FIG. 4 is a right side view of a powered hard floor cleaner according to FIG. 1.

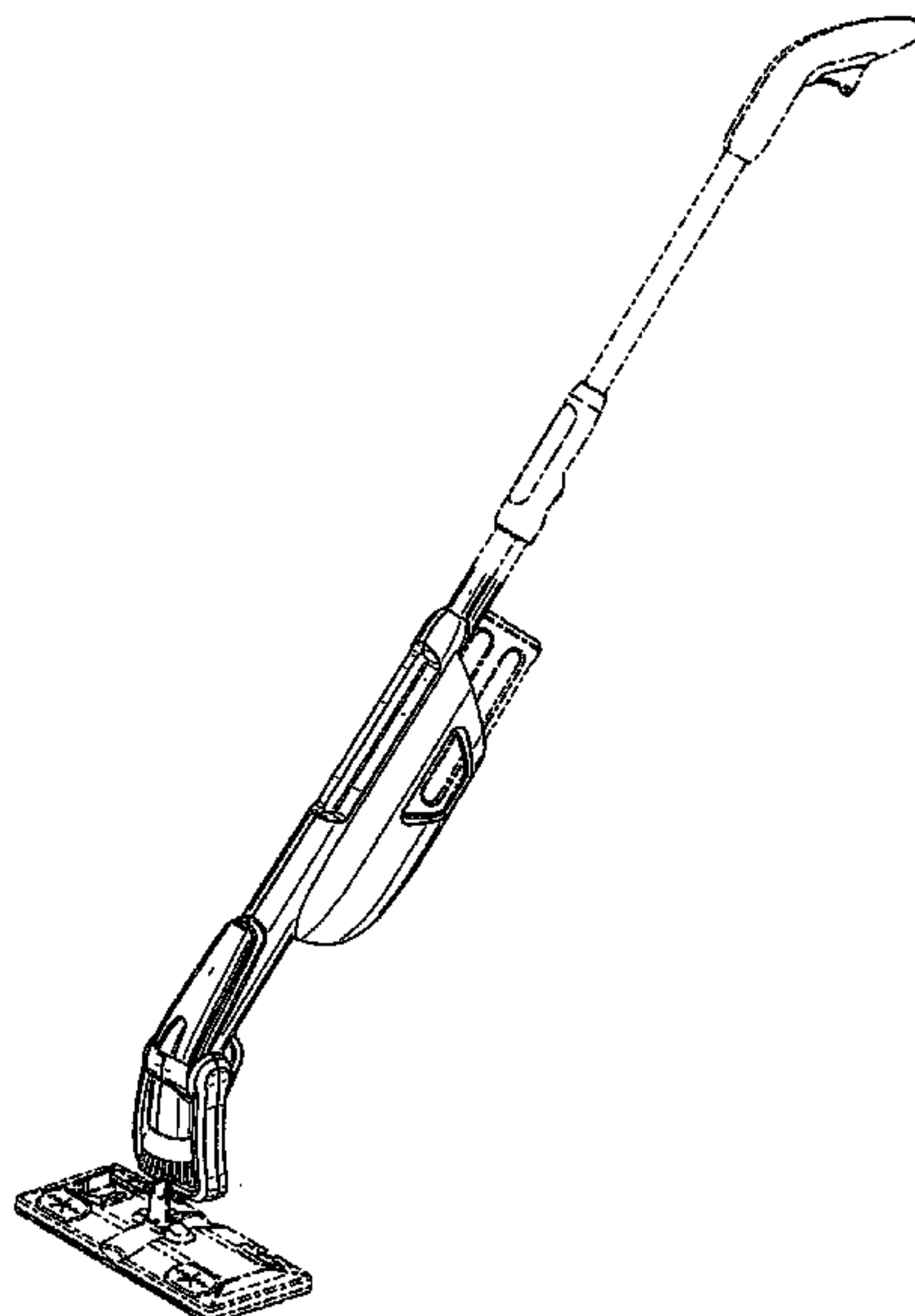
FIG. 5 is a left side view of a powered hard floor cleaner according to FIG. 1.

