(57) **CLAIM**

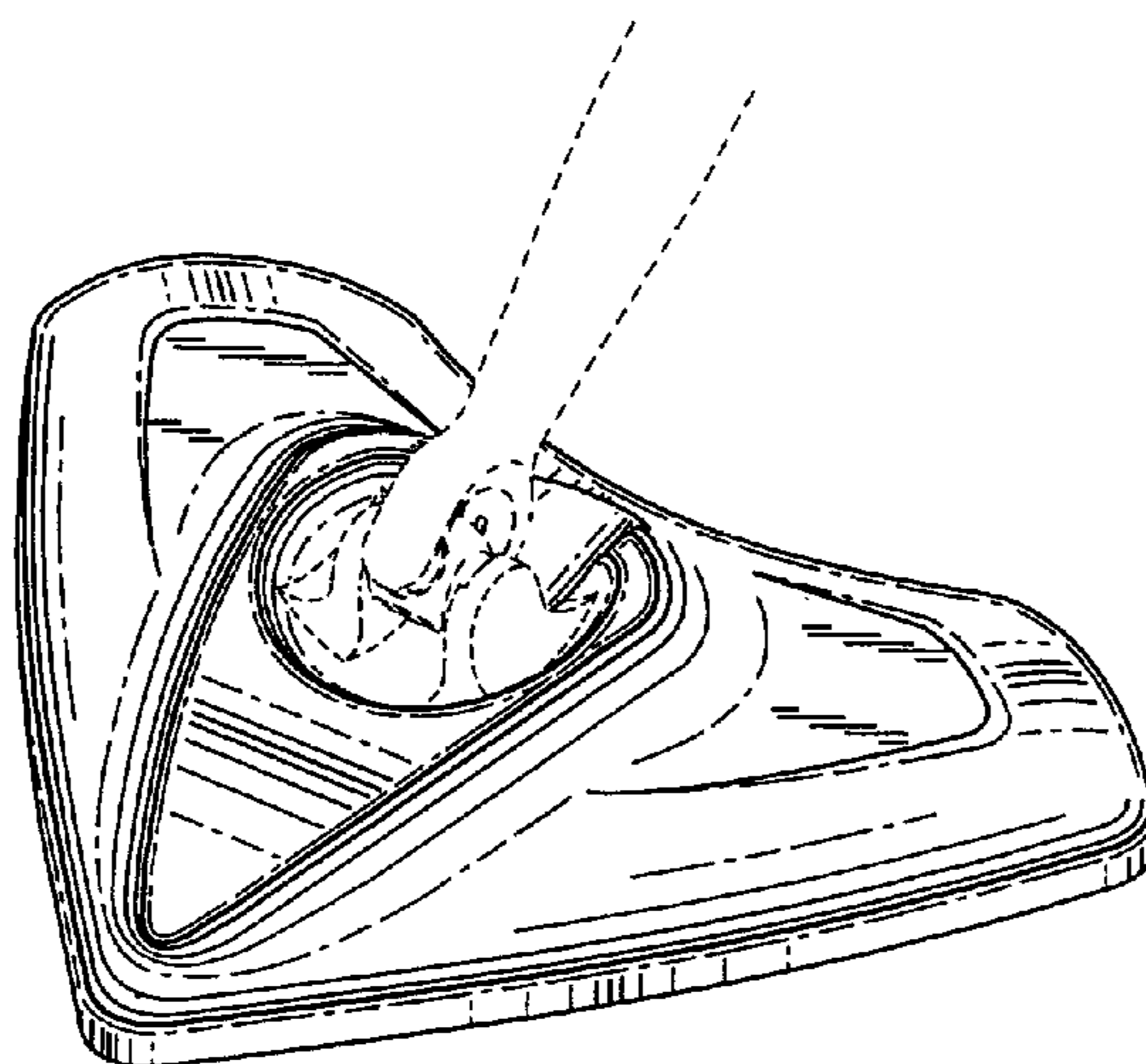
The ornamental design for a bathroom mop, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a bathroom mop;
FIG. 2 is a front view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a left side view thereof, the right side view being
a mirror image of the left side view;
FIG. 4 is a top view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a rear view thereof; and,
FIG. 6 is a bottom view thereof.

