(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for an ostomy pouch valve and cap, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a minimized front, right side perspective view of an ostomy pouch valve and cap embodying my design, the ostomy pouch is shown in broken lines and not forming a part of the design;

FIG. 2 is an enlarged, inverted left side elevational view thereof, the right side being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 3 is a top plan thereof as seen in FIG. 2;

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof;

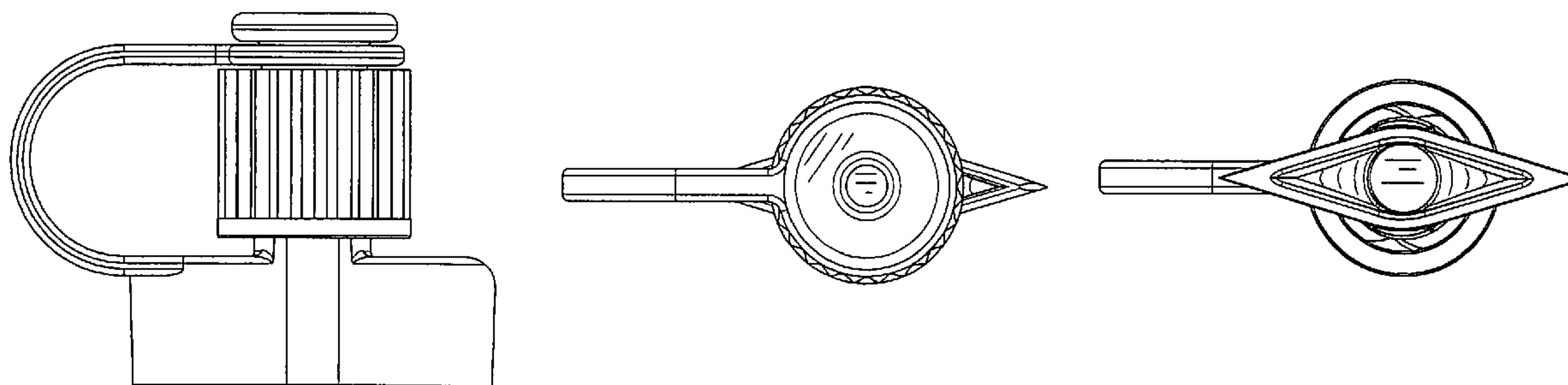
FIG. 7 is a left side, elevational view of the valve and cap with the cap opened;

FIG. 8 is a plan view of the cap along line 8—8 of FIG. 7;

