with the present invention;

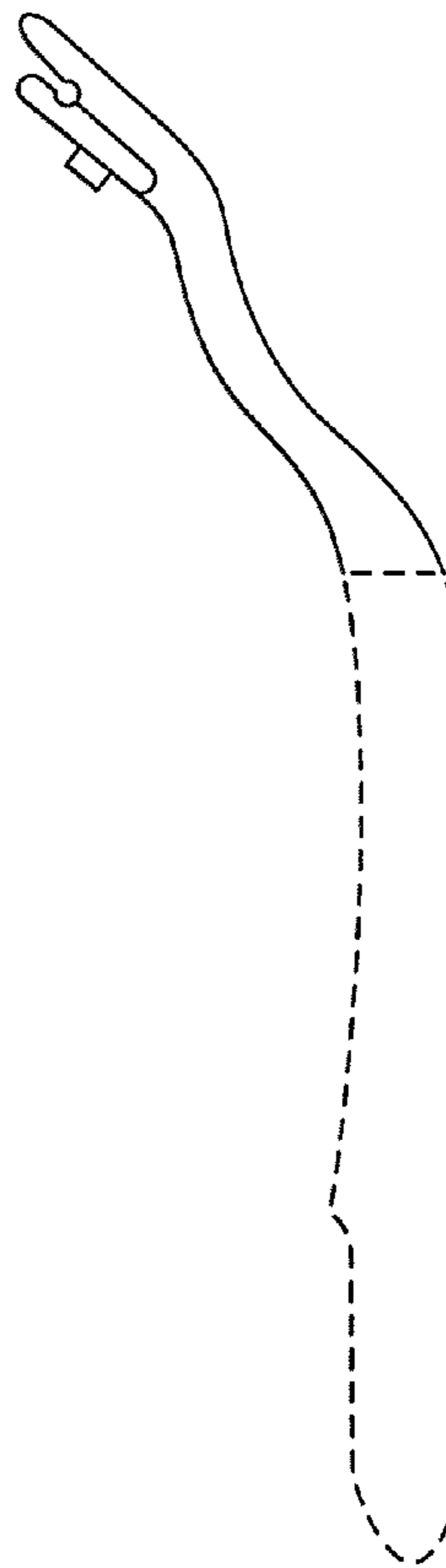