The broken lines in the drawings are shown for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design. In addition, the surface shading illustrated in the drawings is provided merely to highlight the contour of design; it is not intended to be illustrative of texture or gloss.

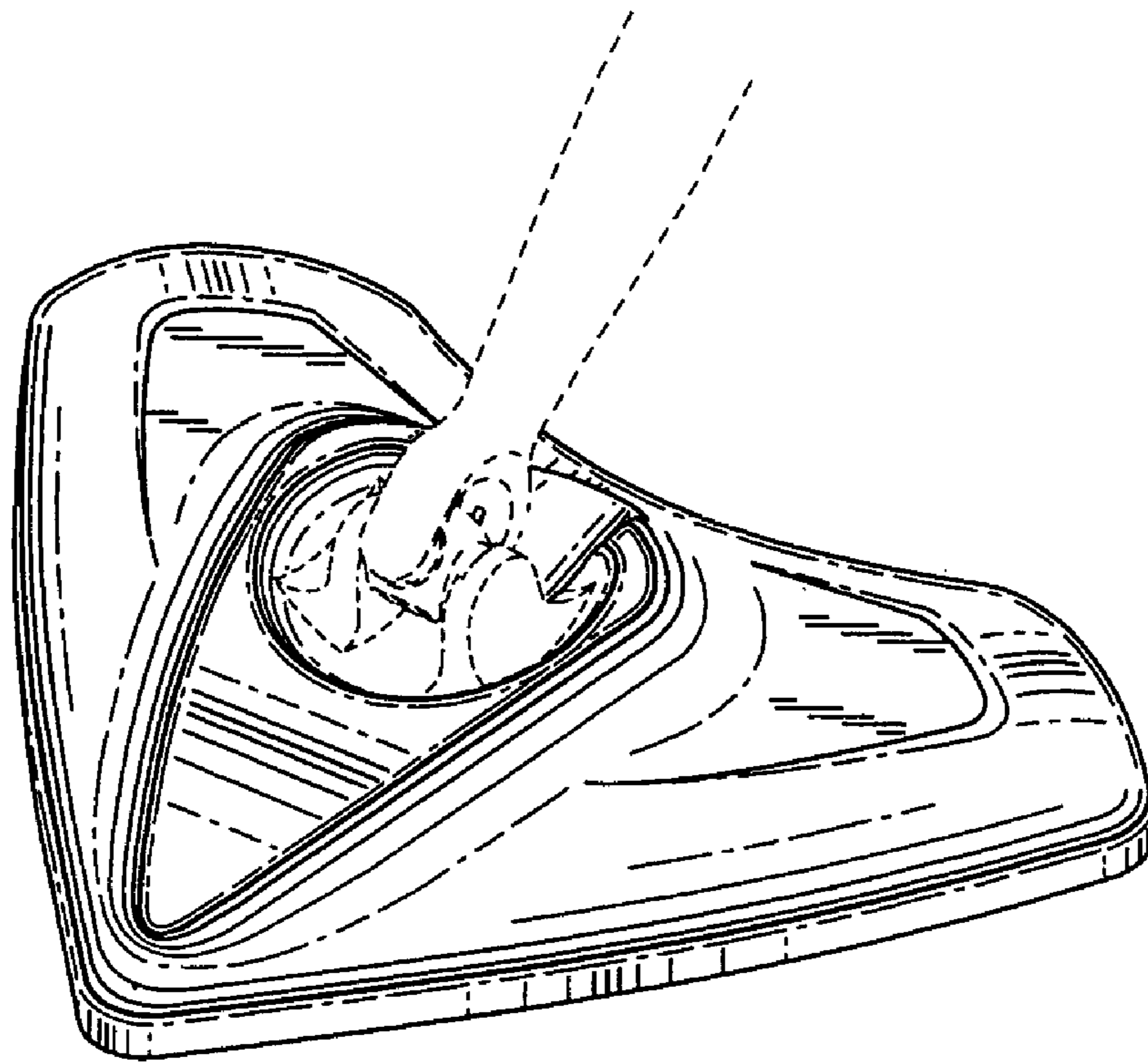

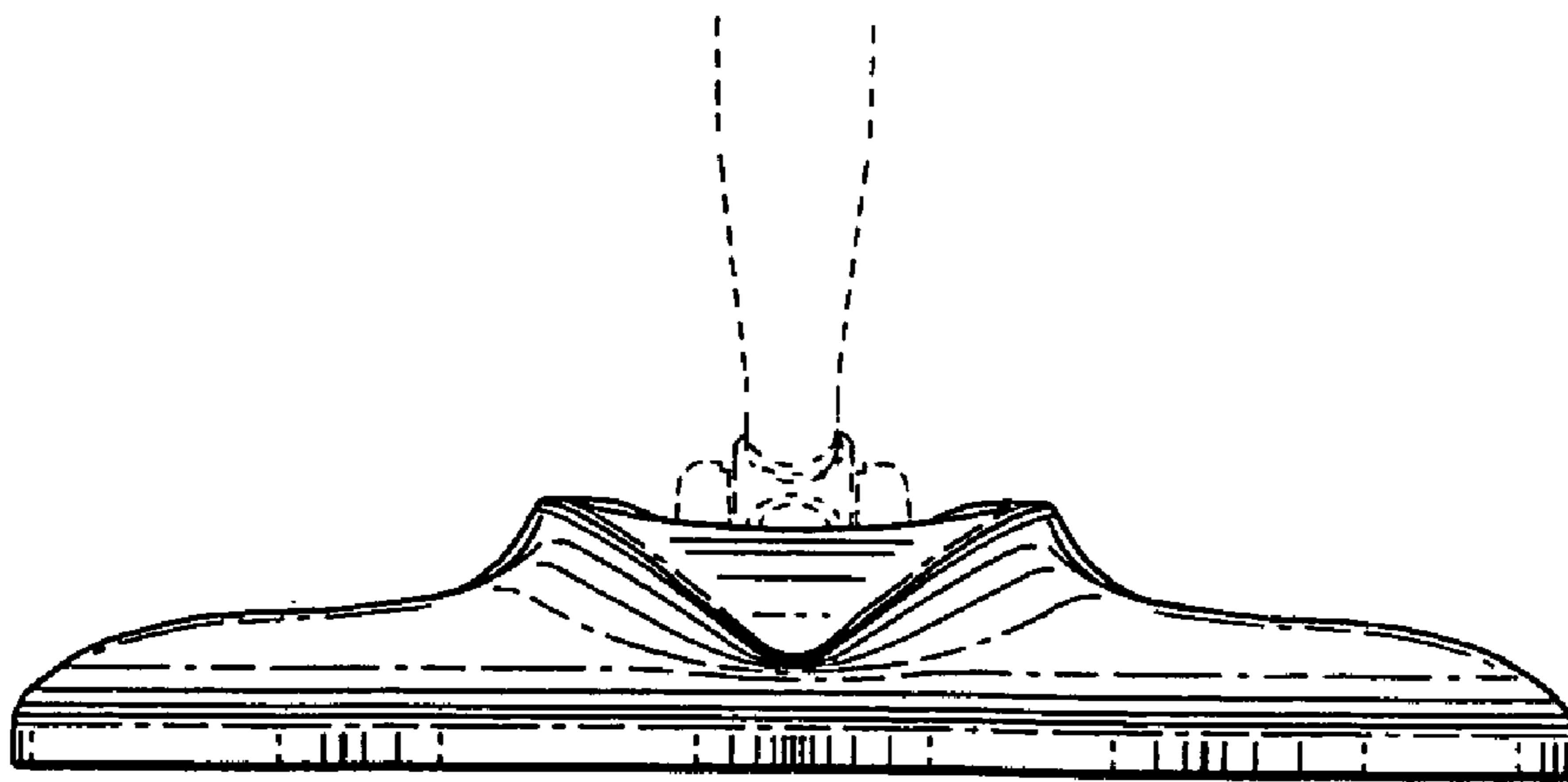