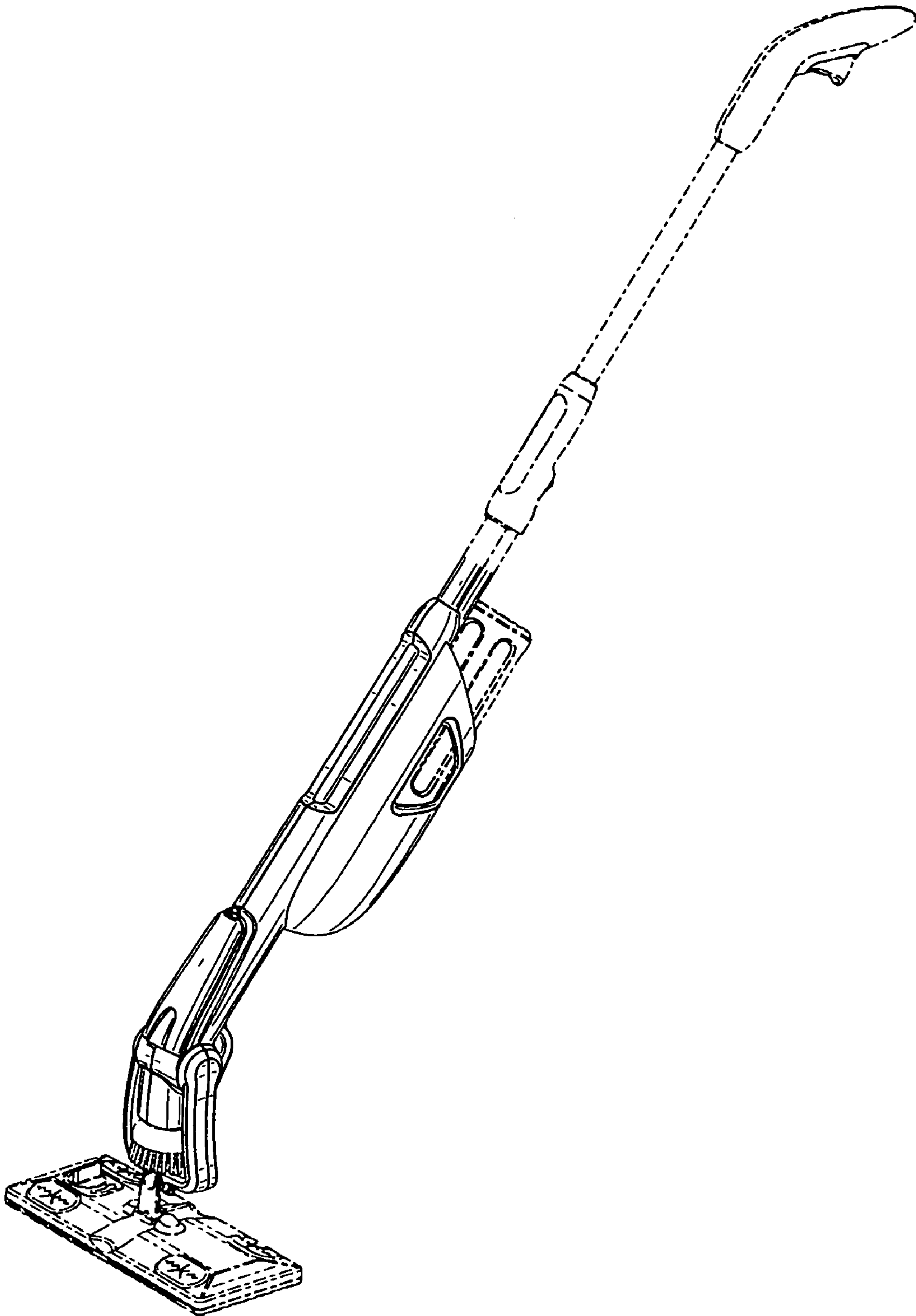