FIG. 9 is a top view of the valve and cap with the cap open; and,

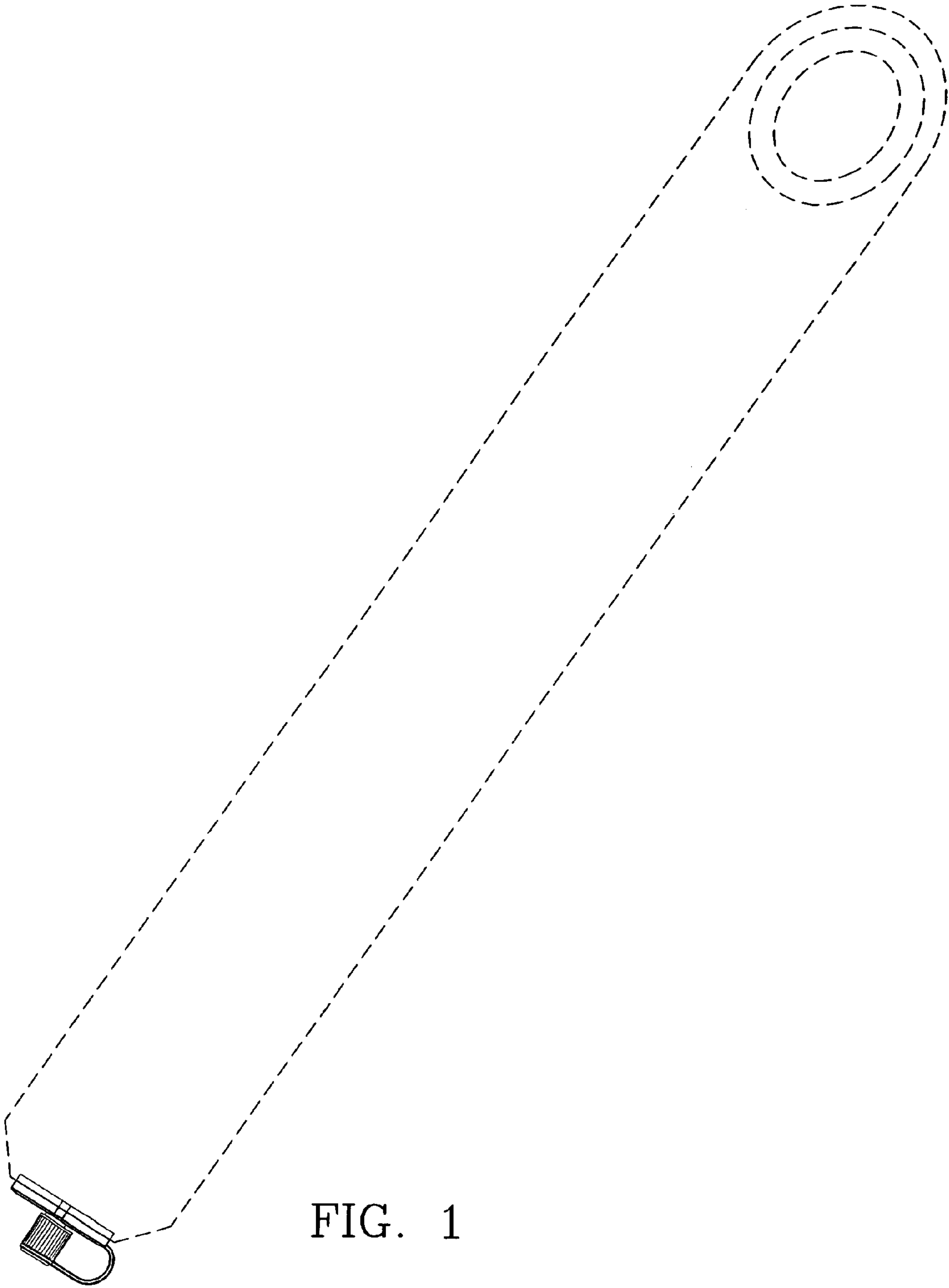

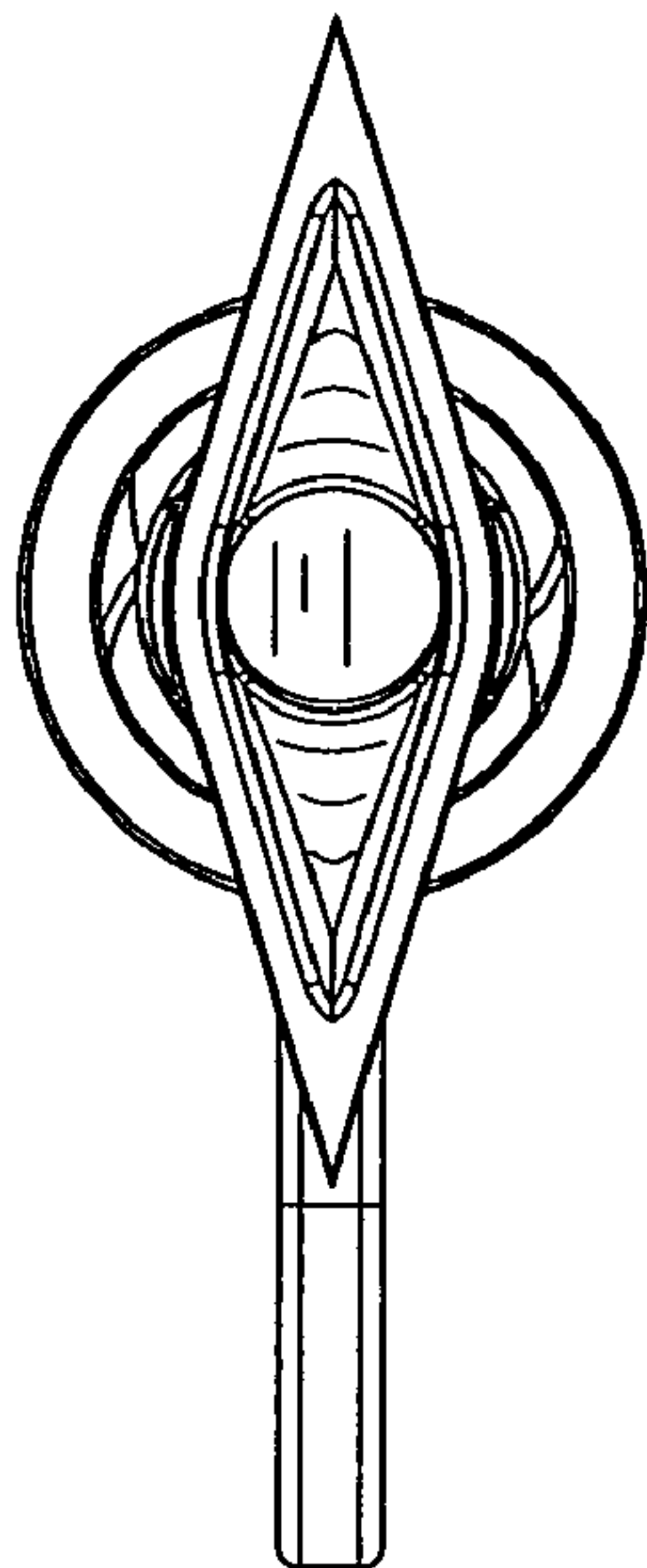

