as shown and described.

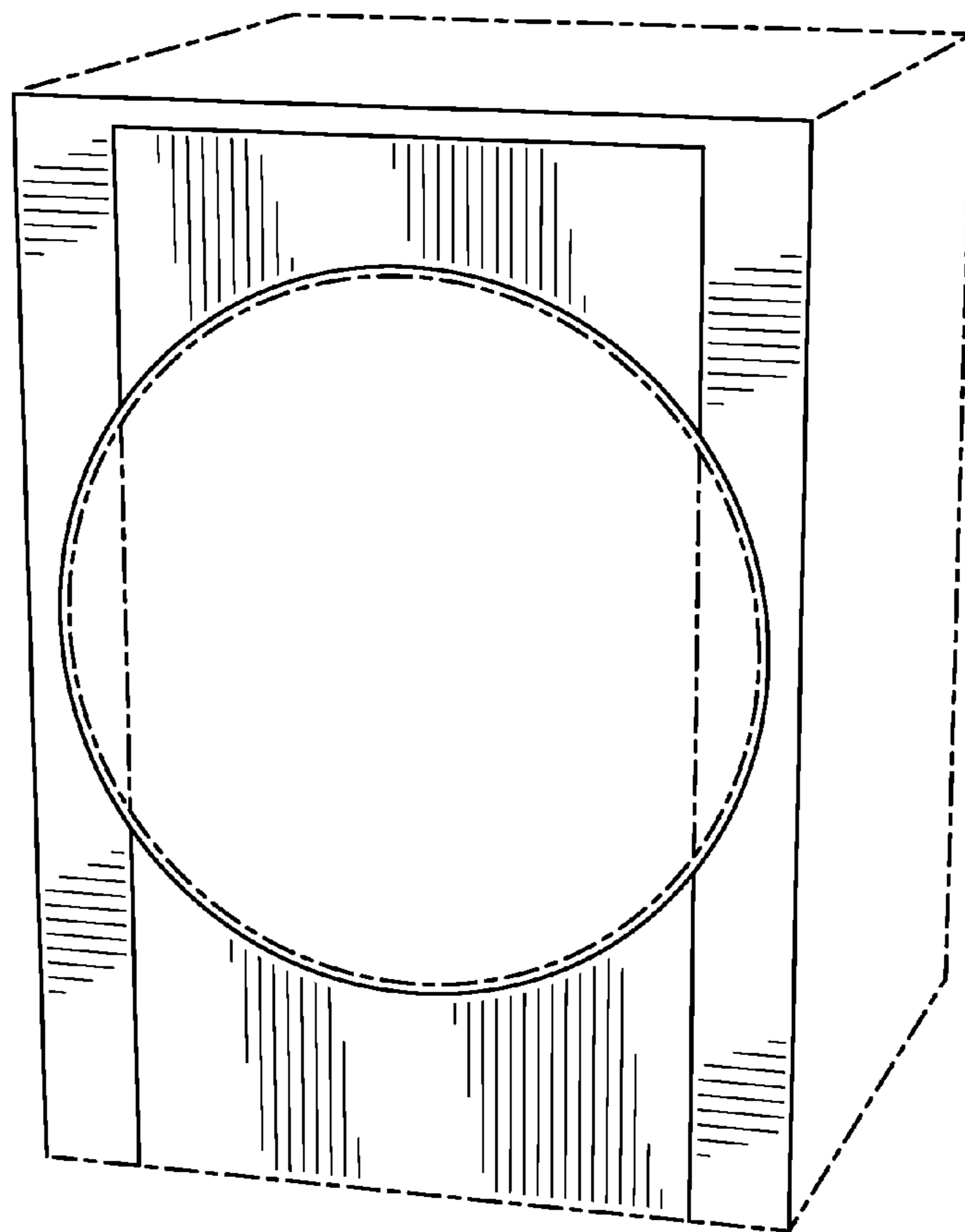