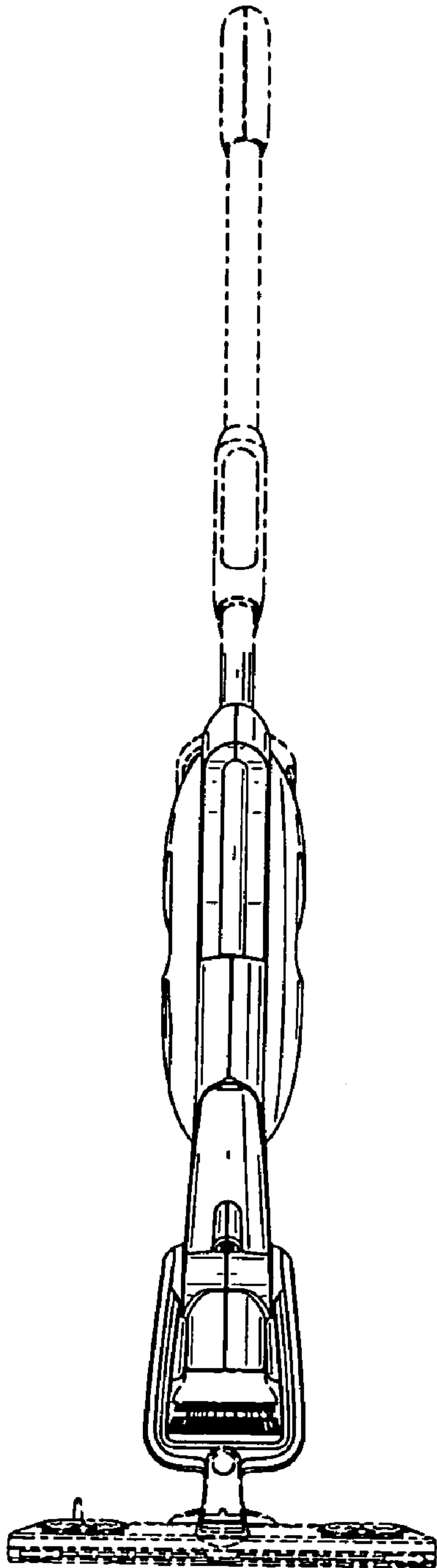

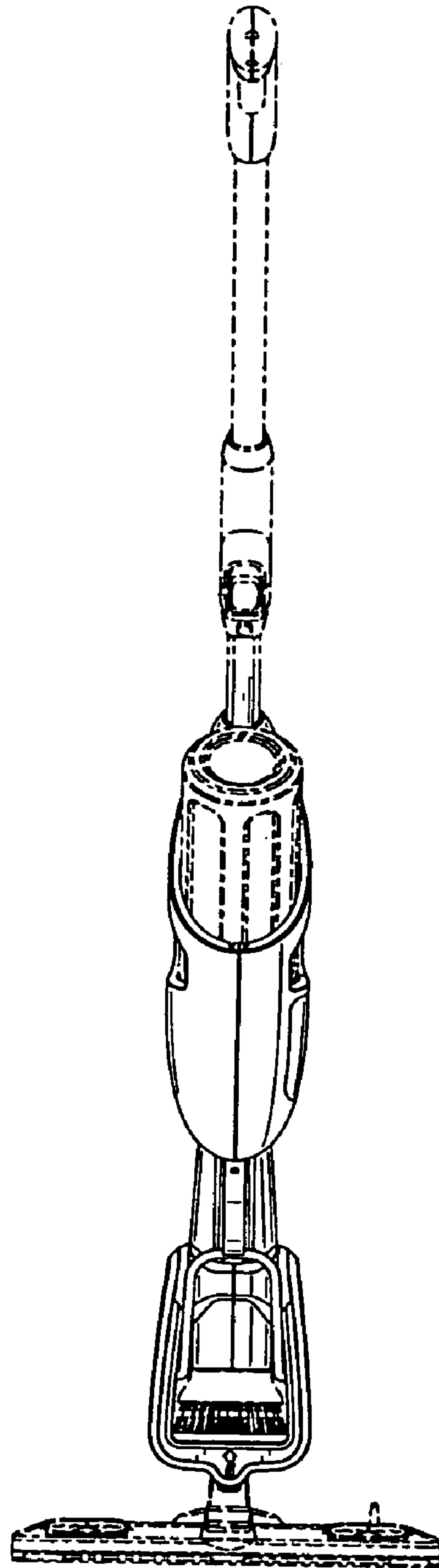