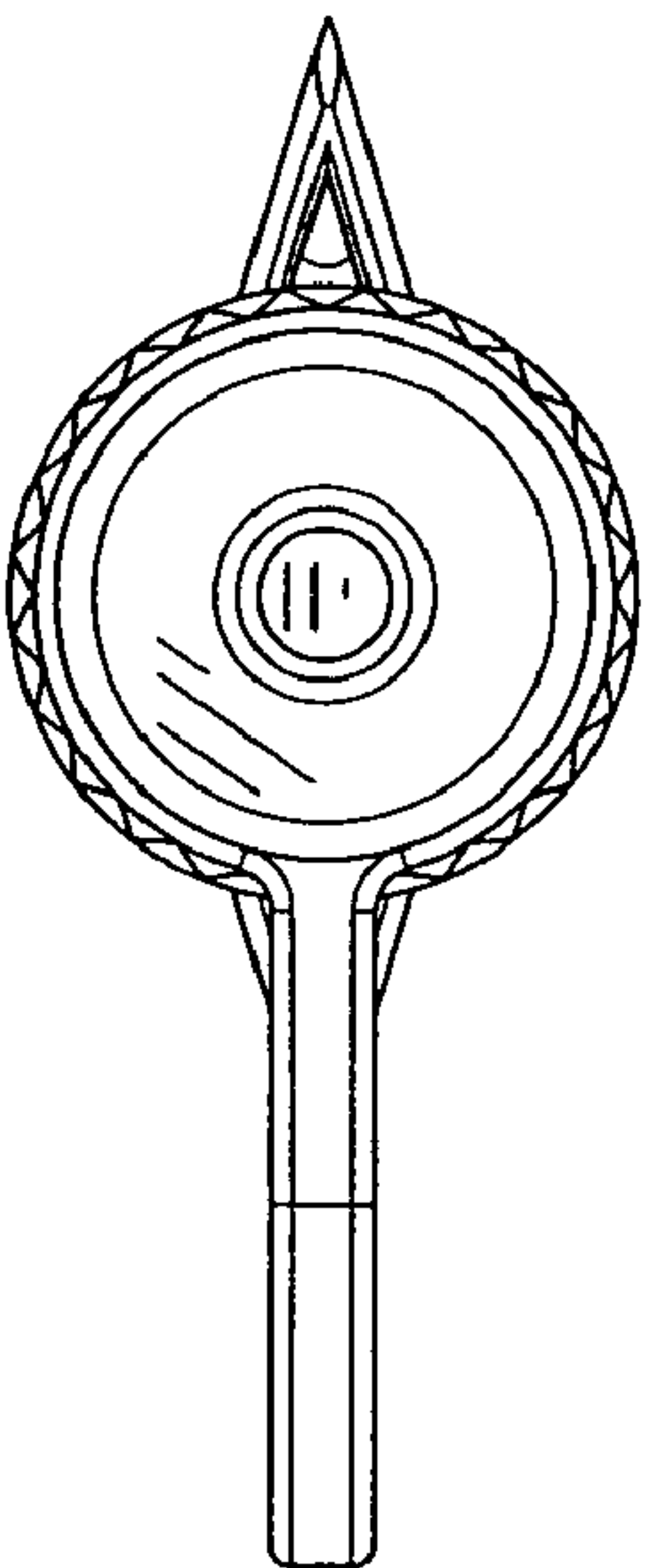

