FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view of the design shown in FIG. 1;


FIG. 3 is a planar cross-sectional view taken along lines 3—3 in FIG. 2;


FIG. 4 is a planar cross-sectional view taken along lines **4**—**4** in FIG. **2**; and,


FIG. 5 is a planar cross-sectional view taken along lines 5—5 in FIG. 2.


The broken line showing is included for the purpose of illustrating and forms no part of the claimed design.
