The ornamental design for athletic shoe spike protector, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

A slip on cover for the sole of athletic shoes that provides a solid, sole-like surface appearance under an individual's spiked or cleat style shoes.

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of an athletic shoe spike protector showing my new design;

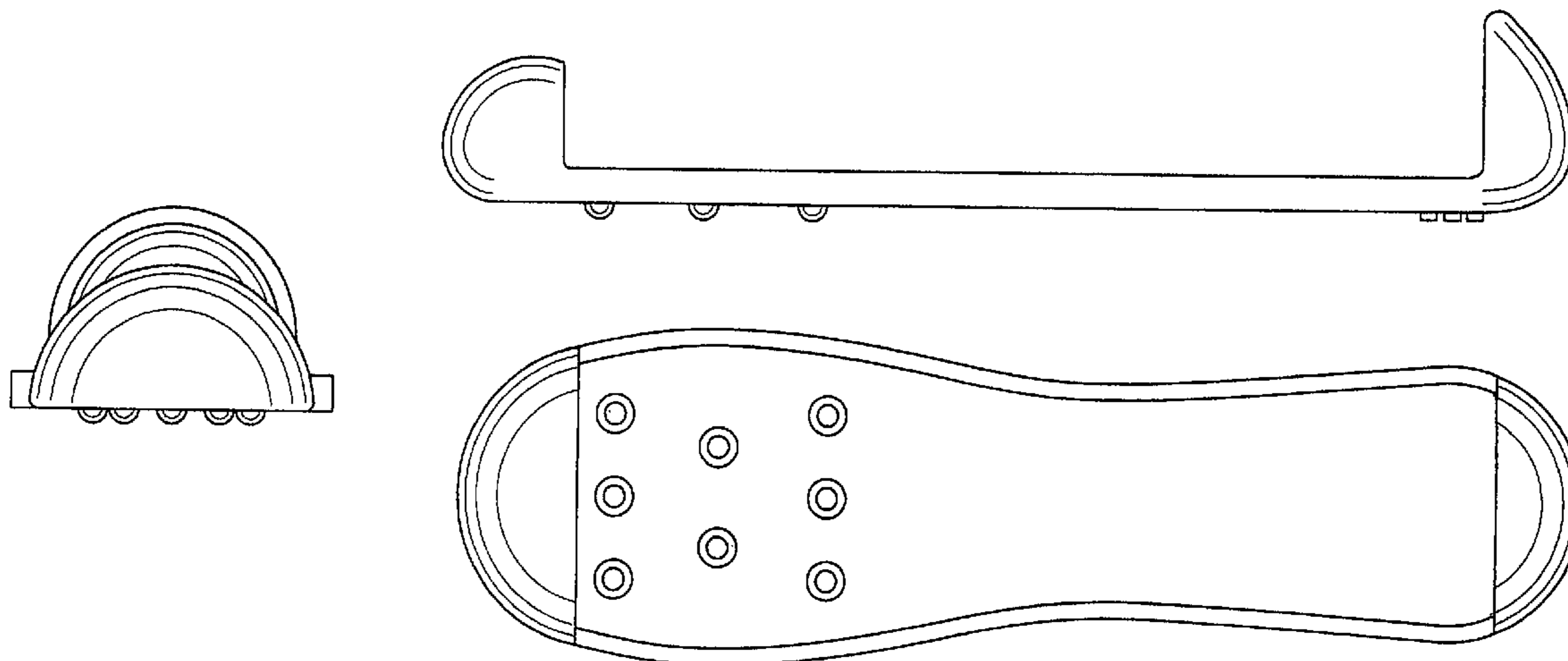
FIG. 2 is a back perspective view;