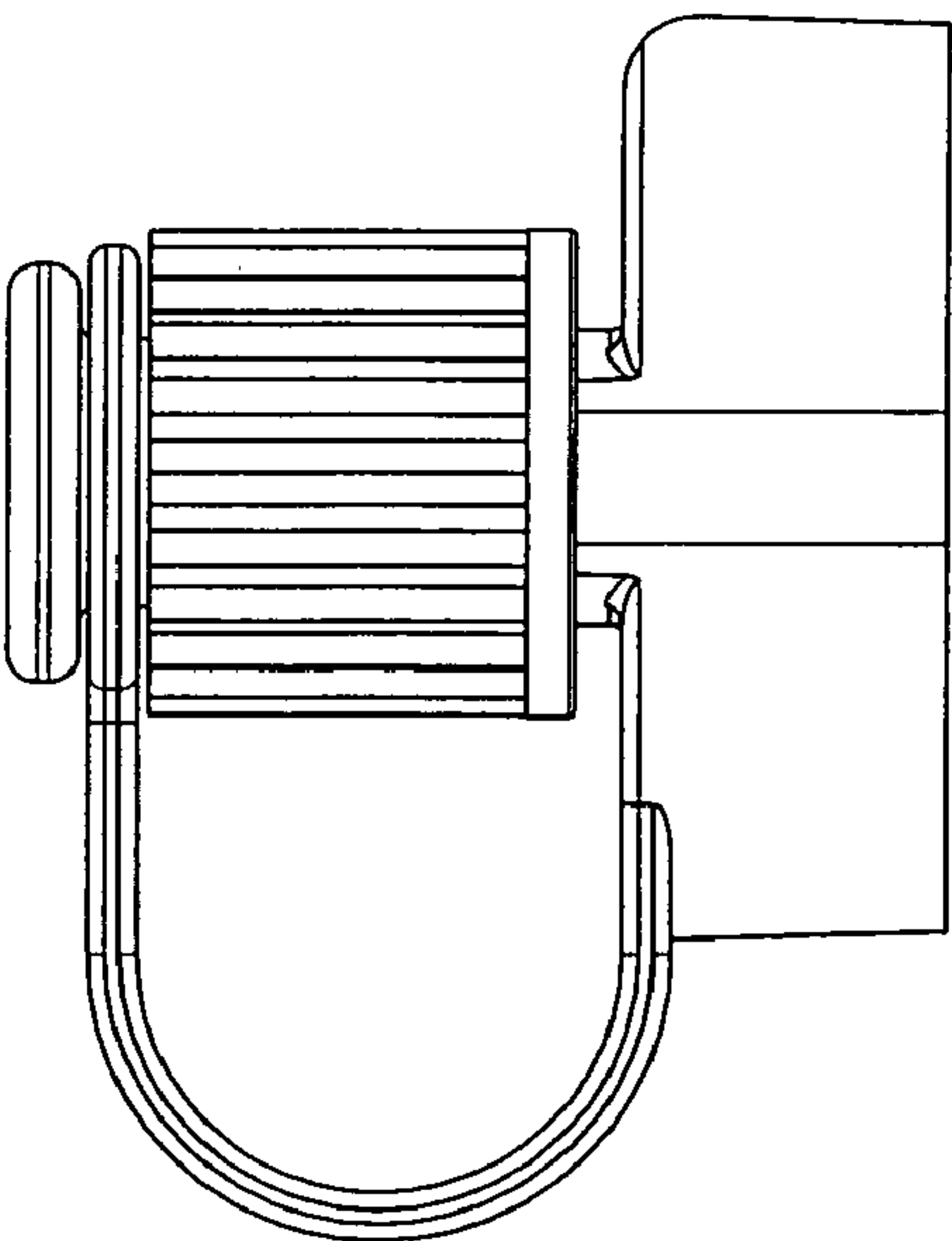

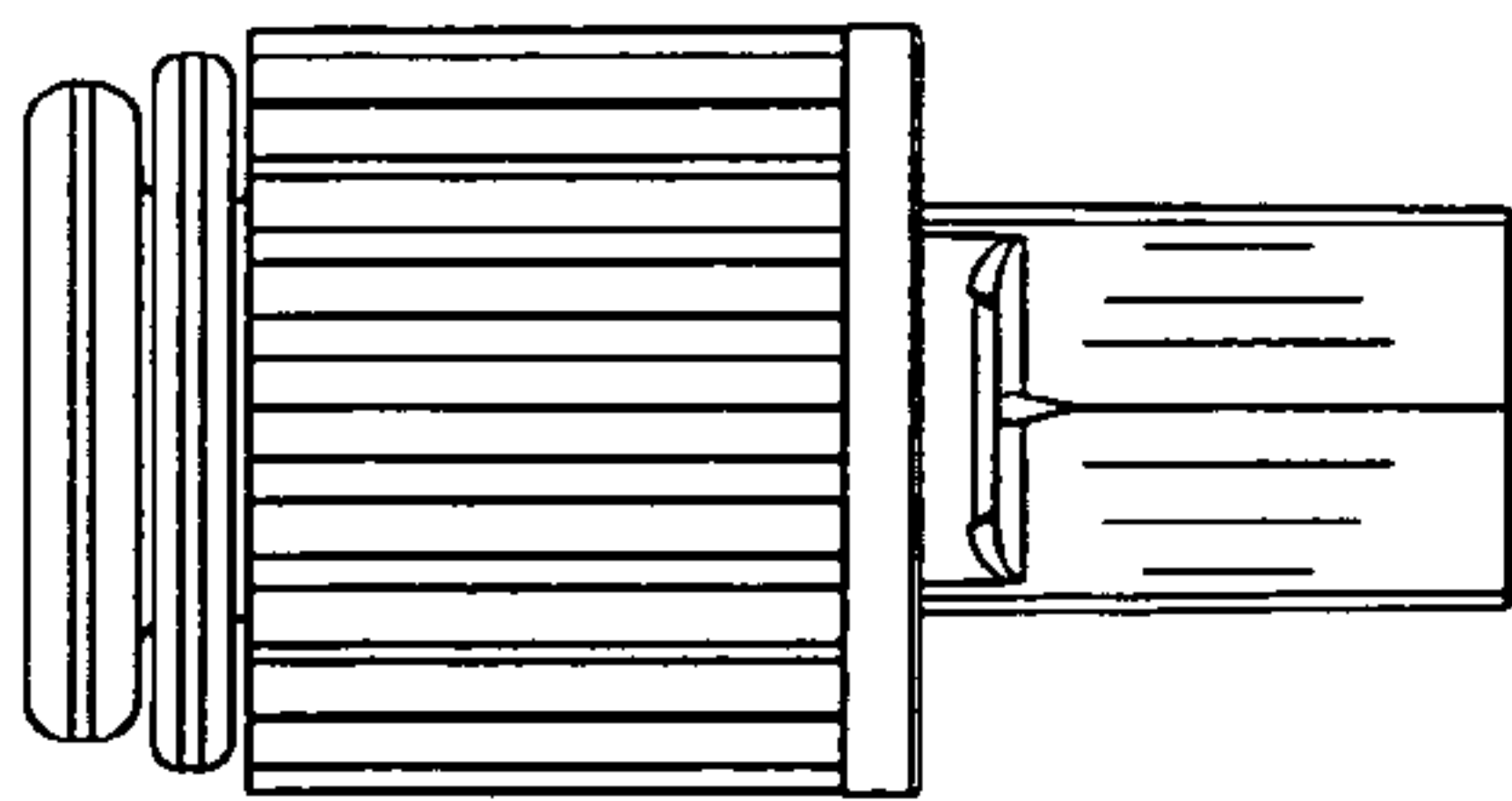