DESCRIPTION

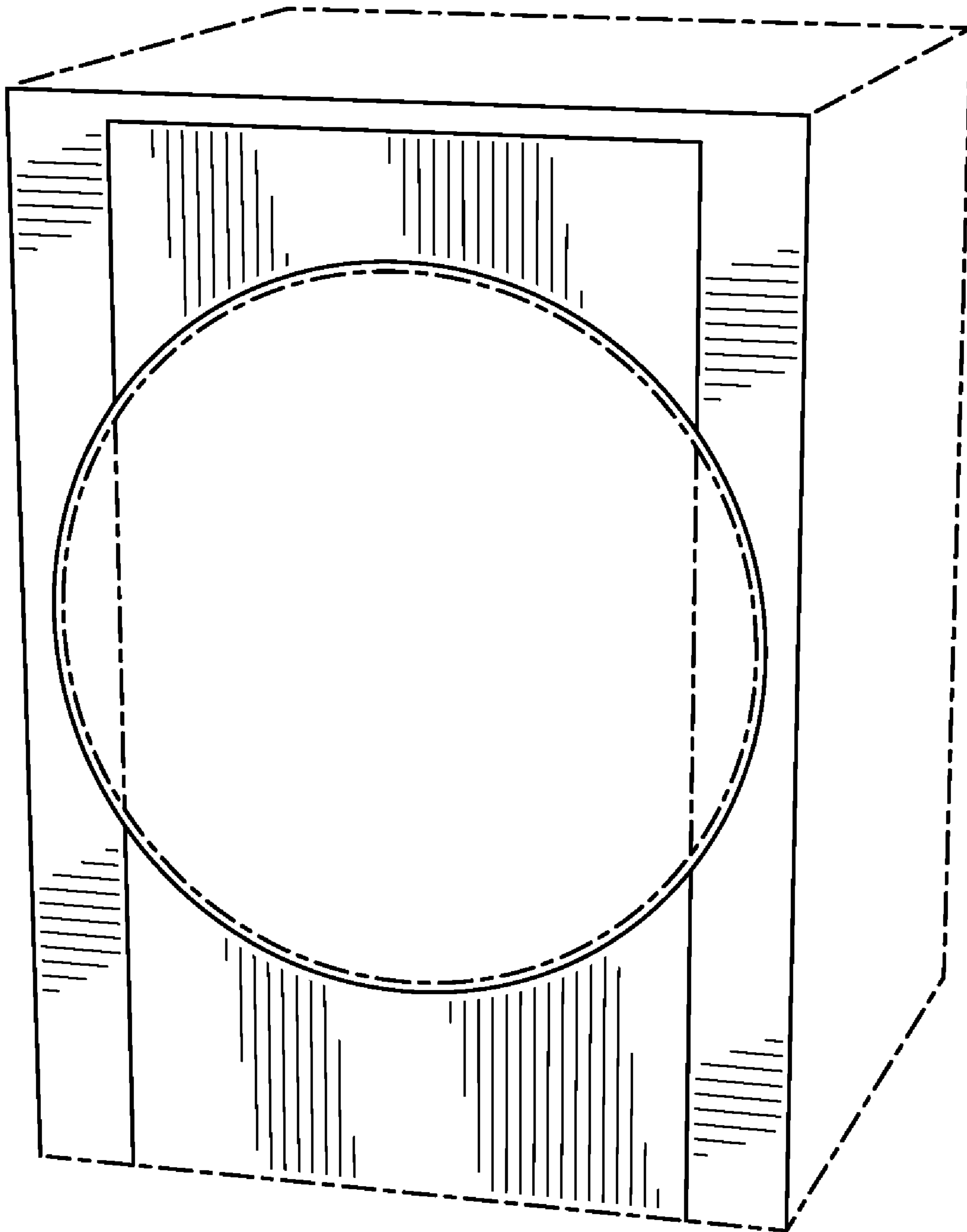

