FIG. 11 is a side elevation view thereof looking at the closed end;

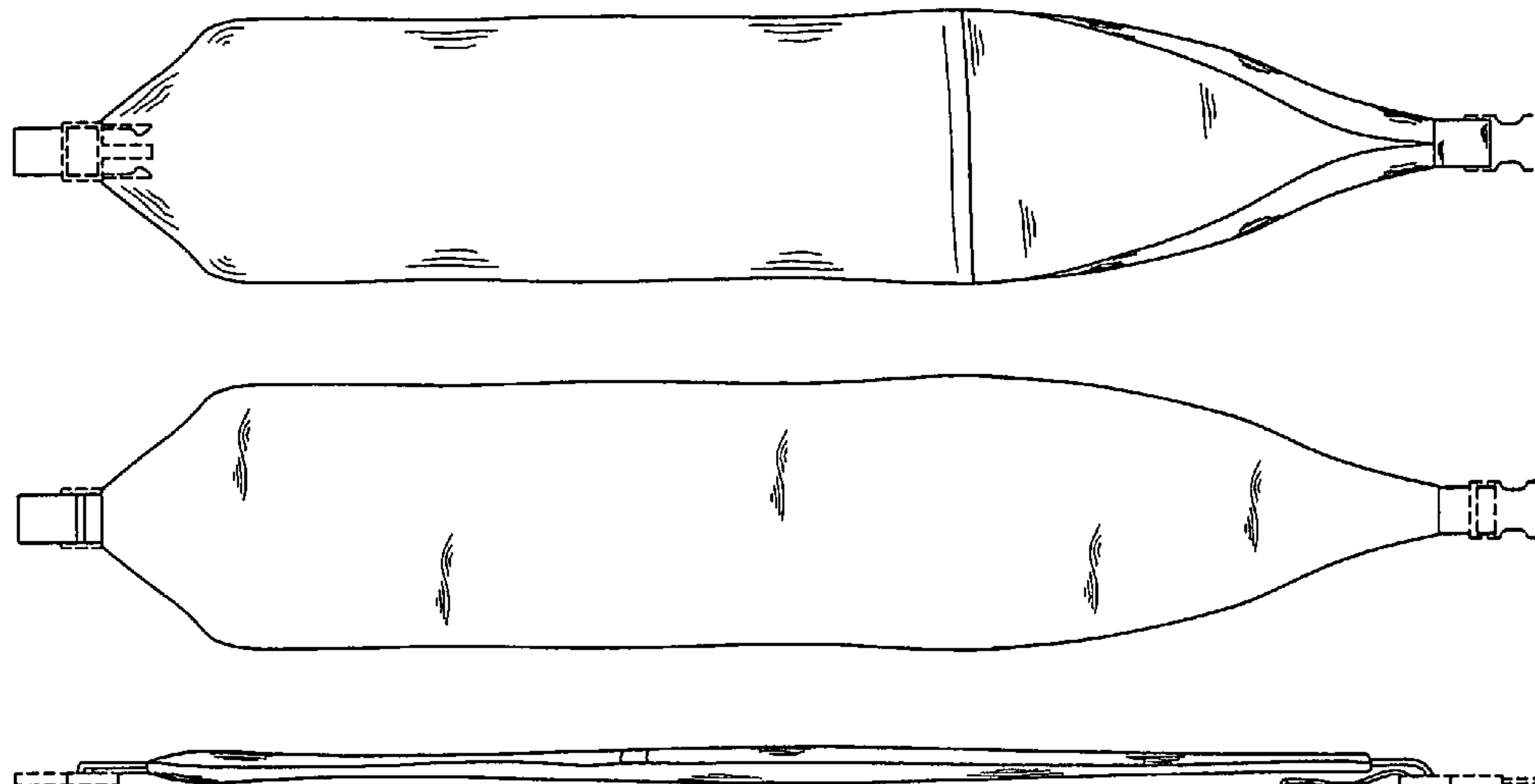
FIG. 12 is a side elevation view thereof looking at the end opposite the closed end;

