FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the furniture post embodying the new design;

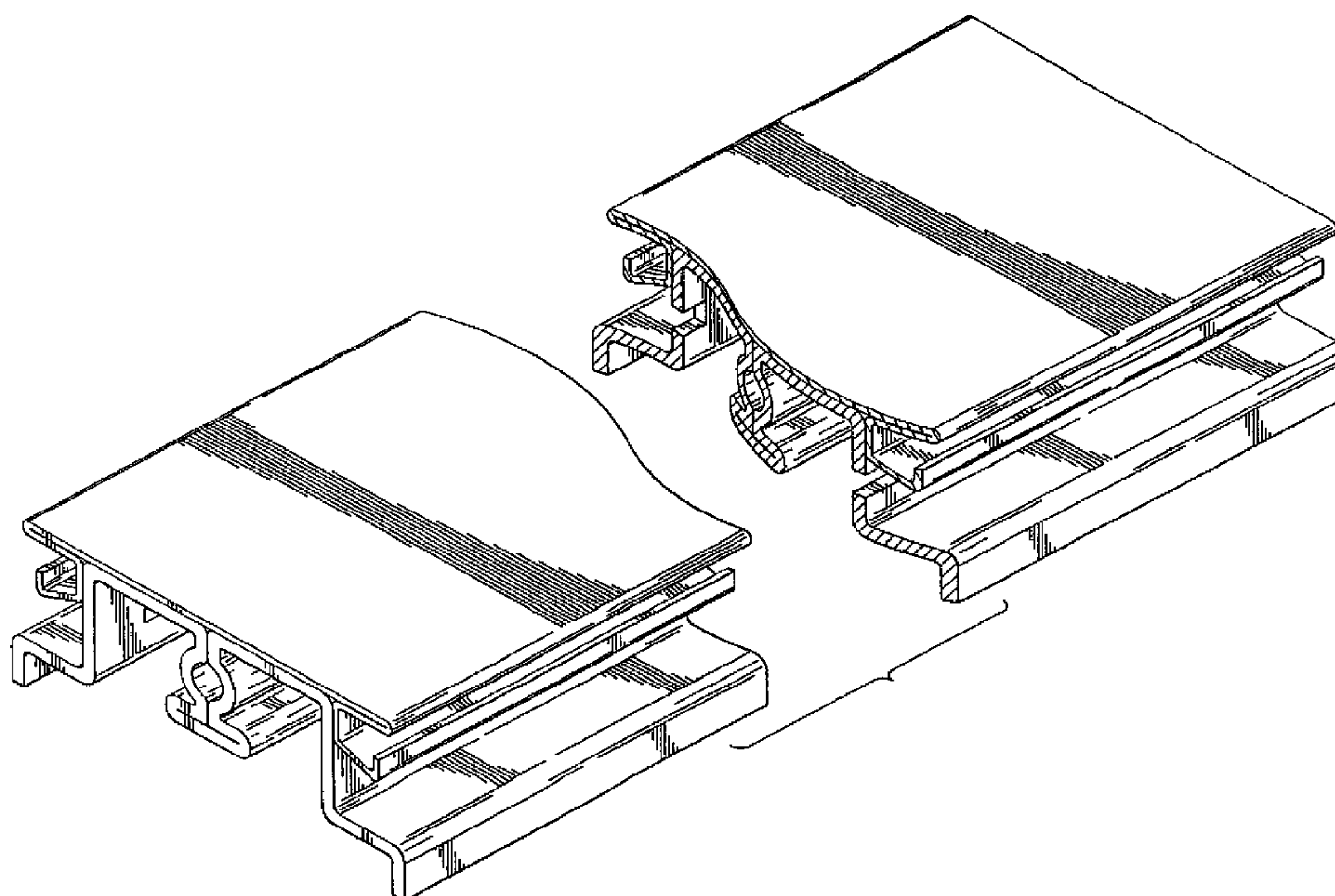
FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view, the right side being a mirror image thereof;

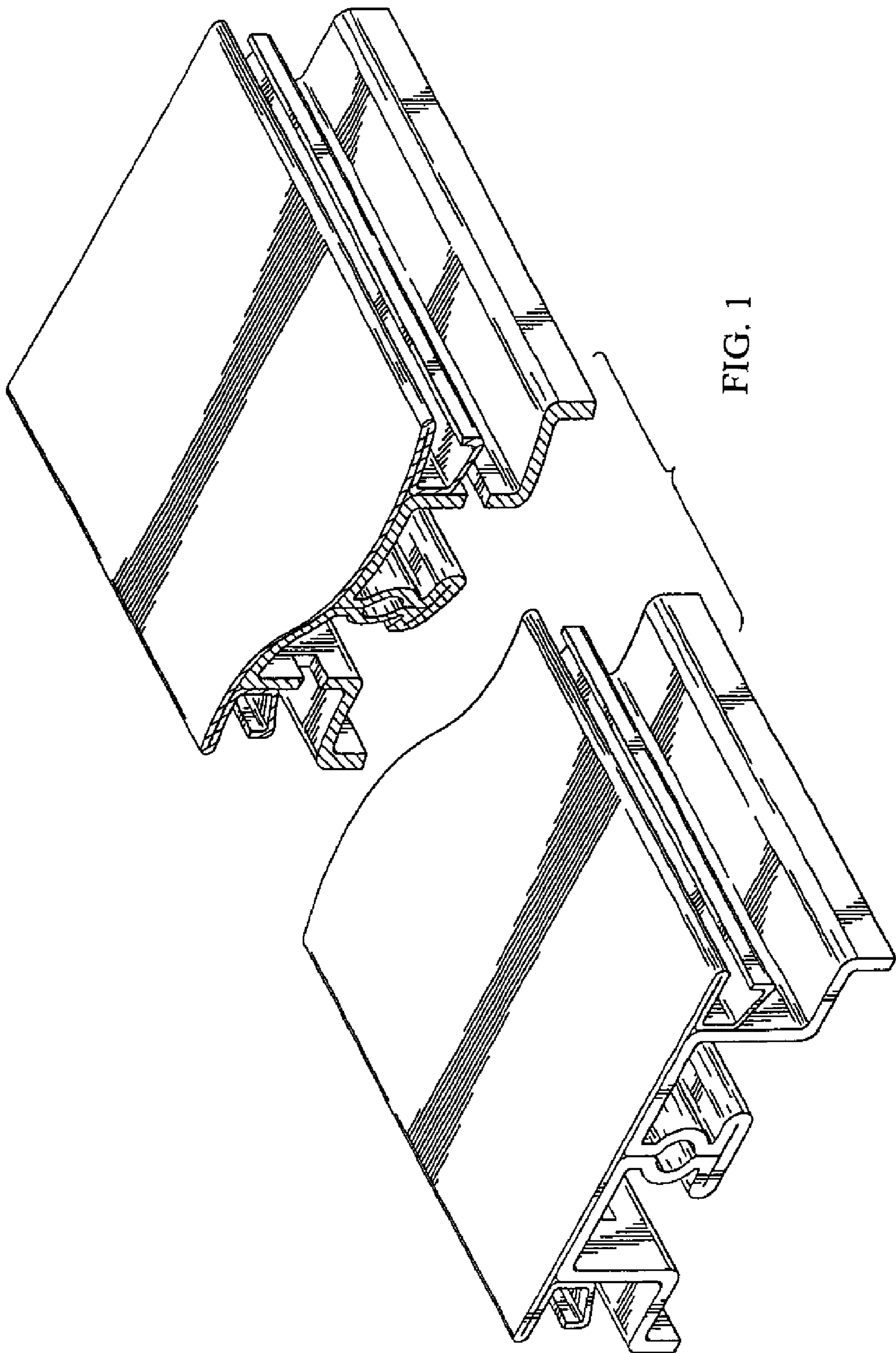

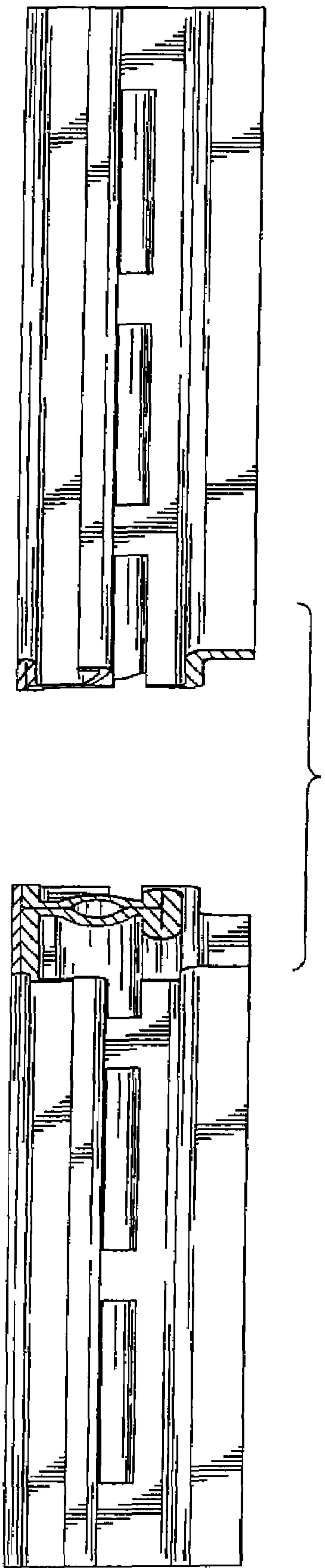