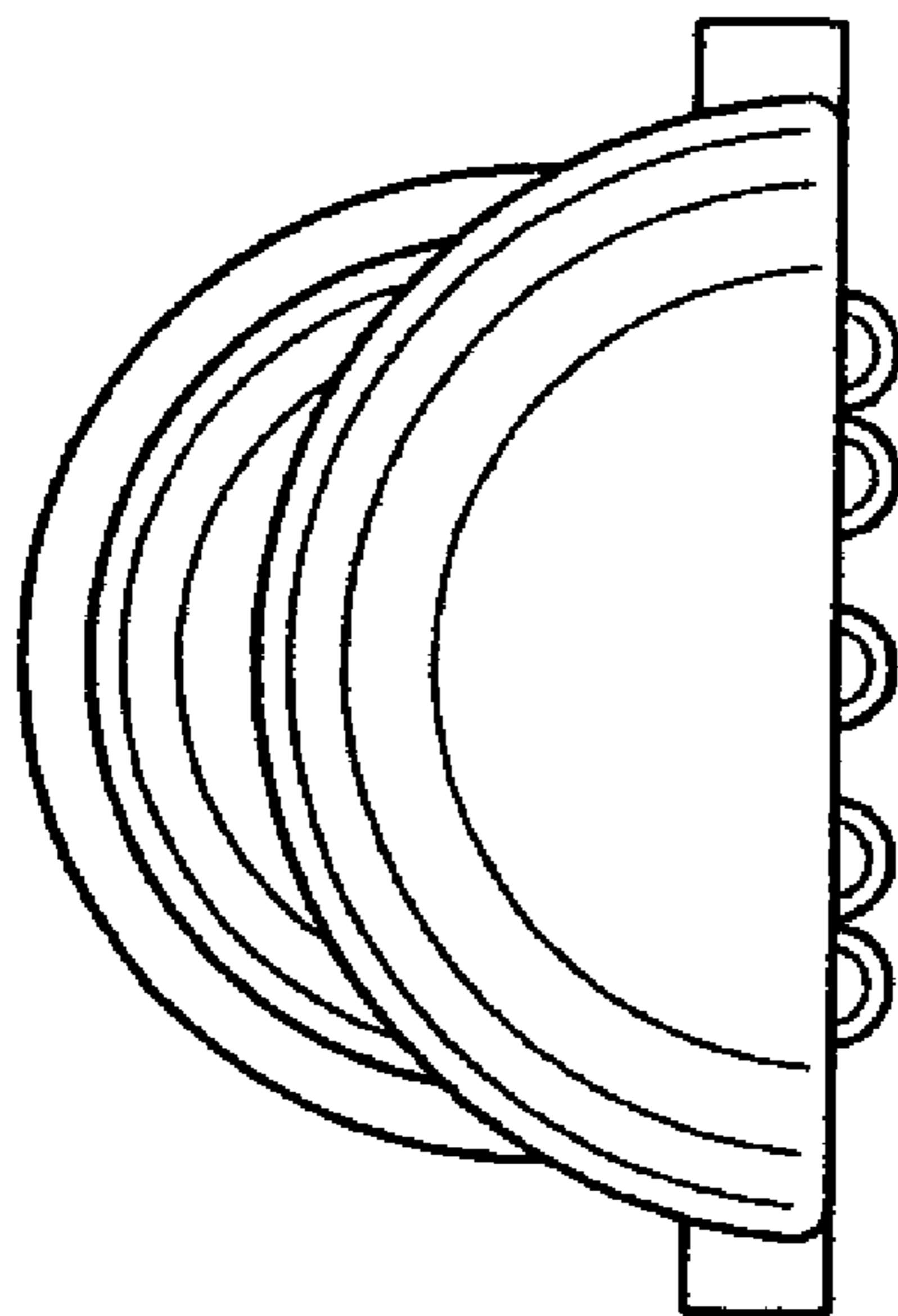

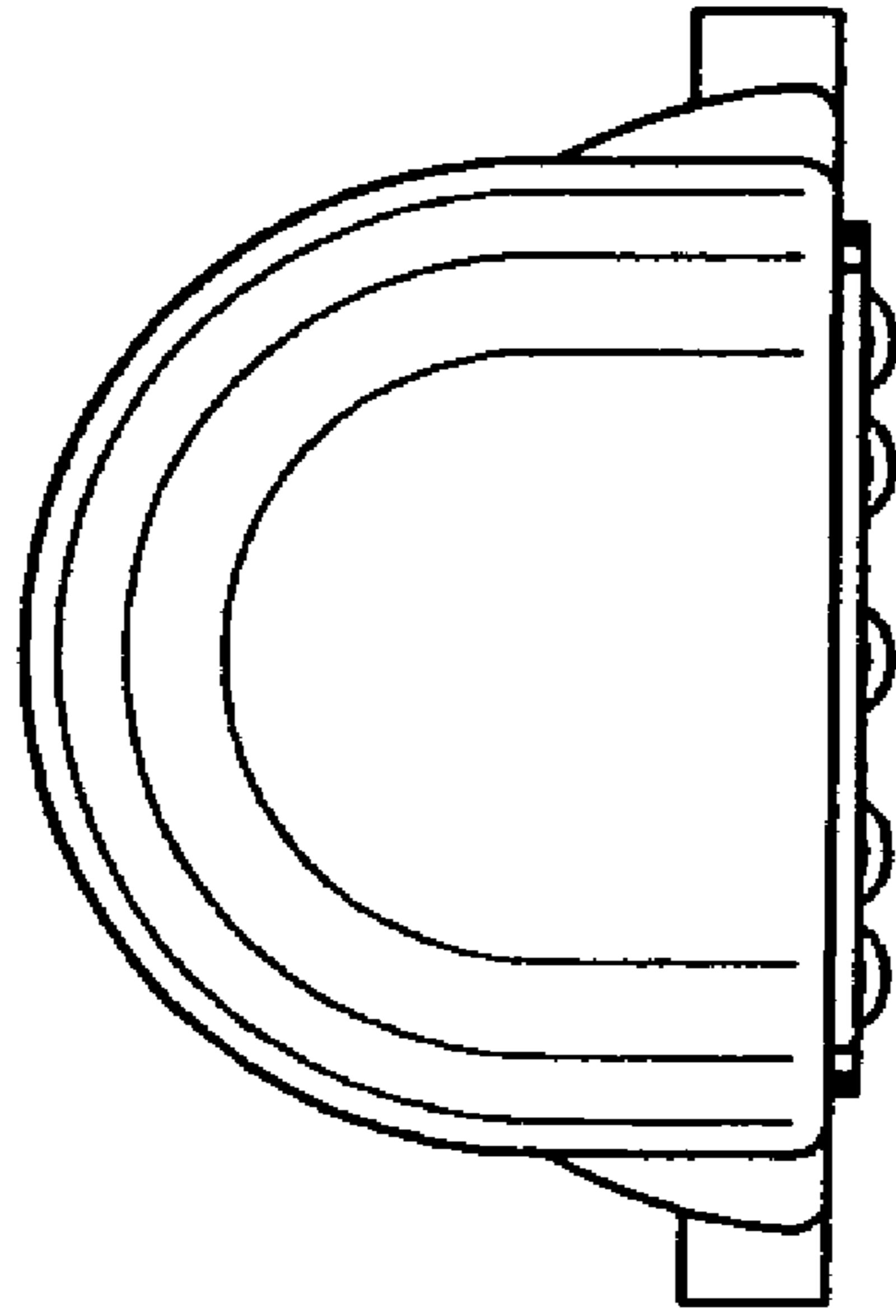