FIG. 13 is an edge view thereof; and,

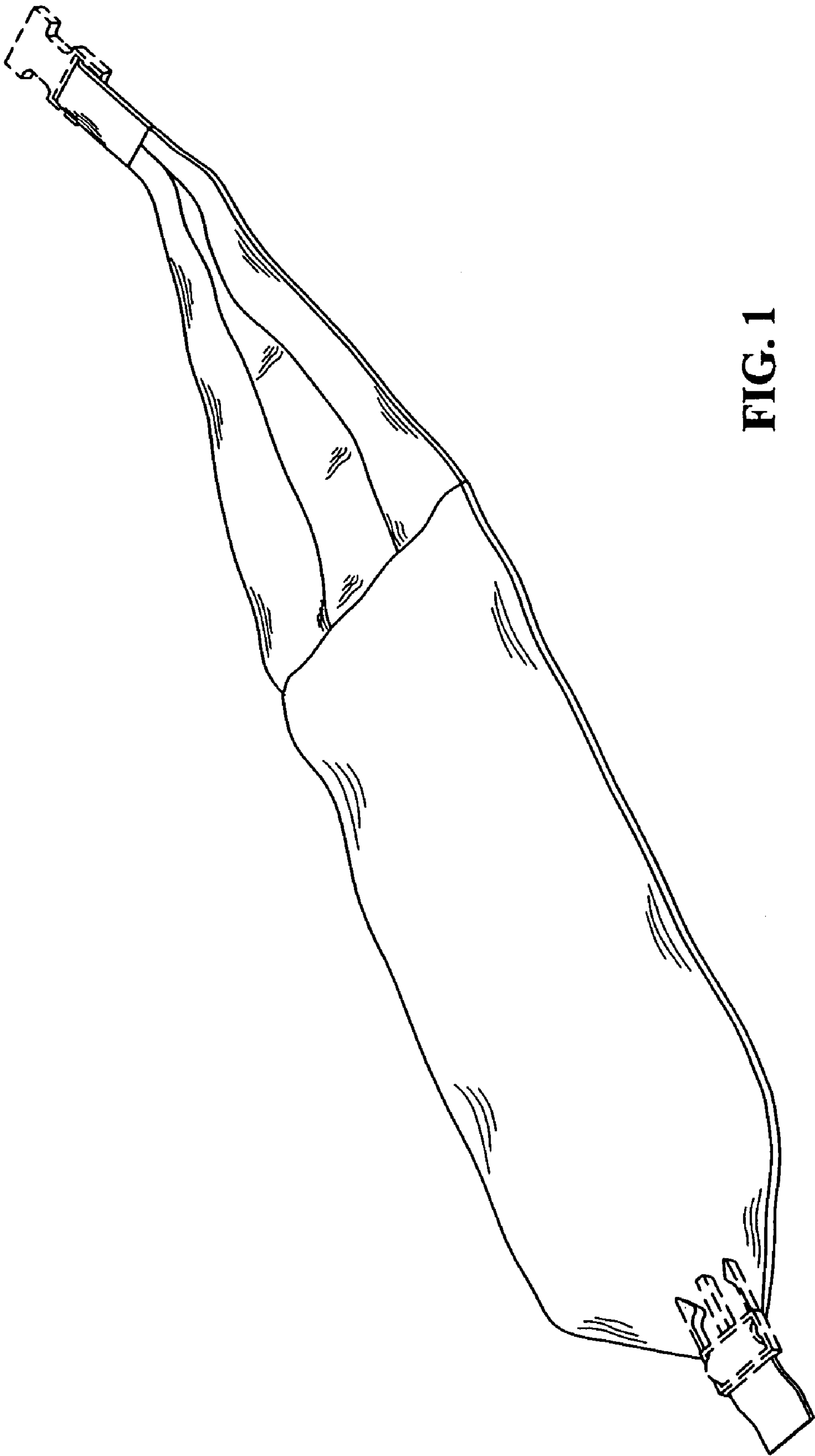
FIG. 14 is an opposite edge view thereof.

