DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, left perspective view of a chair embodying my new design;

FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view thereof, the right side elevational view being a mirror image thereof;

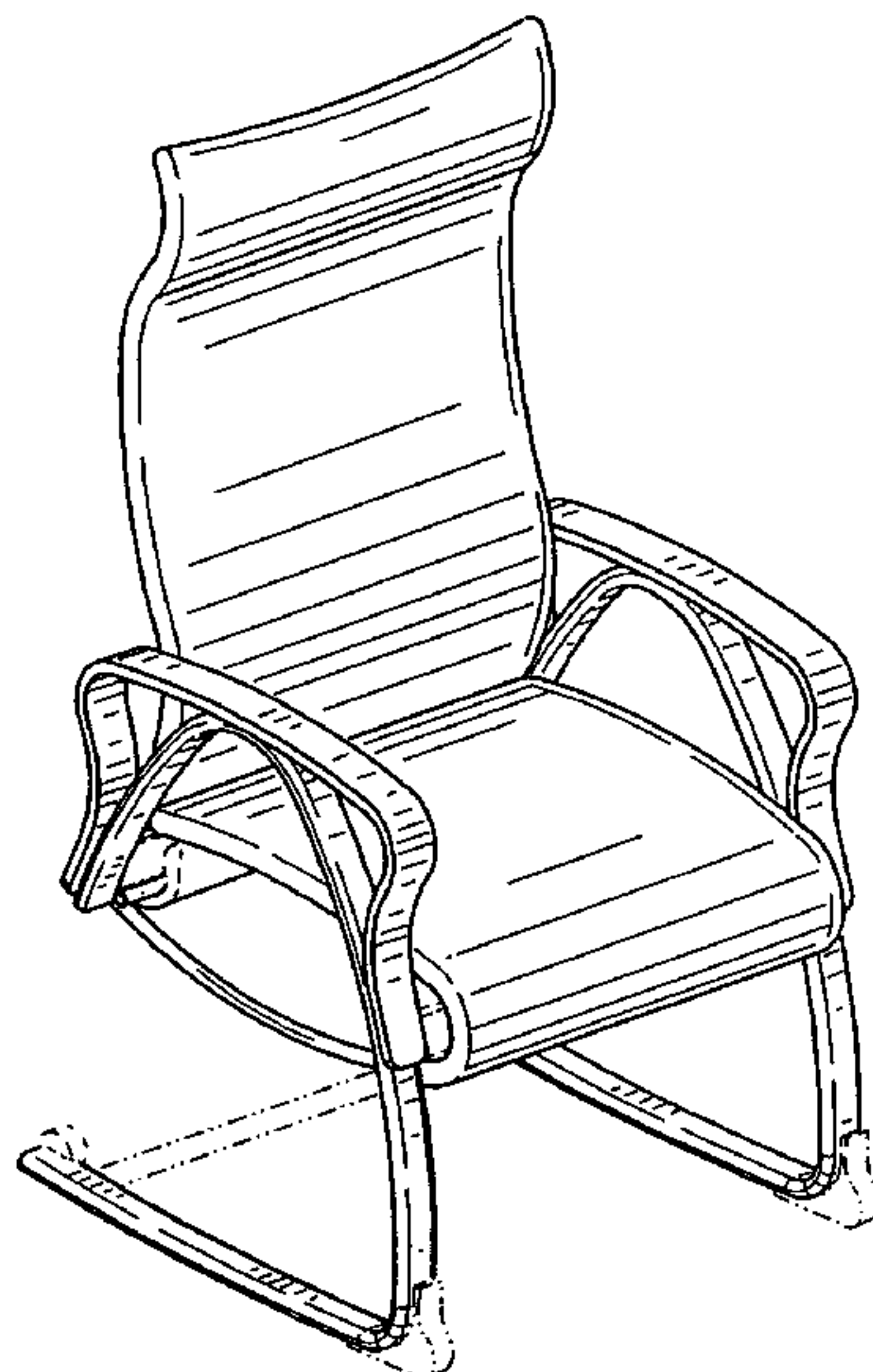

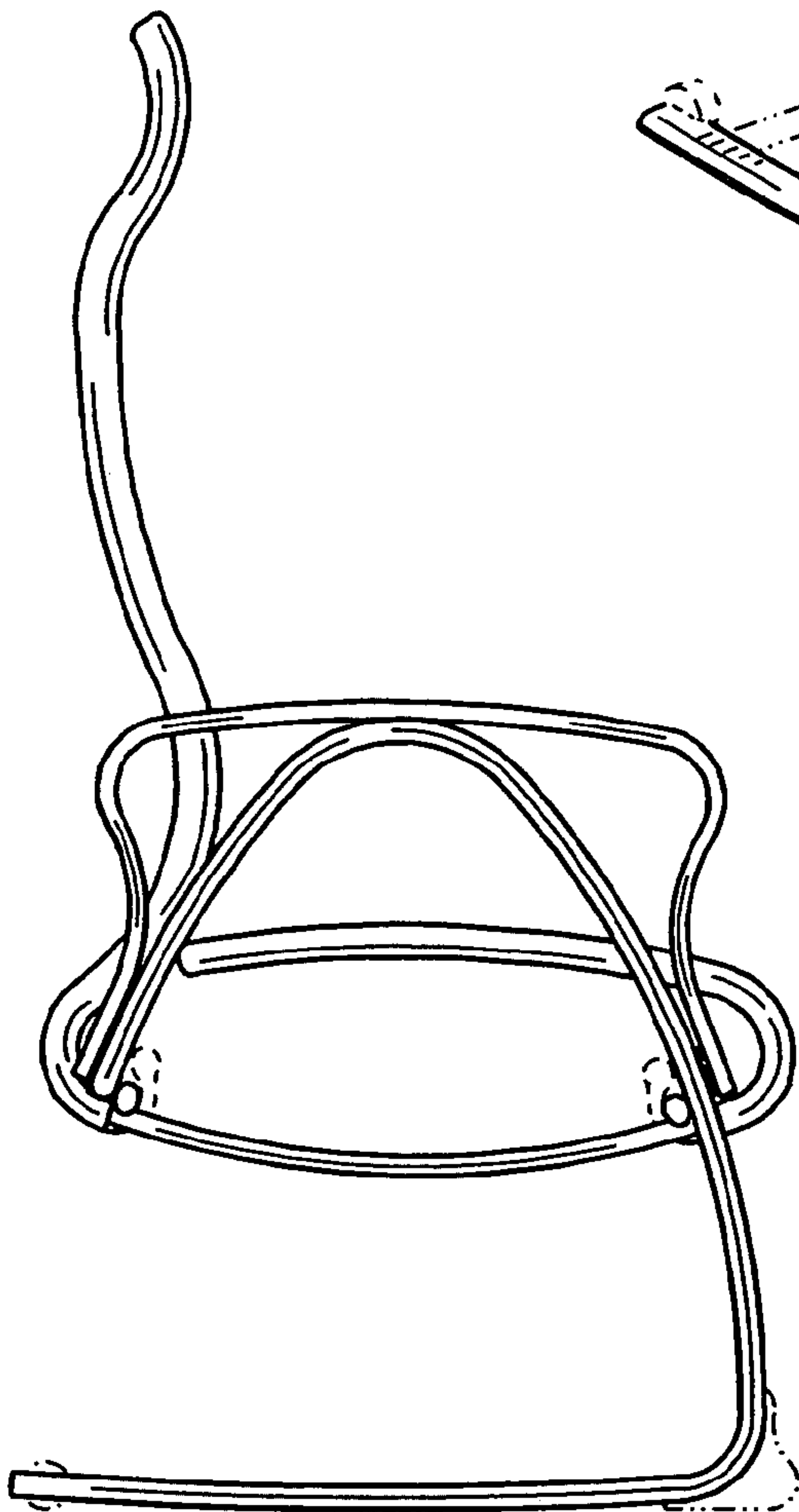