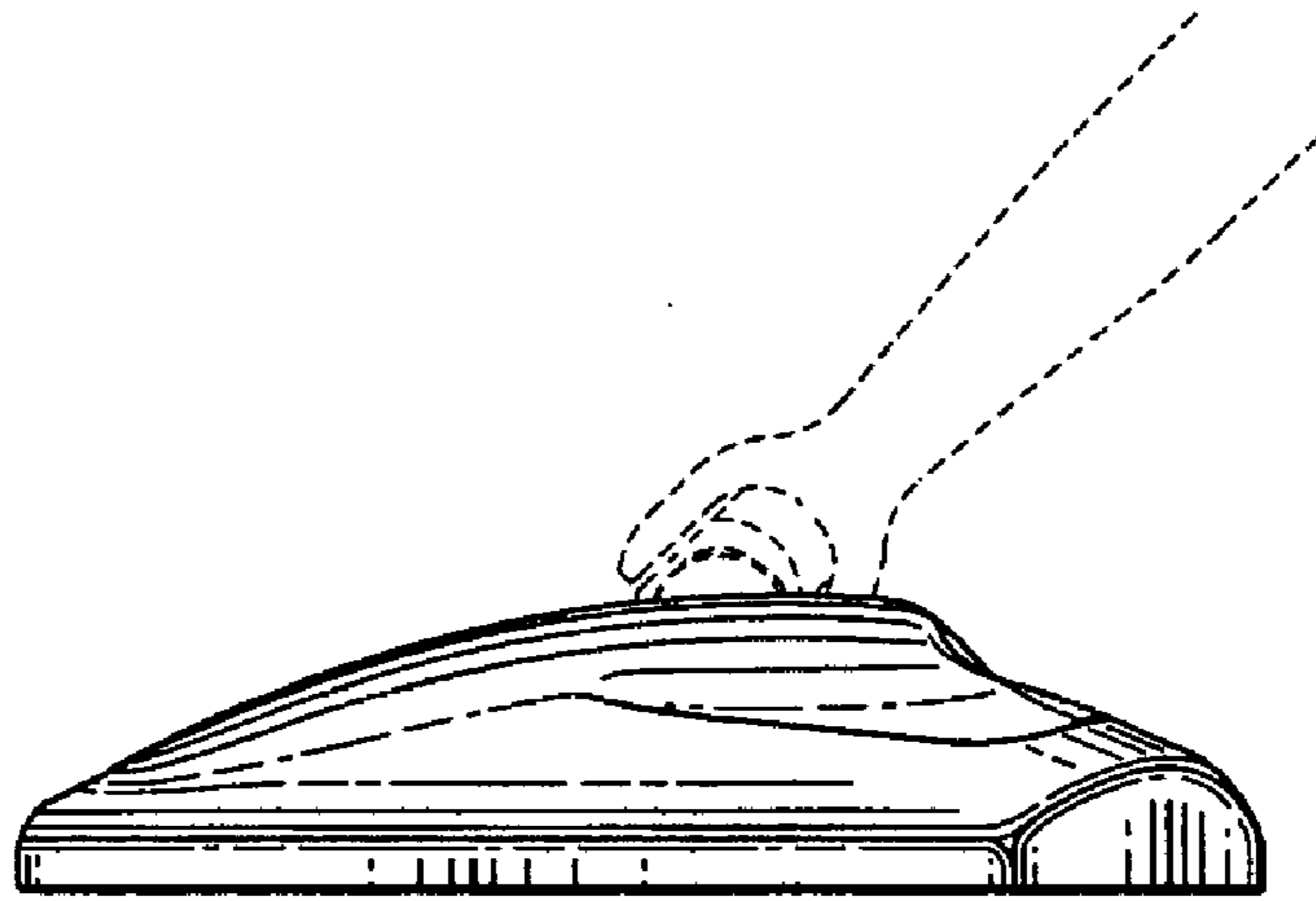

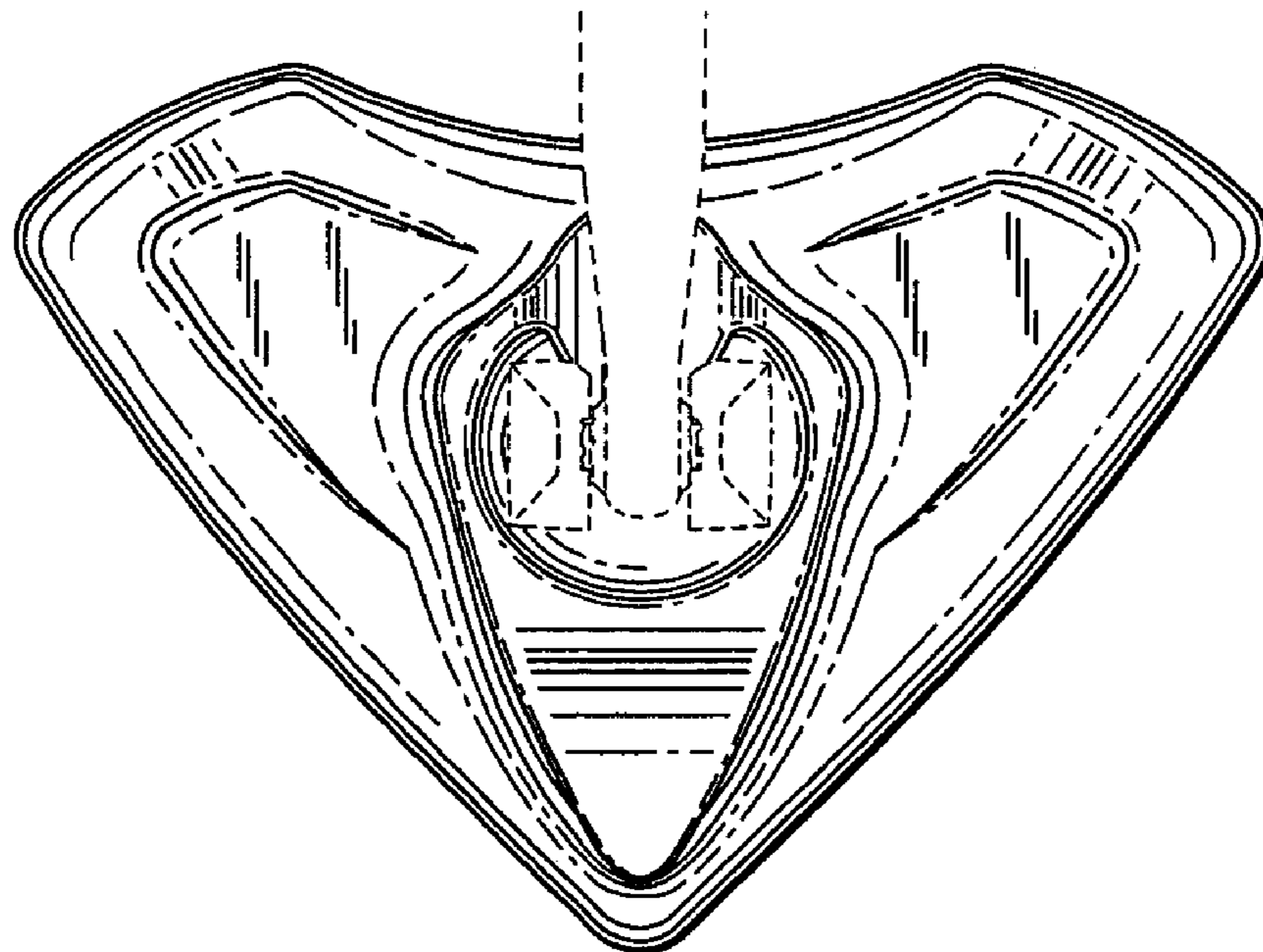

