FIG. 1 is front view of an ornamental design for a seat and base showing my new design;

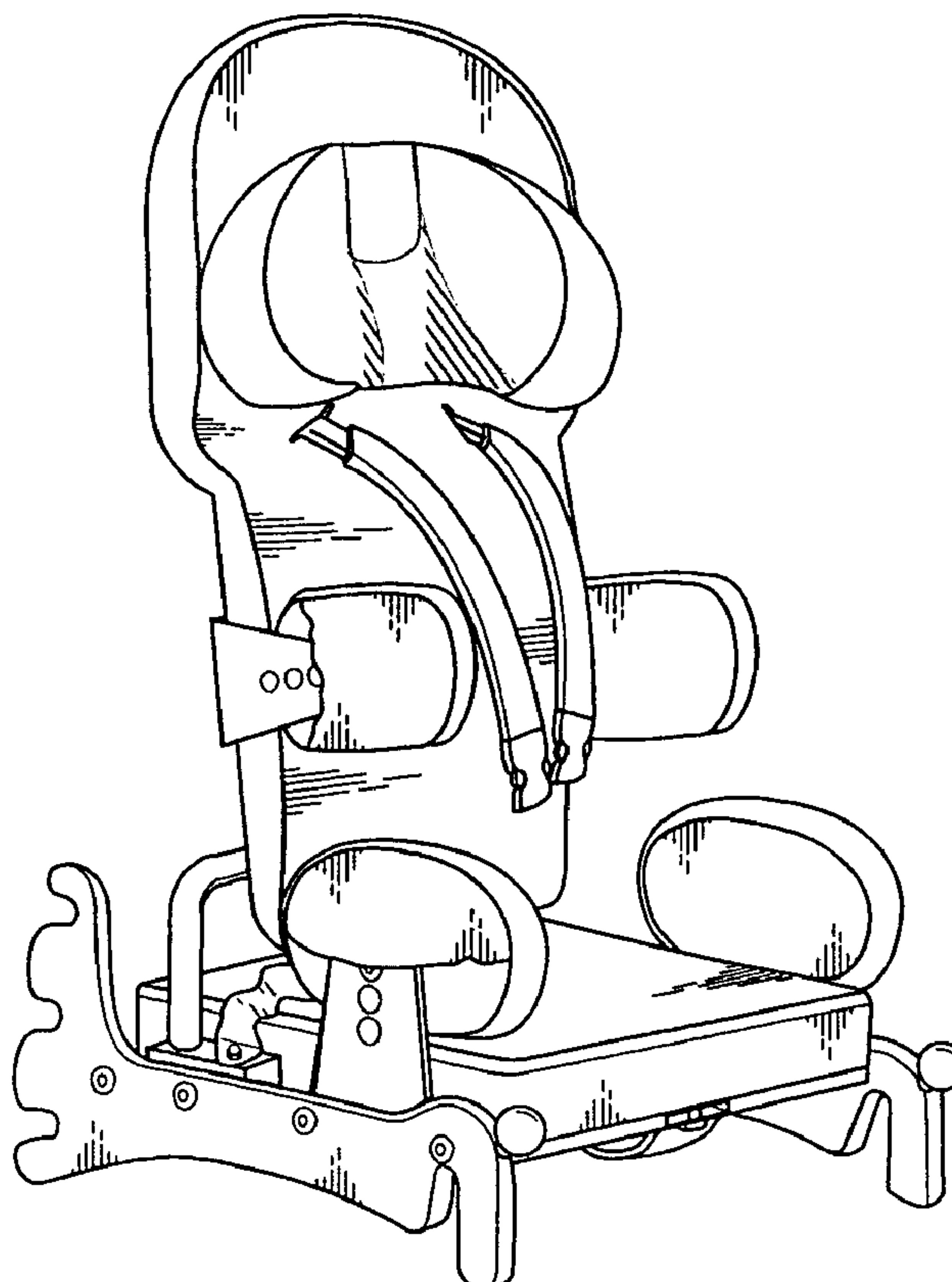