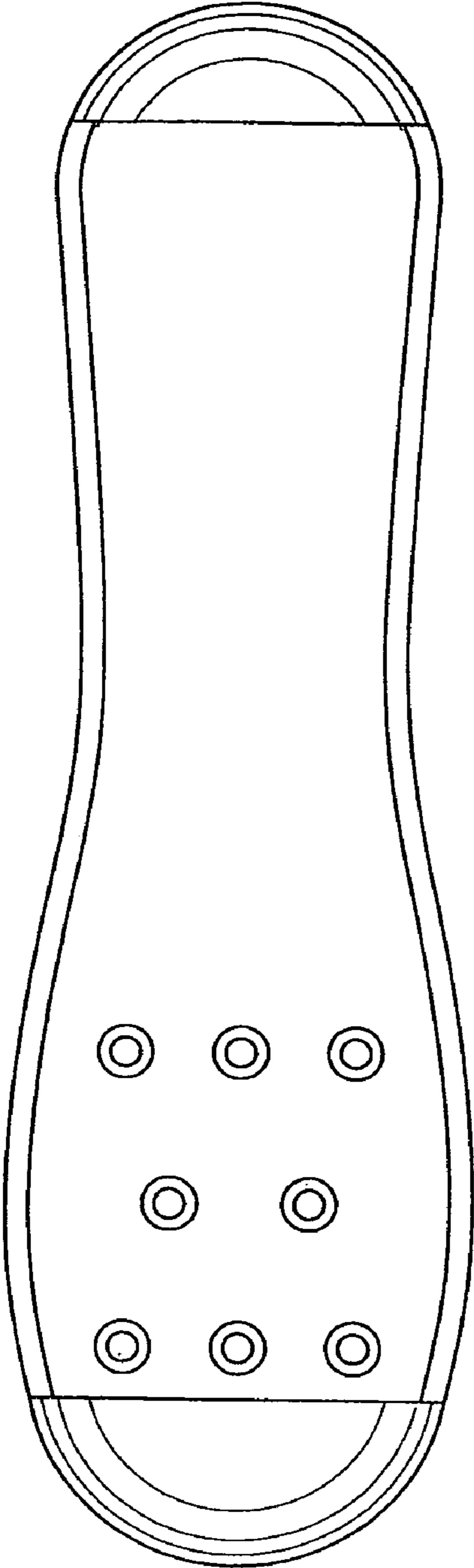