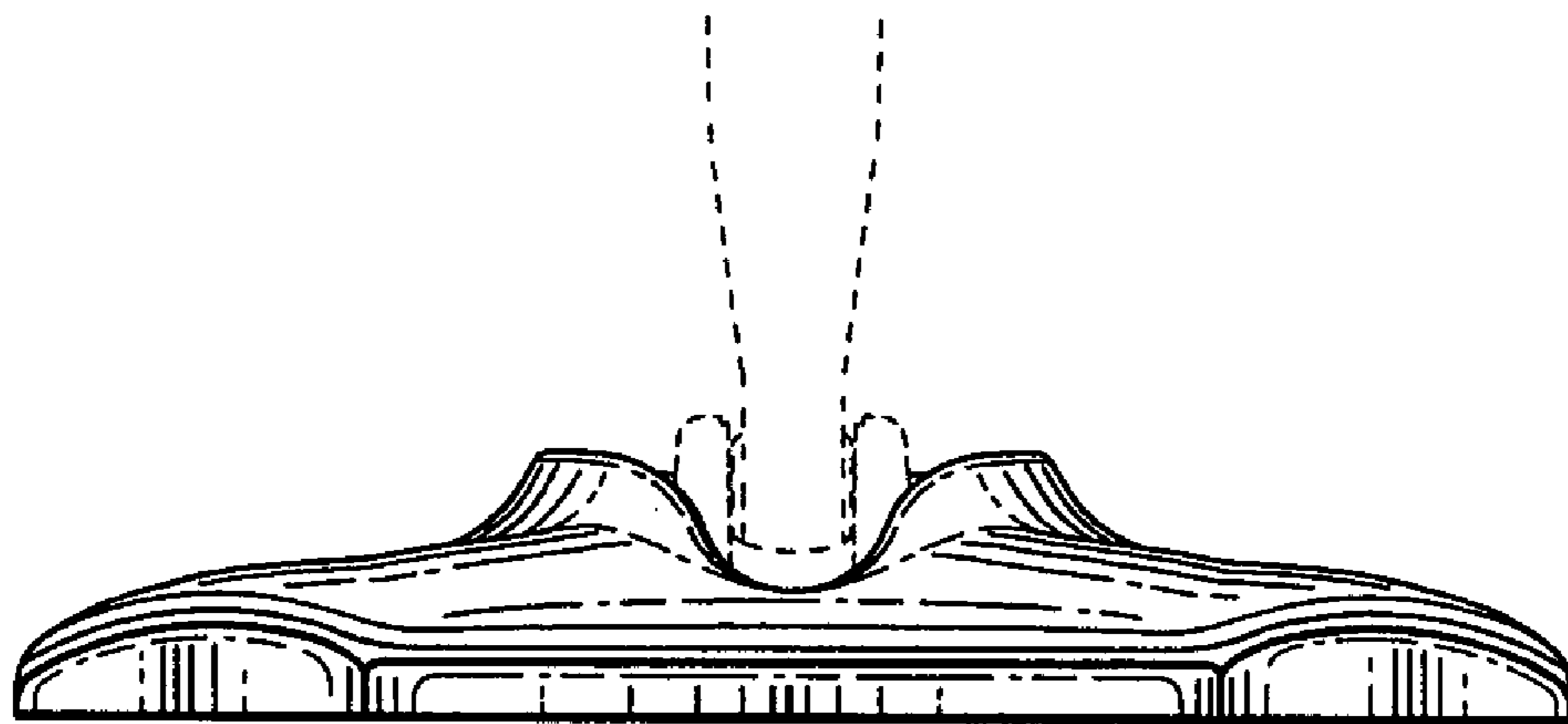

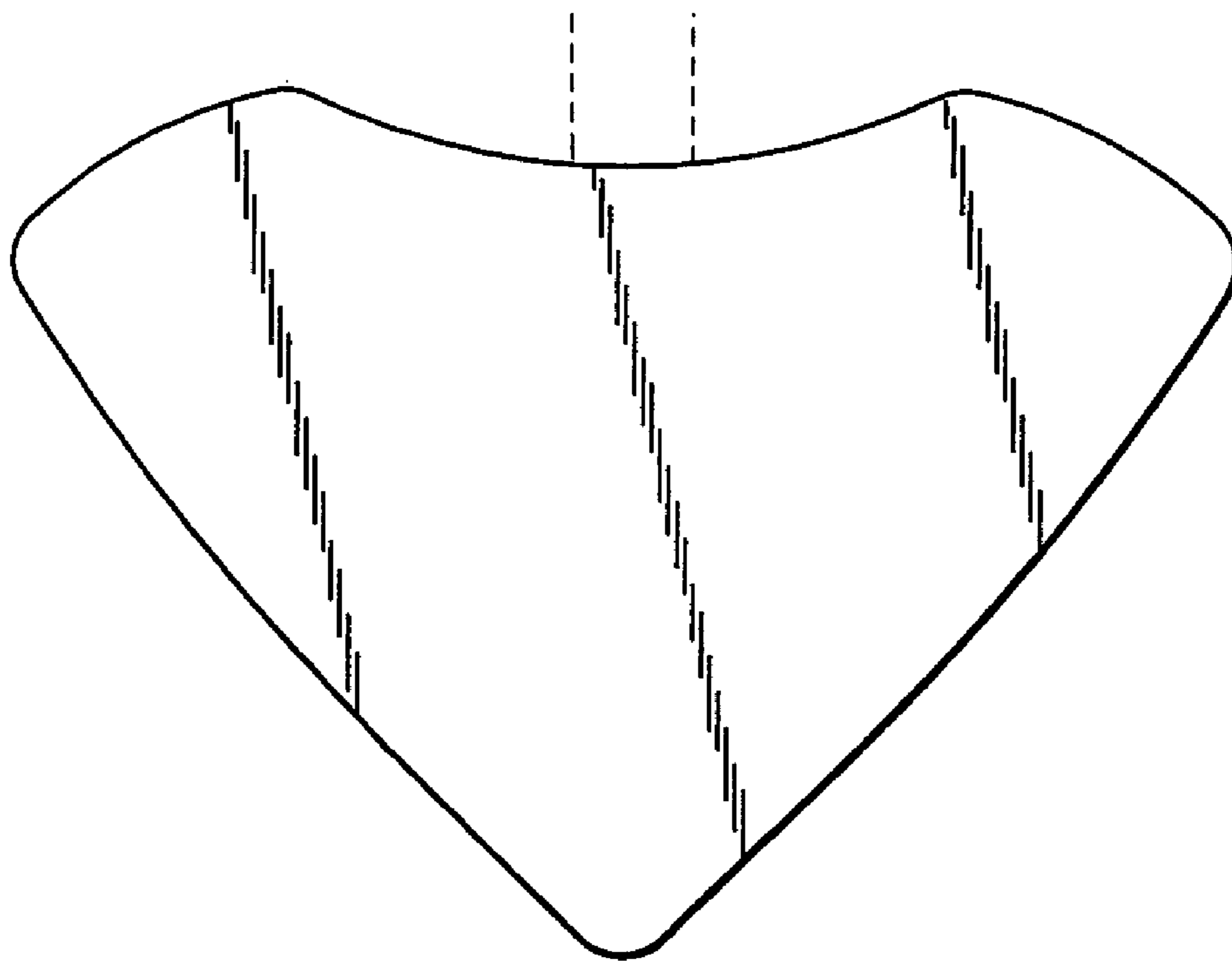