FIG. 2 is an elevated perspective view of the embodiment depicted in FIG. 1;

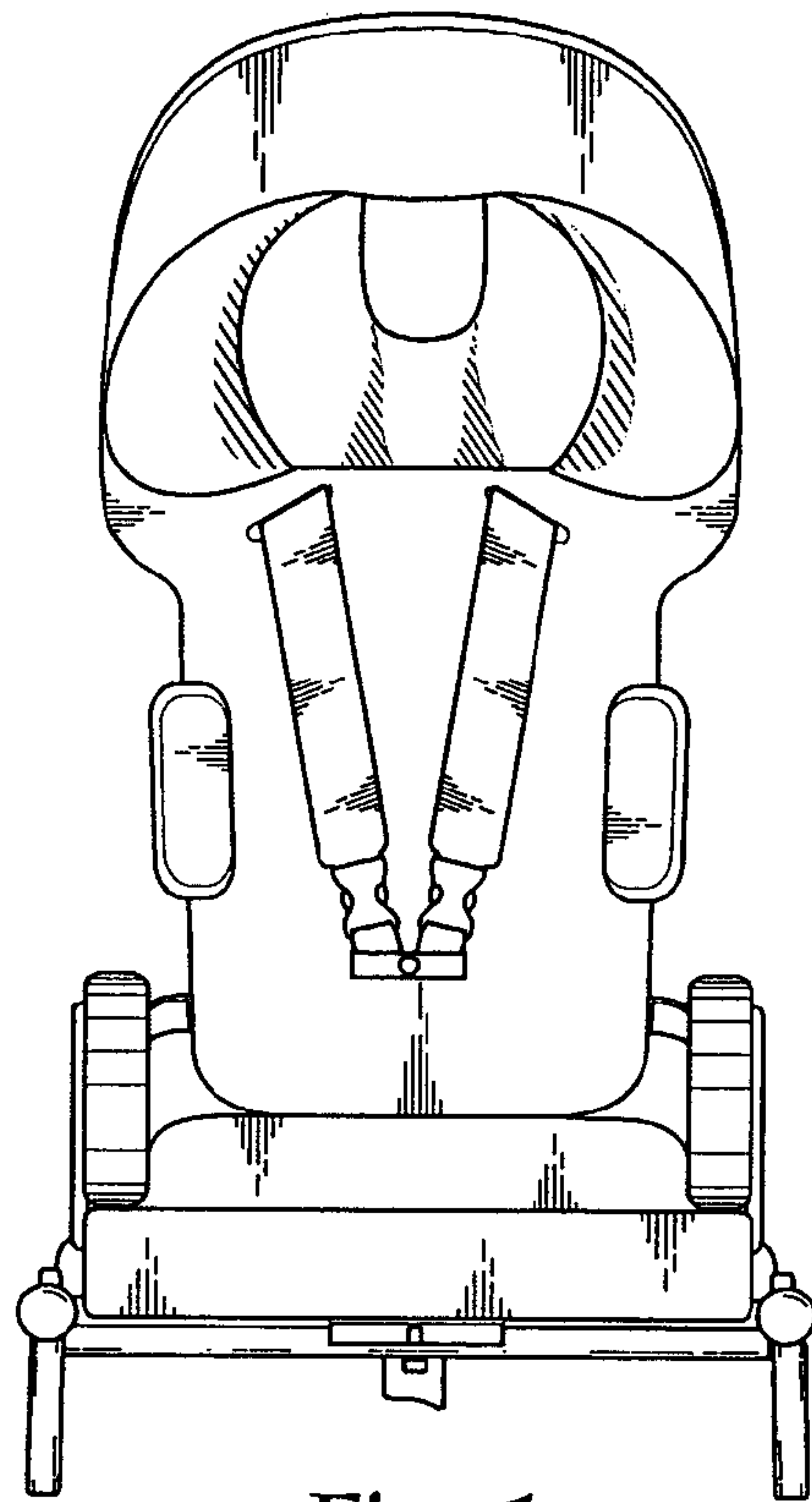

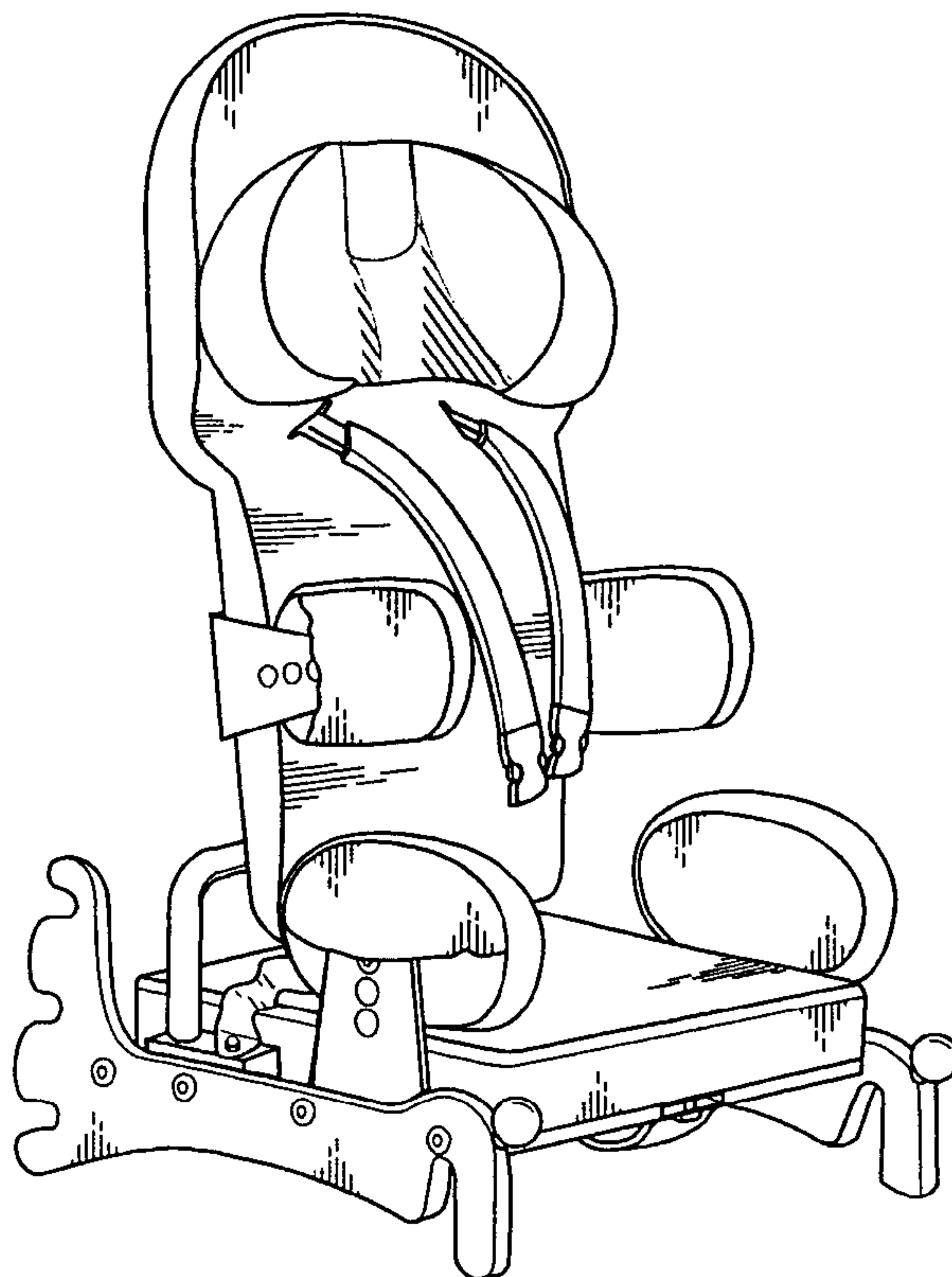