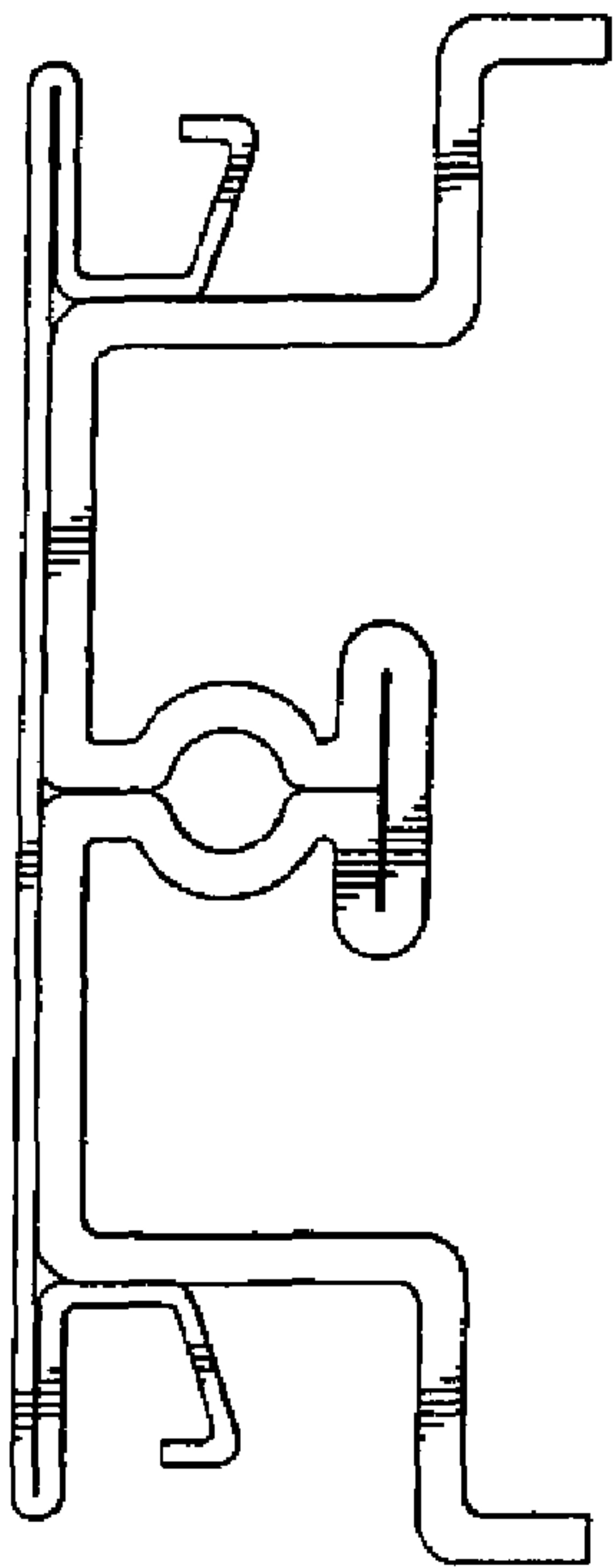

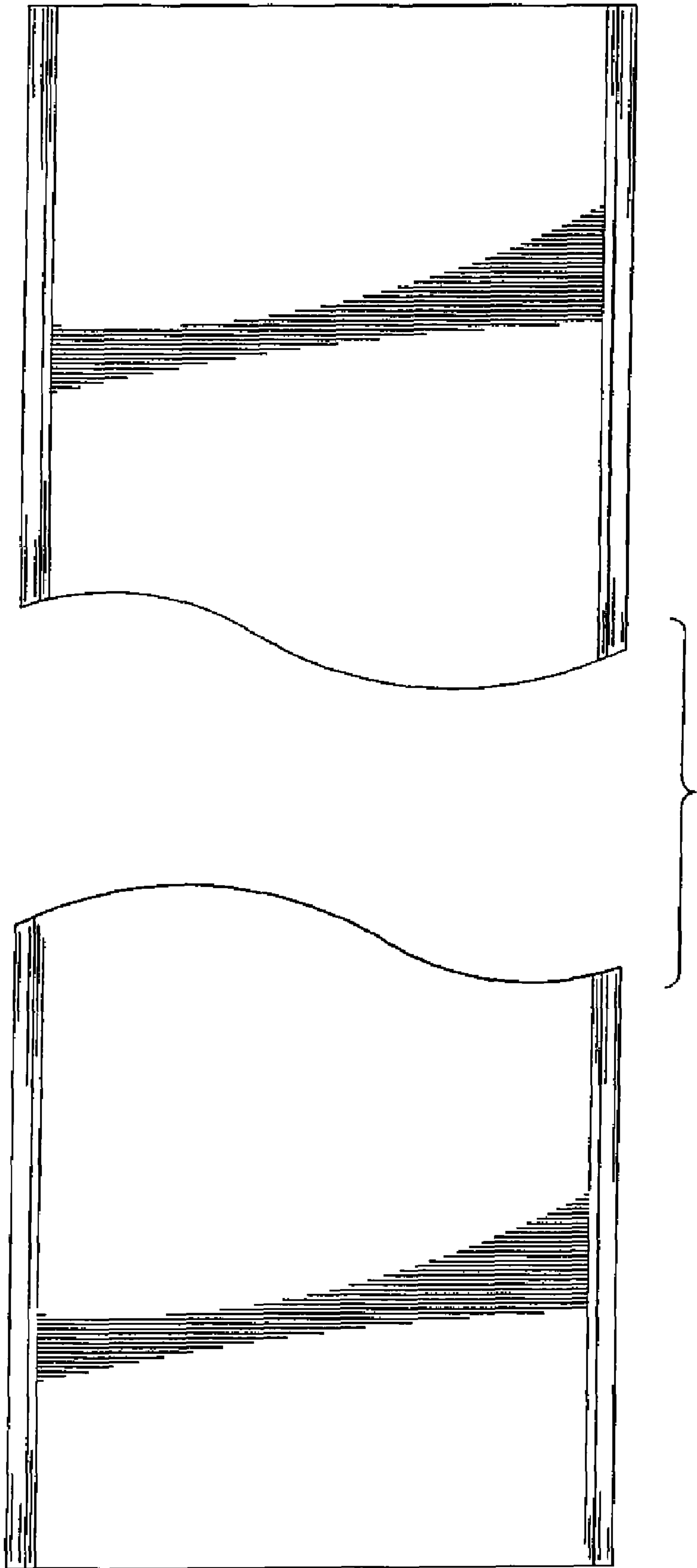