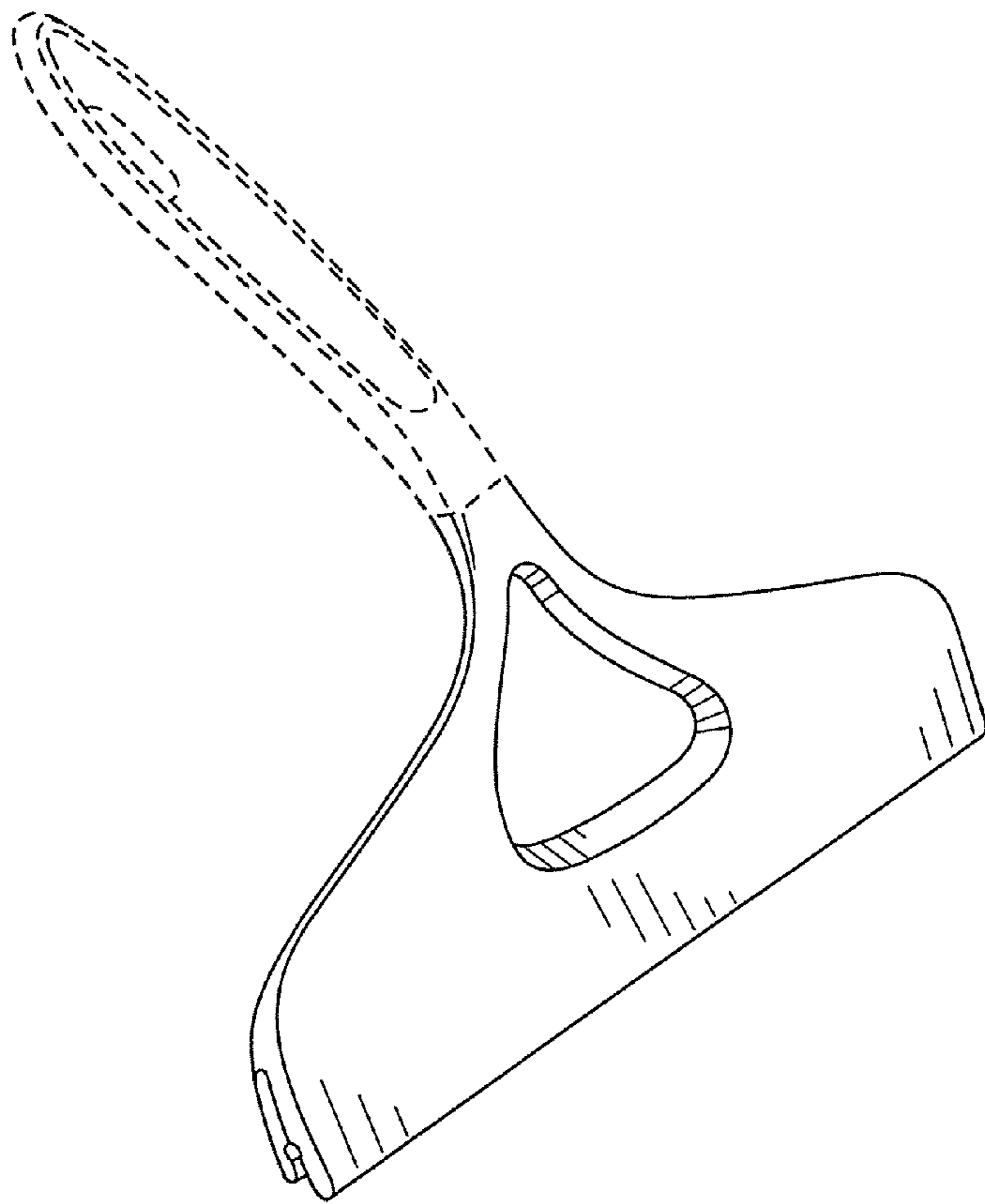