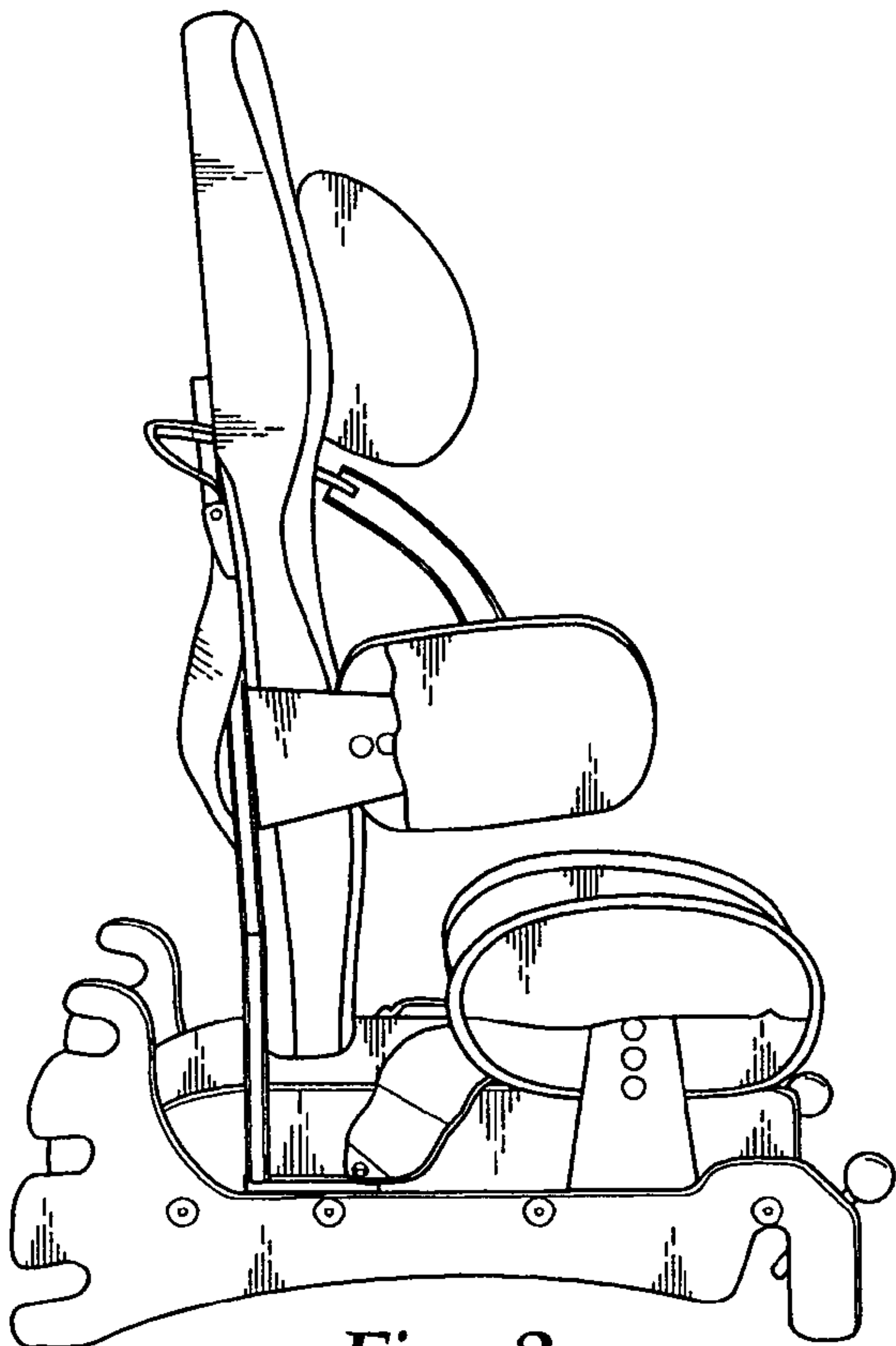

