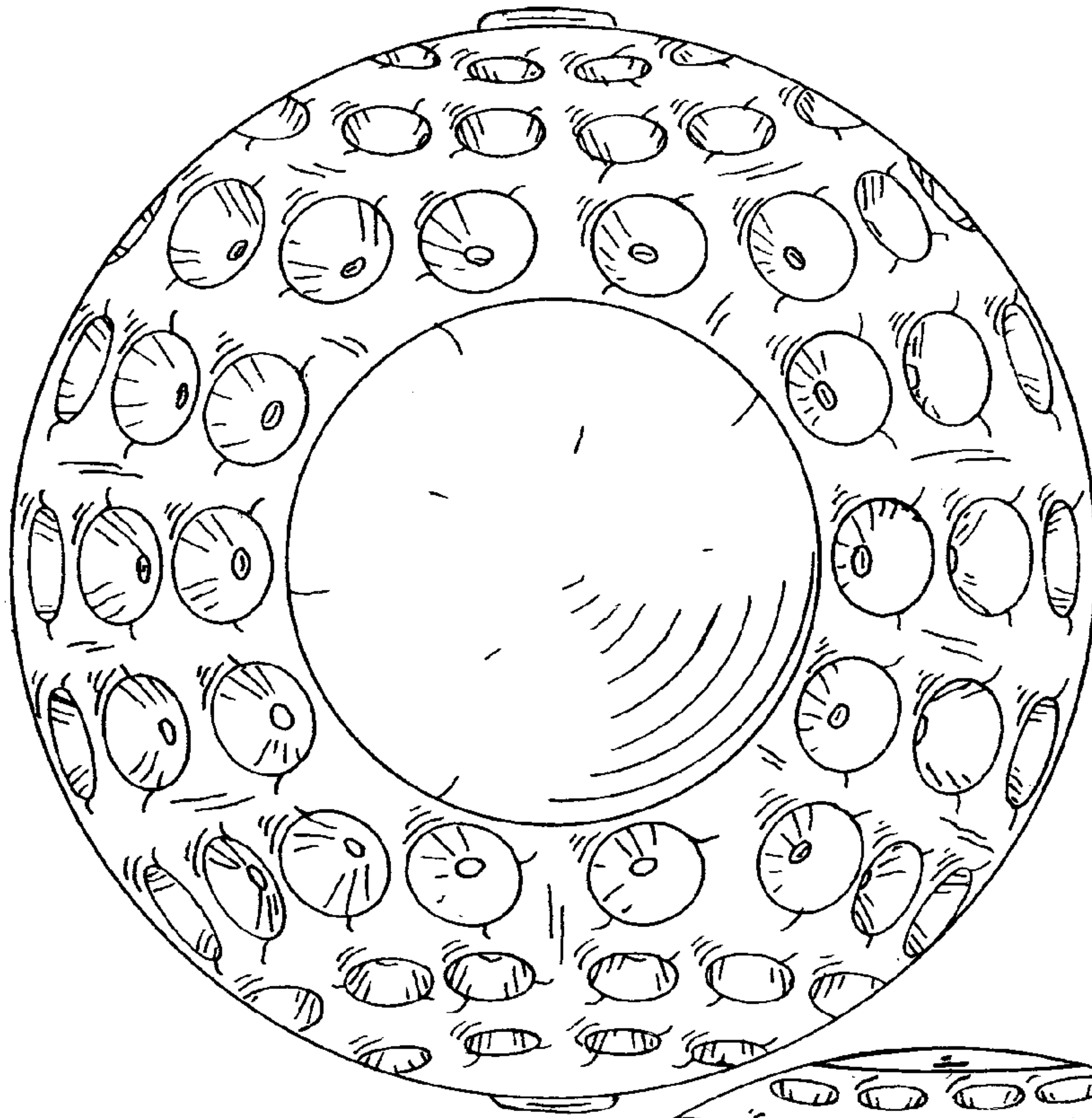