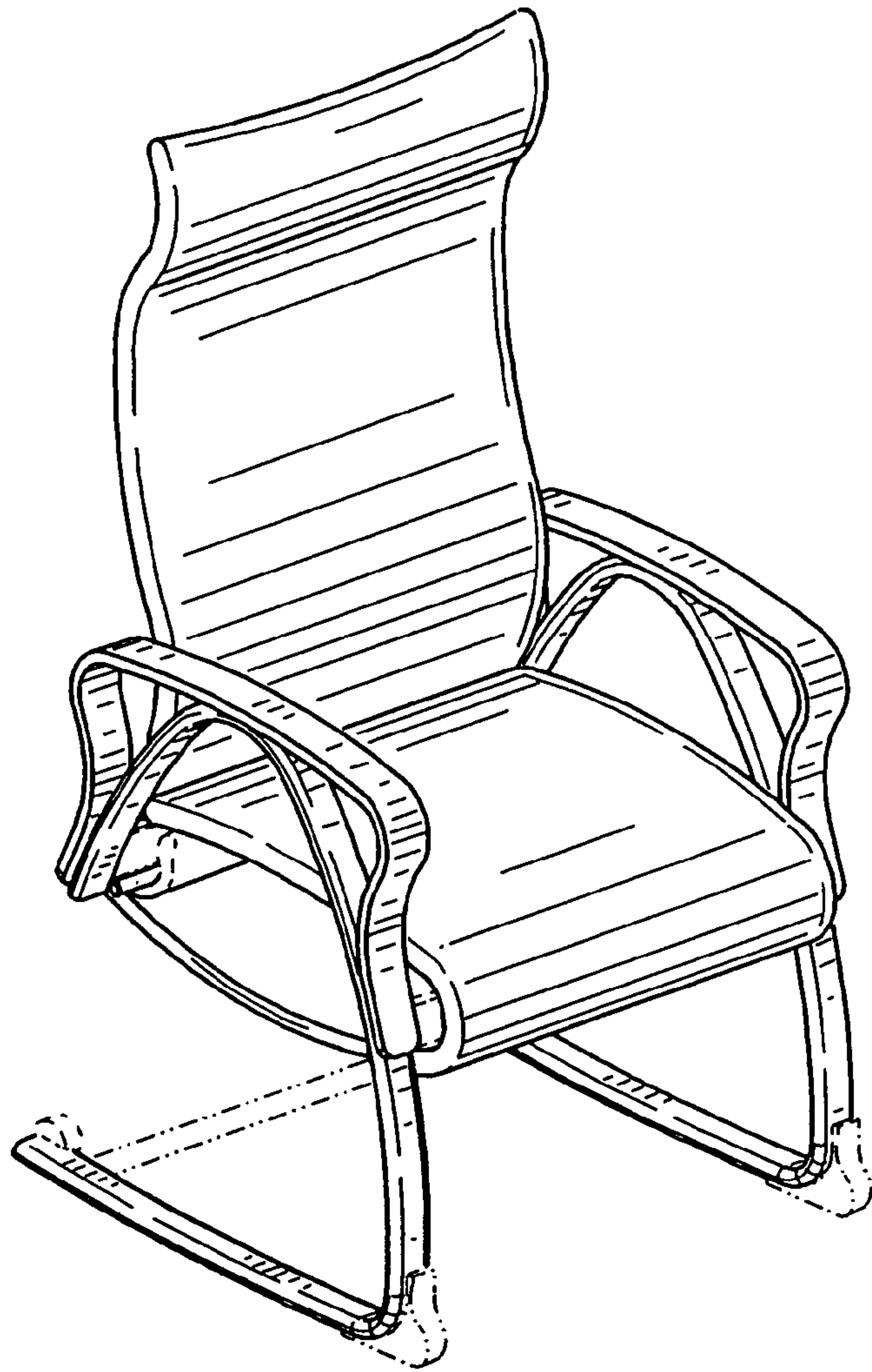

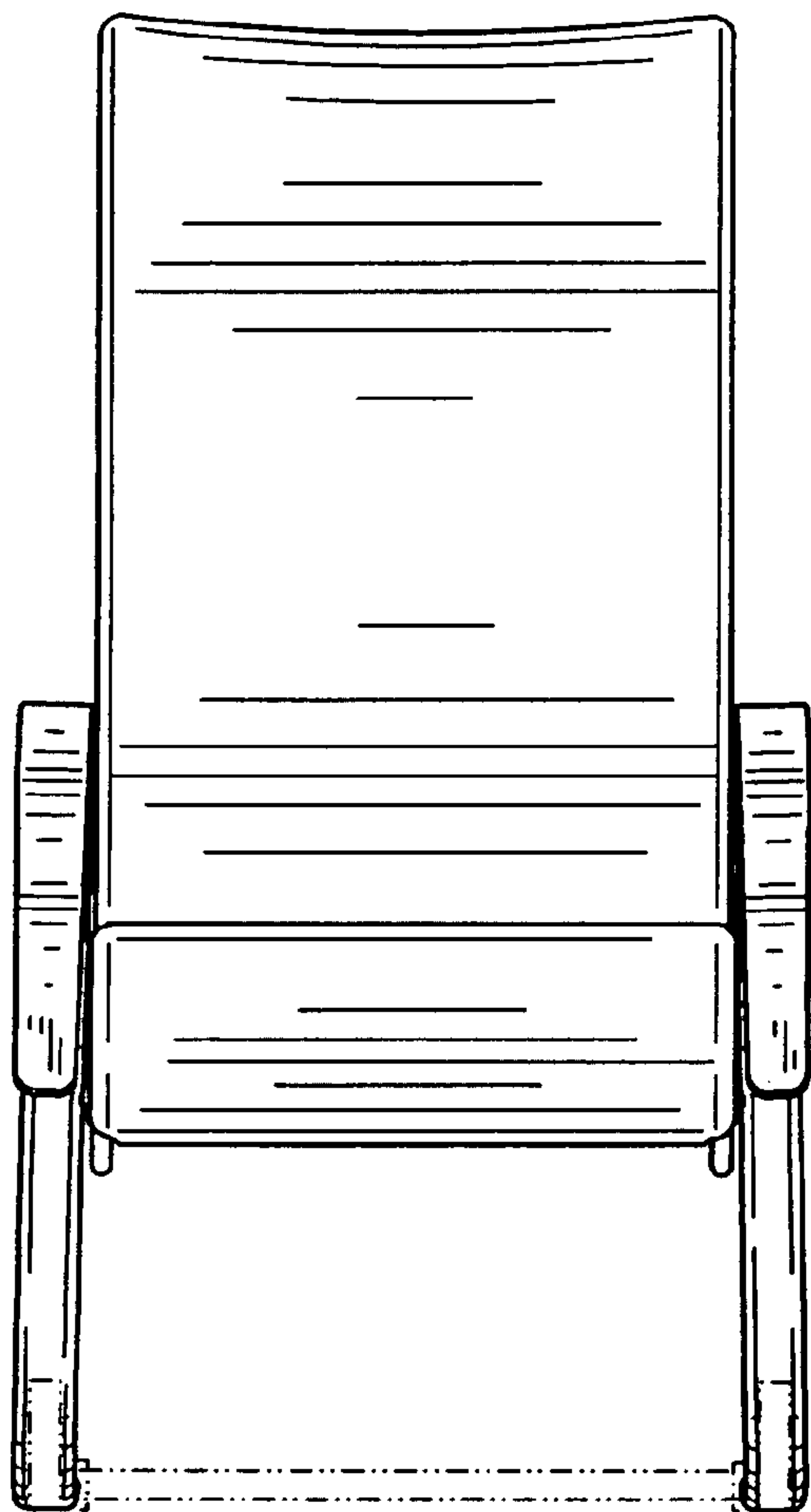