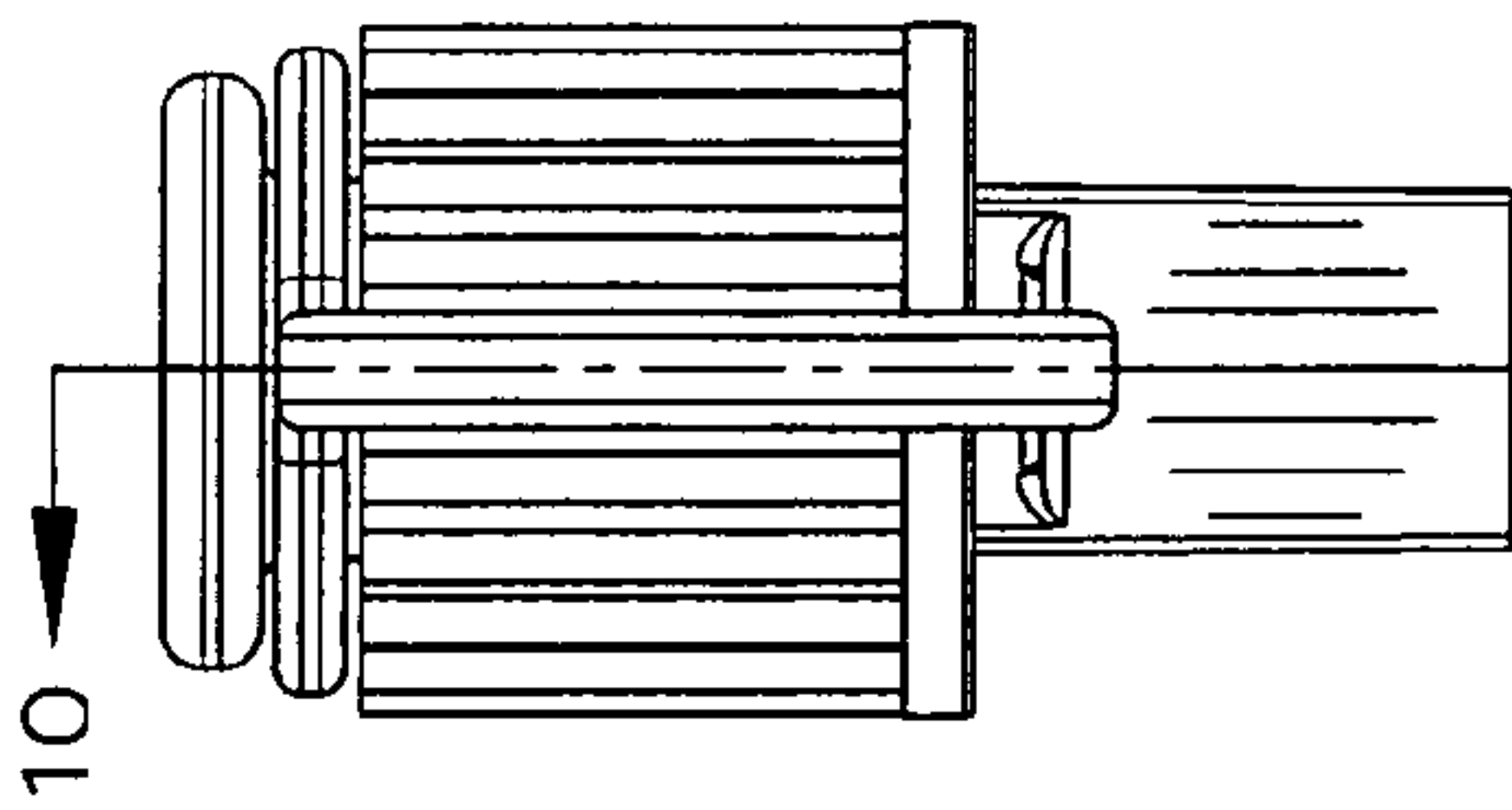

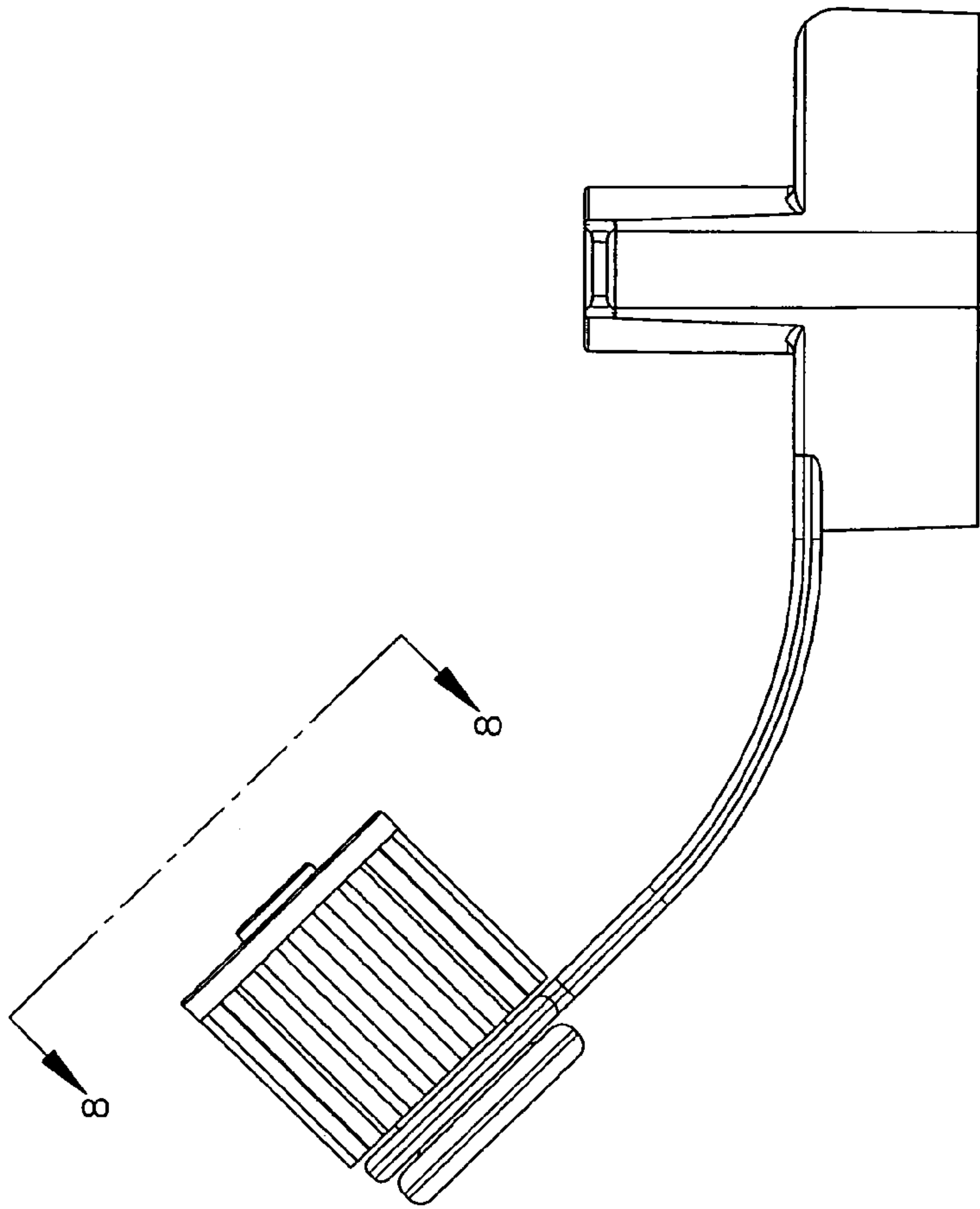