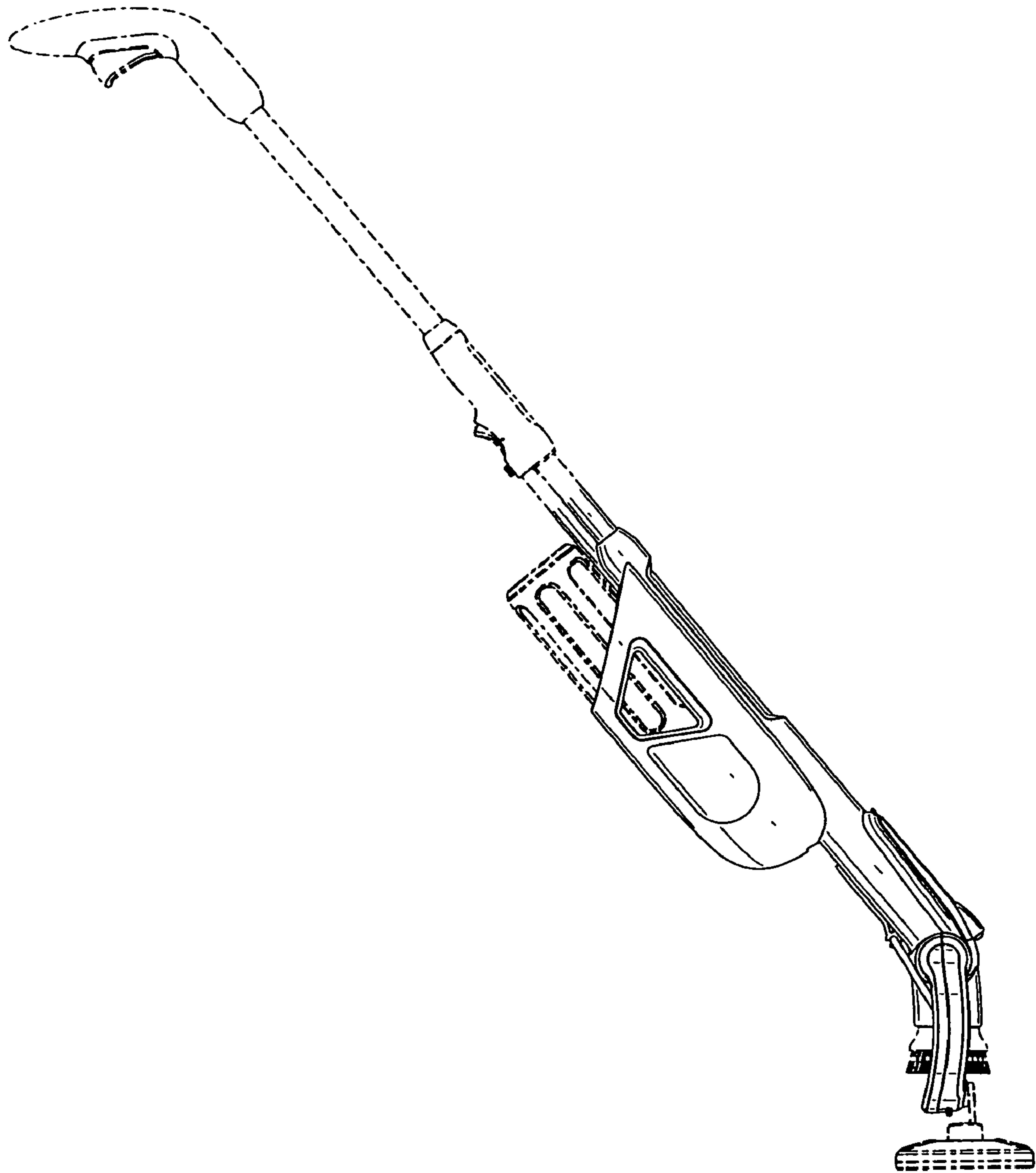