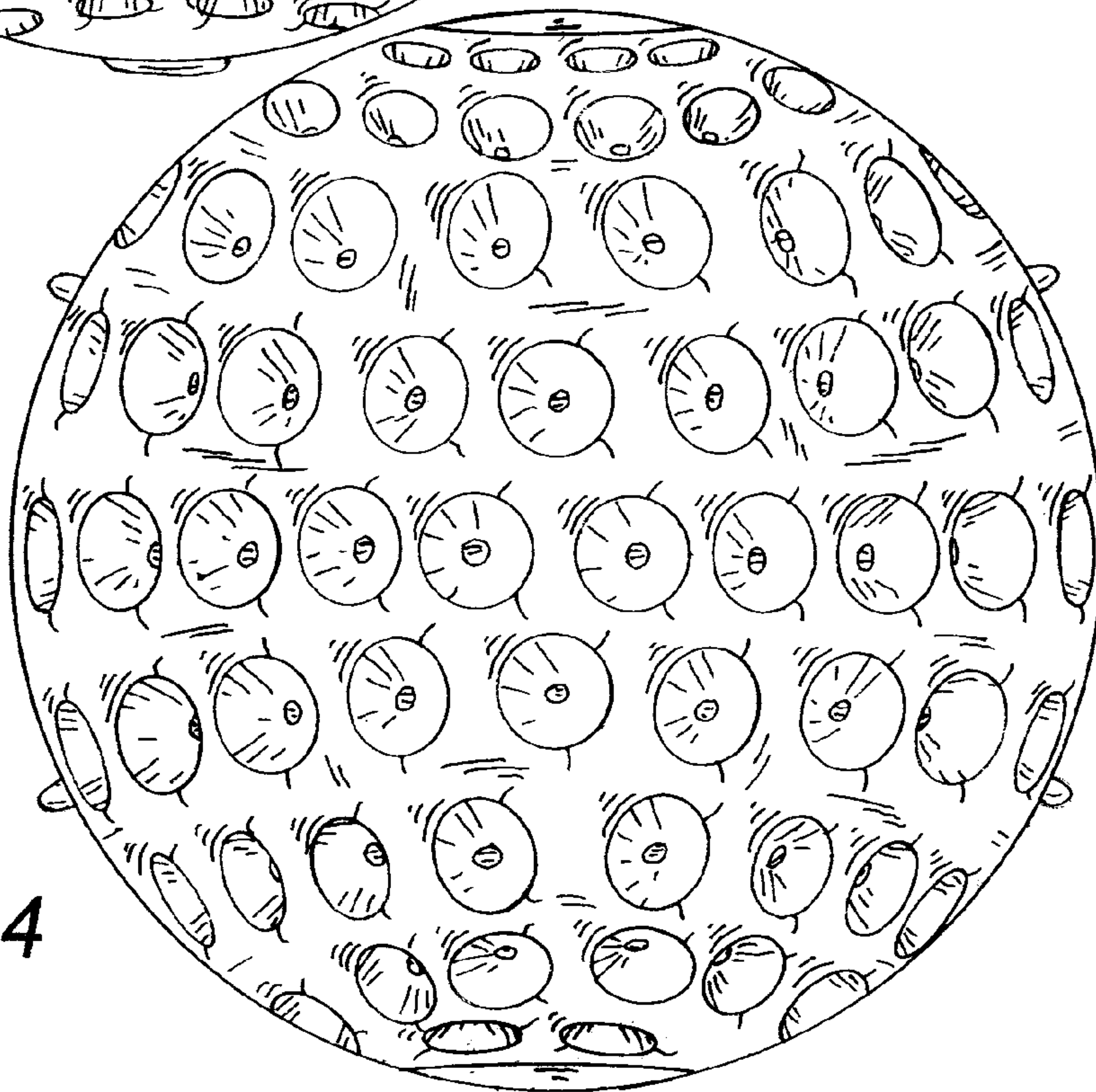