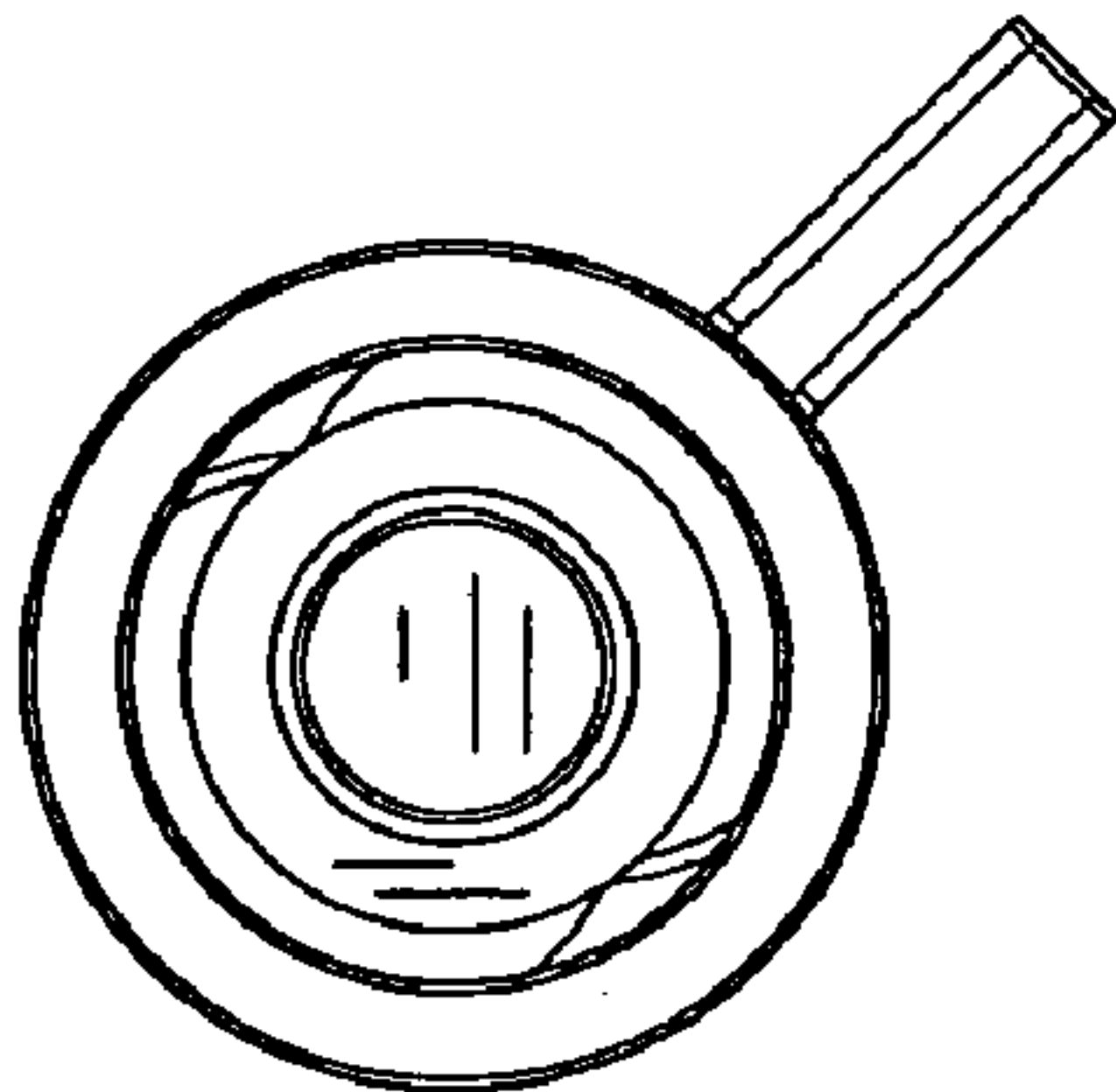