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

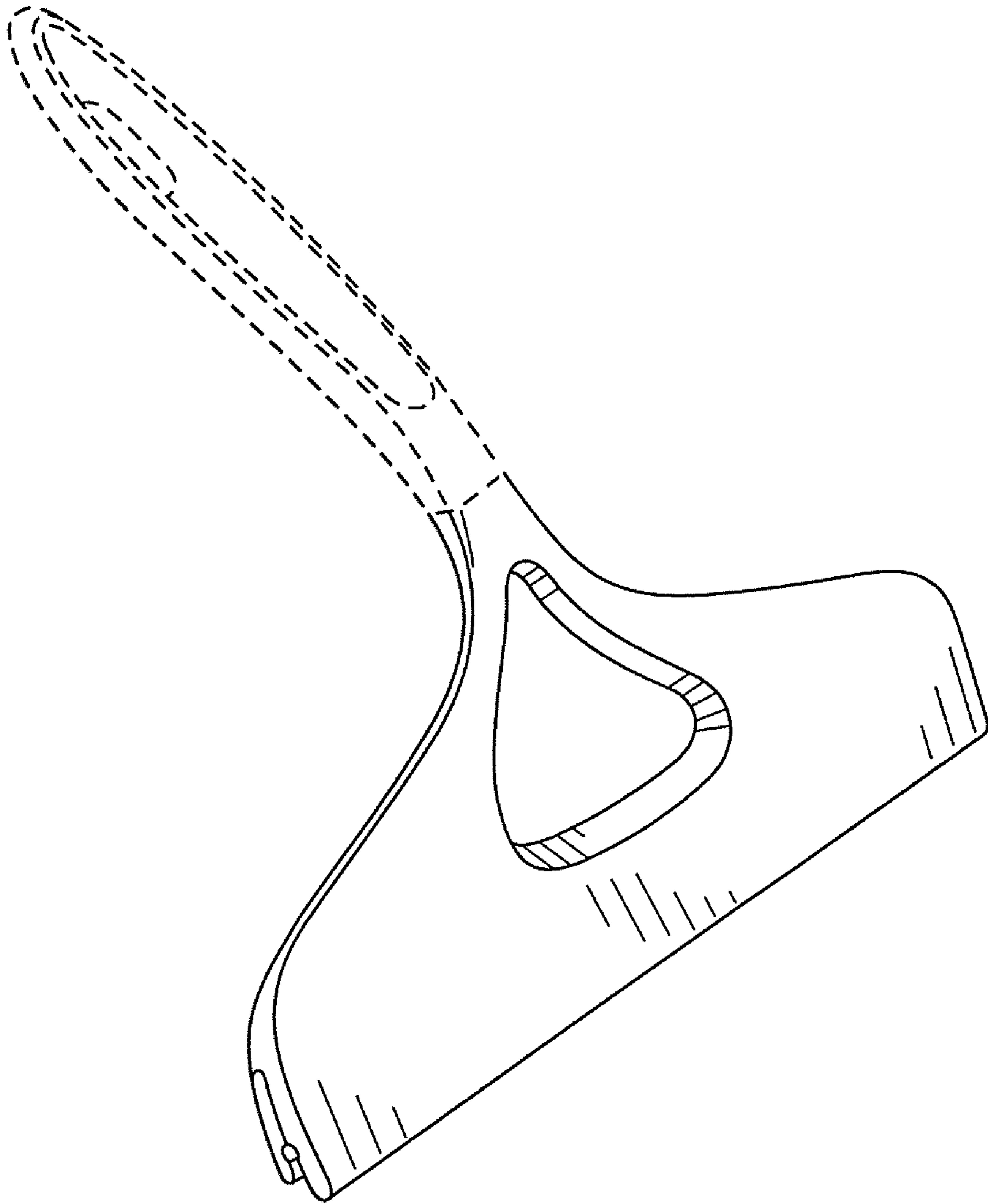