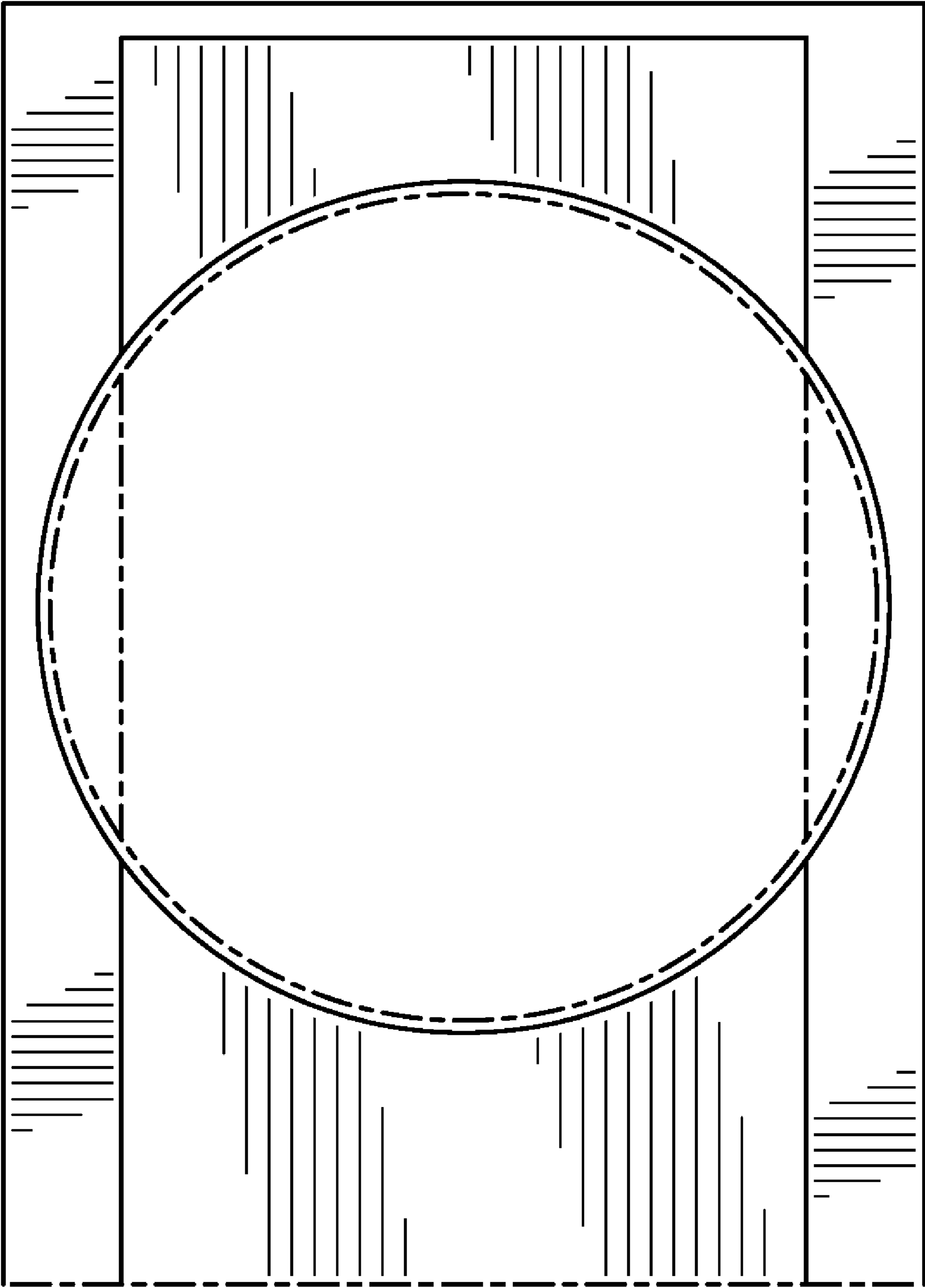