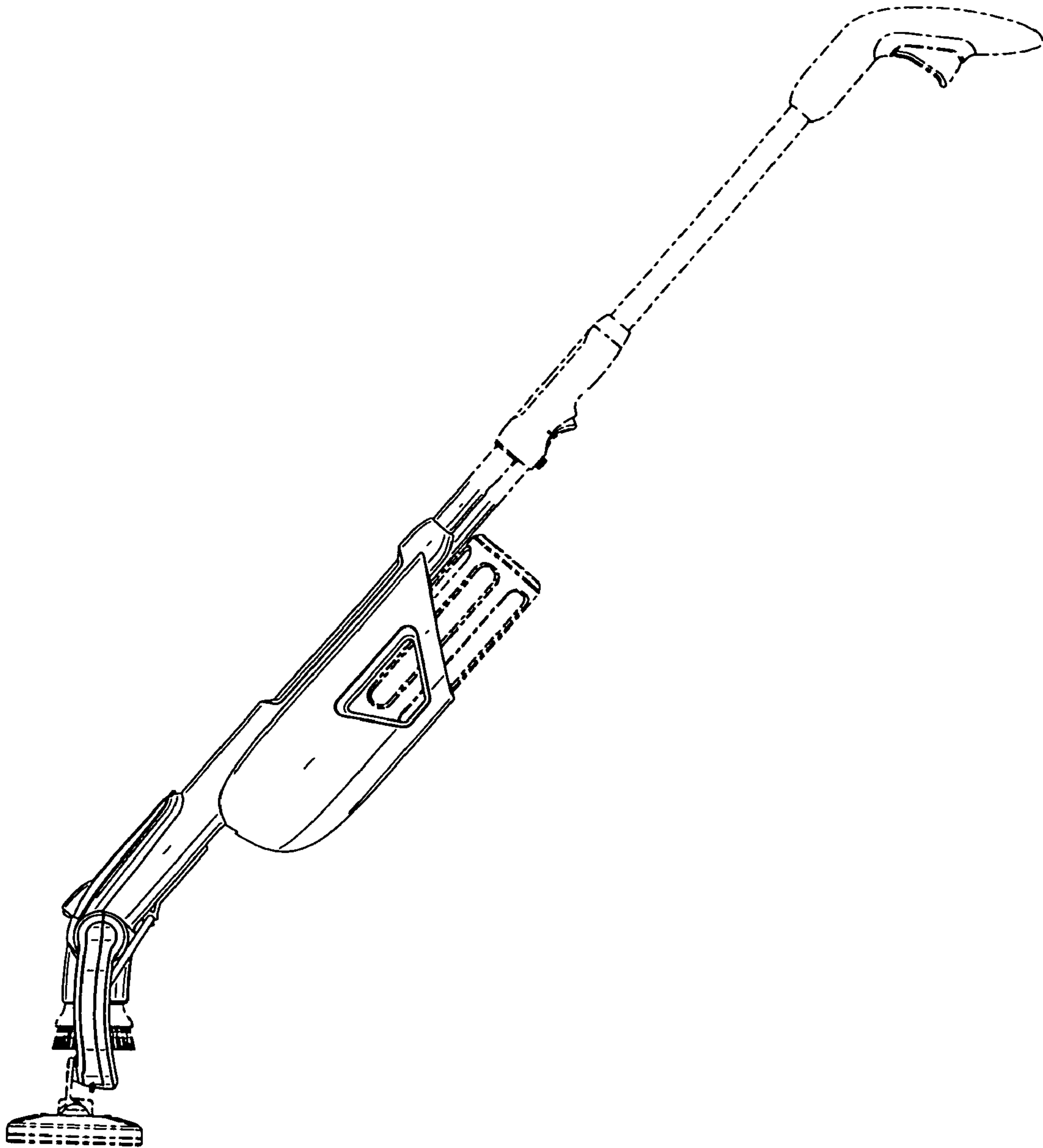

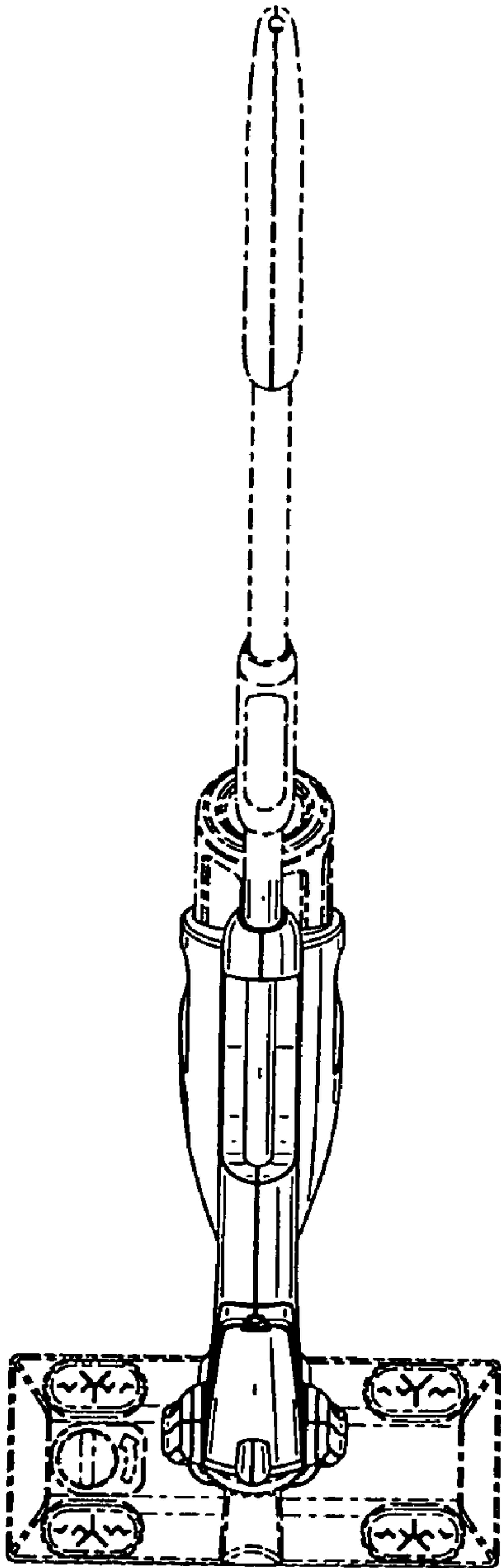