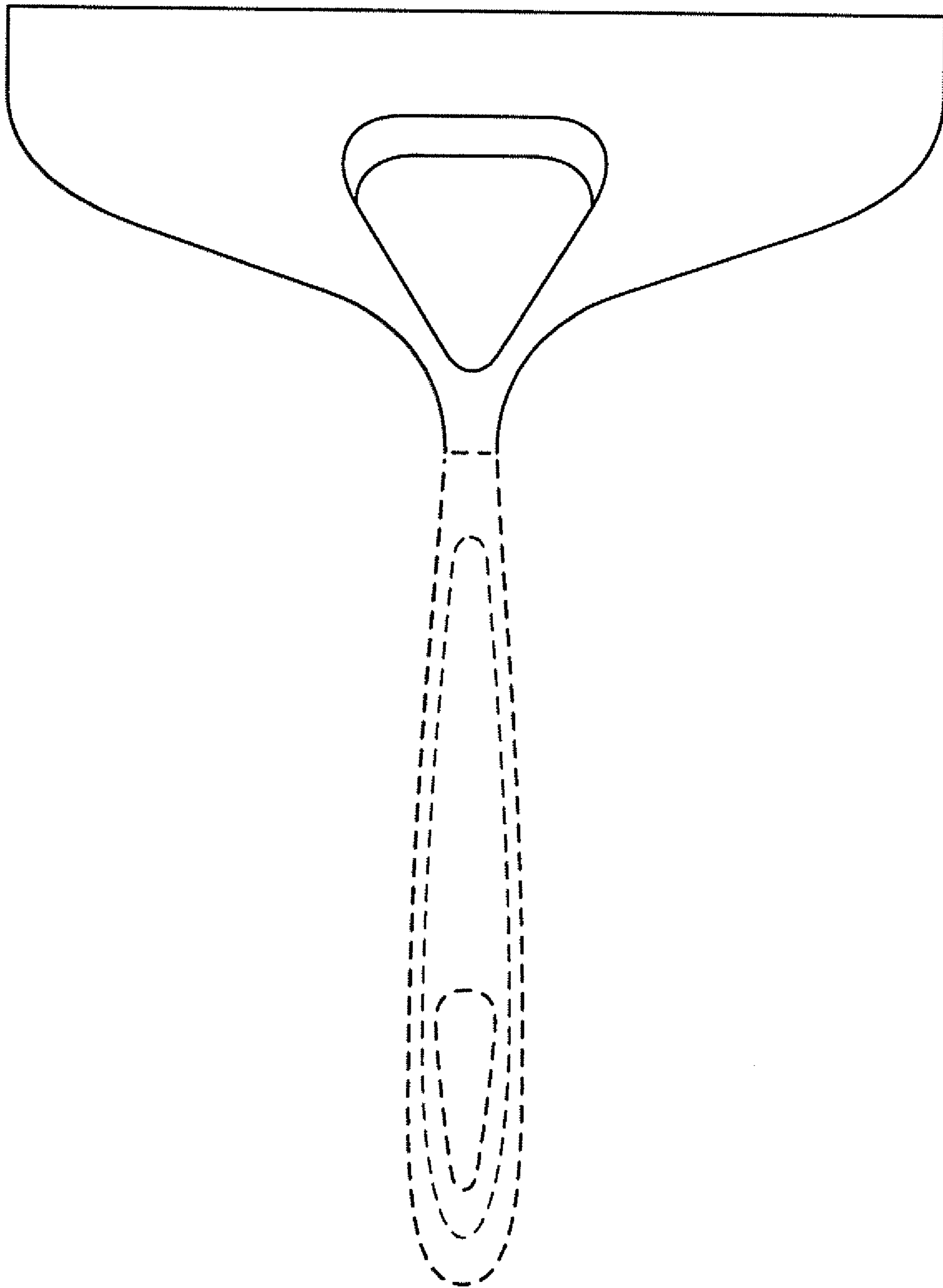