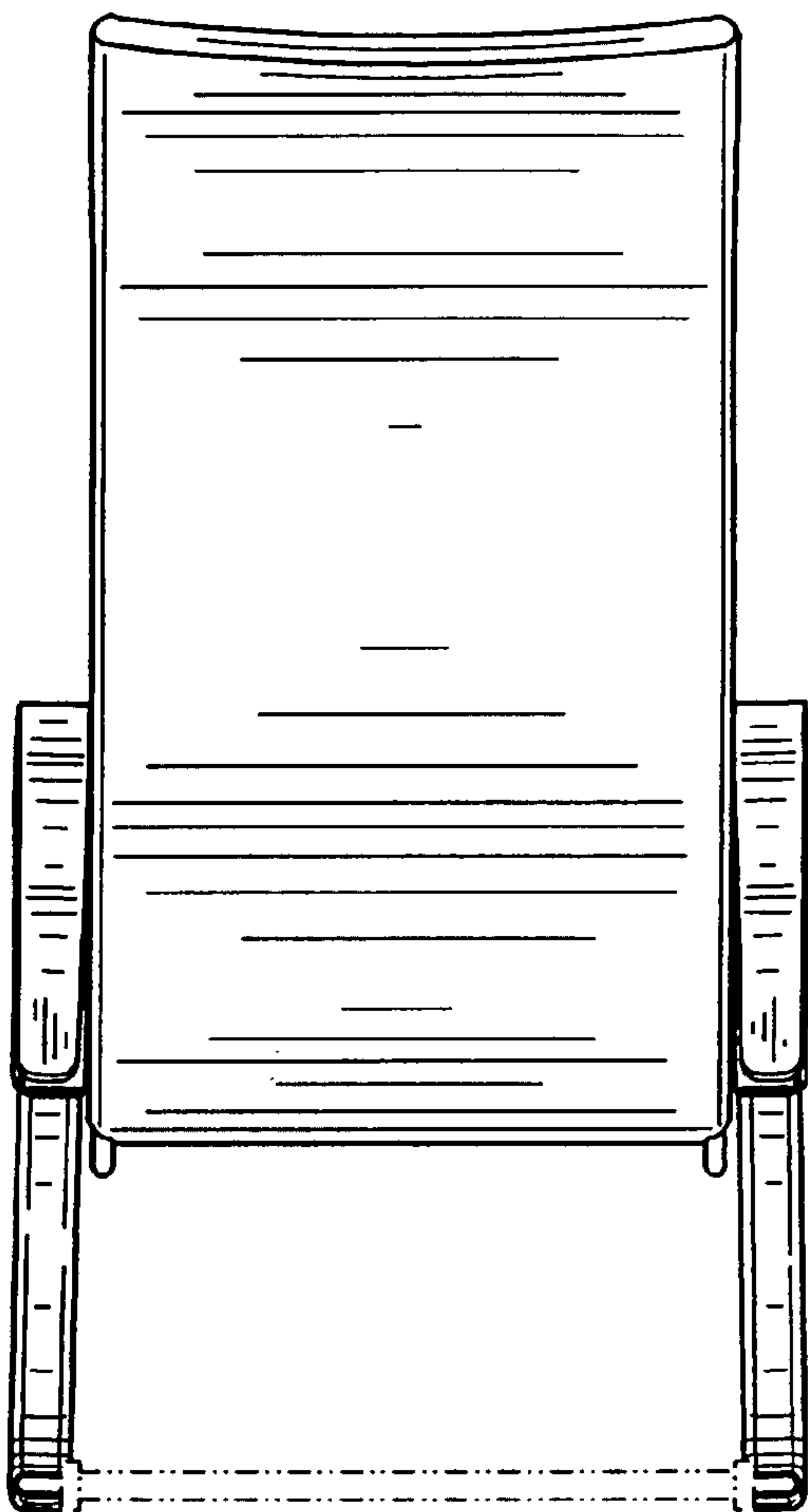

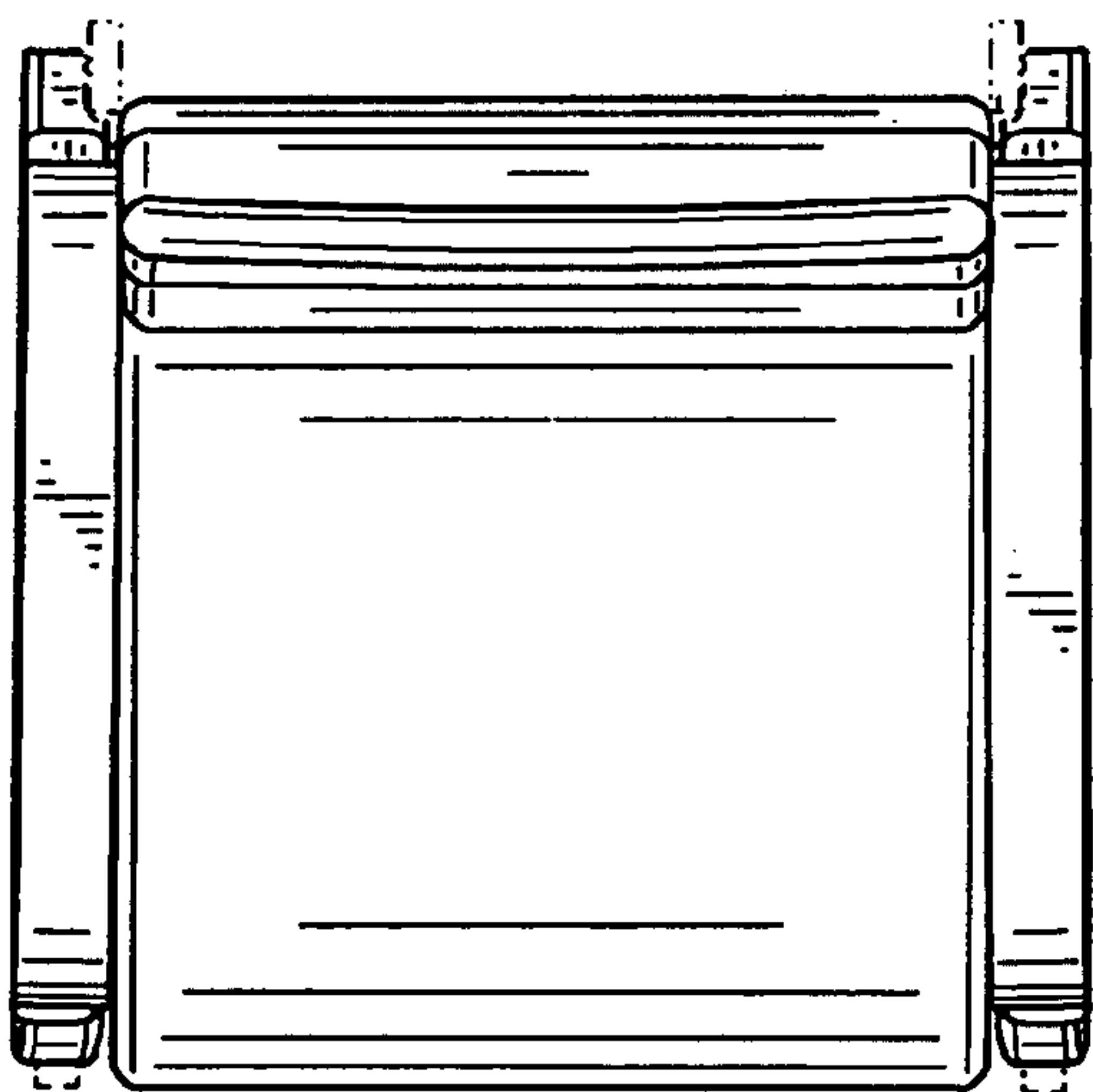