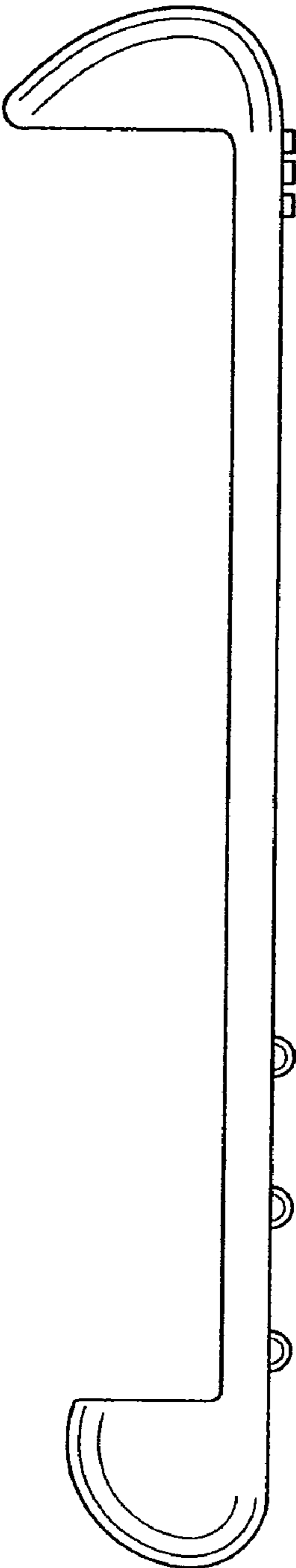

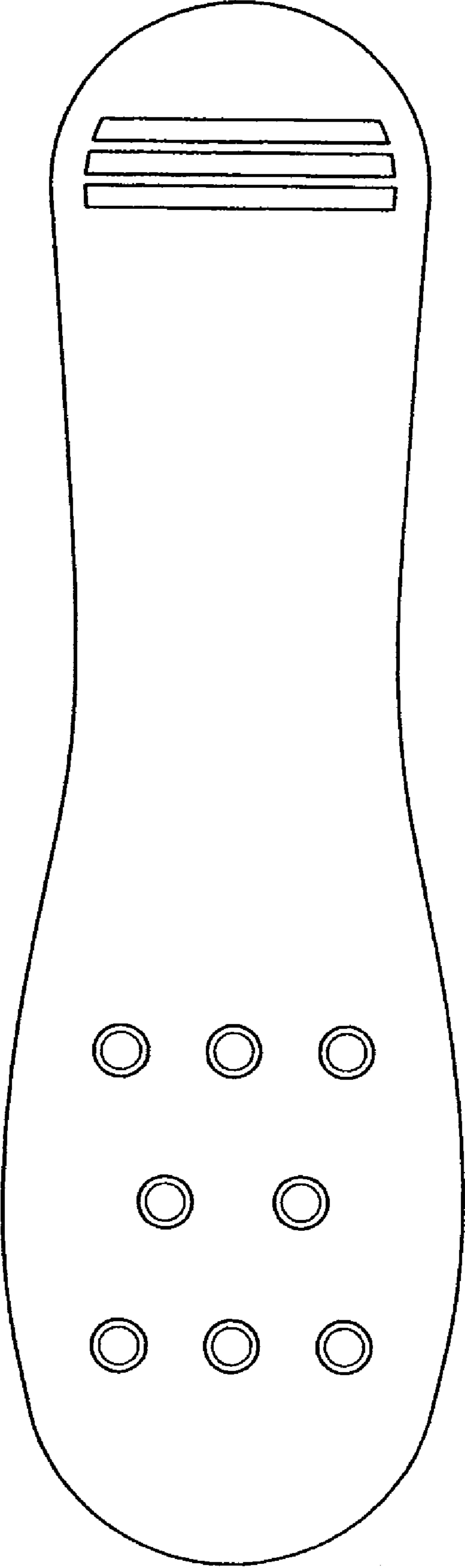