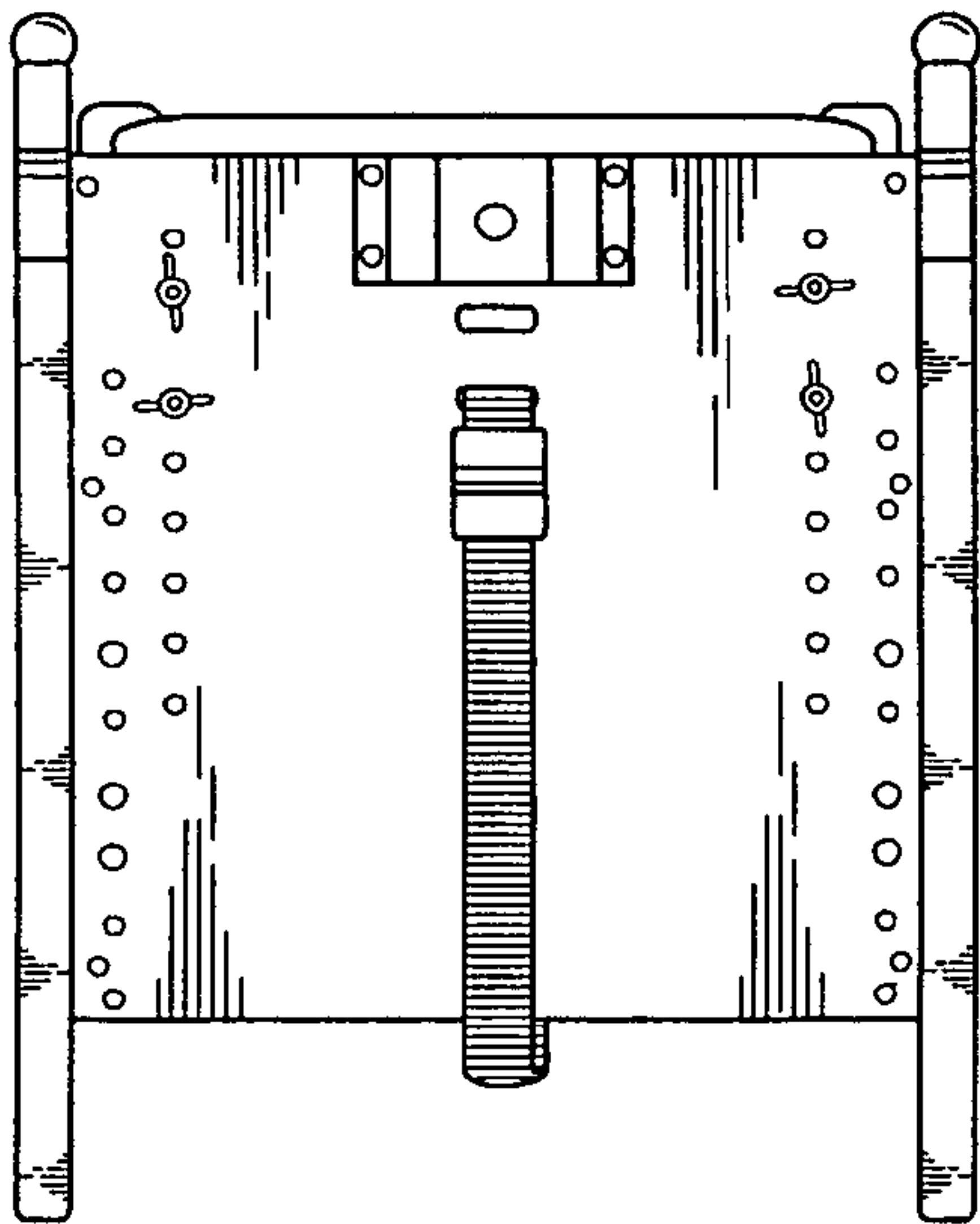

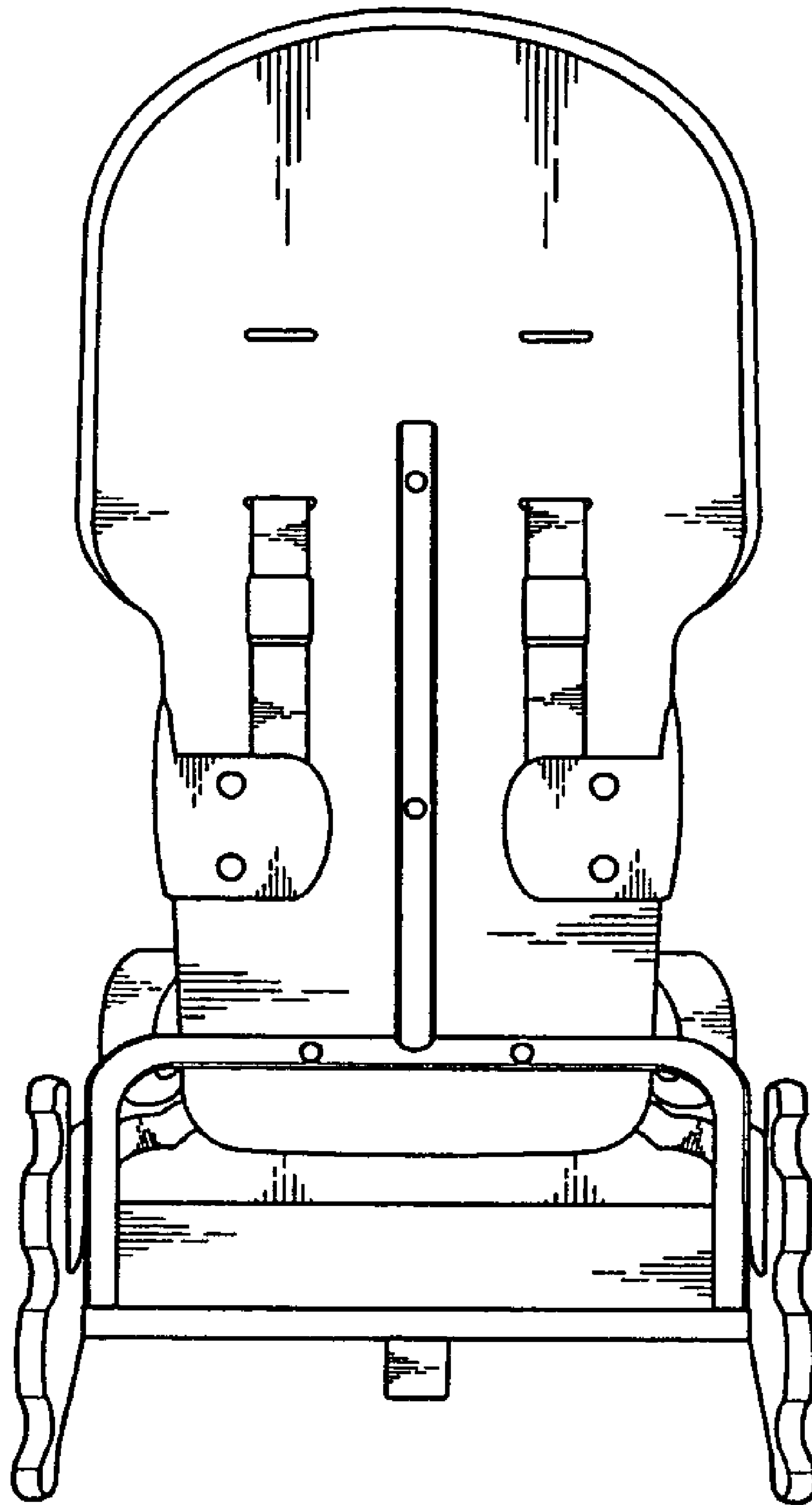