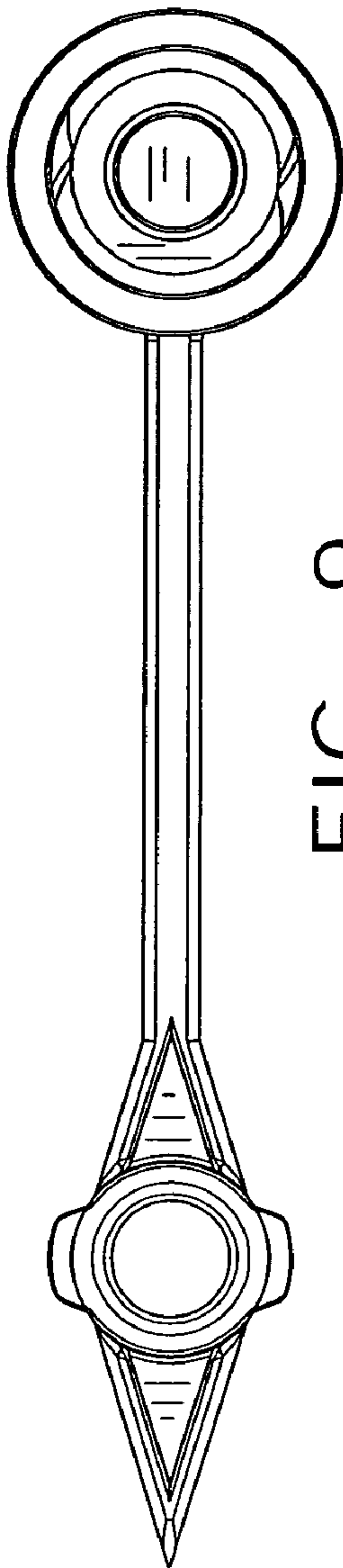

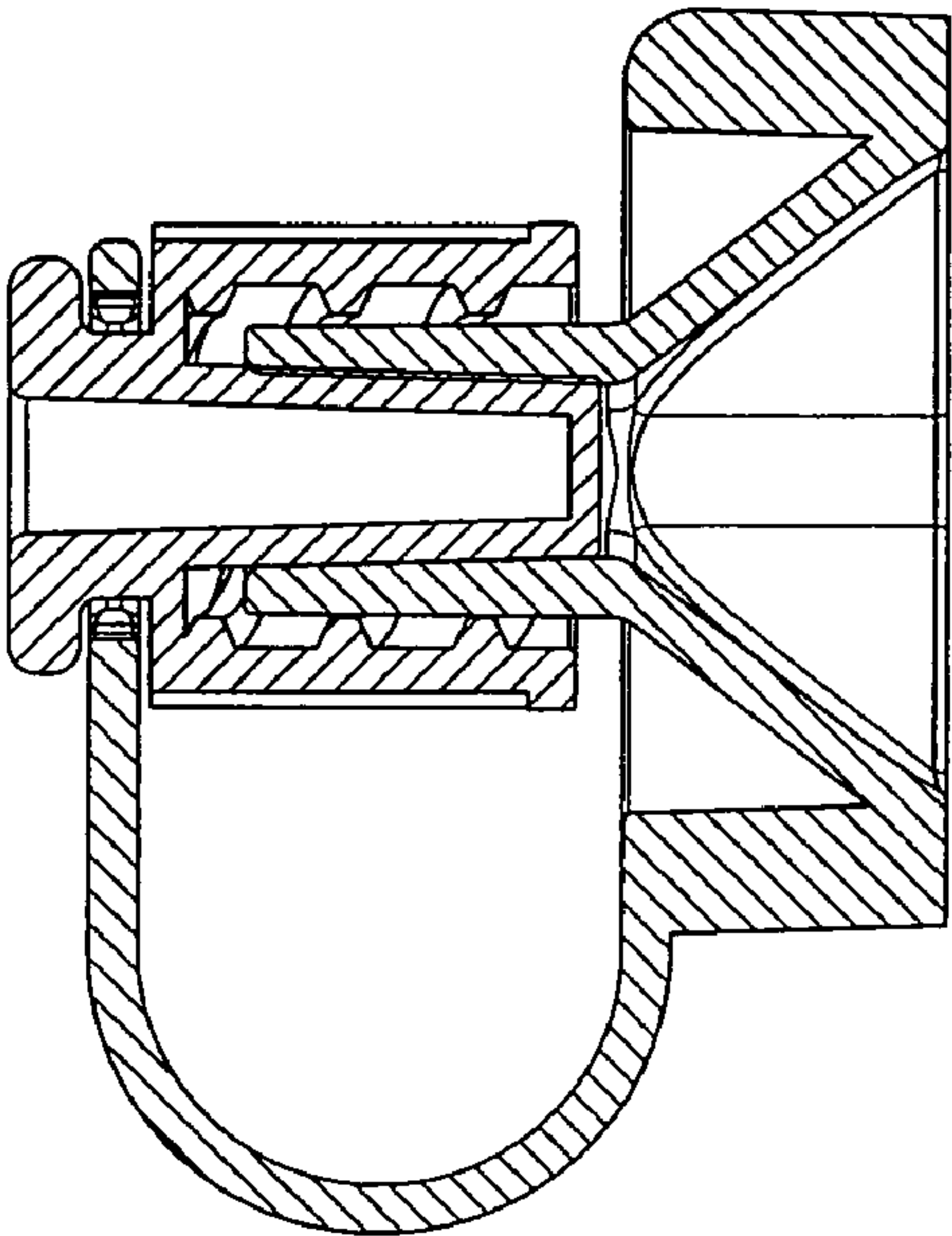