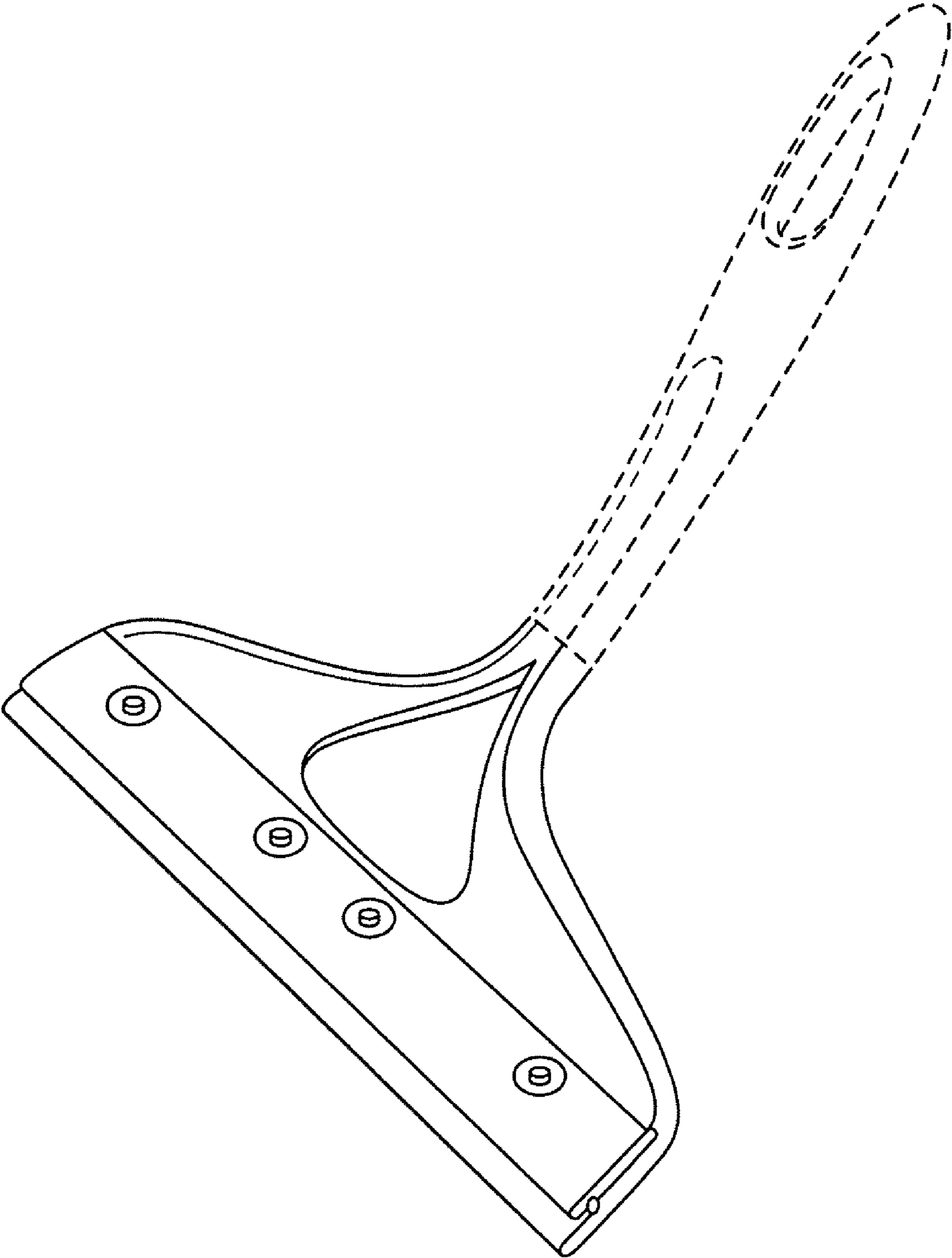

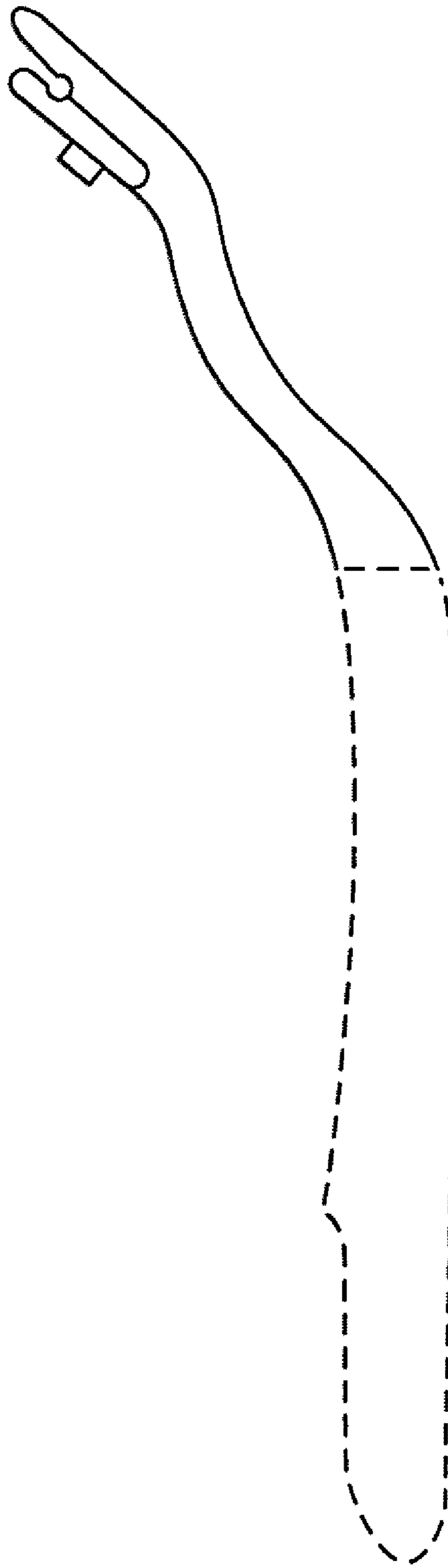