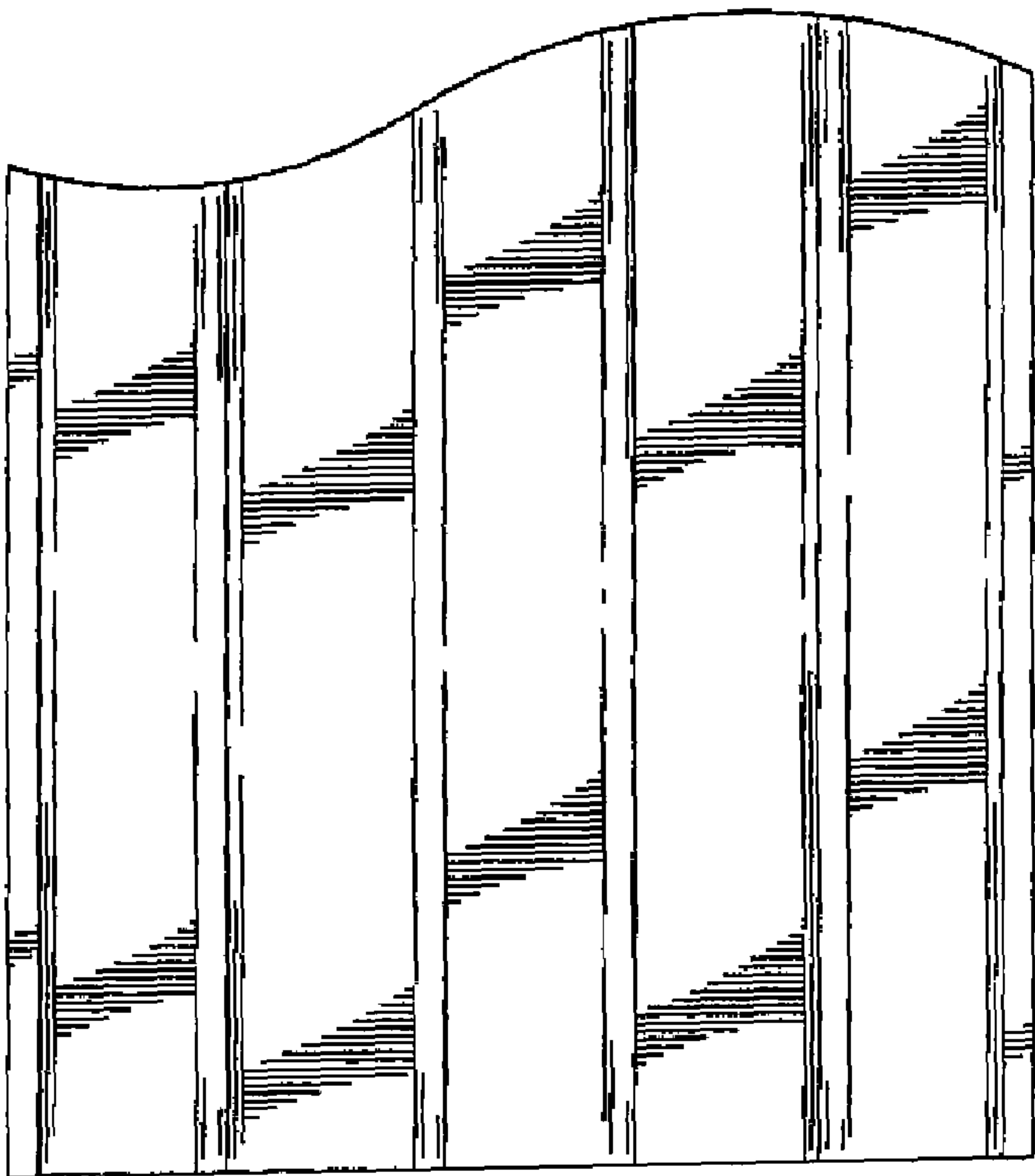
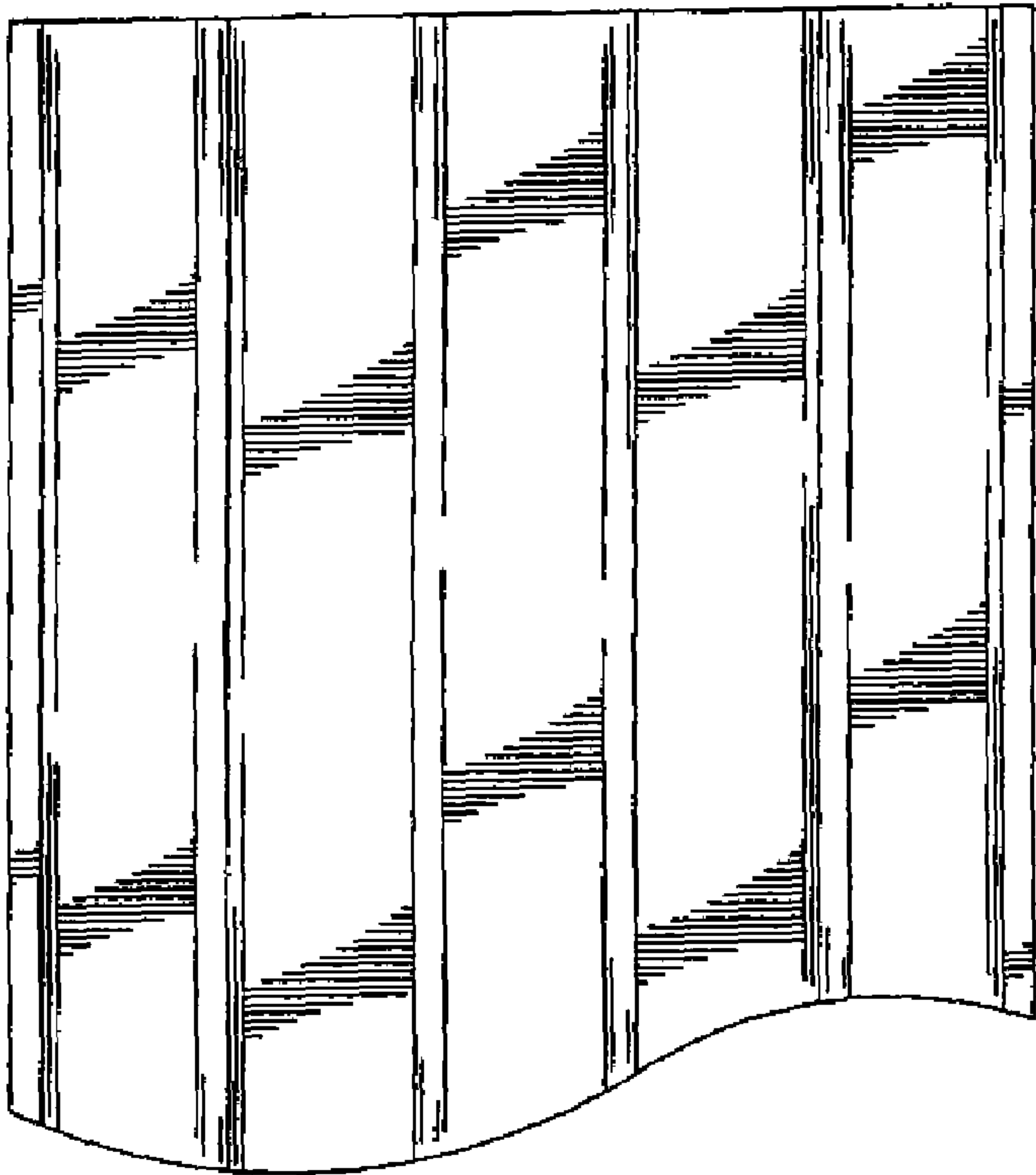