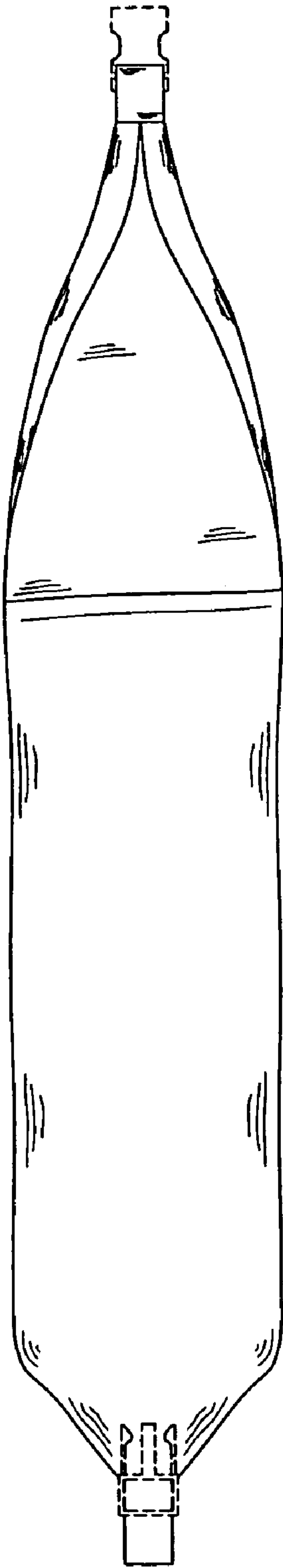

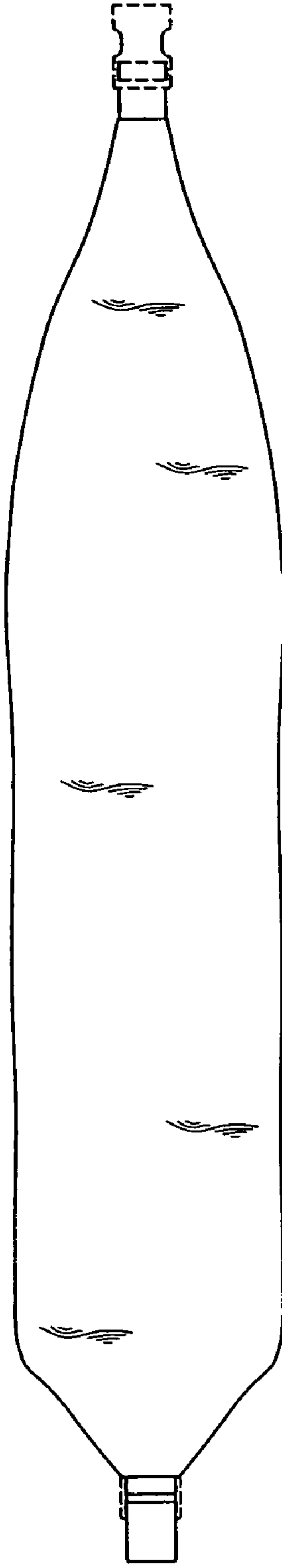

