CLAIM


The ornamental design for a portion of a laundry appliance, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a portion of a laundry appliance showing our new design; and,

FIG. 2 is a front view thereof.

The broken line(s) which define the bounds of the claimed design form no part thereof. The broken line showing of unshaded portions of the laundry appliance is included for the purpose of illustrating environmental matter and forms no part of the claimed design. The difference in shading indicates a contrast of appearance and does not depict any particular color, texture, or material.