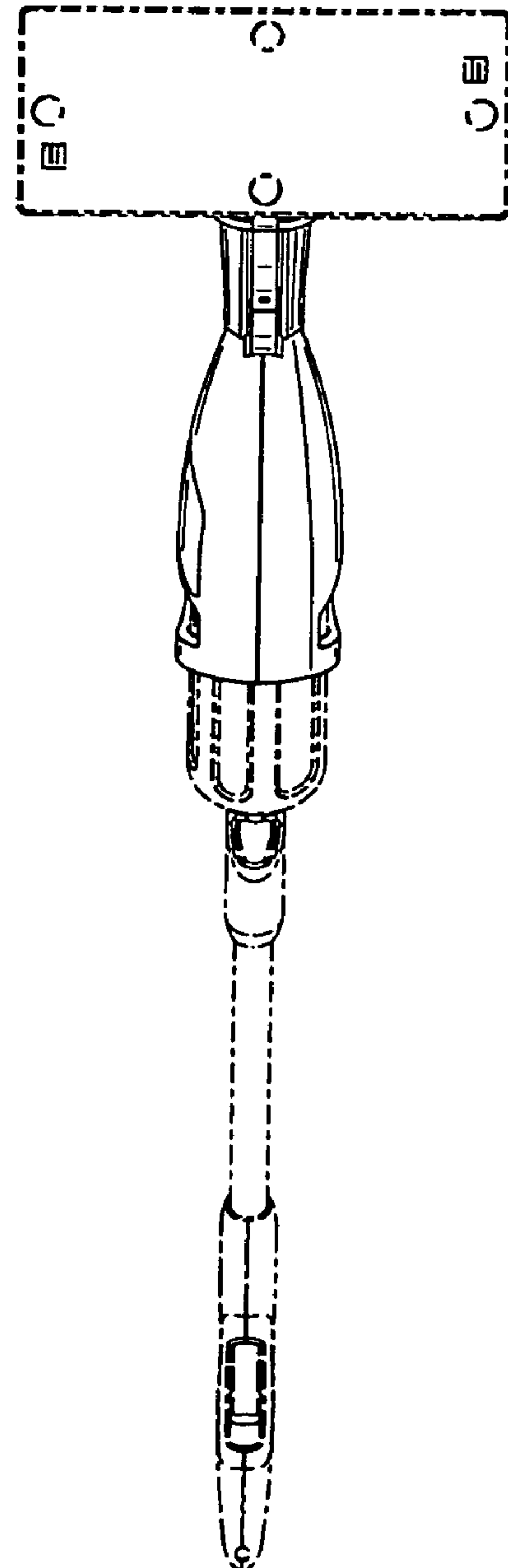