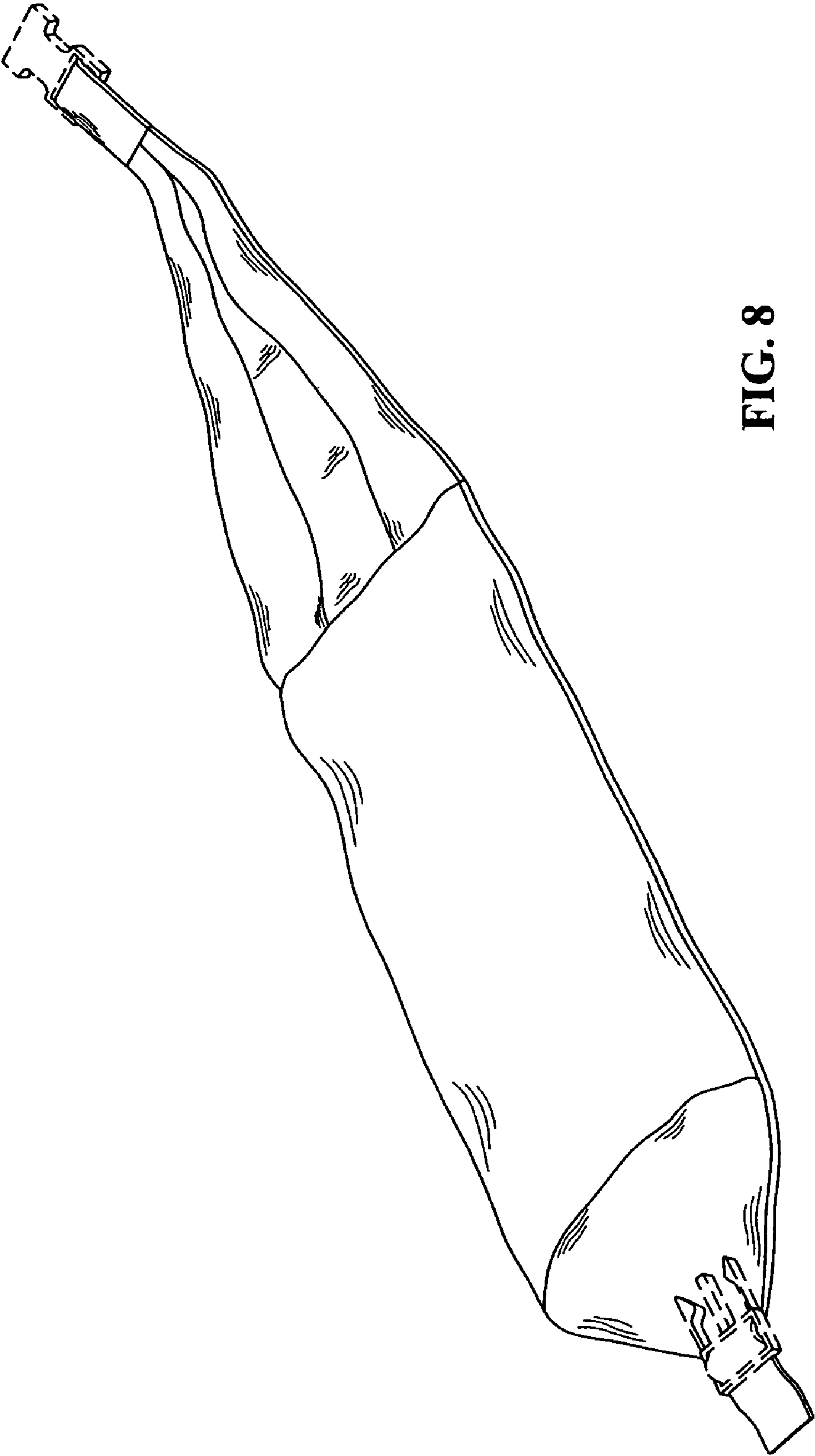

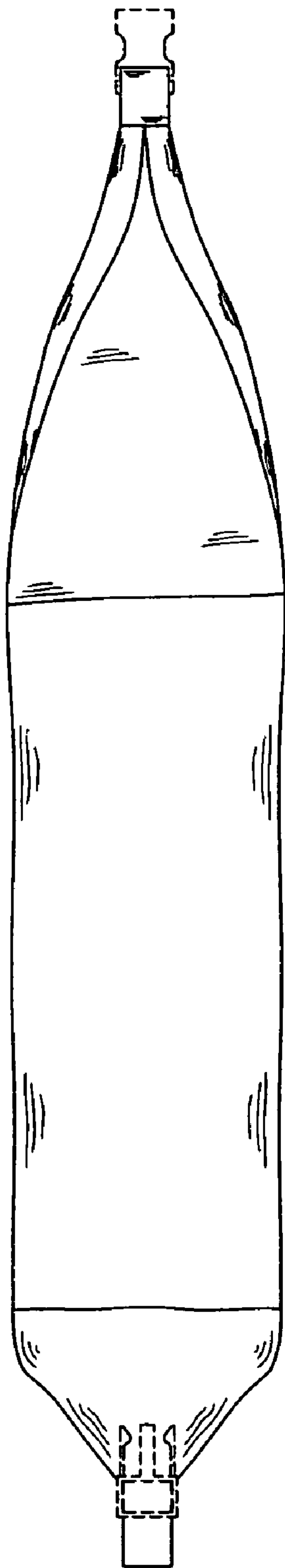

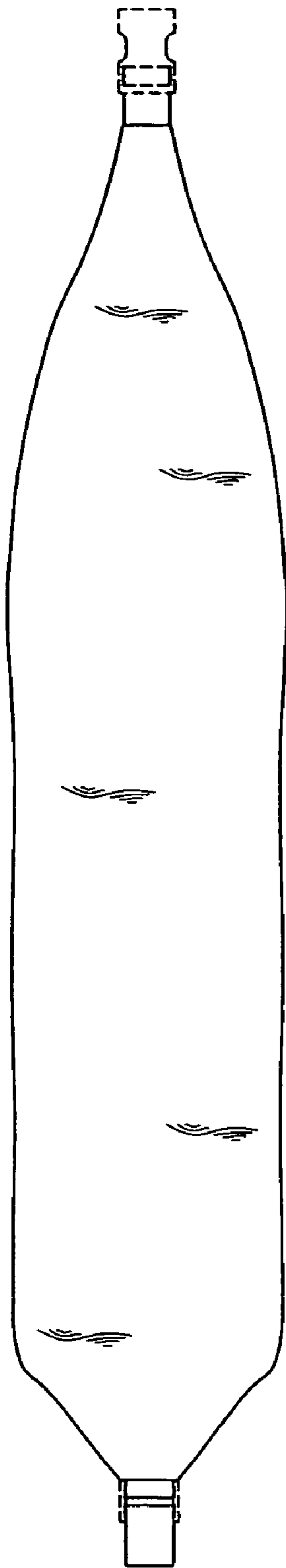
